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(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a magnetic picture phone pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The present design relates to a magnetic pad for holding pictures of friends, relatives, local services and others, and simultaneously displaying related telephone numbers.

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the magnetic picture phone pad of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the magnetic picture phone pad of the present invention.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view from the left side of the magnetic picture phone pad as shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view from the right side of the magnetic picture phone pad as shown in FIG. 1.

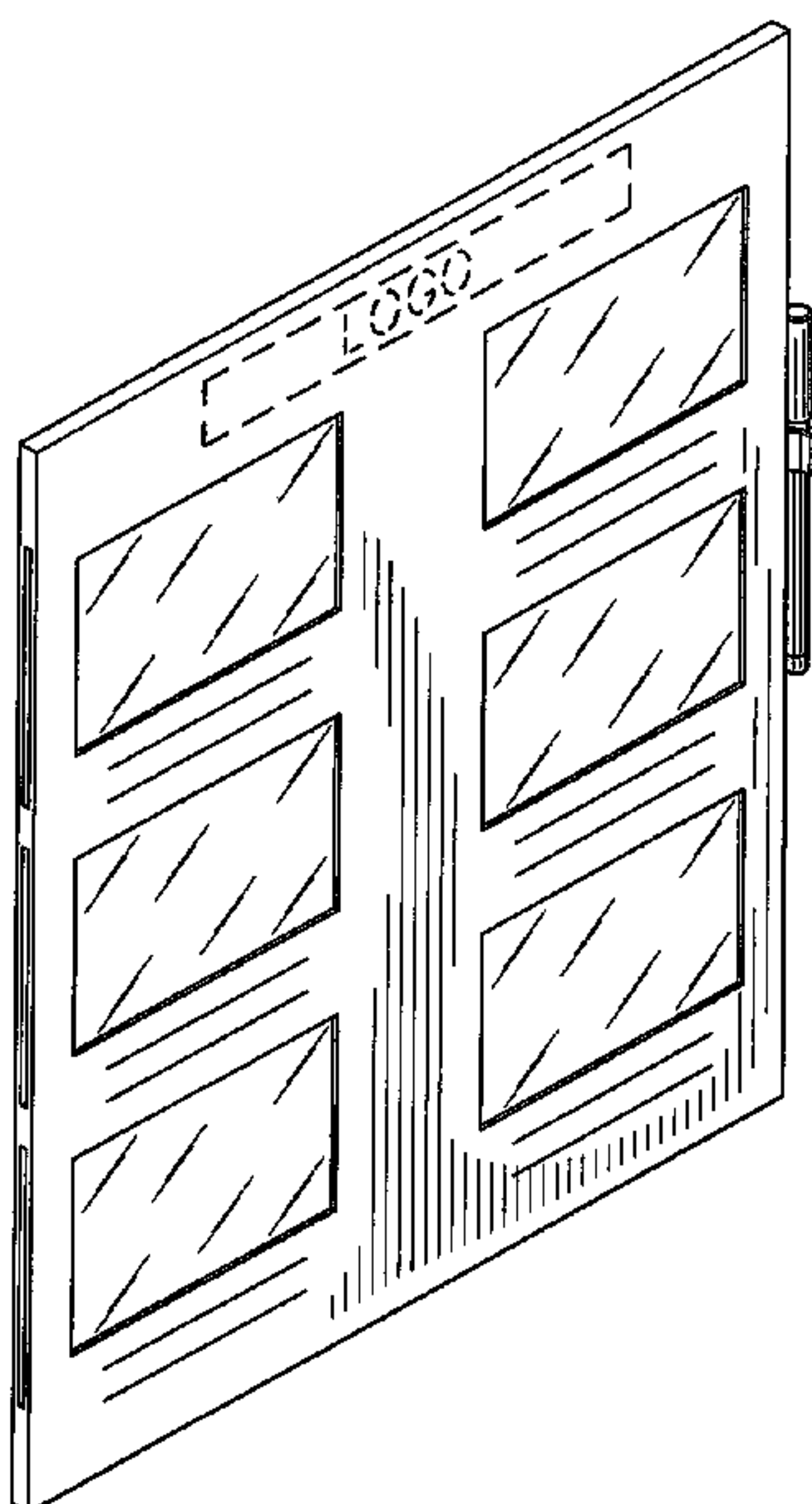
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the magnetic picture phone pad as shown in FIG. 1.

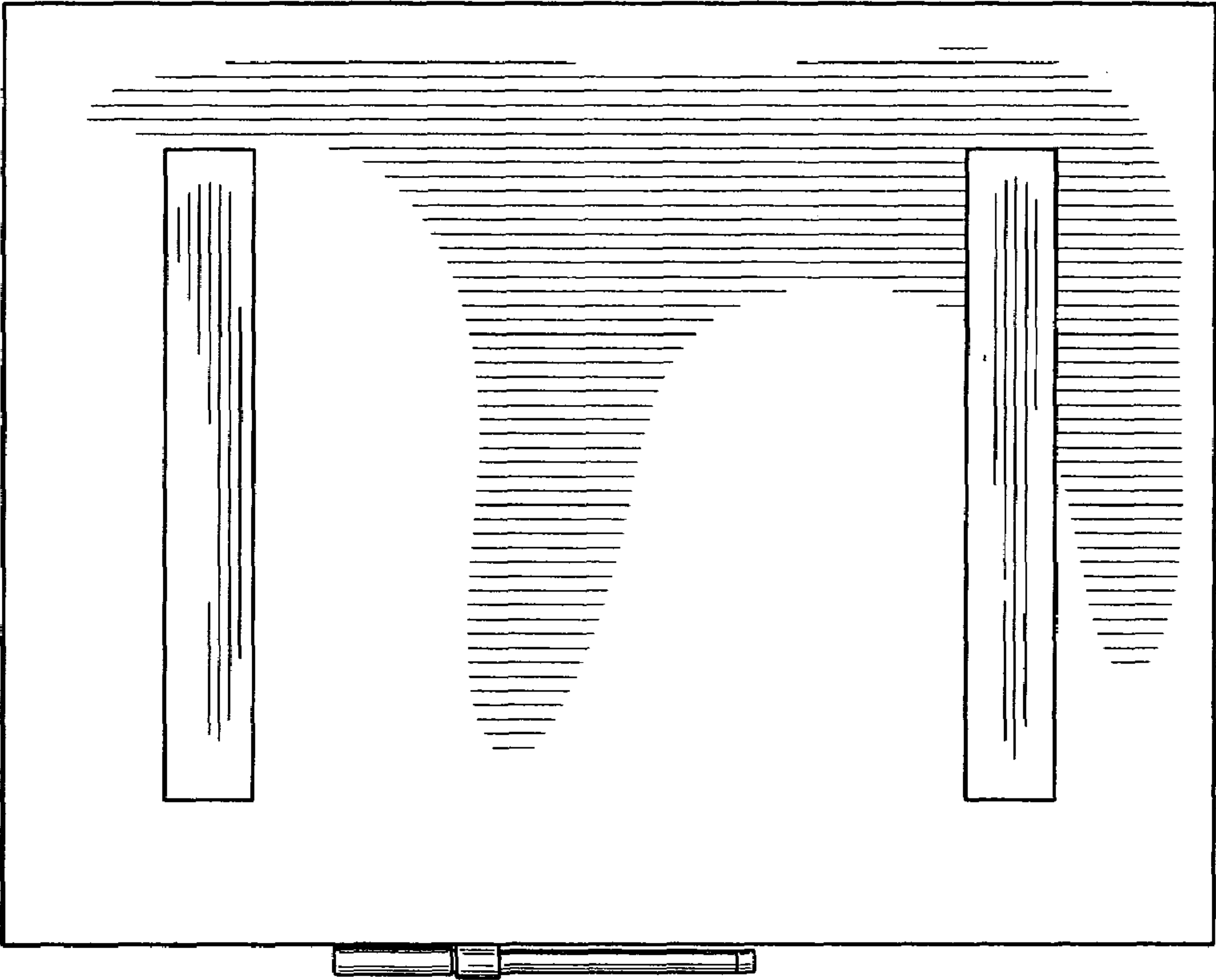

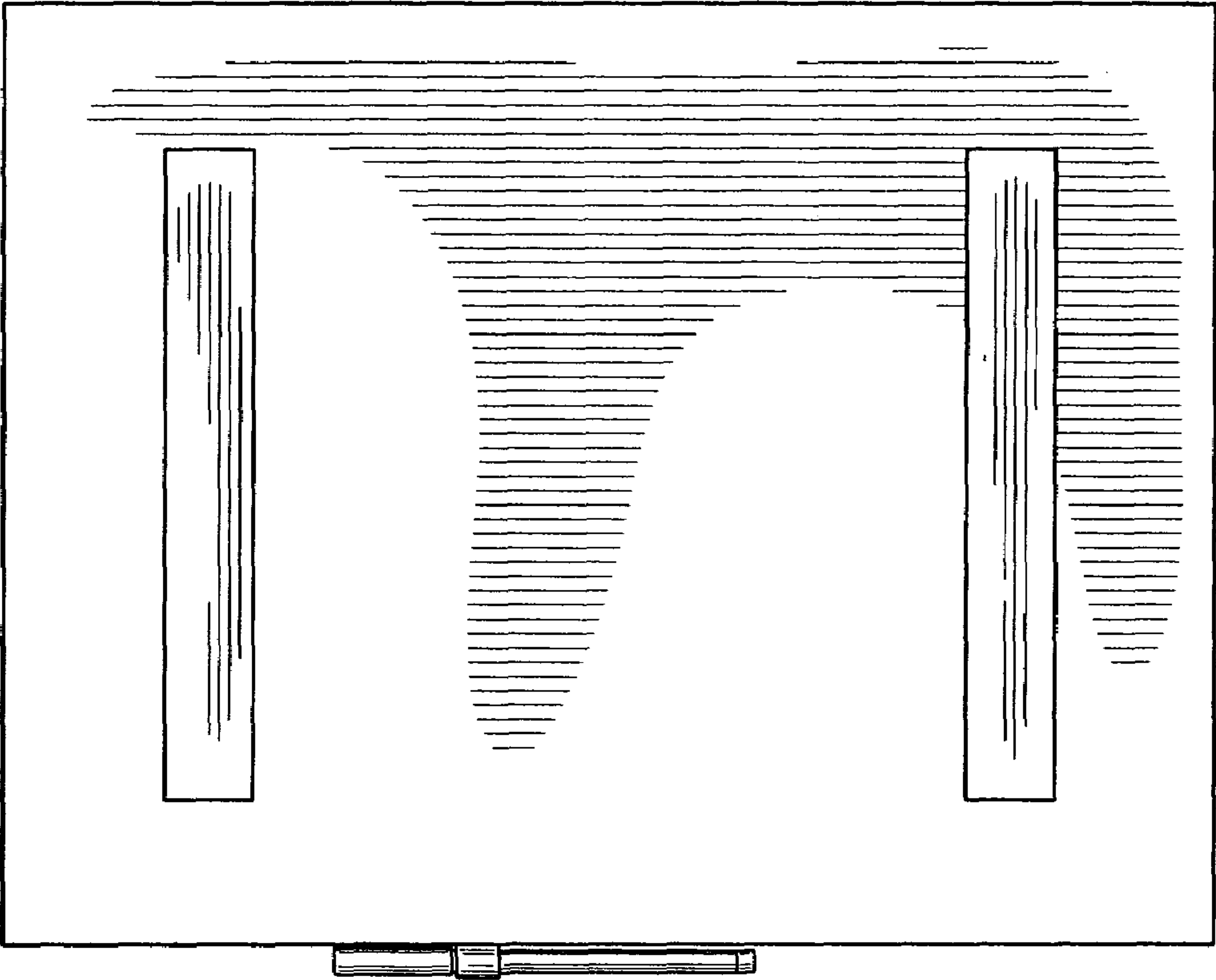

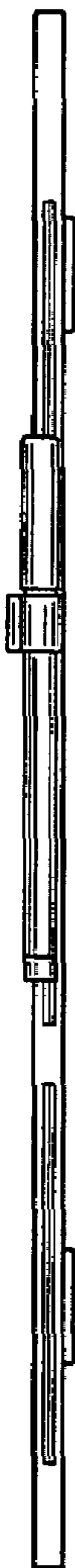

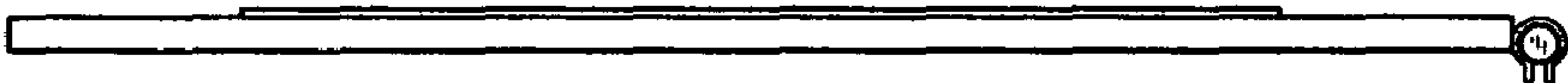

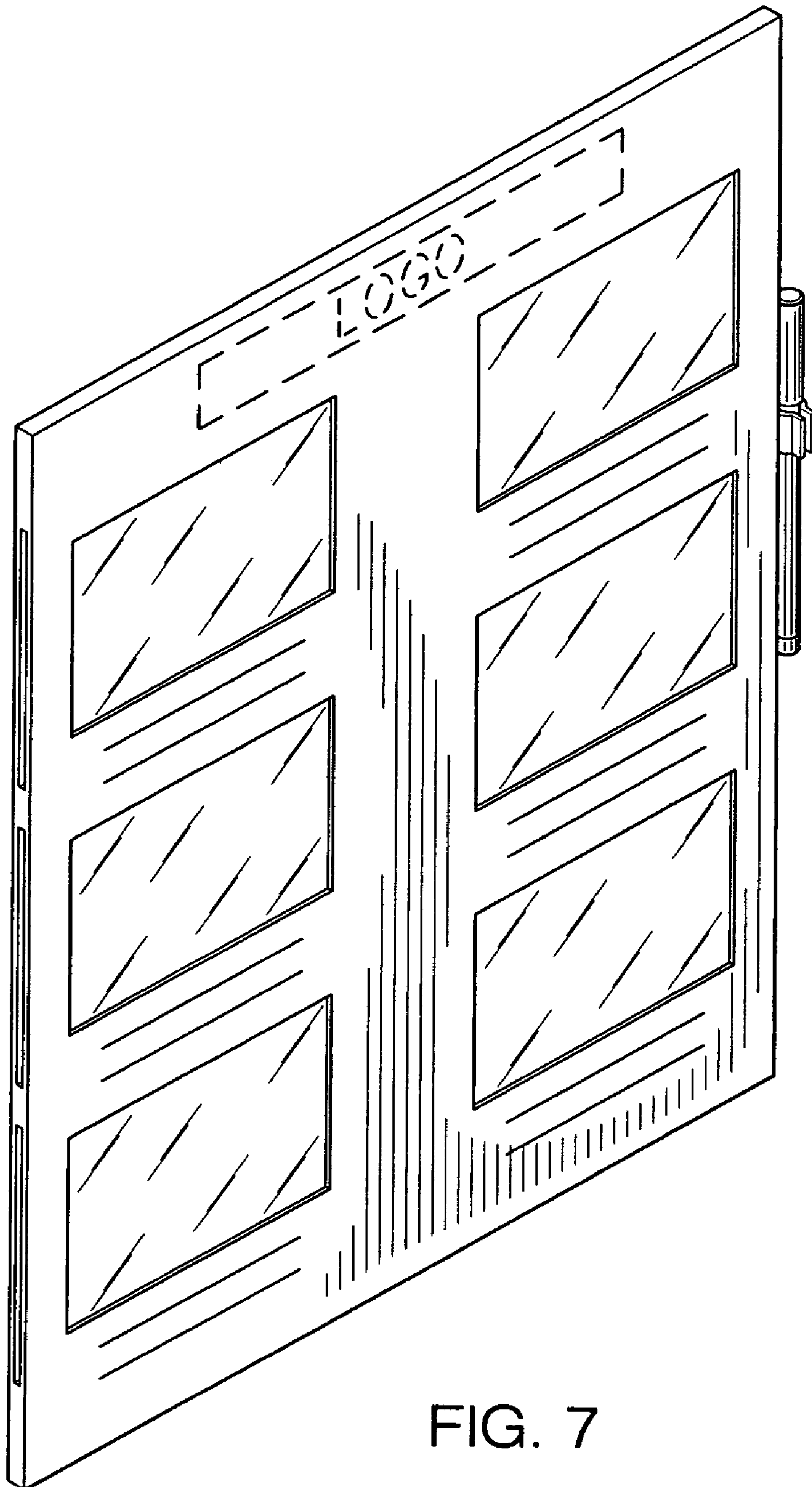
