(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cutlery utensil, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 18 is a first side view of the cutlery utensil of FIG. 15.

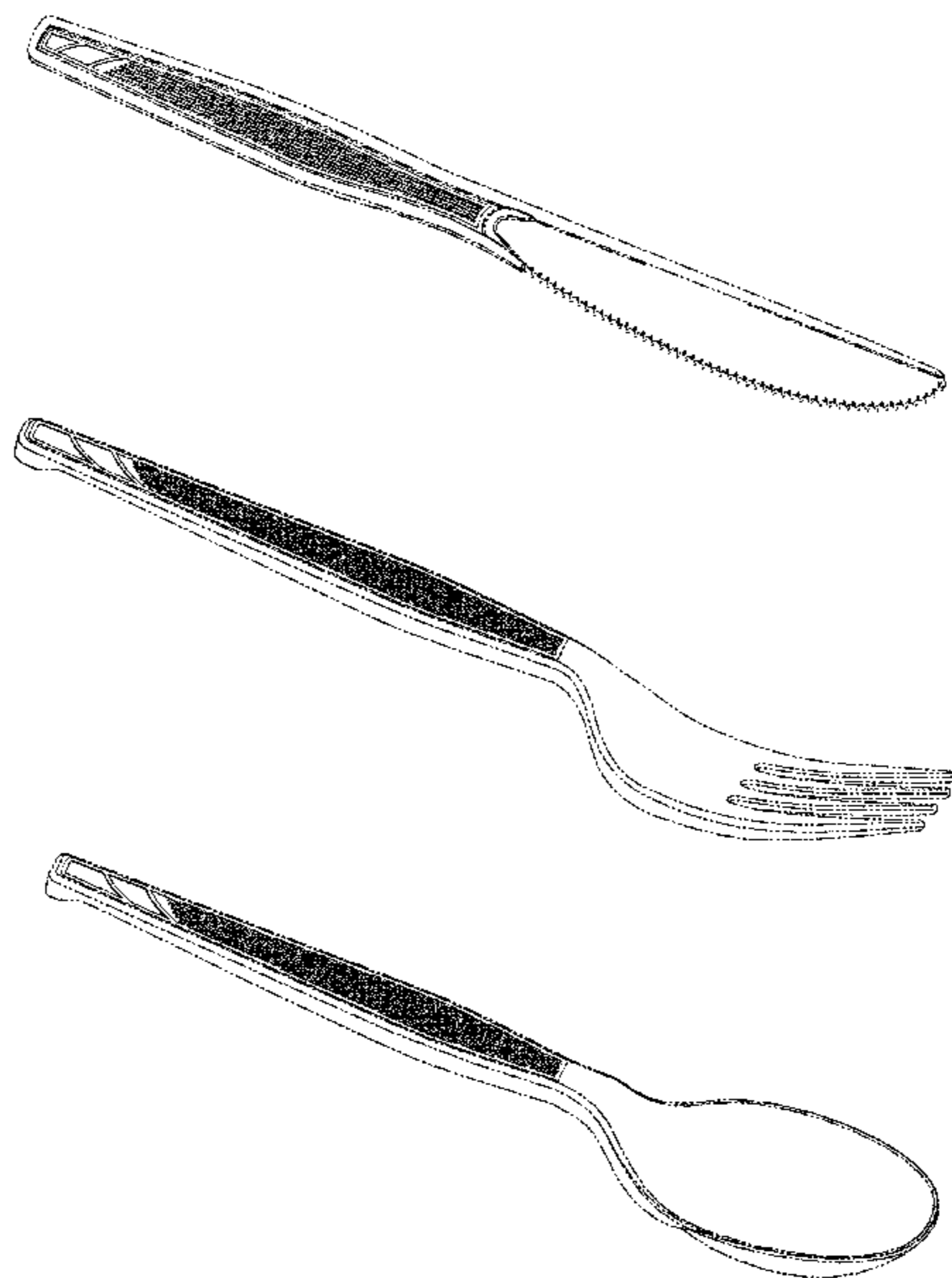
FIG. 19 is a second side view of the cutlery utensil of FIG. 15.

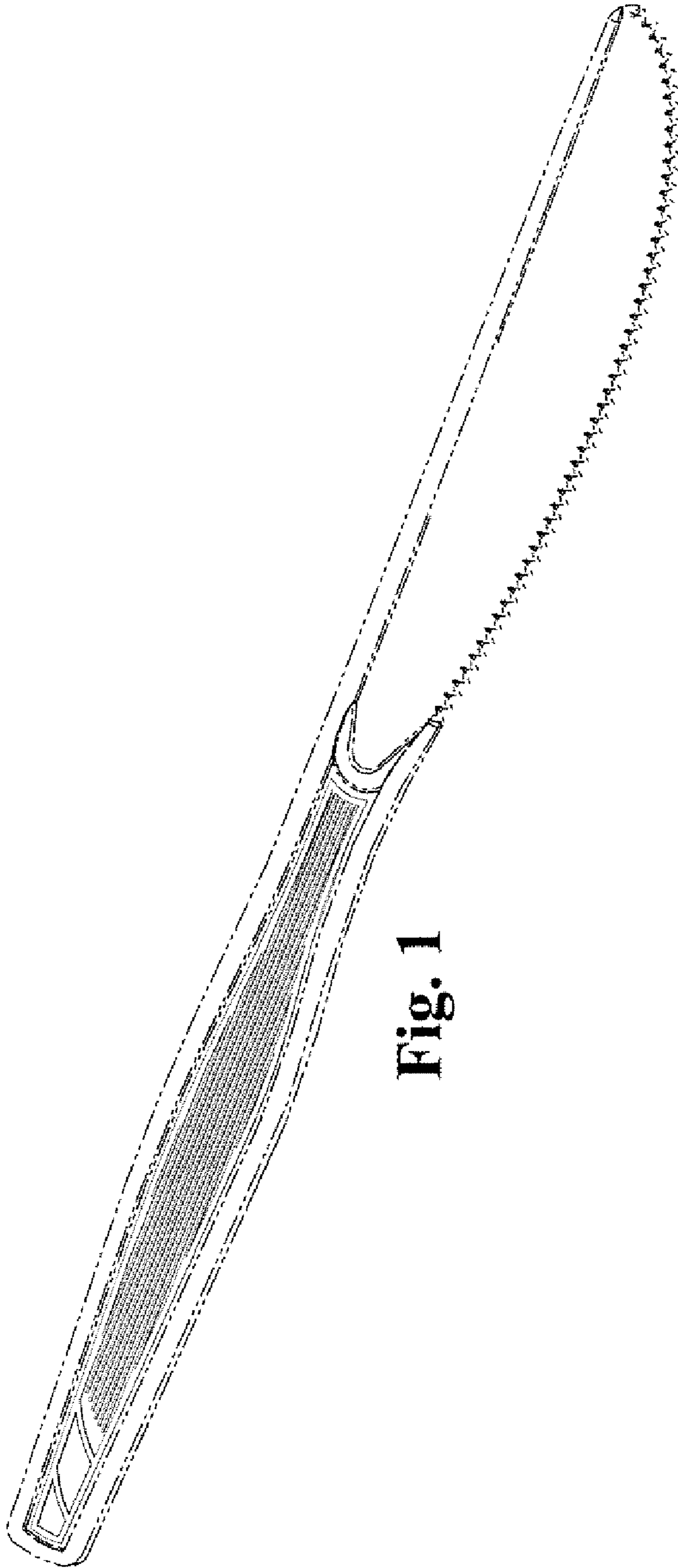

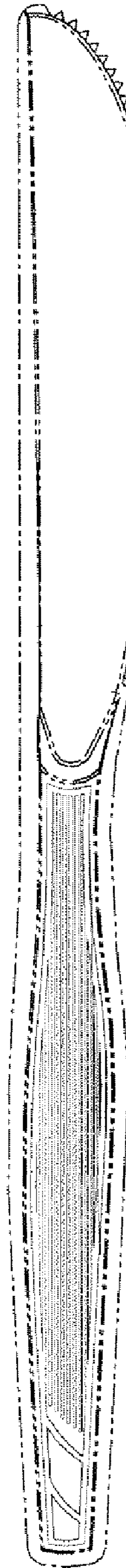

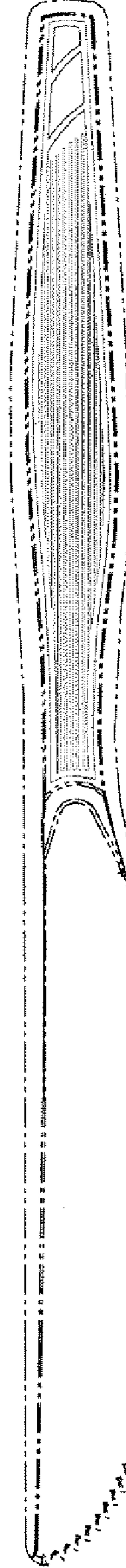

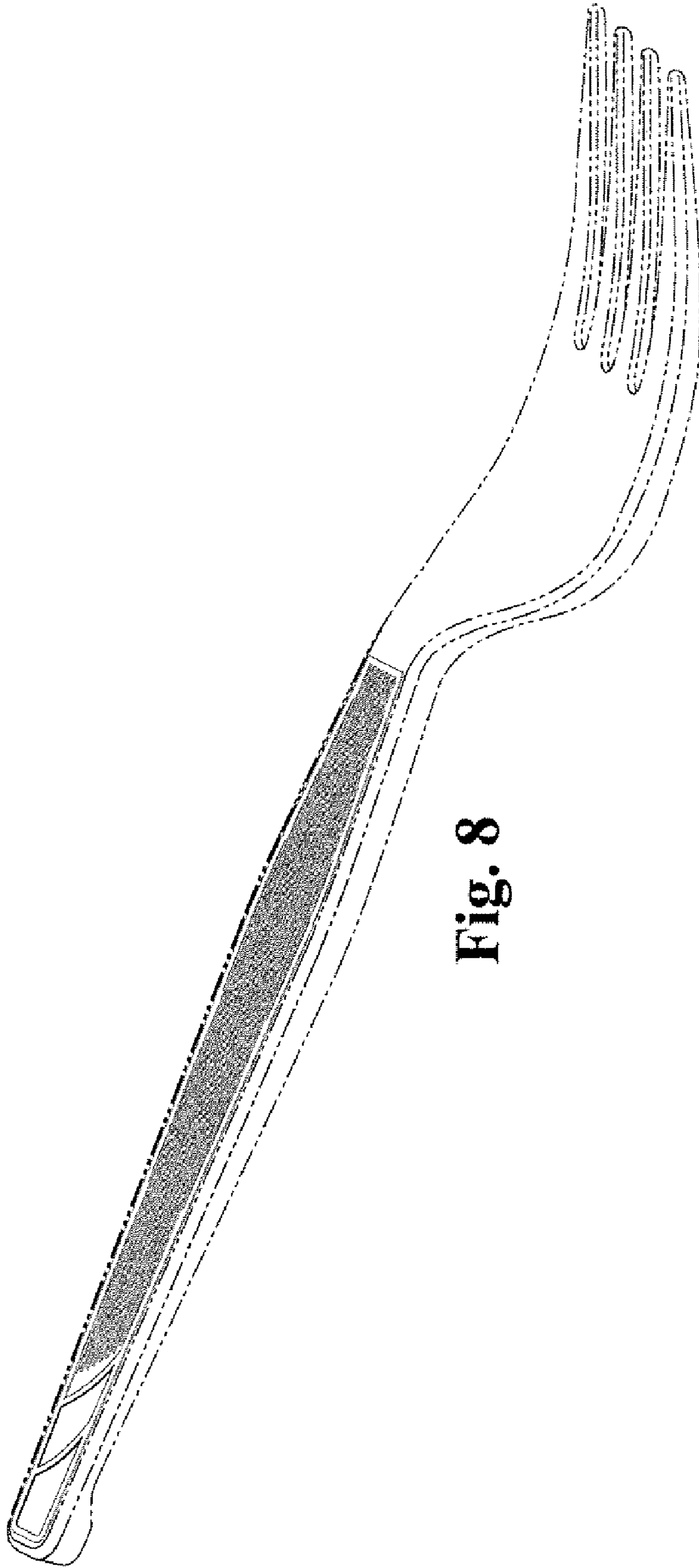

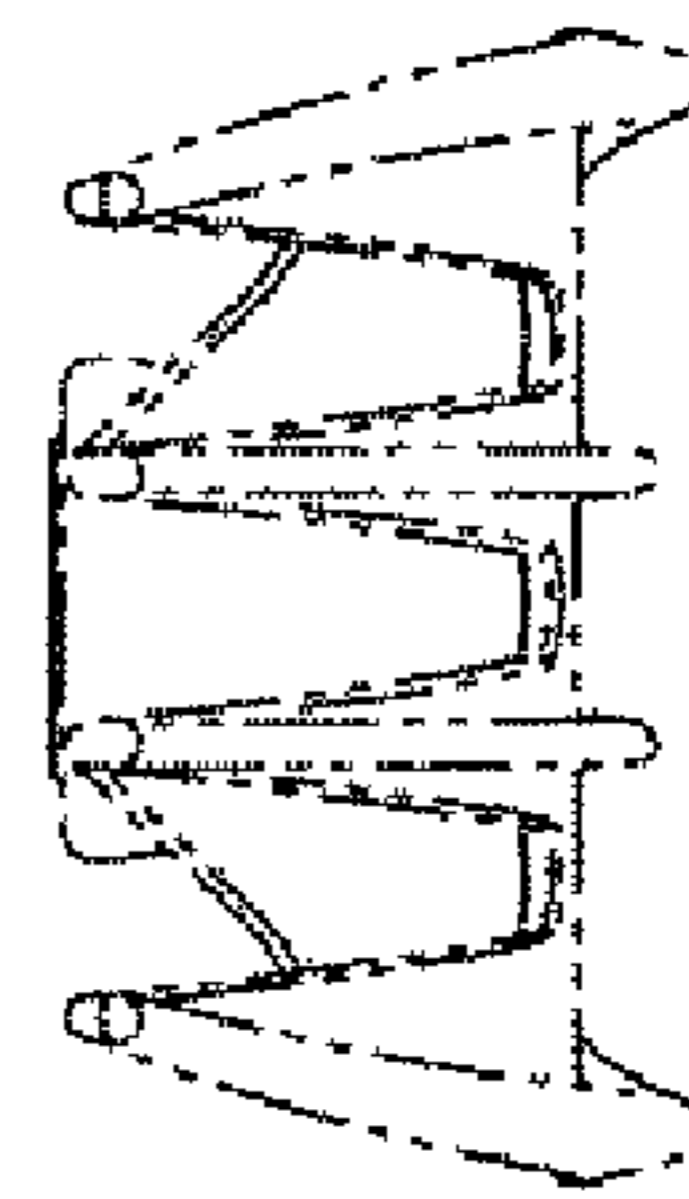

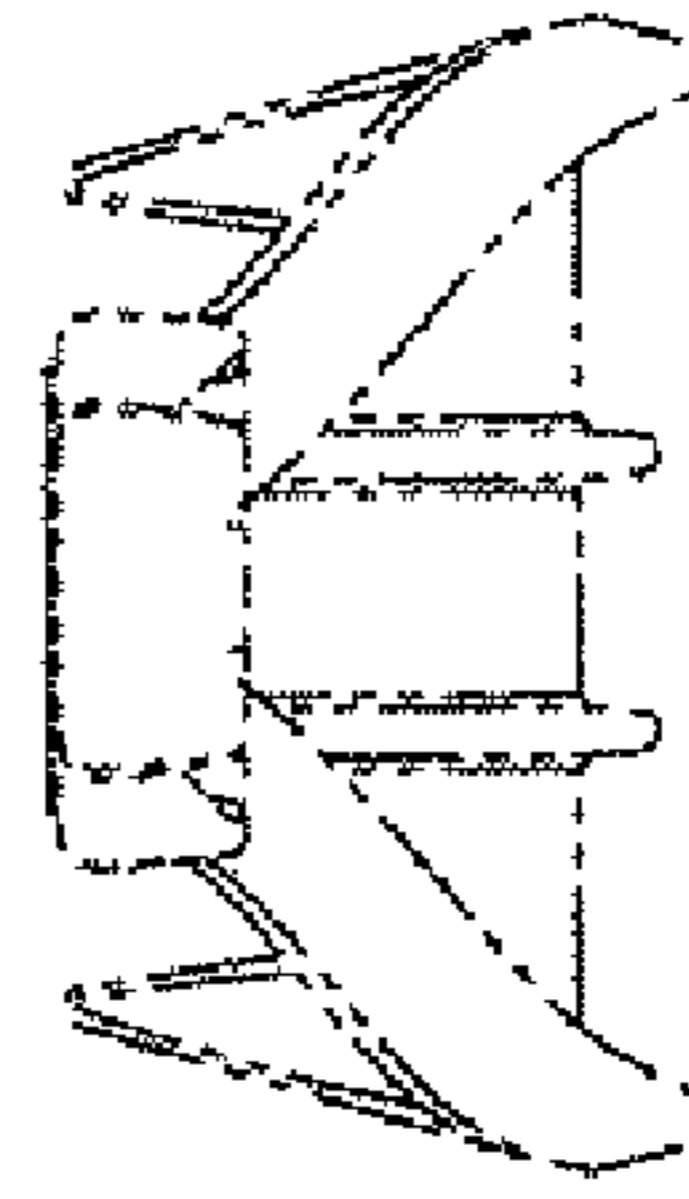
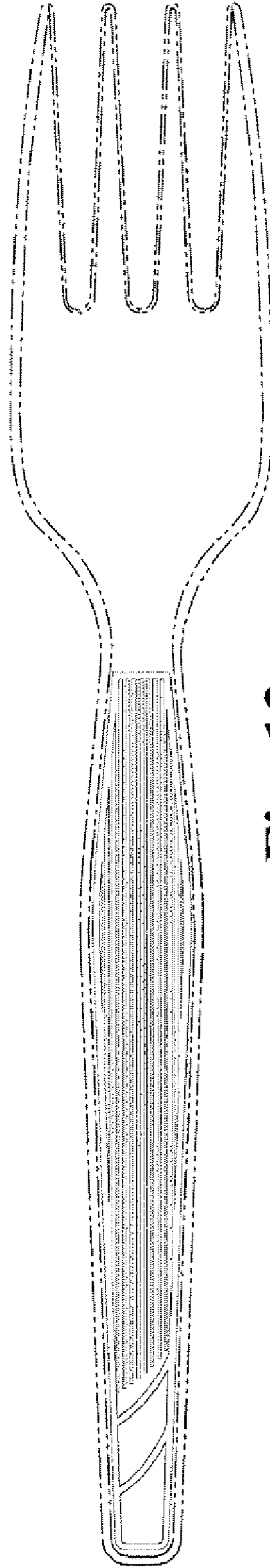
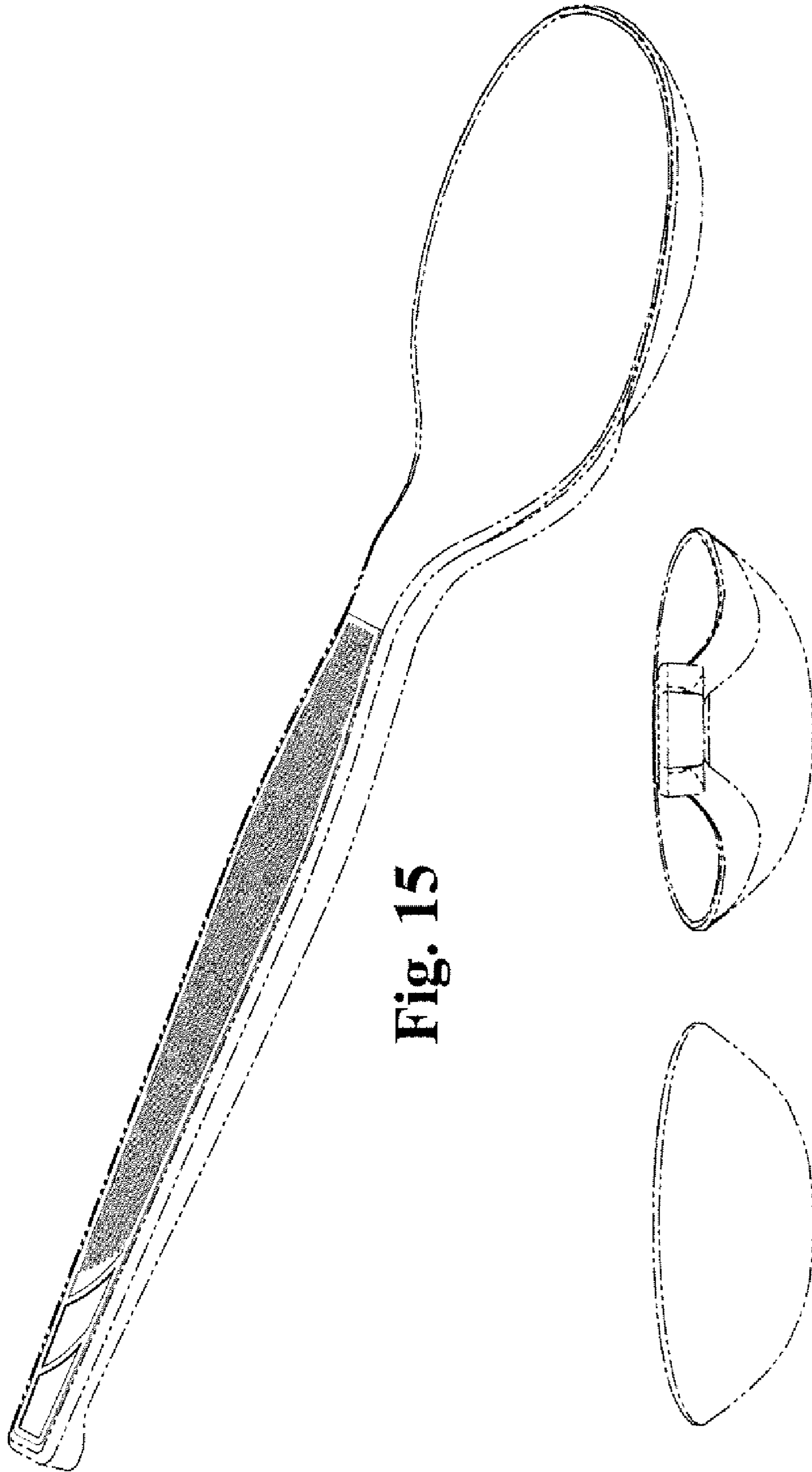

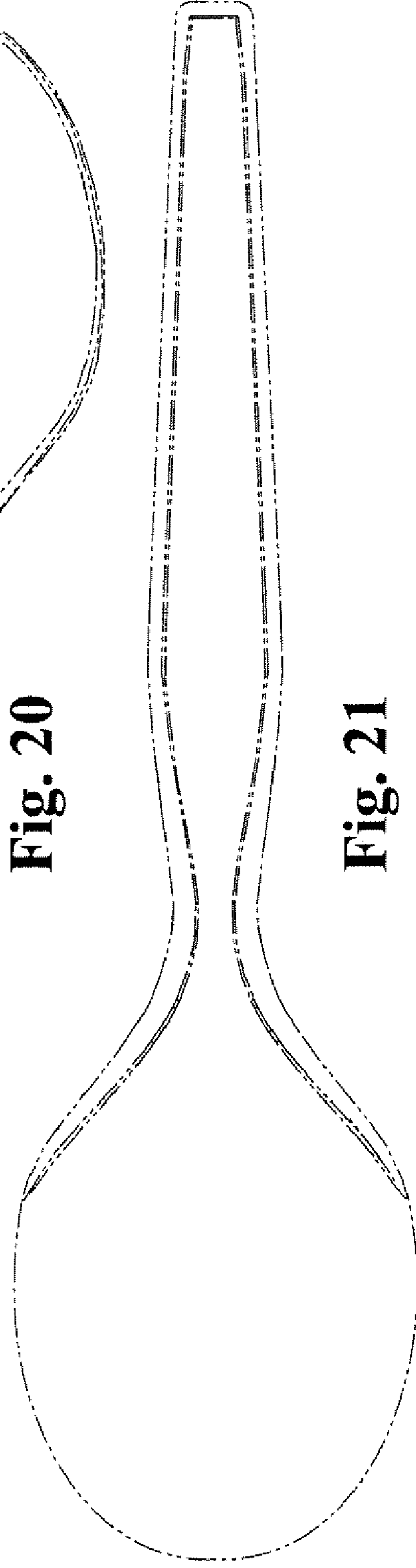
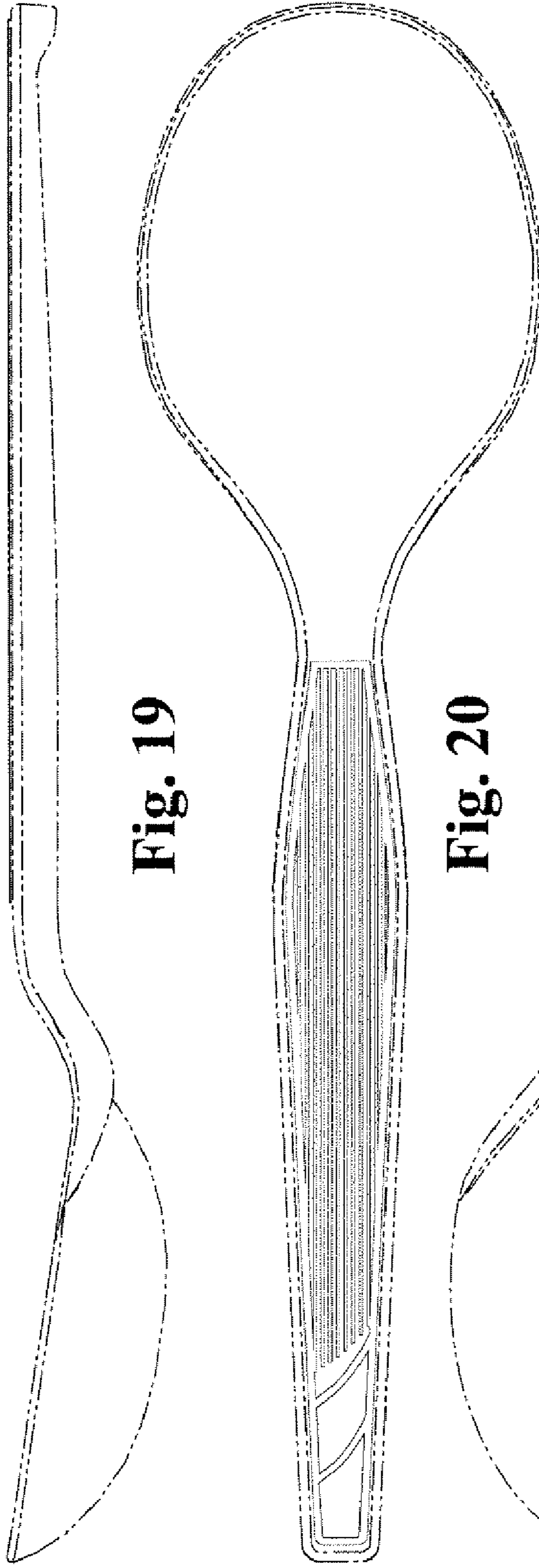
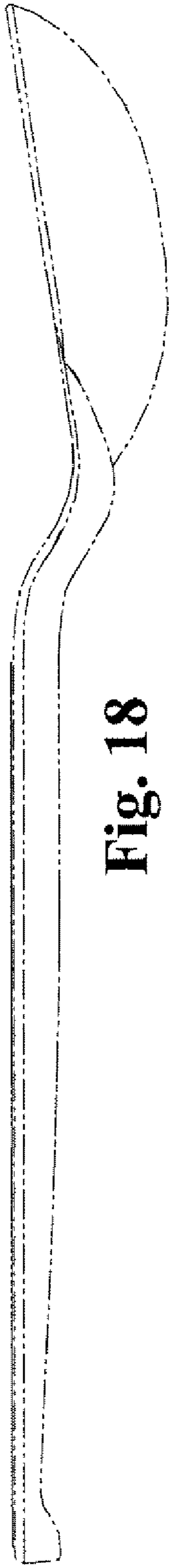
