(57)**CLAIM**


The ornamental design of a clothing hanger accessory with clothing wear indicators, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view, taken from the front, of a clothing hanger accessory with clothing wear indicators, in accordance with my new design;
- FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the clothing hanger accessory with clothing wear indicators of FIG. 1;
- FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the clothing hanger accessory with clothing wear indicators of FIG. 1;
- FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the clothing hanger accessory with clothing wear indicators of FIG. 1;
- FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the clothing hanger accessory with clothing wear indicators of FIG. 1;
- FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the clothing hanger accessory with clothing wear indicators of FIG. 1; and,
- FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the clothing hanger accessory with clothing wear indicators of FIG. 1.

The broken lines shown on the neck of the clothing hanger accessory are meant to indicate perforation, while the broken lines shown on the clothing wear indicators are meant to represent areas at which the article can be folded.








