FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image;

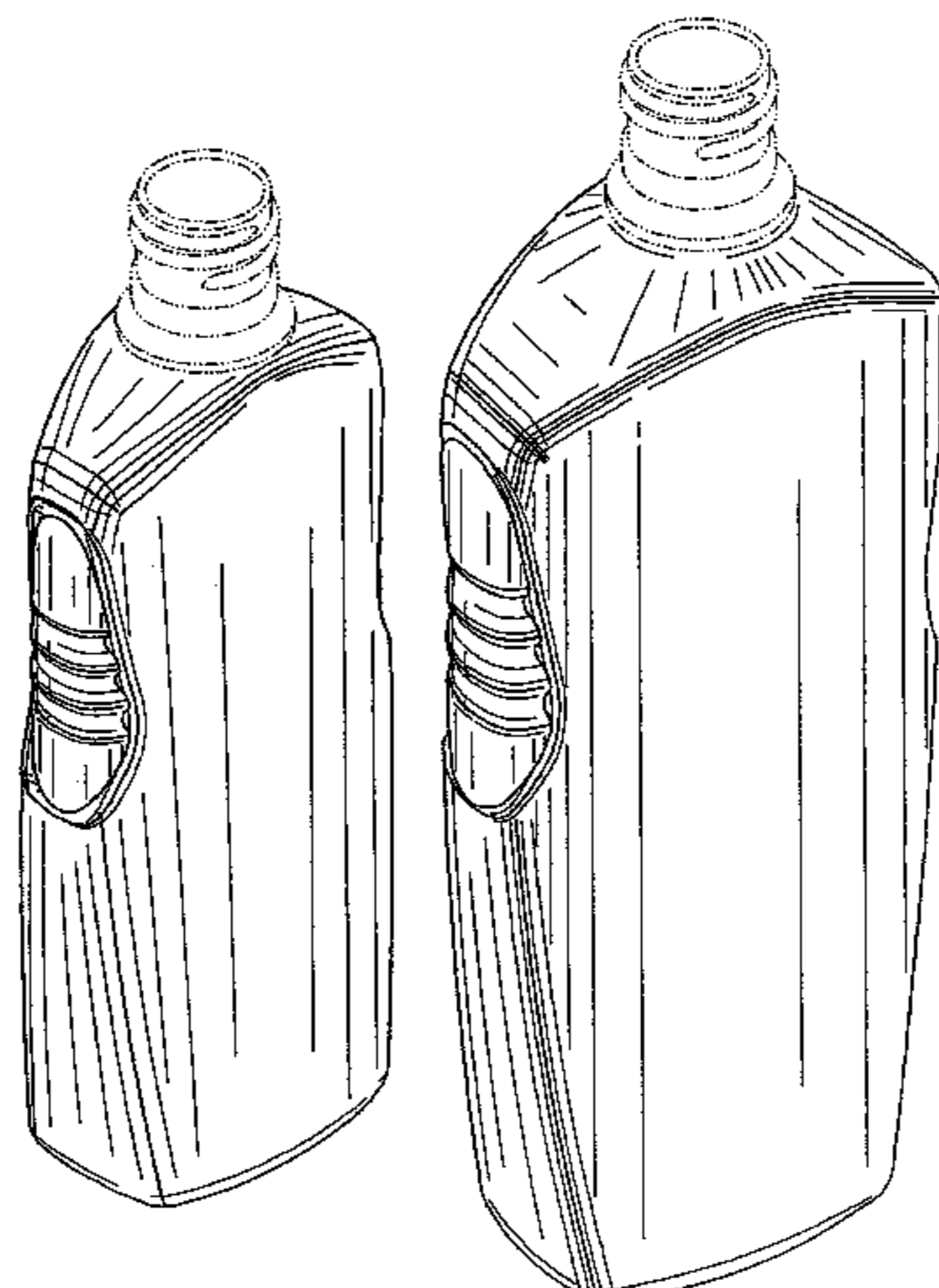
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image;

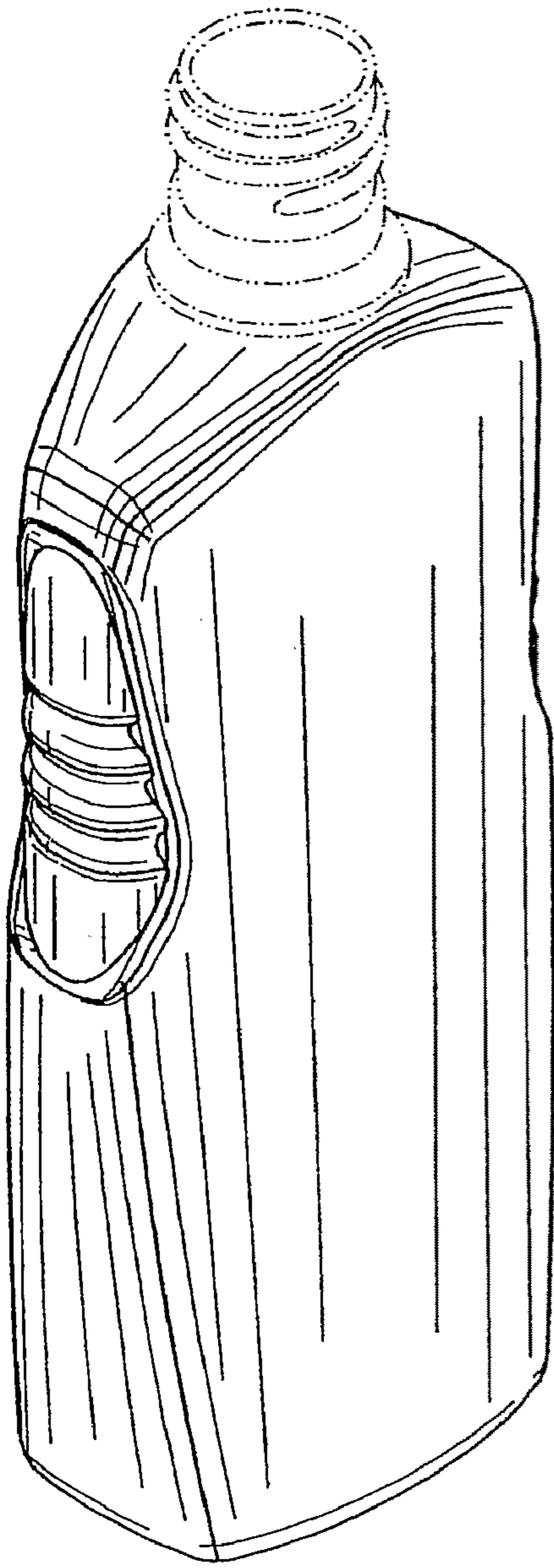

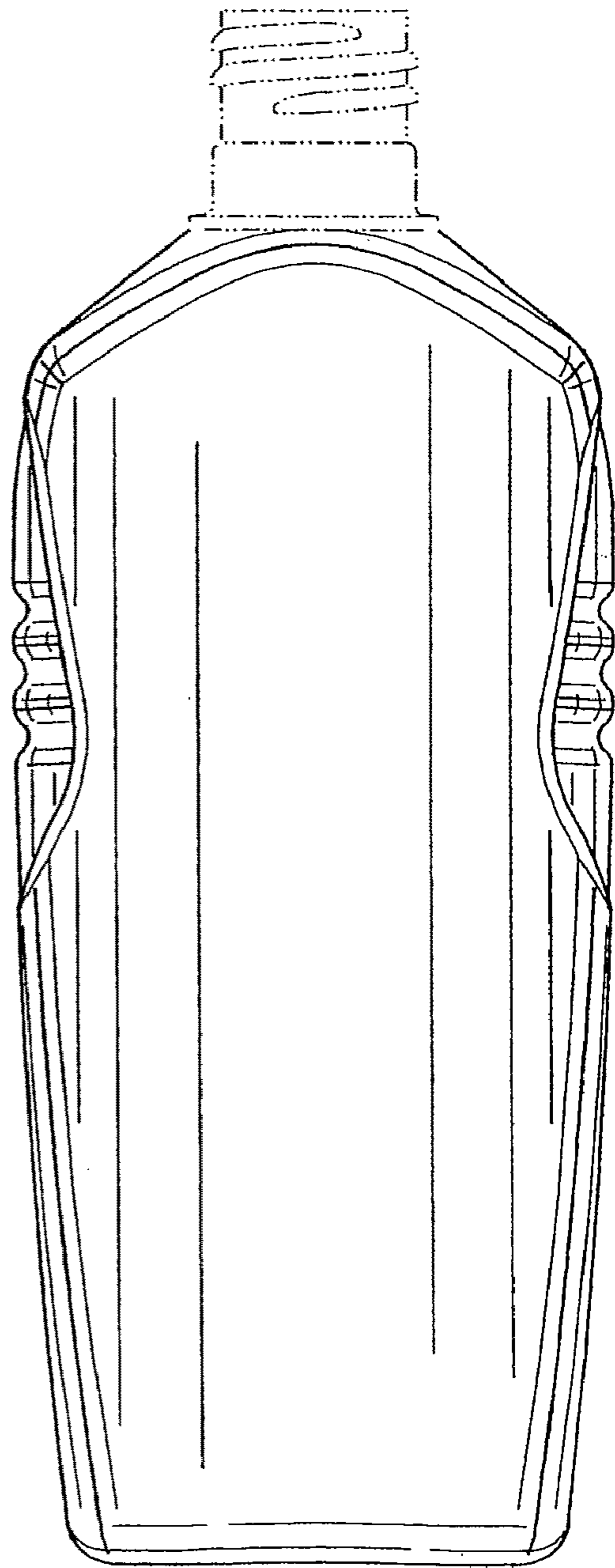

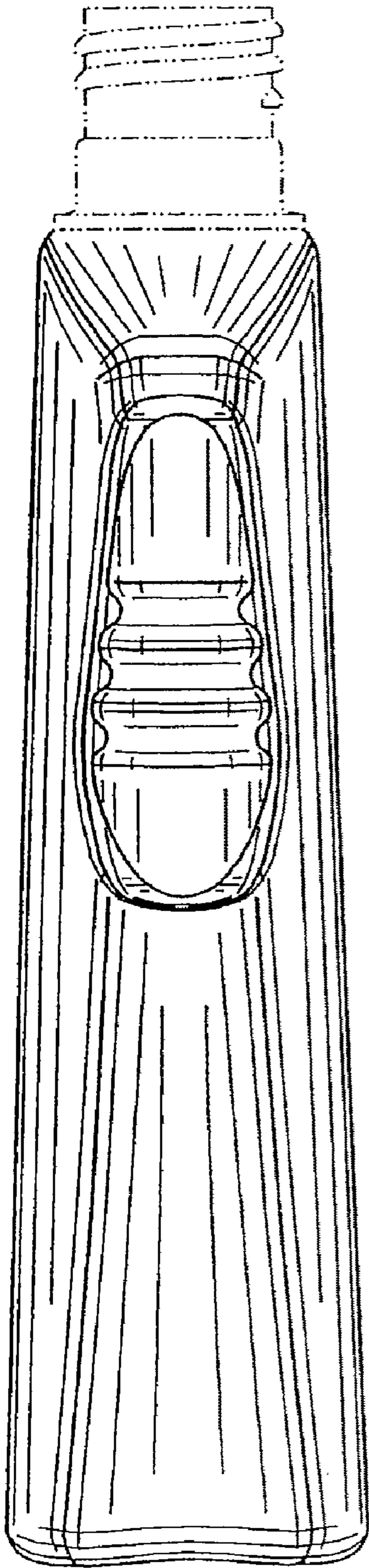

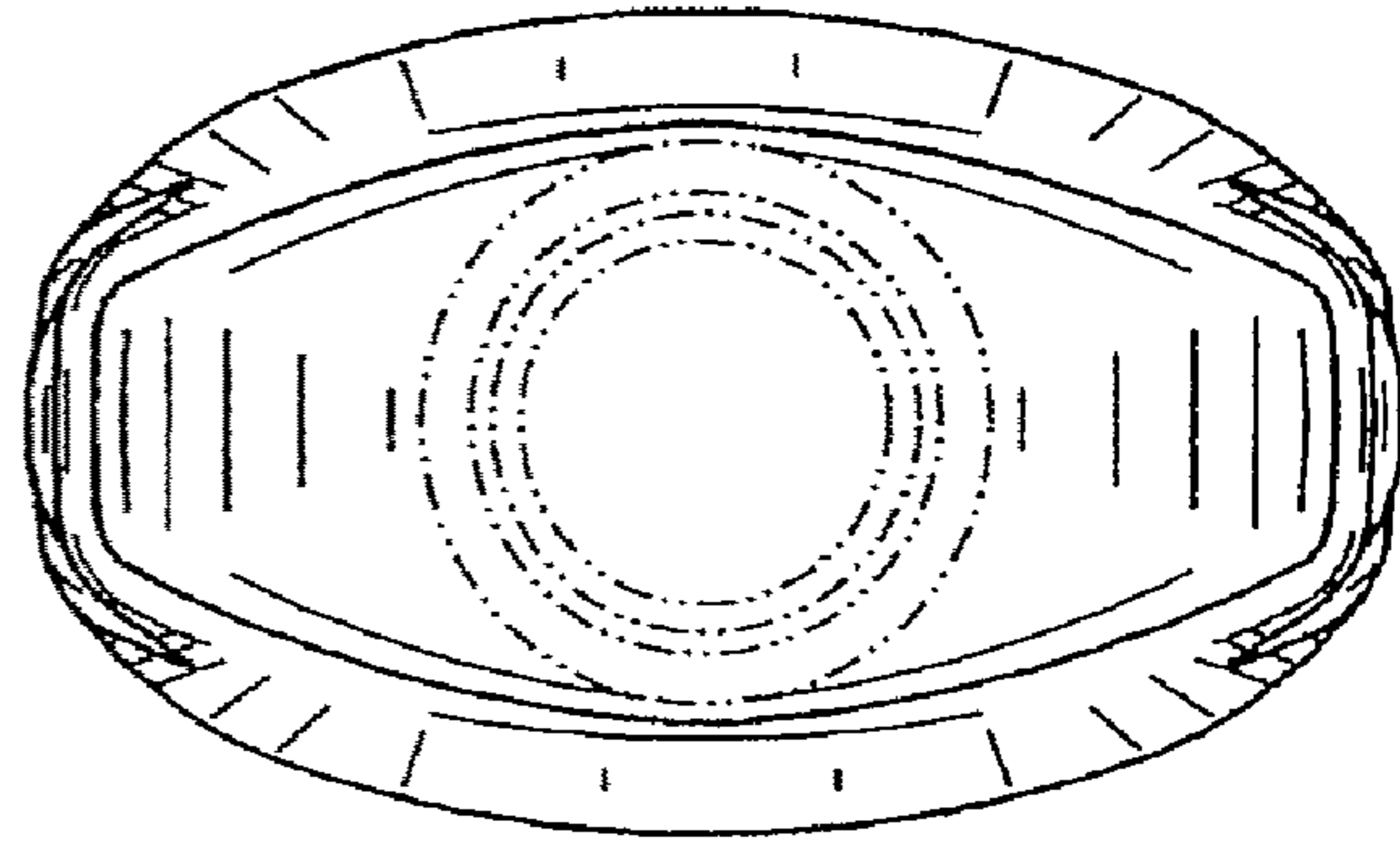

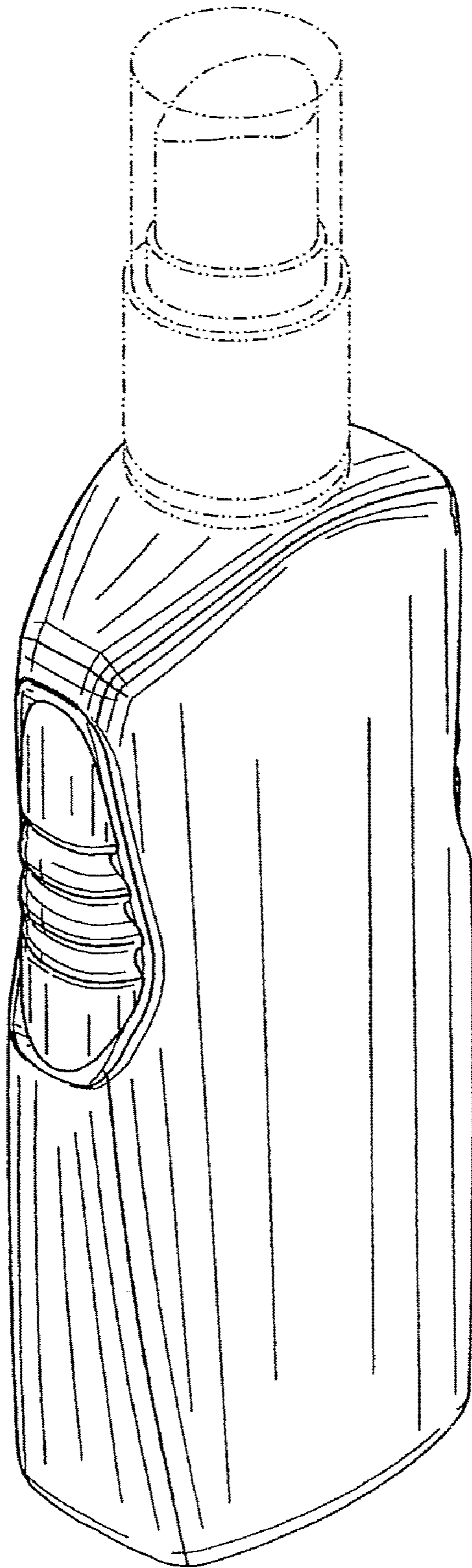

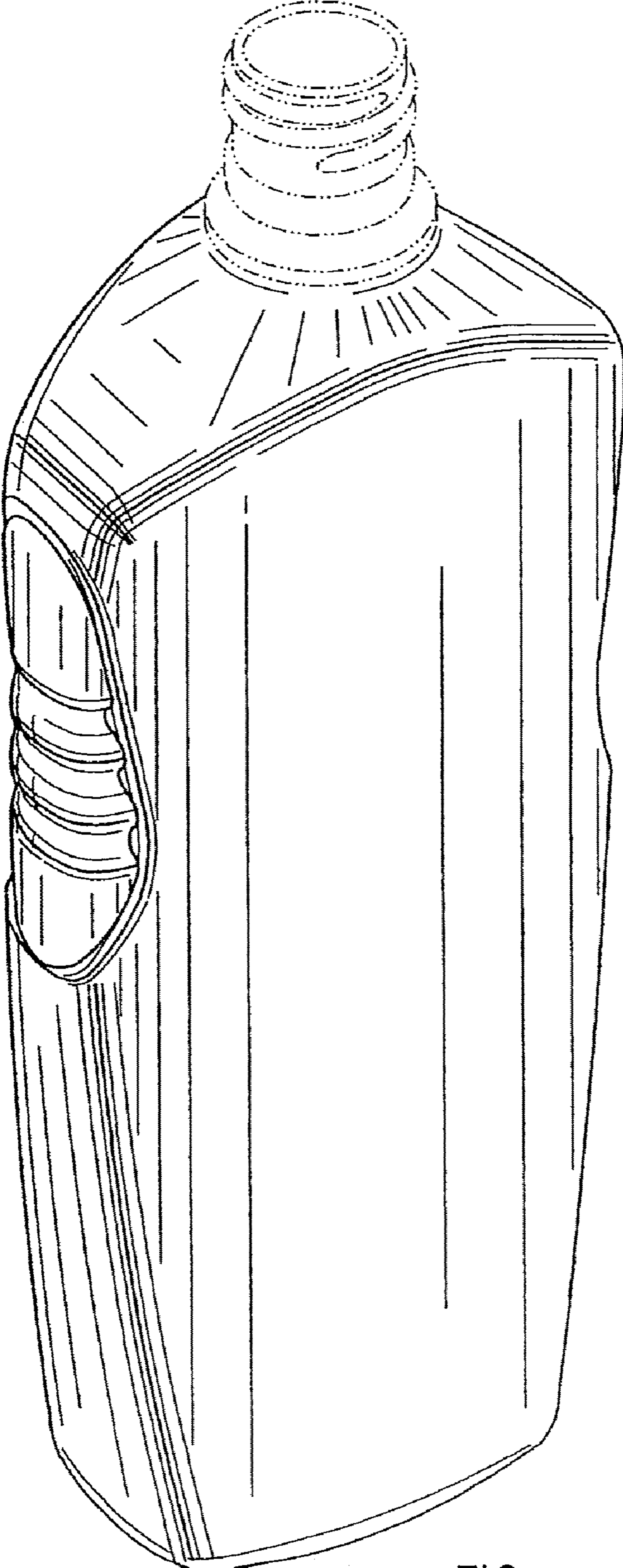

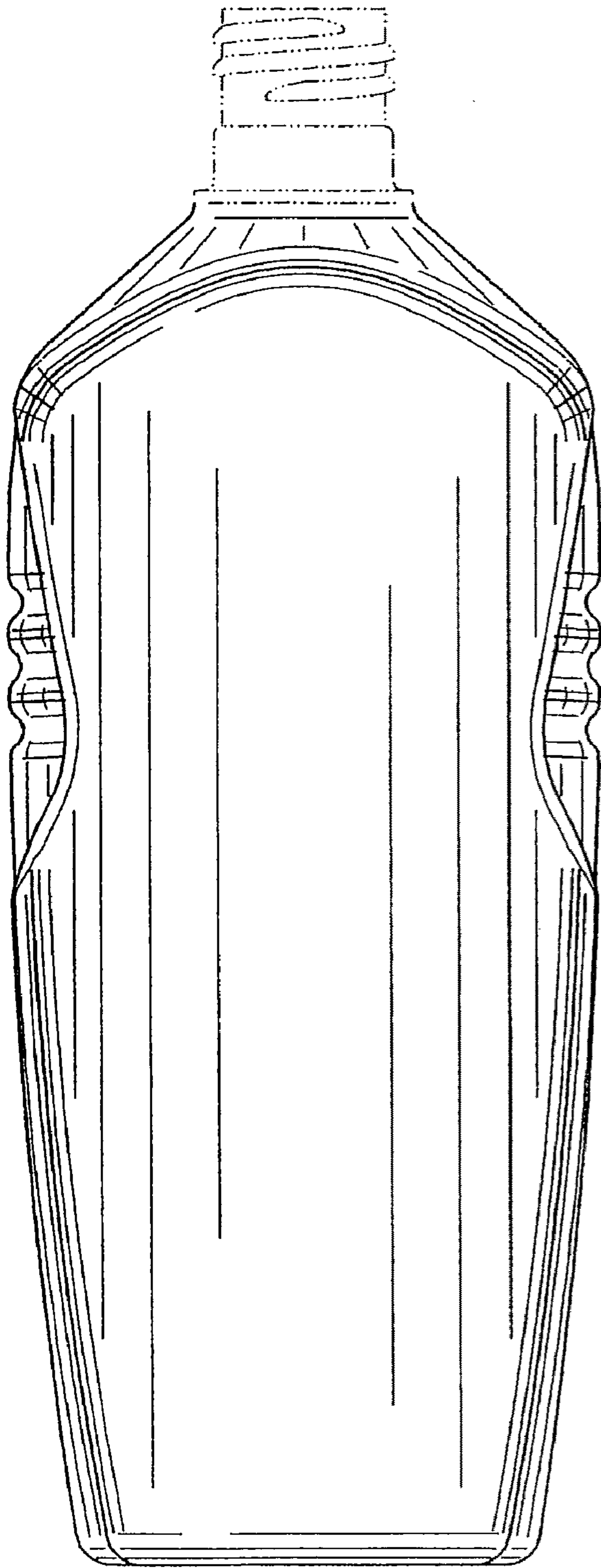

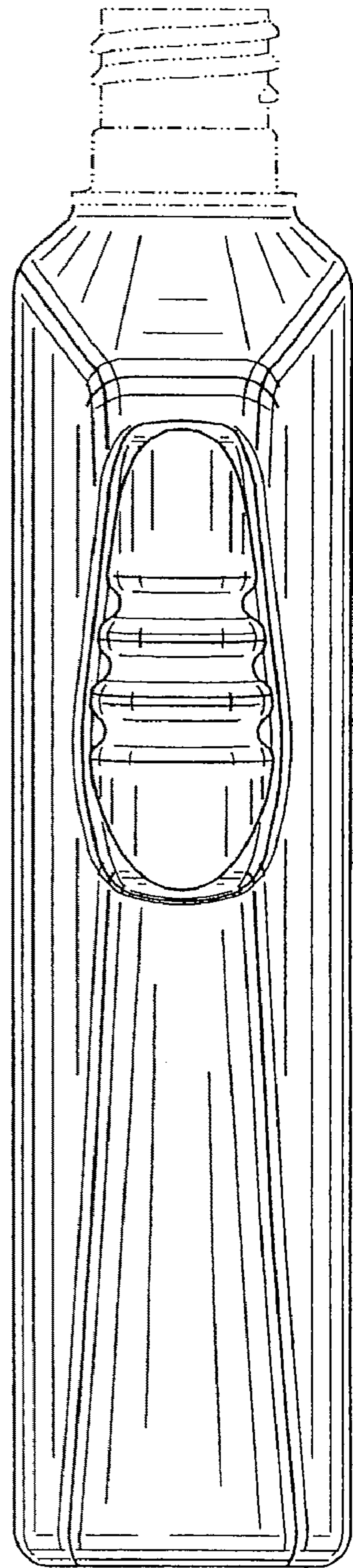

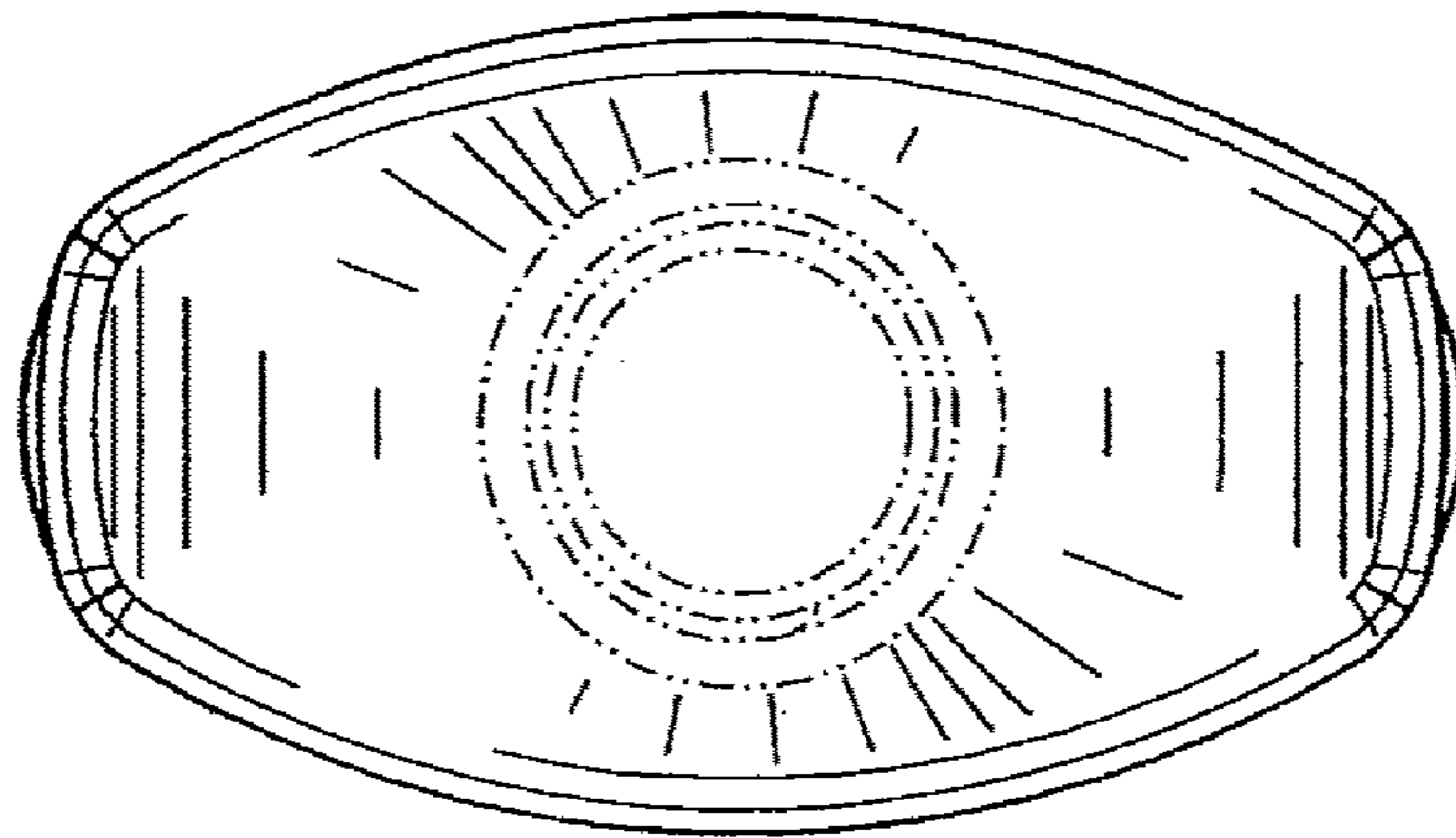

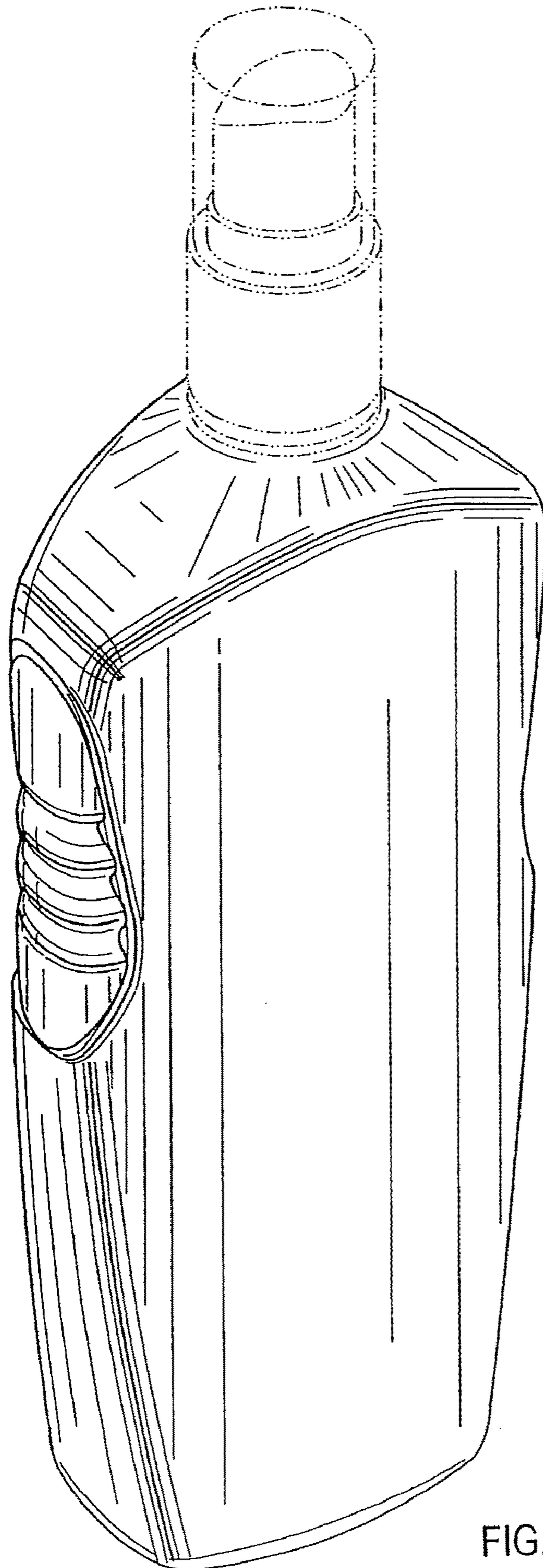
