FIG. 4 is a perspective bottom view thereof;

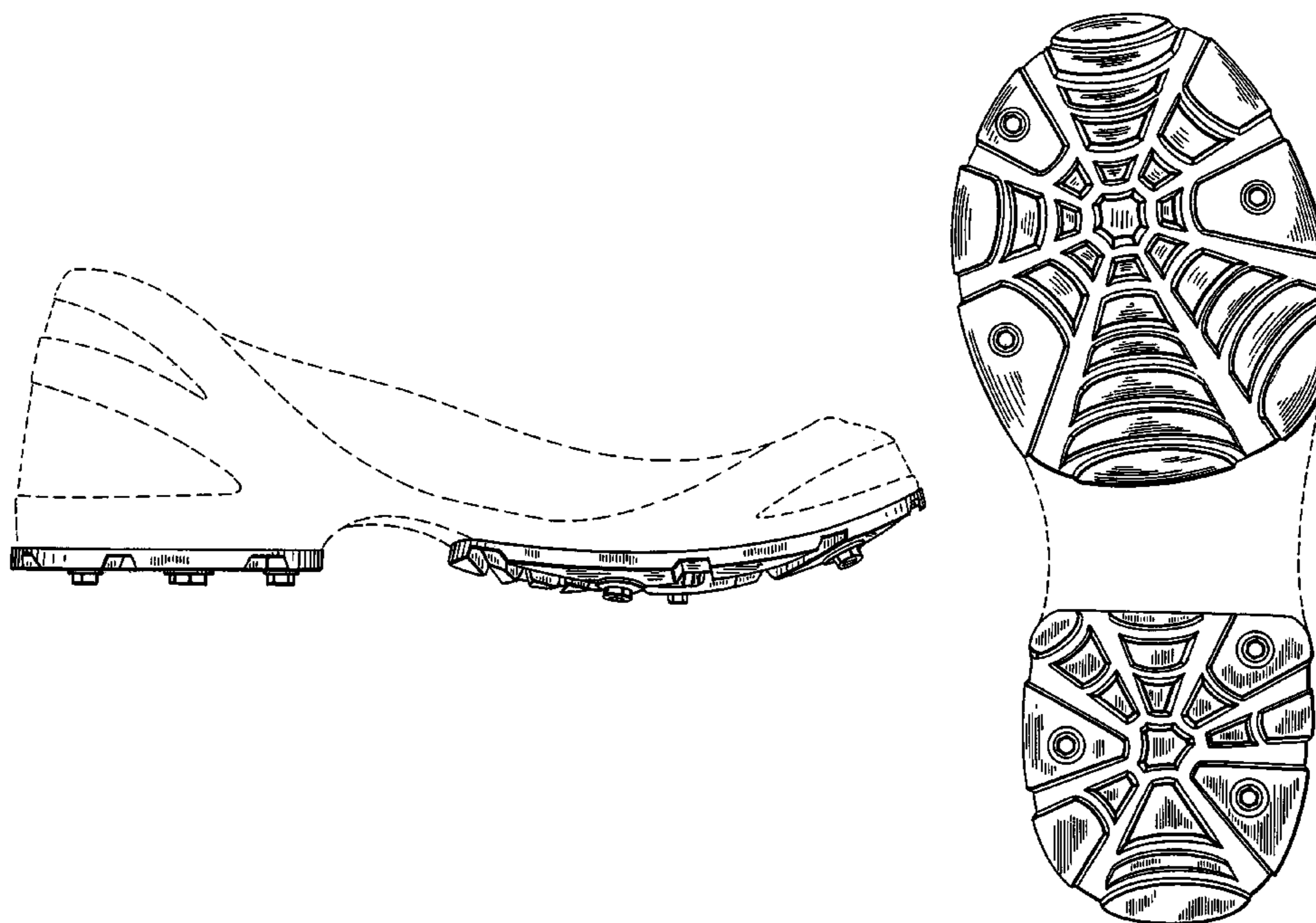
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

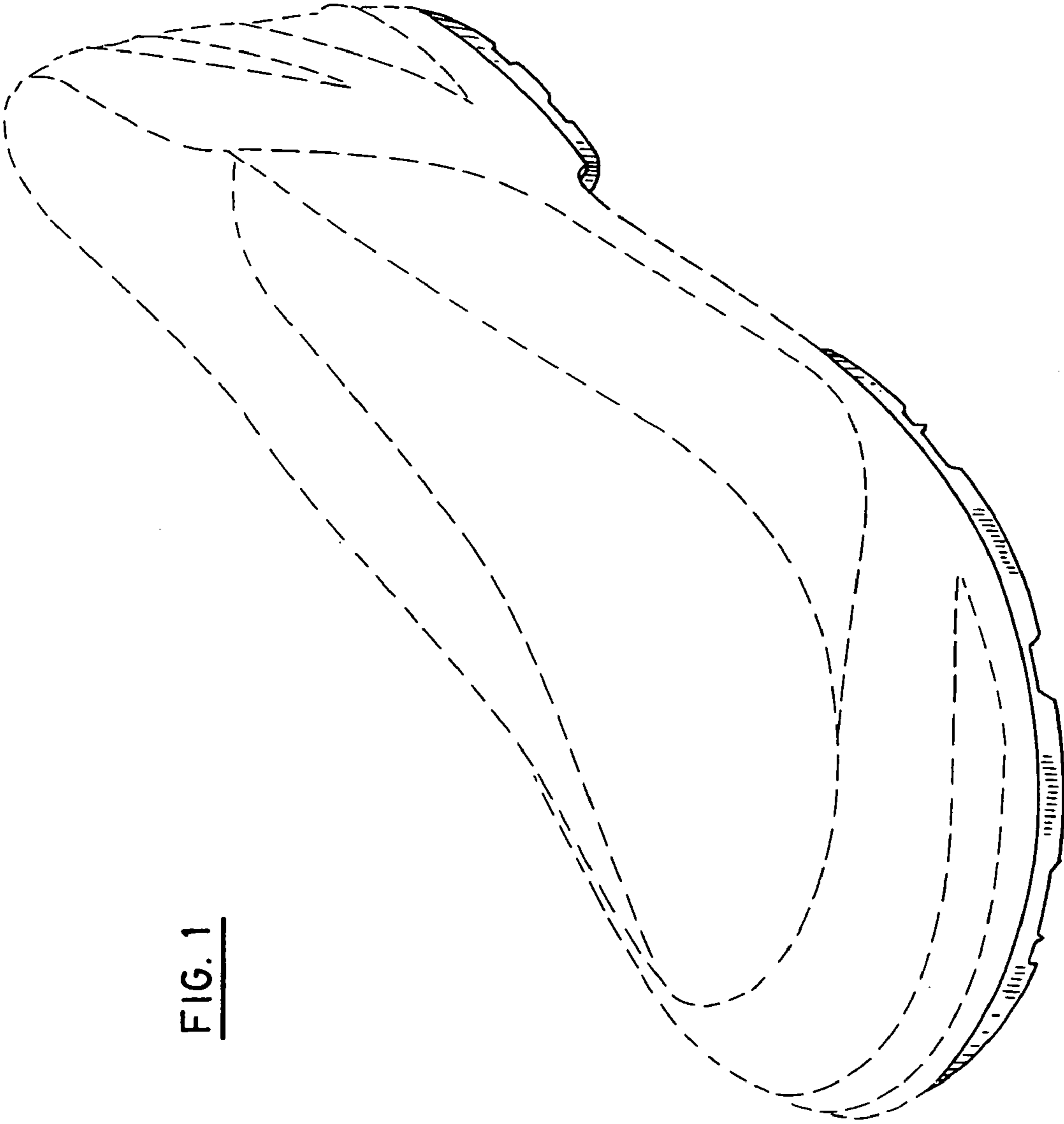

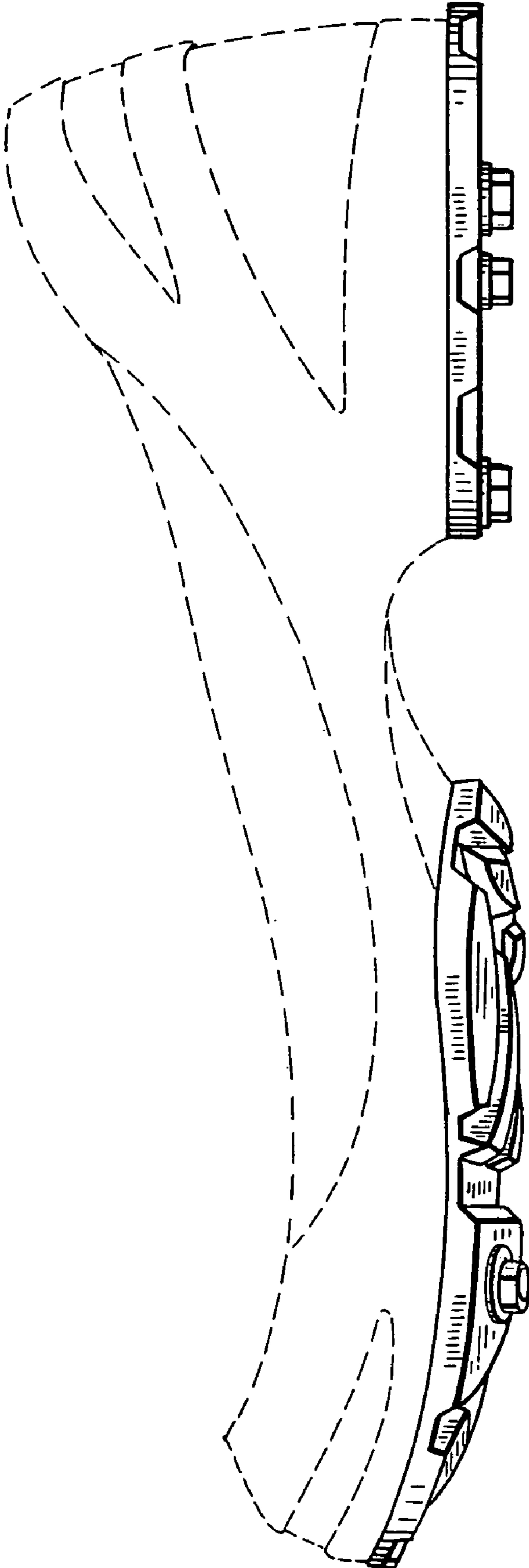

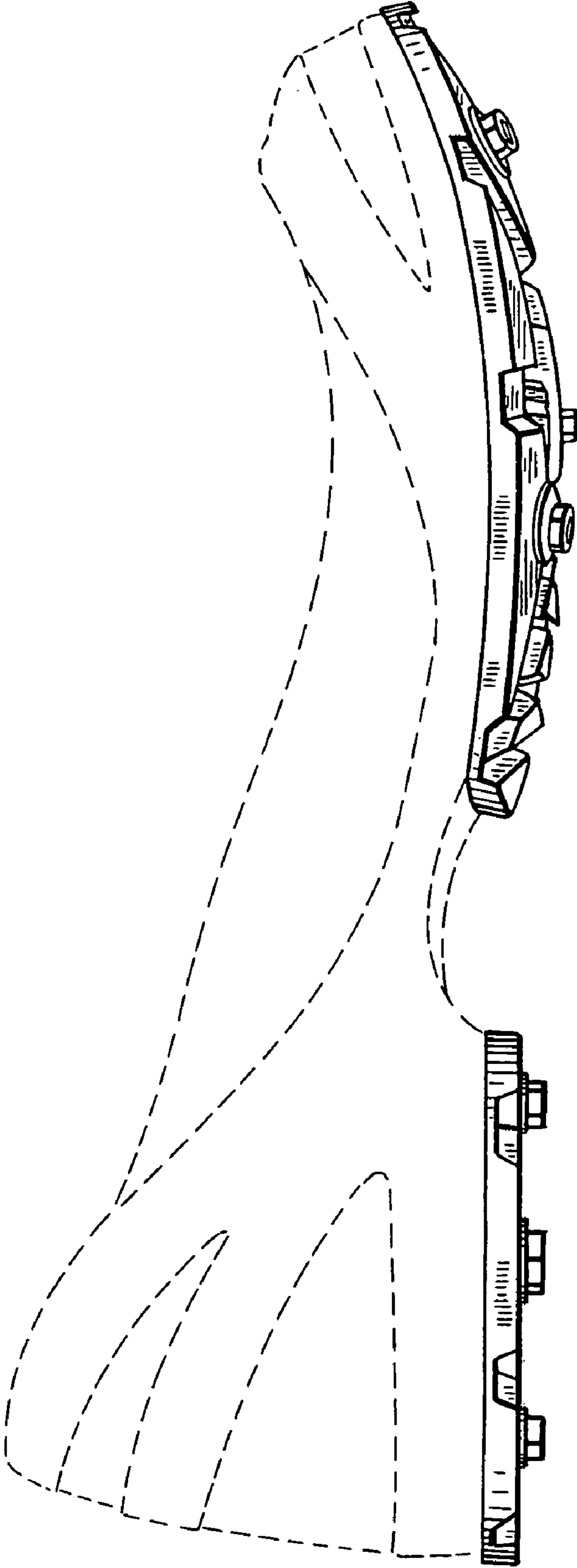

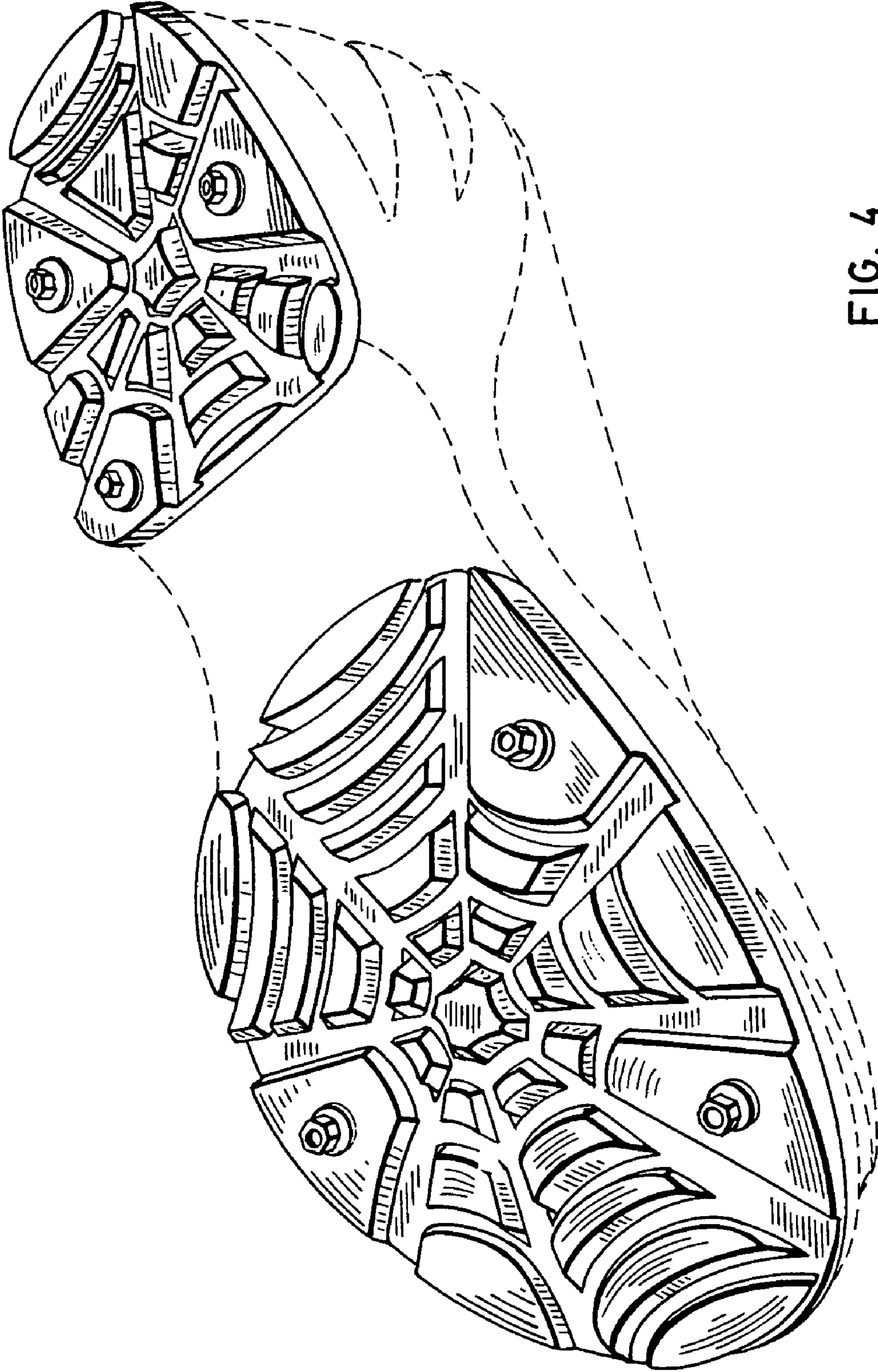

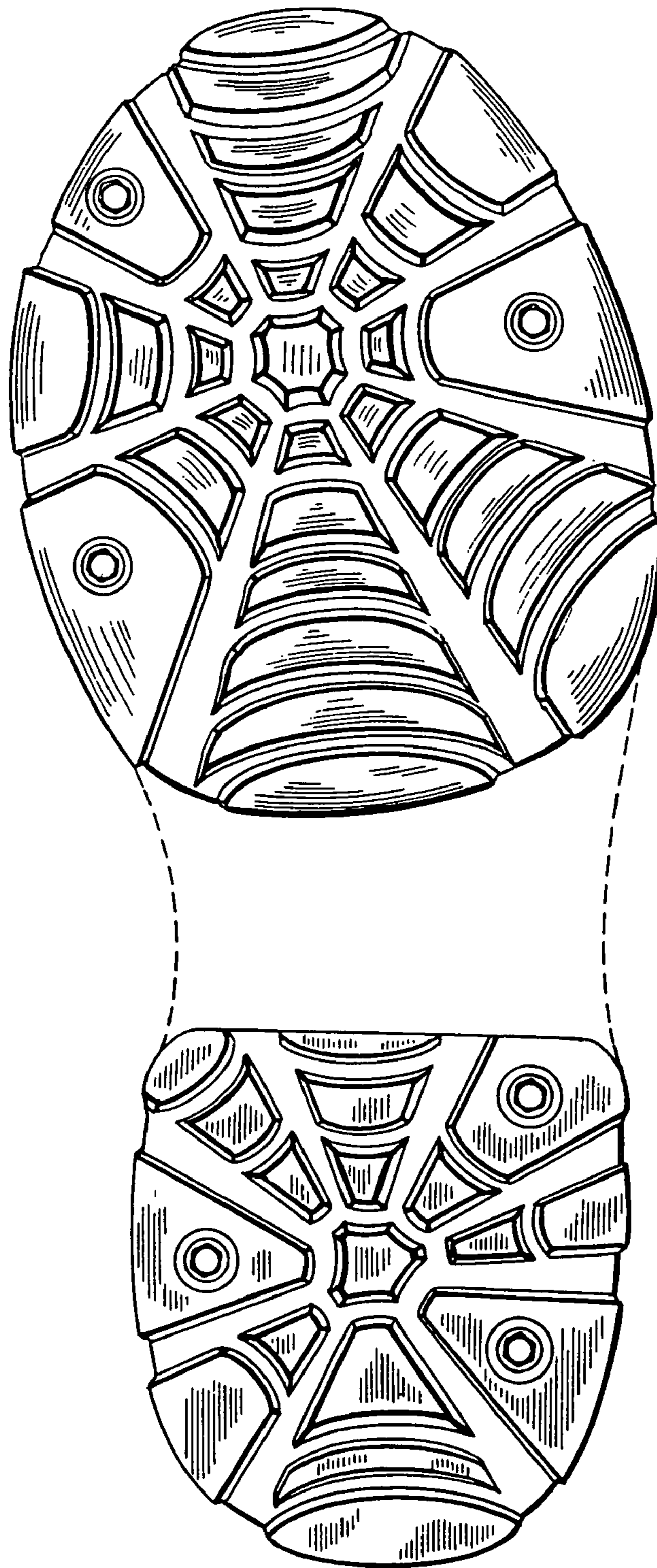

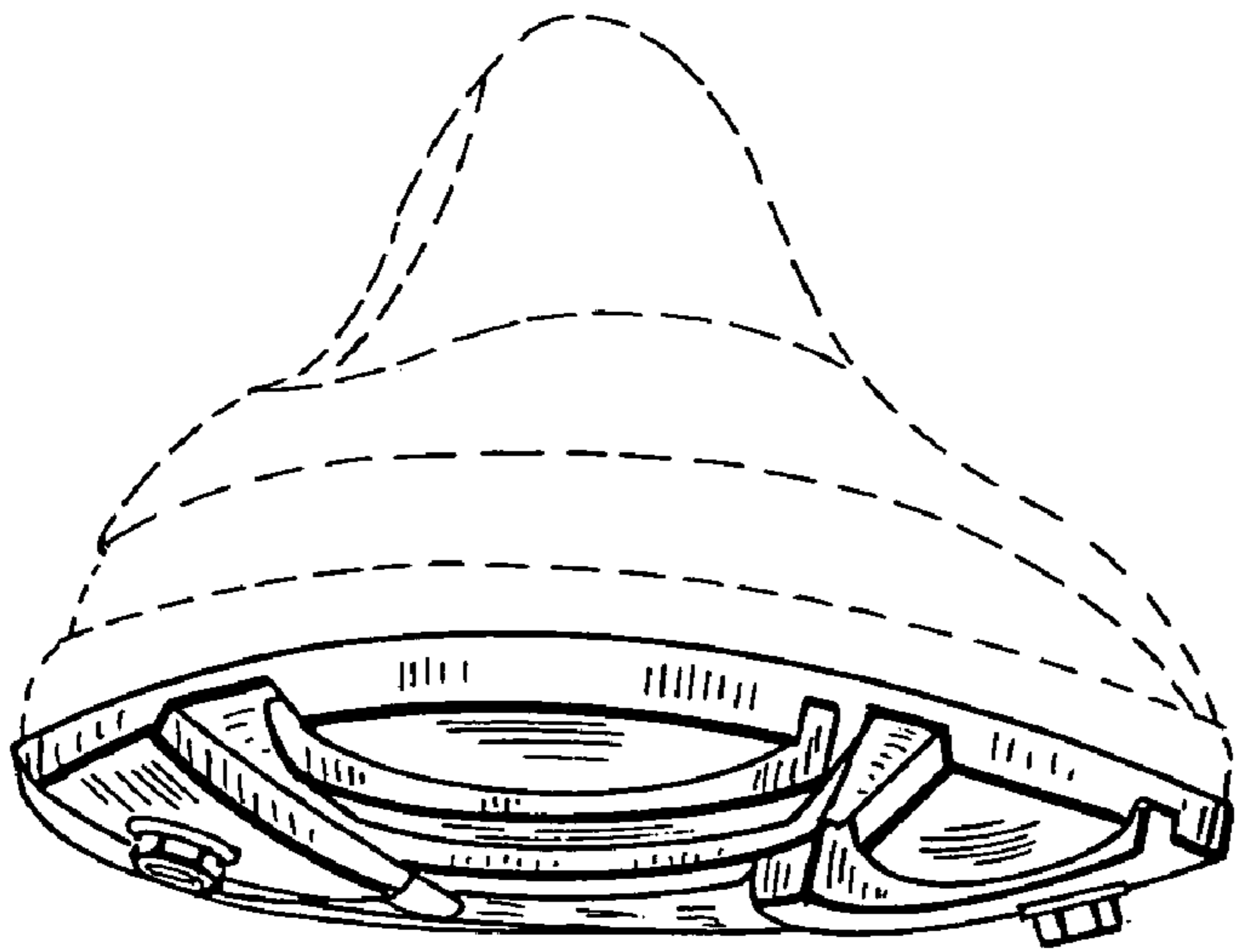

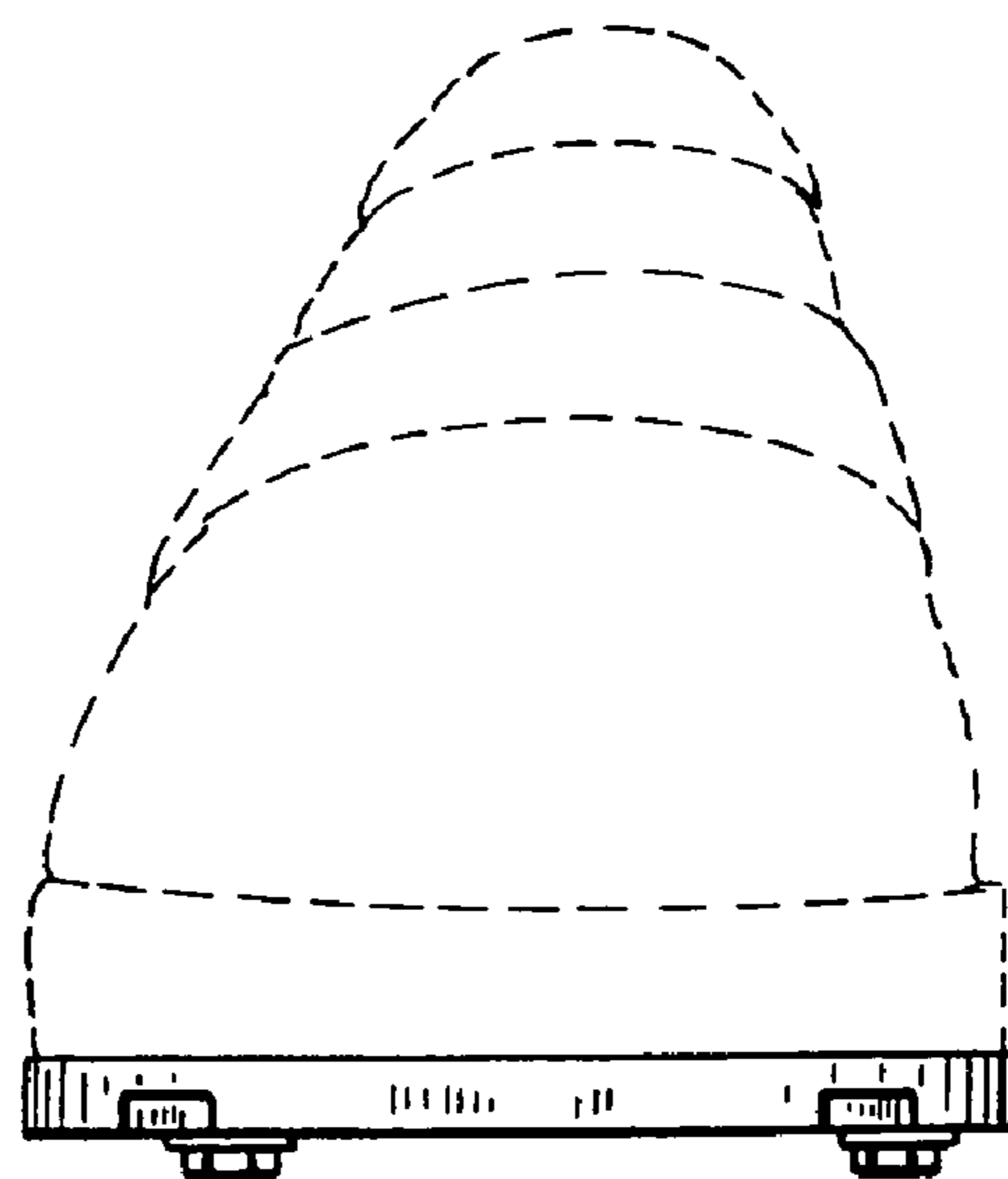
