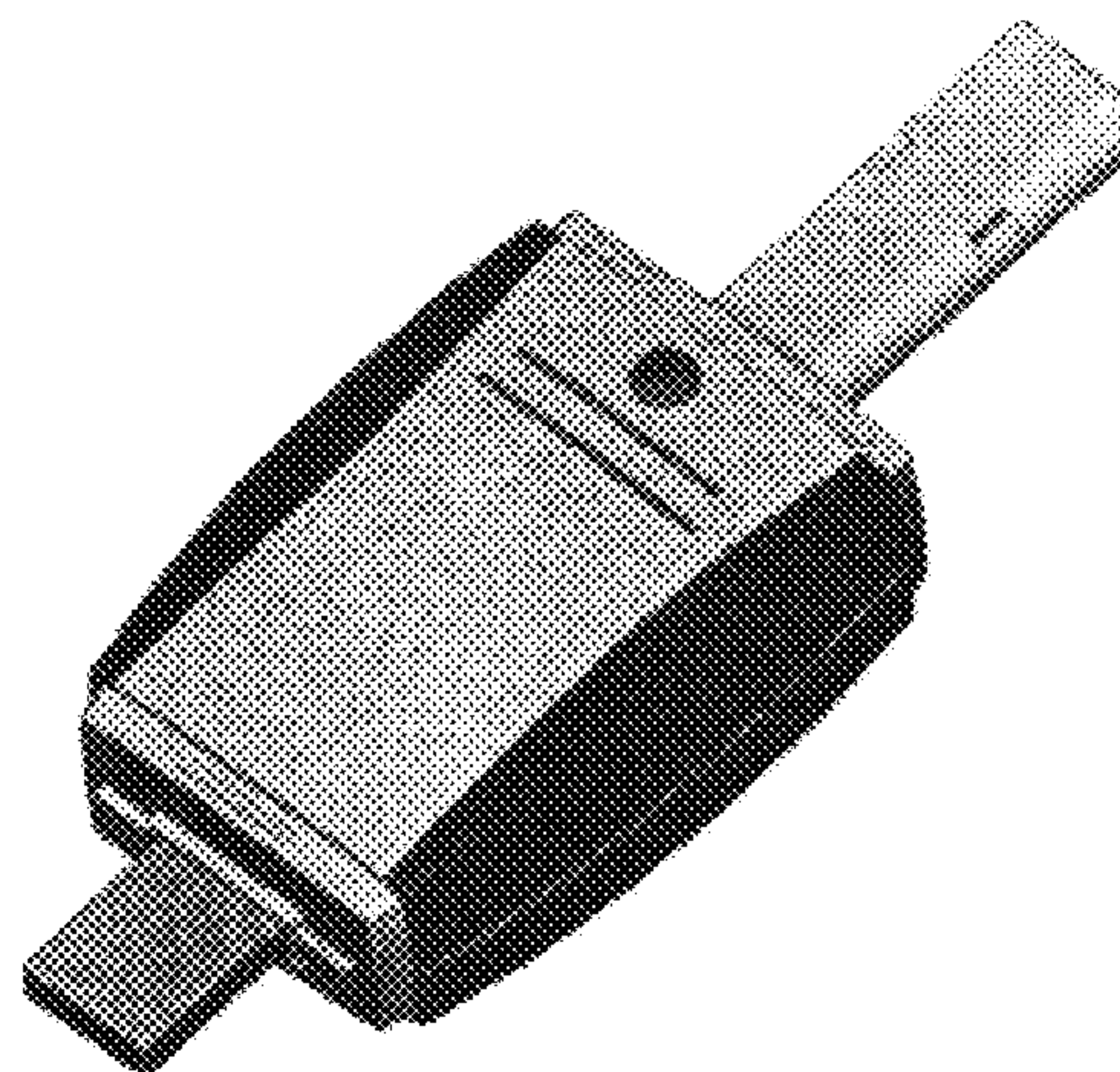
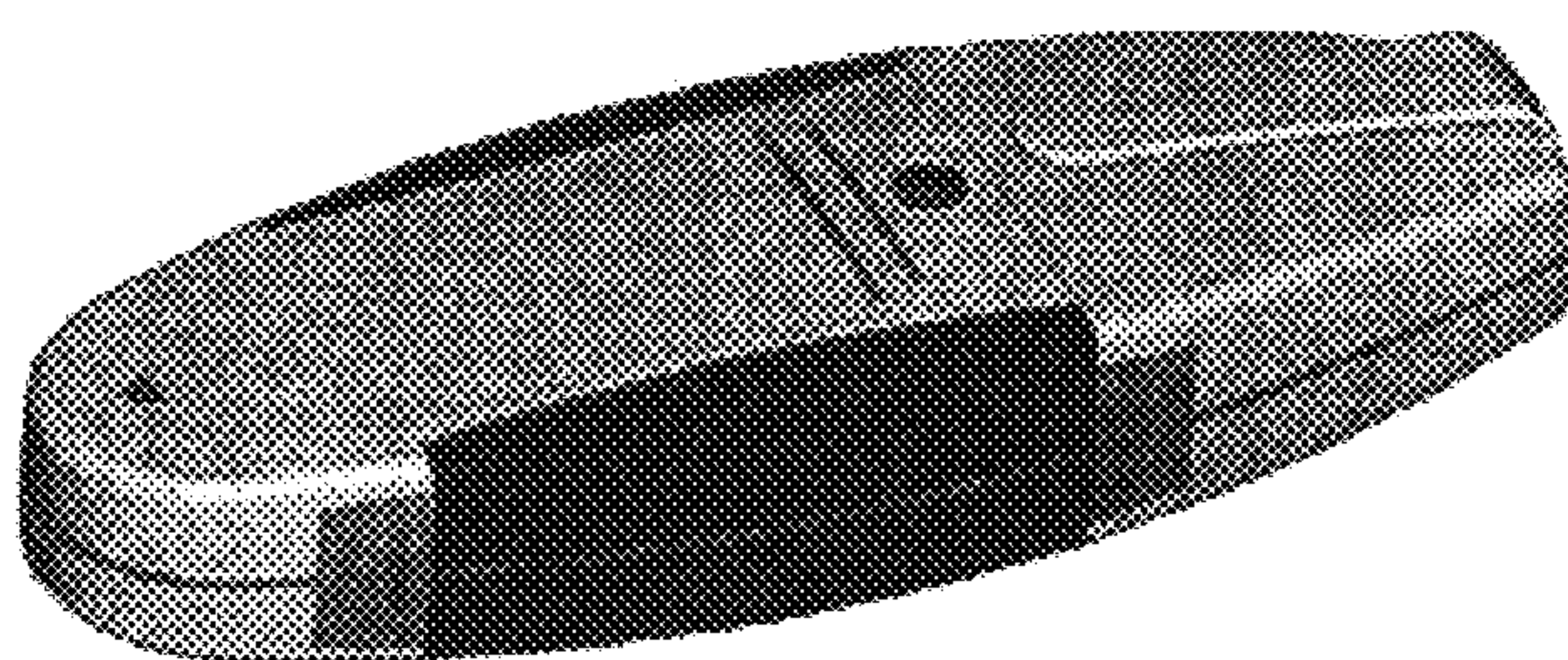
DESCRIPTION

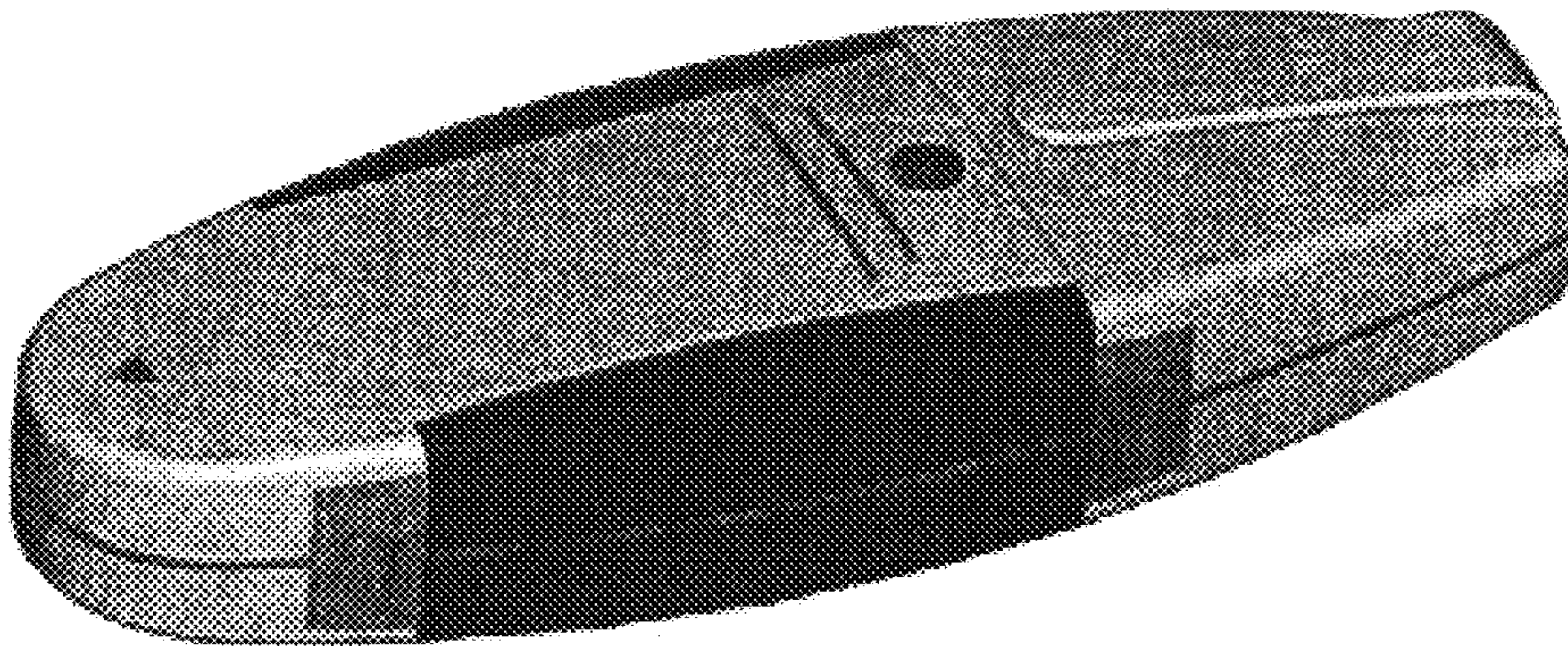

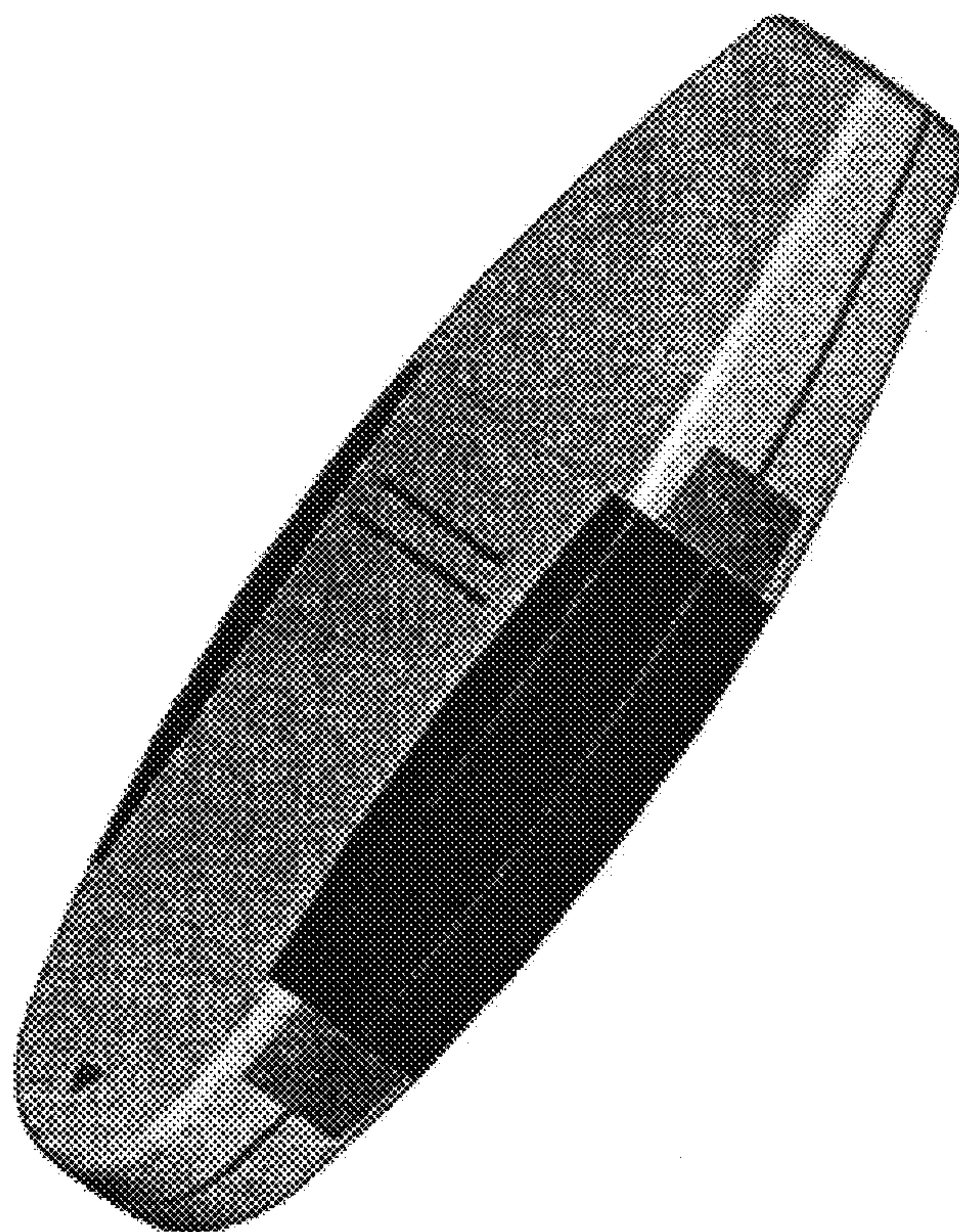

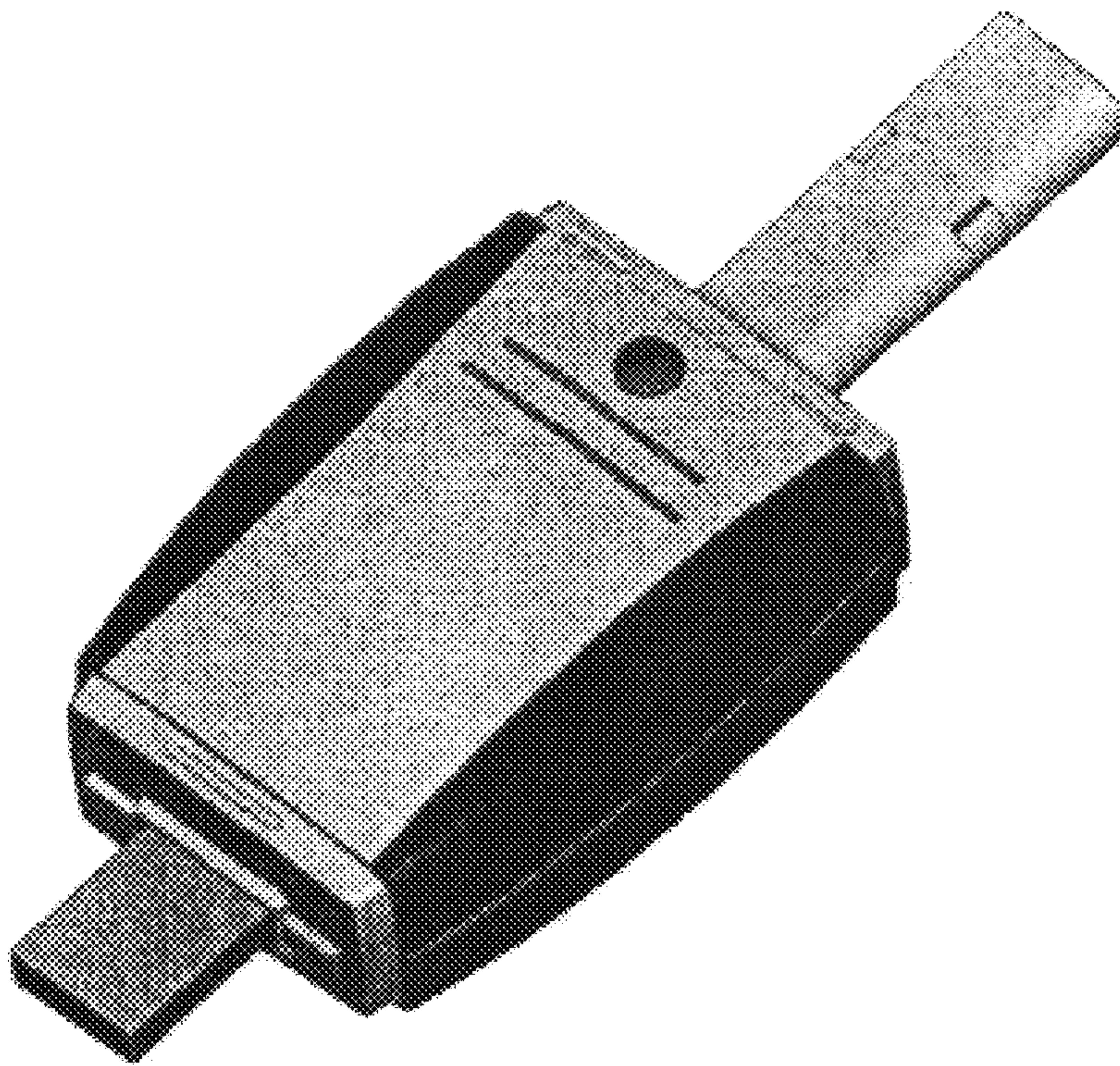
