FIG. 8 is an elevation view of the rear thereof;

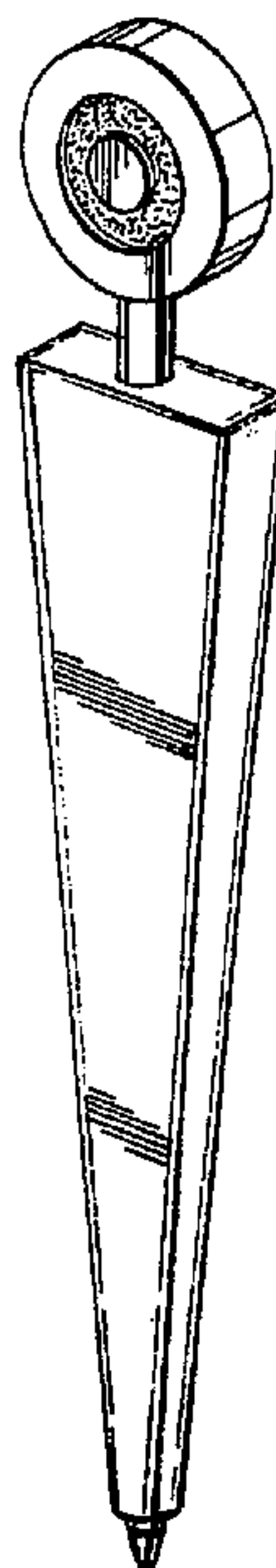
FIG. 9 is an elevation view of one side, the other side being

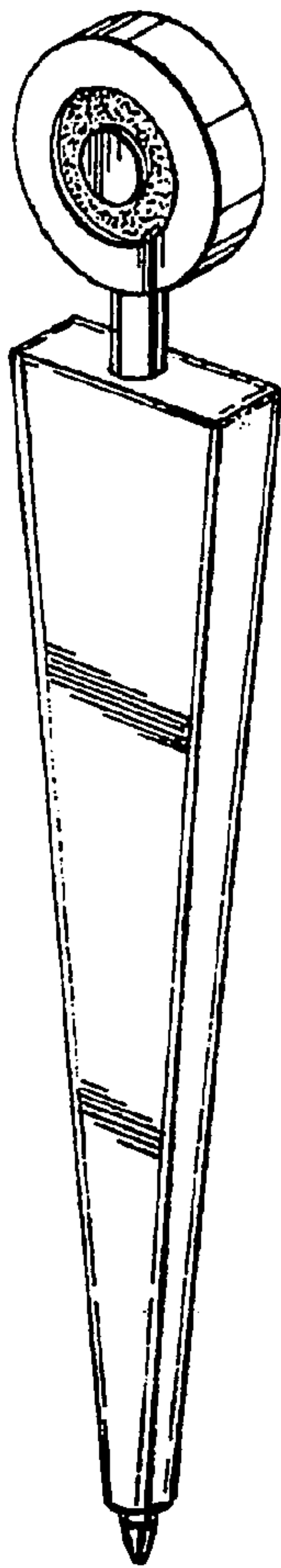

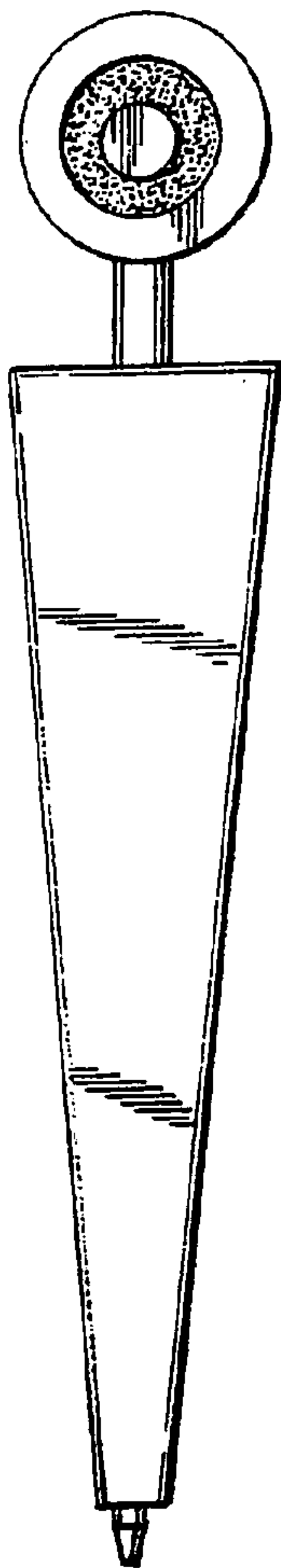

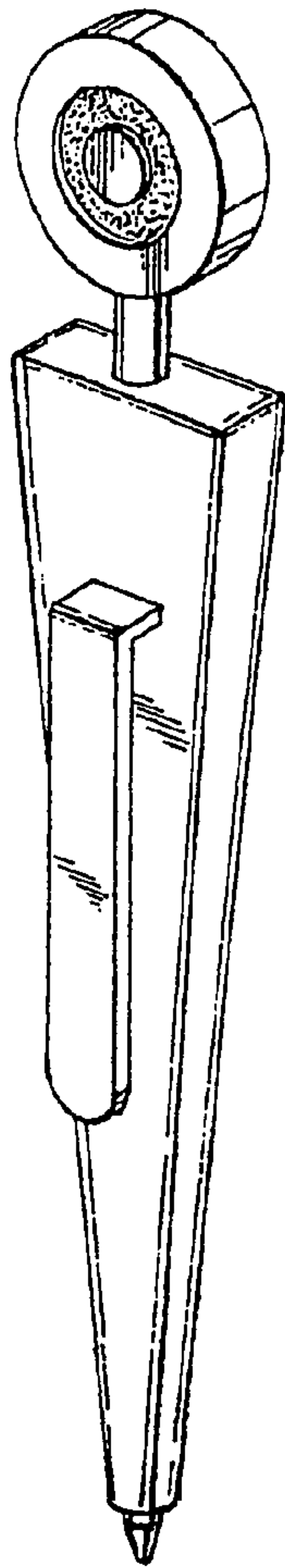

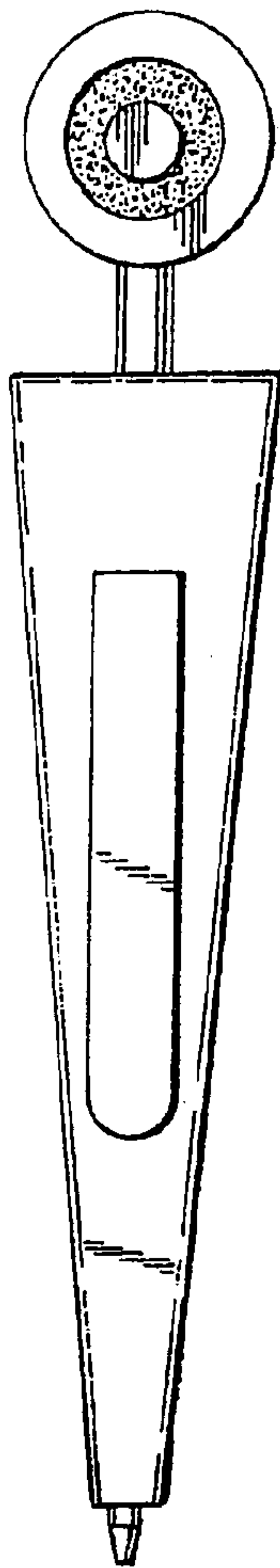

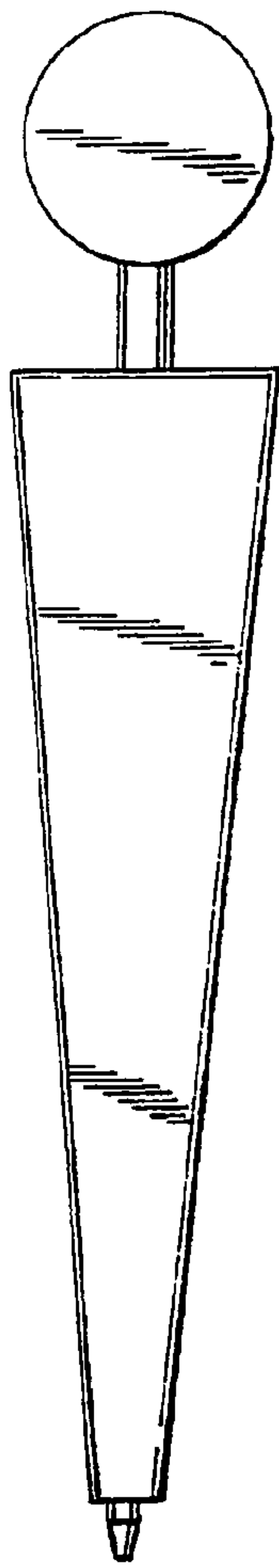

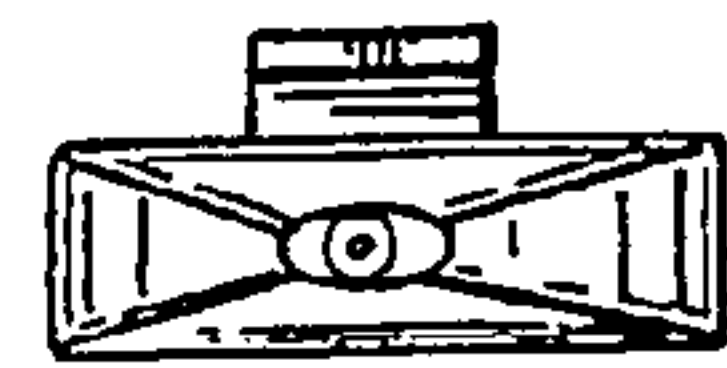

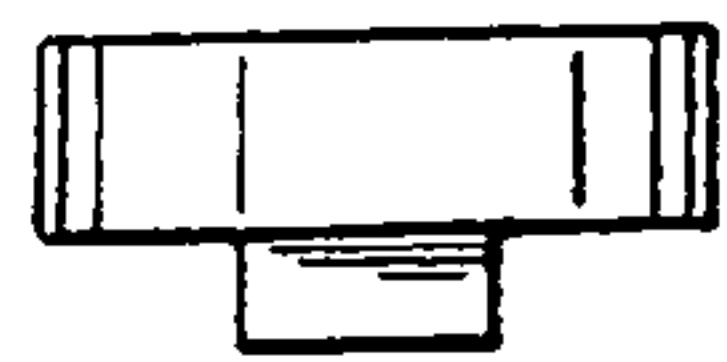
