FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

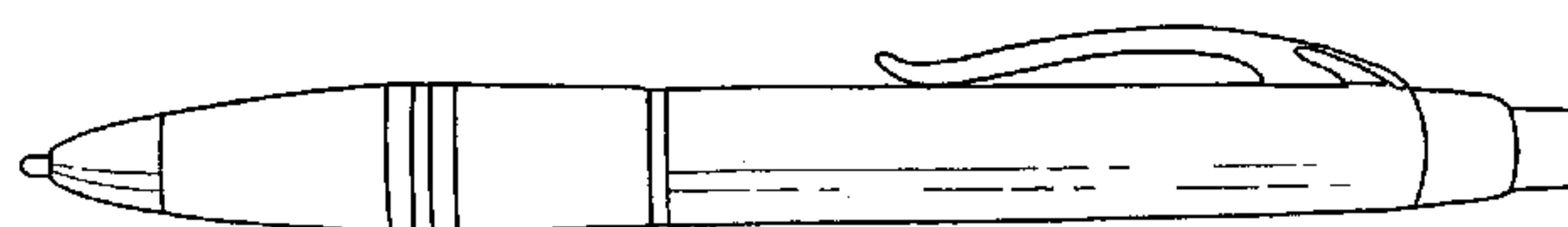
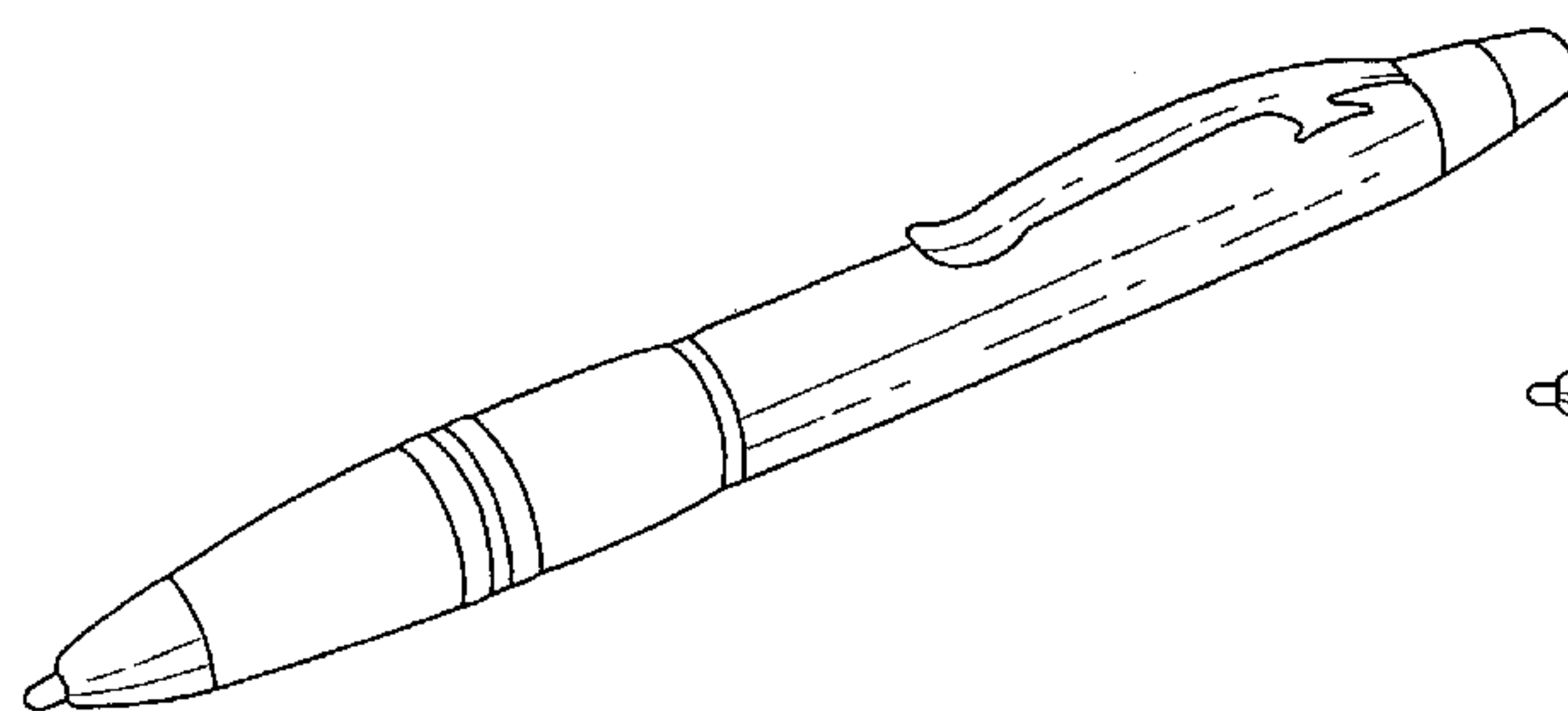
FIG. 4 is an opposite side view to that shown in FIG. 2;

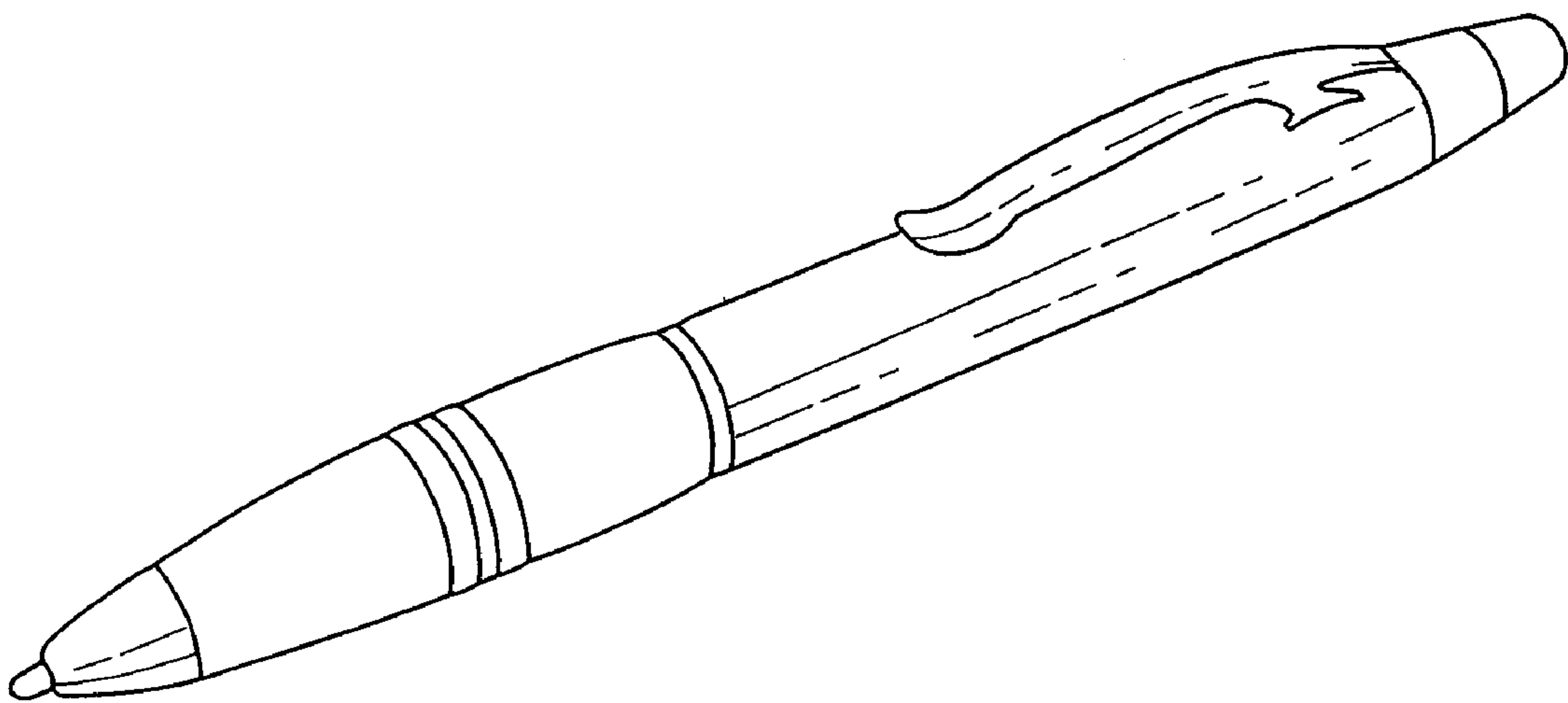

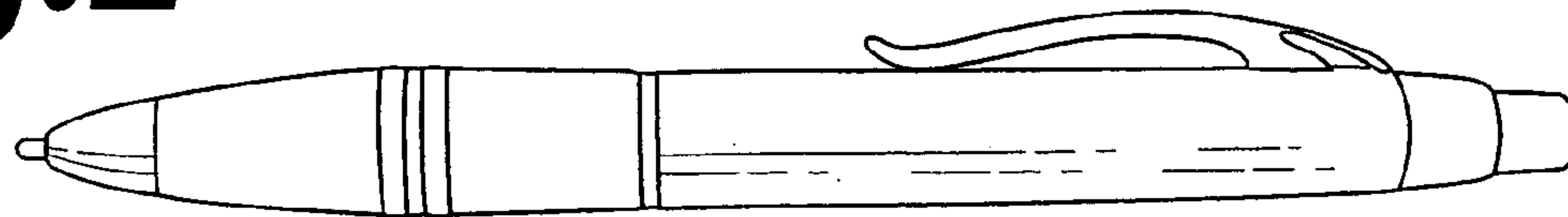

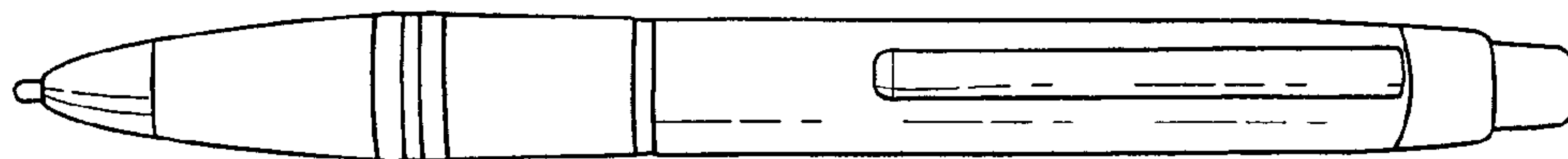

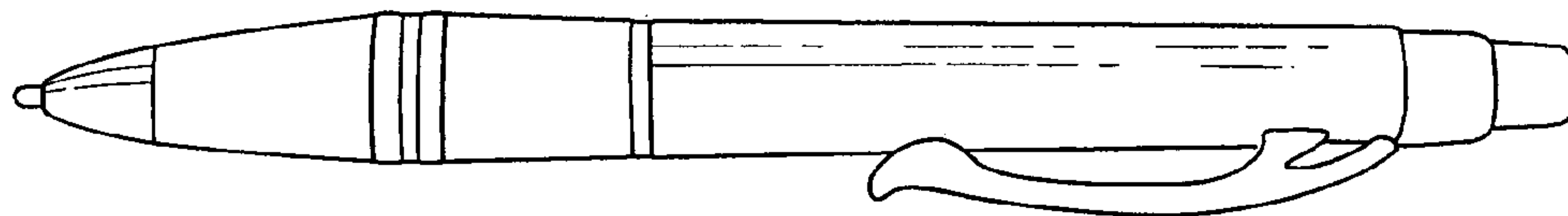

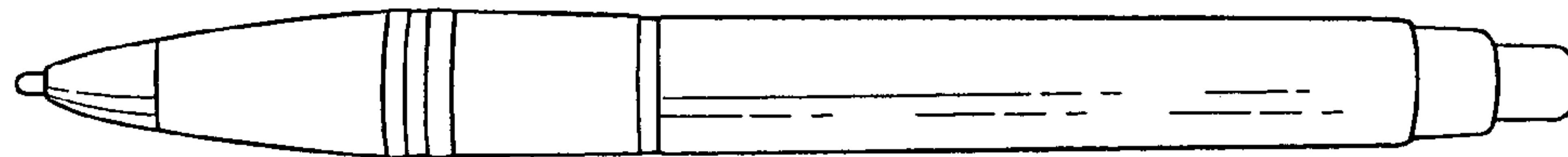

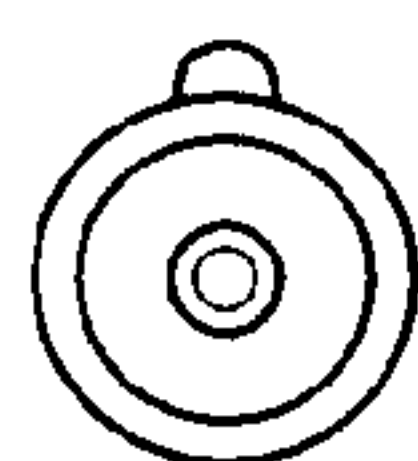
