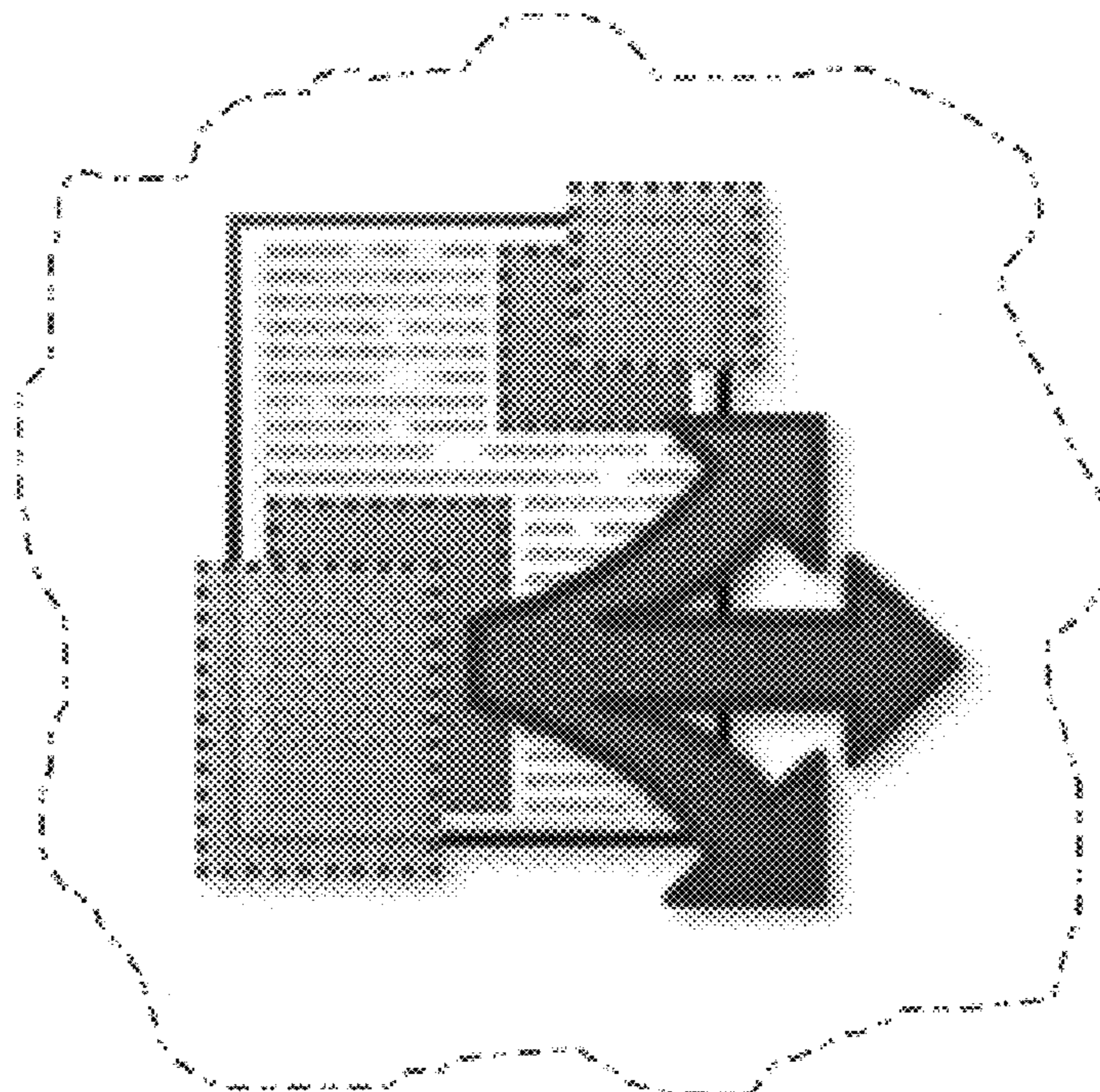
The FIGURE is a front view of a variable information suite

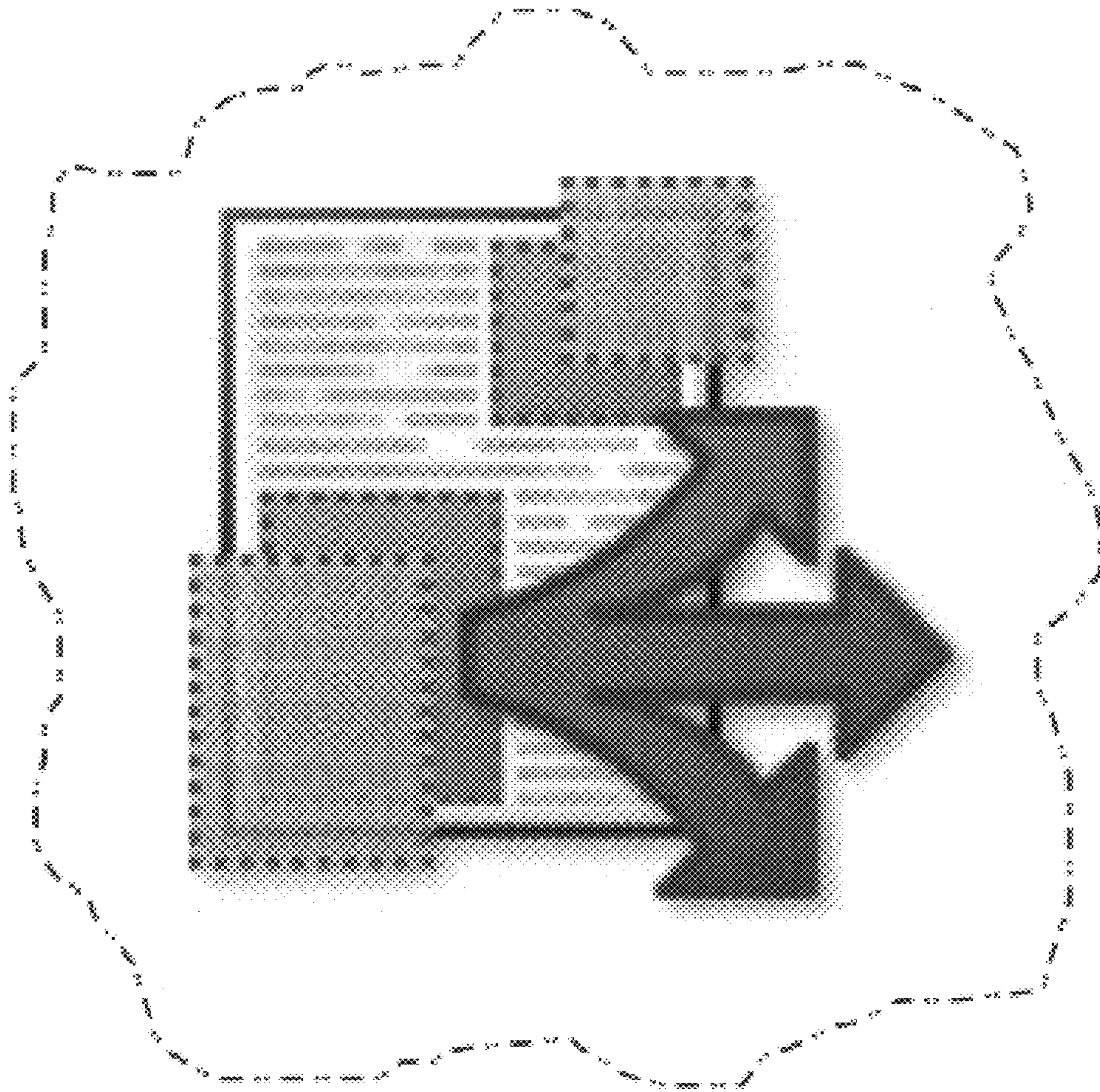
