FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;

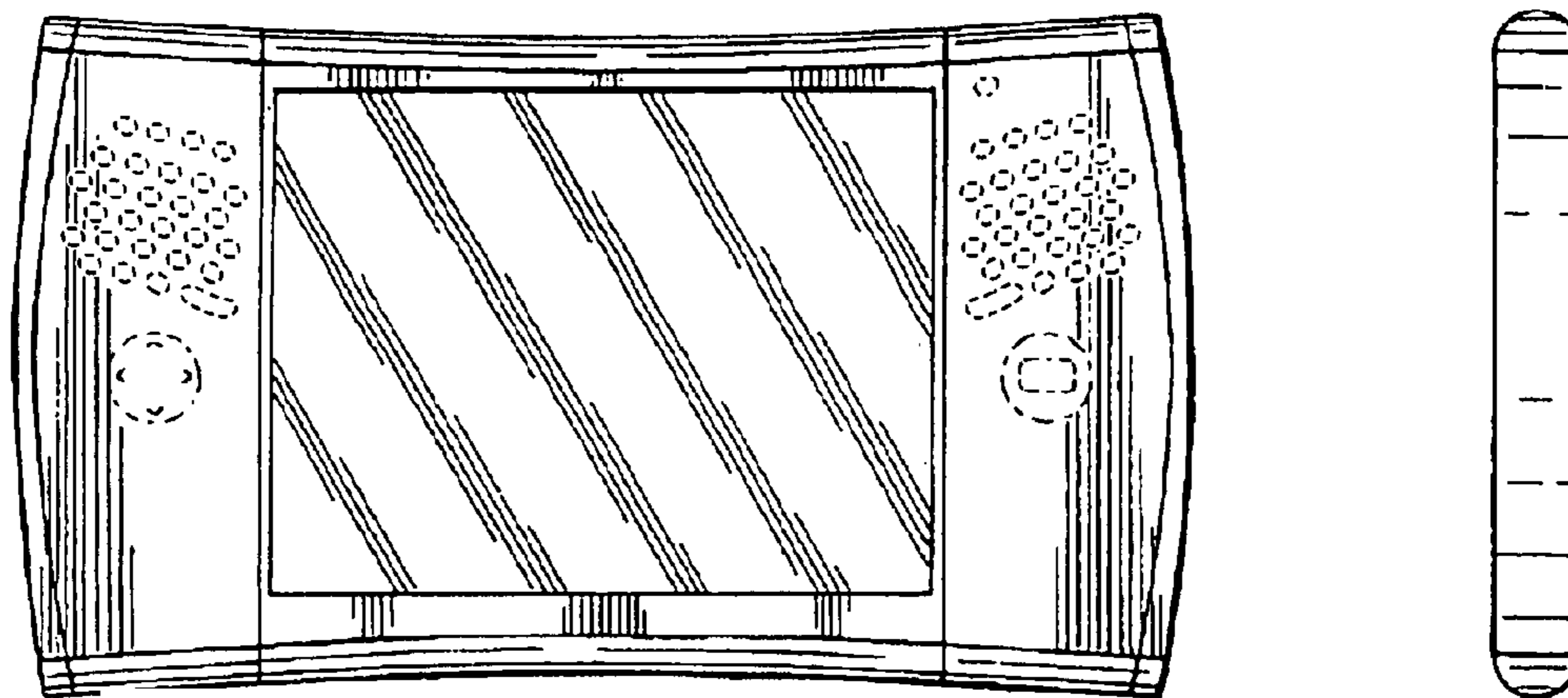
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

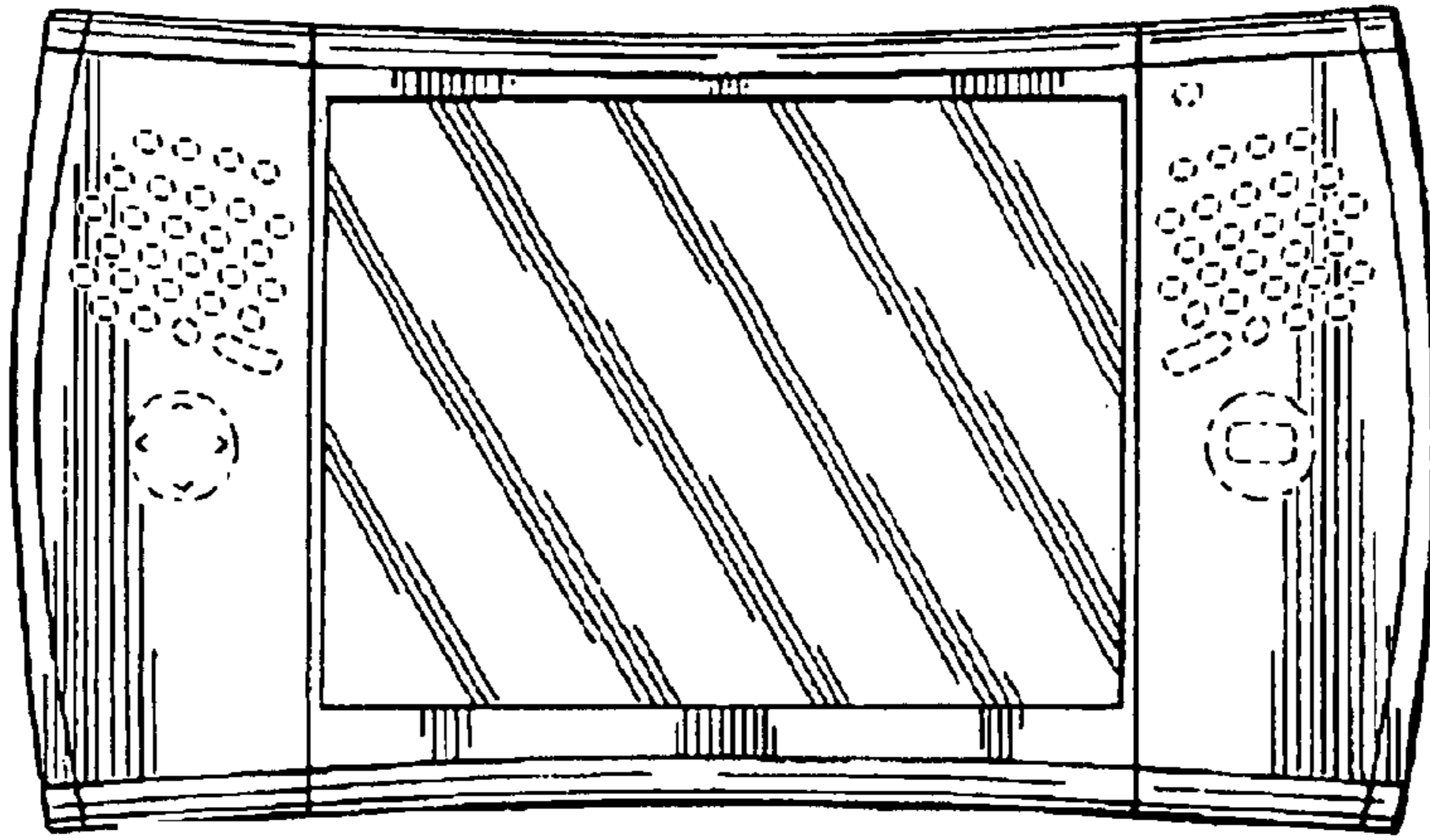
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,

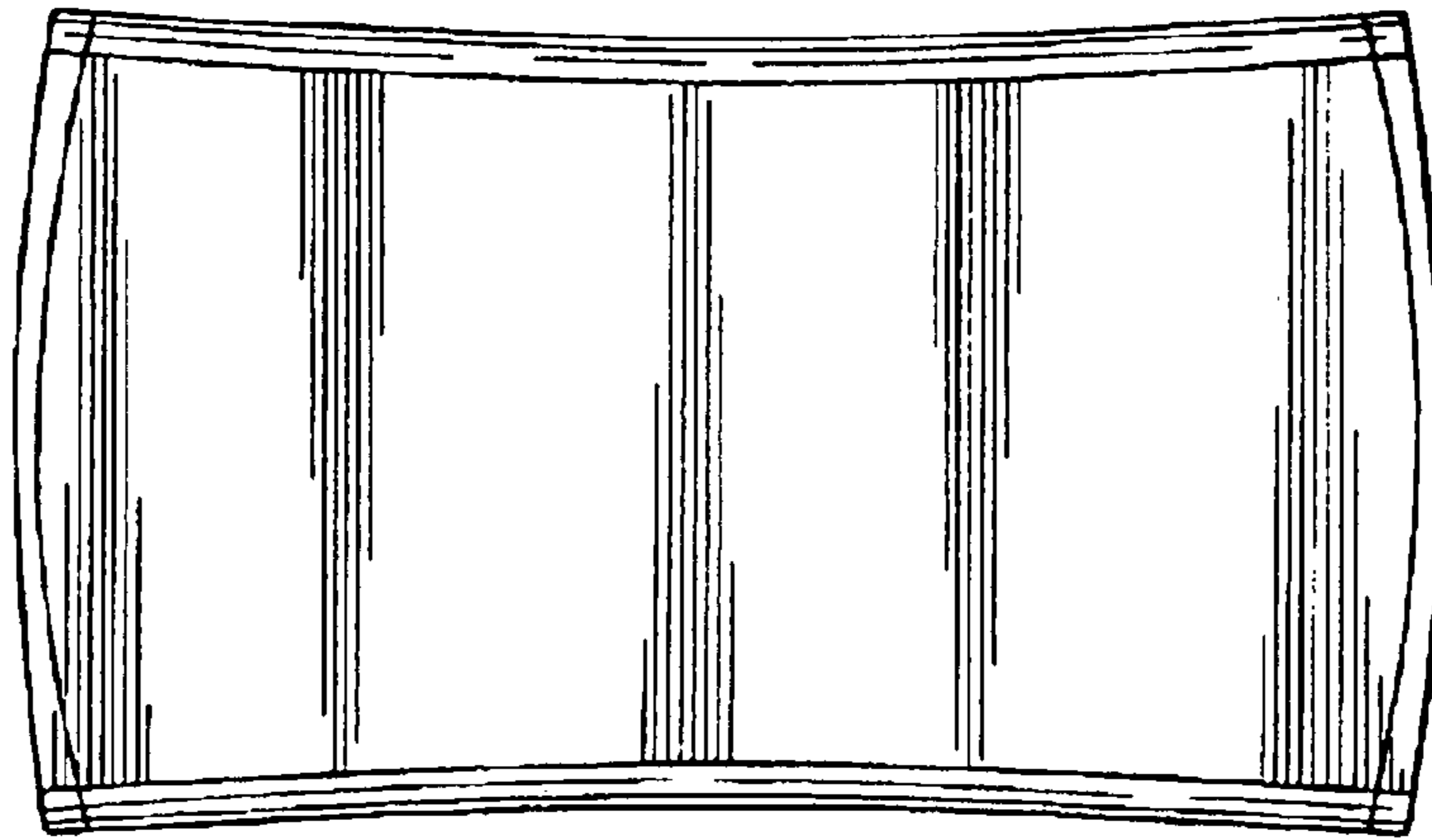




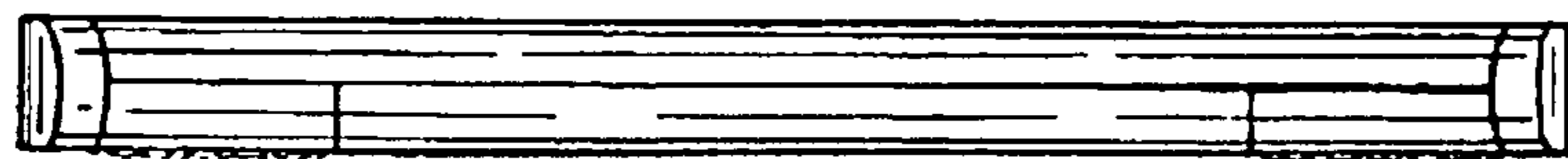

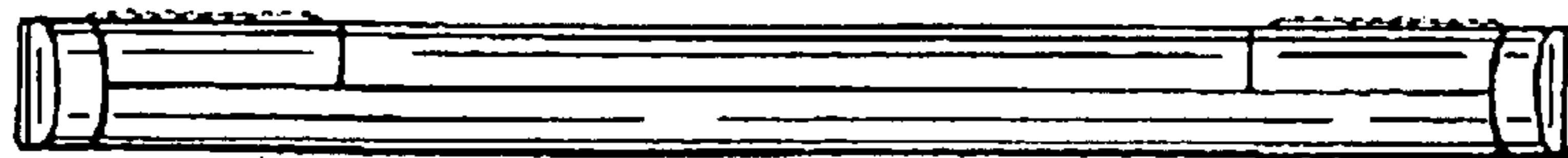
