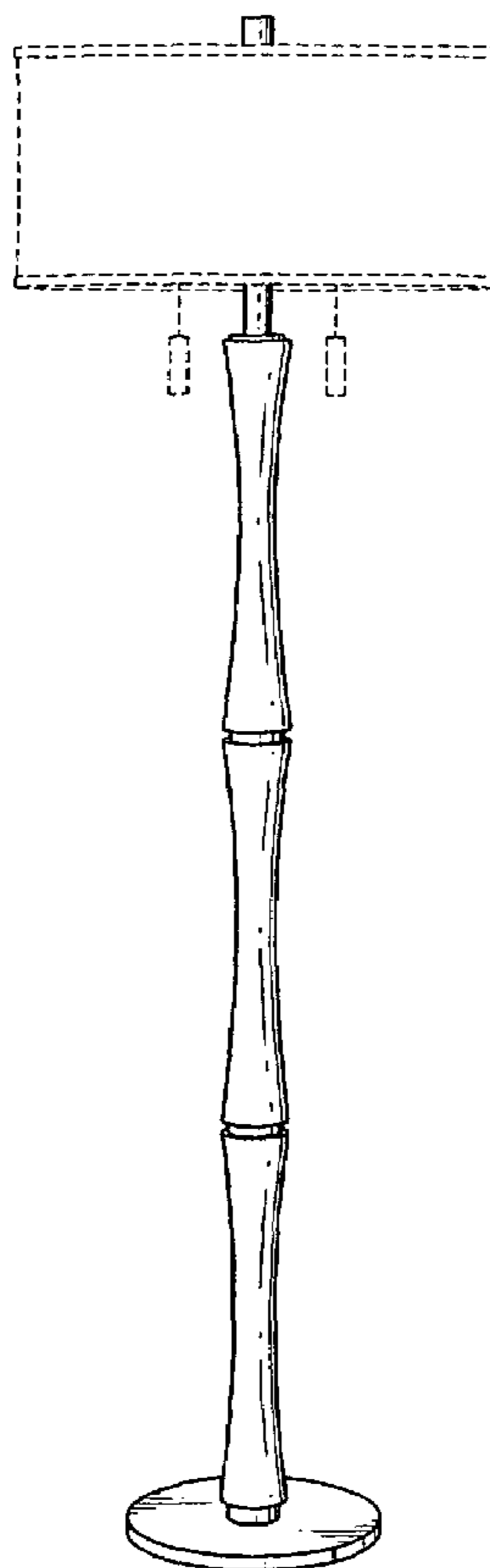
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof; the right side view would be a mirror image of FIG. 3;

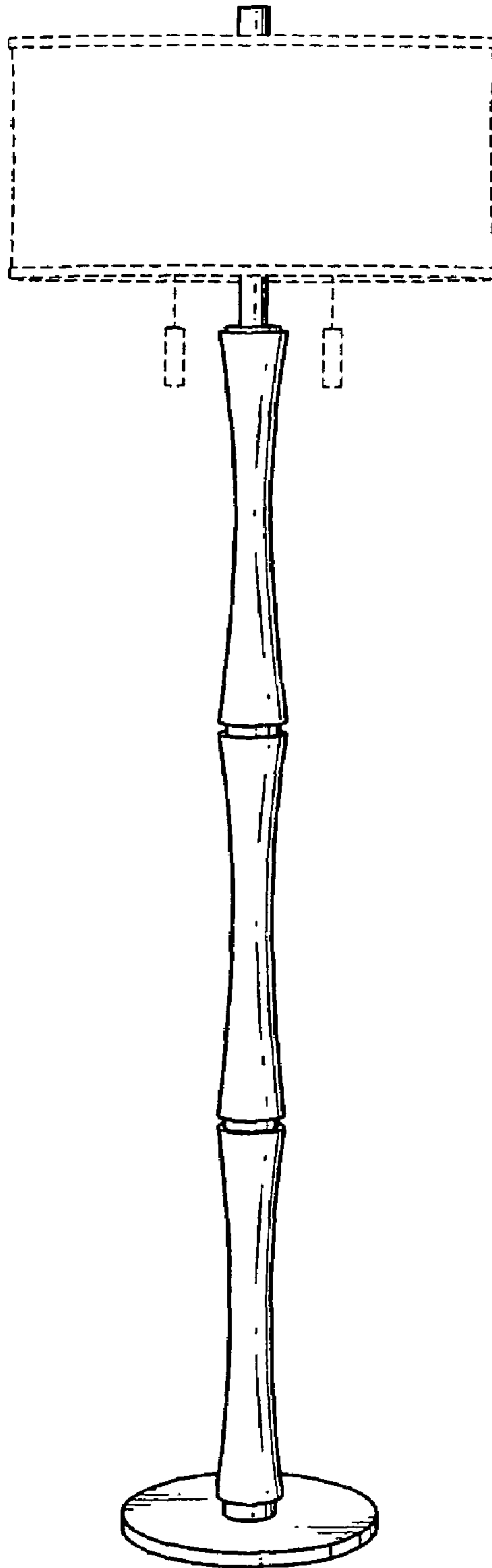

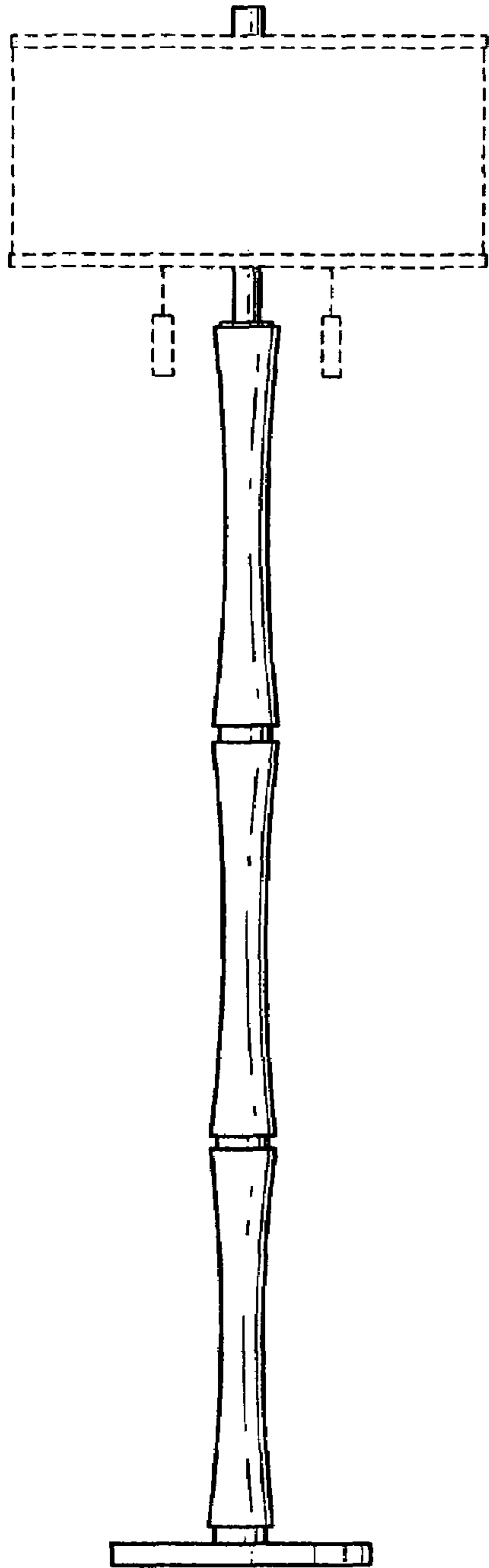

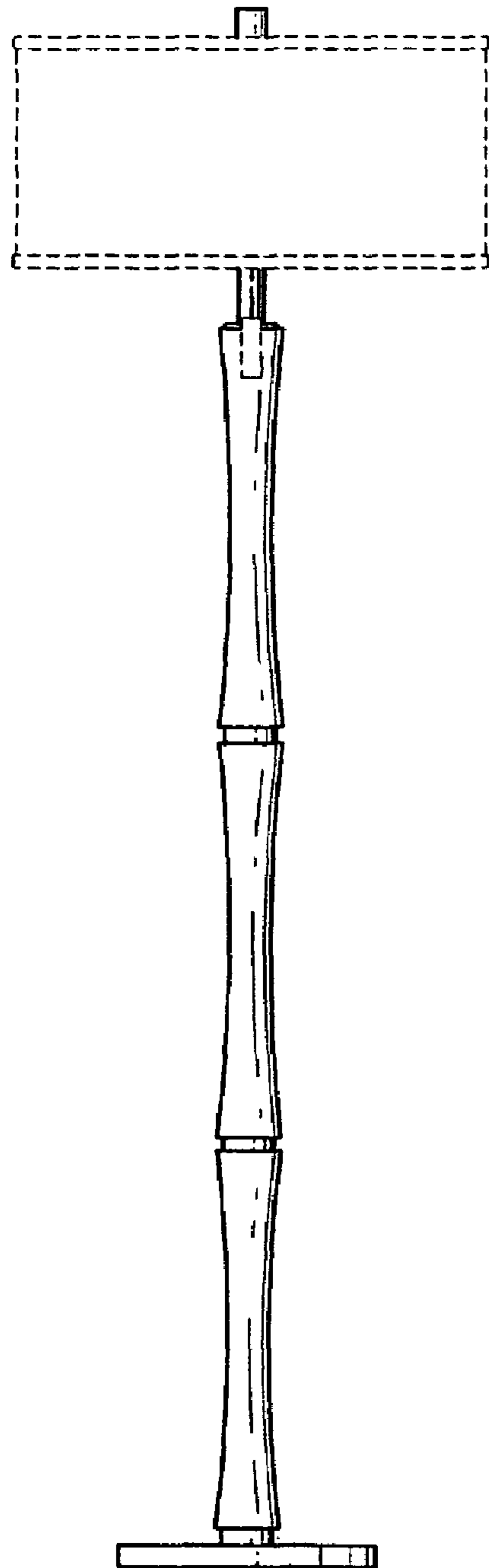

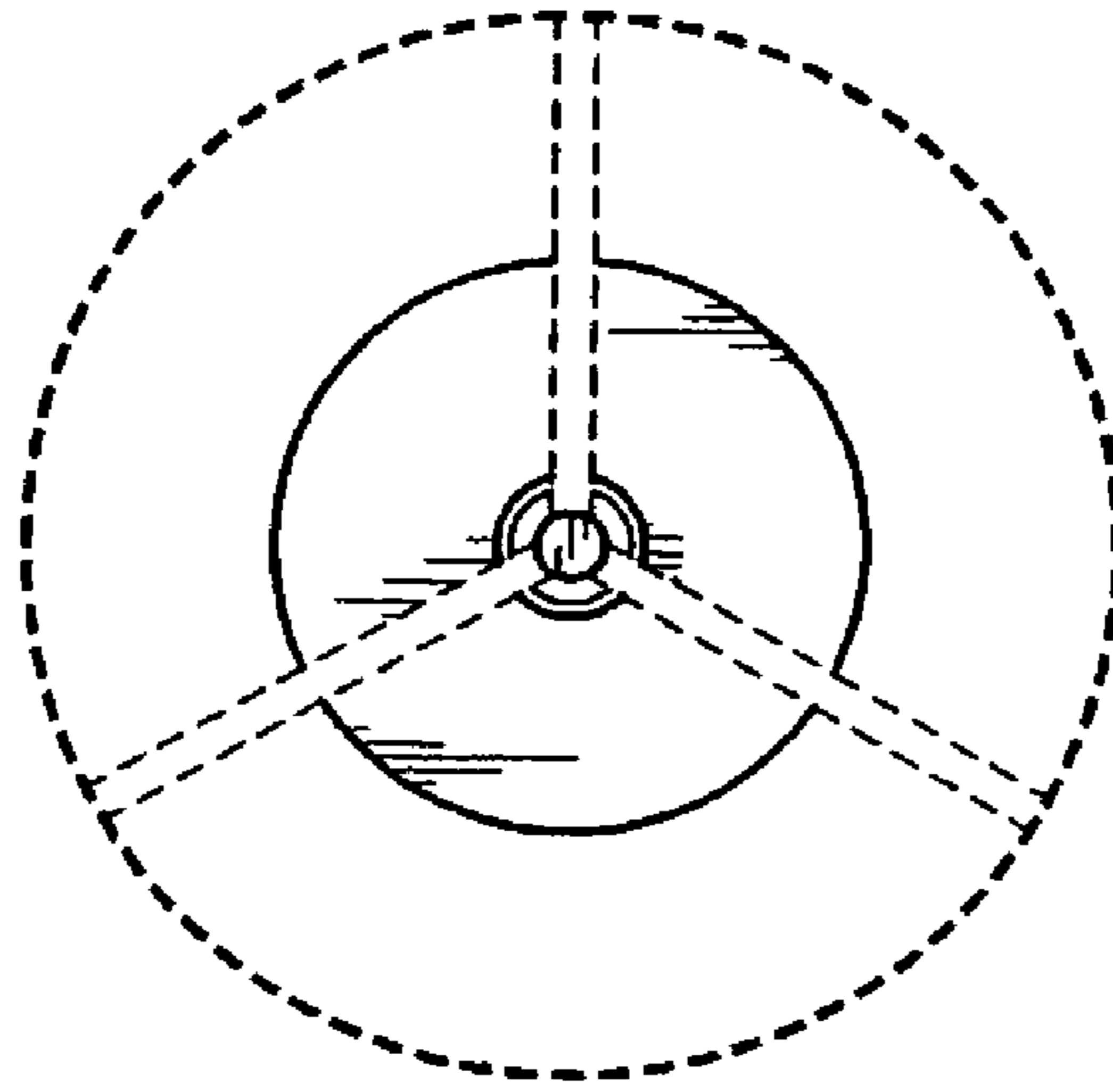

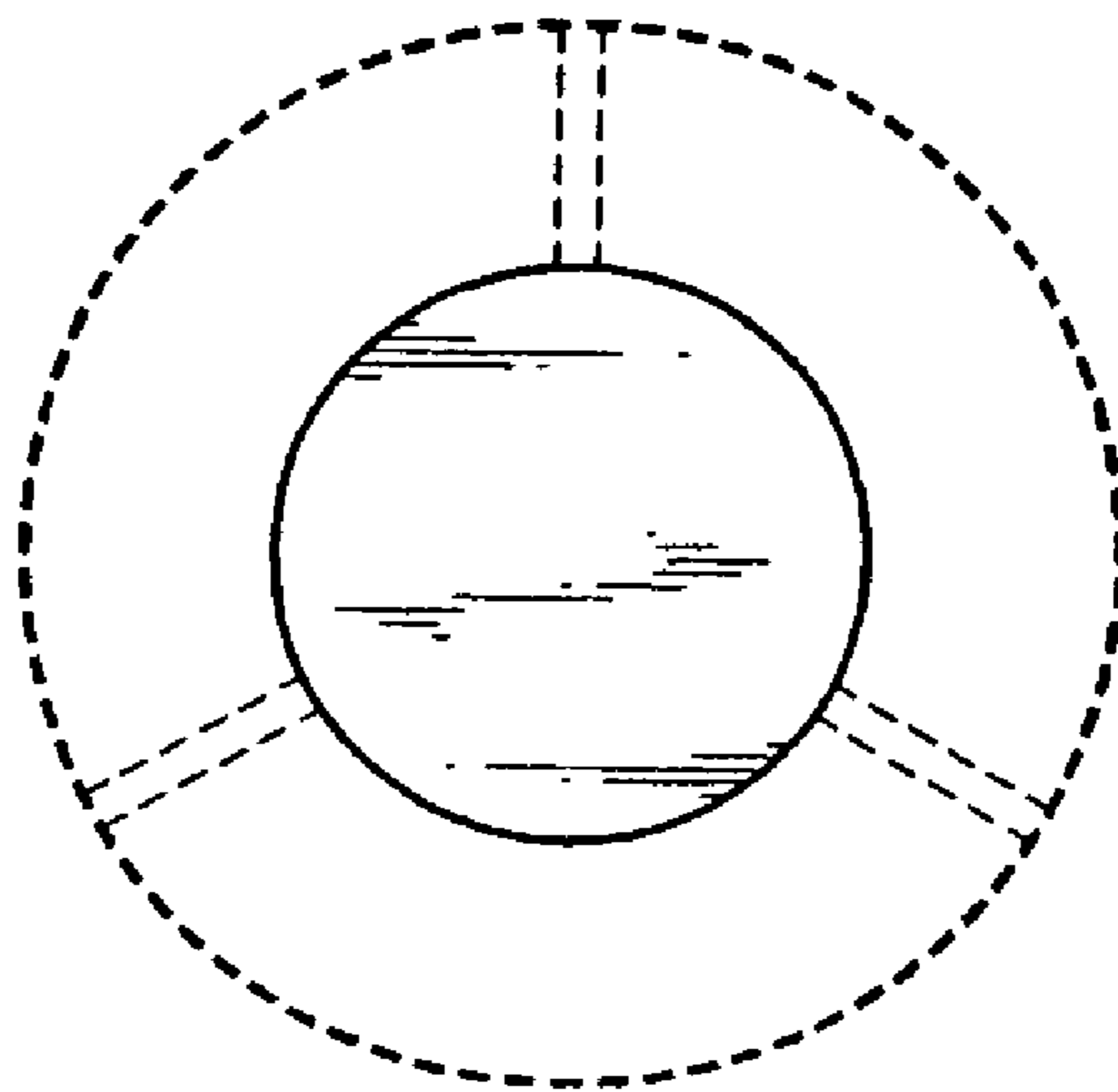
