(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a motorcycle boot, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right side perspective view of a motorcycle boot, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a front, right side perspective view of a second embodiment of the motorcycle boot that includes a zipper along the length of the spine;

FIG. 8 is a right side view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a left side view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a front view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a rear view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 7; and,

FIG. 12 is a top view of the motorcycle boot of FIG. 7.

The broken line showing of a lower vamp and a sole is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure and forms no part of the claimed design.

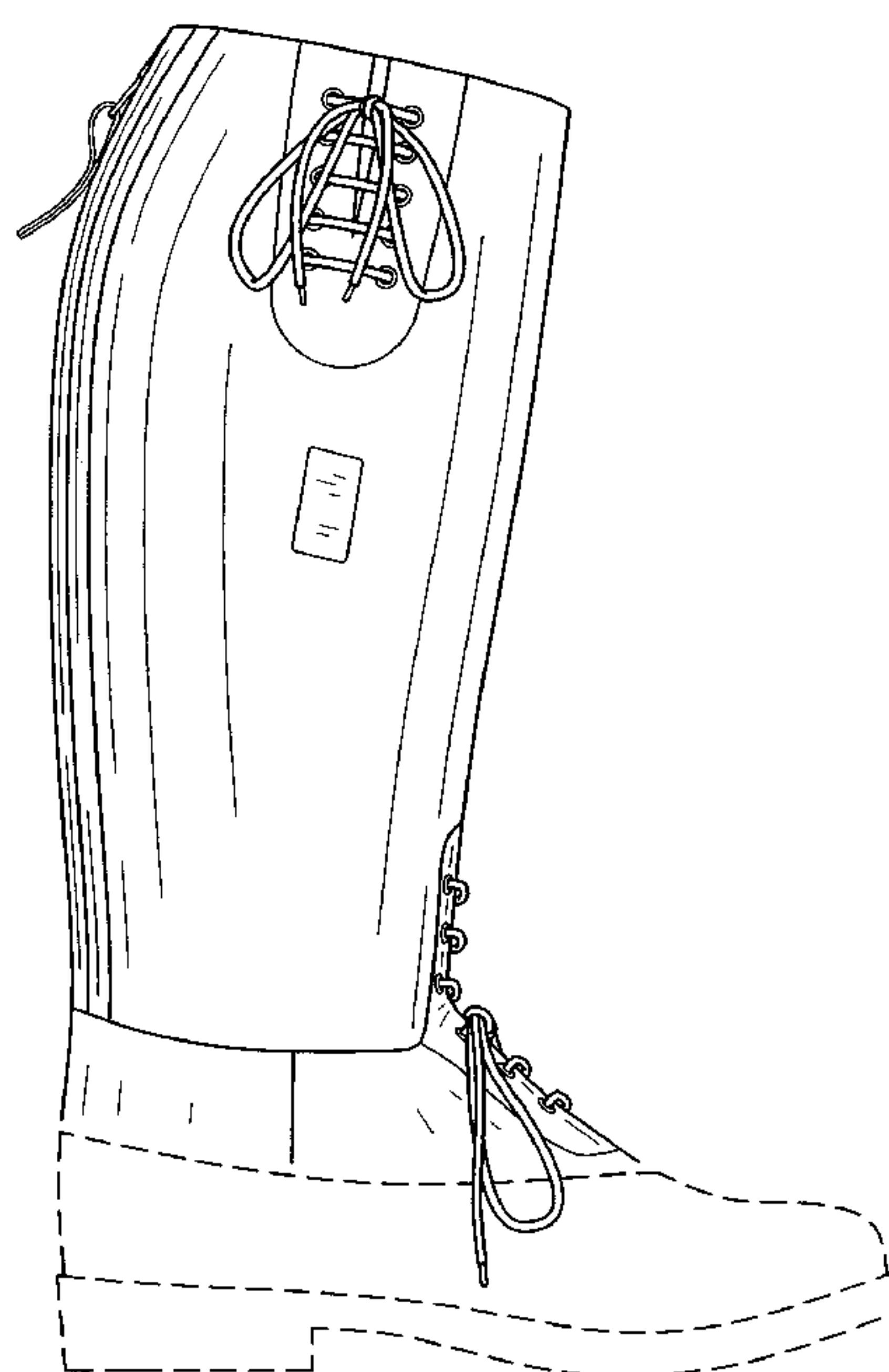
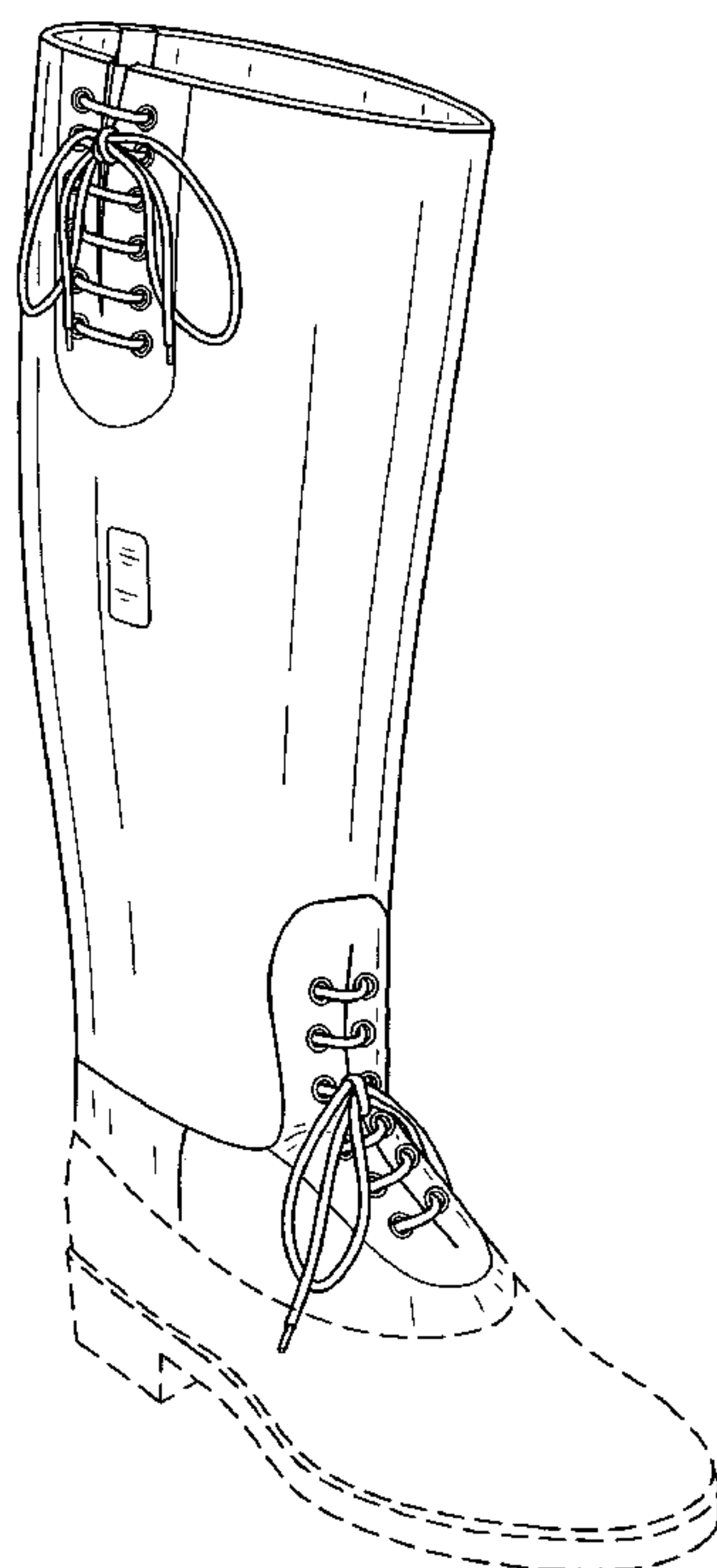

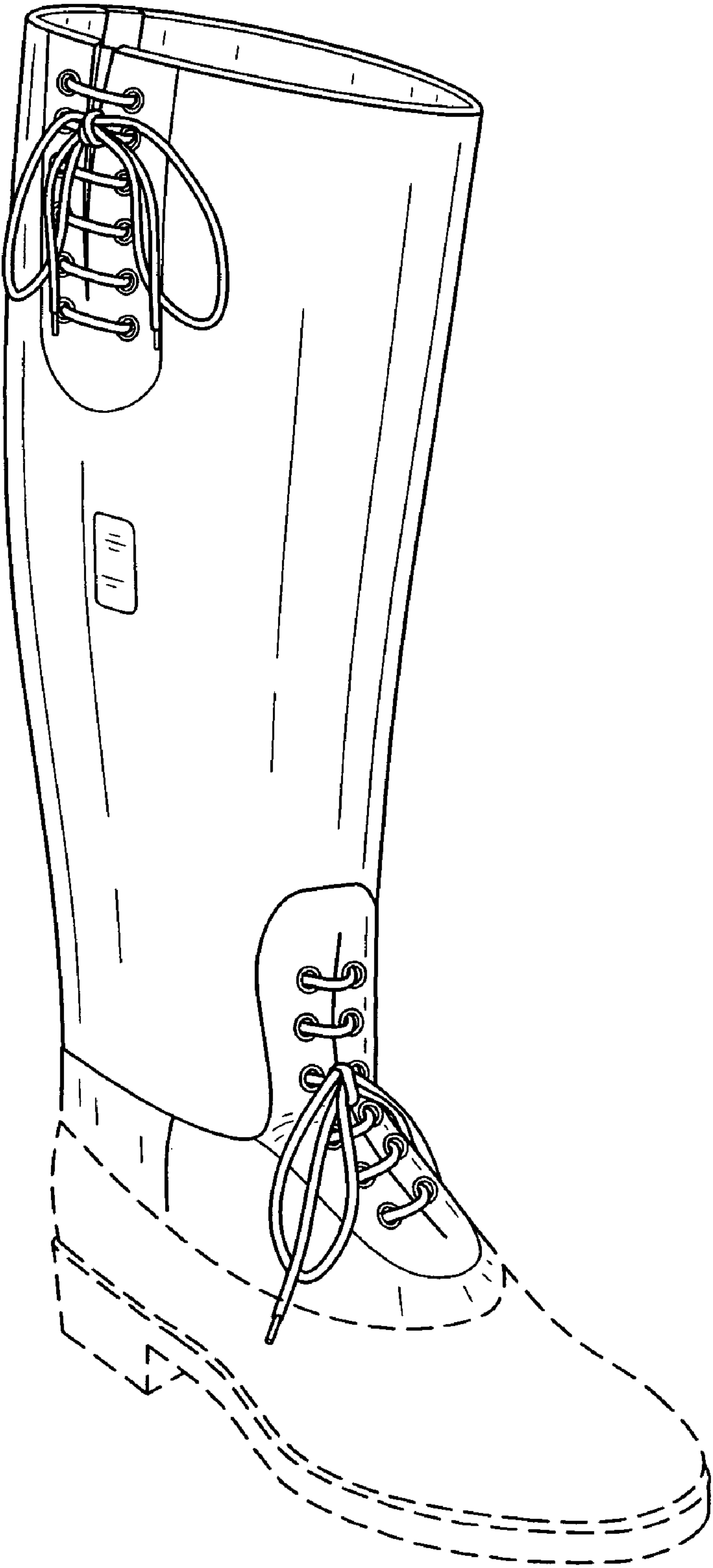

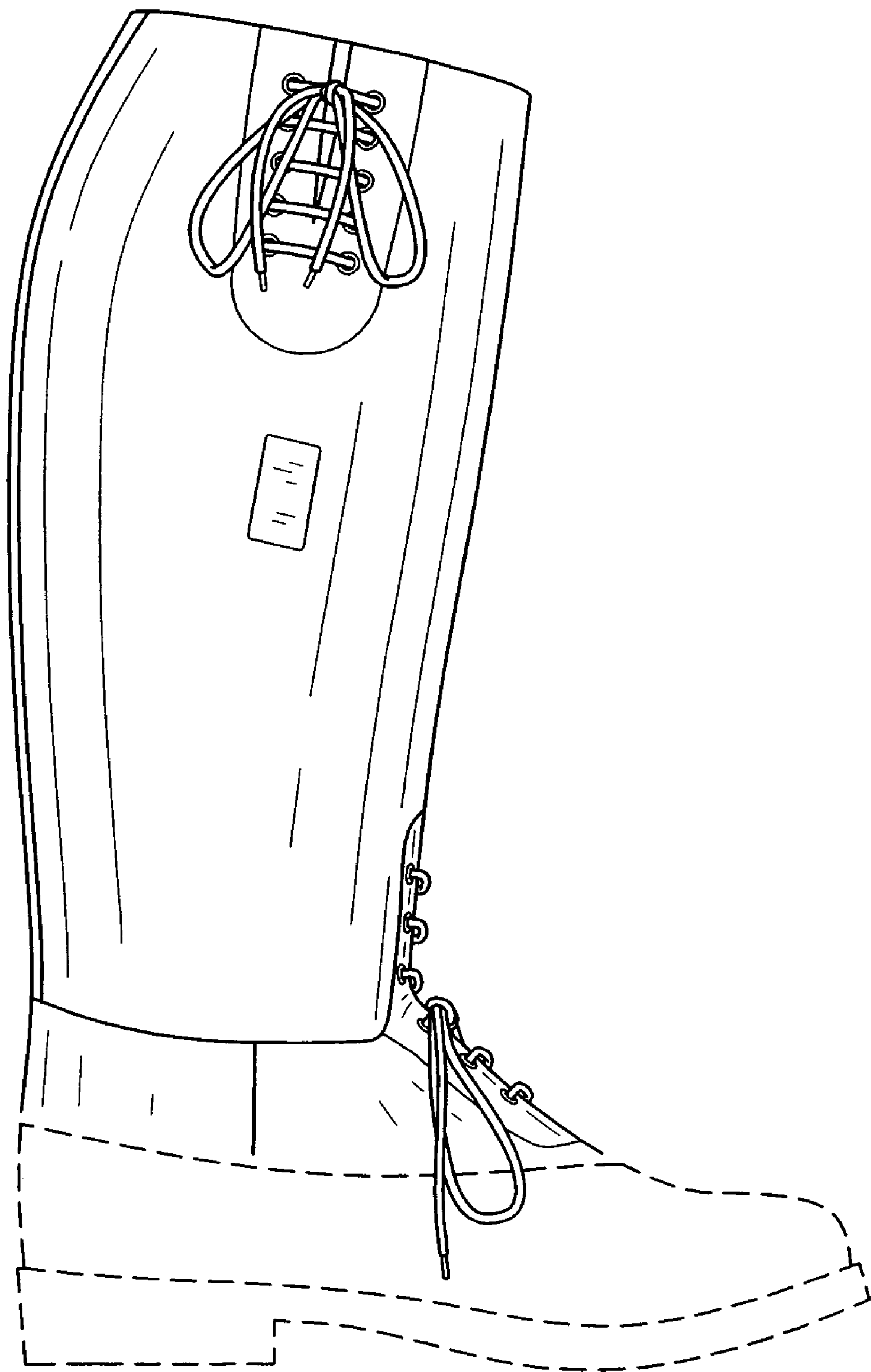

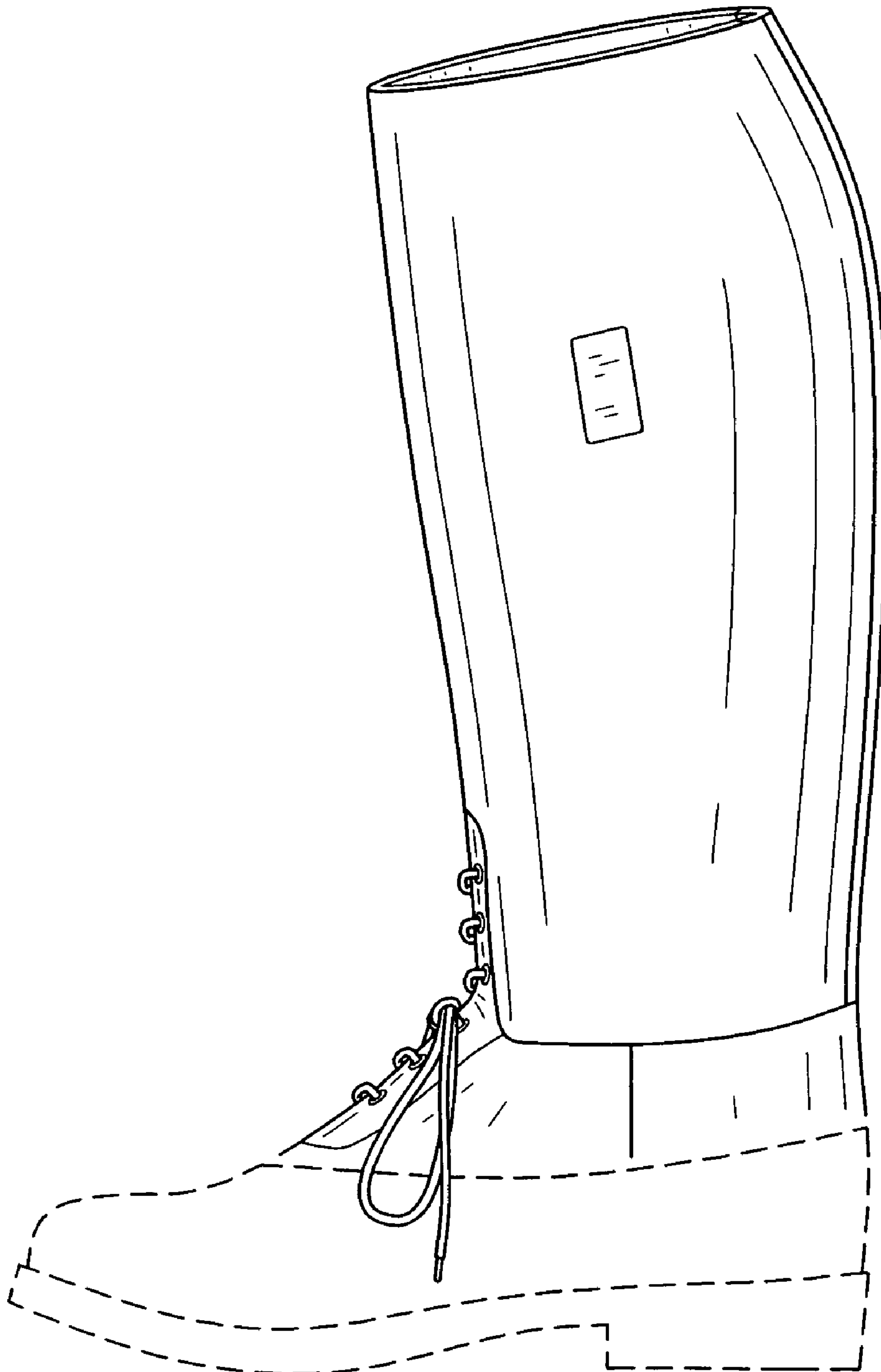

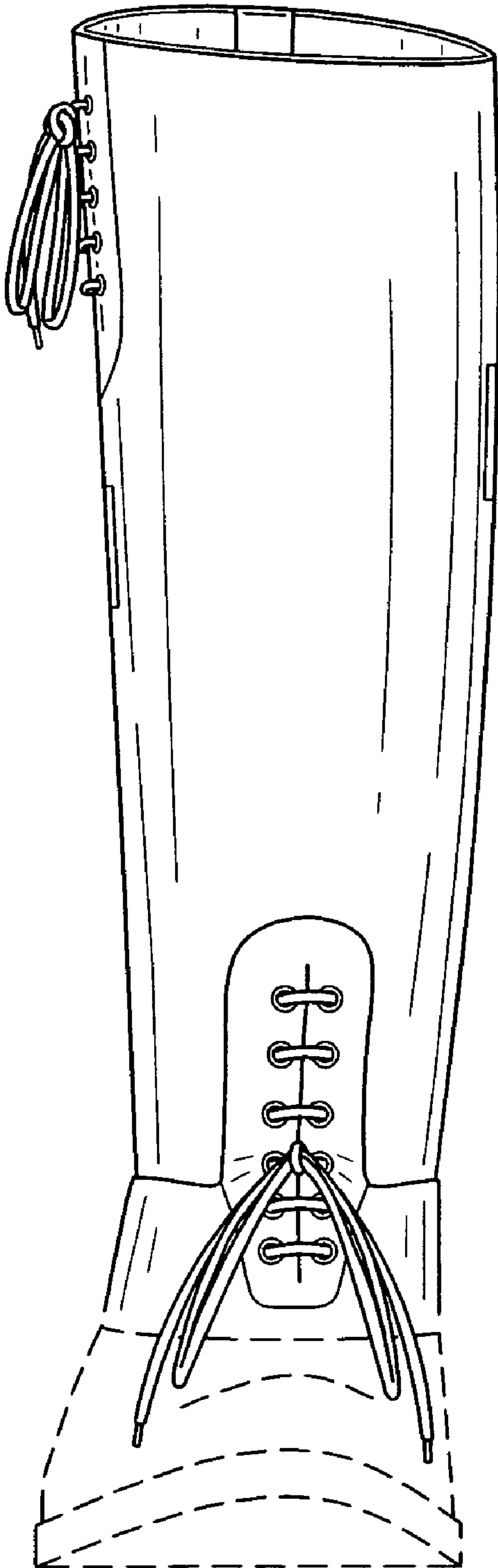

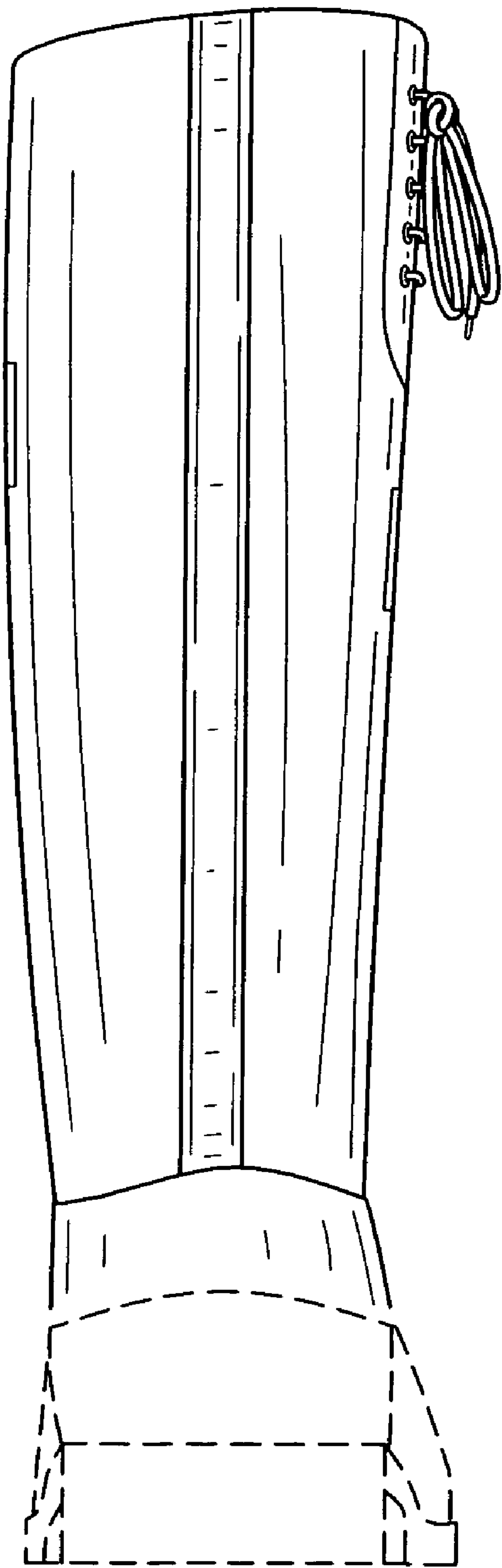

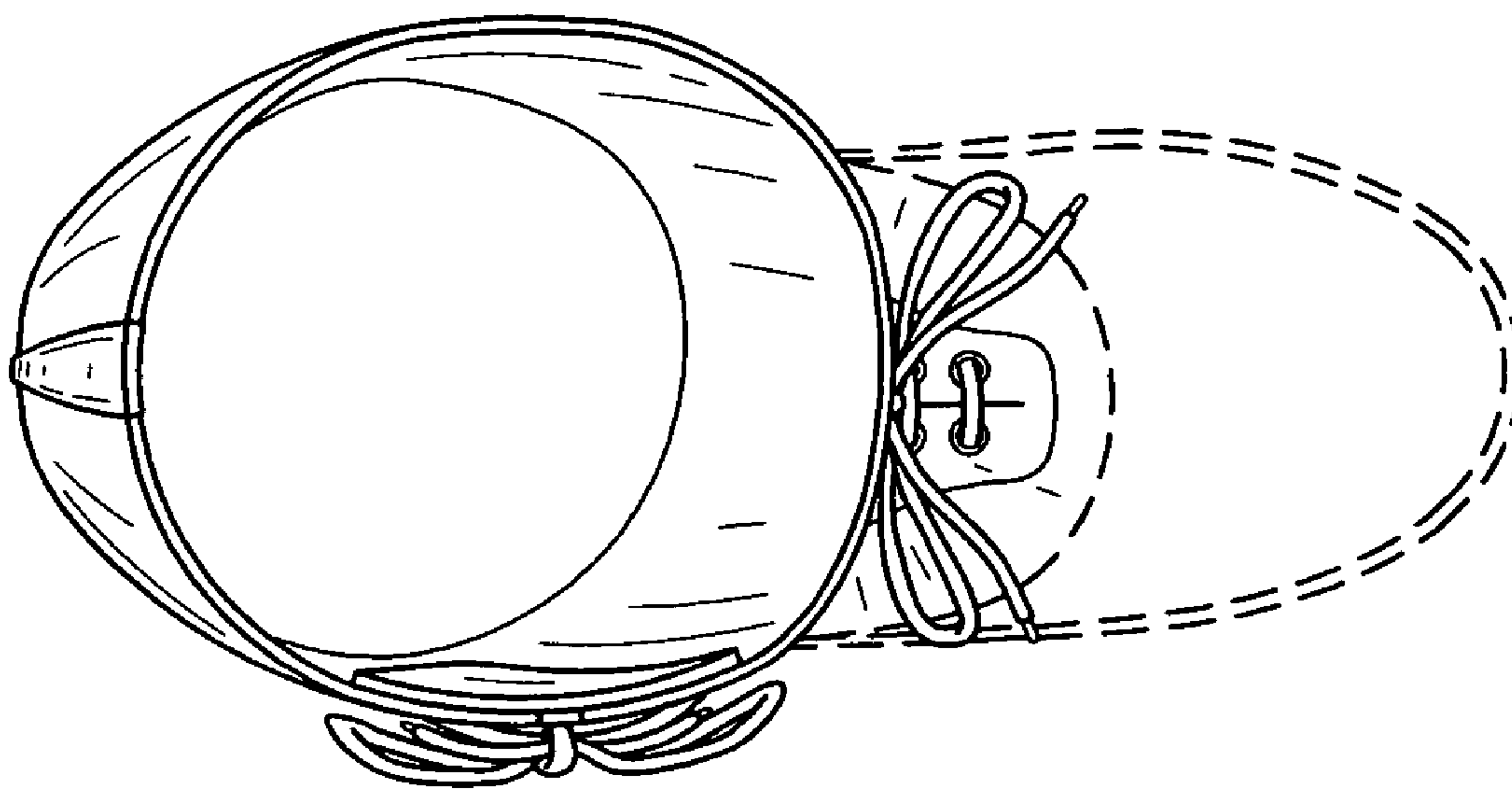

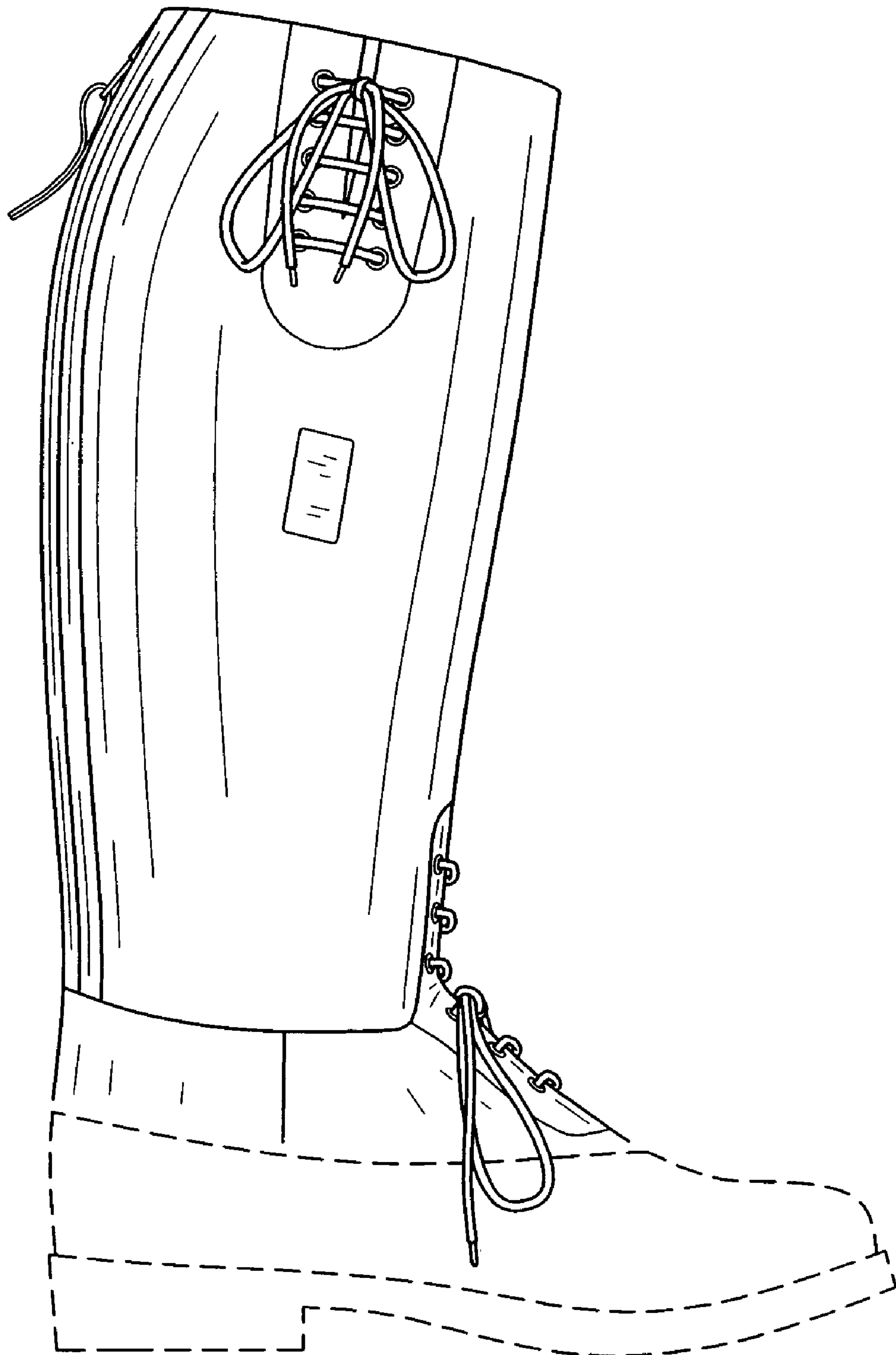

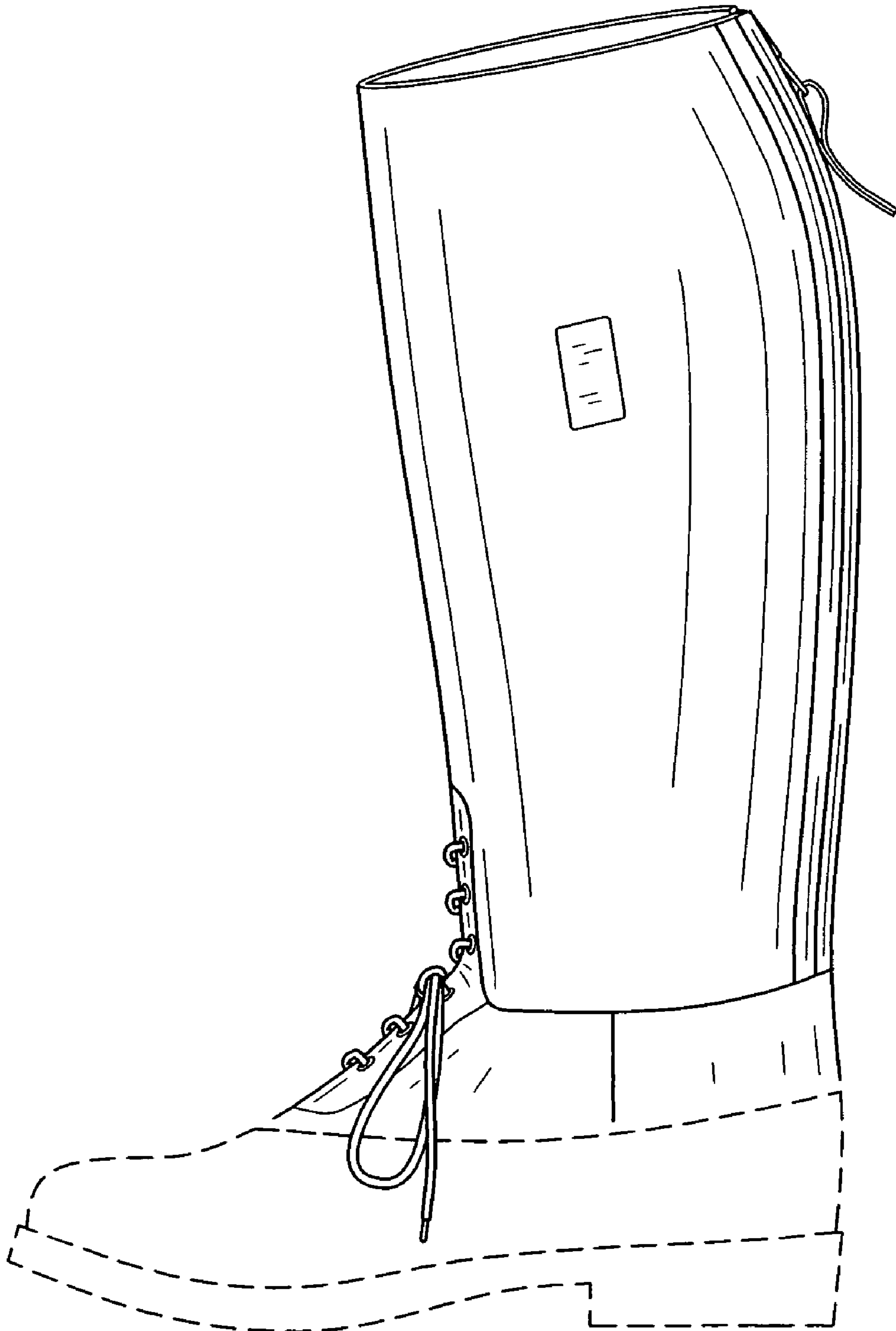

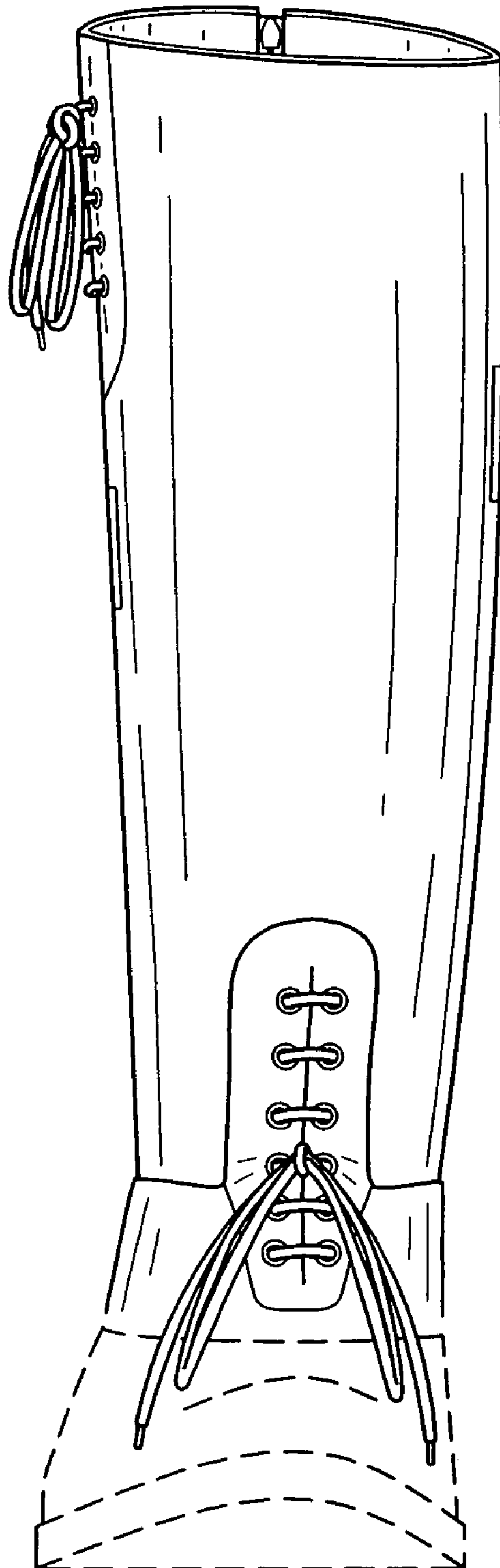

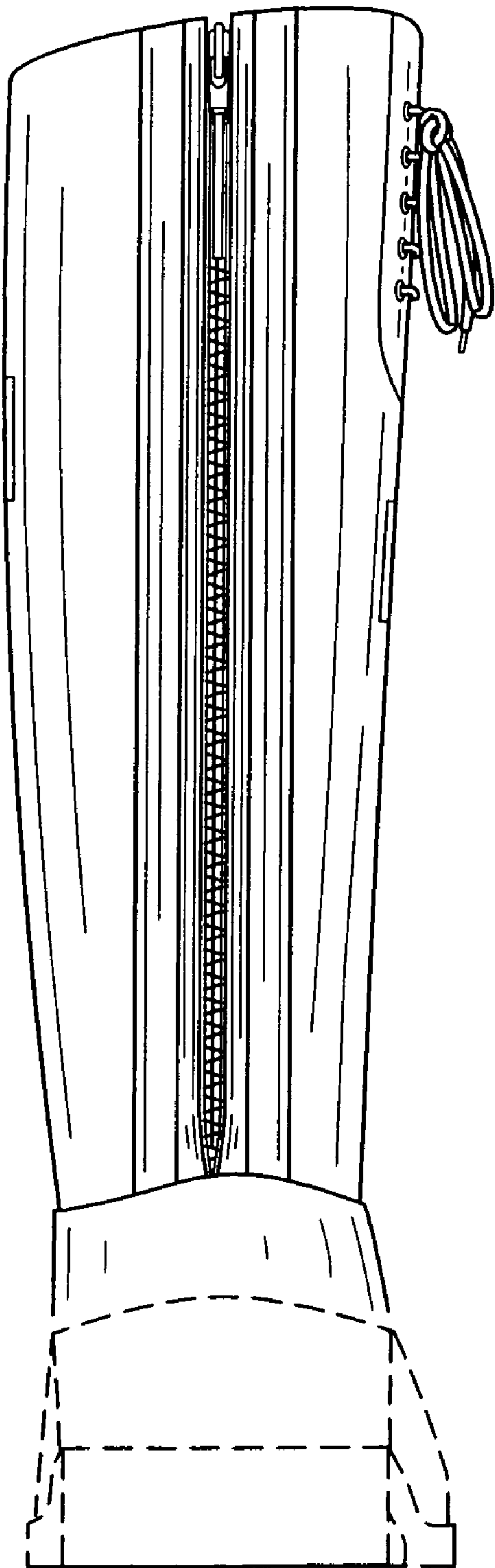
