FIG. 4 is a left side view of the carry tote;

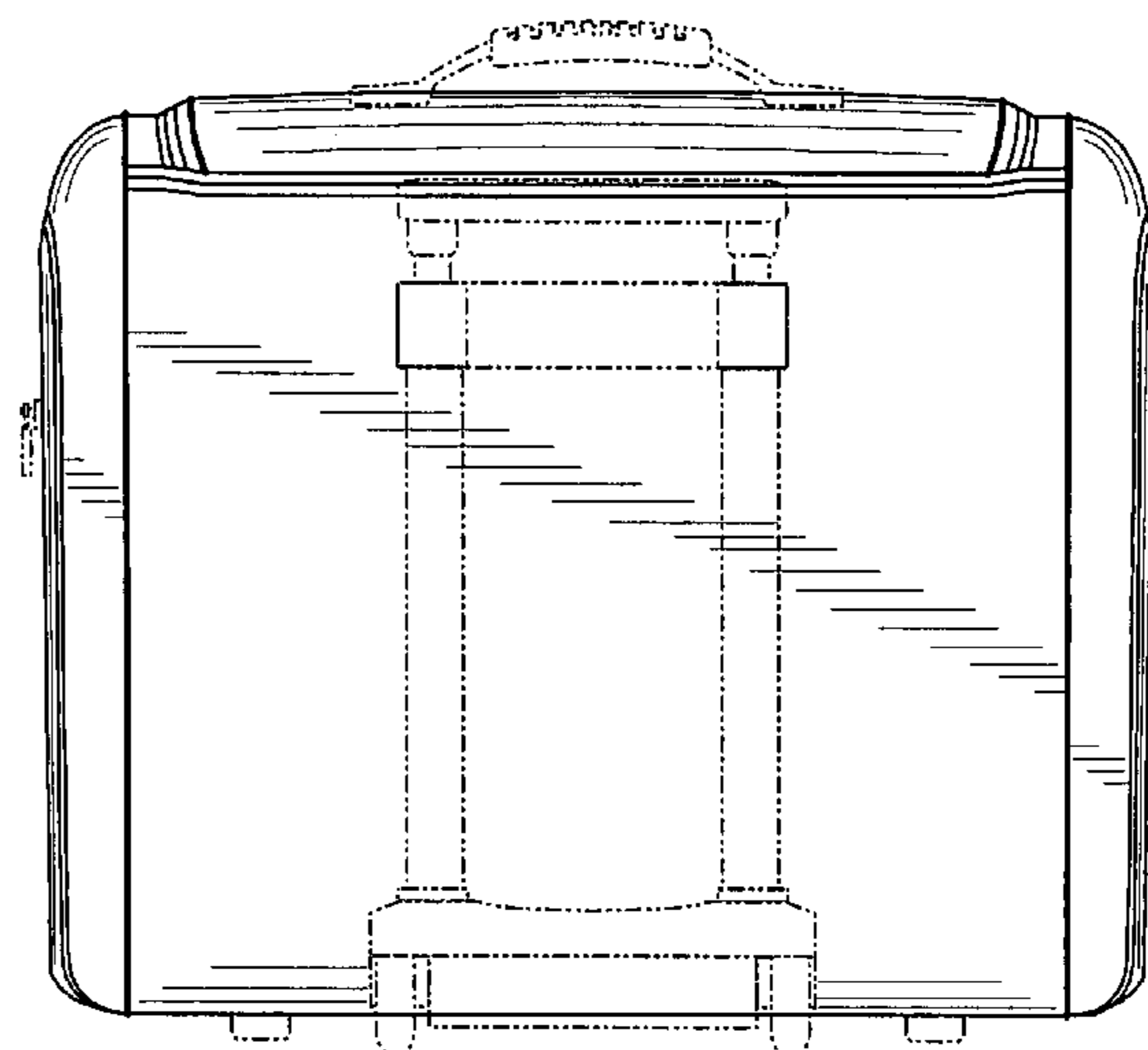
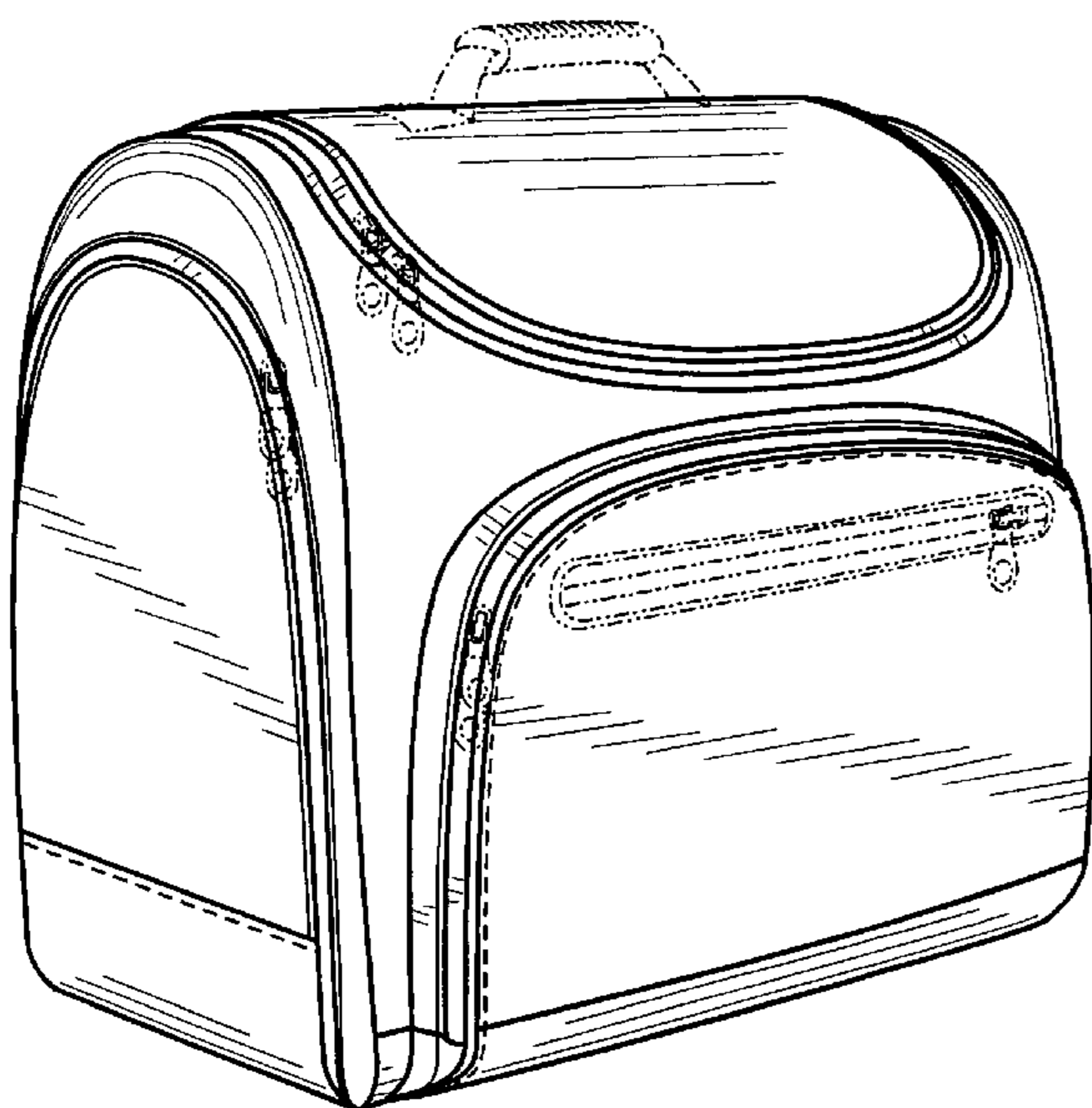
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the carry tote;

FIG. 7 is a bottom side view of the carry tote.

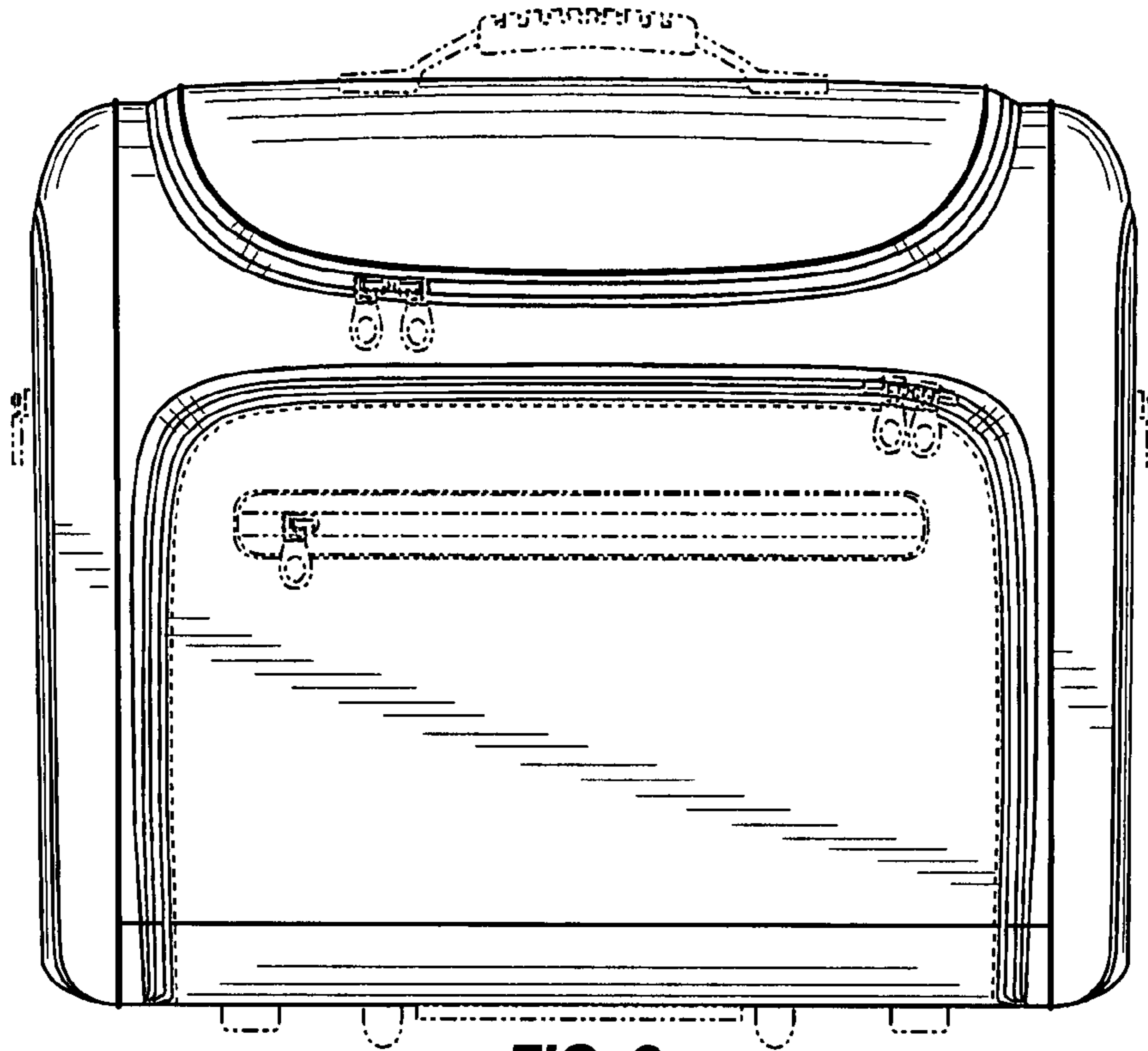
The regularly dashed bold lines on the sides and front of the

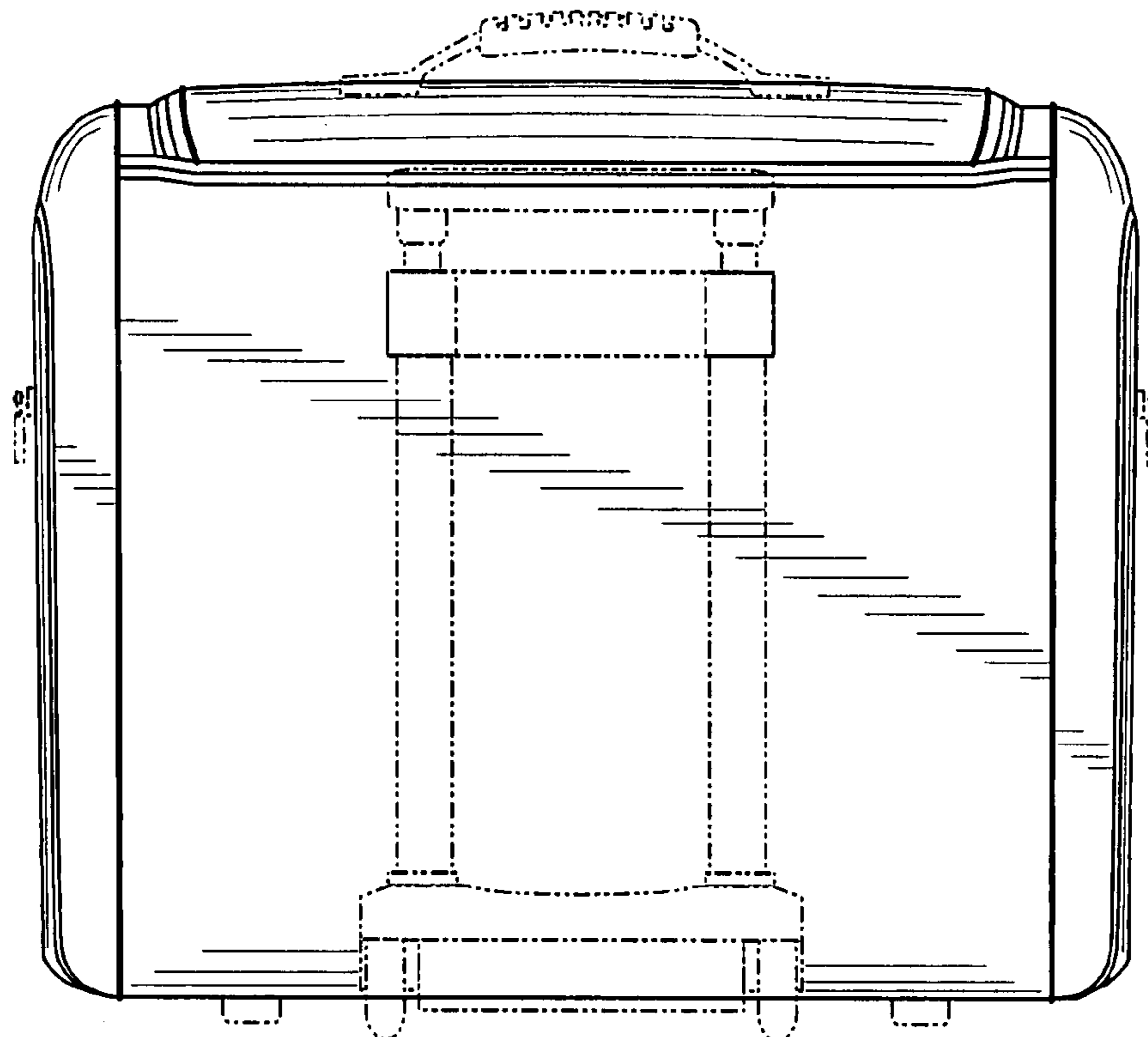




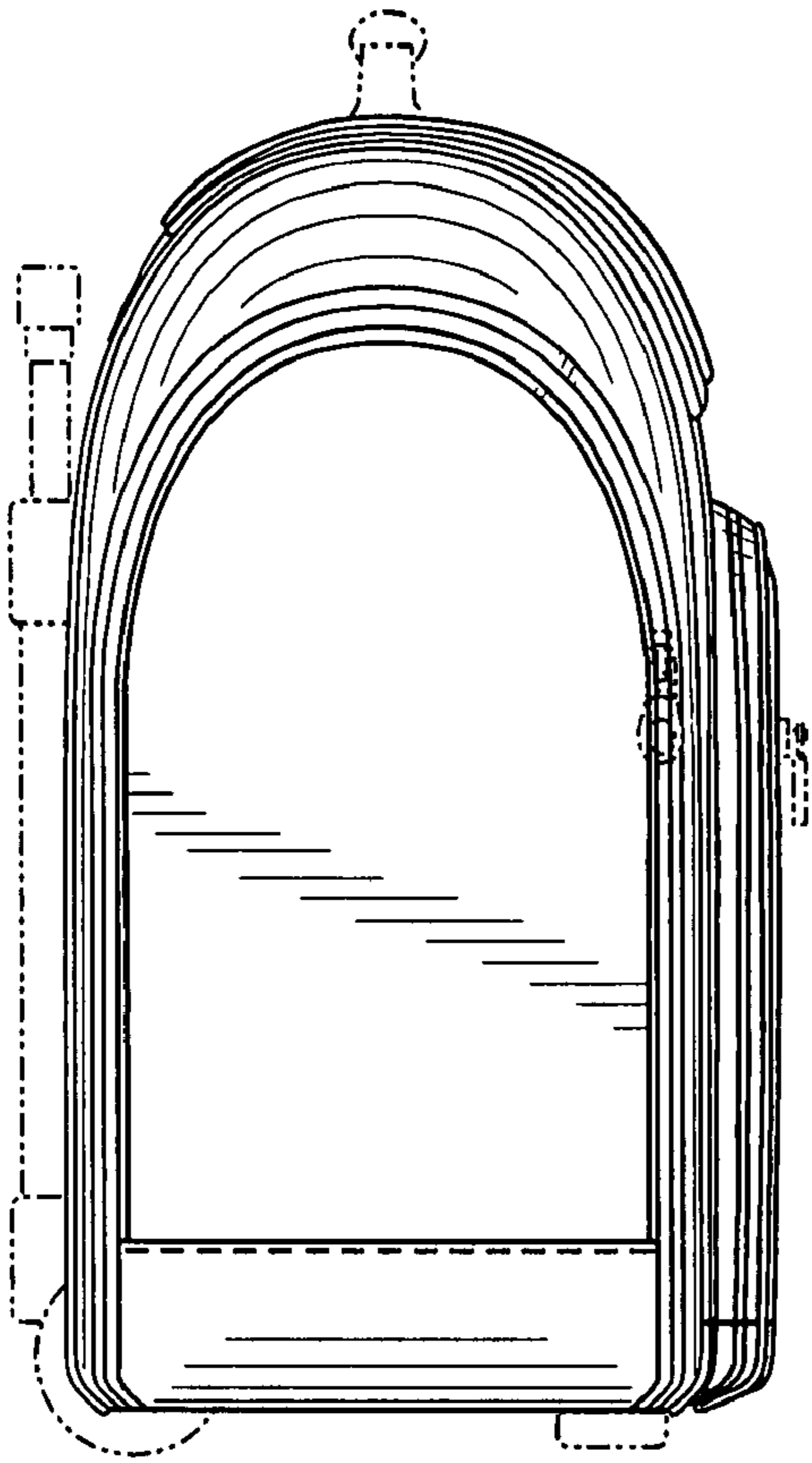

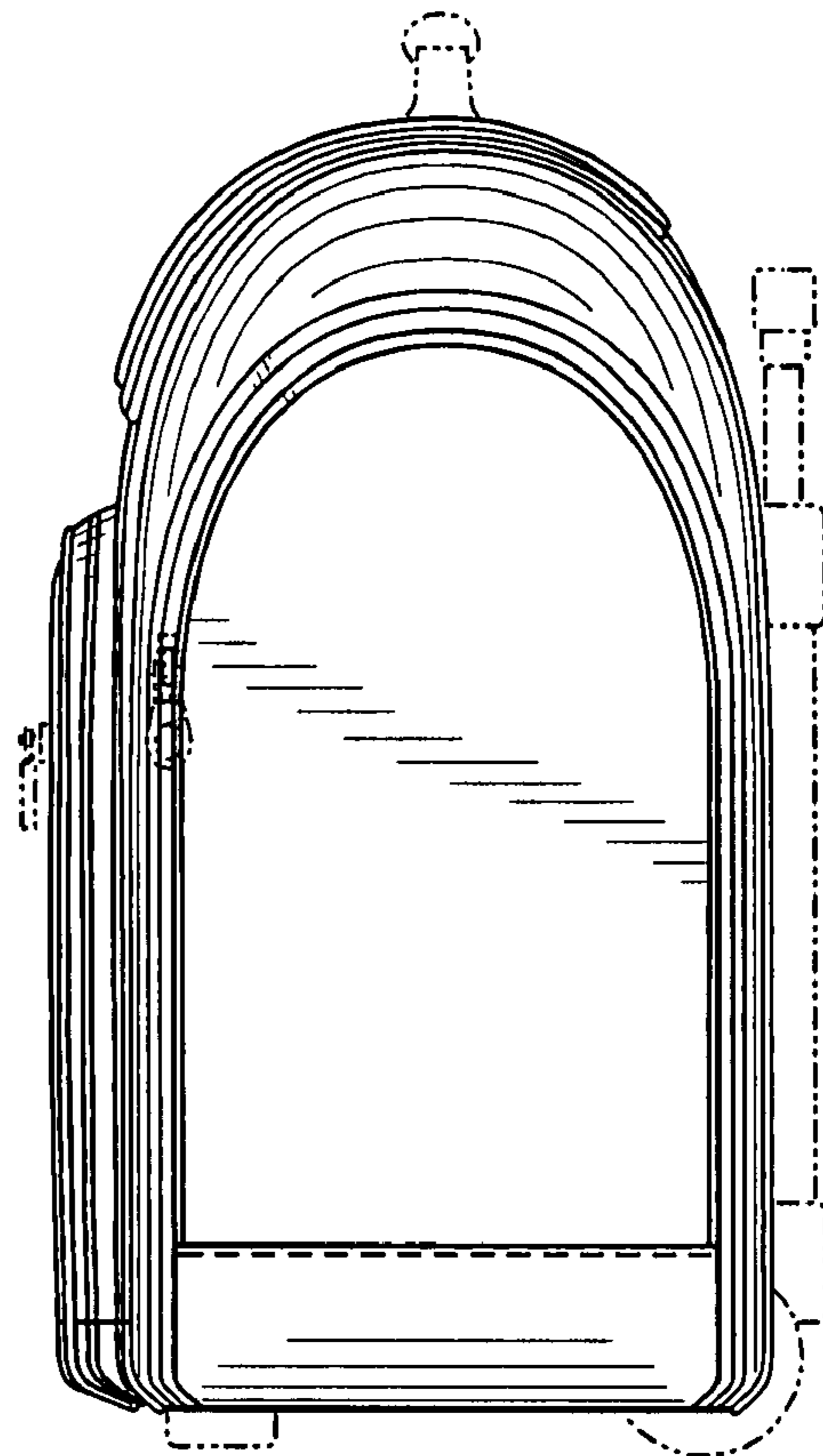

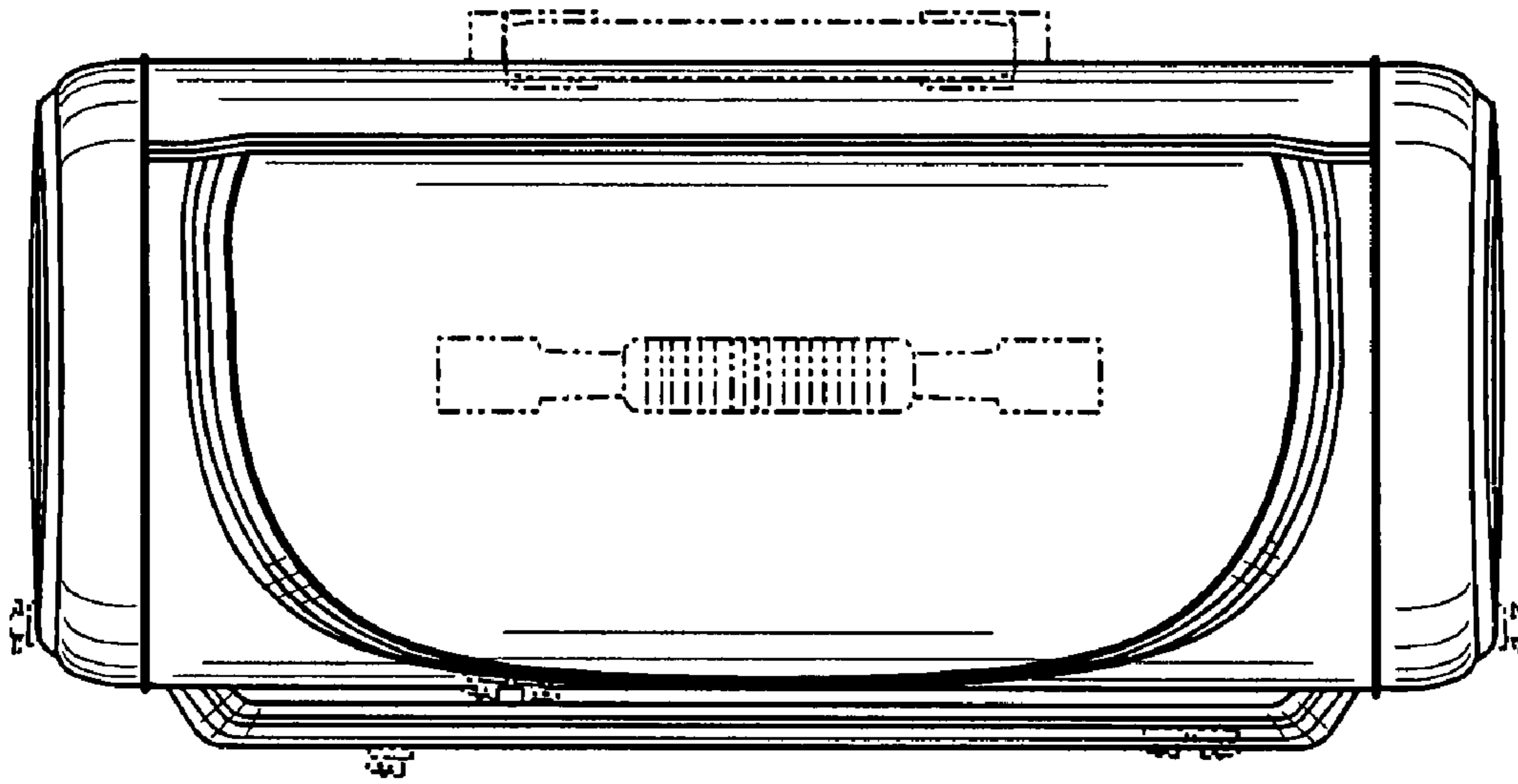

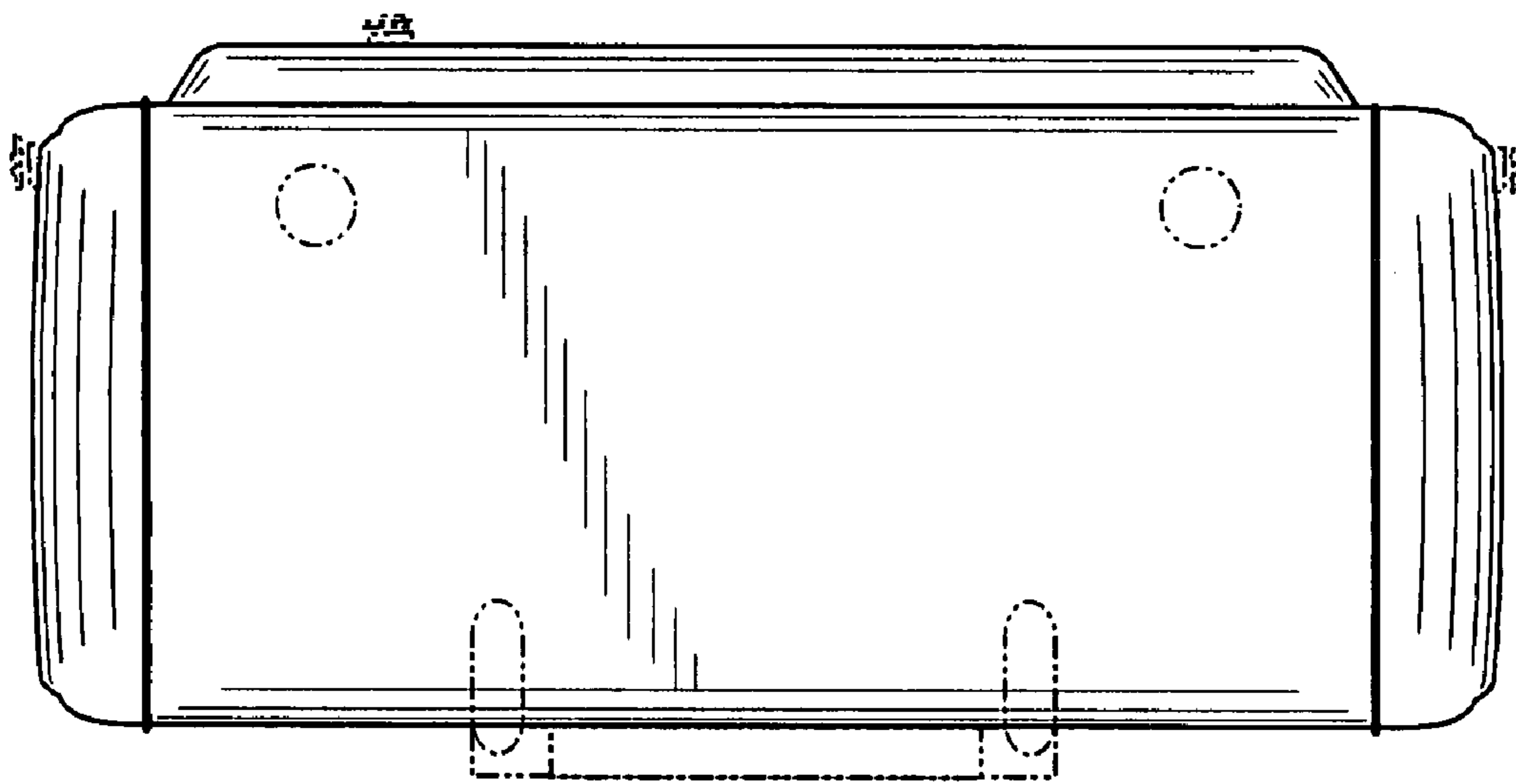
