(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a circular tablet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a circular tablet showing our new design with portions shown in stippling to indicate color contrast;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation, the other side elevations being identical;

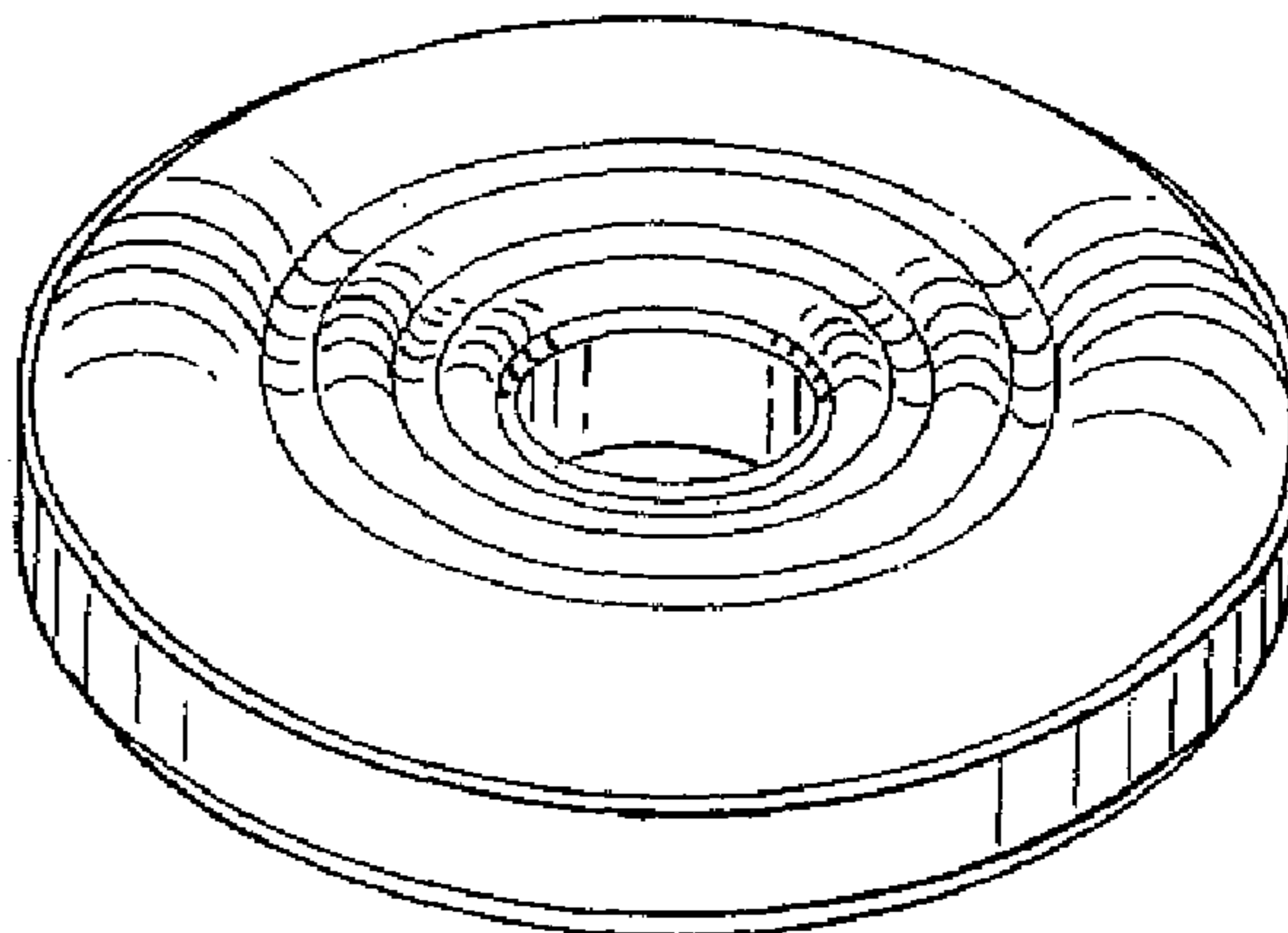
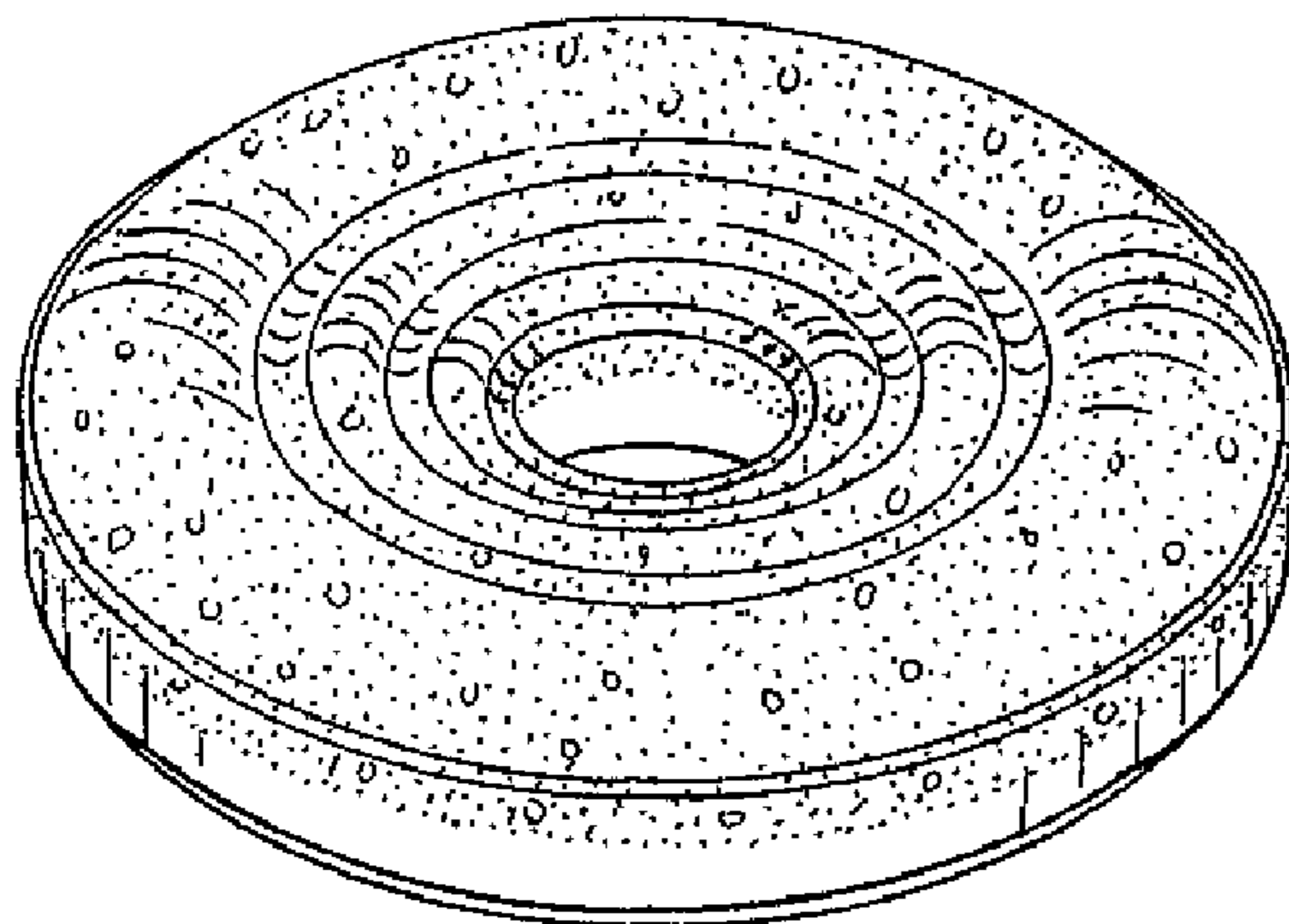
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken through a diameter; and,

FIG. 6 is a top perspective view of a modified embodiment of the design shown in FIGS. 1 through 5, the other views being identical thereto apart from the lack of stippling to indicate color contrast.

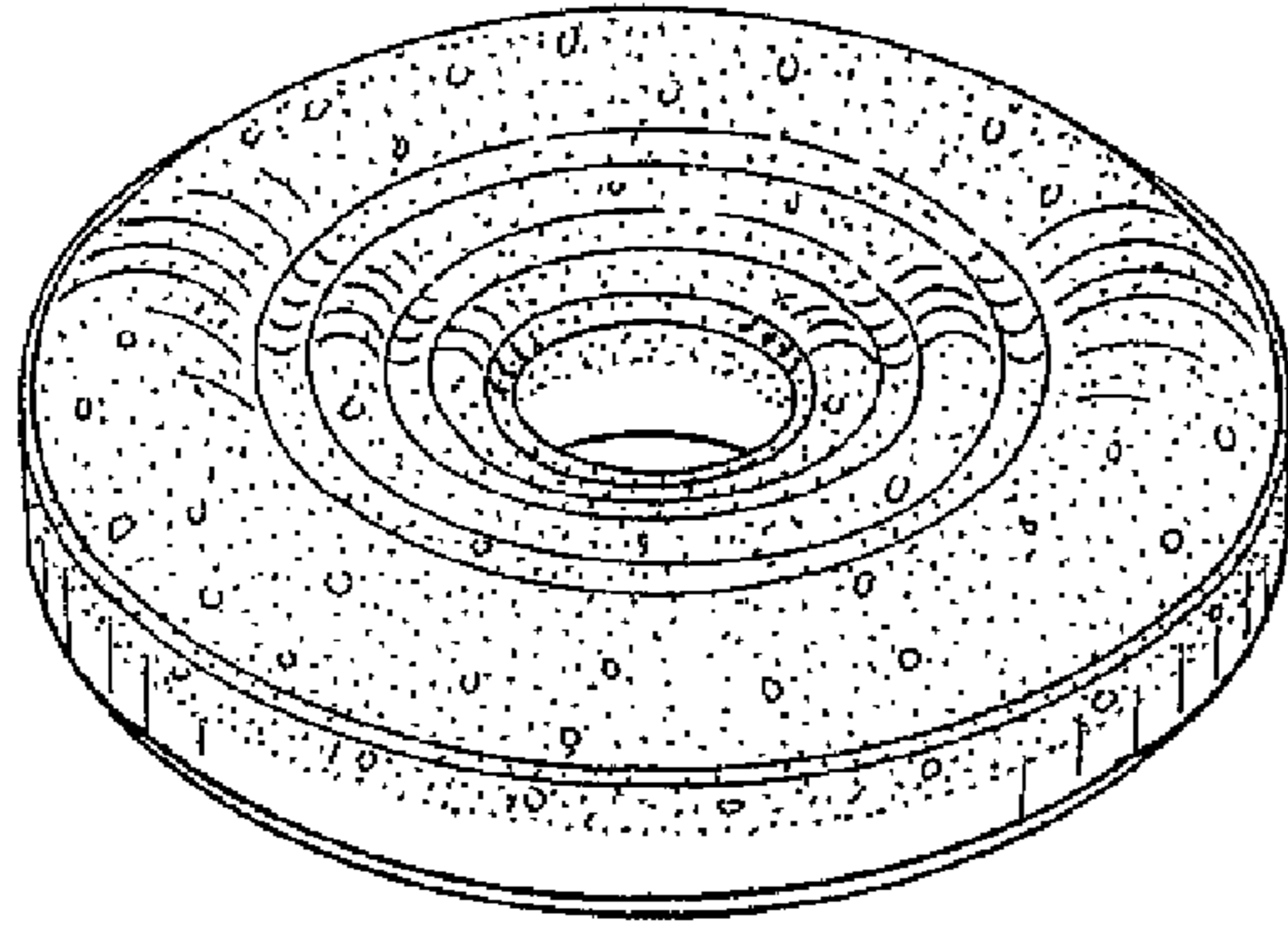

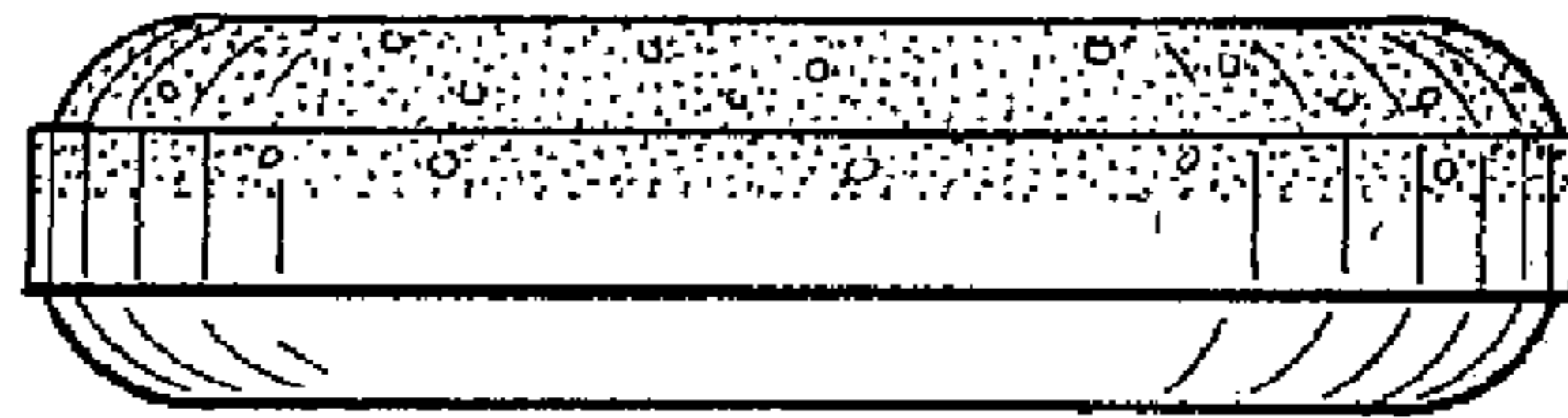

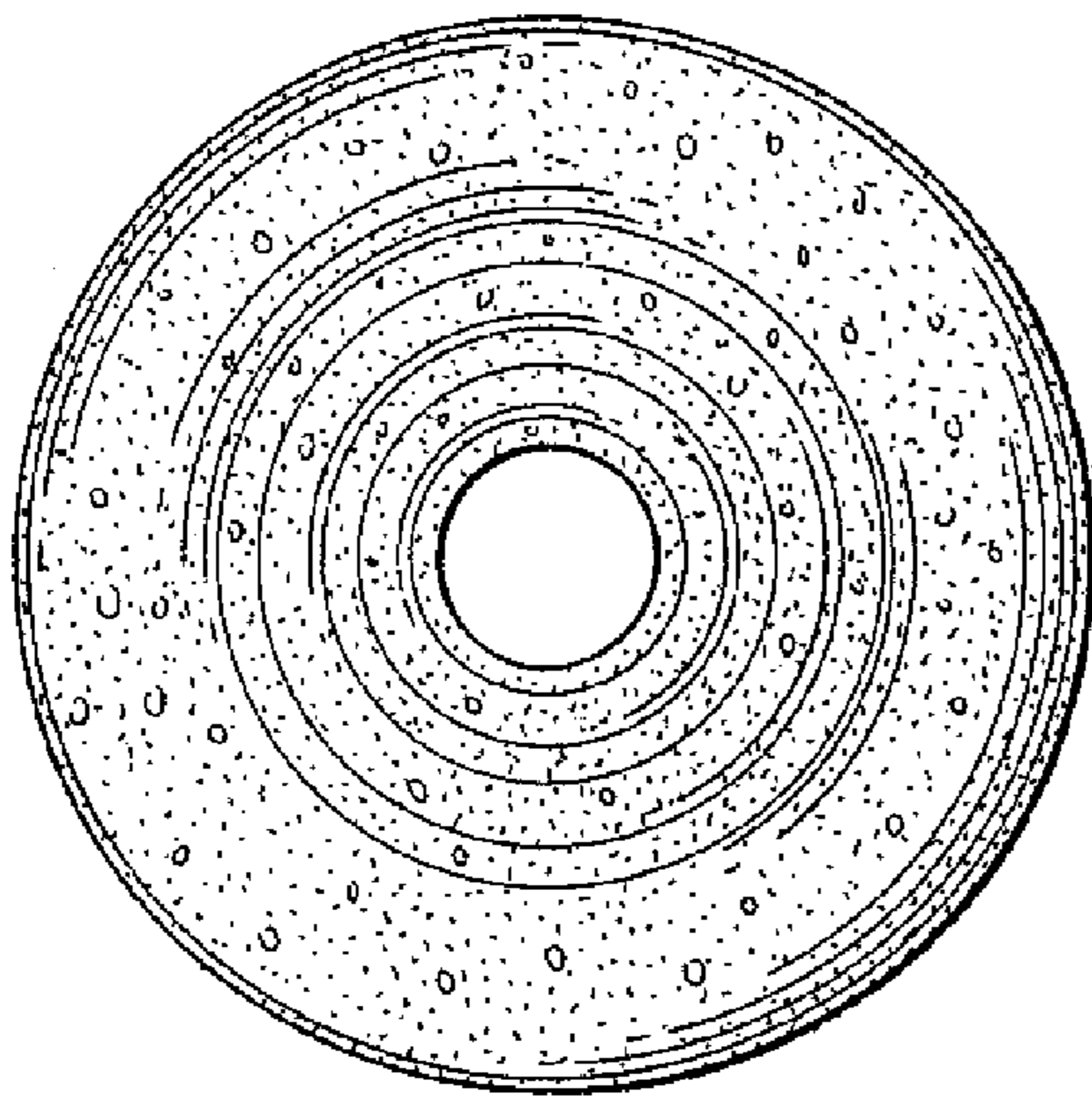

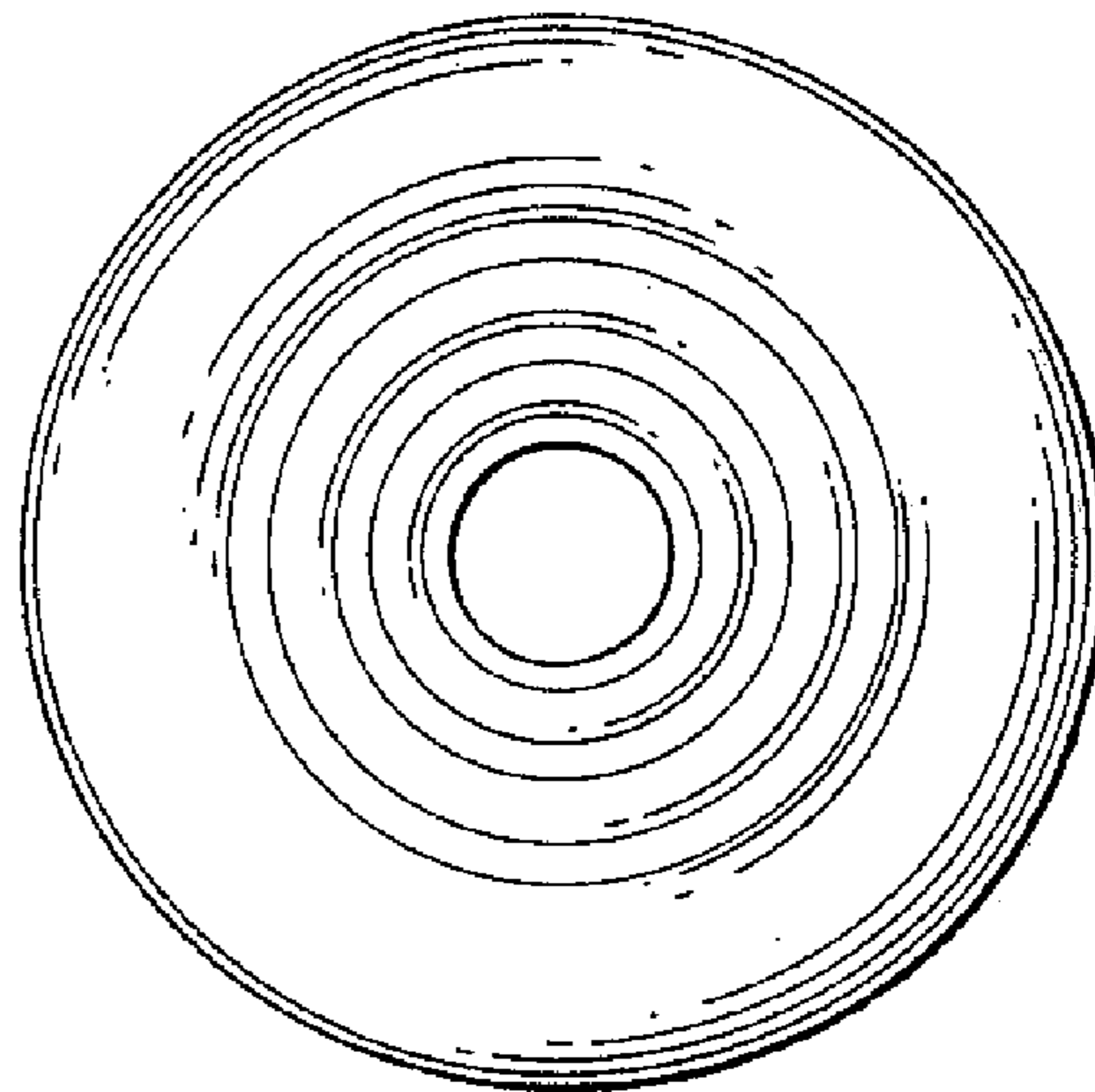

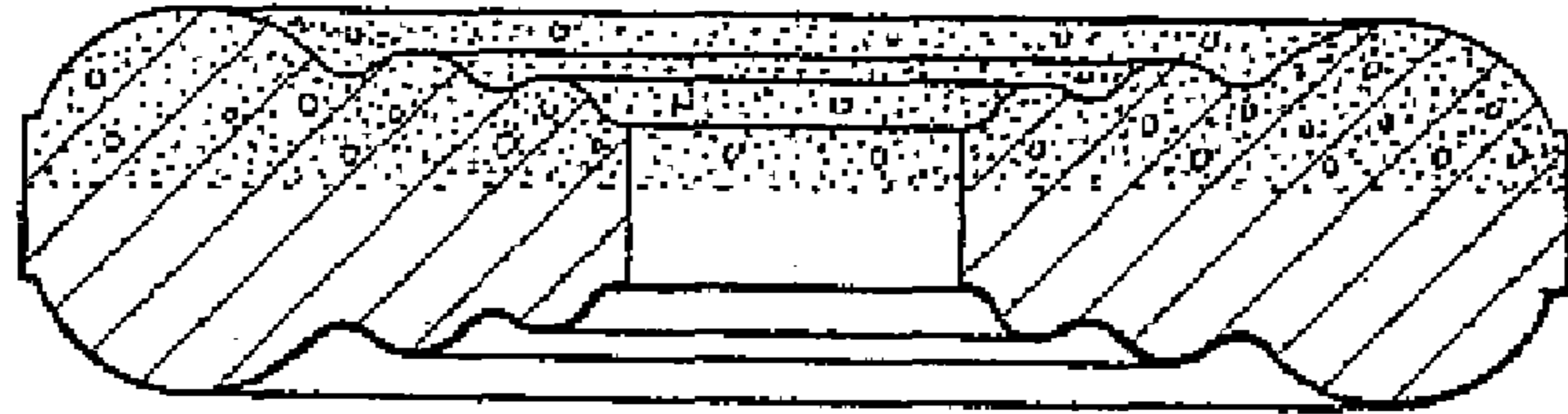
