(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an open back tank top, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an open back tank top showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of the open back tank top shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view of the open back tank top shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the open back tank top shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the open back tank top shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 7 is front perspective view of a second embodiment of an open back tank top in accordance with the present invention, the only difference from the first embodiment shown in FIG. 1 being the configuration of the neck line, it being understood that all other surfaces are the same as those of the first embodiment shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view of the open back tank top shown in FIG. 7.

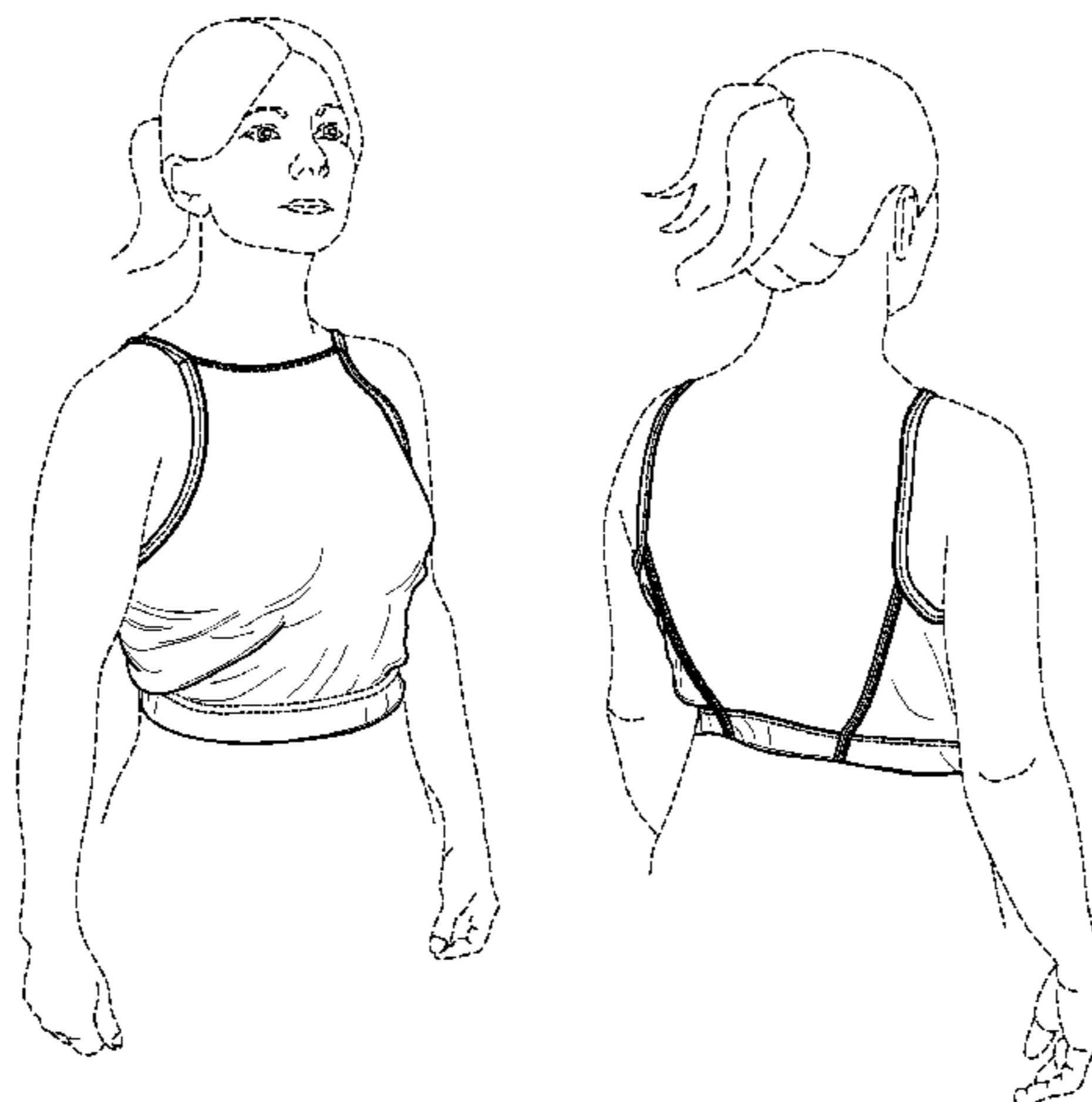
FIG. 9 is front perspective view of a third embodiment of an open back tank top in accordance with the present invention, the only difference from the first embodiment shown in FIG. 1 being the configuration of the neck line, it being understood that all other surfaces are the same as those of the first embodiment shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 10 is a rear perspective view of the open back tank top shown in FIG. 9.

The matter shown in broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 2 is present solely to show environment, namely a woman's body, and does not form part of the design.

The broken lines, in FIGS. 1-10, on the surface of the tank top represent stitching.

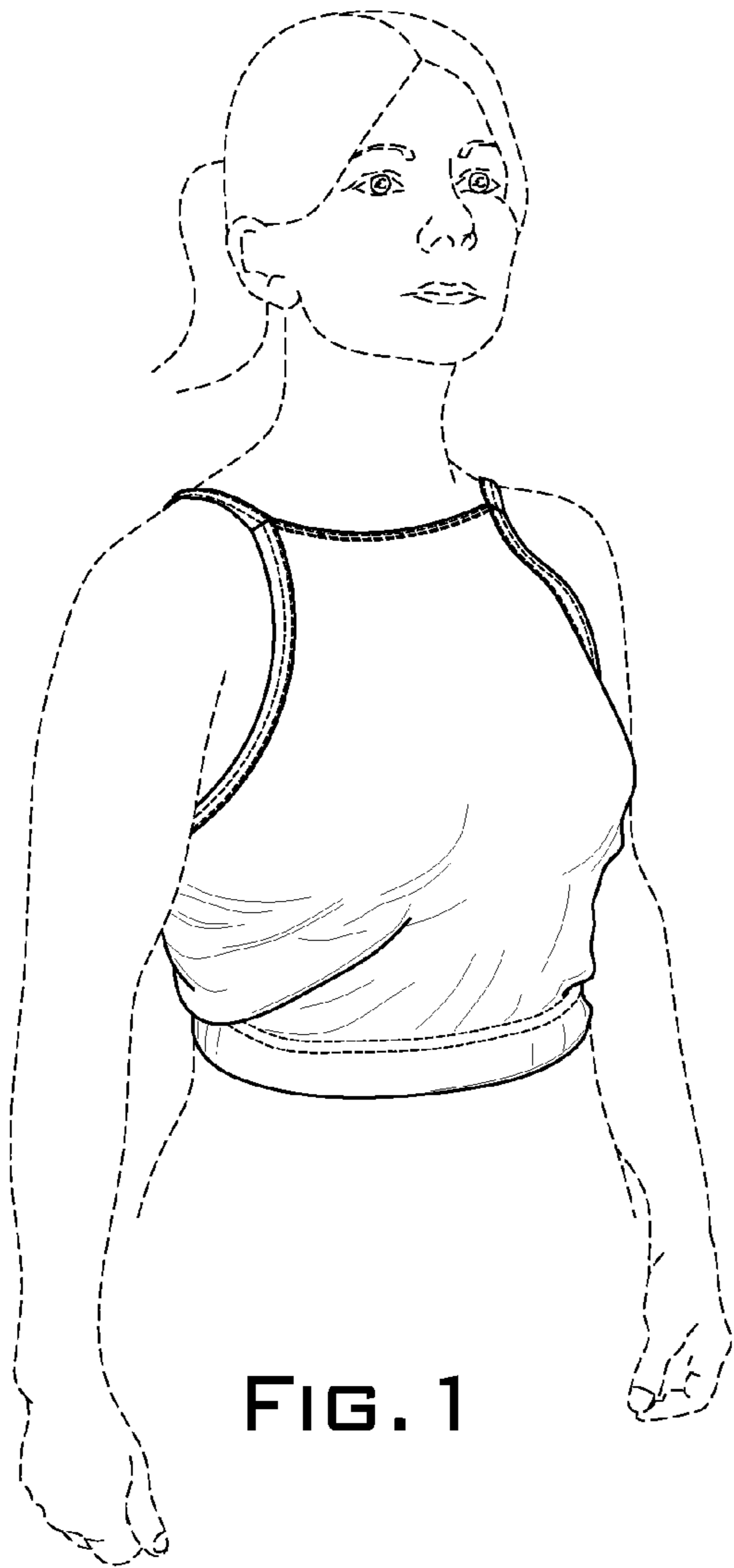

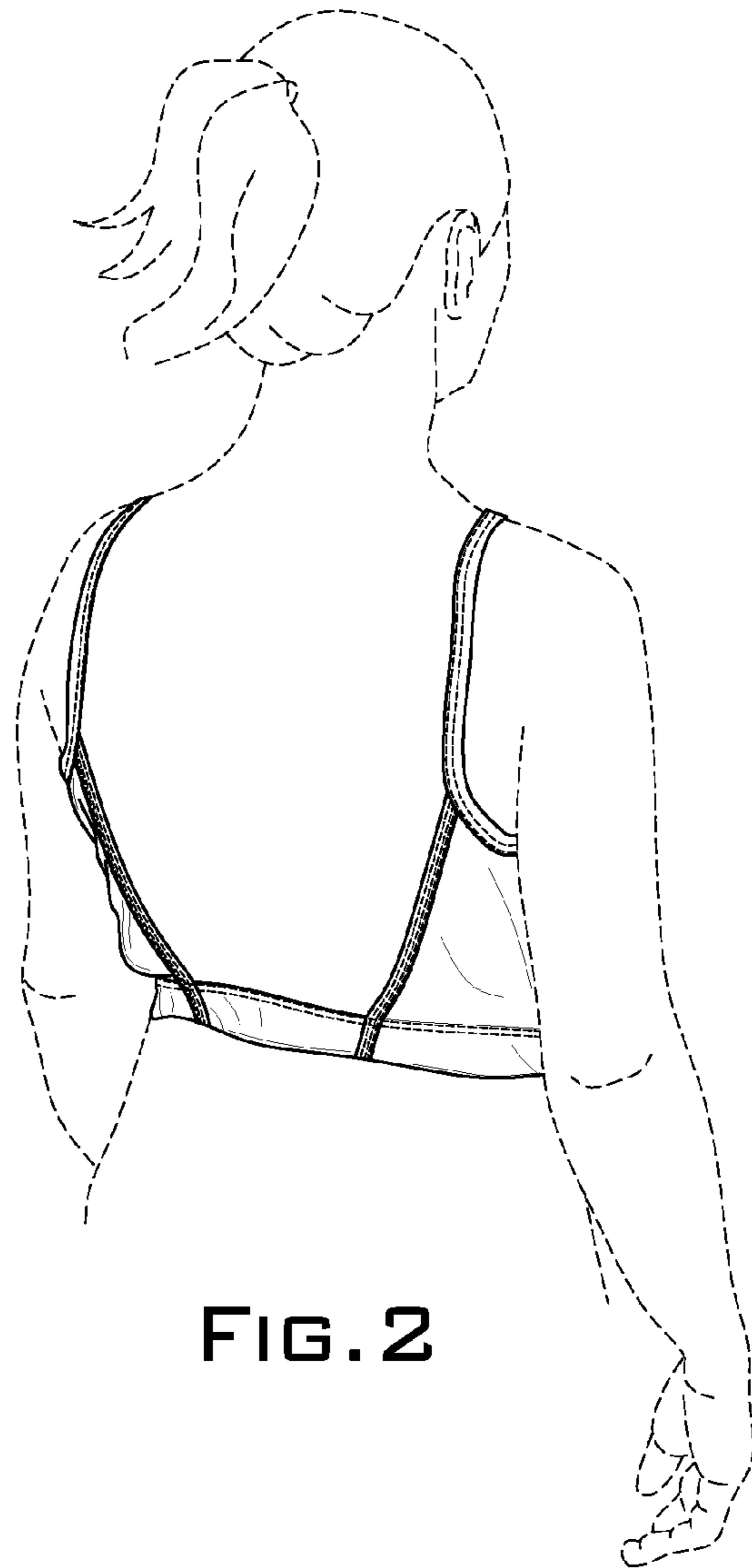

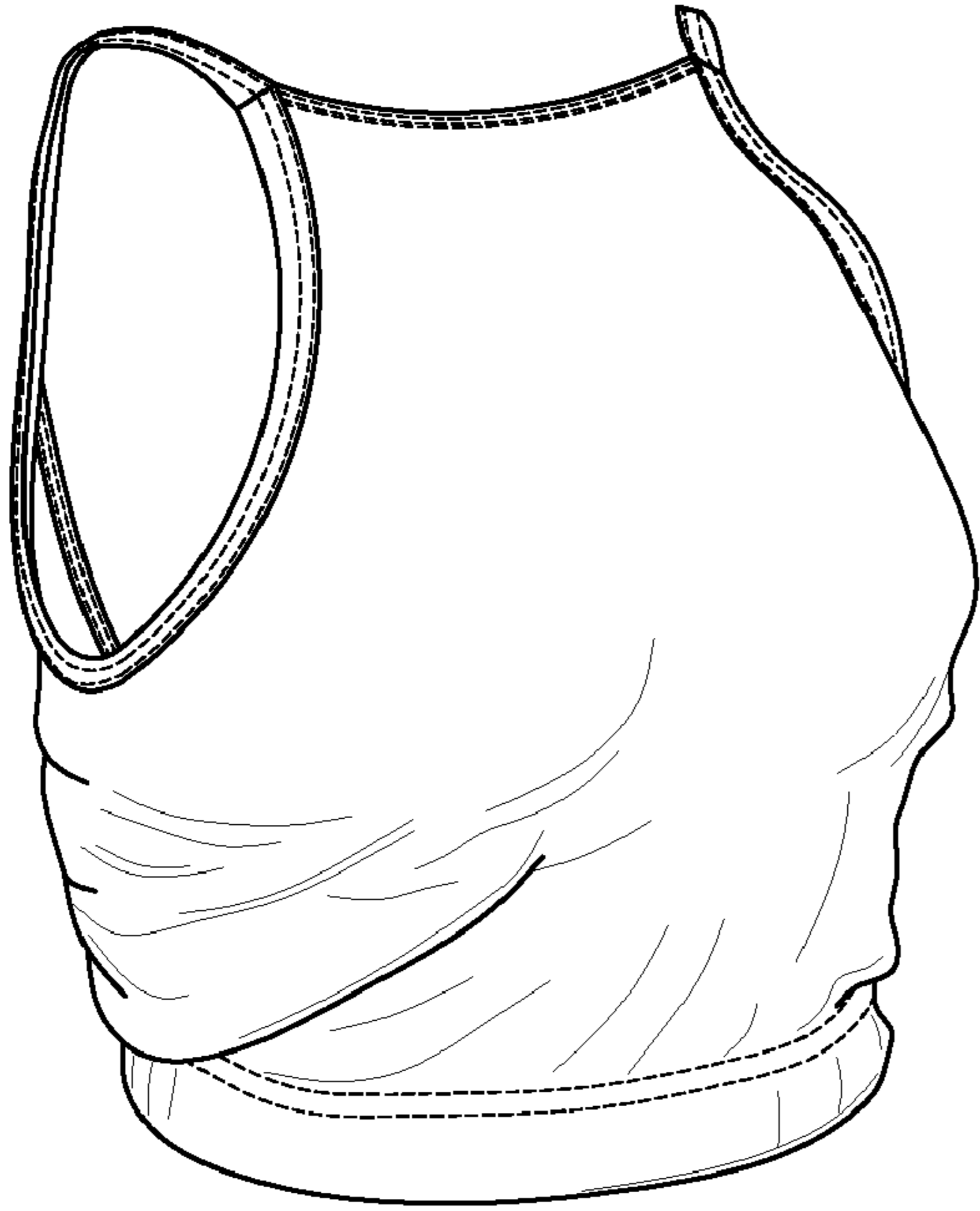

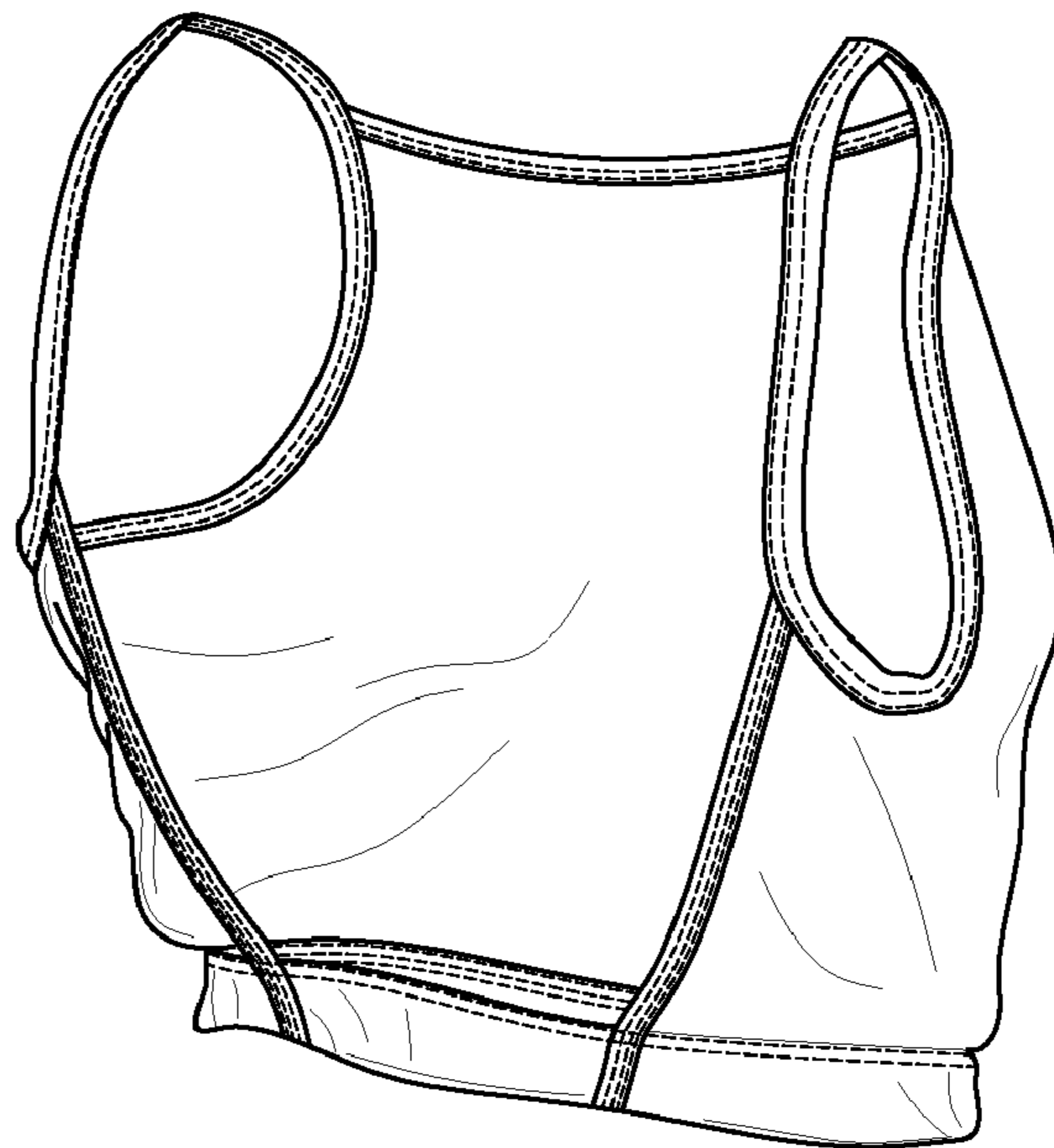

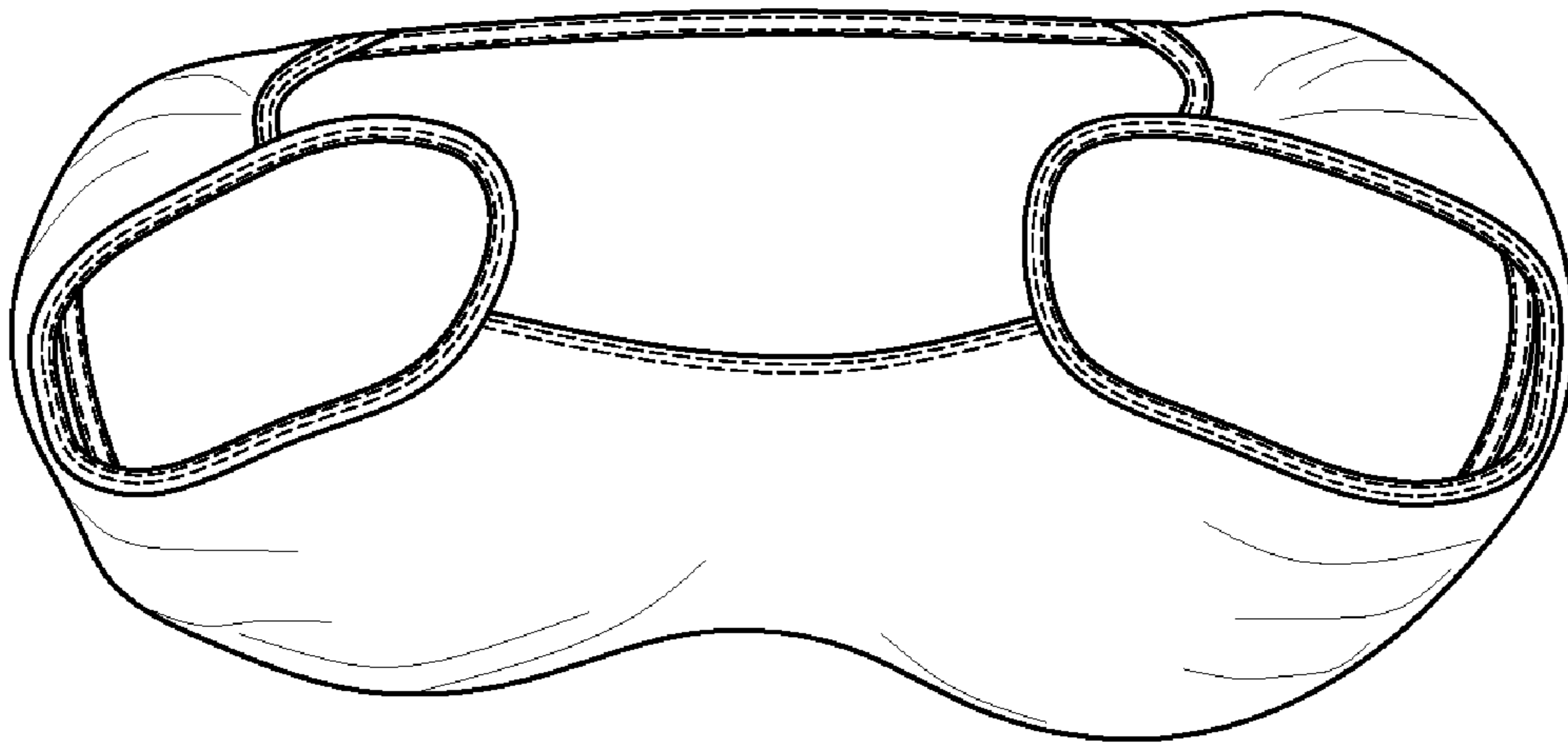

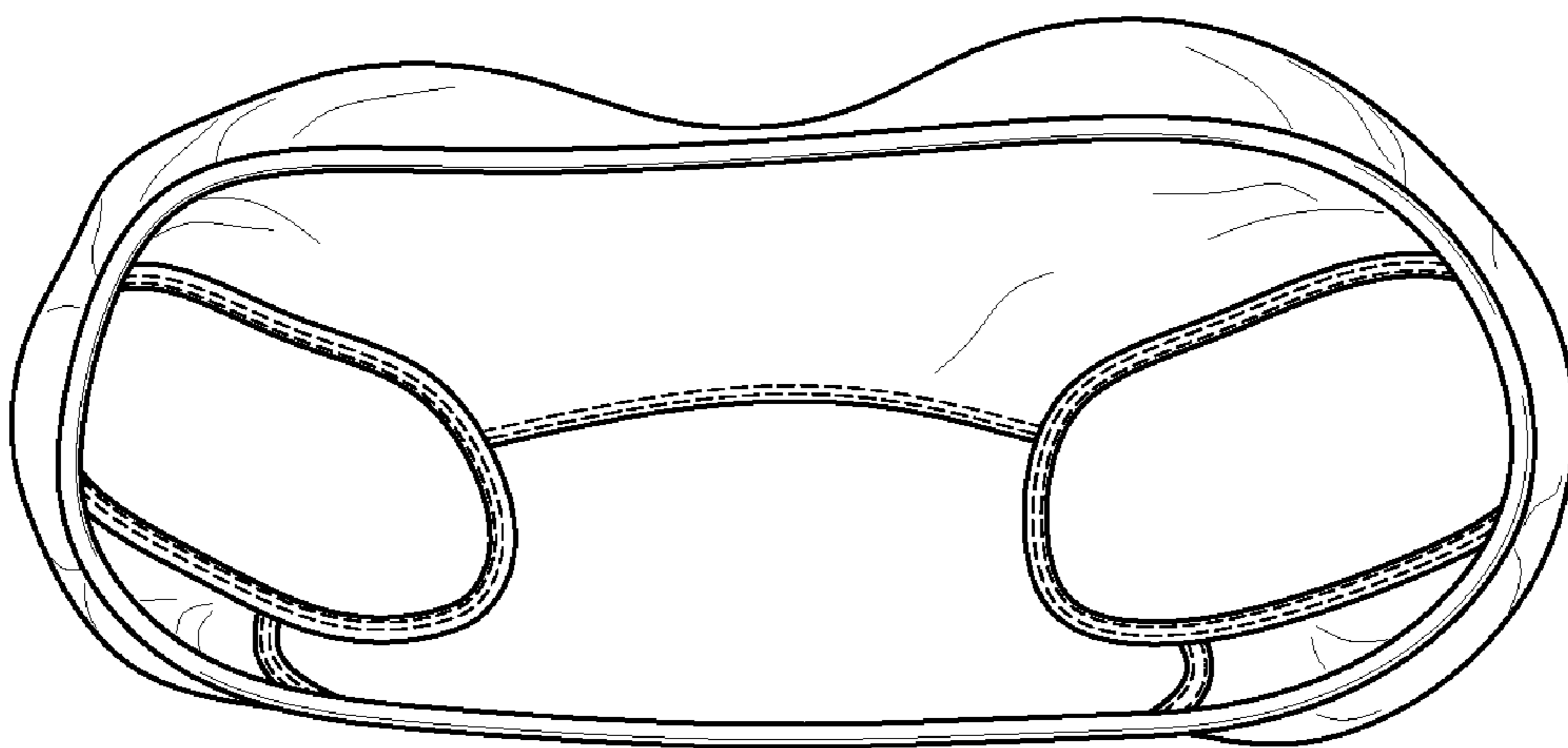

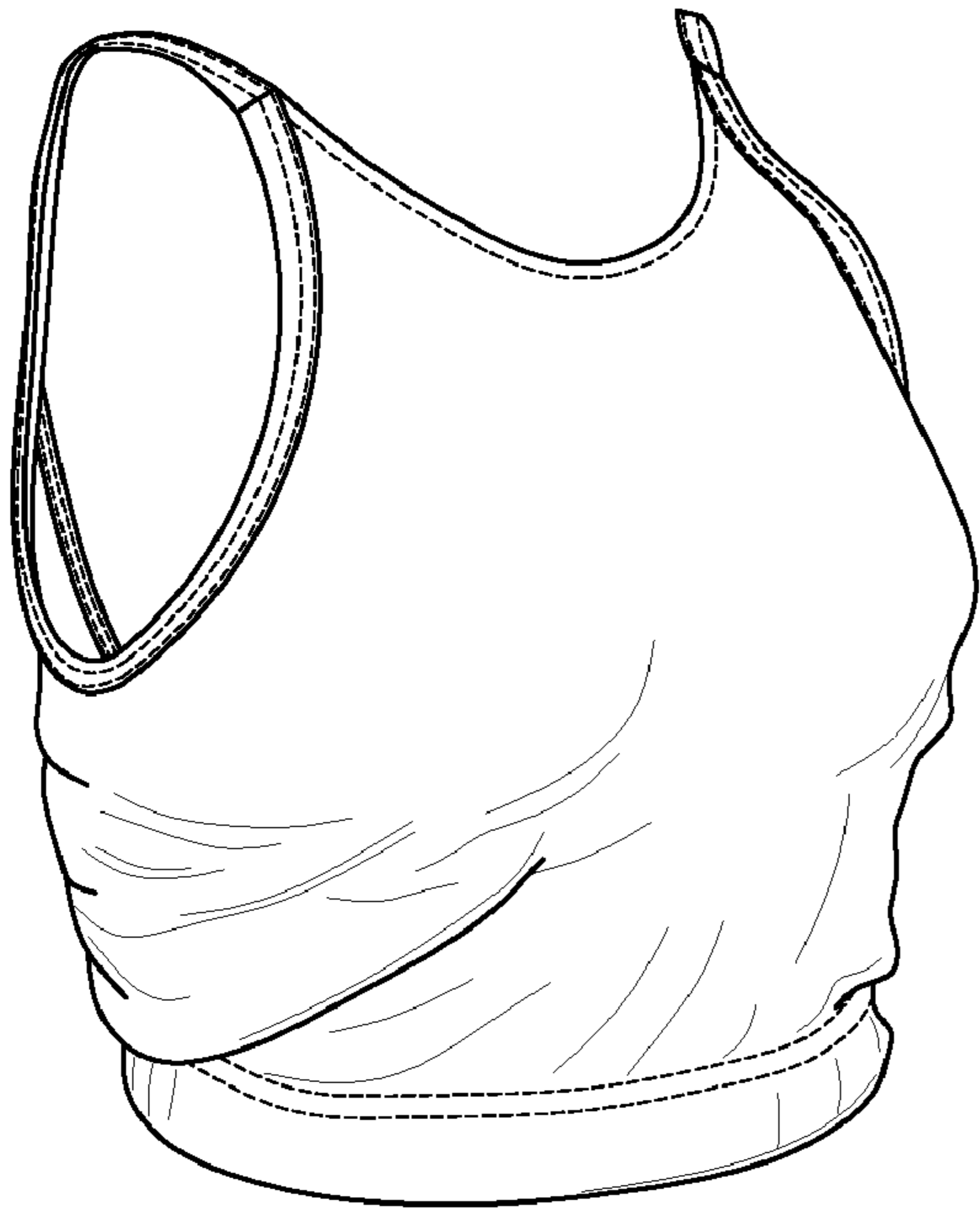

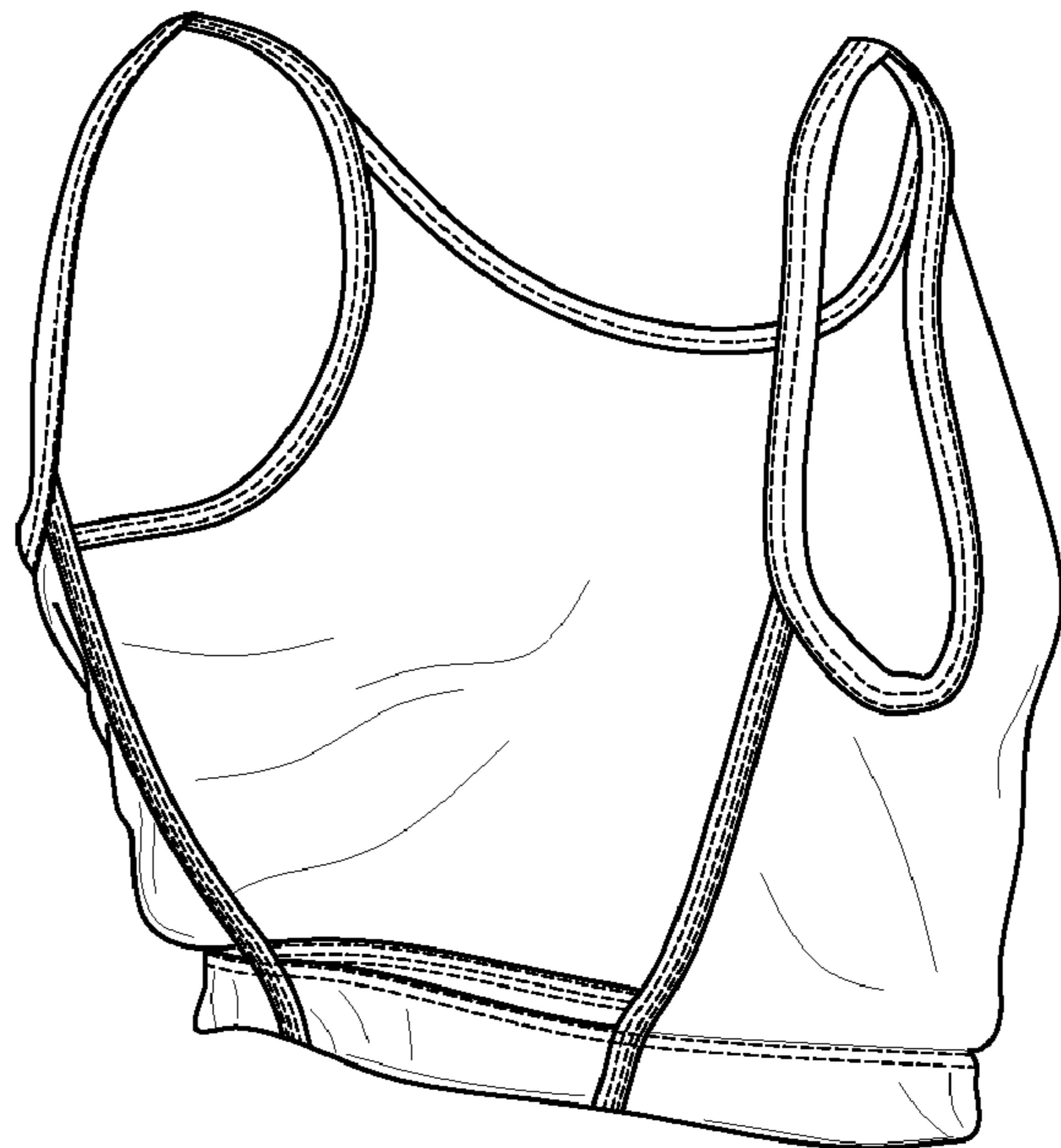

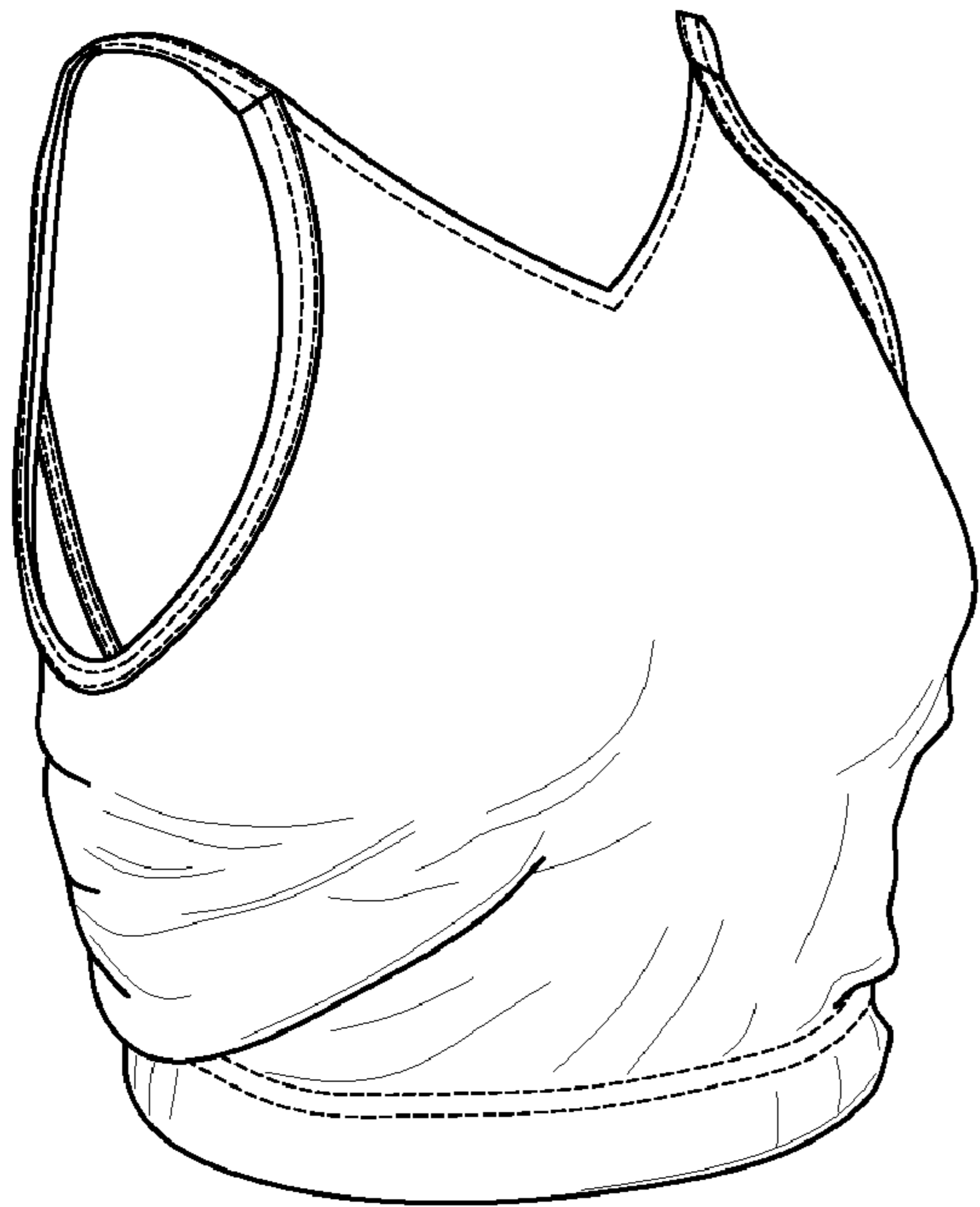

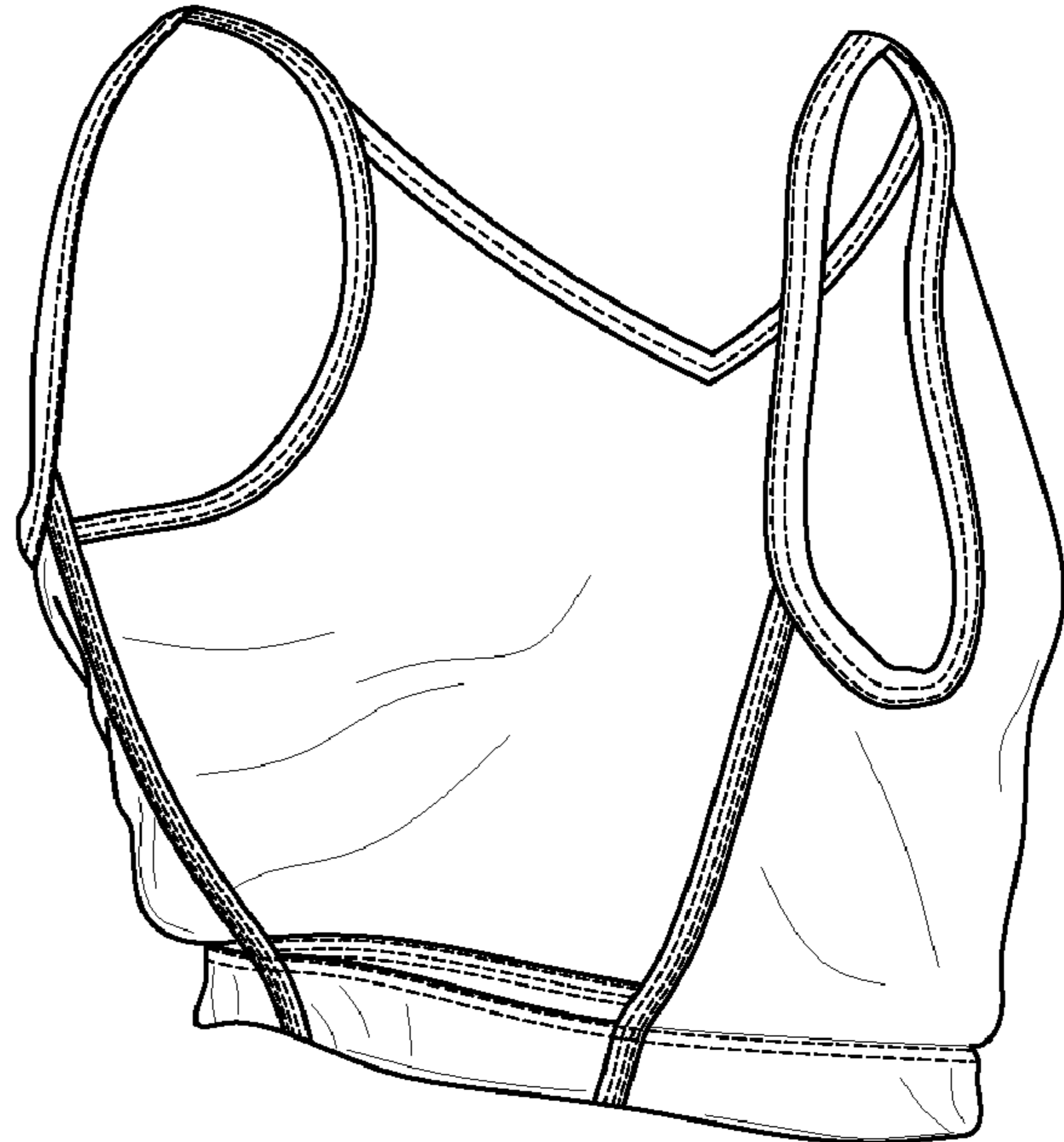
