FIG. 2 is a reduced front elevational view thereof.

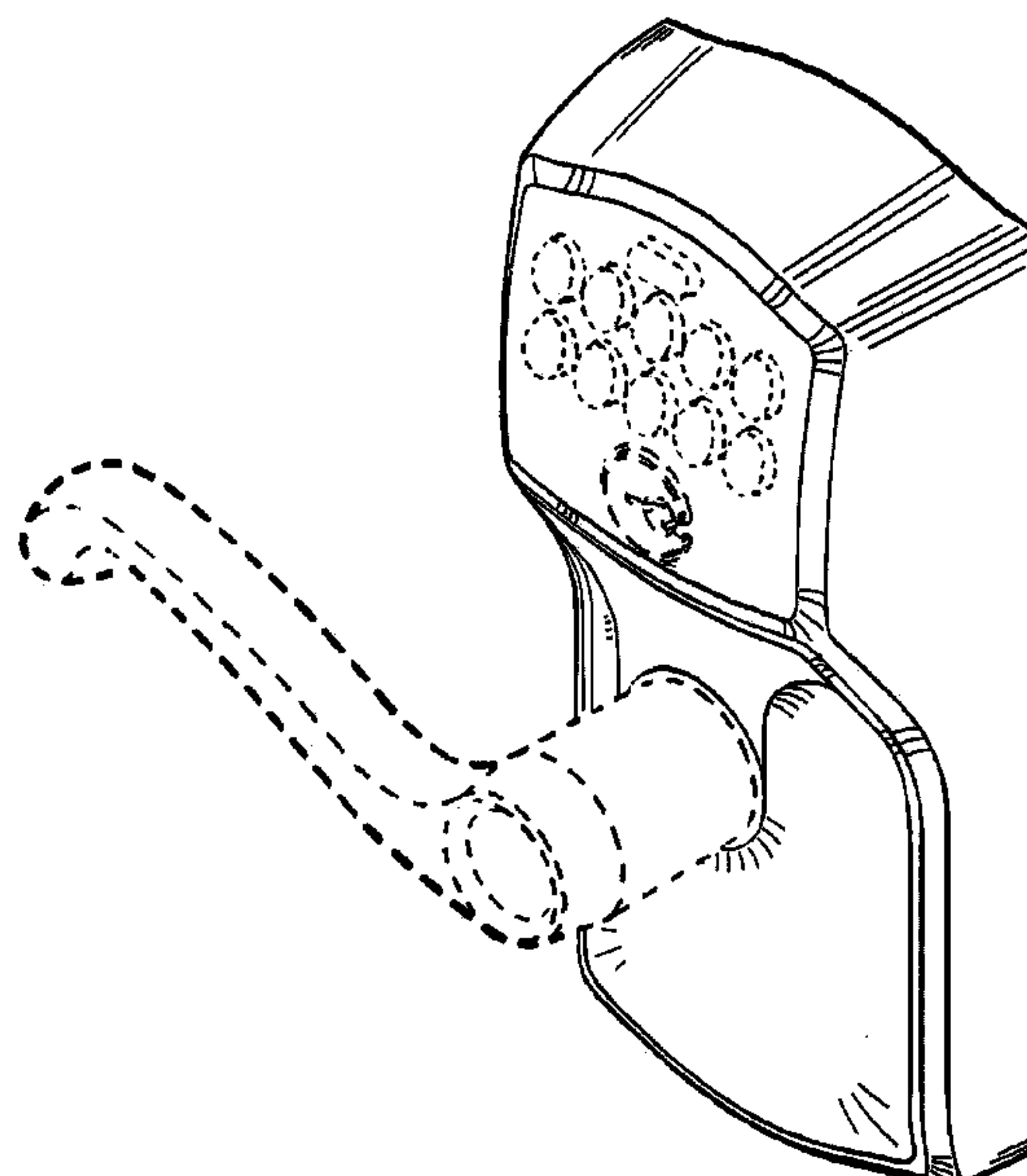
FIG. 3 is a reduced top plan view thereof.

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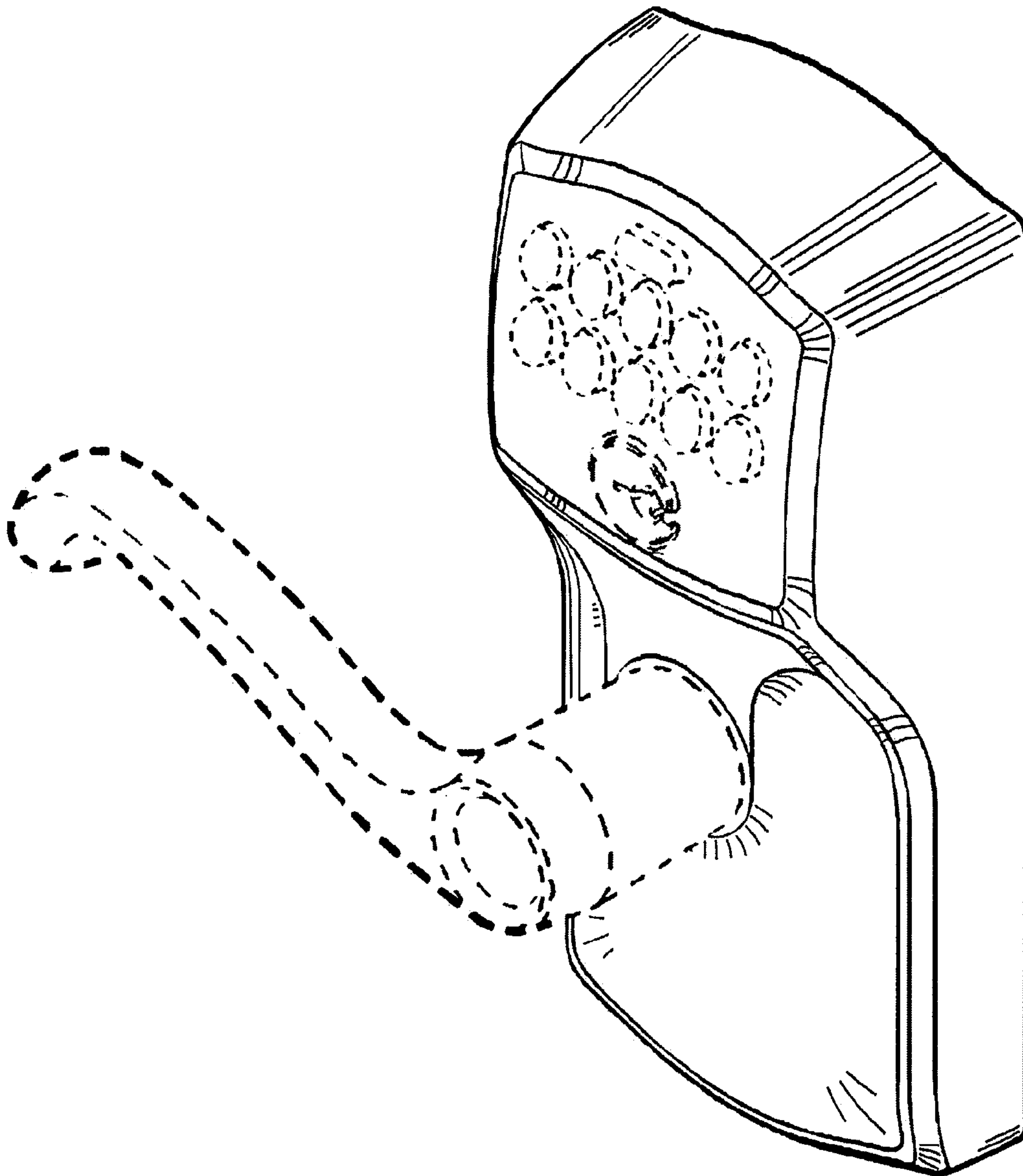

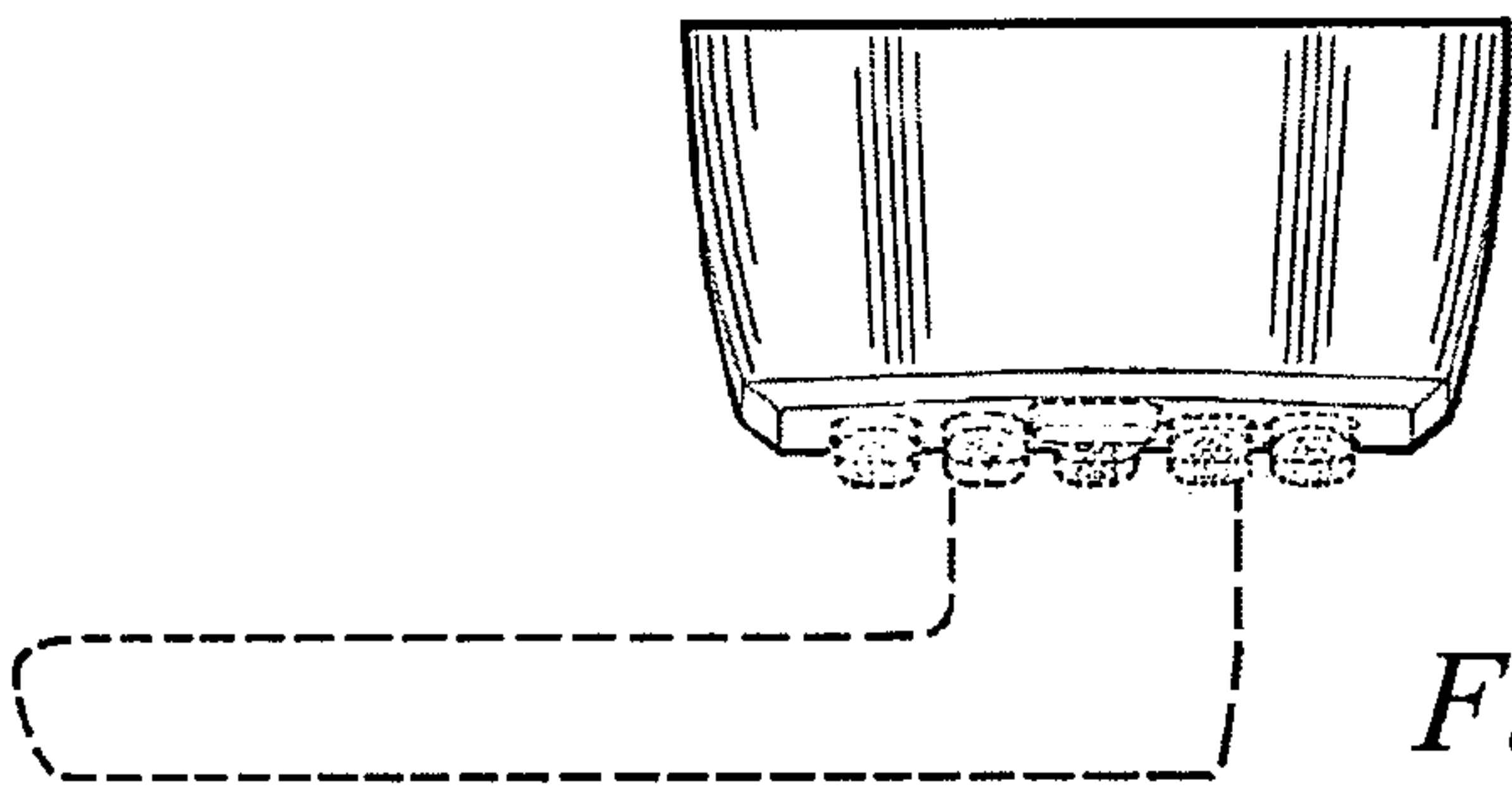

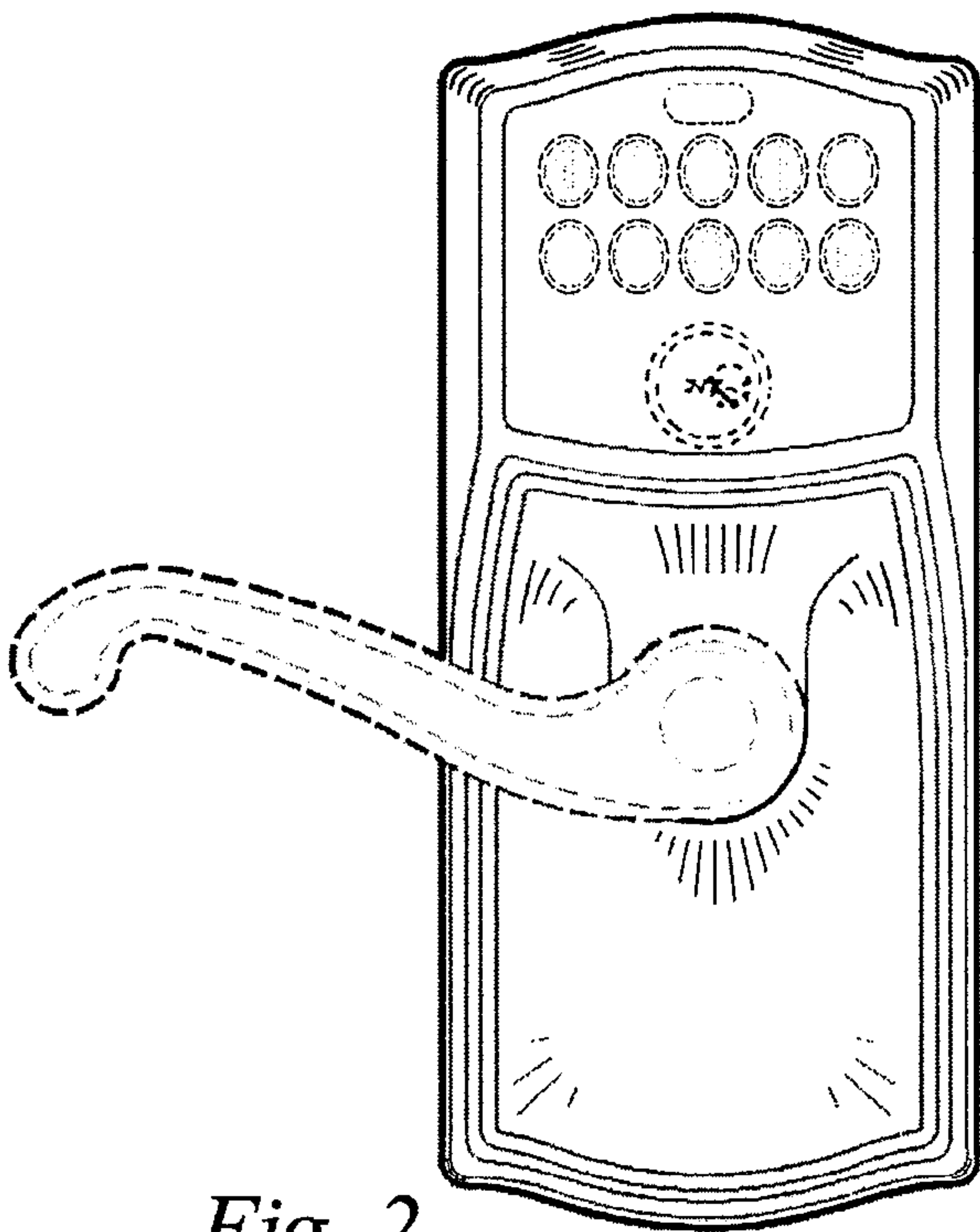

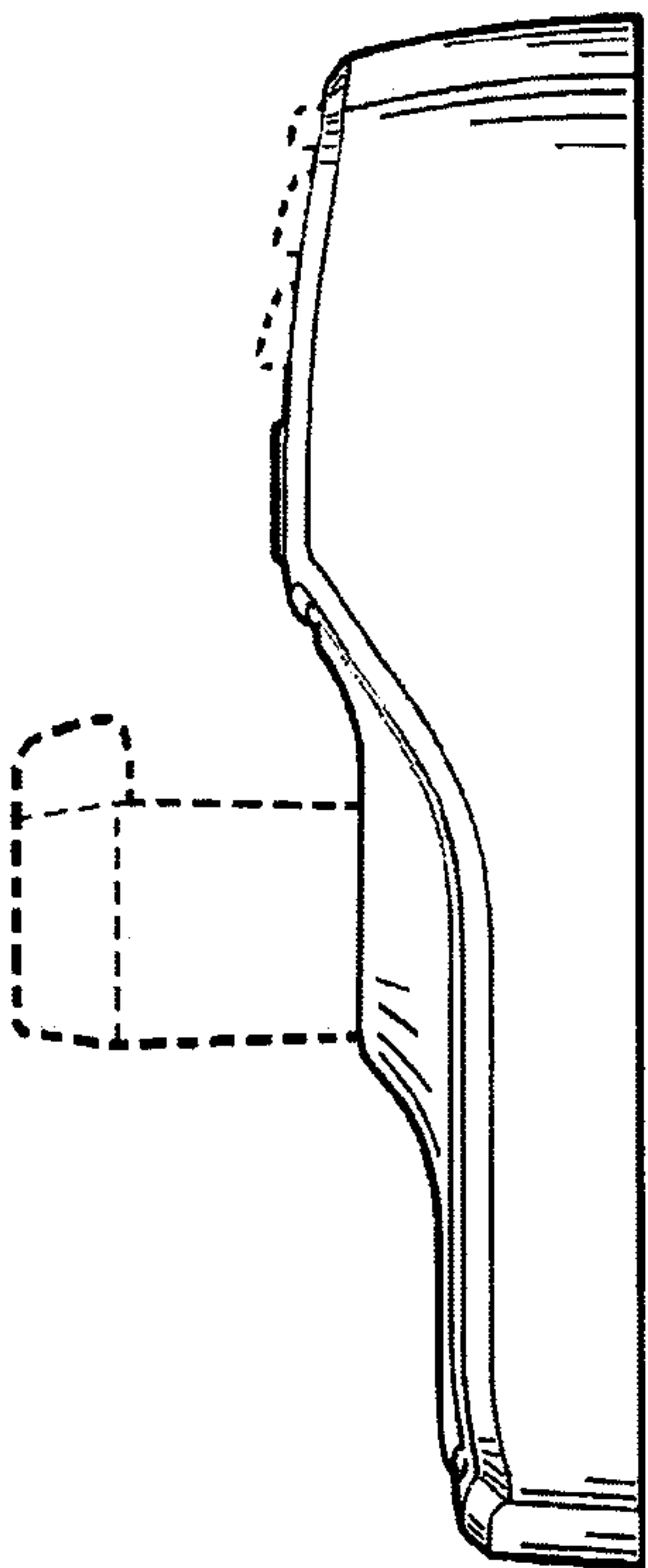

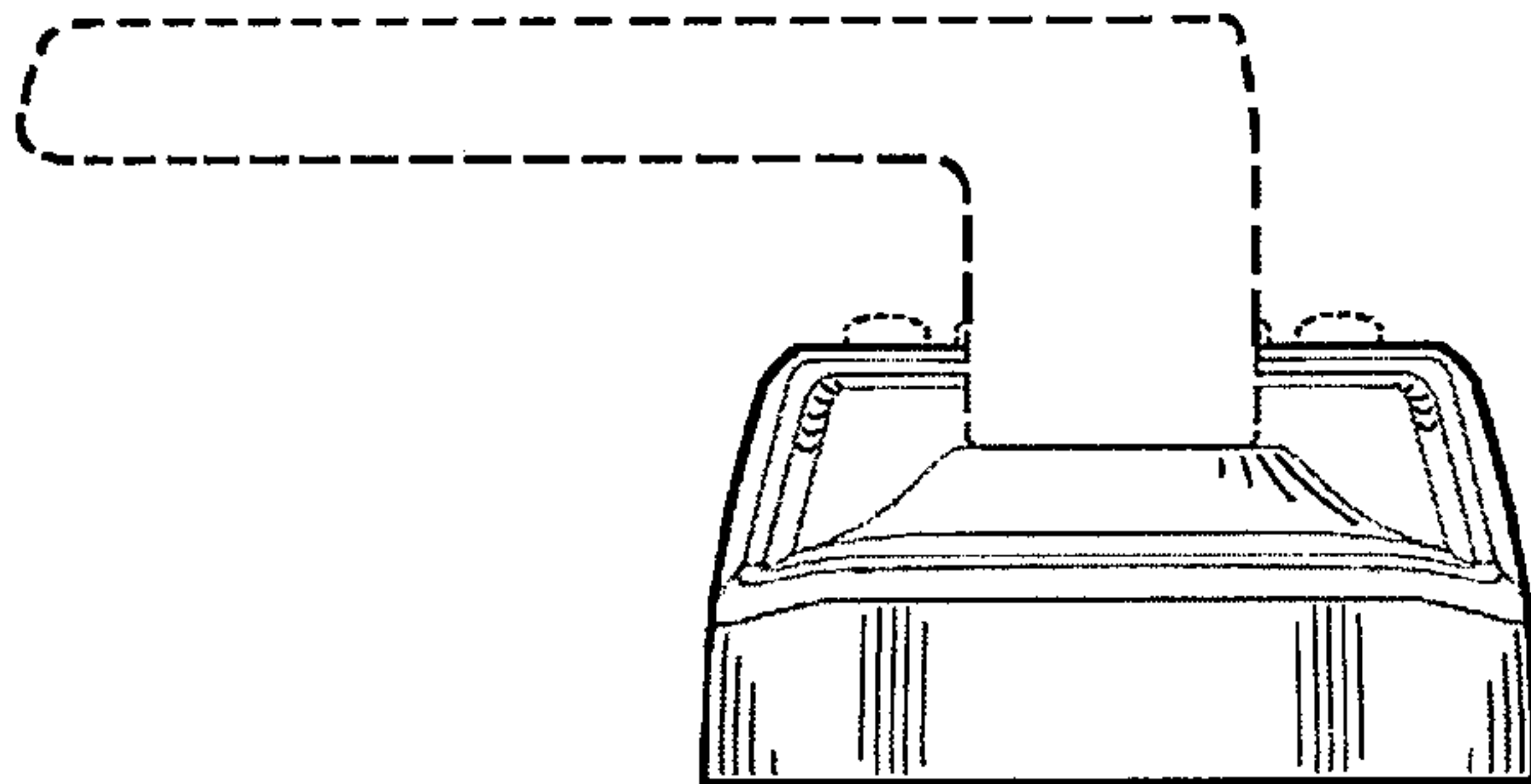
