The ornamental design for a transitional image for a portion of a display screen, as shown and described.

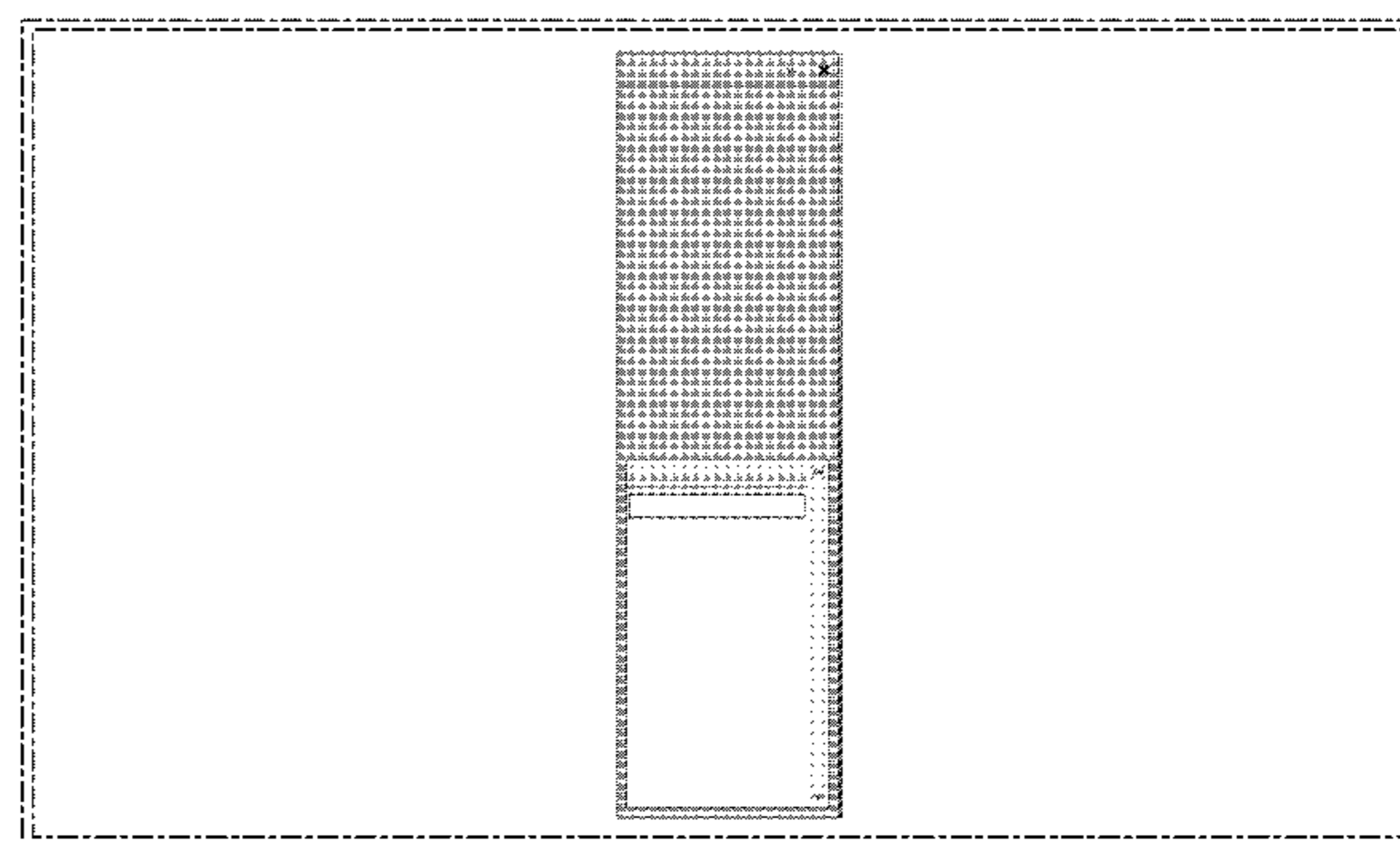
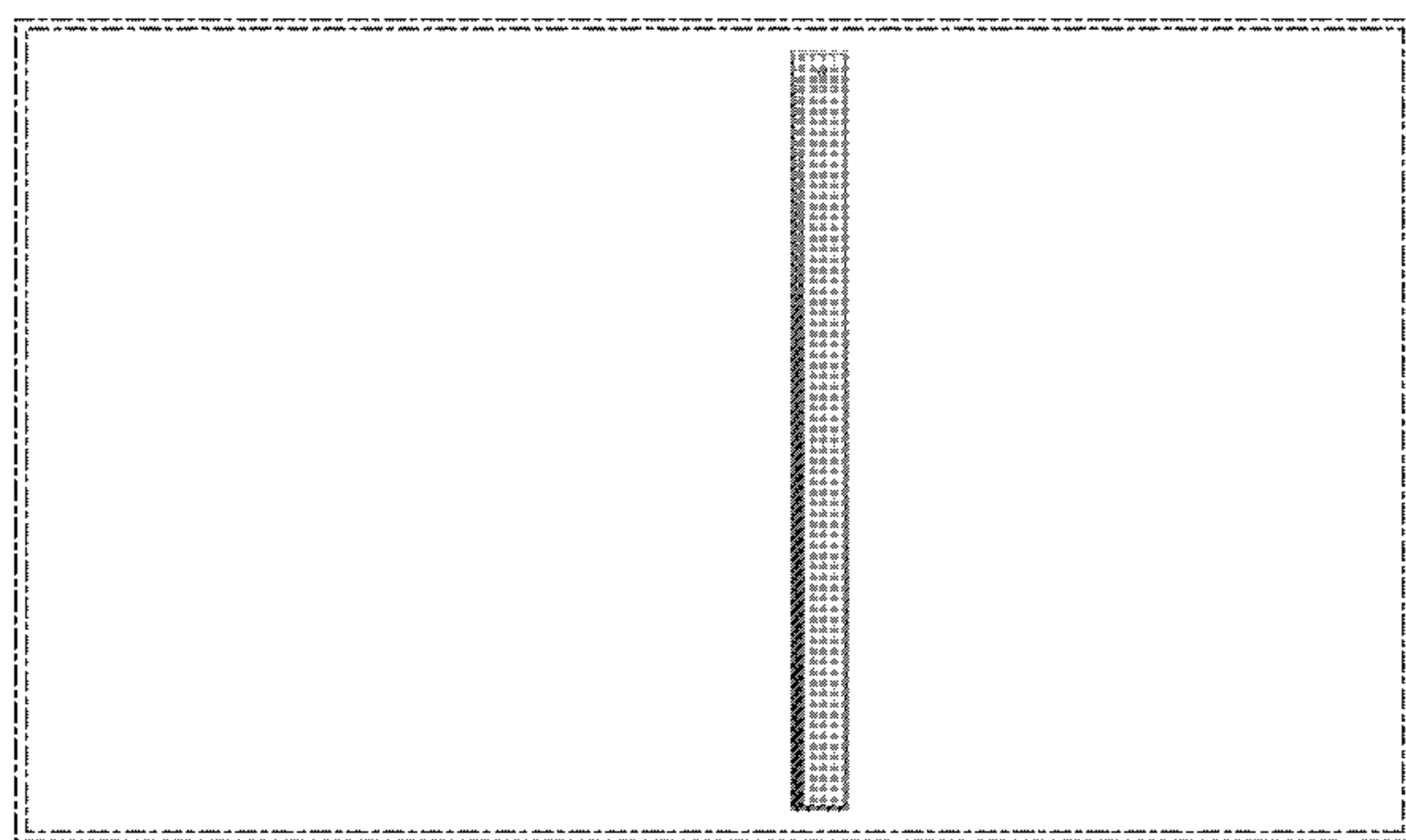
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a the first image of a transitional image for a portion of a display screen showing my new design; and,

FIG. 2 is a front view of the second image thereof.

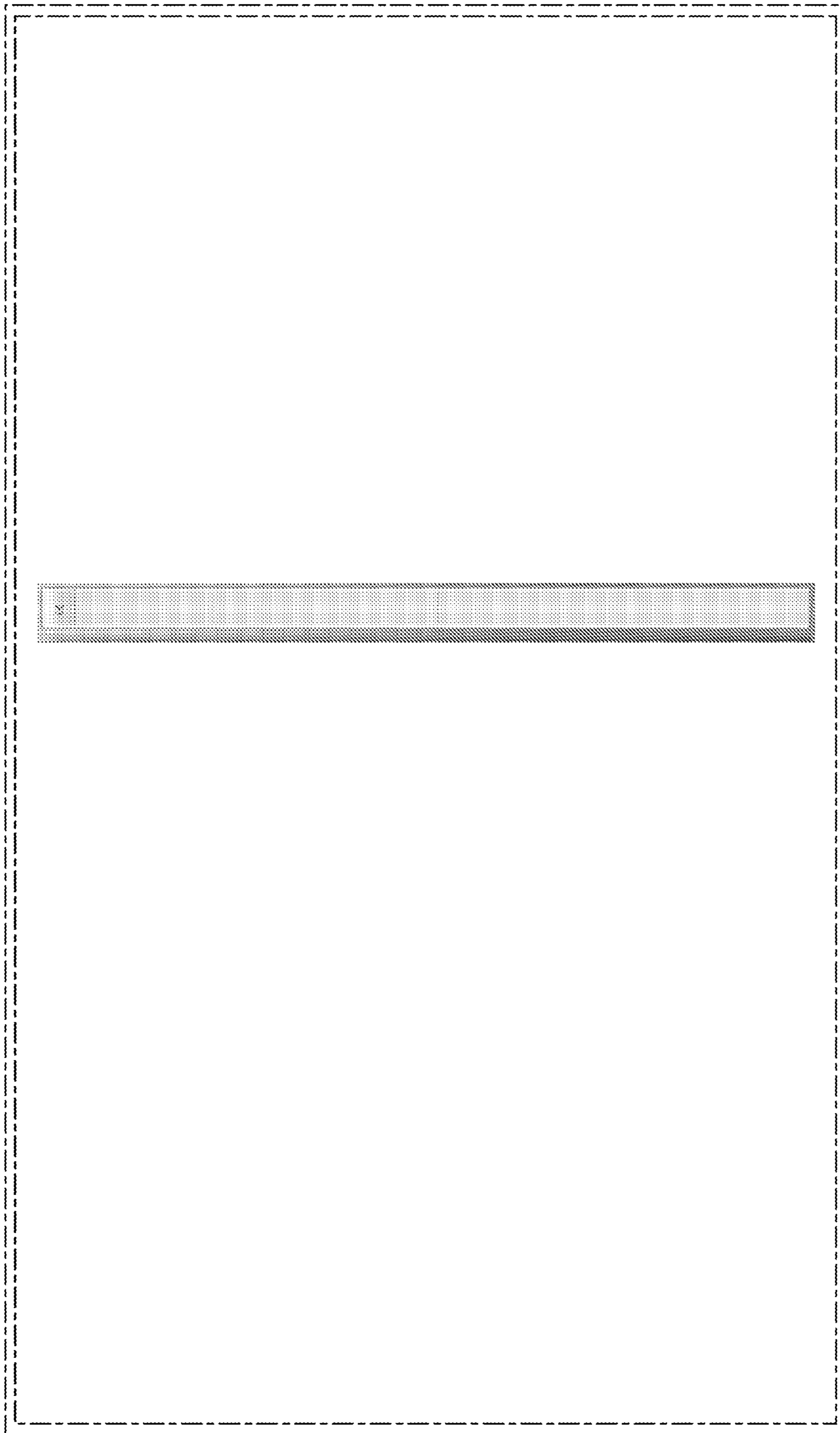

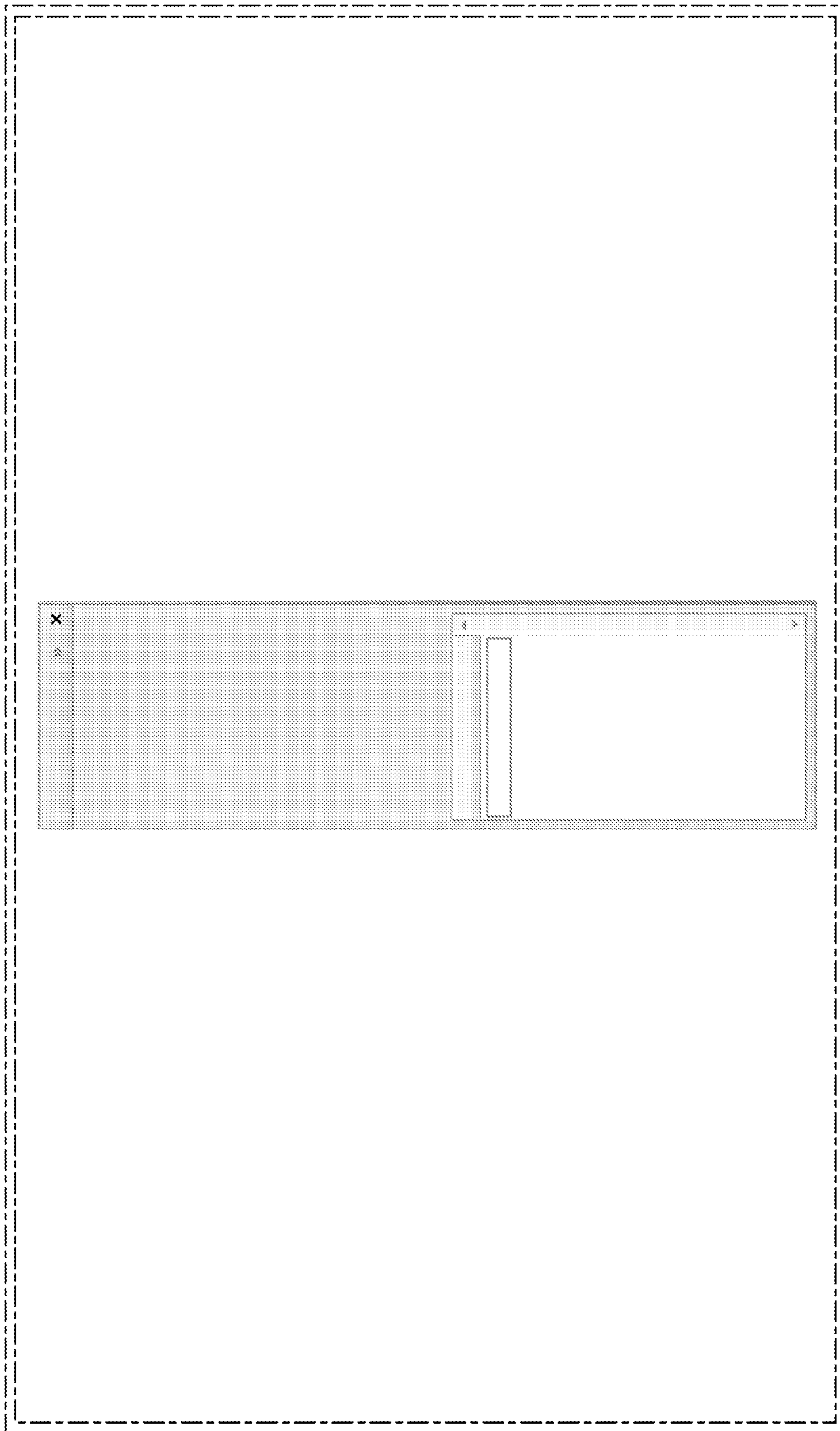
