DESCRIPTION

FIG. 12 is a top plan view of a second modified embodiment thereof;

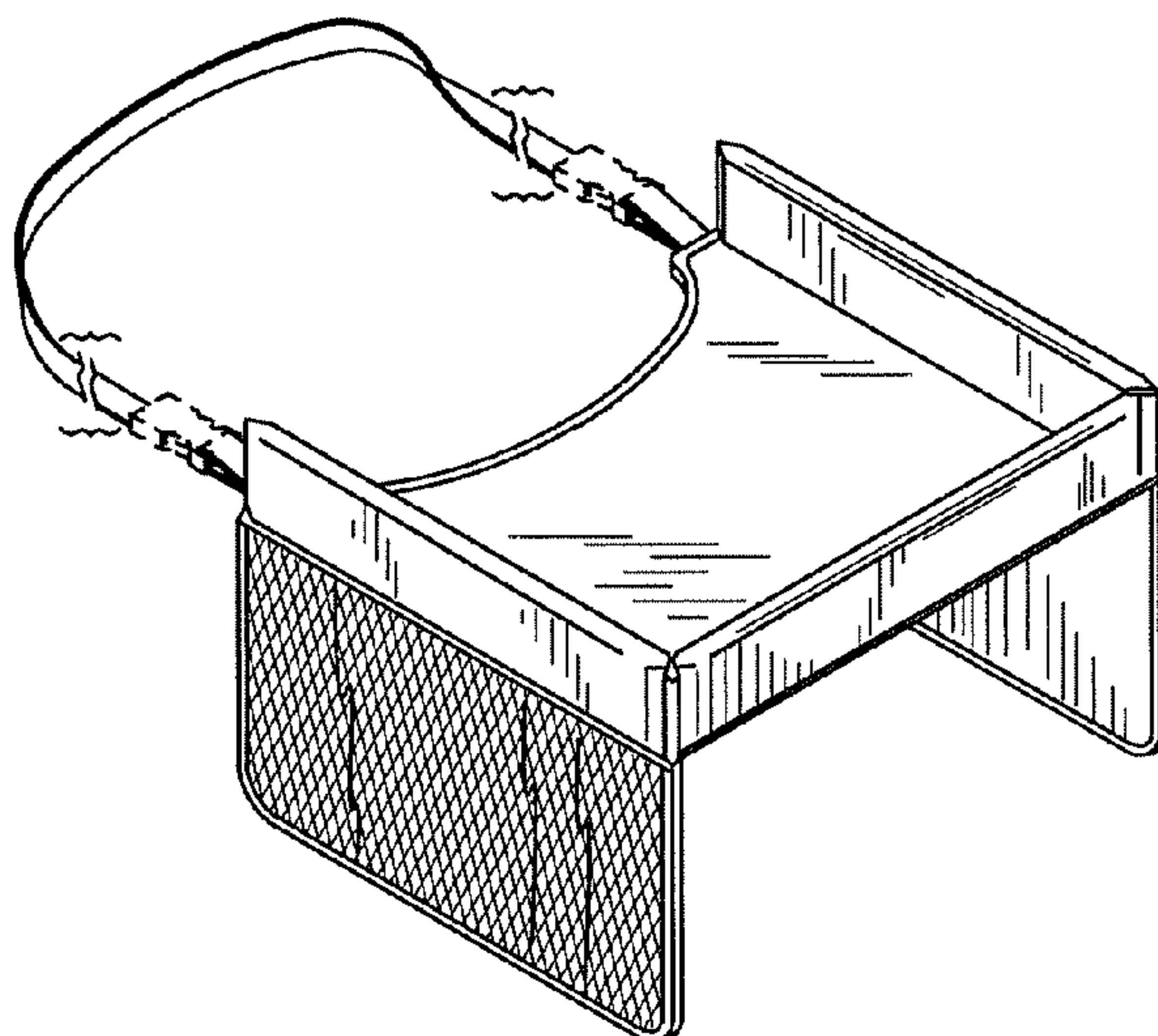
FIG. 13 is a left elevation view there of, the right elevation being a mirror image;

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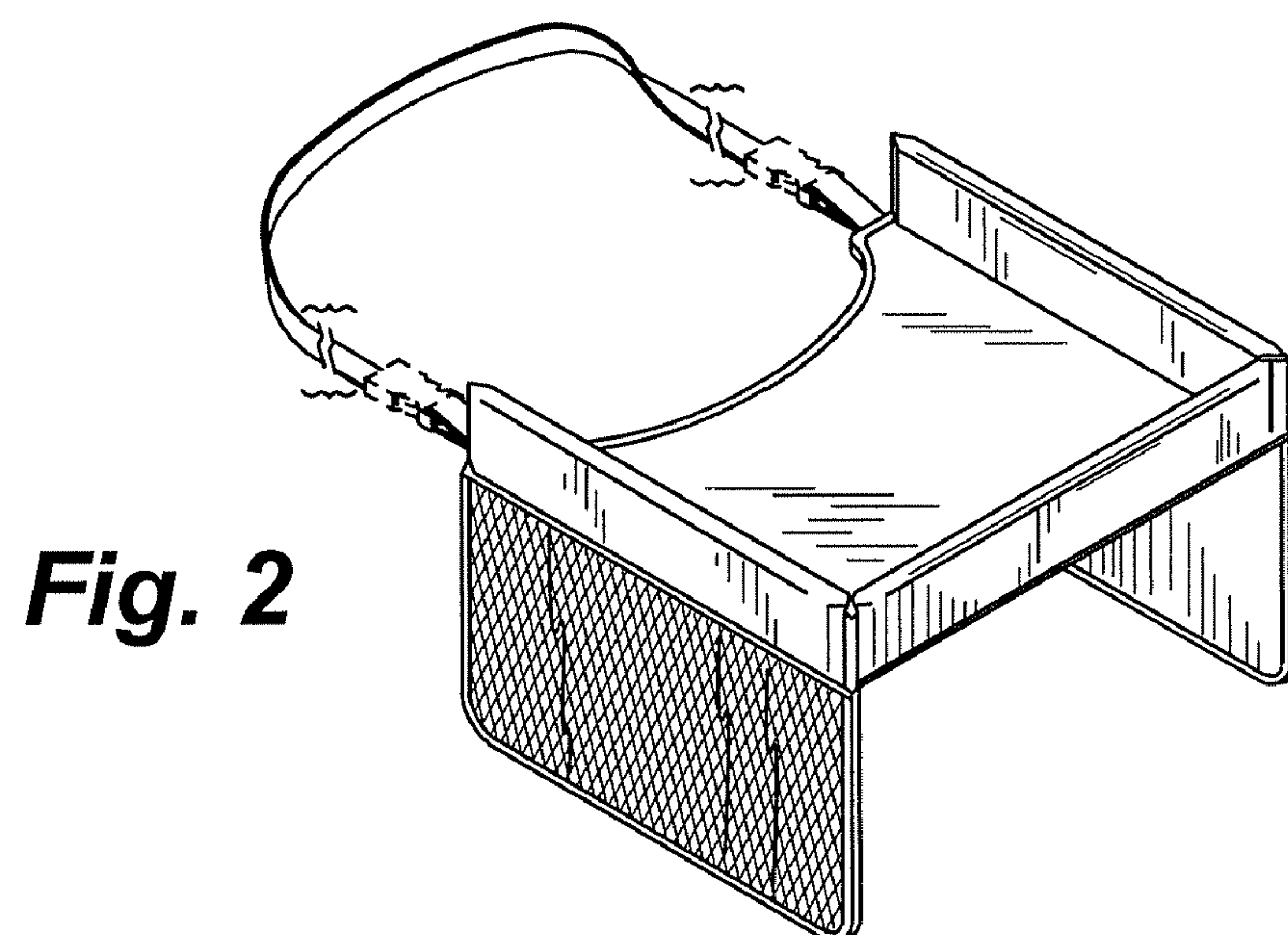
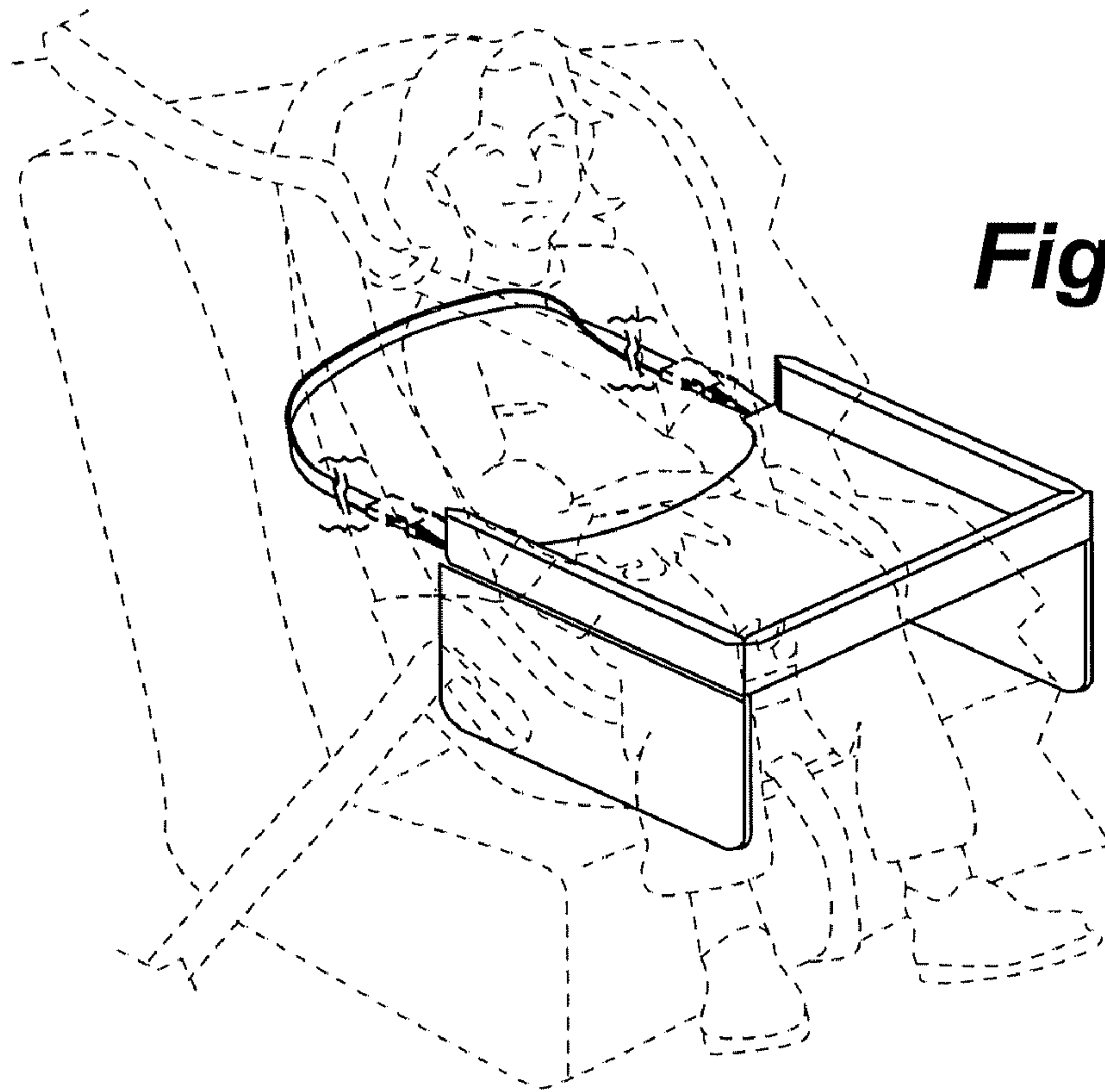

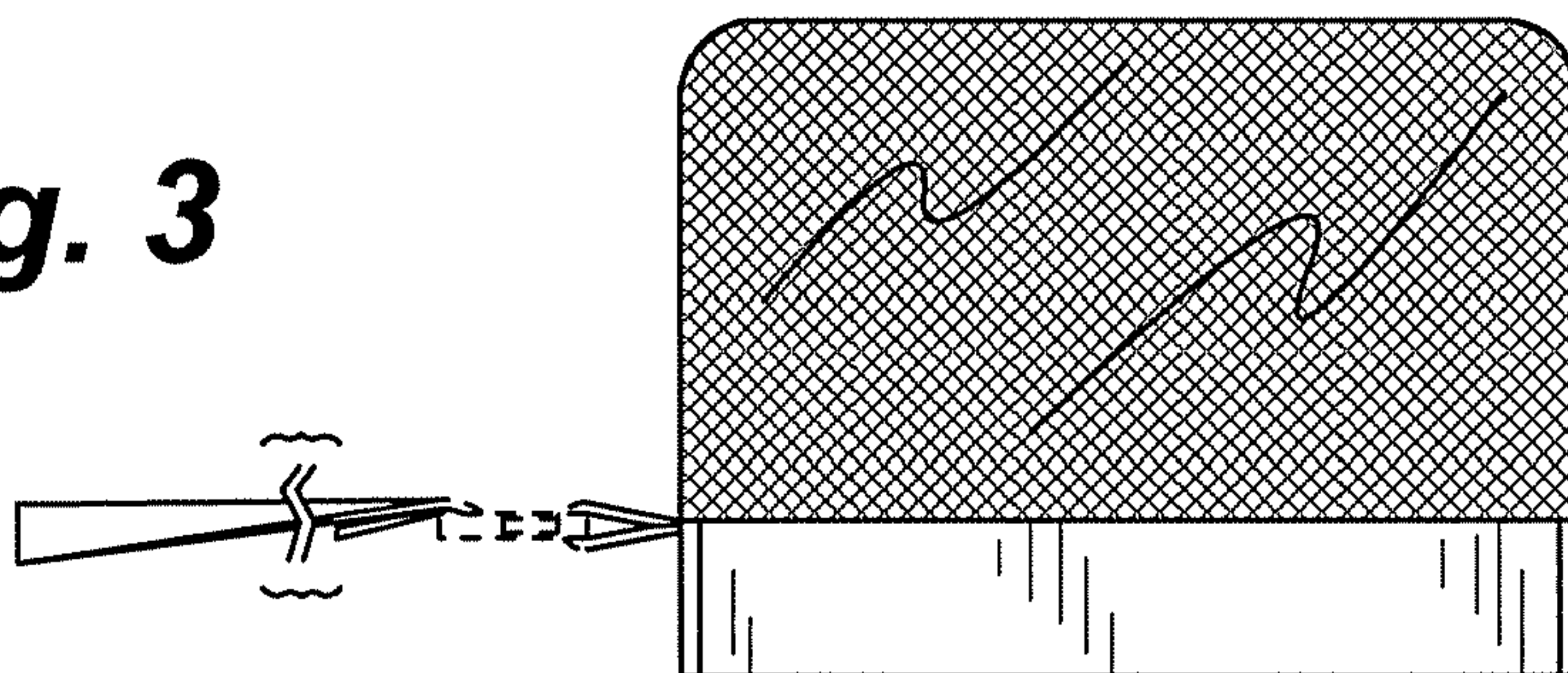

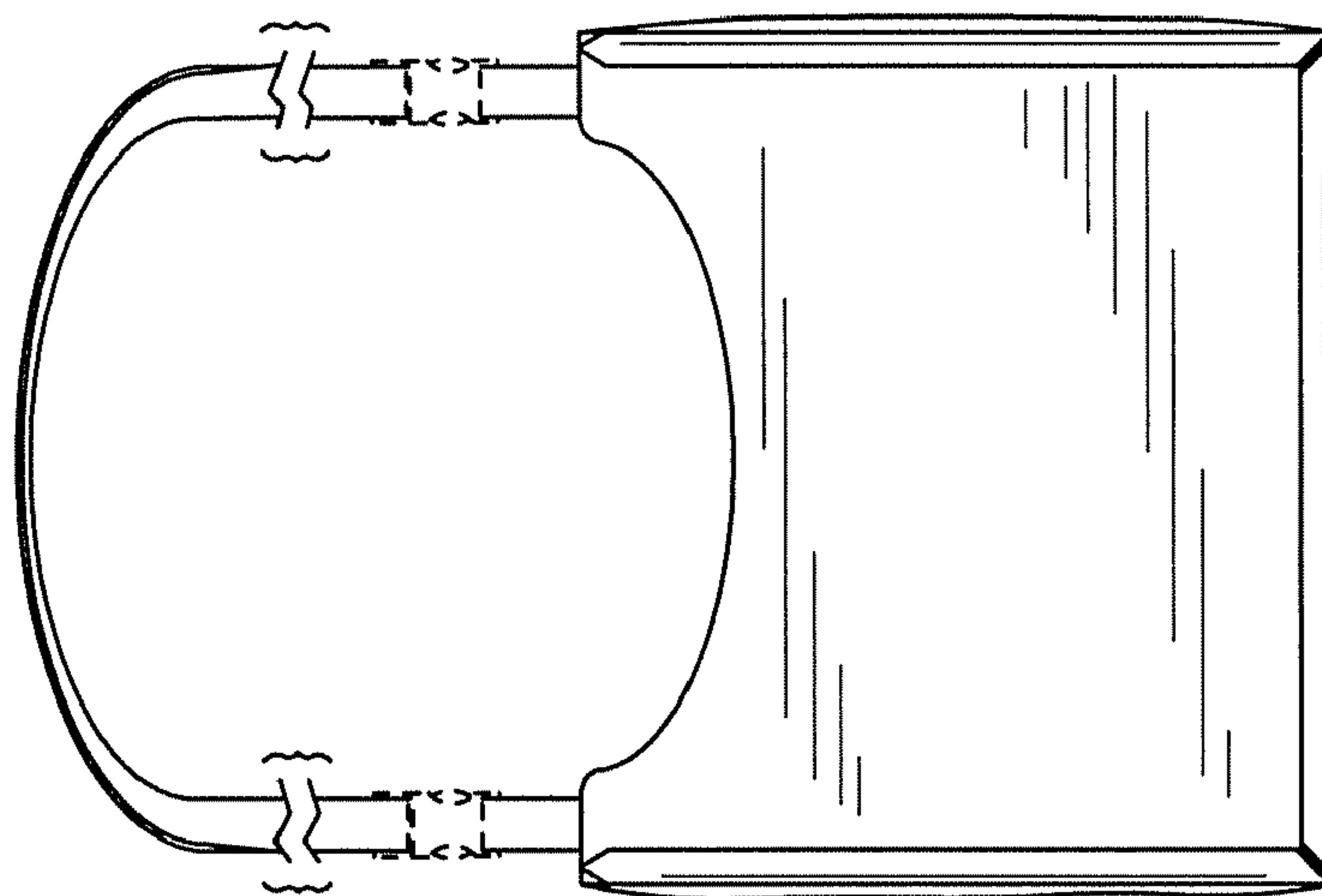

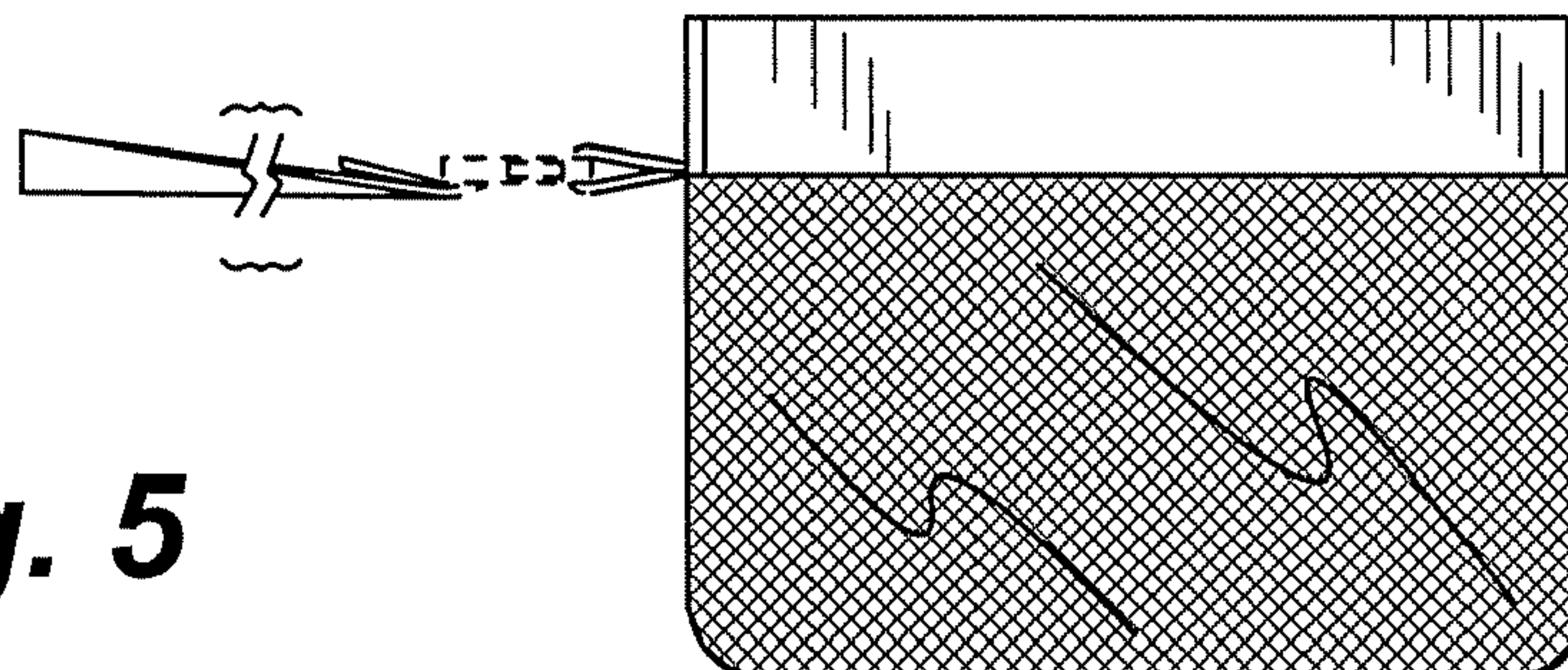

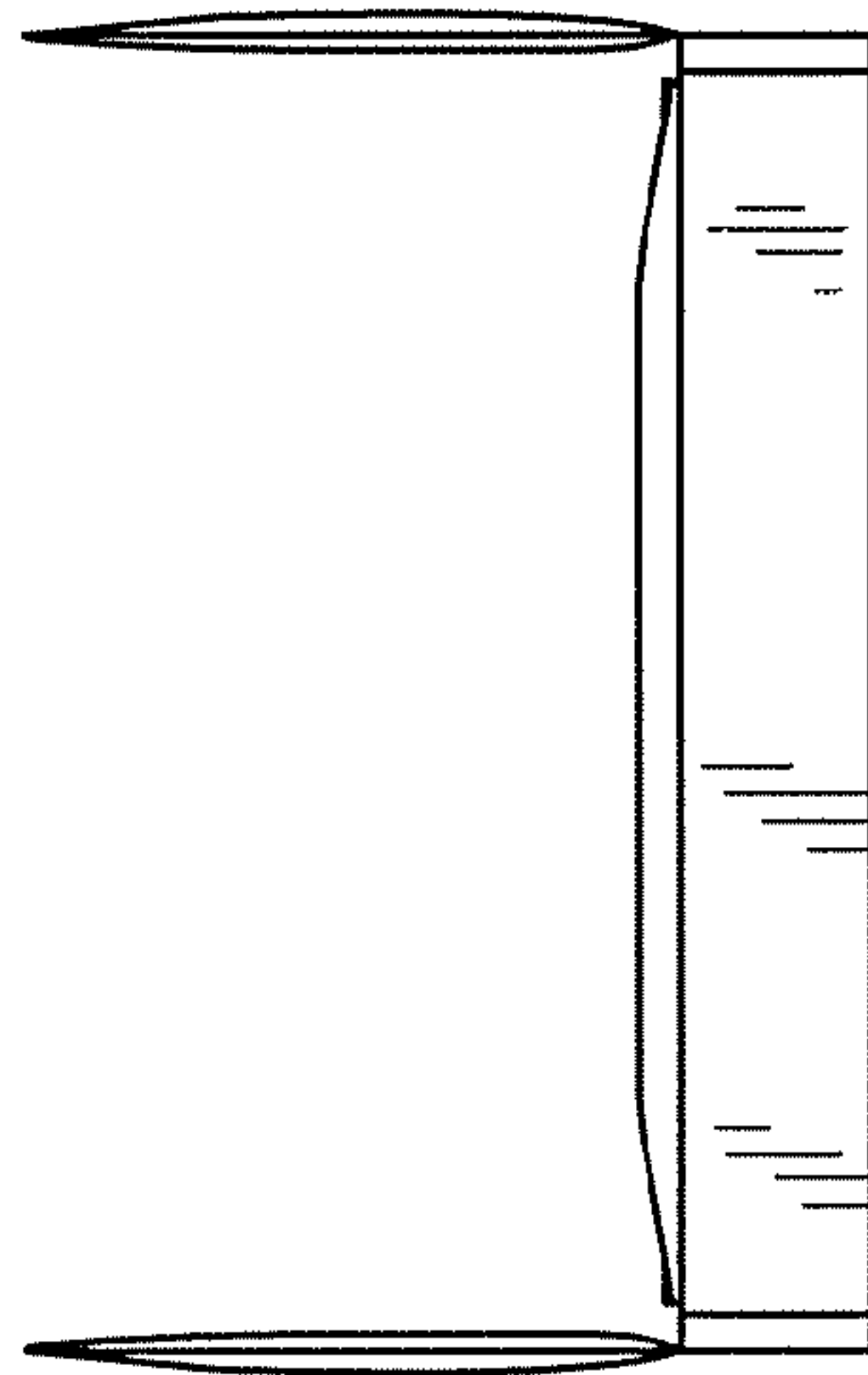

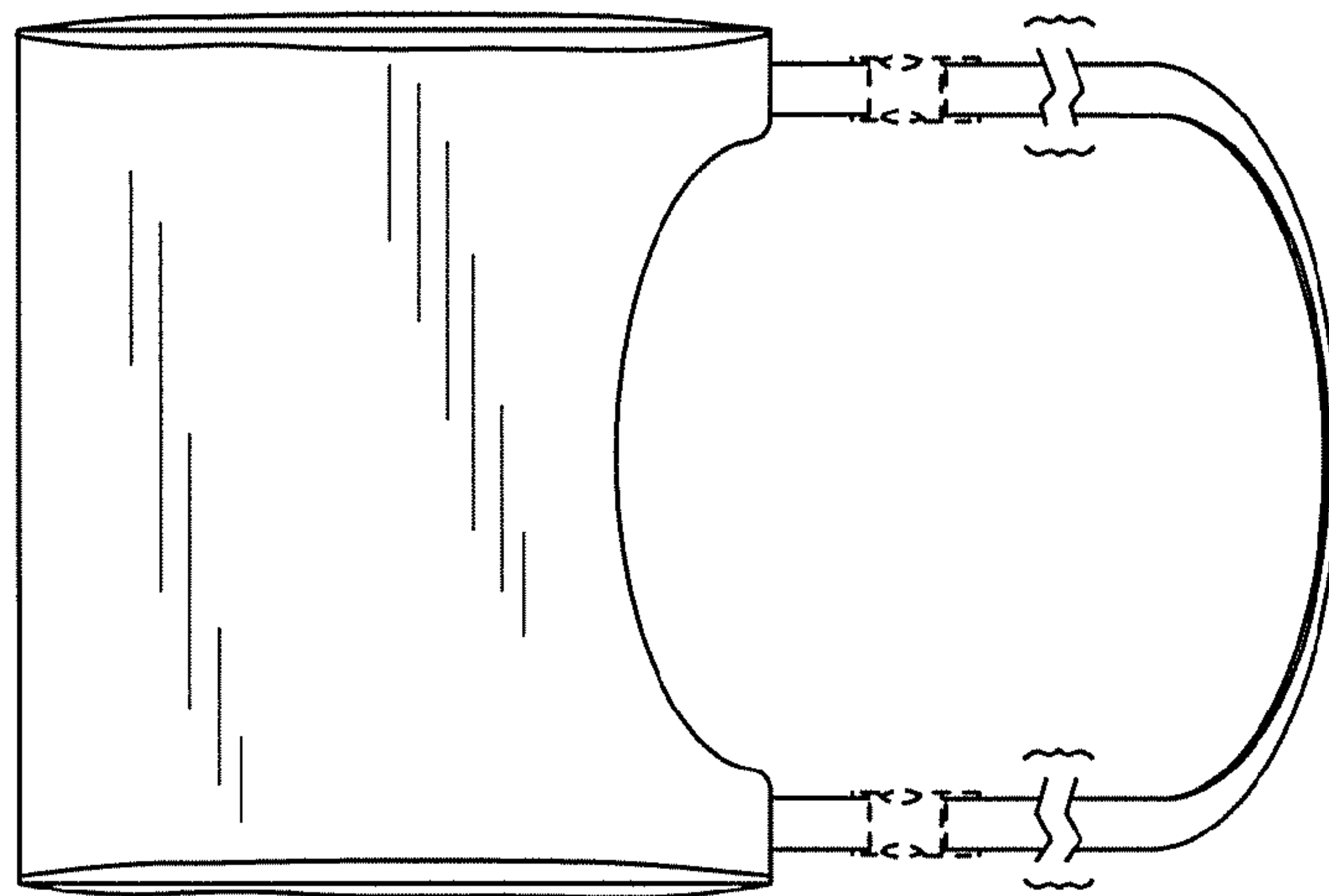
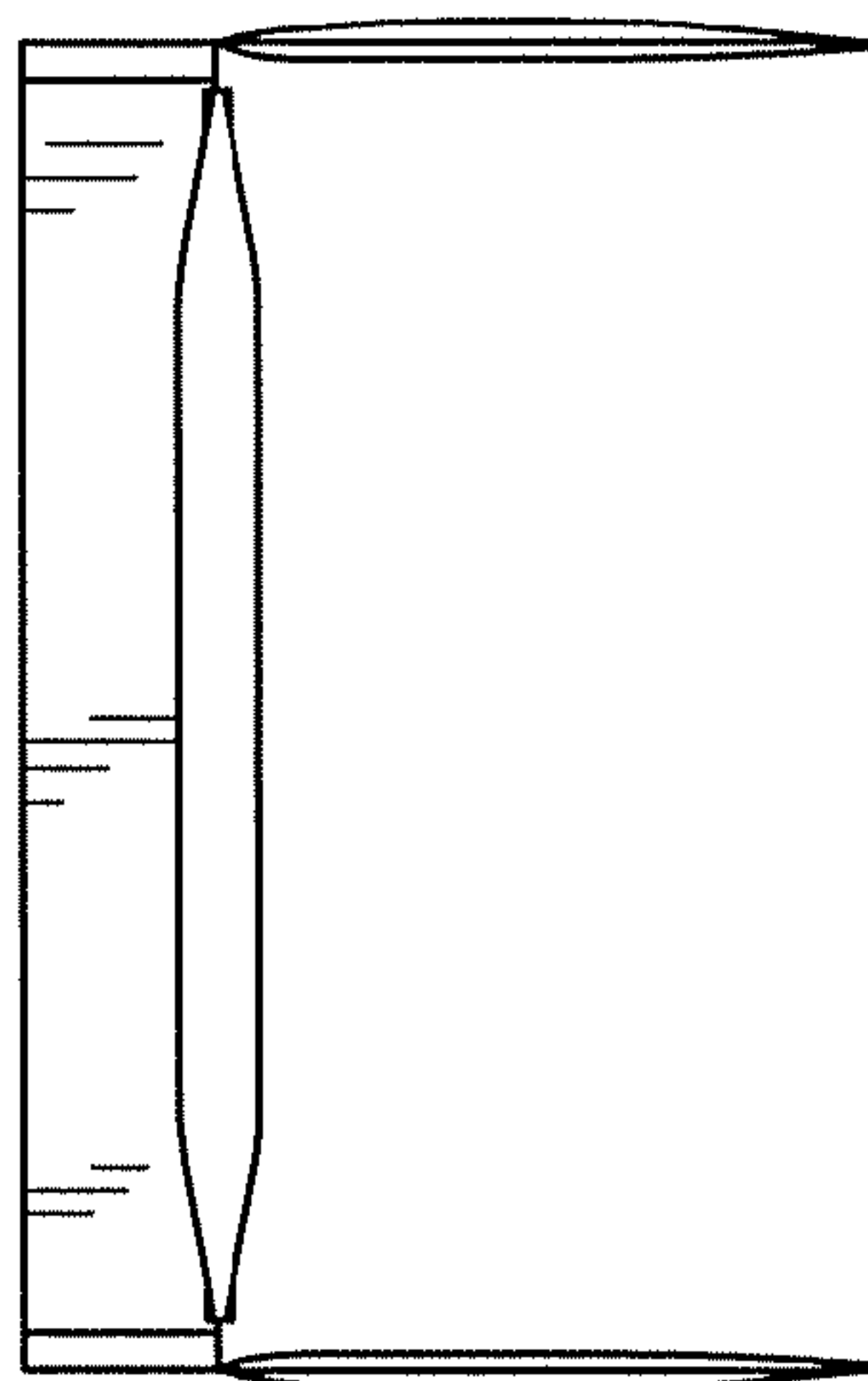

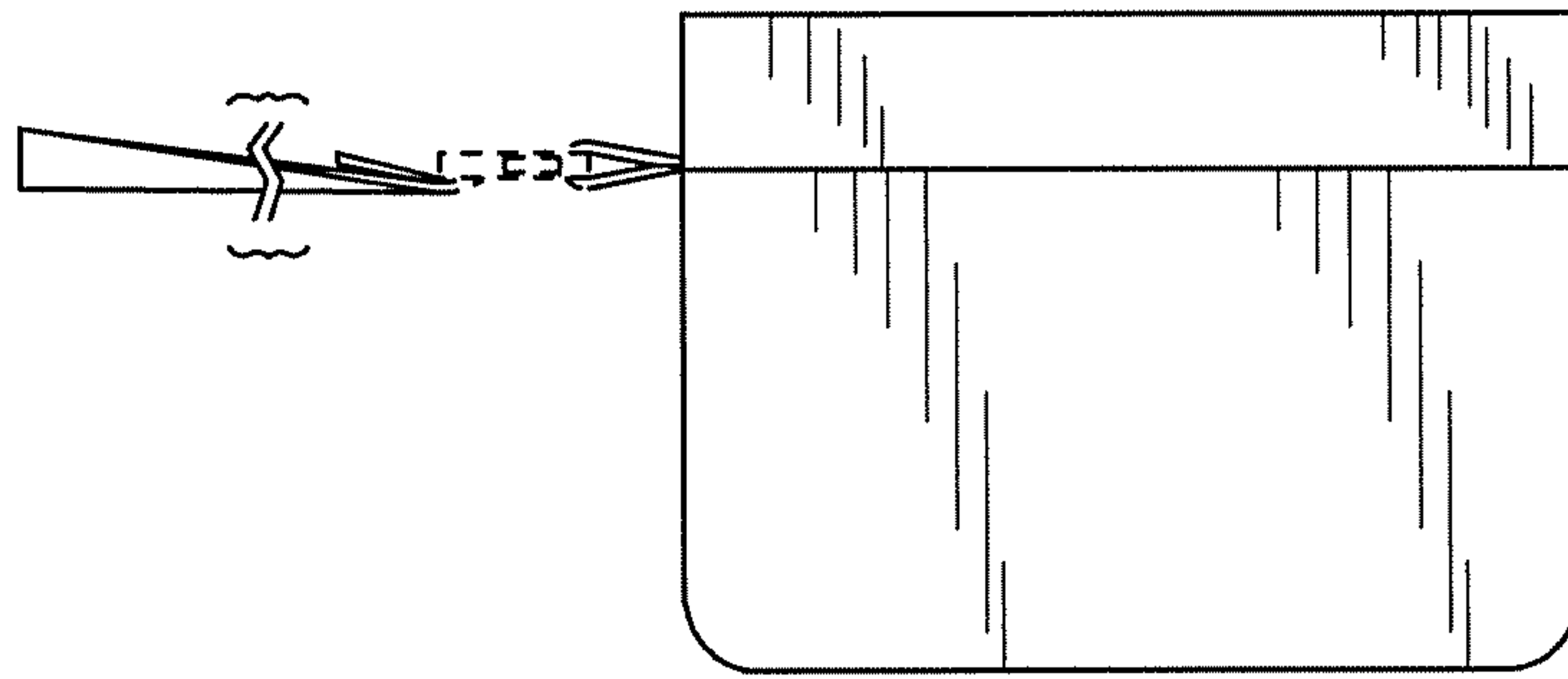

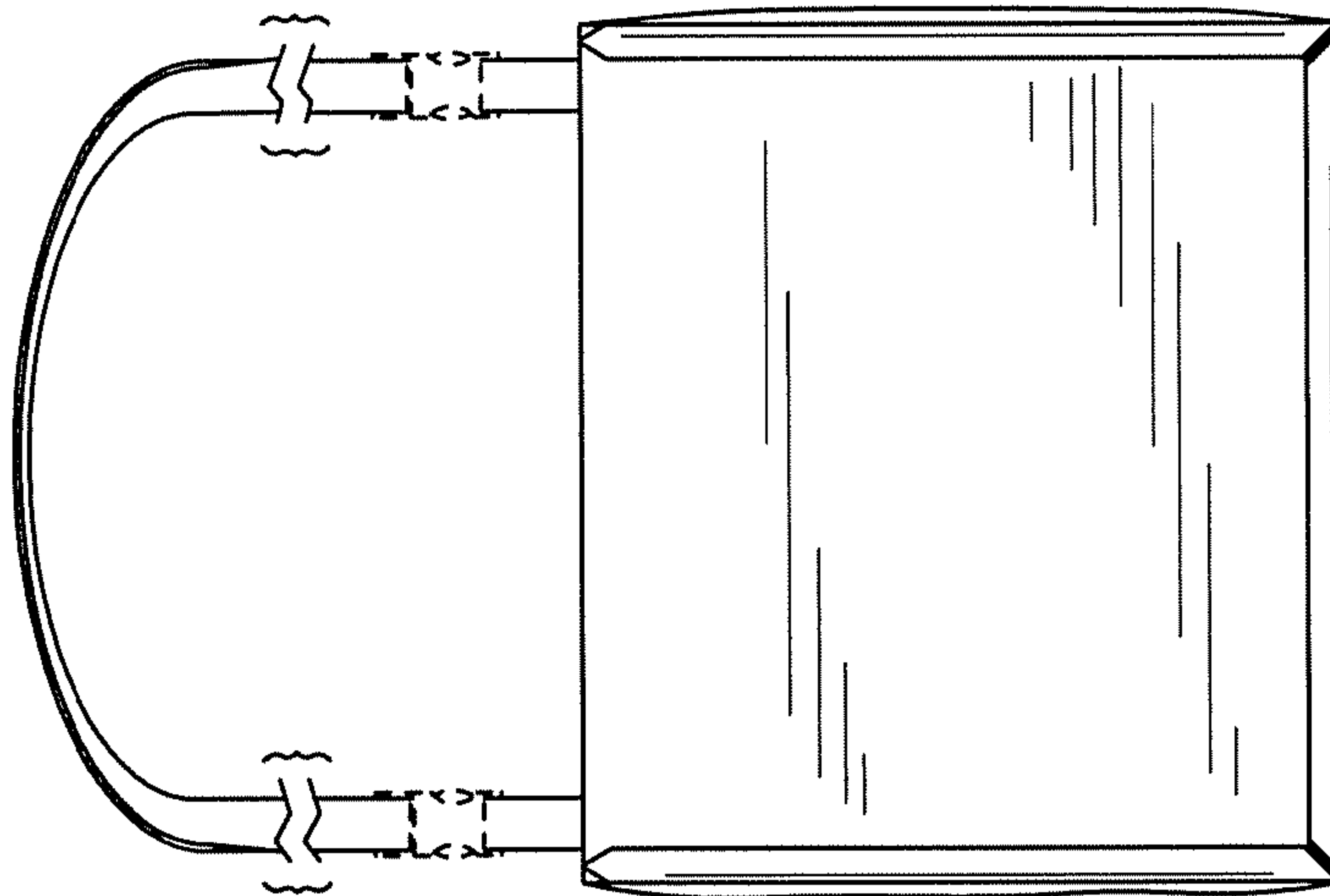

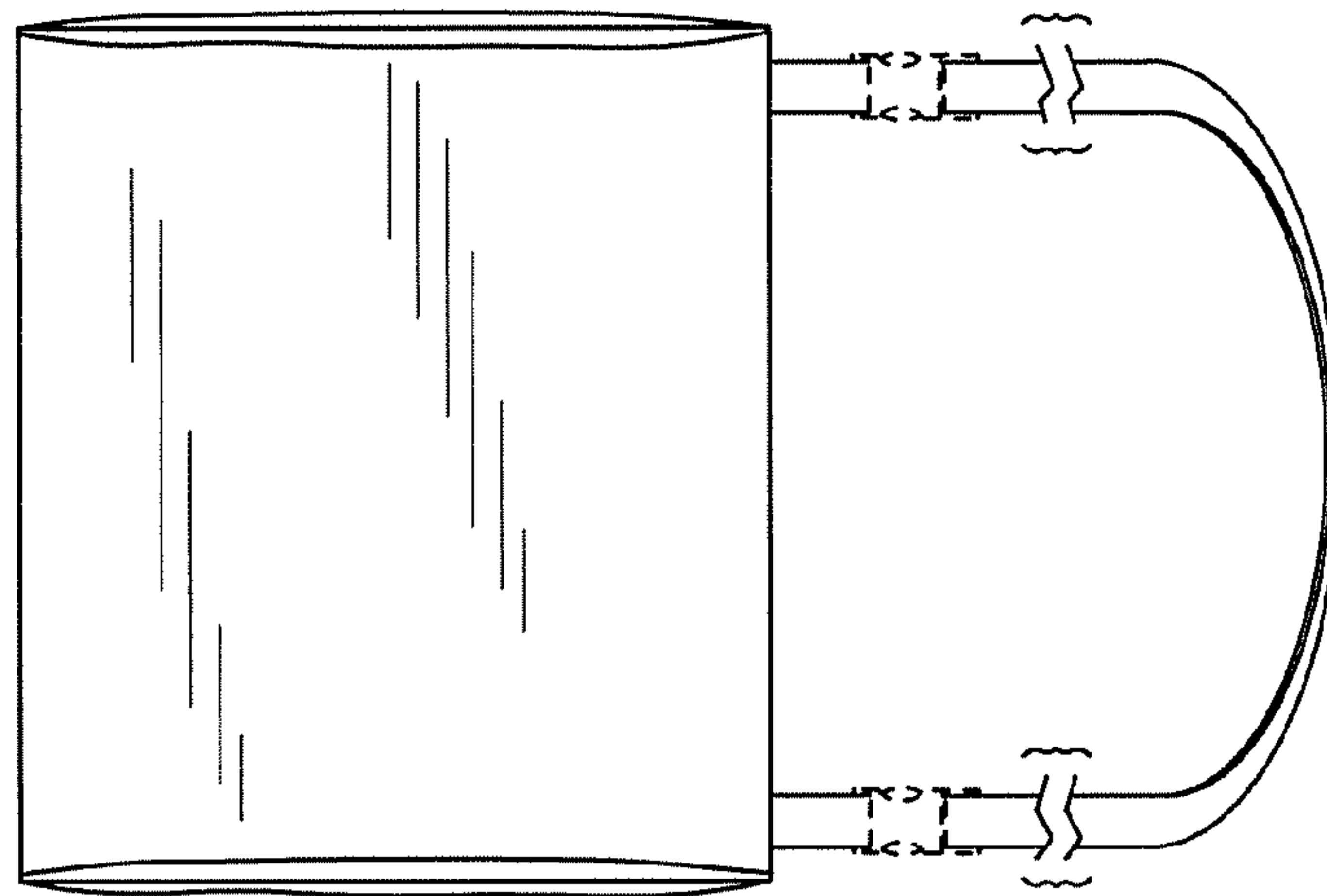

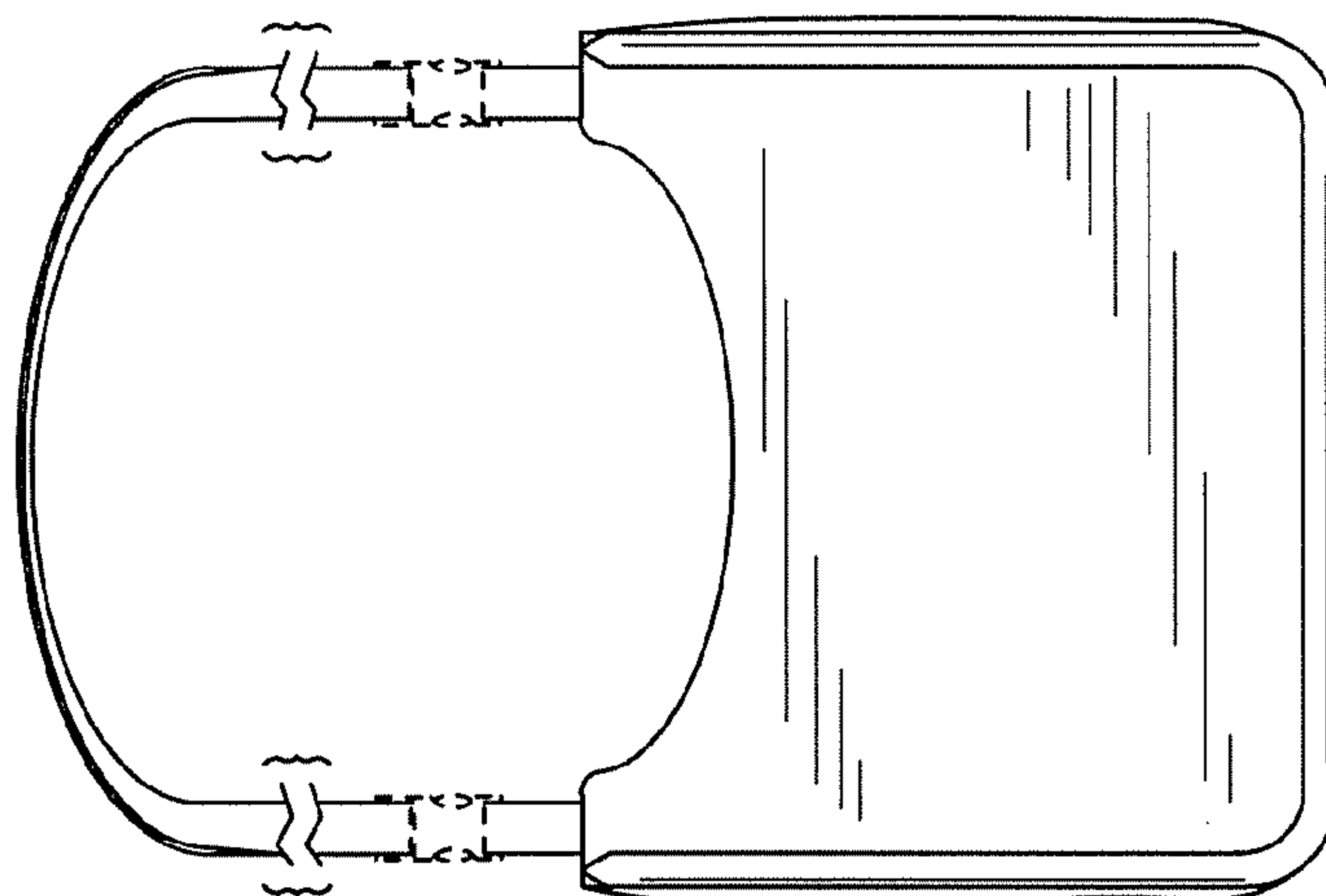

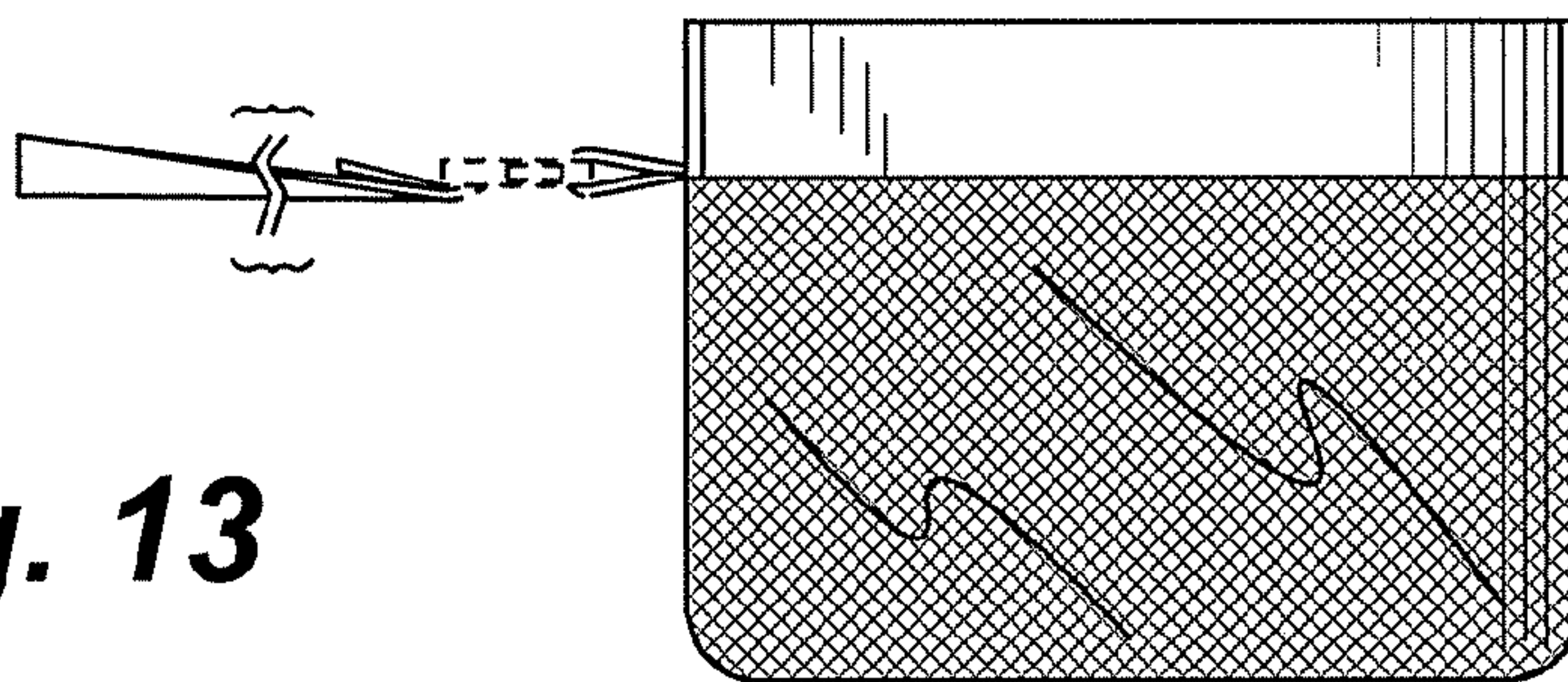
