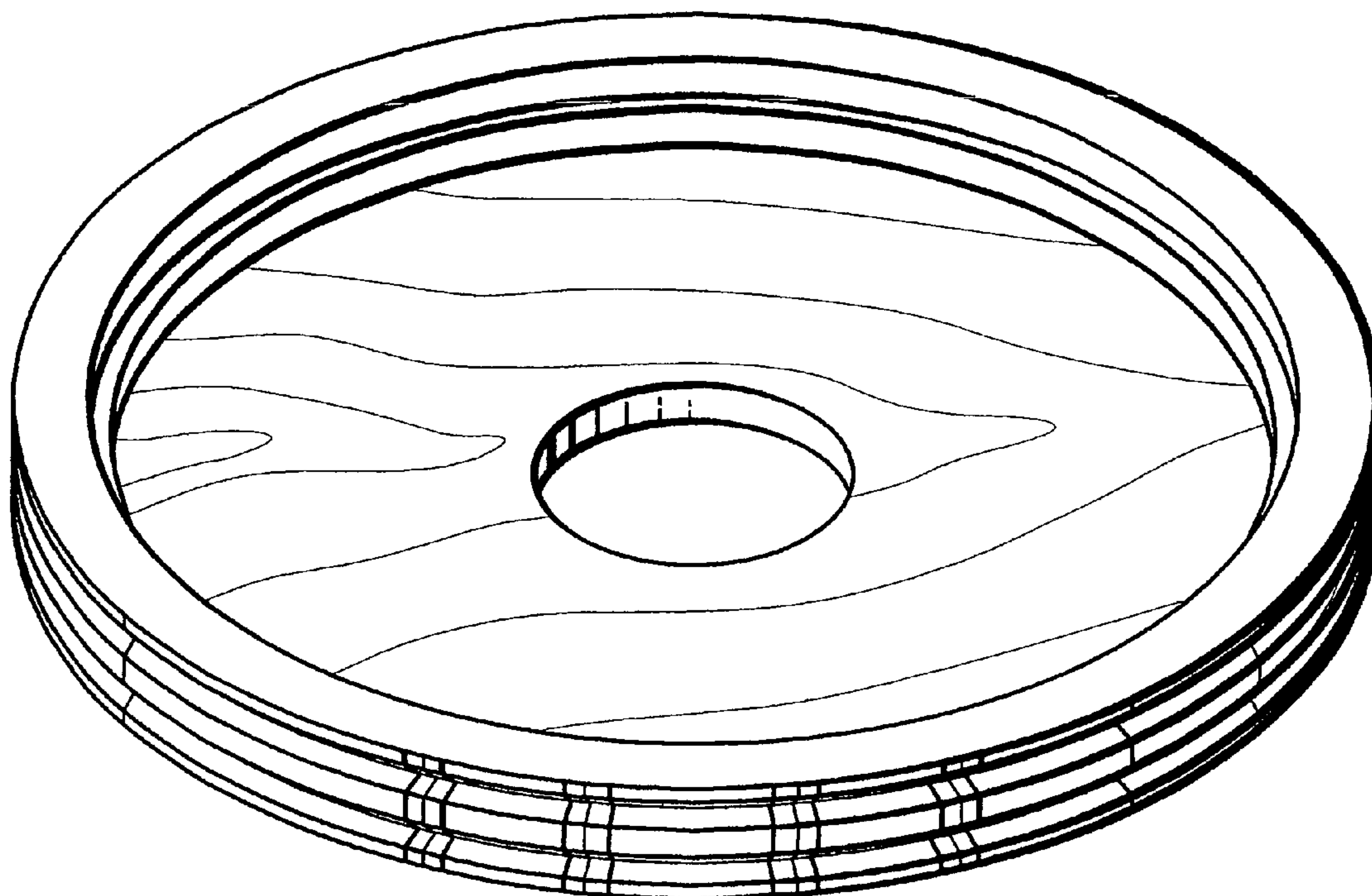
DESCRIPTION

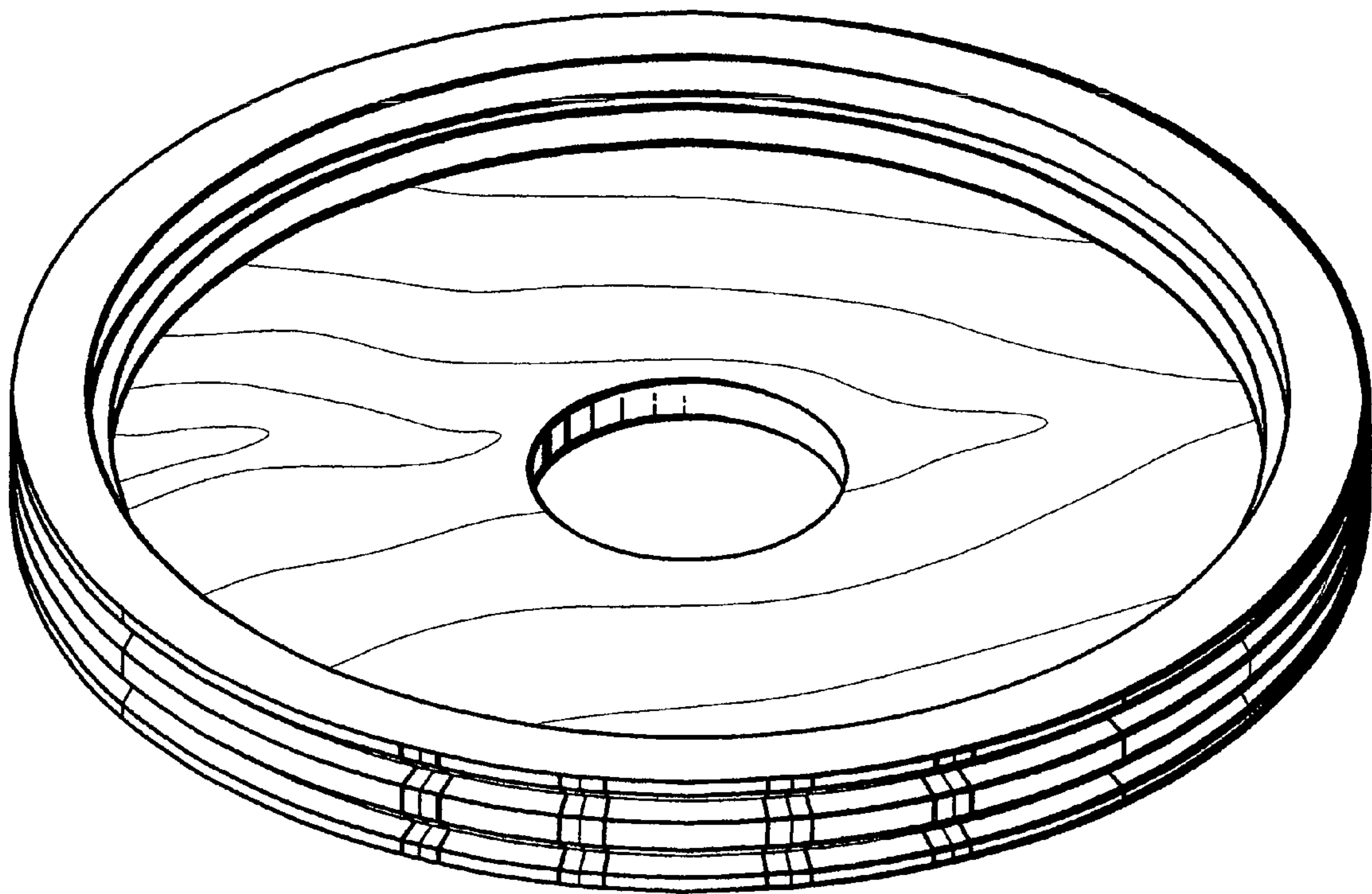

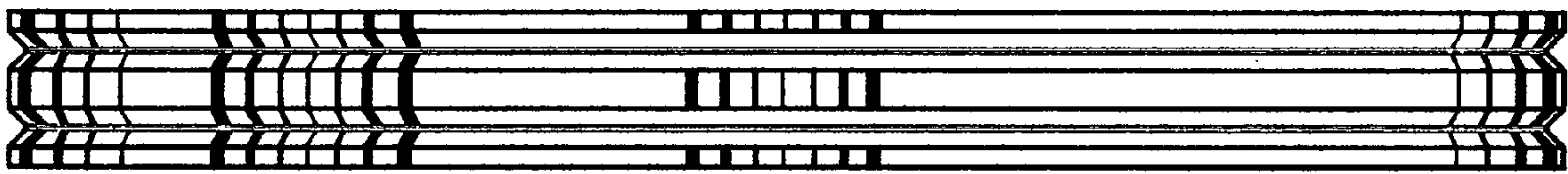

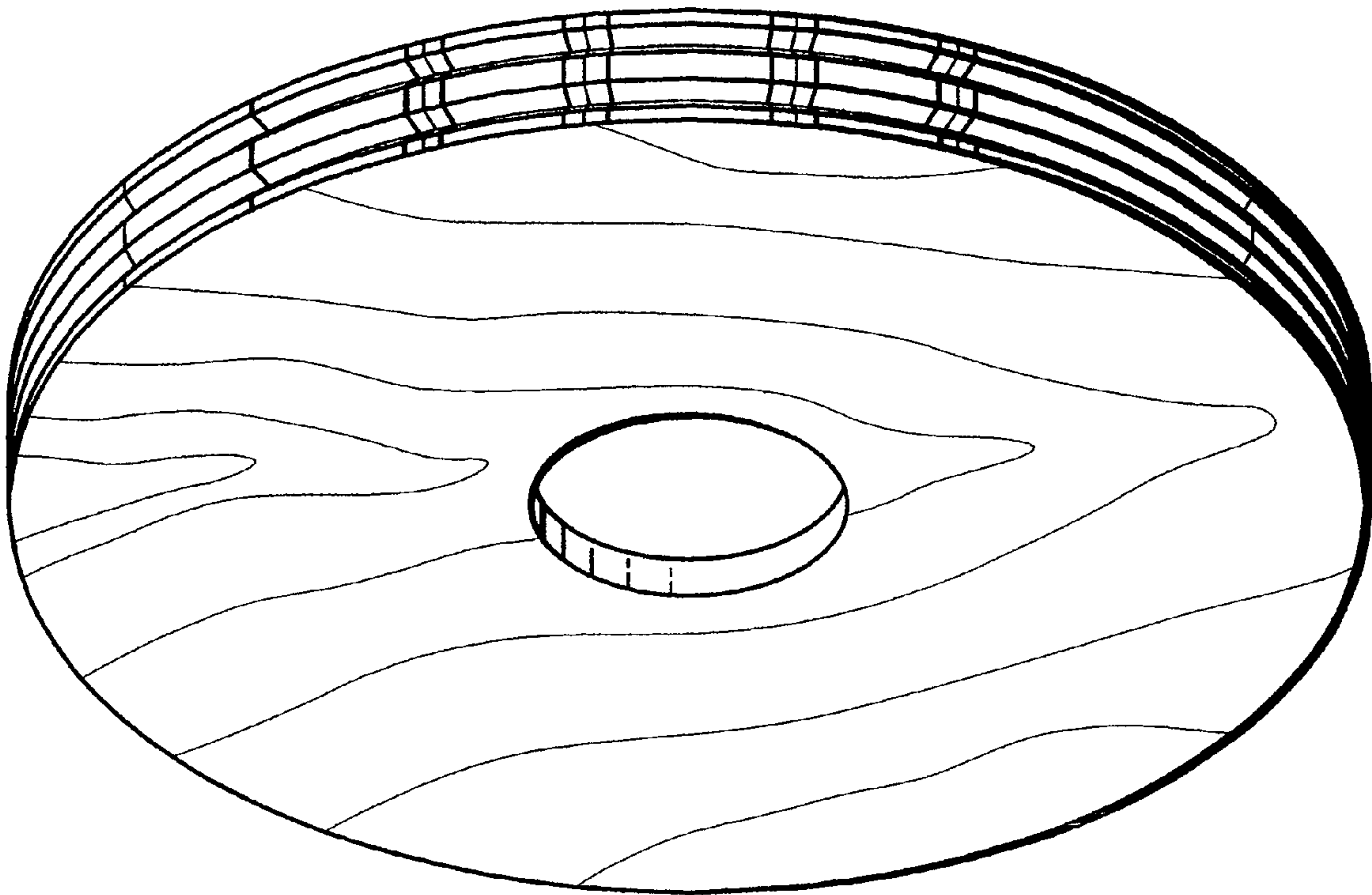
