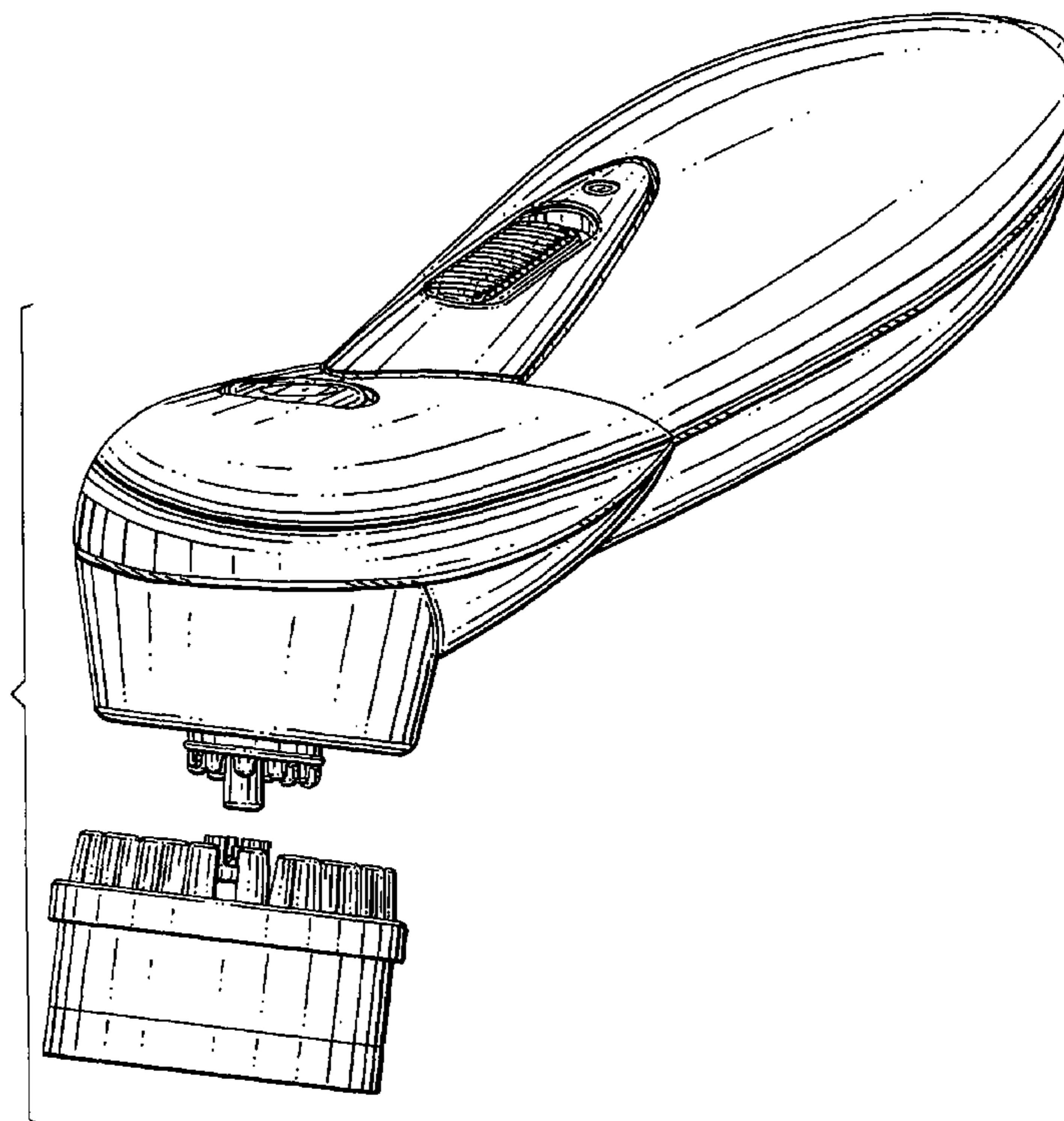
FIG. 7 is a front plan view thereof with the actuation device

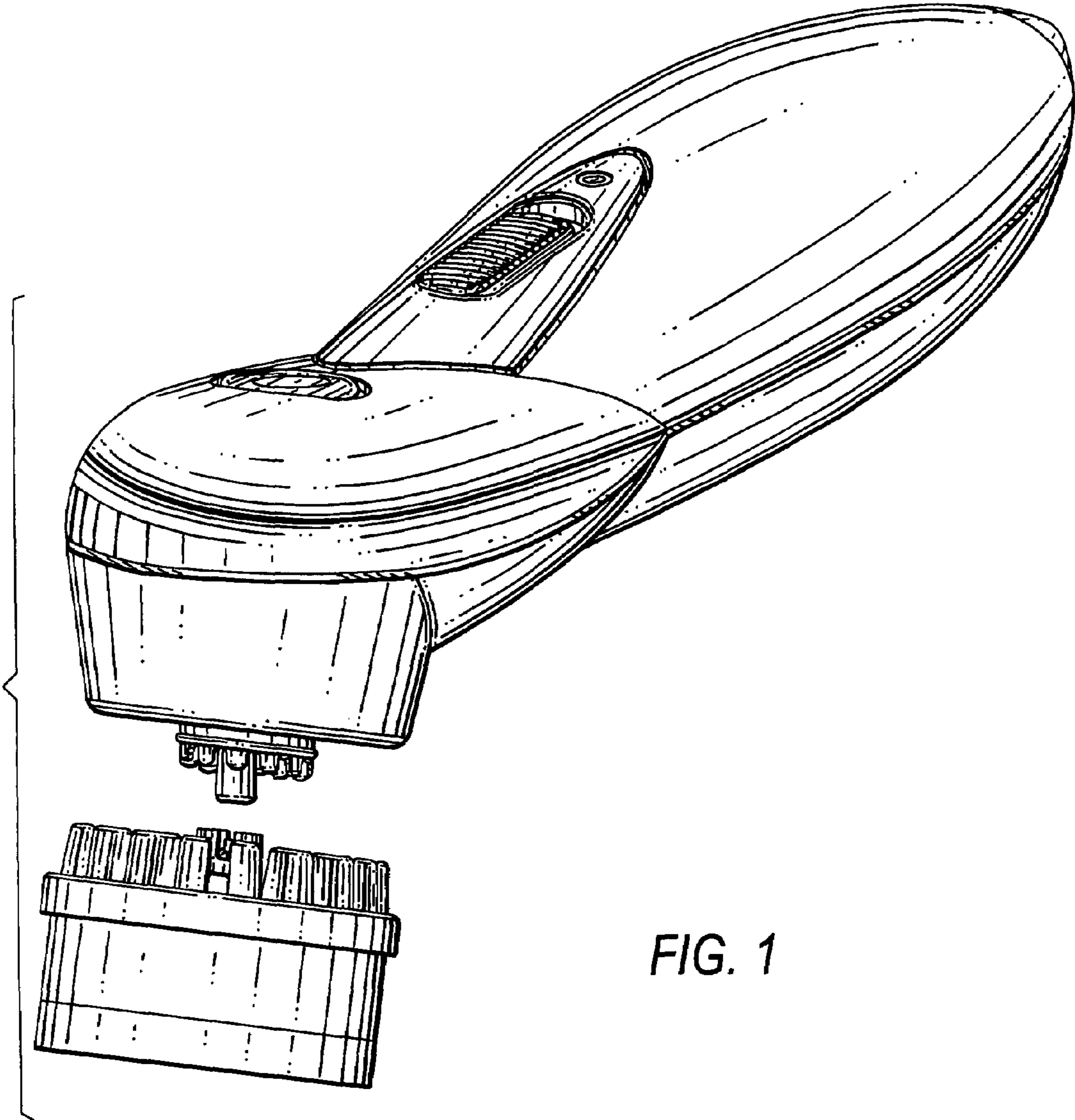

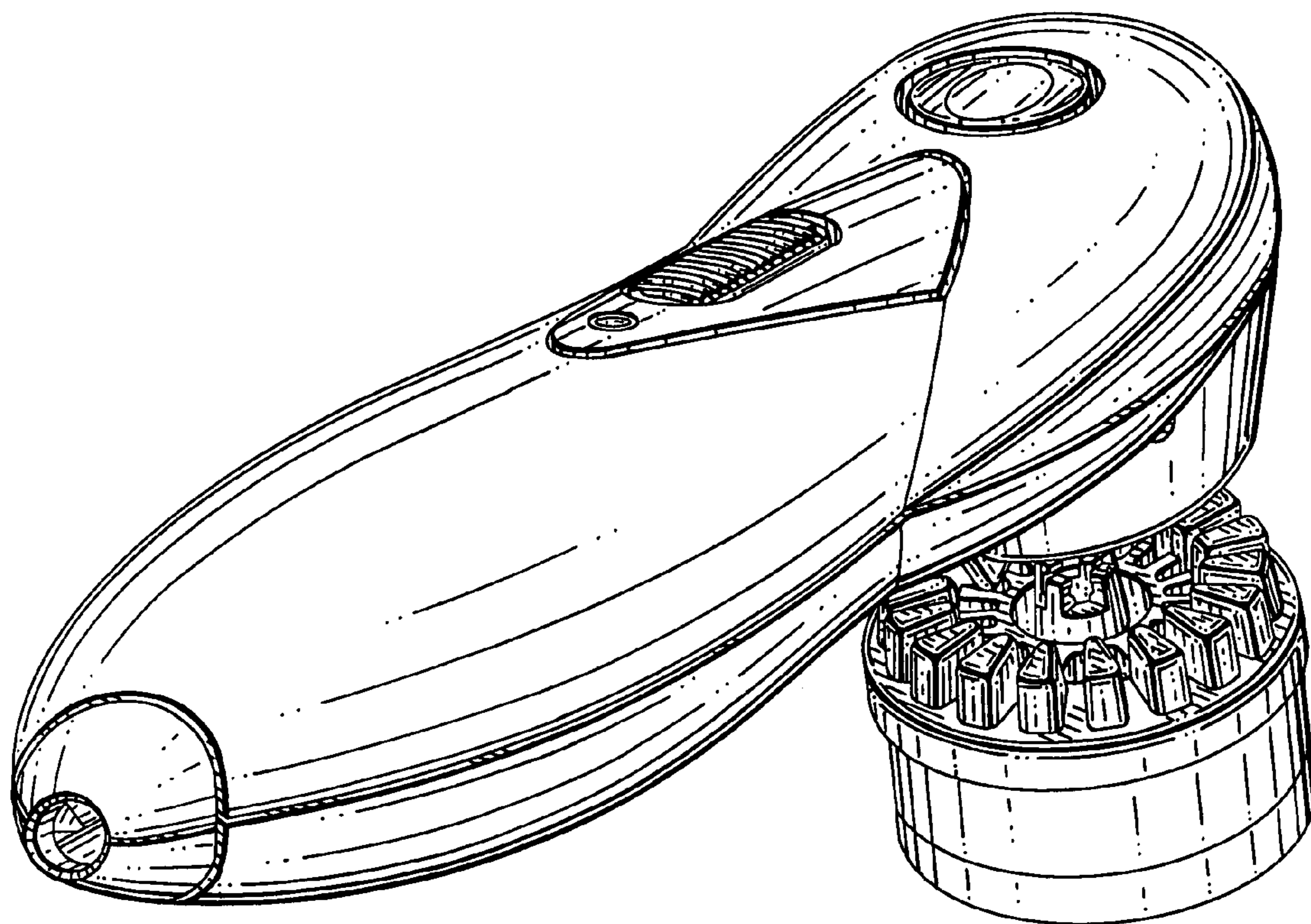

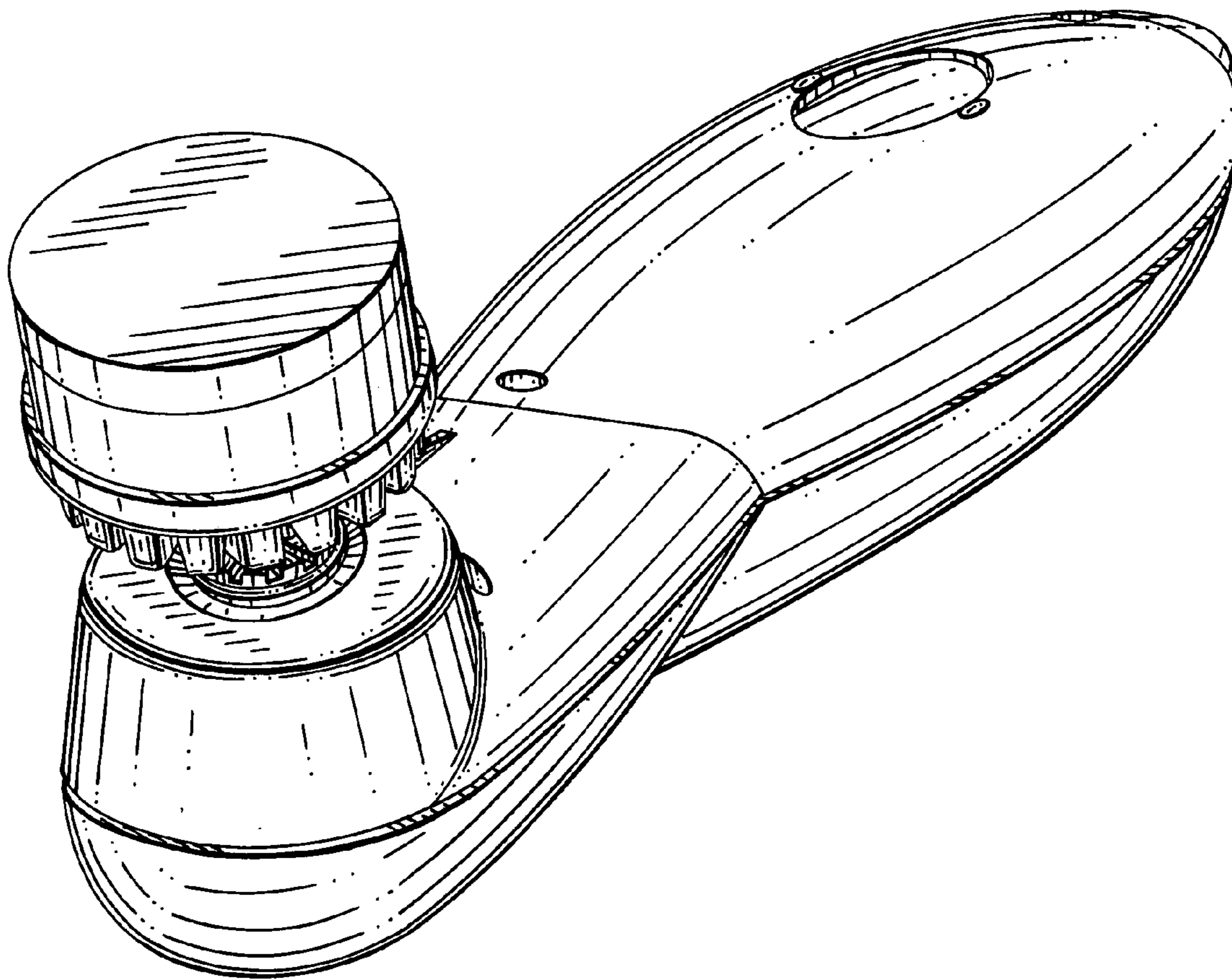

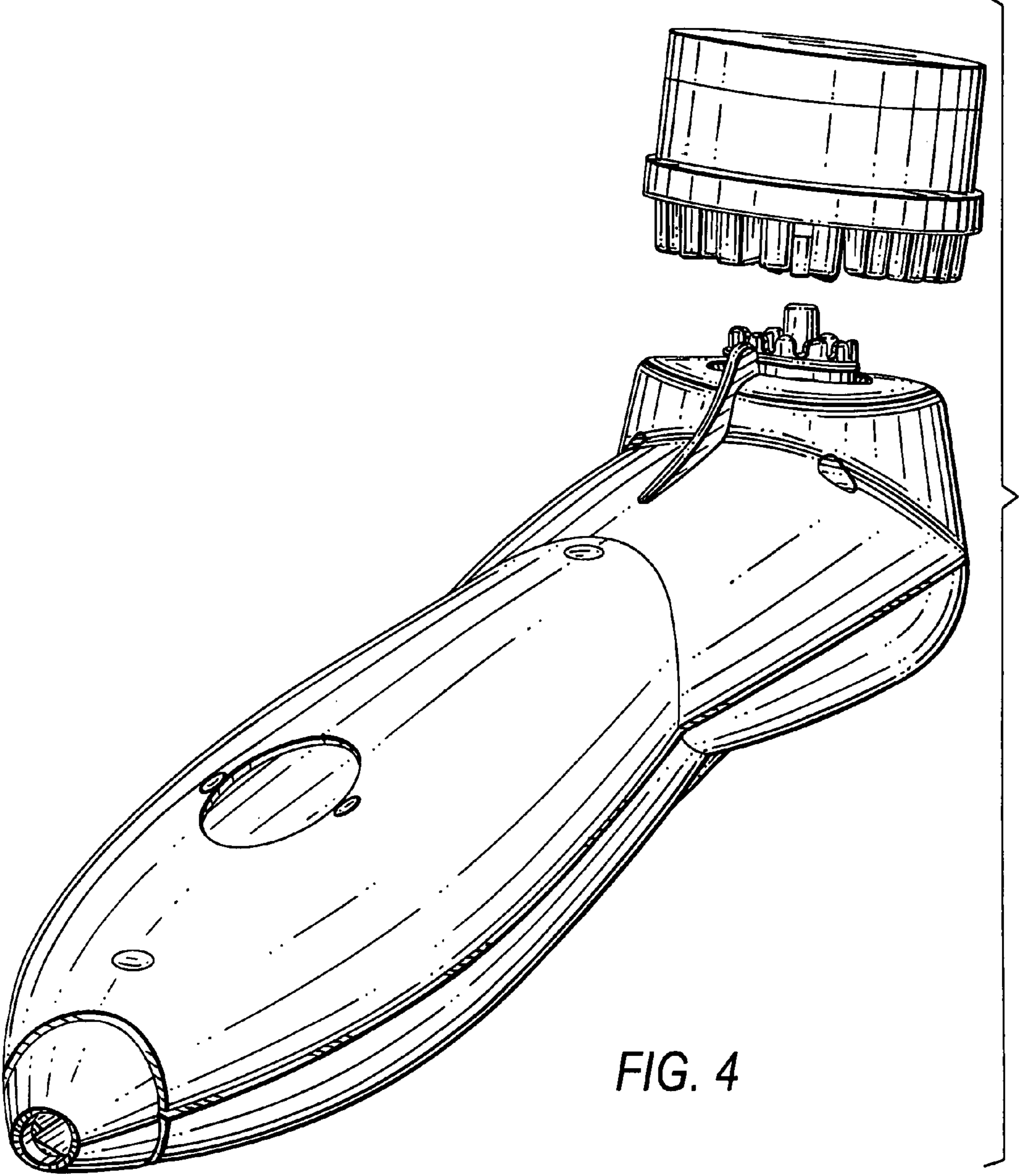

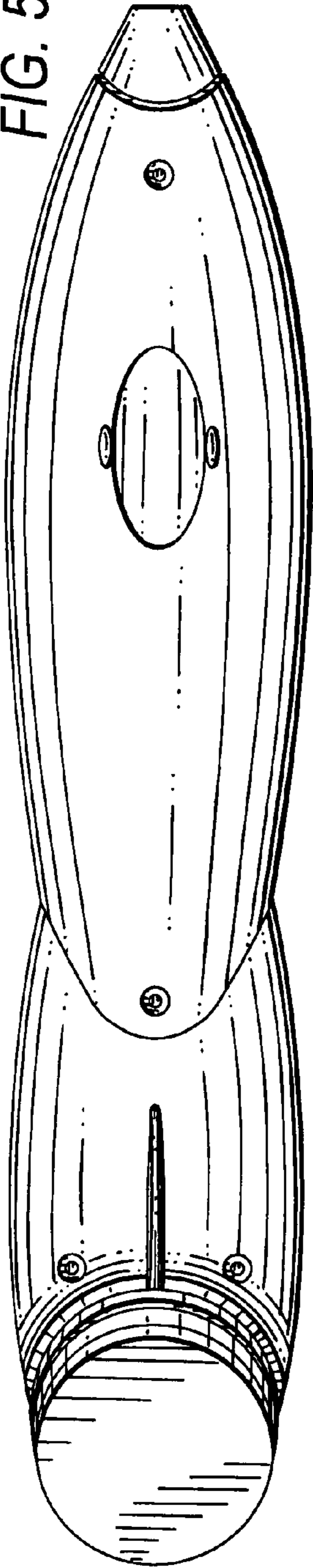

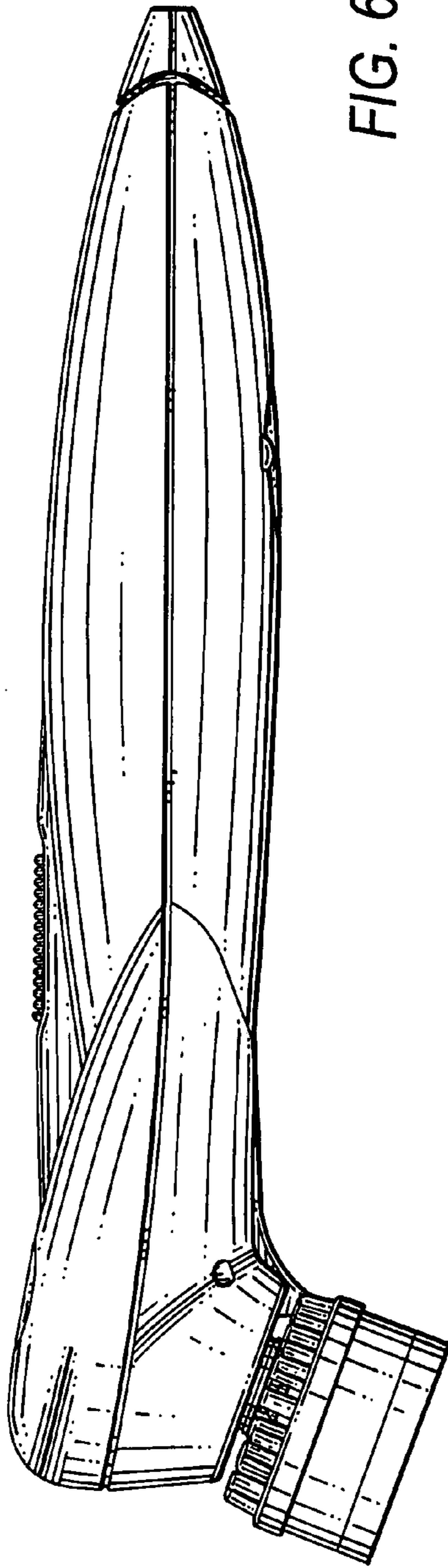
