CLAIM (57)

The ornamental design for a bench, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is a bench such as can be used to support a seated person.

FIG. 1 is a right, top, front perspective view of a bench embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the front view shown;


FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the right side shown; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.







