DESCRIPTION

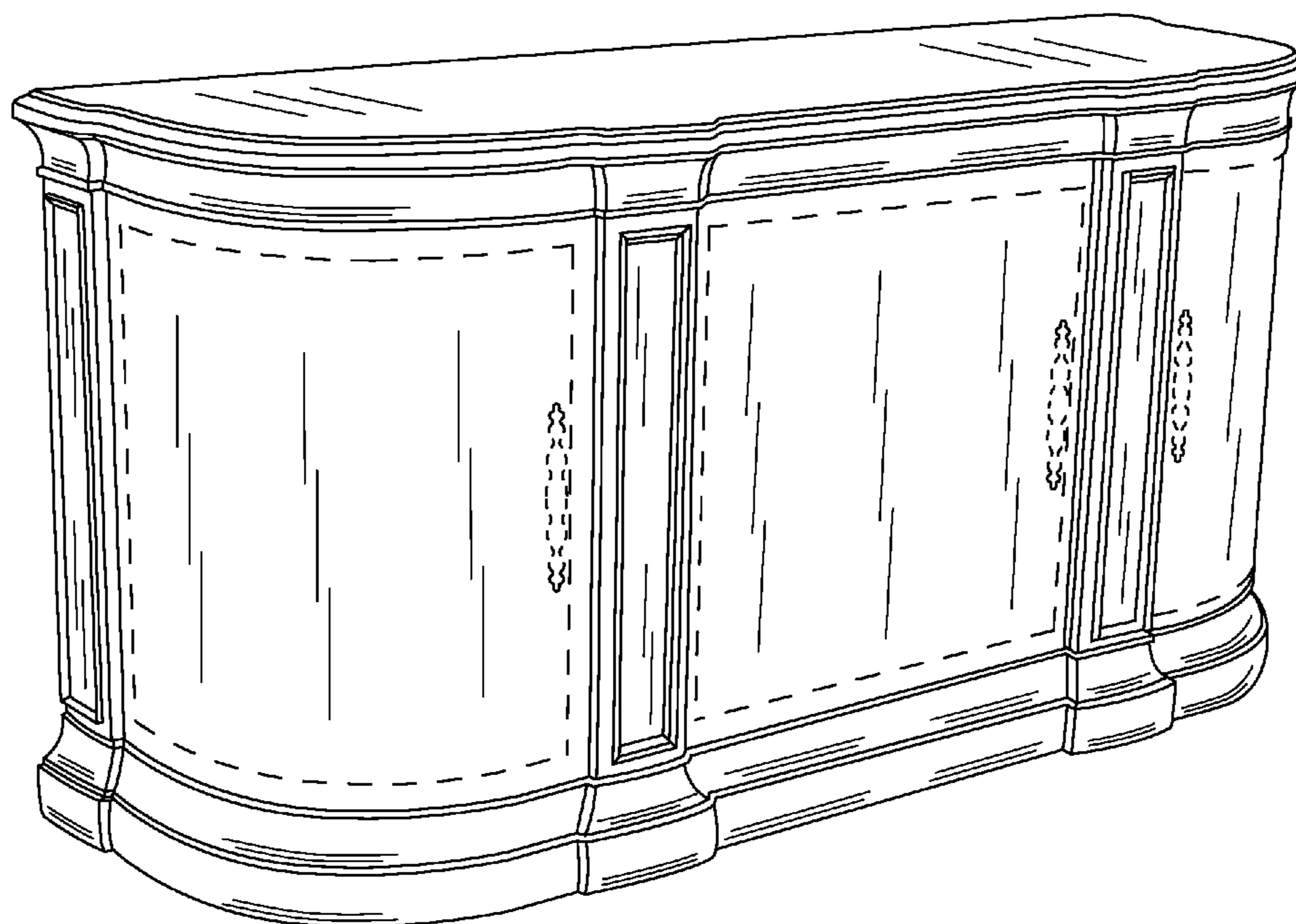
FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a sideboard showing my new design;

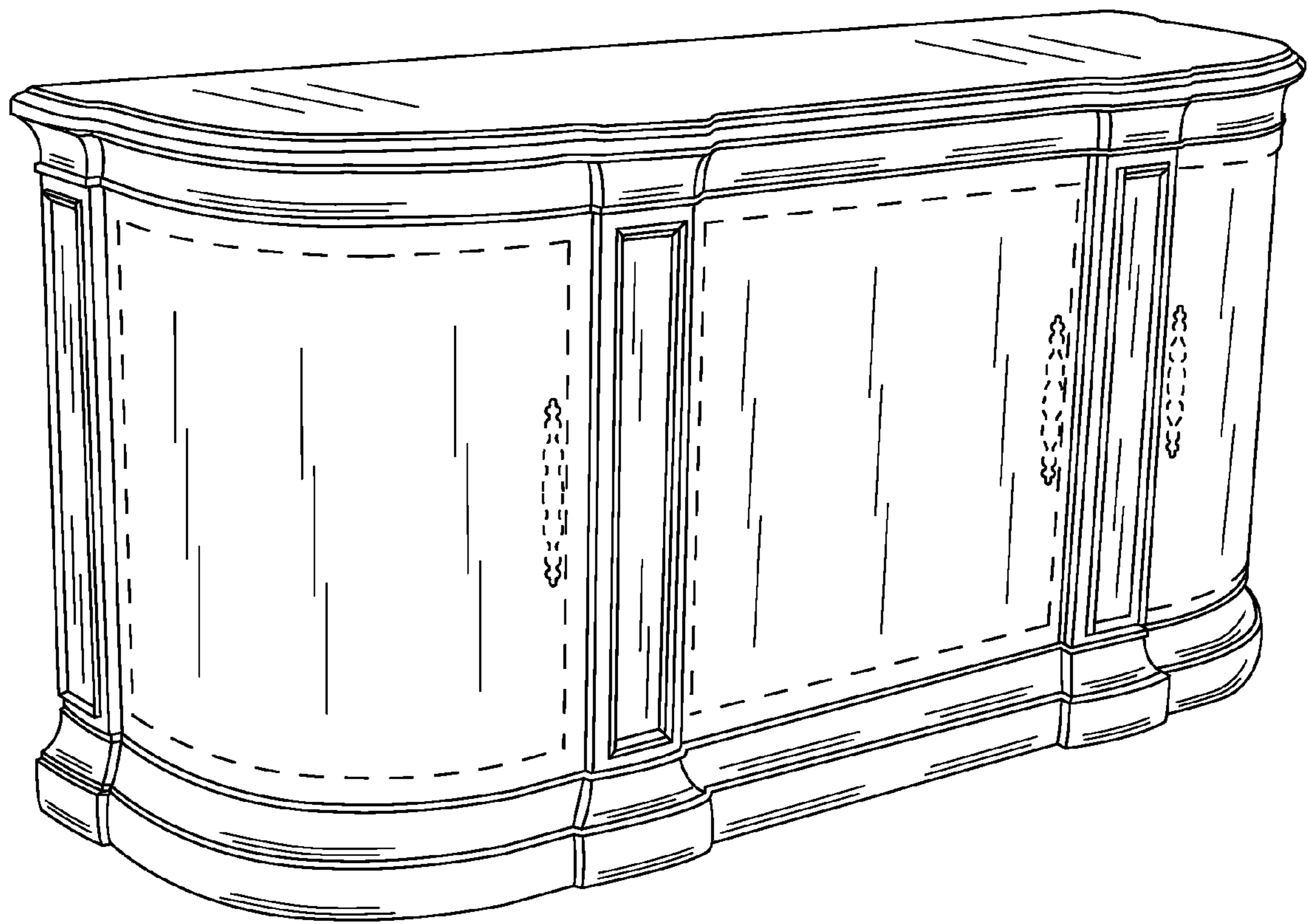

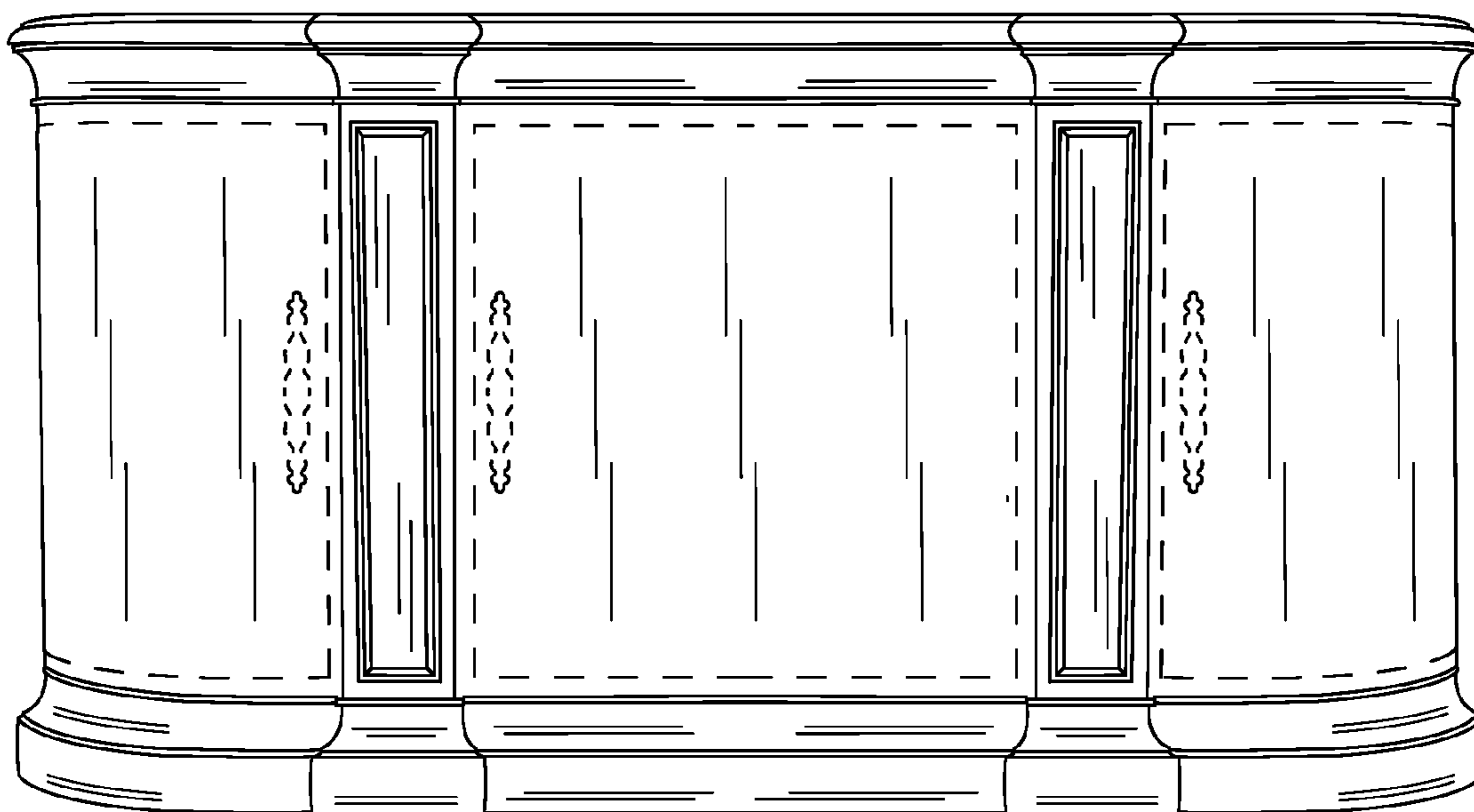

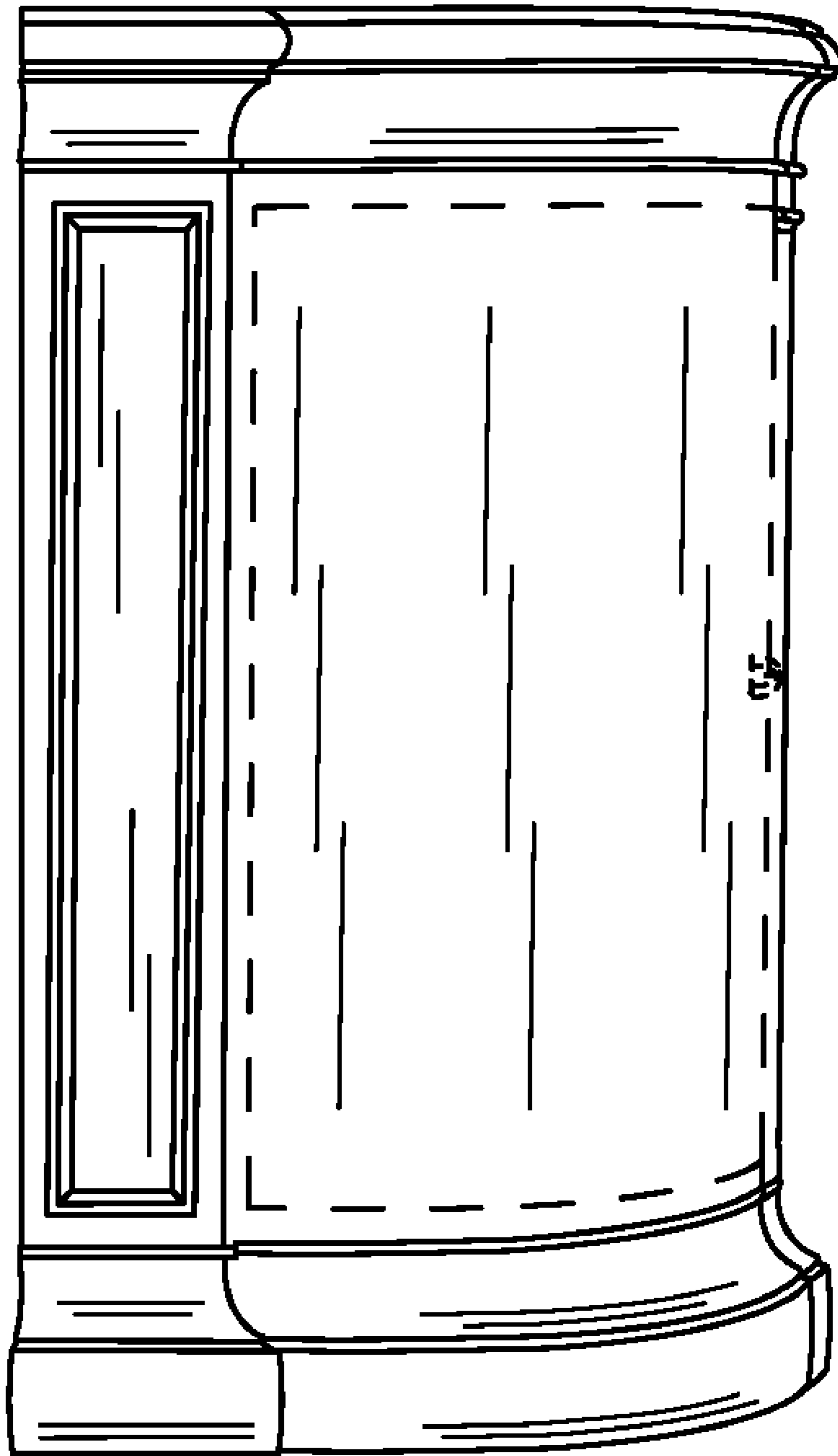
