The ornamental design for a portion of a shelf organizing assembly, as shown and described.

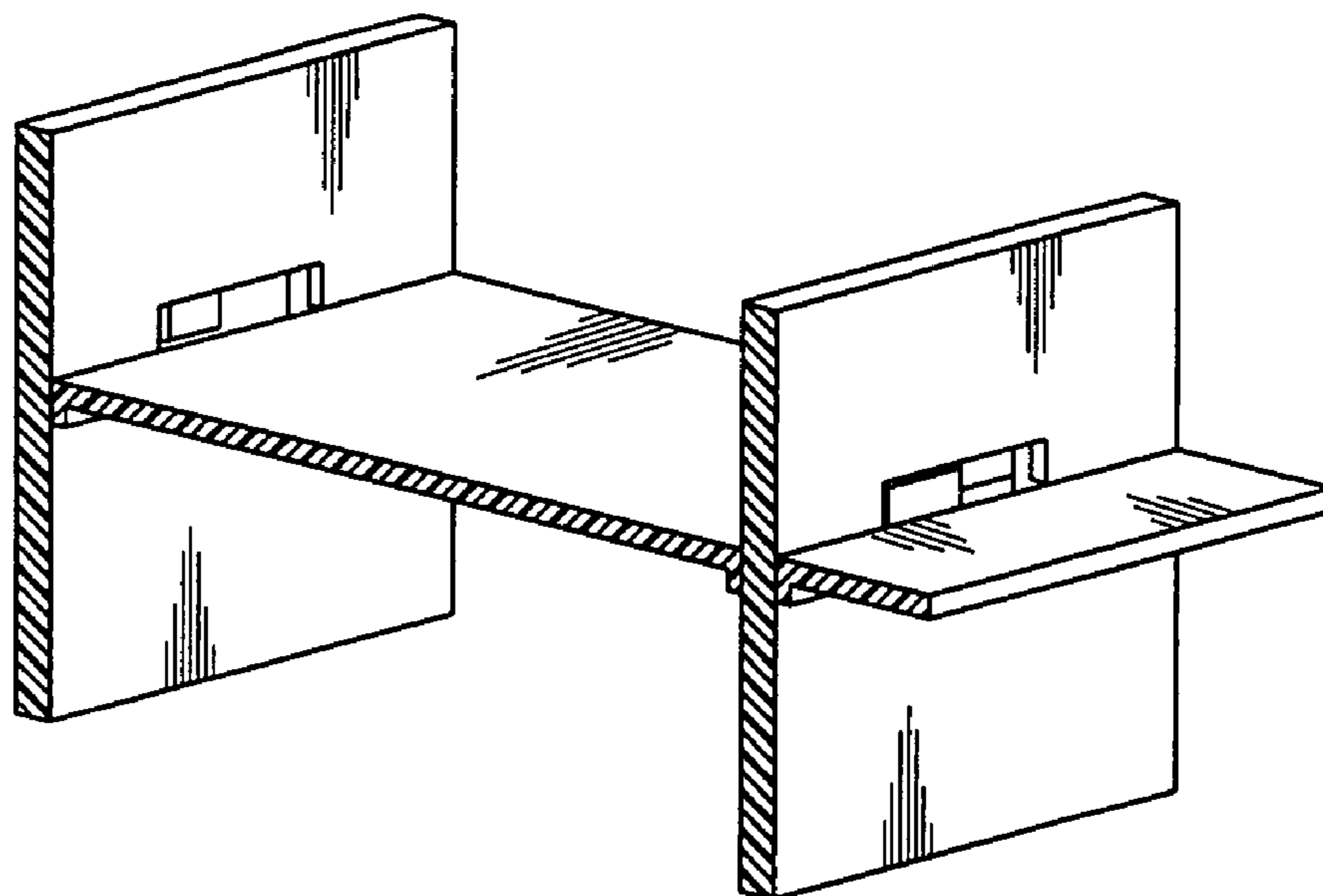
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front, top, side perspective view of a portion of a shelf organizing assembly showing my new design.

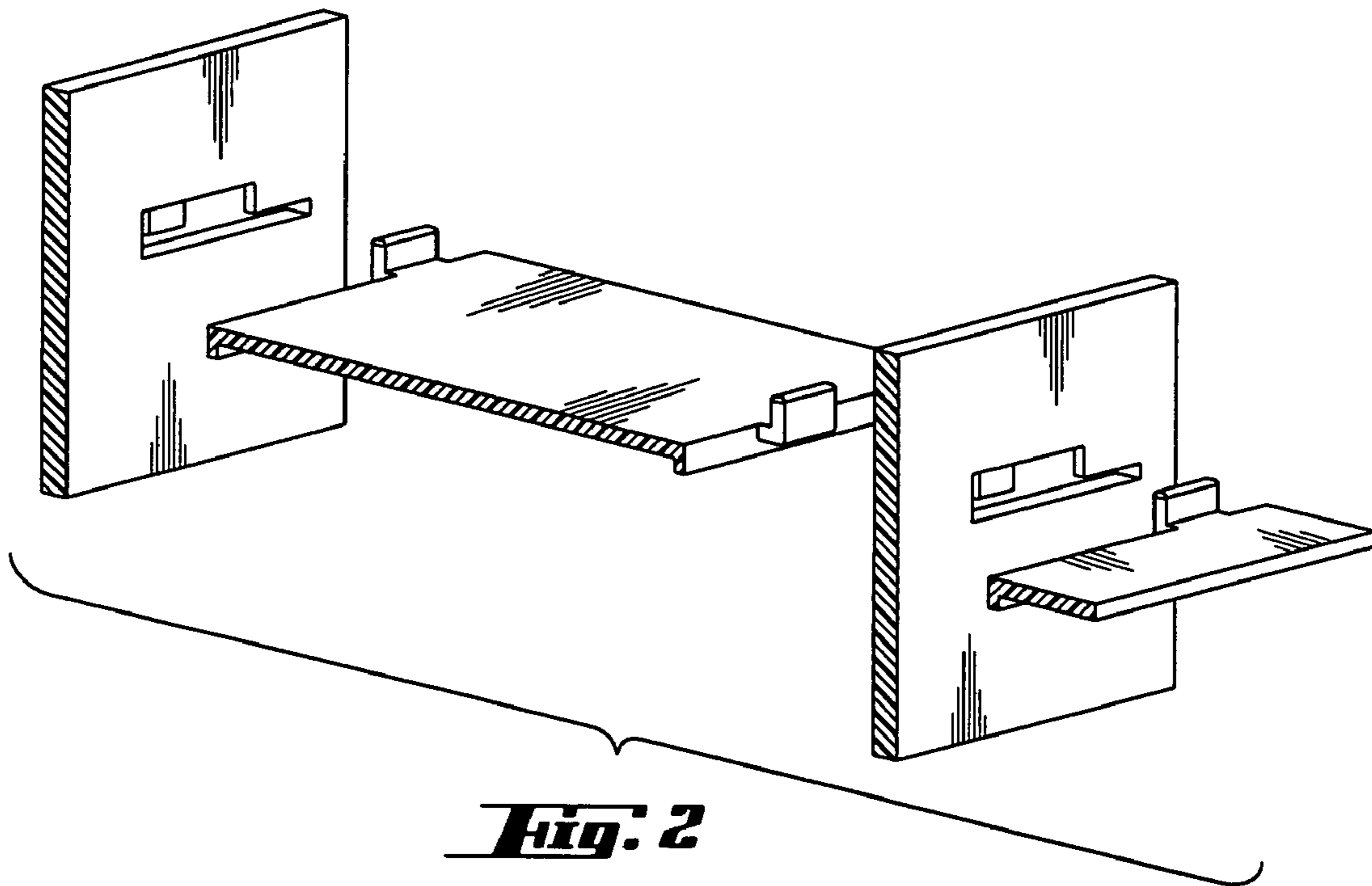
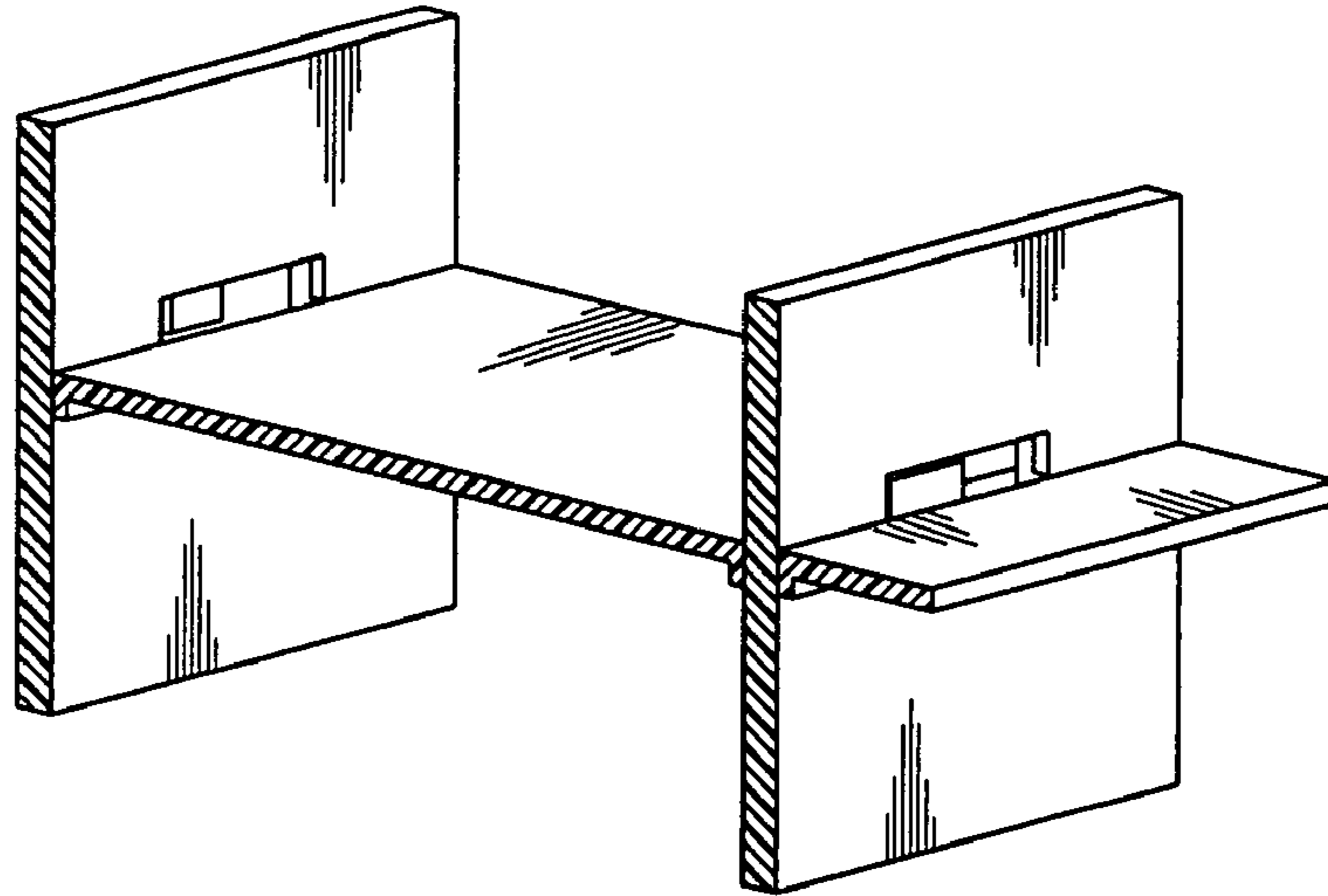
FIG. 2 is an exploded view of the individual components thereof; and,
