DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top/front perspective view of a portion of a pipe
fitting according to an embodiment of the present design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom/front perspective view of the portion of
a pipe fitting shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top/rear perspective view of the portion of a pipe
fitting shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a bottom/rear perspective view of the portion of a
pipe fitting shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of the portion of a pipe fitting
shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the portion of a pipe fitting
shown in FIG. 1;

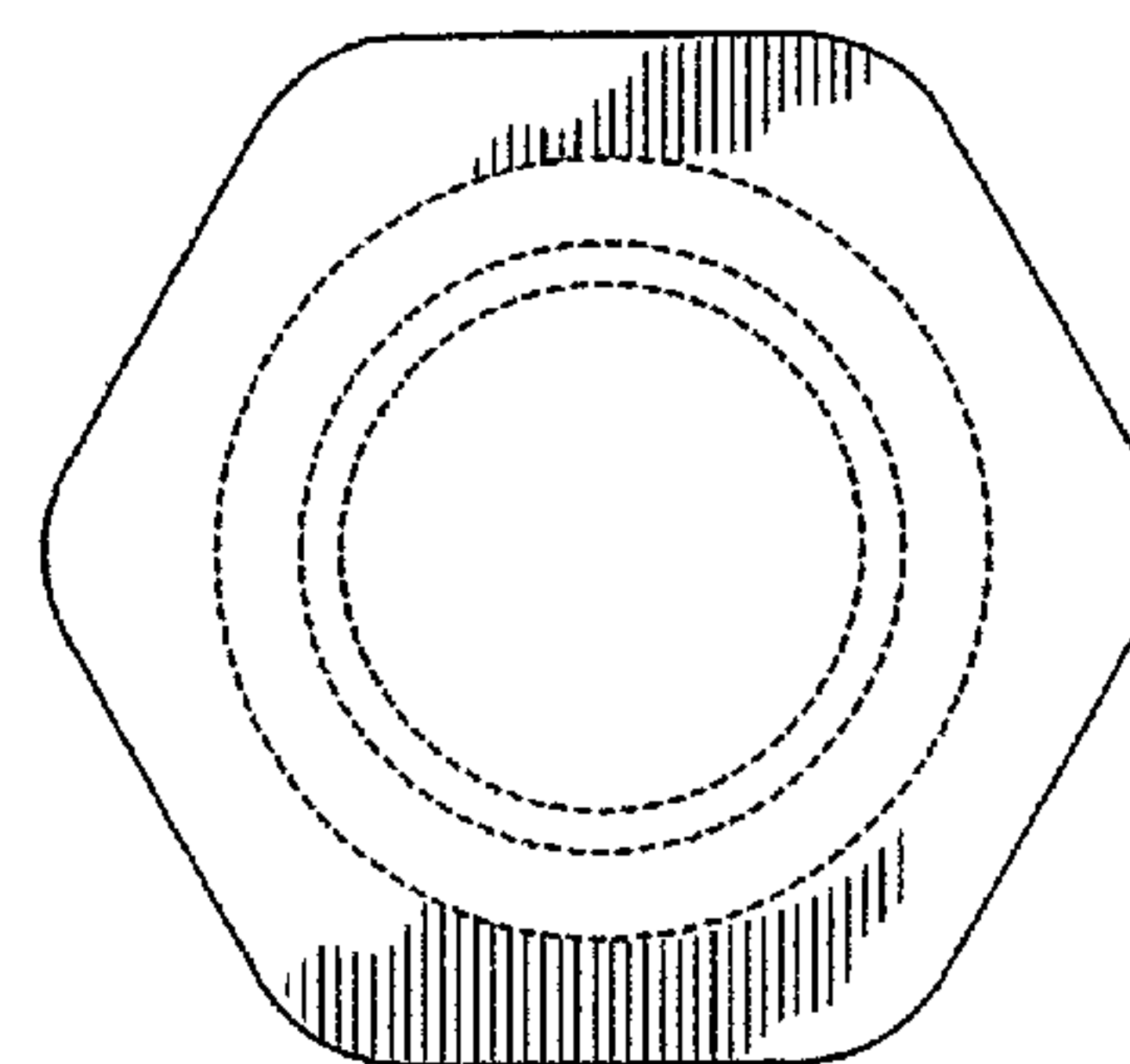
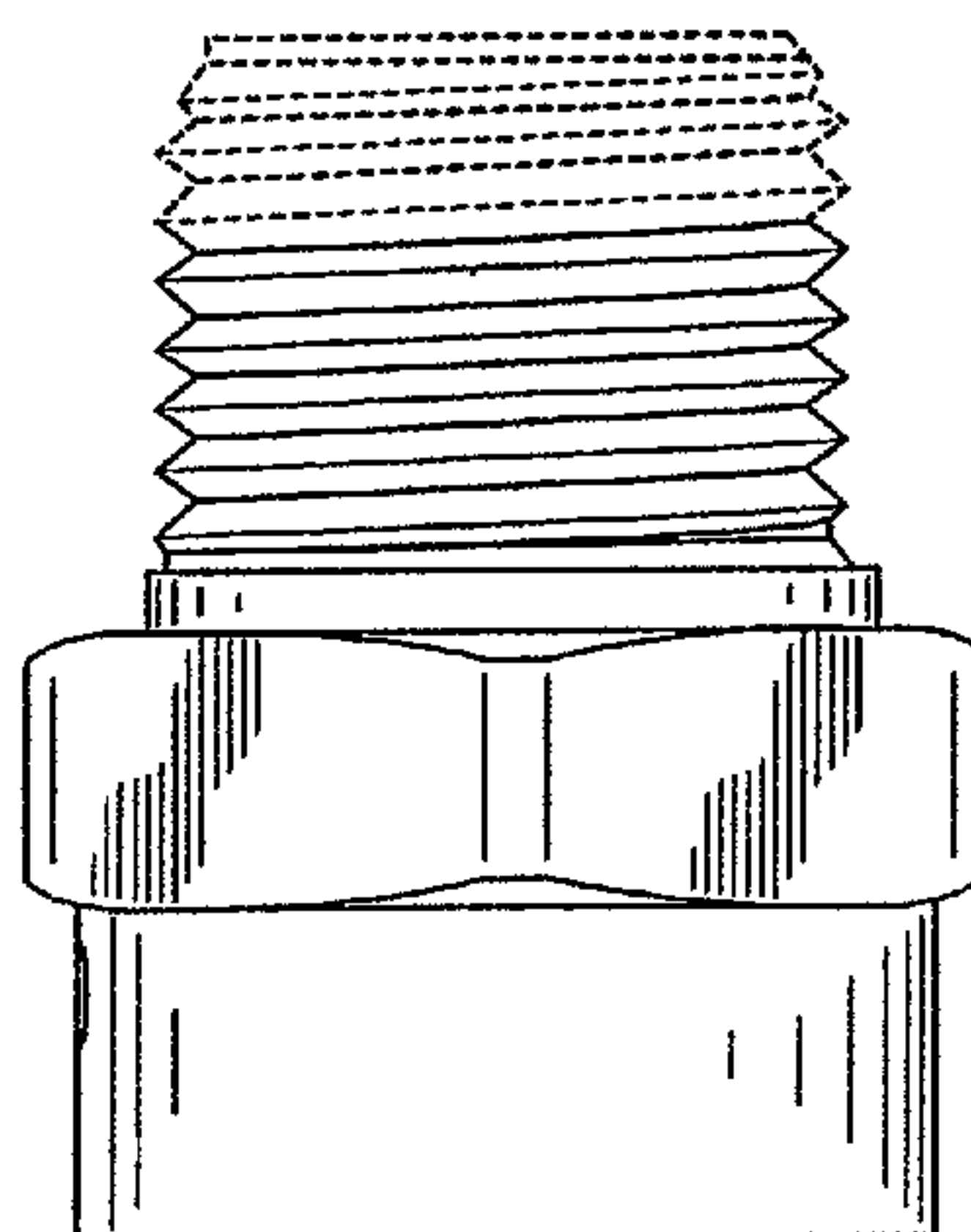
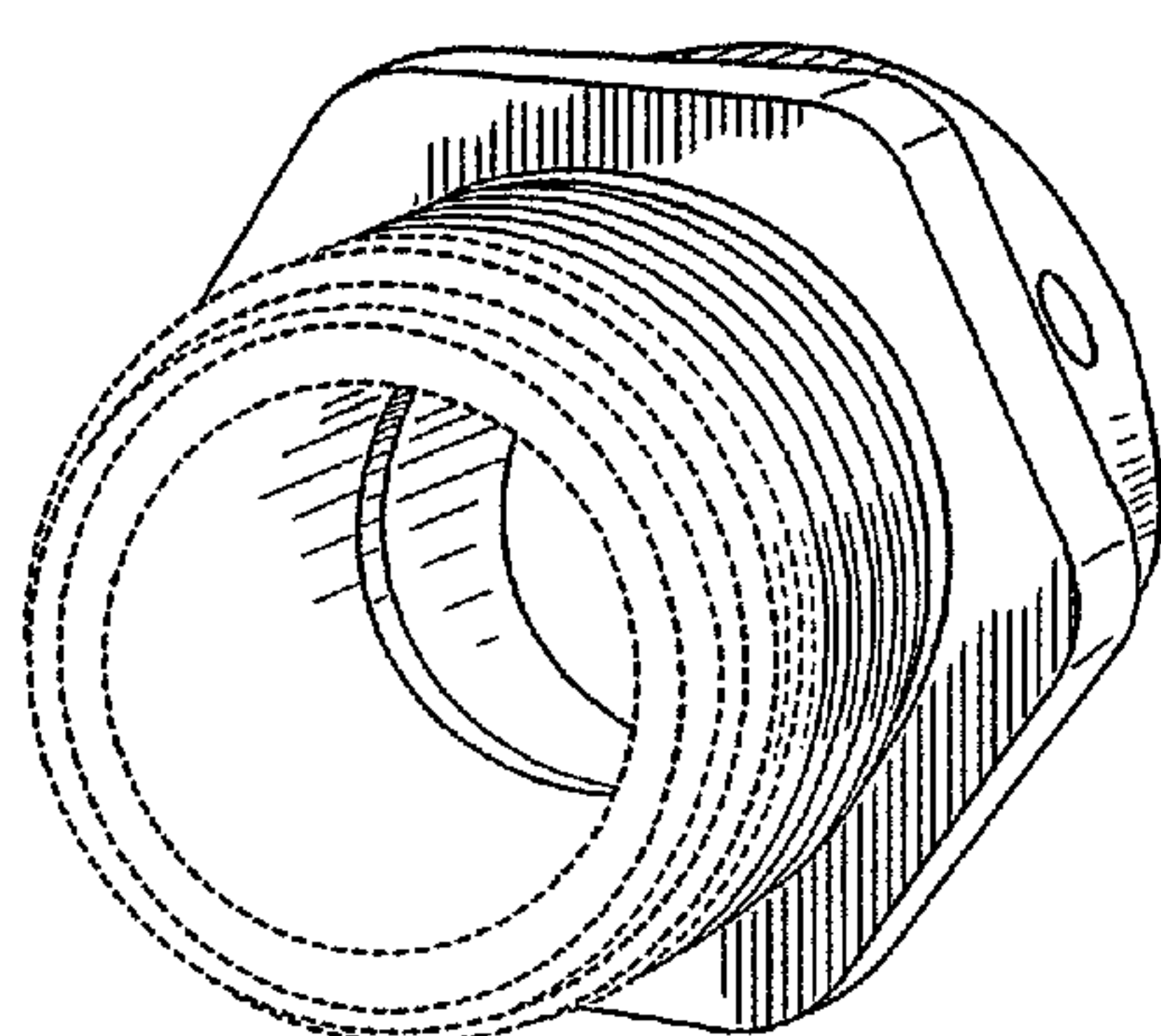
FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view of the portion of a pipe

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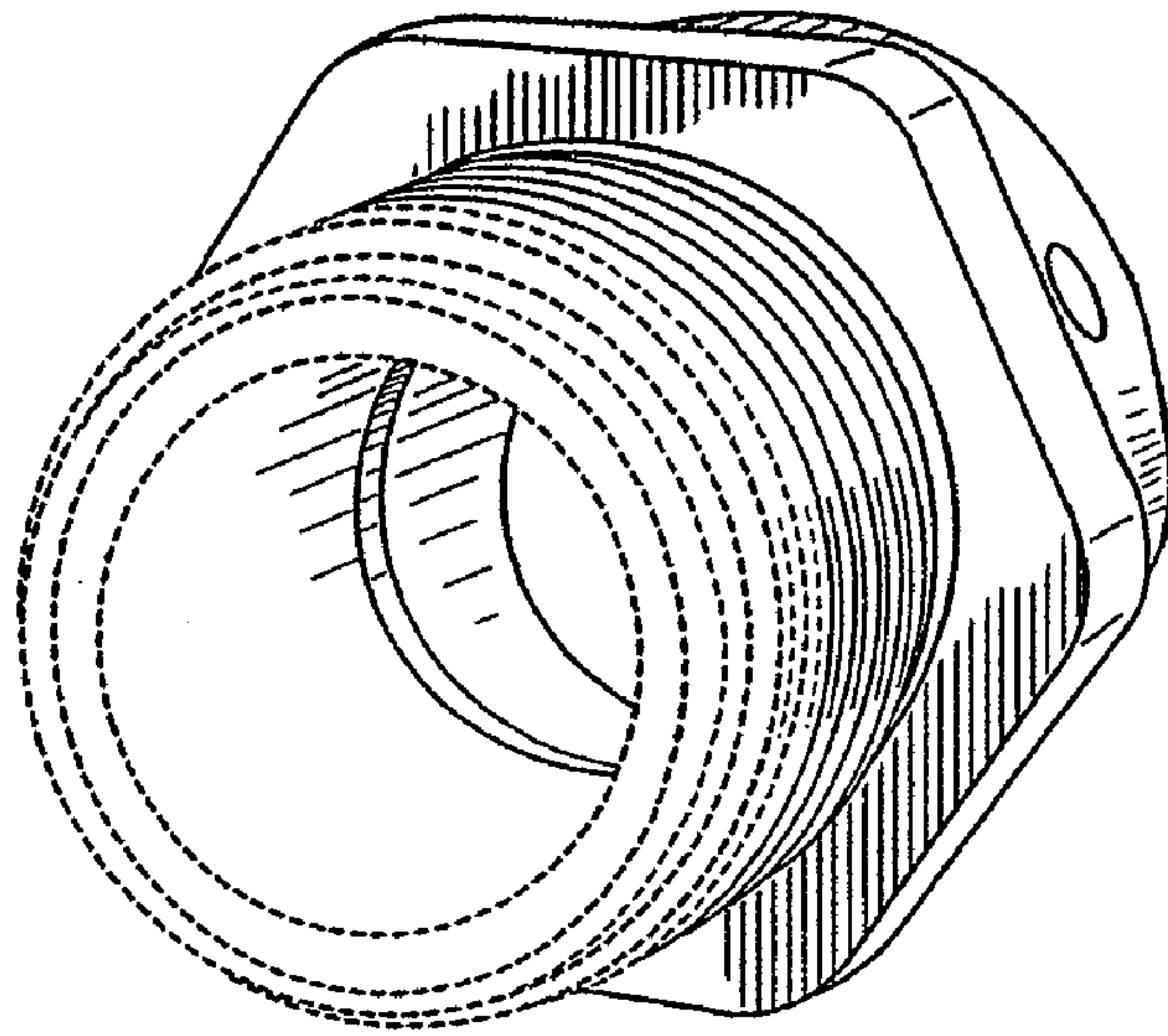

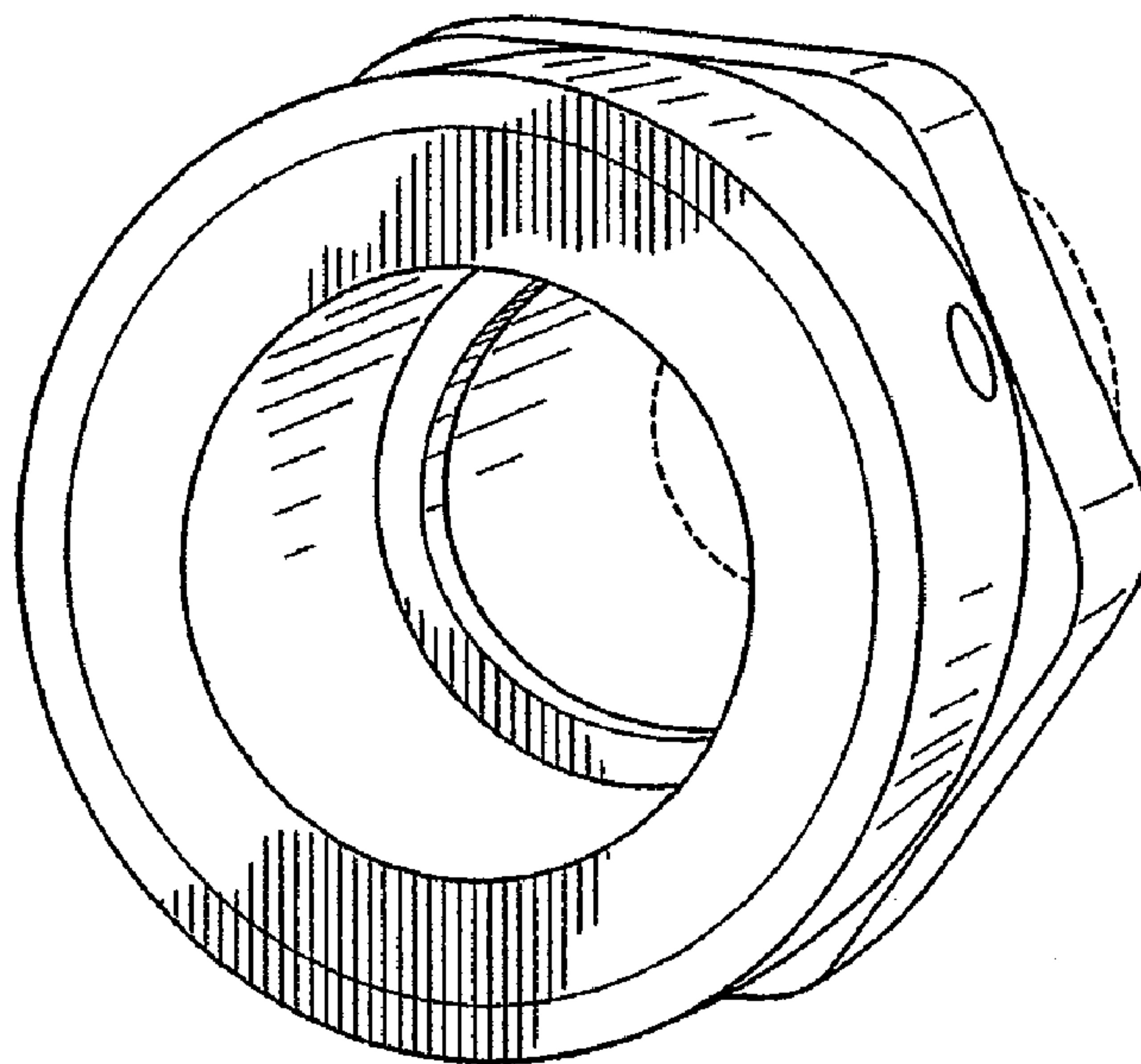

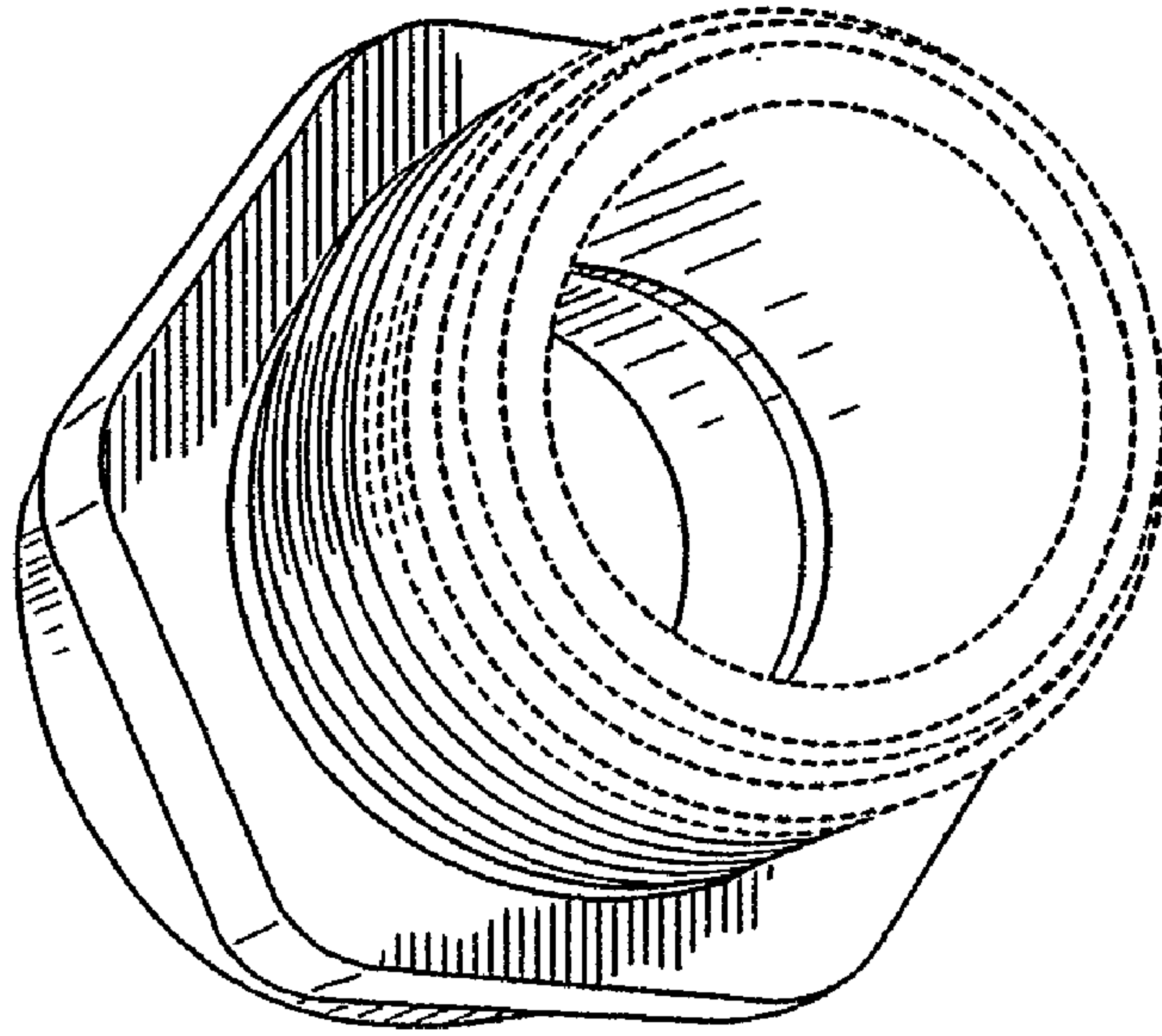

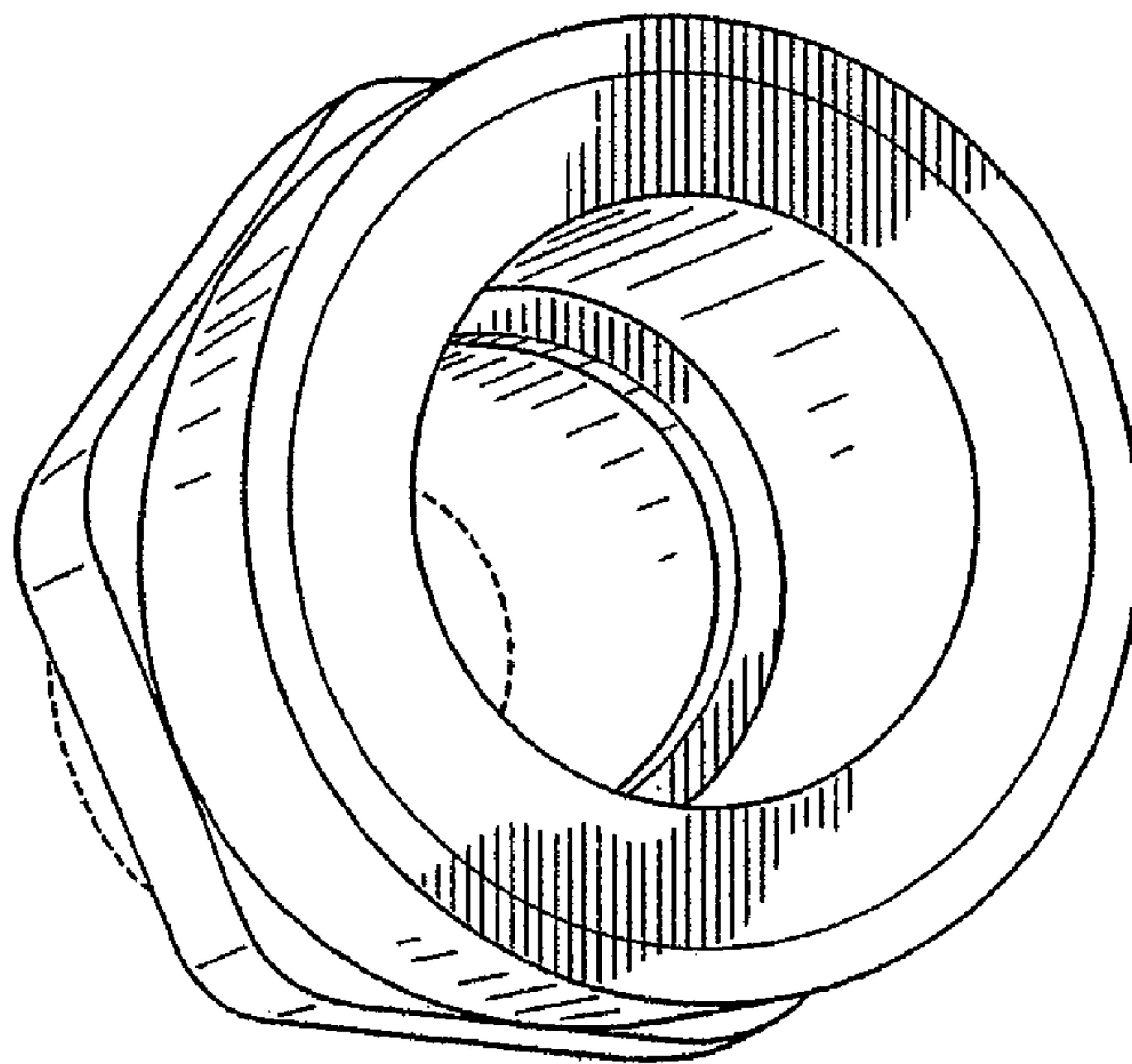

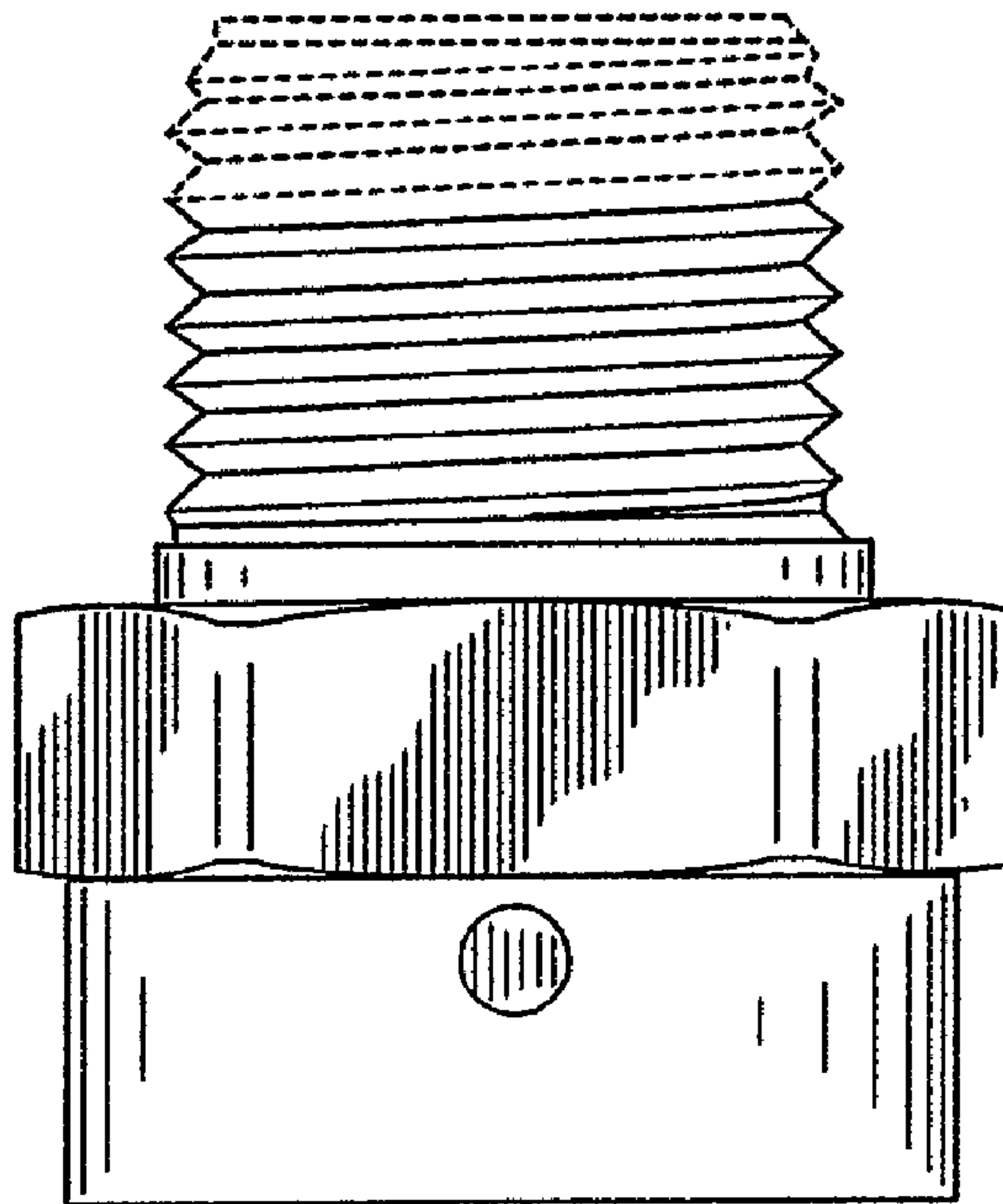

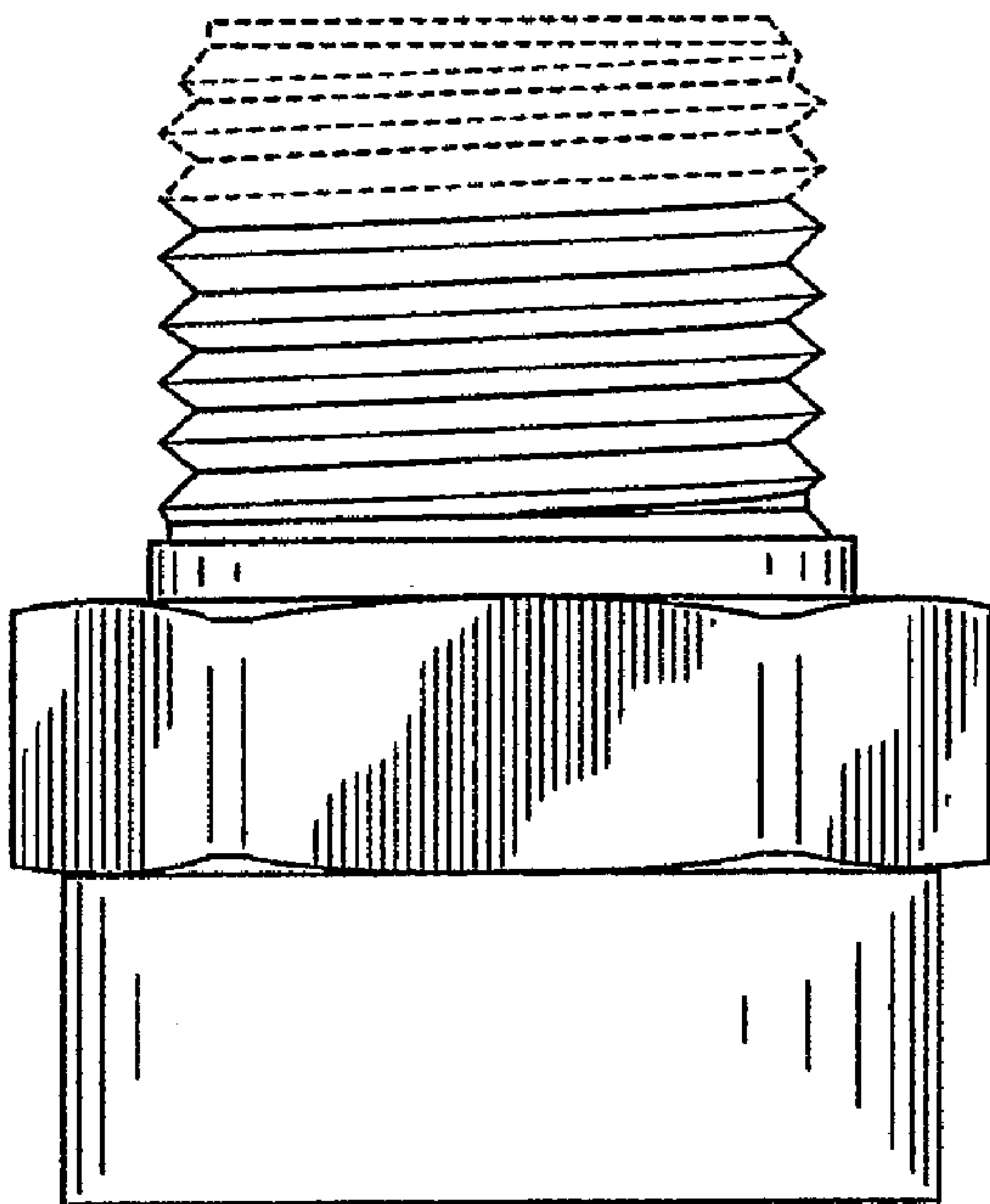

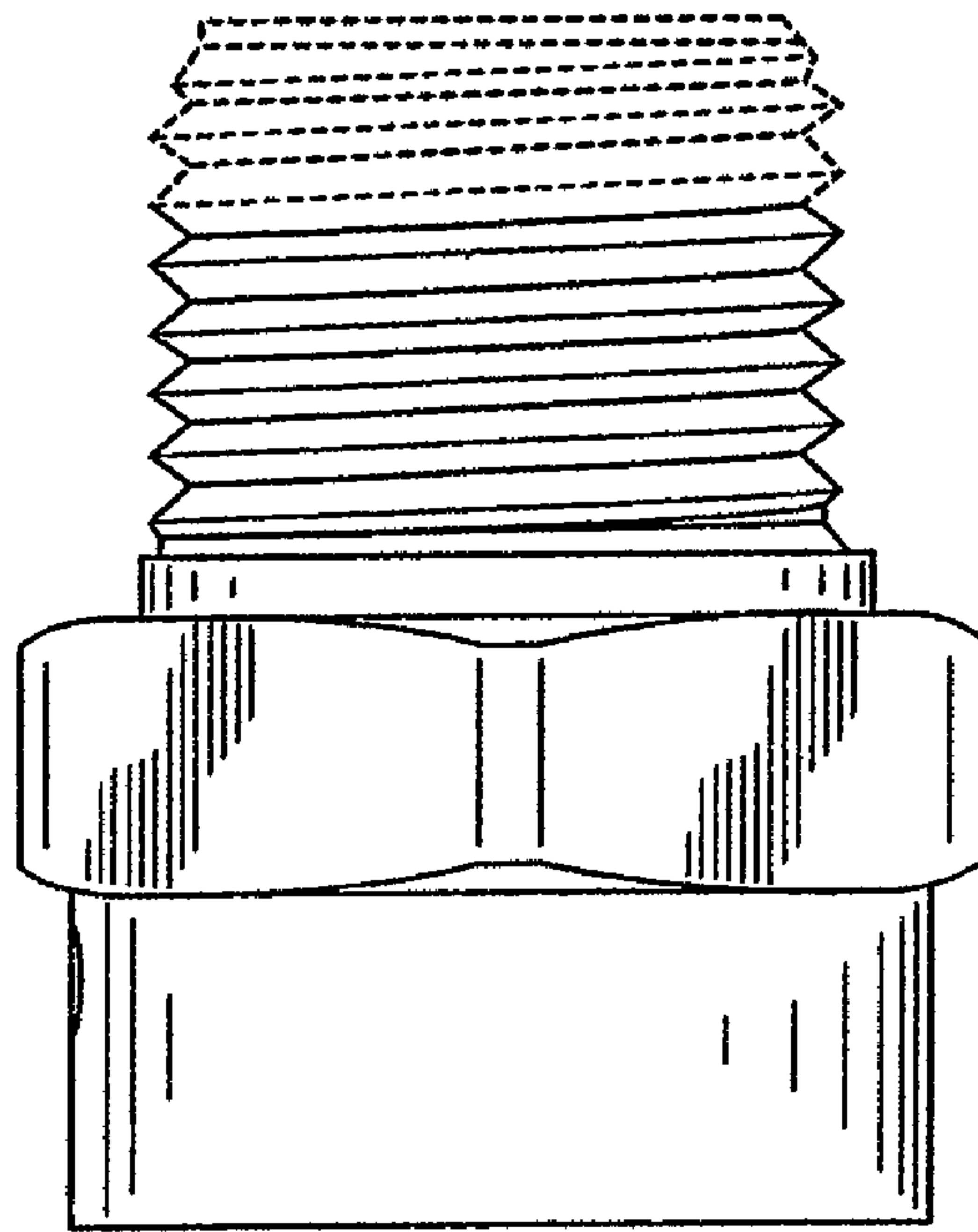

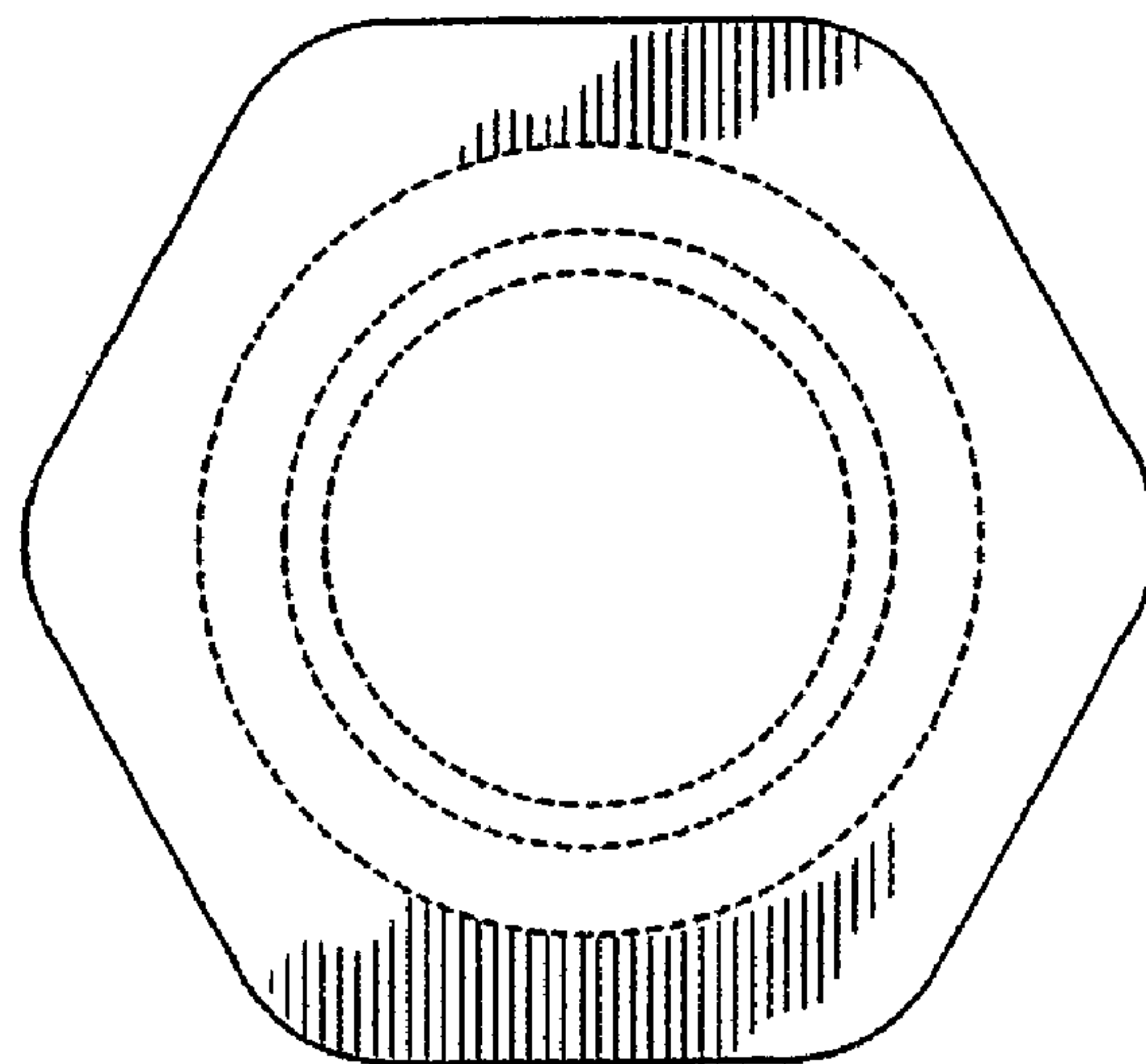

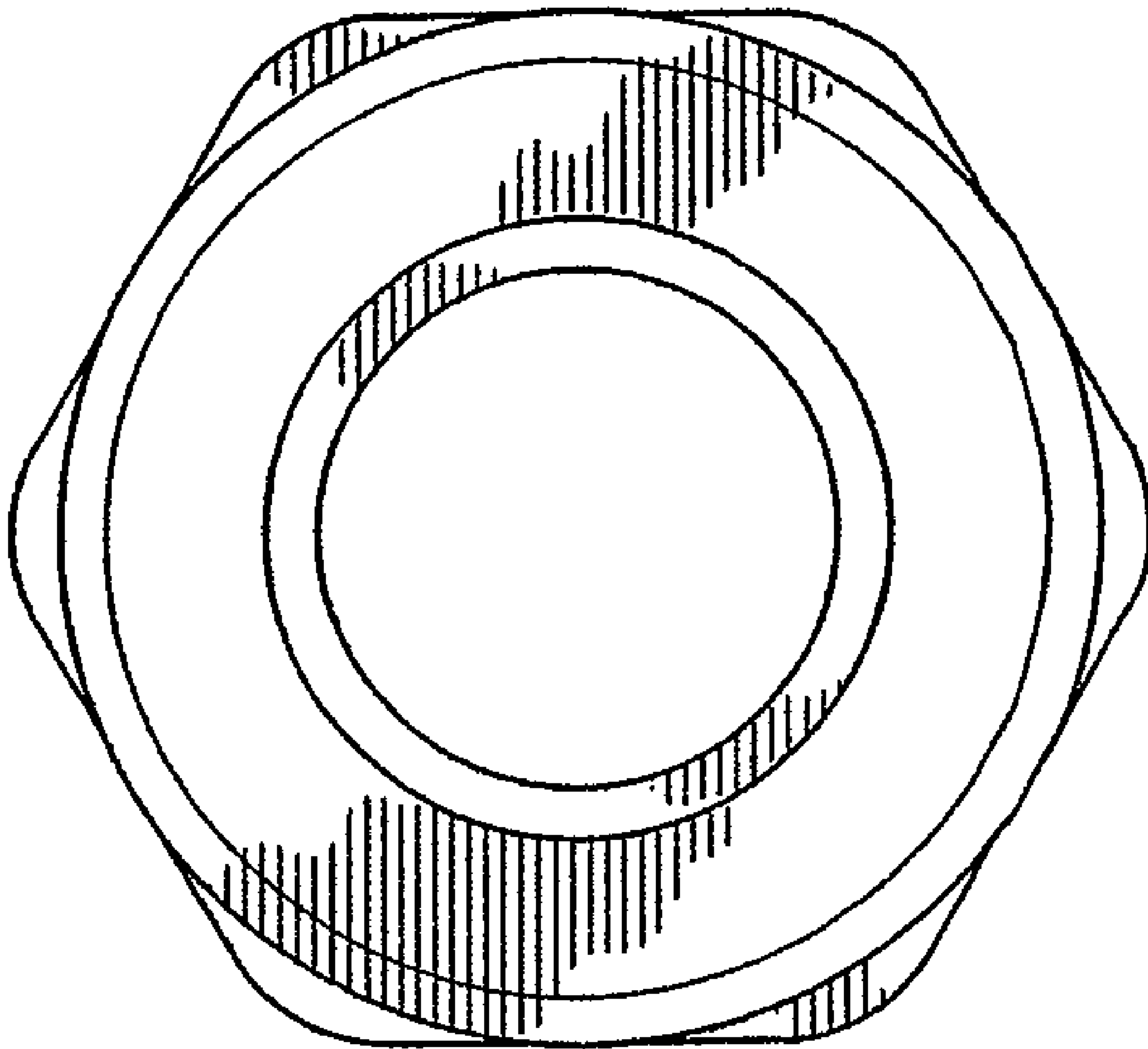
