(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a cleaning apparatus, as shown and described in FIGS. 1-6.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

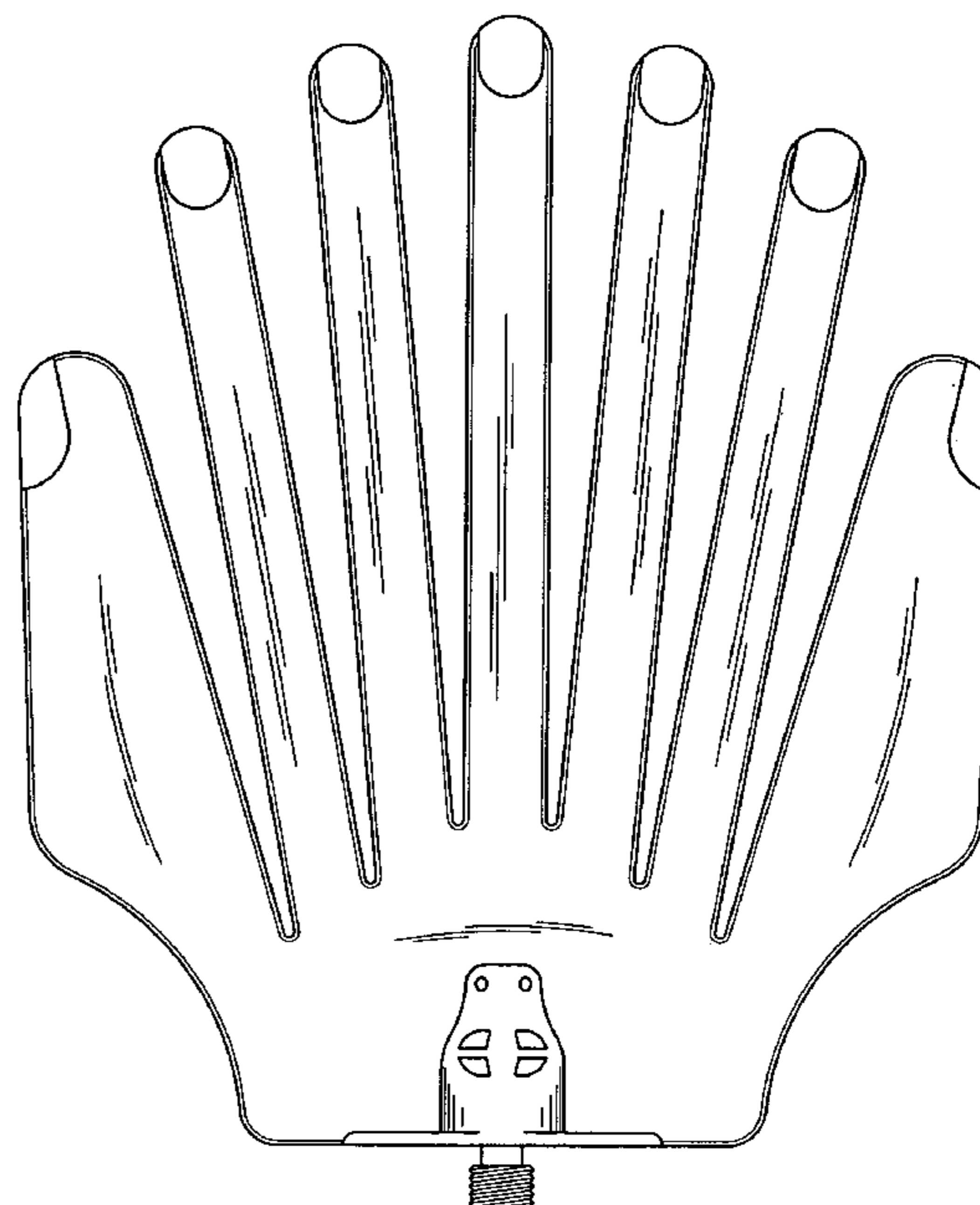
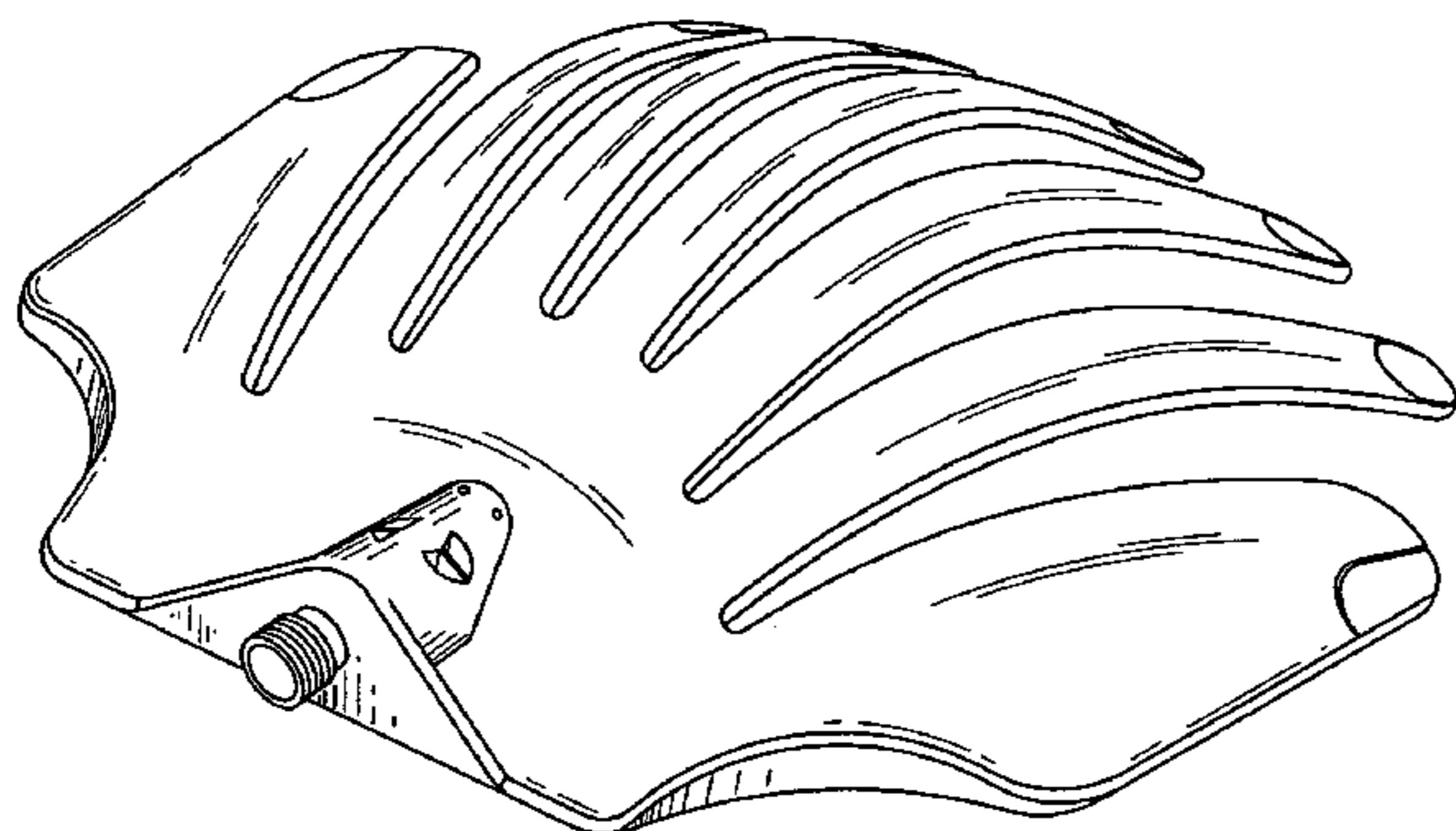
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,

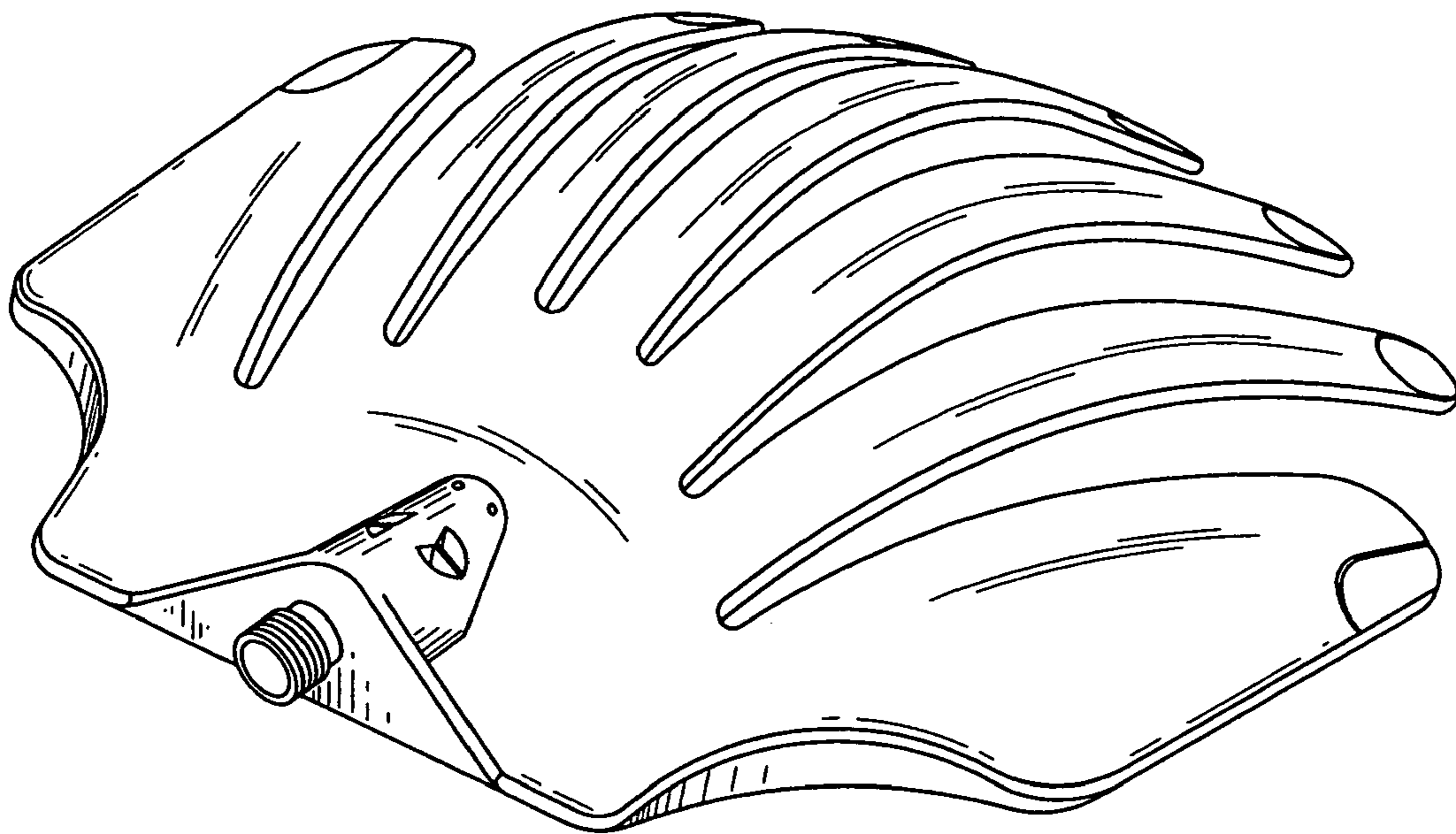

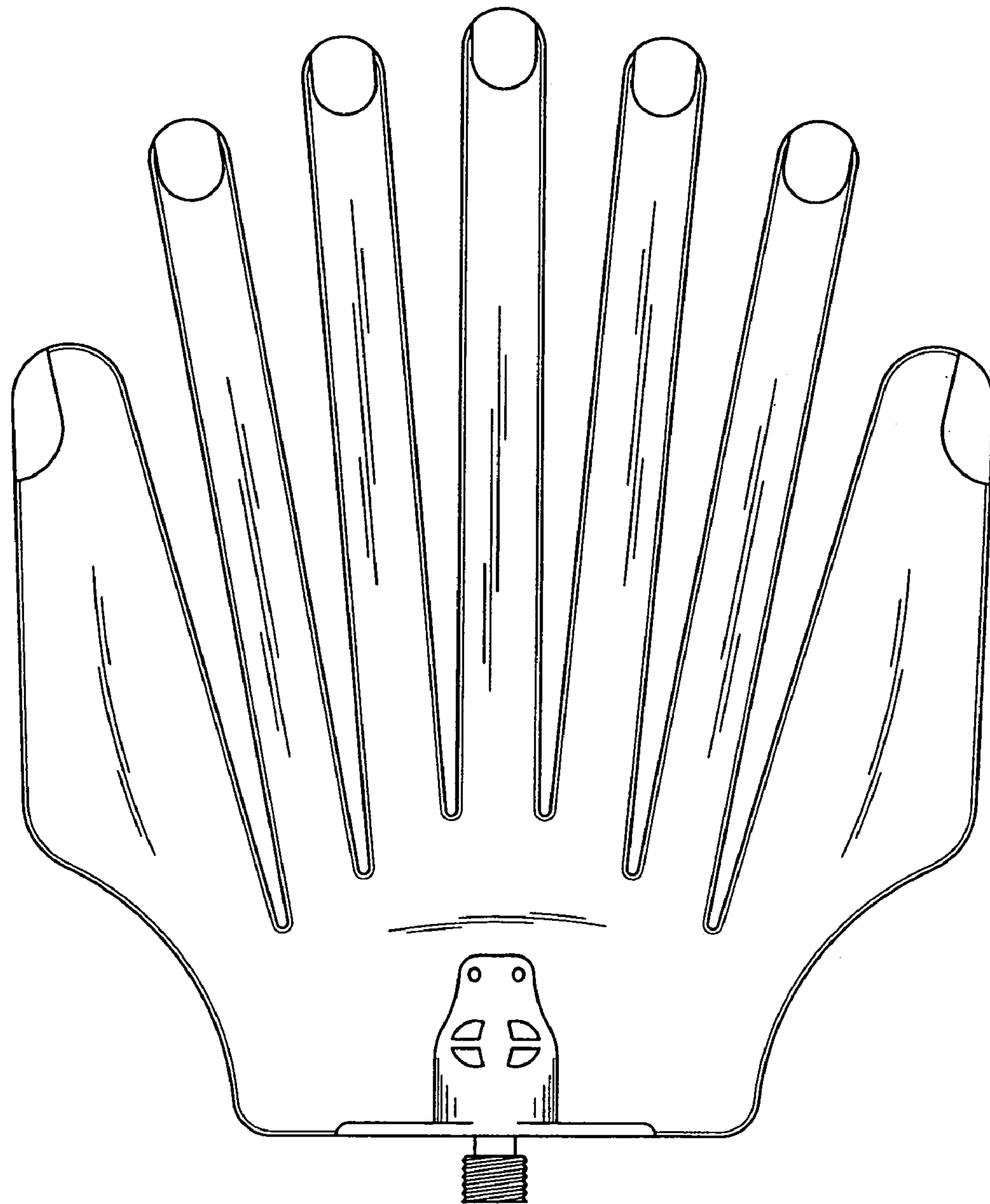

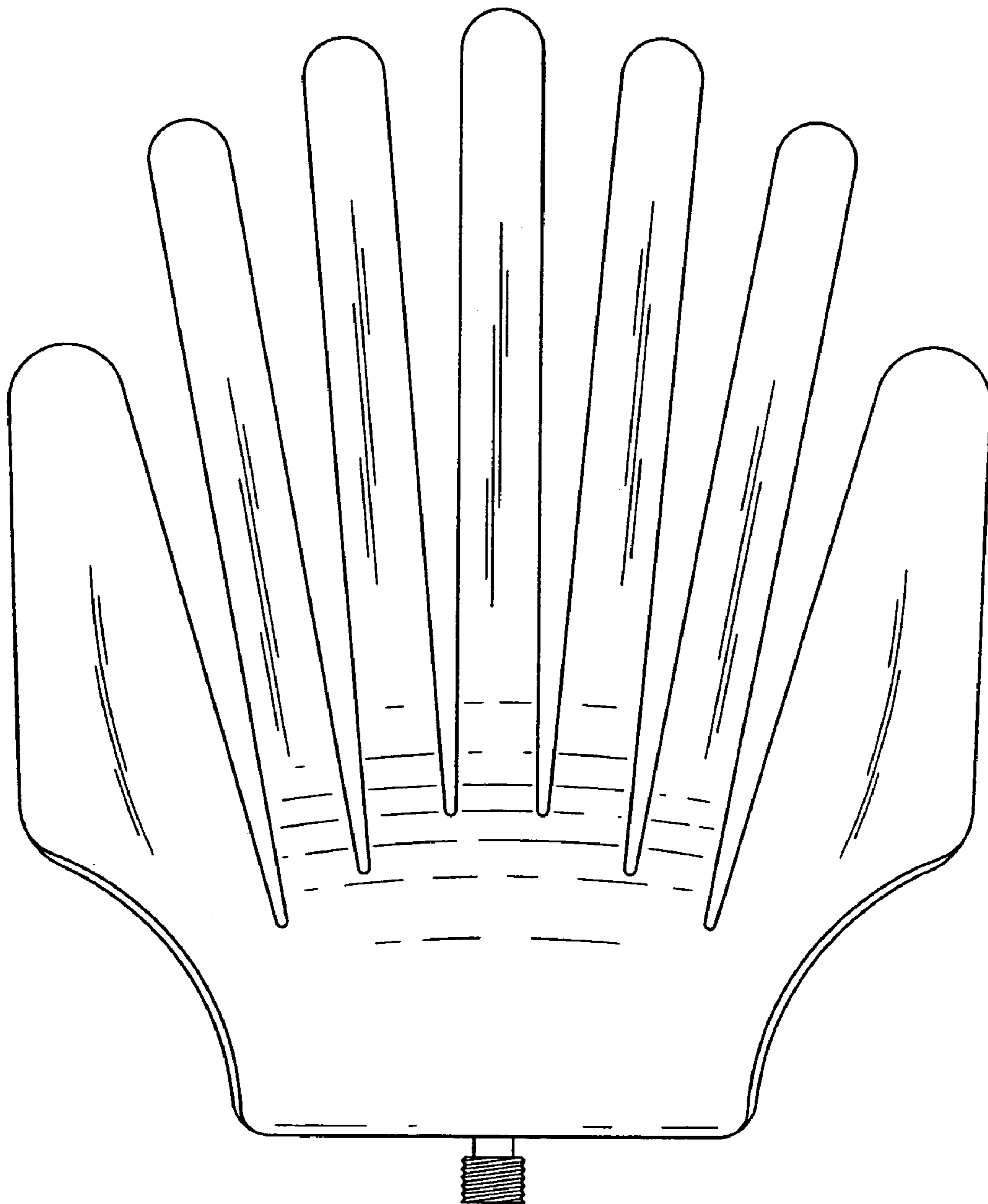

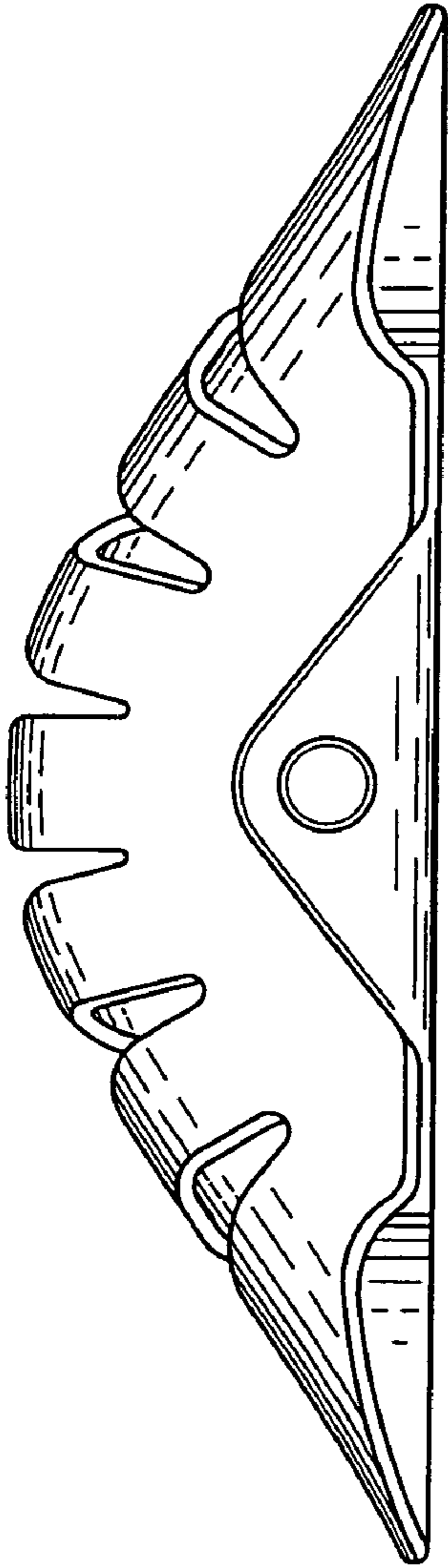

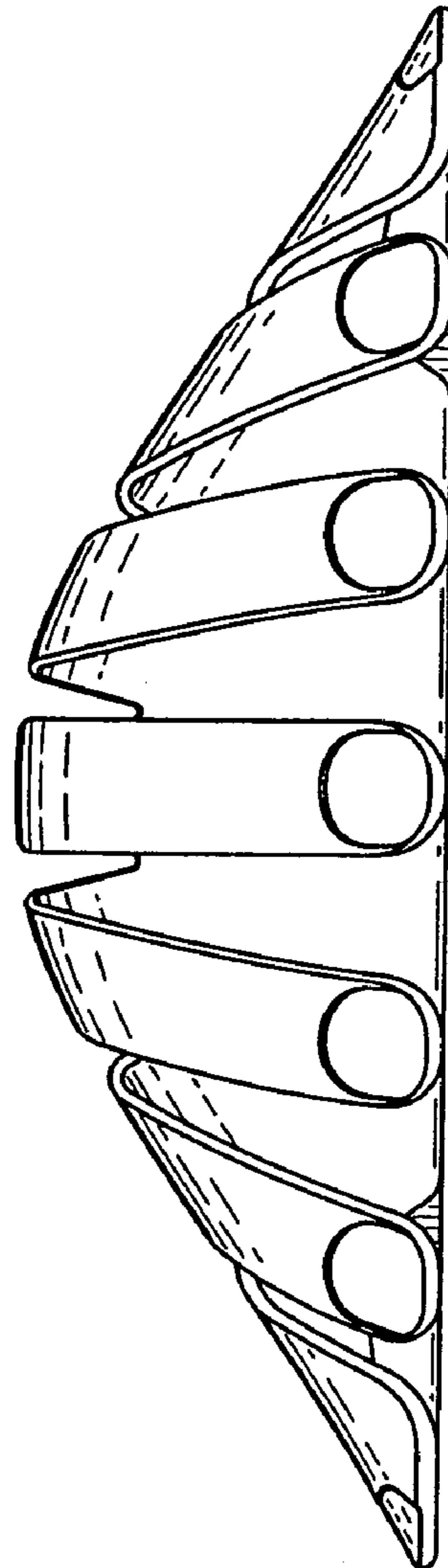

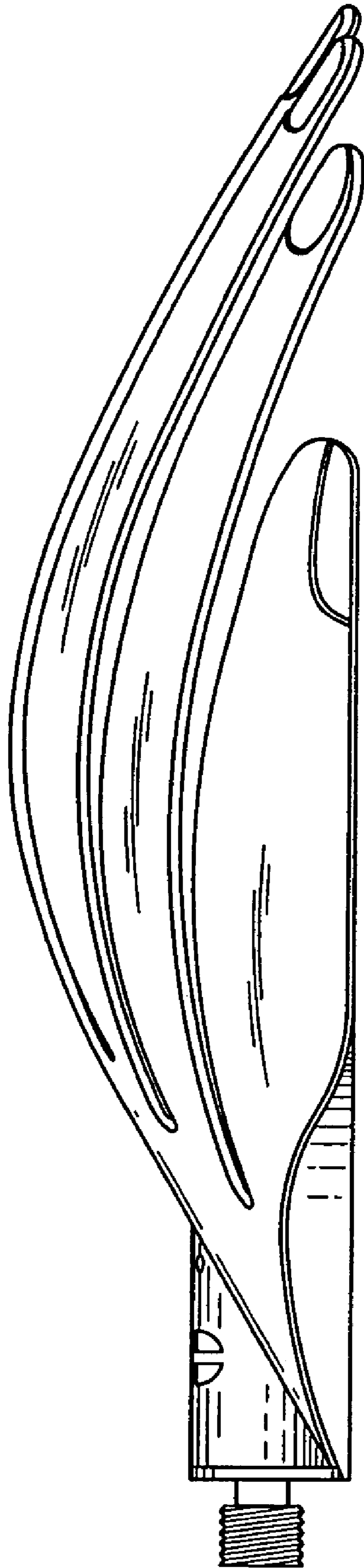
