FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view of FIG. 1.

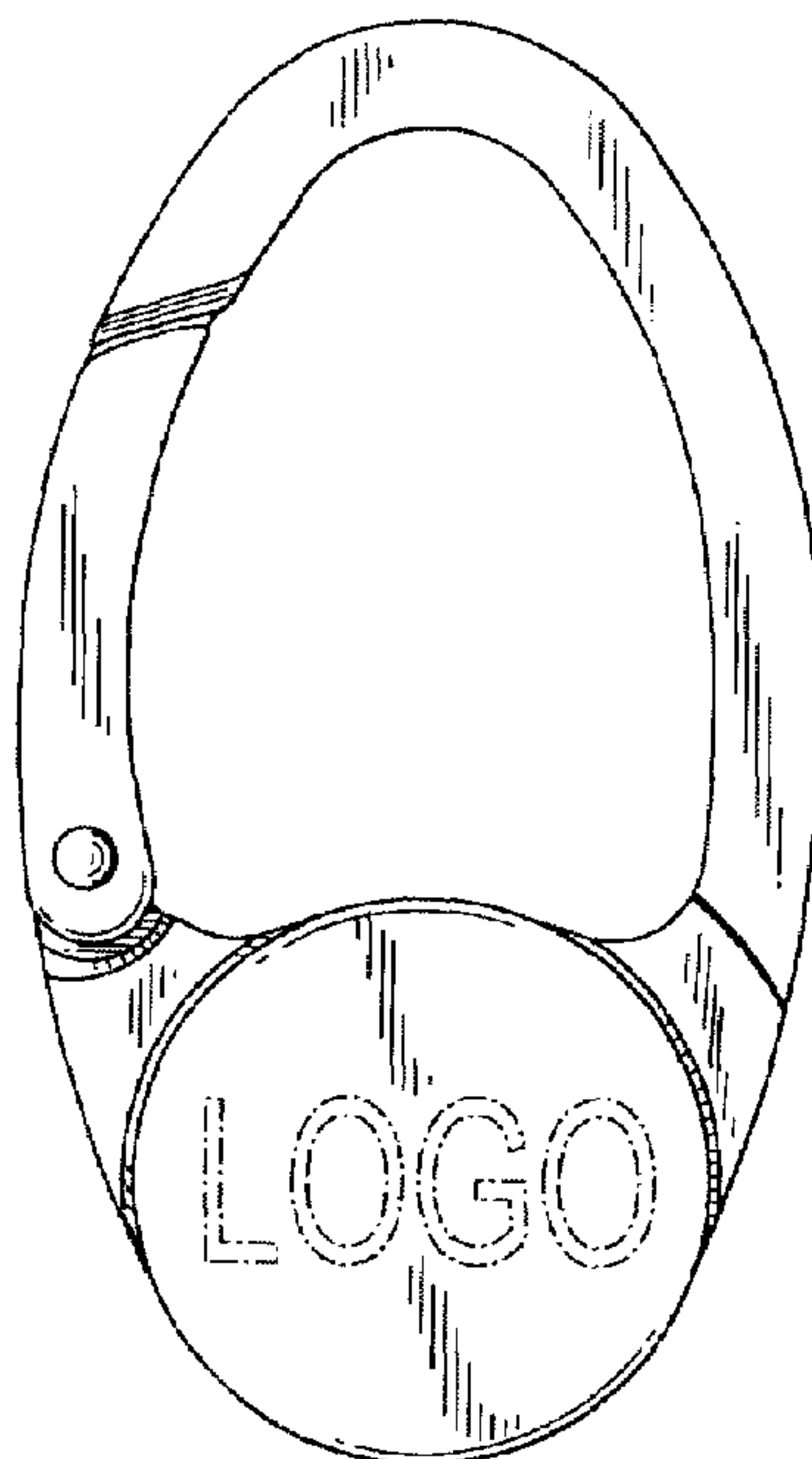
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view of FIG. 1.

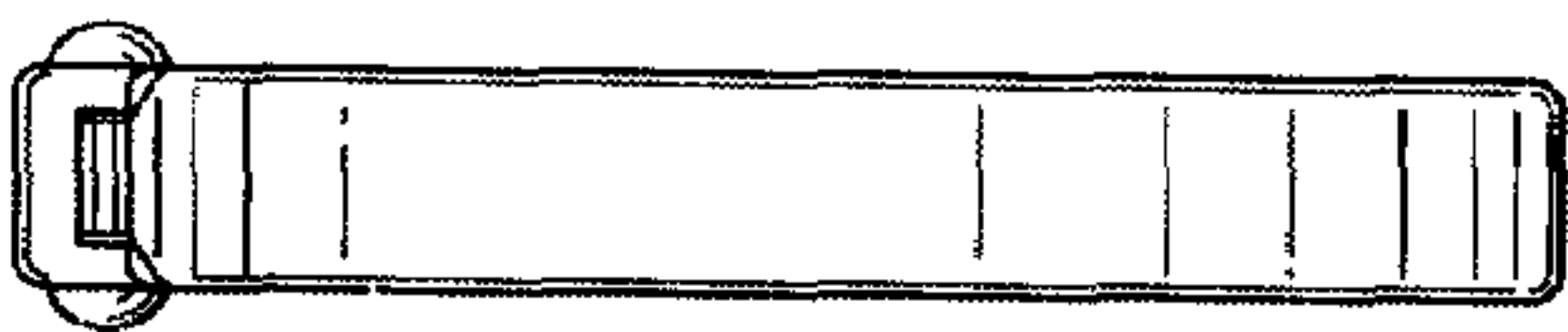

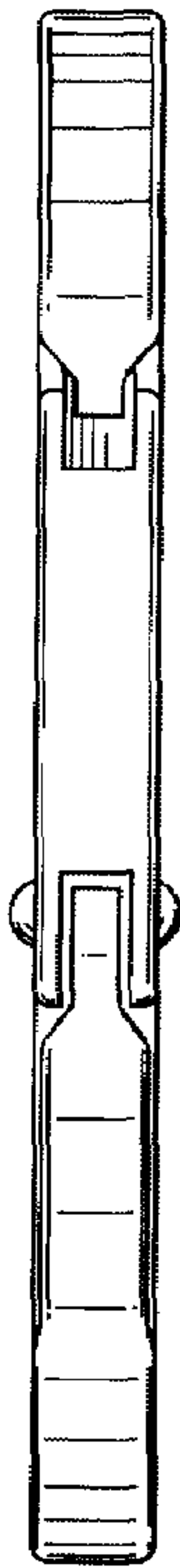

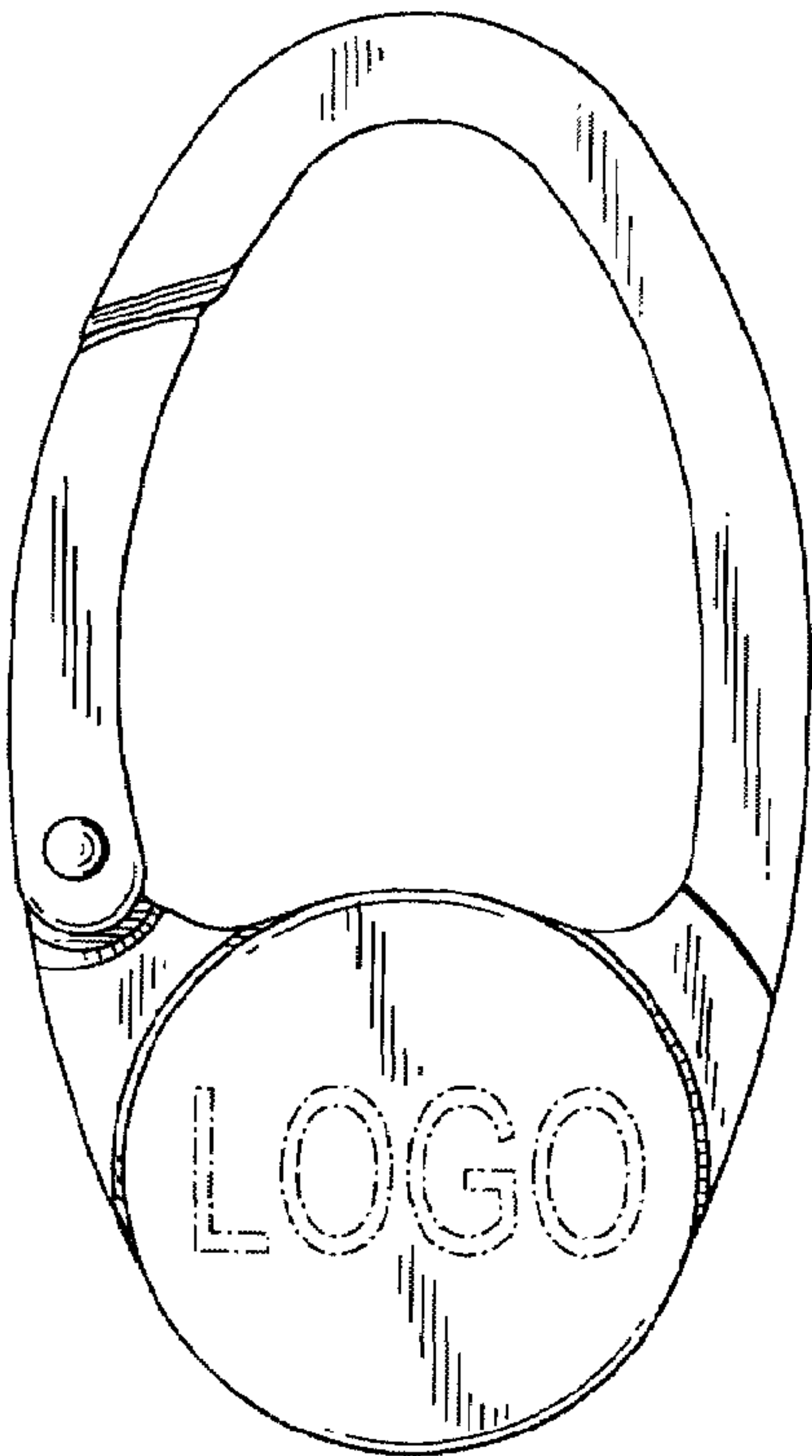

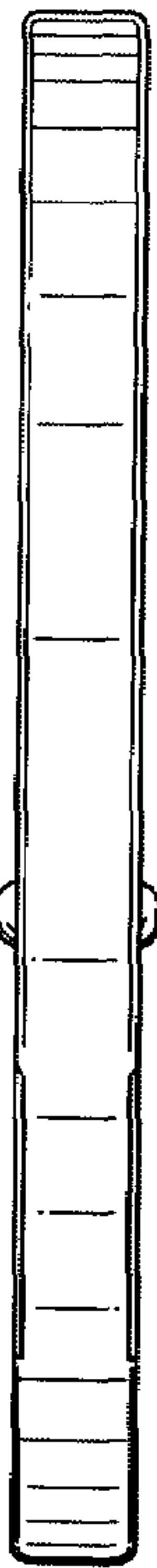

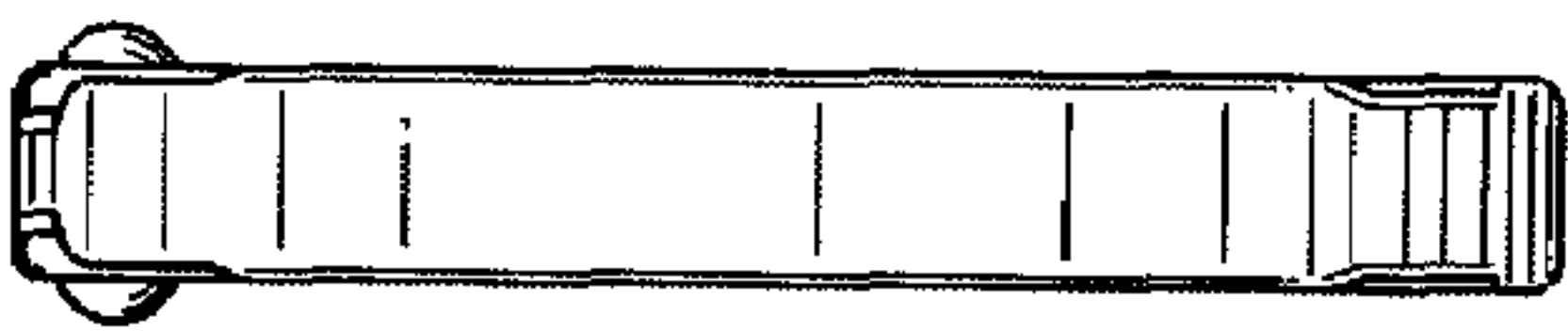

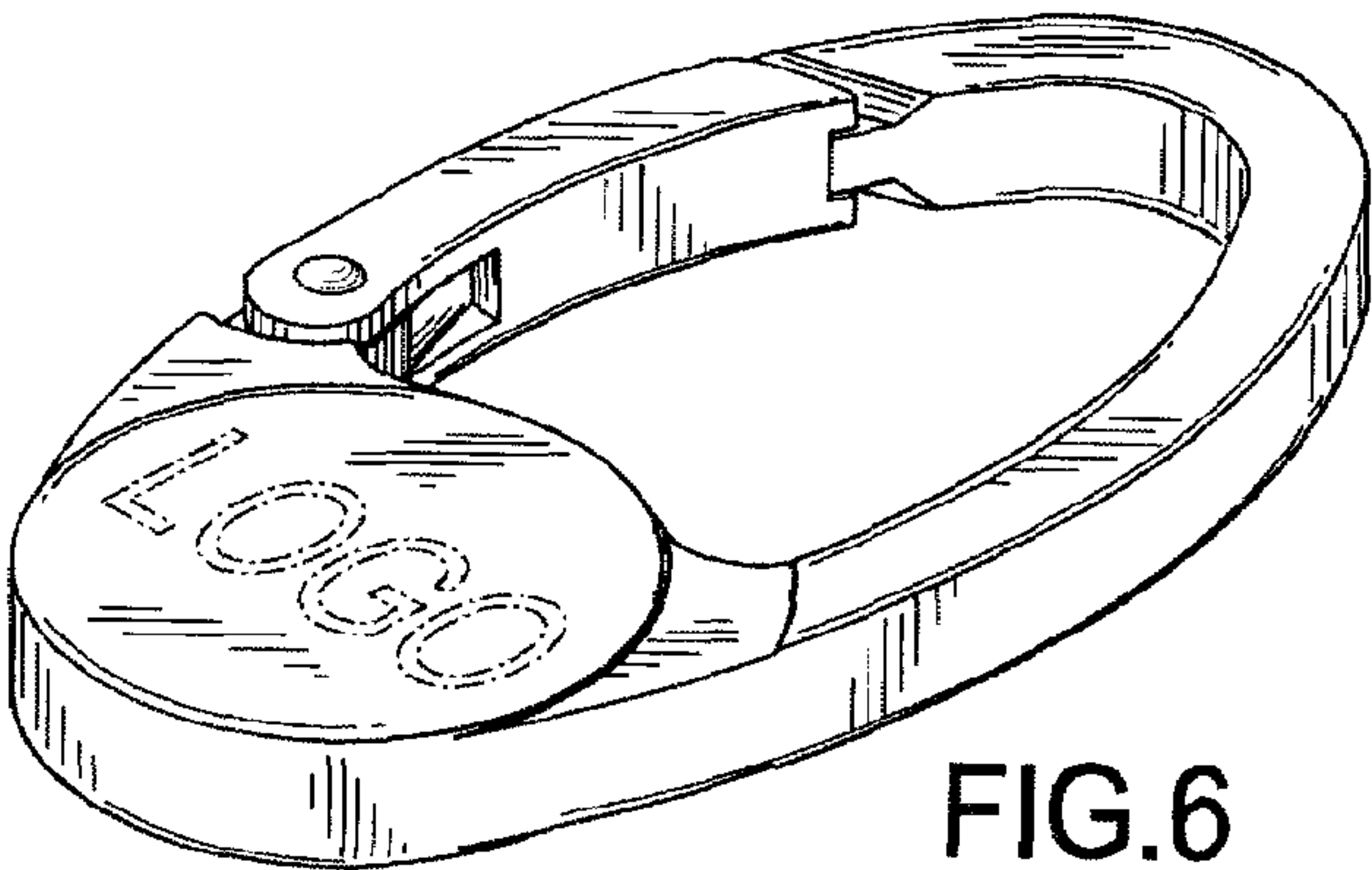
