FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

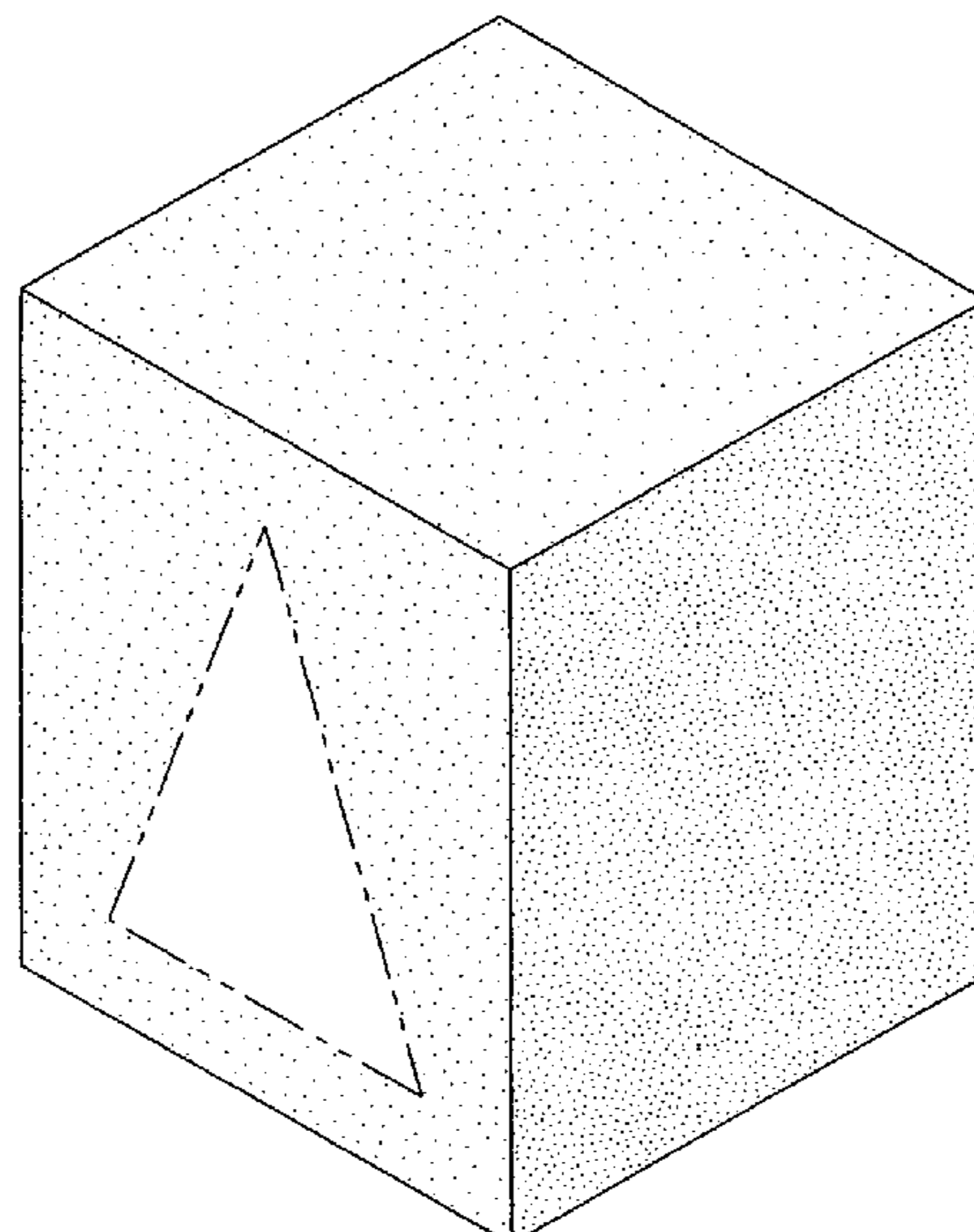
FIG. 3 is a right elevational view thereof, the left elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

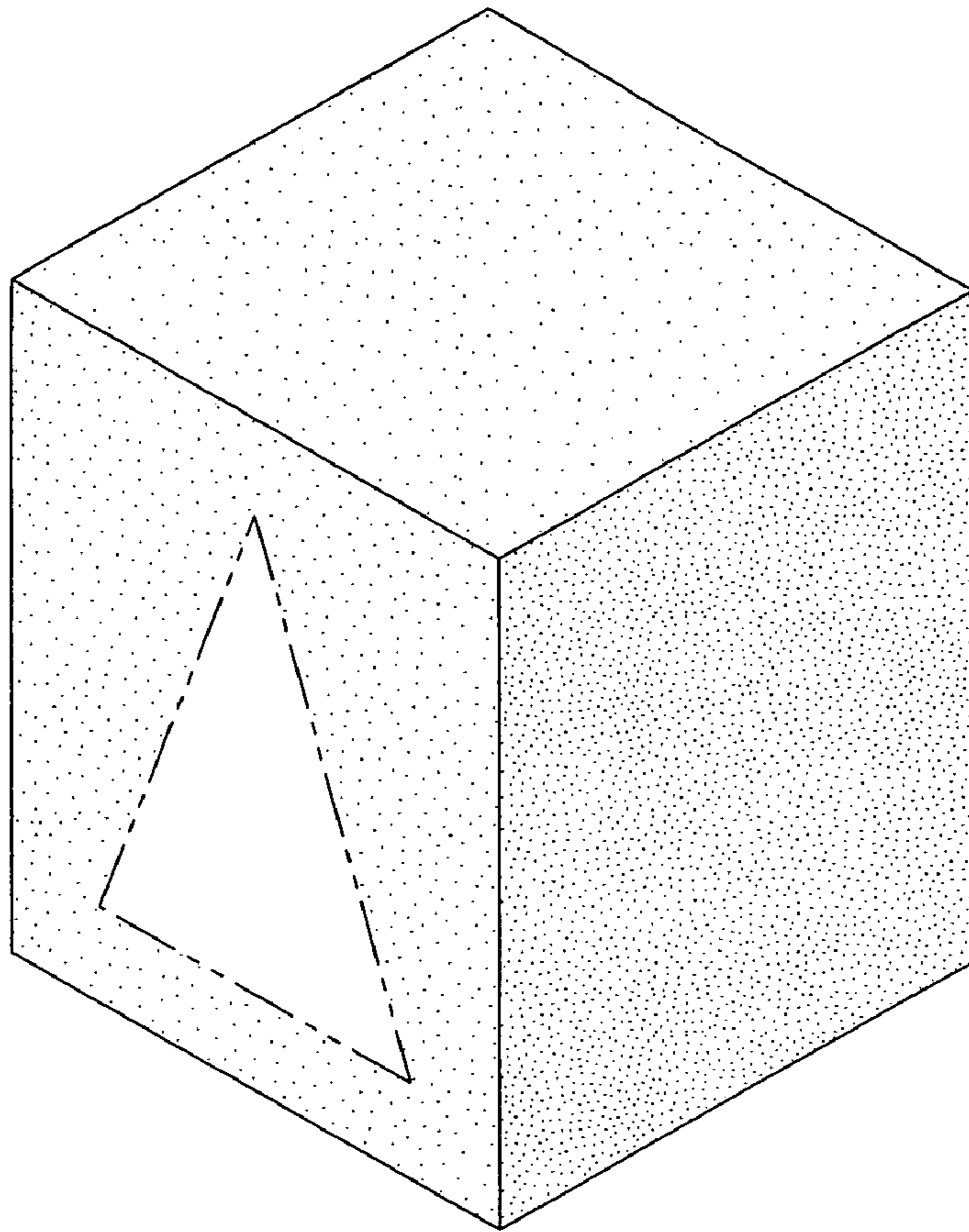

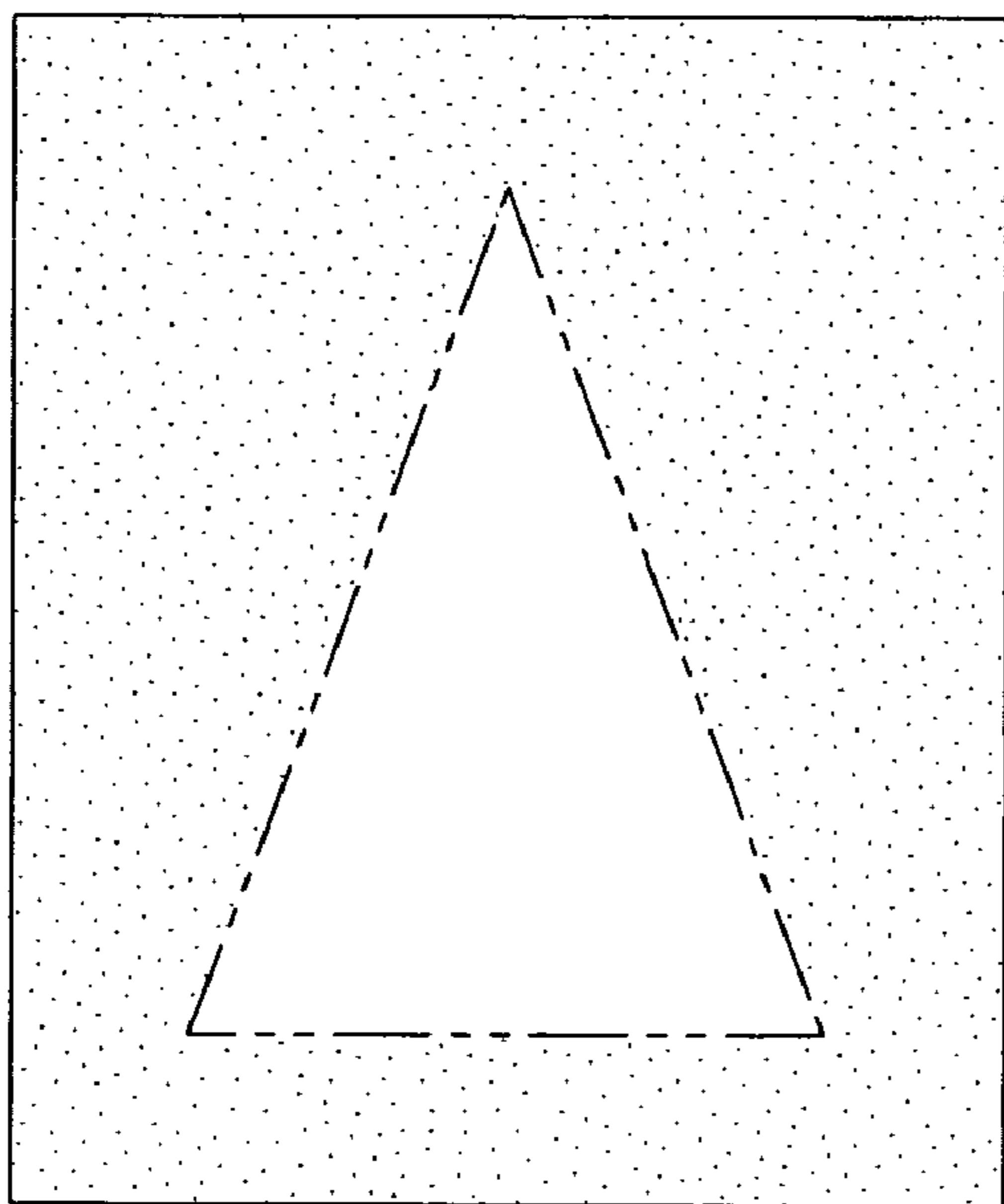

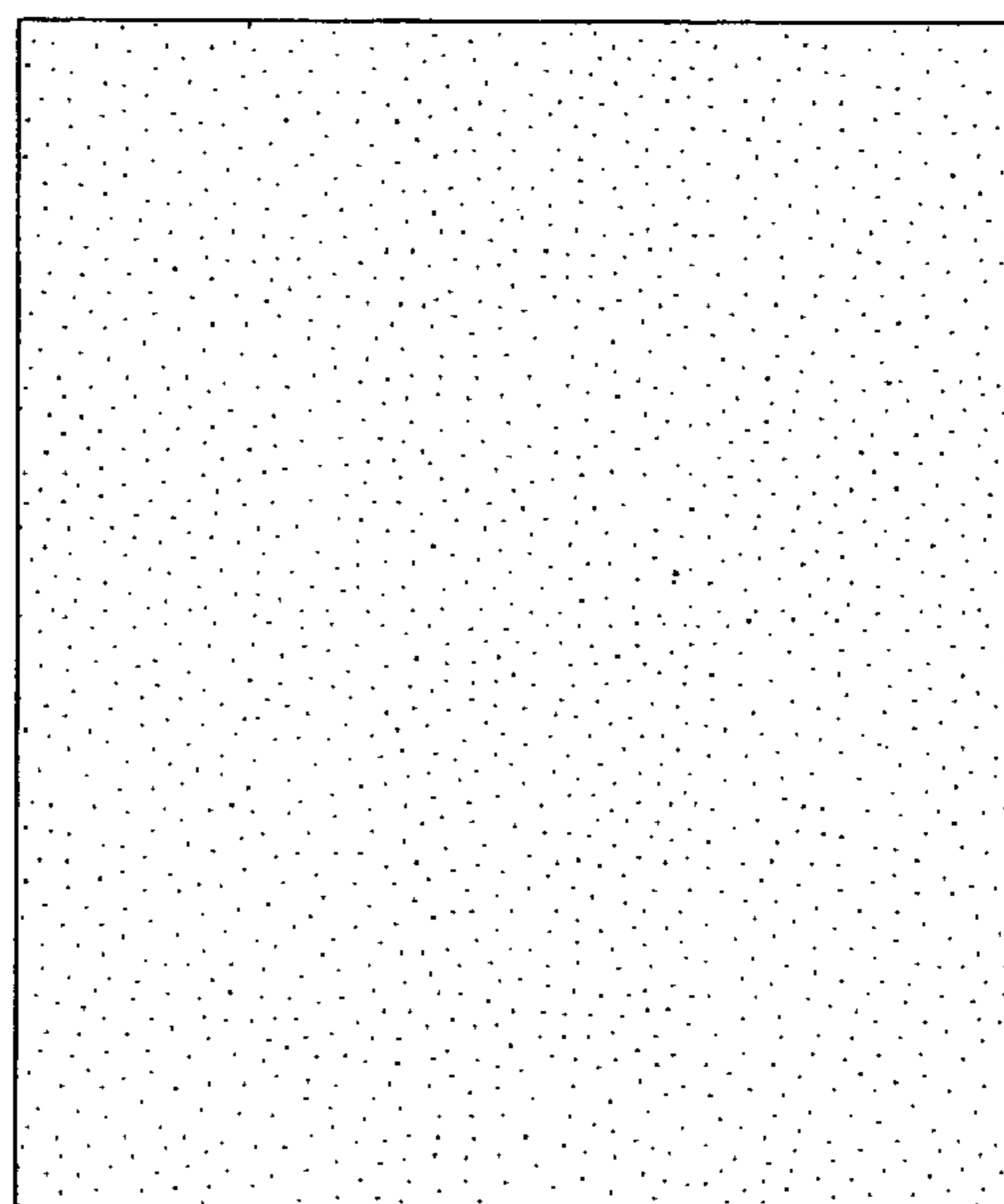

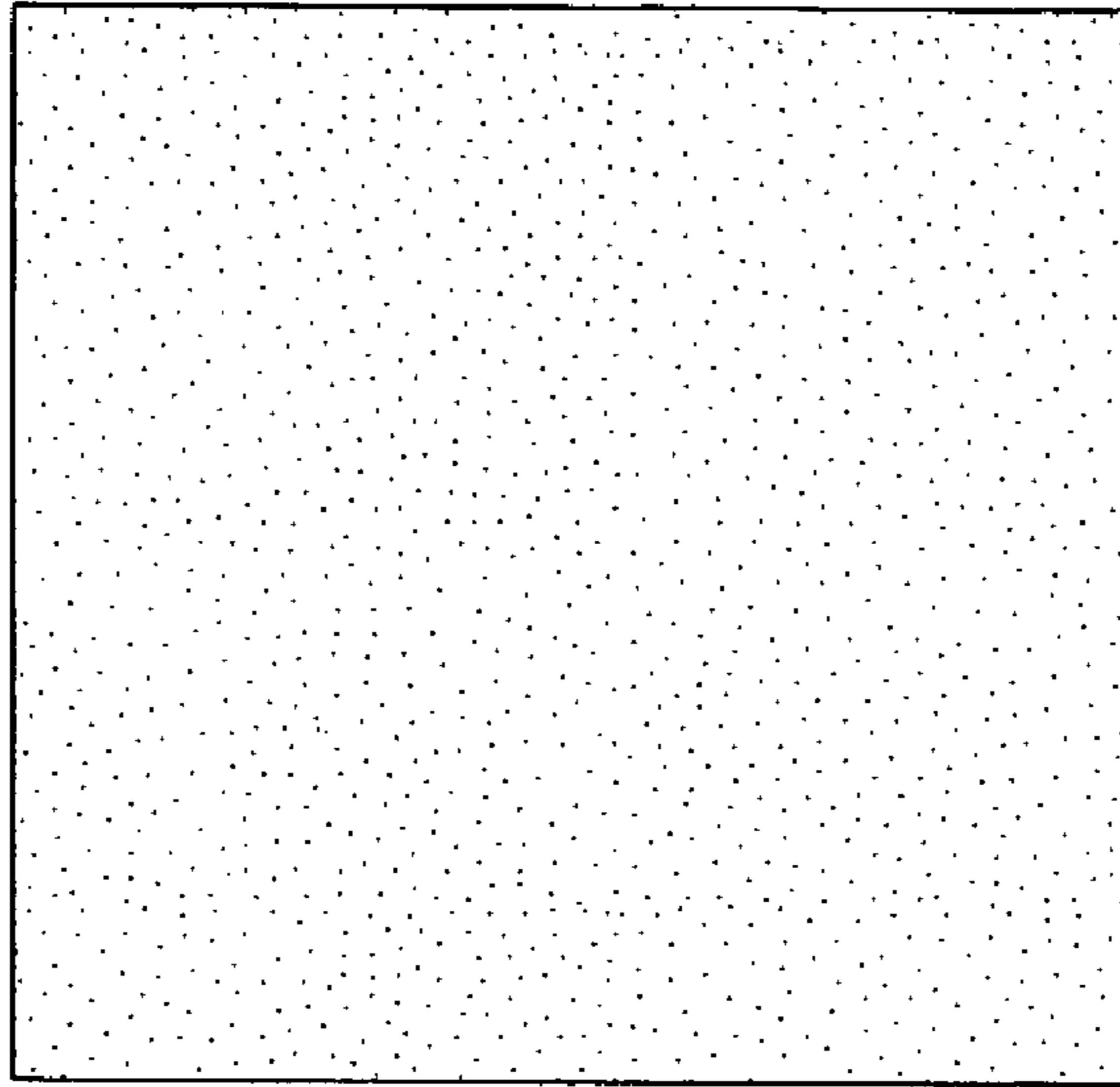

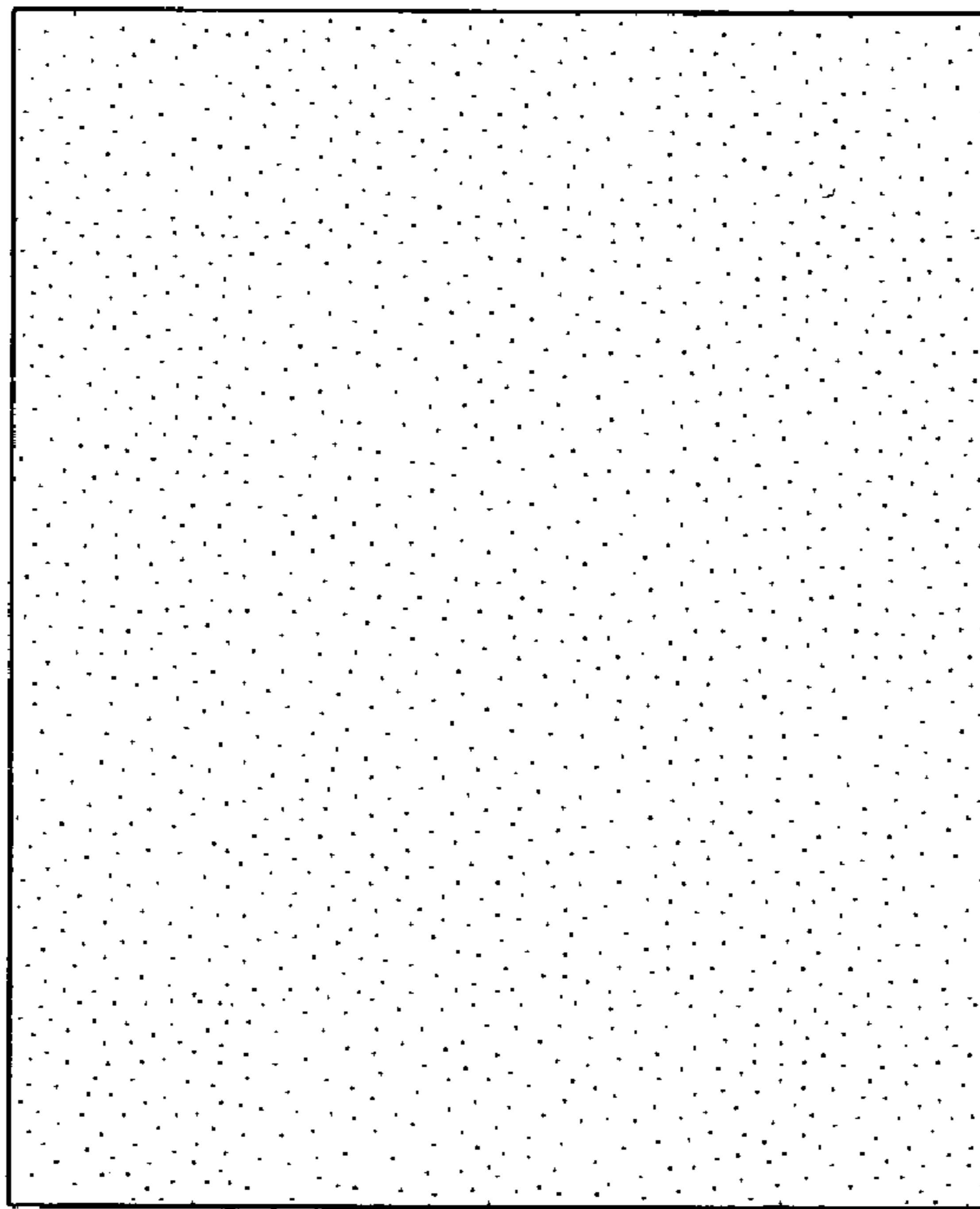
