FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.

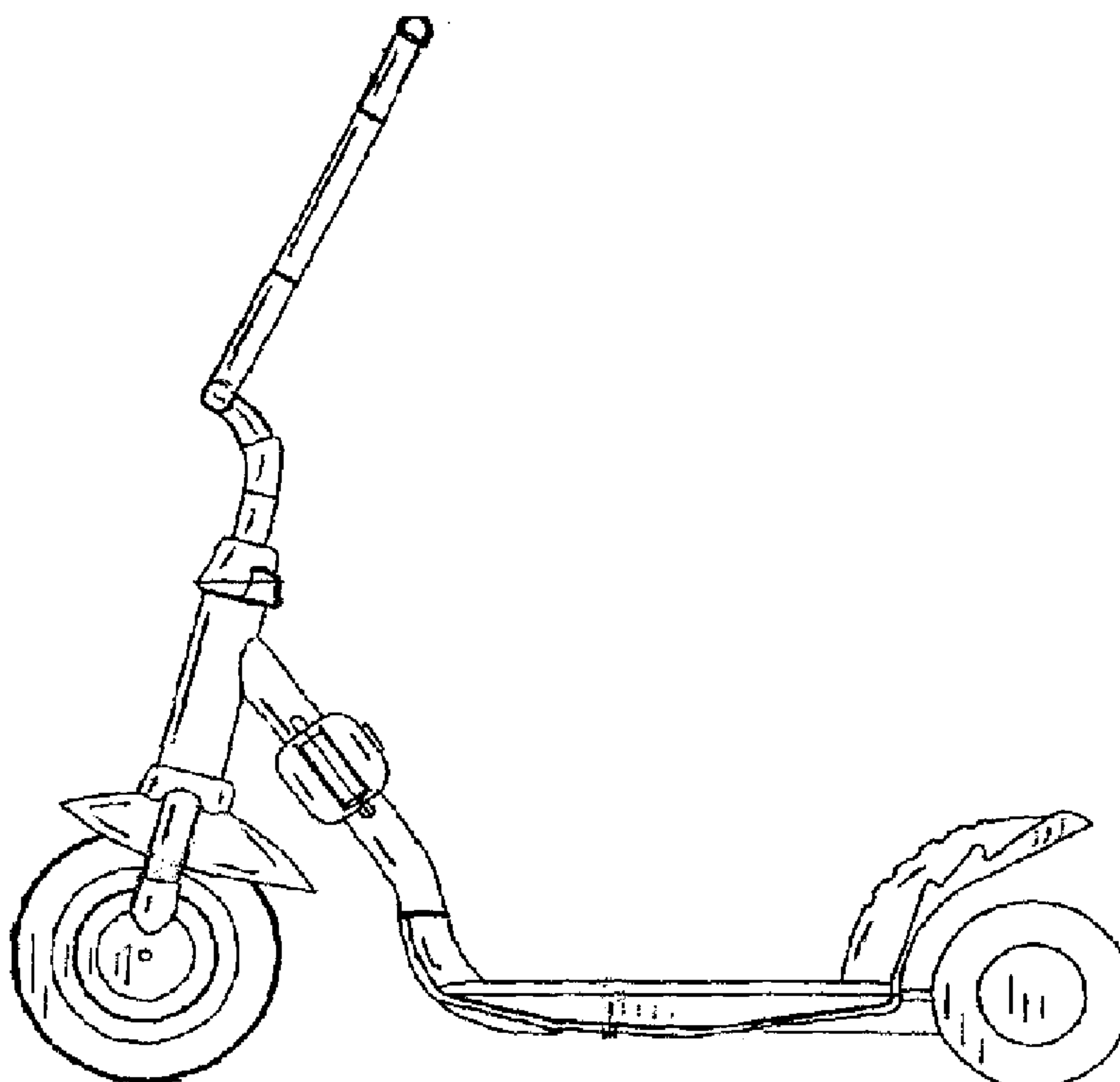
The portions of the footboard shown in broken lines form no part of the claimed design.

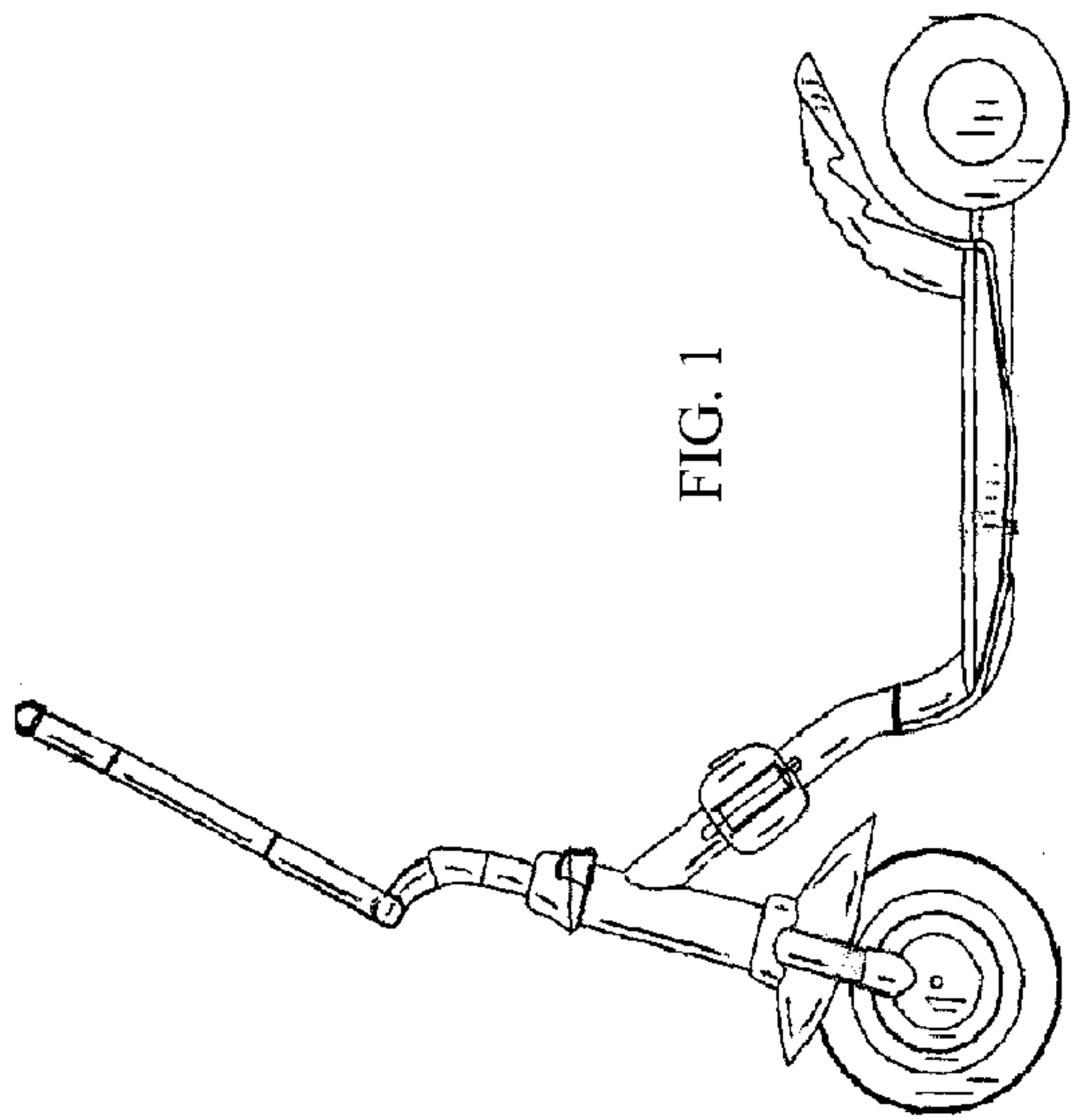

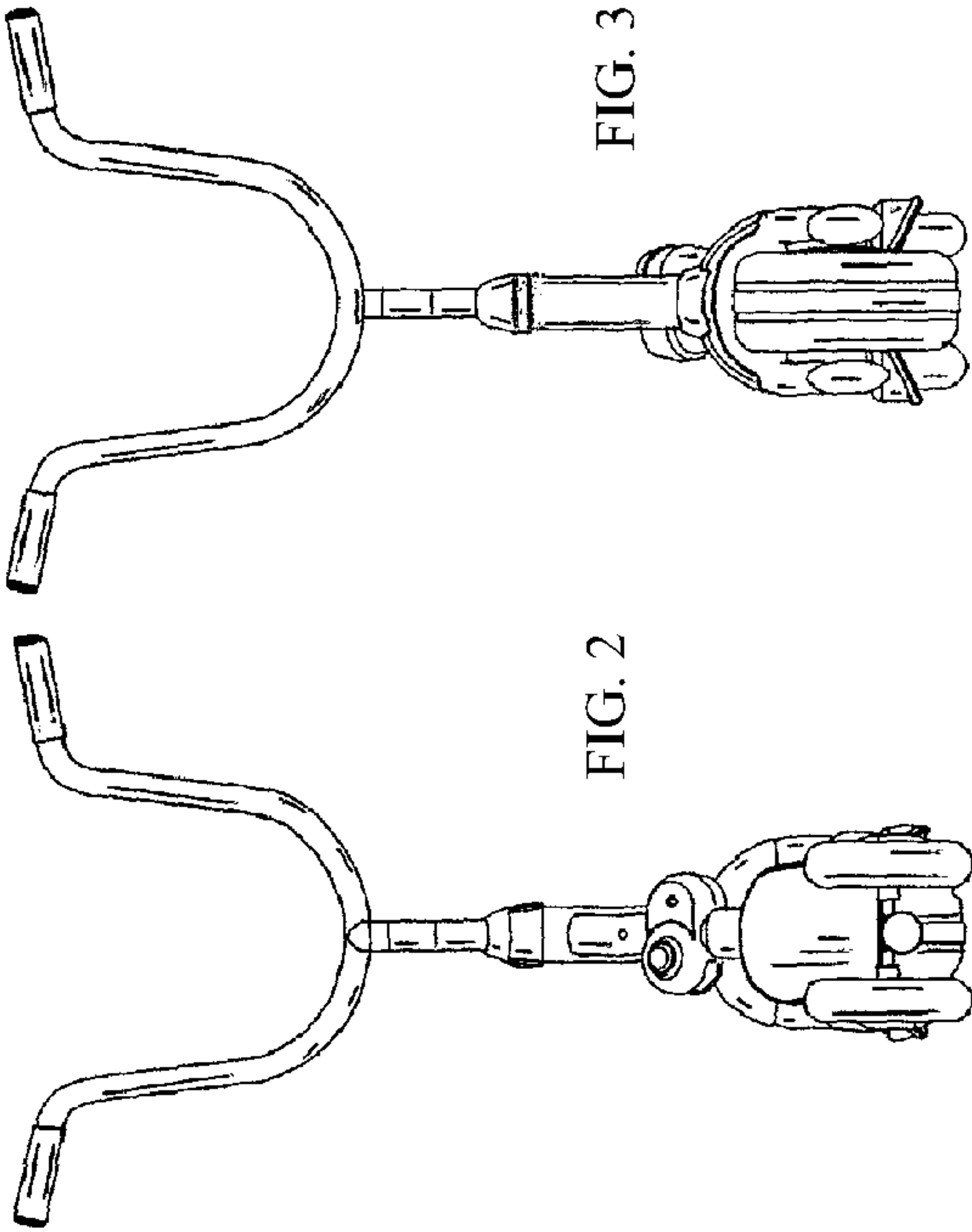

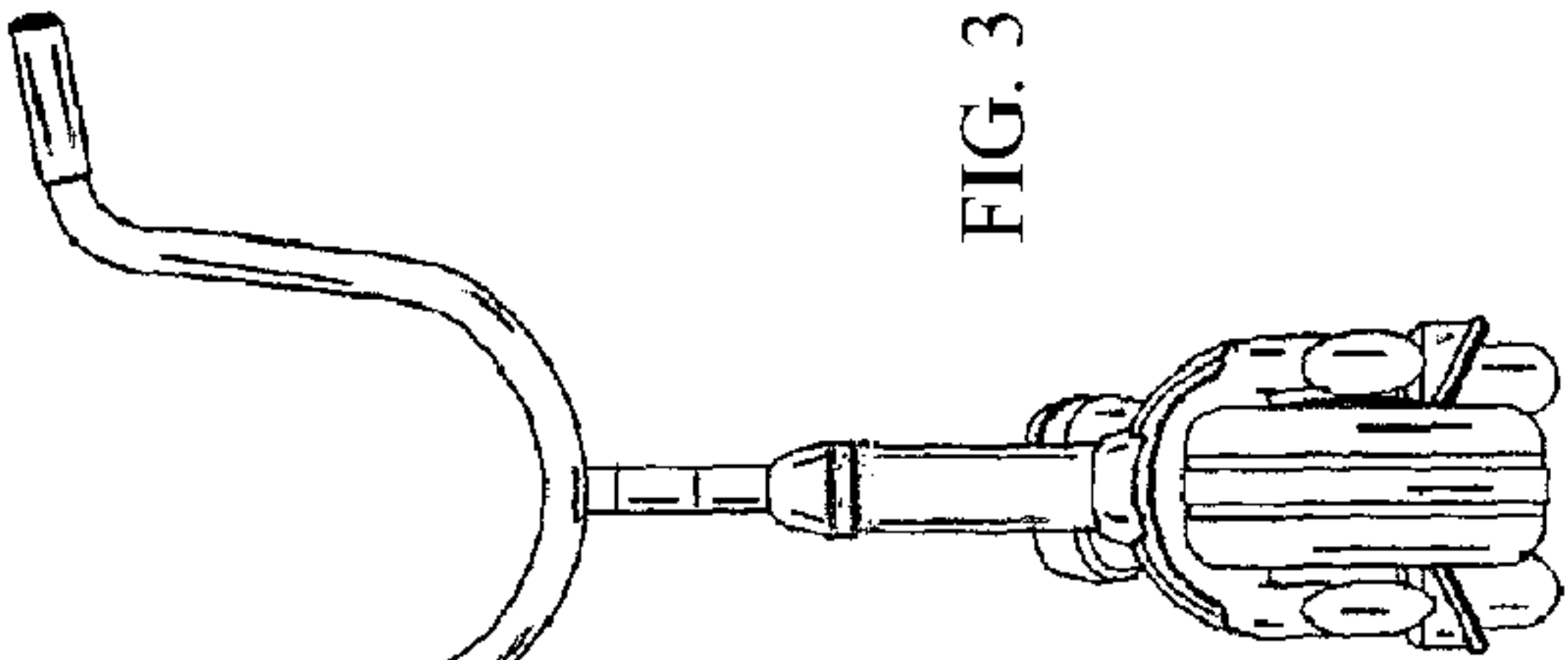

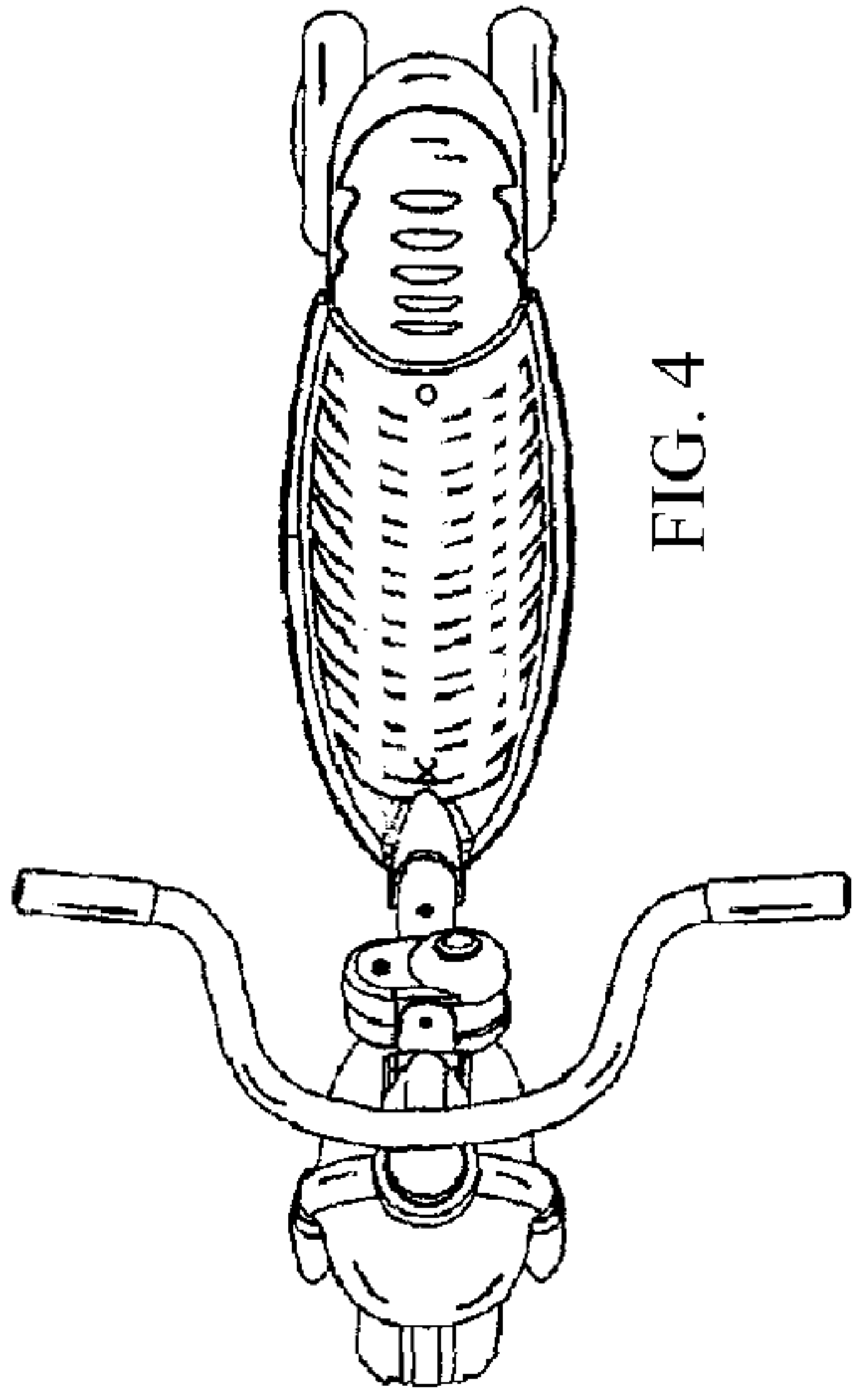

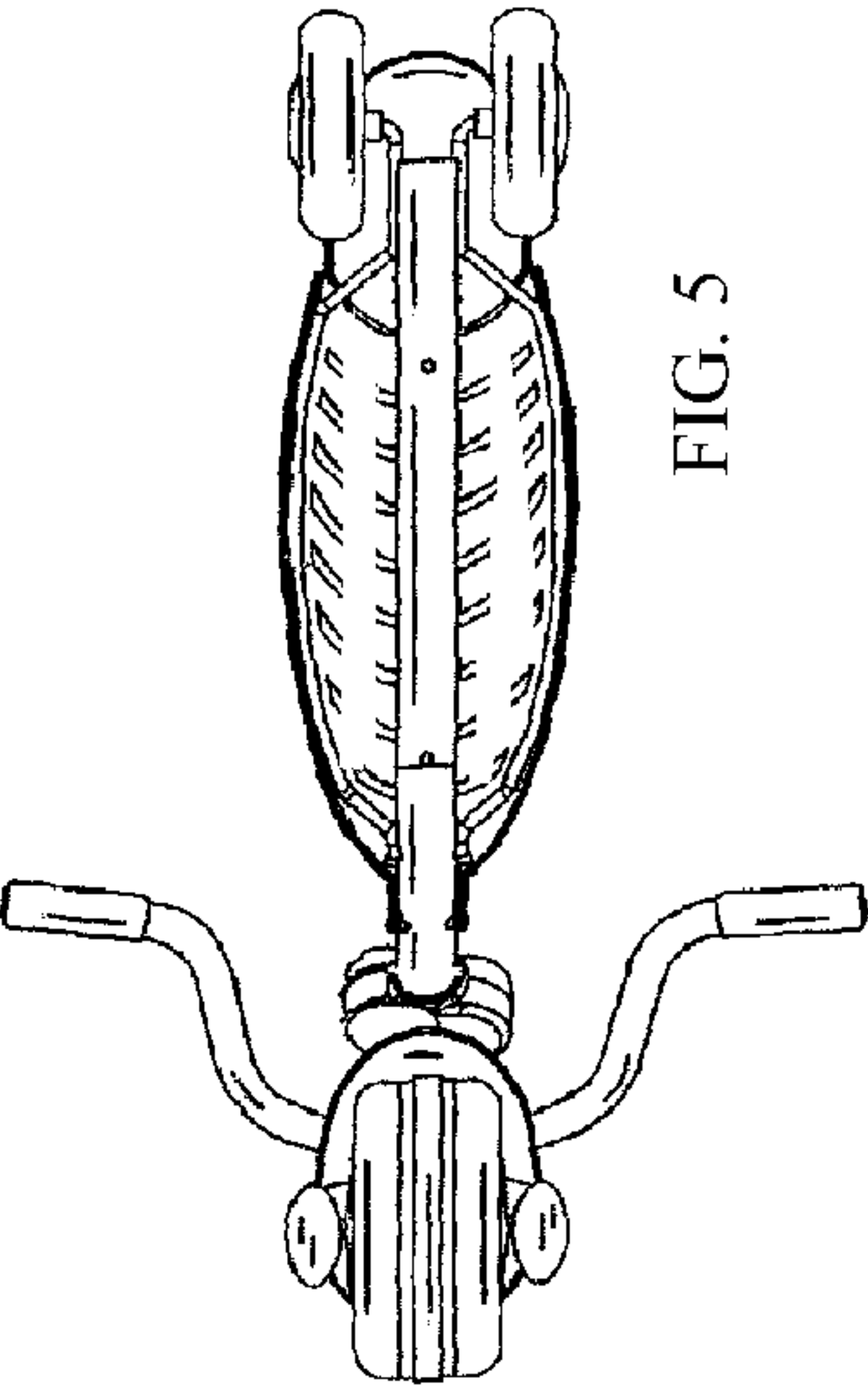
