#### **CLAIM** (57)

The ornamental design for a cocktail table, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cocktail table according to an embodiment of the invention.
- FIG. 2 is an overhead view of a cocktail table according to an embodiment of the invention.
- FIG. 3 is a side view of a cocktail table according to an embodiment of the invention, wherein the opposite side is a mirror-image thereto; and,
- FIG. 4 is an end view of a cocktail table according to an embodiment of the invention, wherein the opposite end is a mirror-image thereto.
