FIG. 5 is top plan view with the front and rear panels open;

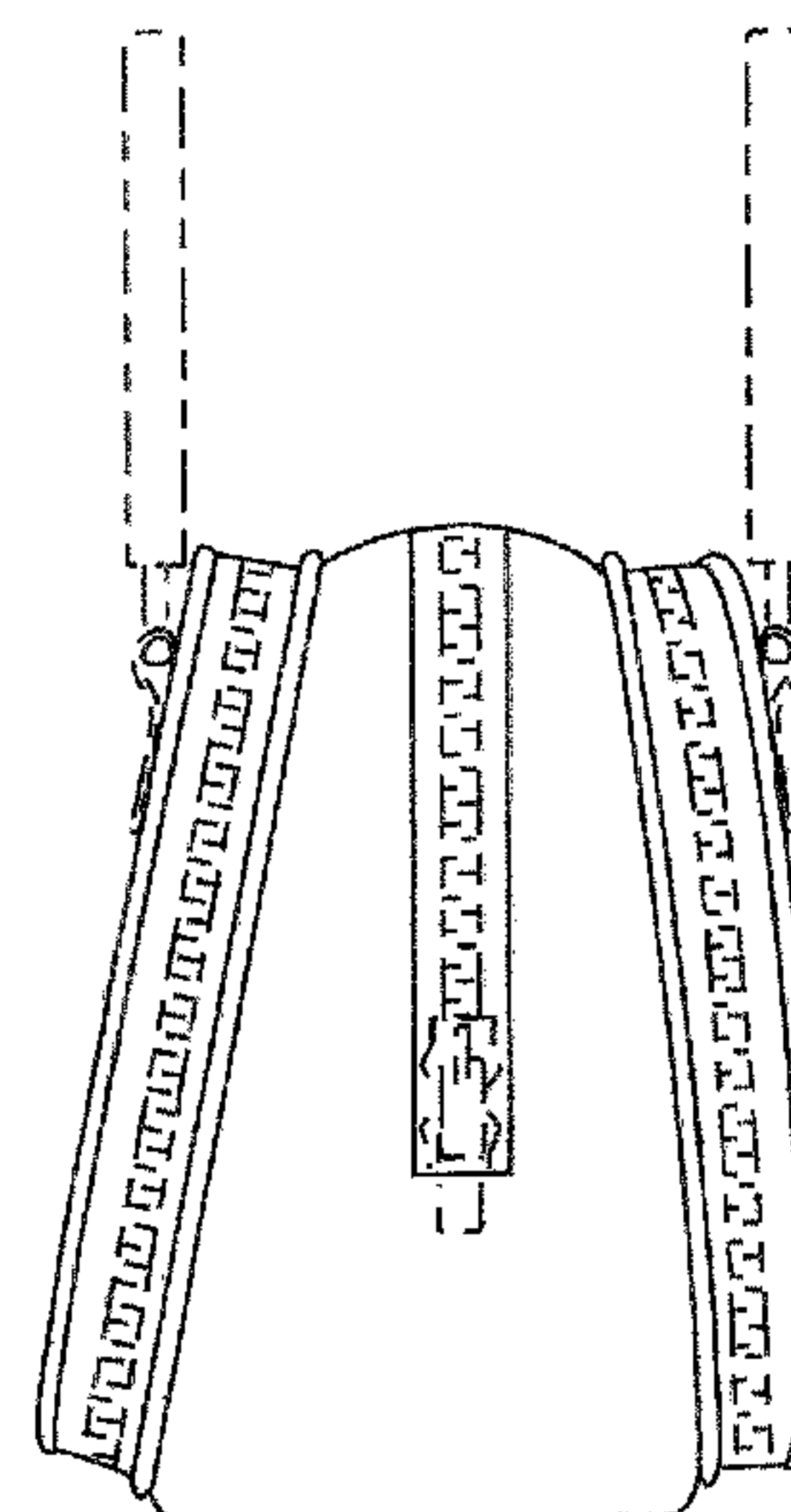
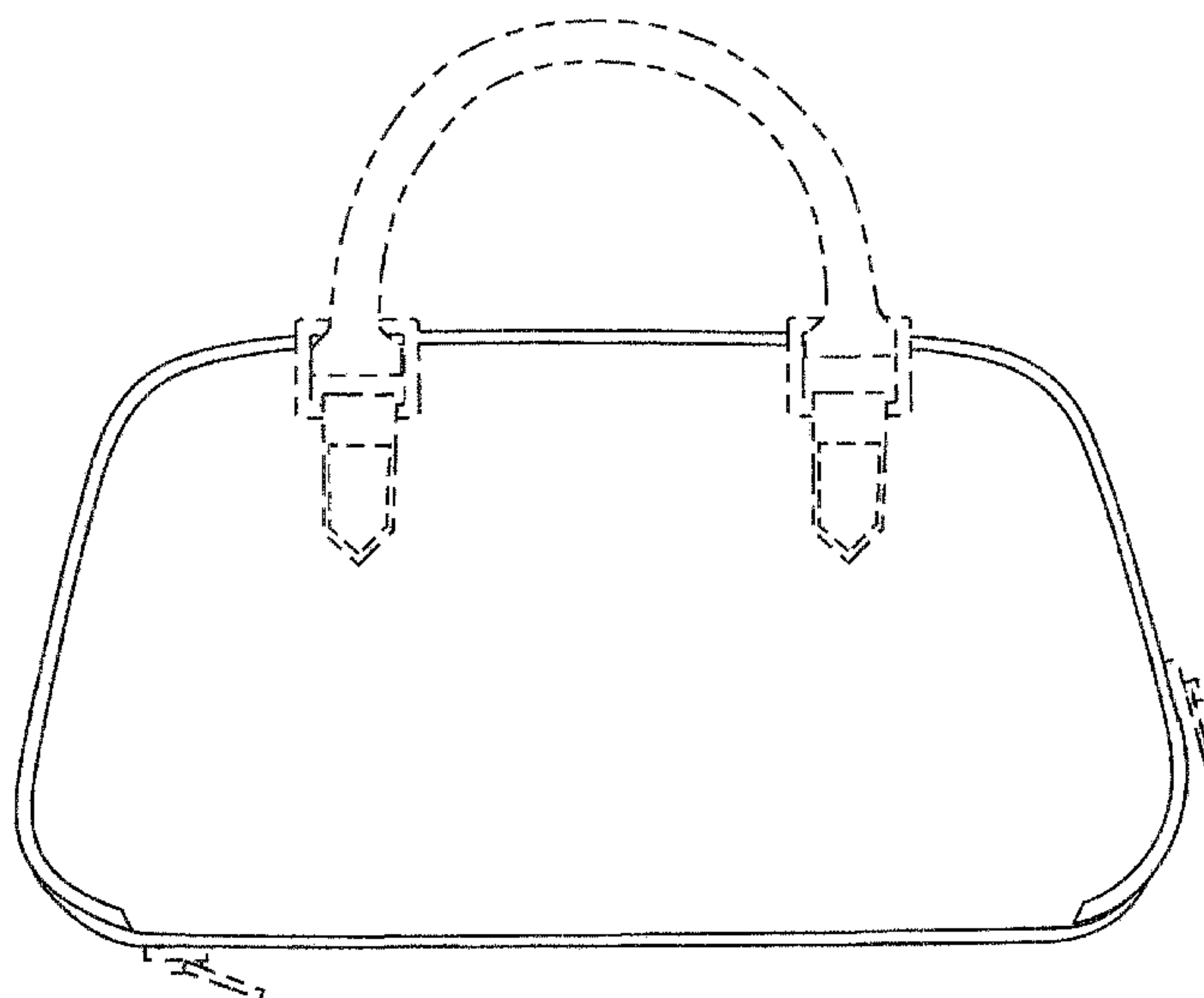
FIG. 6 is front elevational view with the front panel open;

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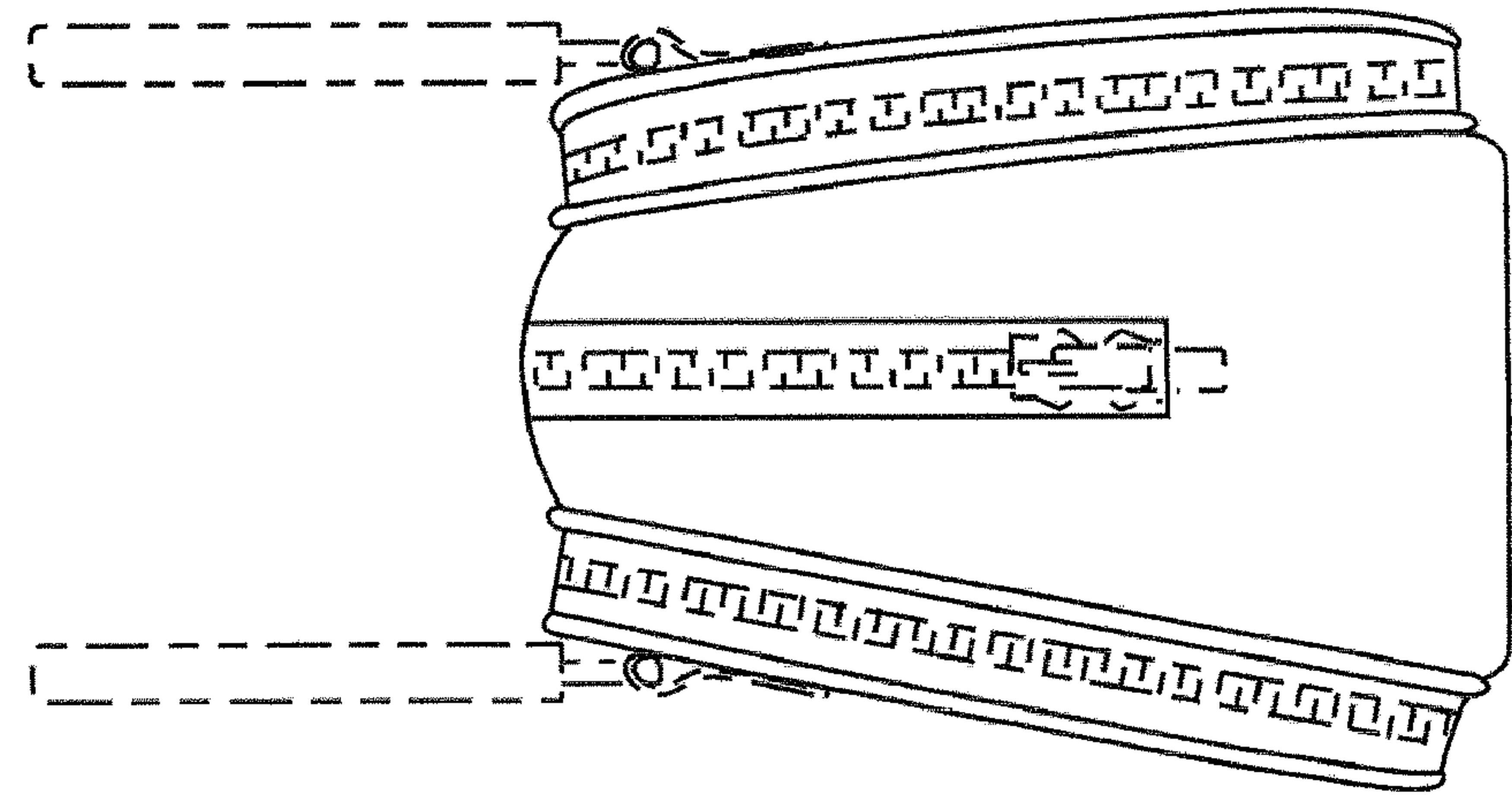

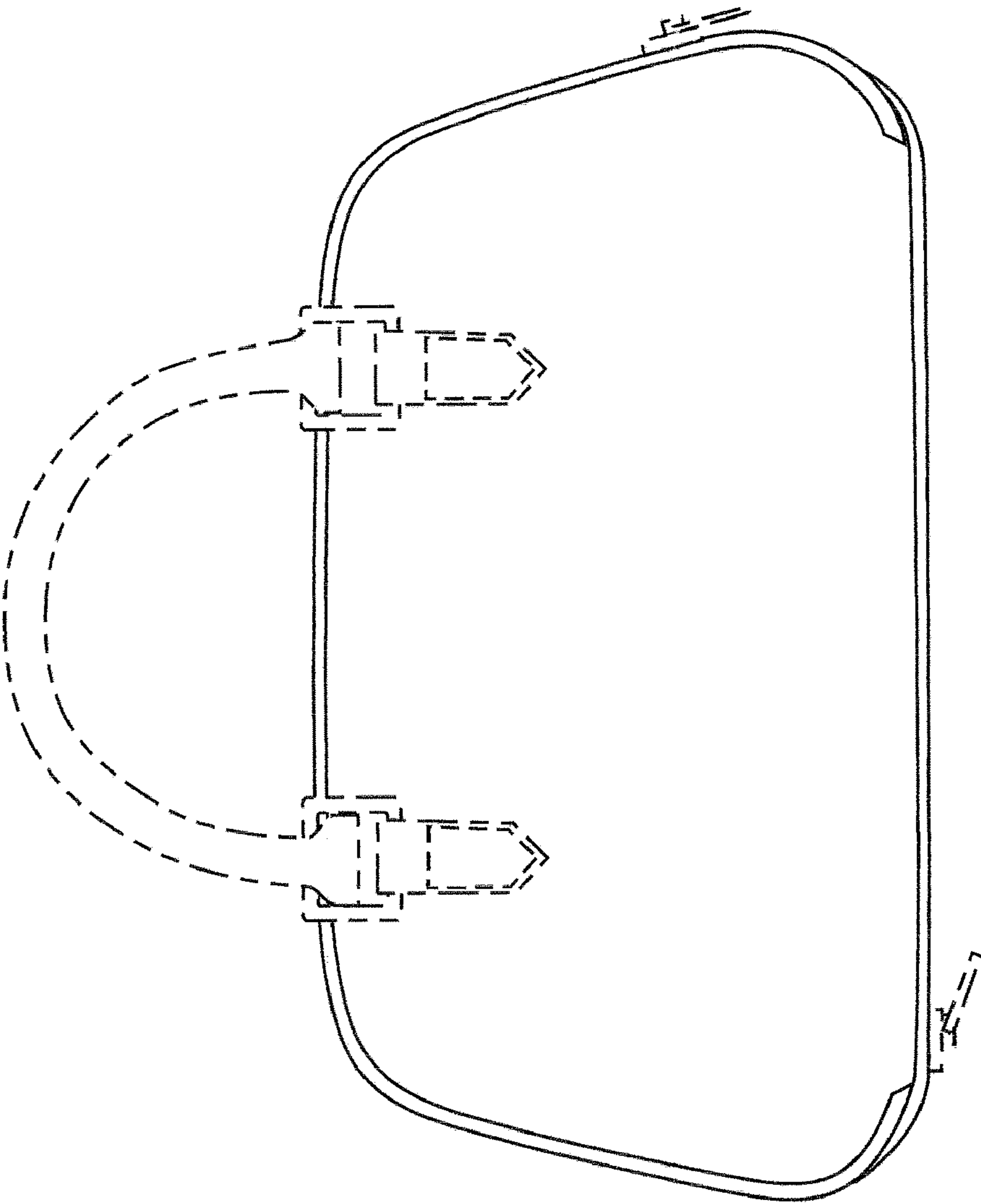

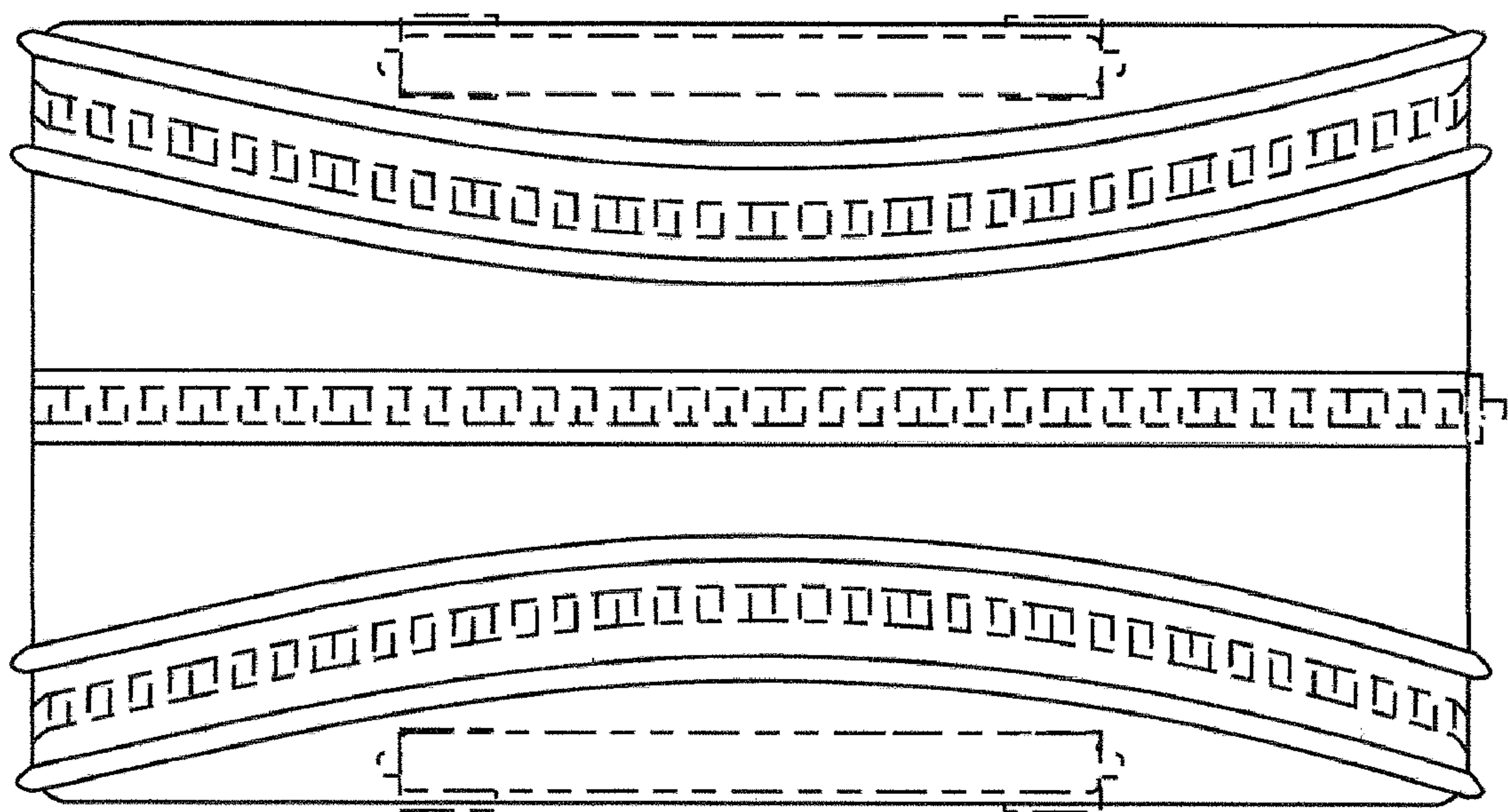

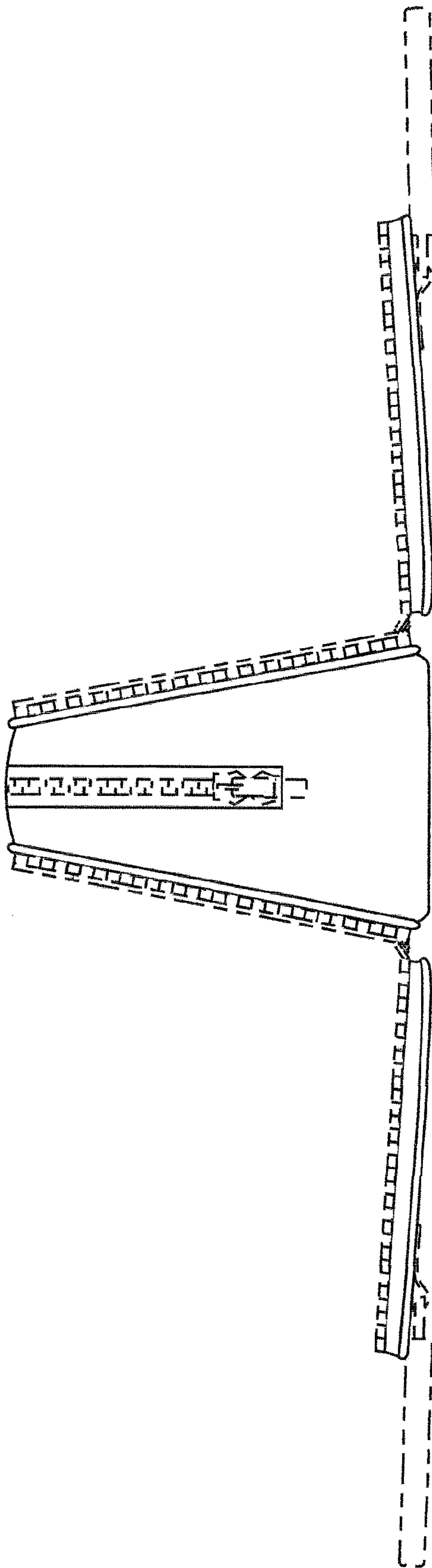

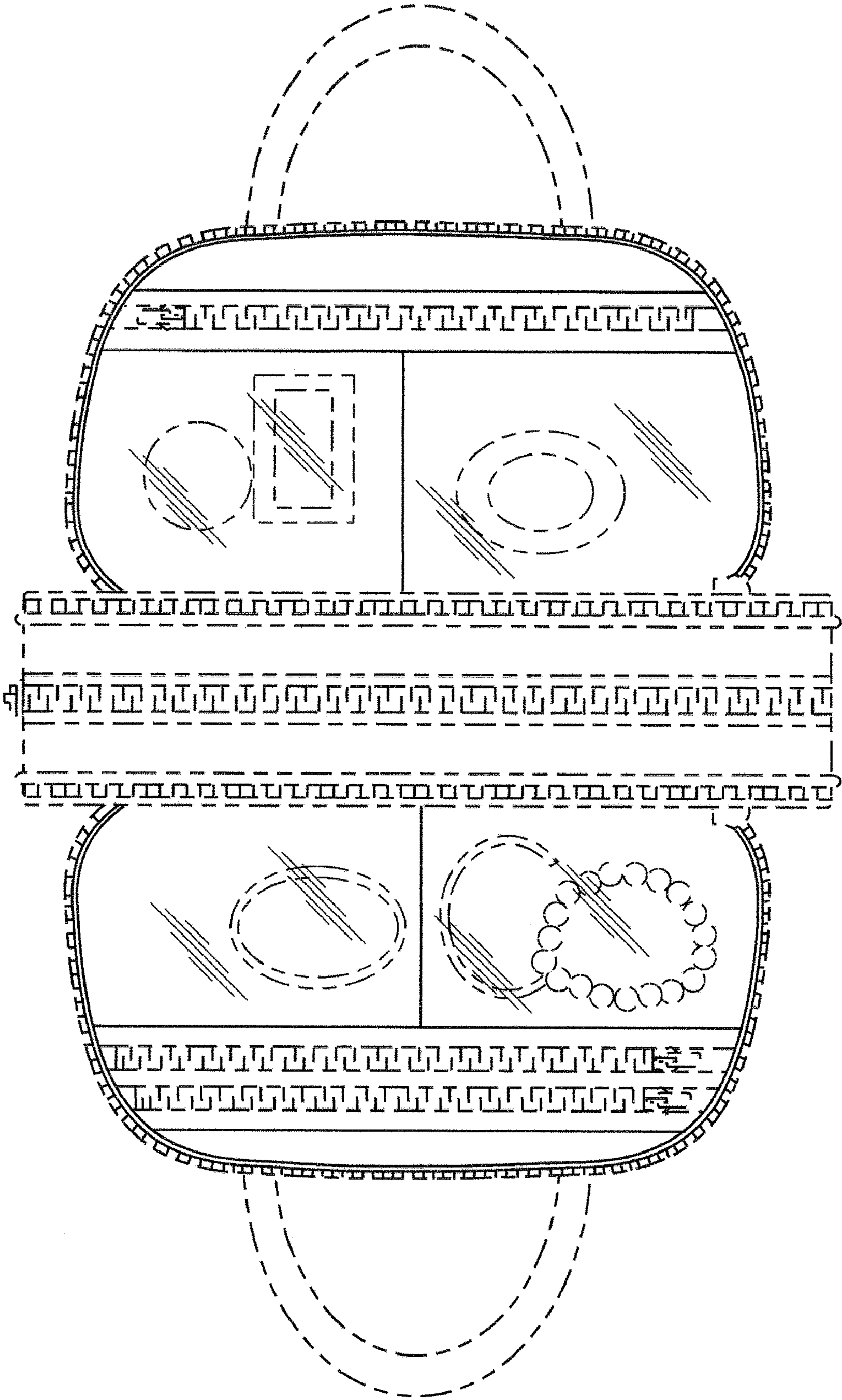

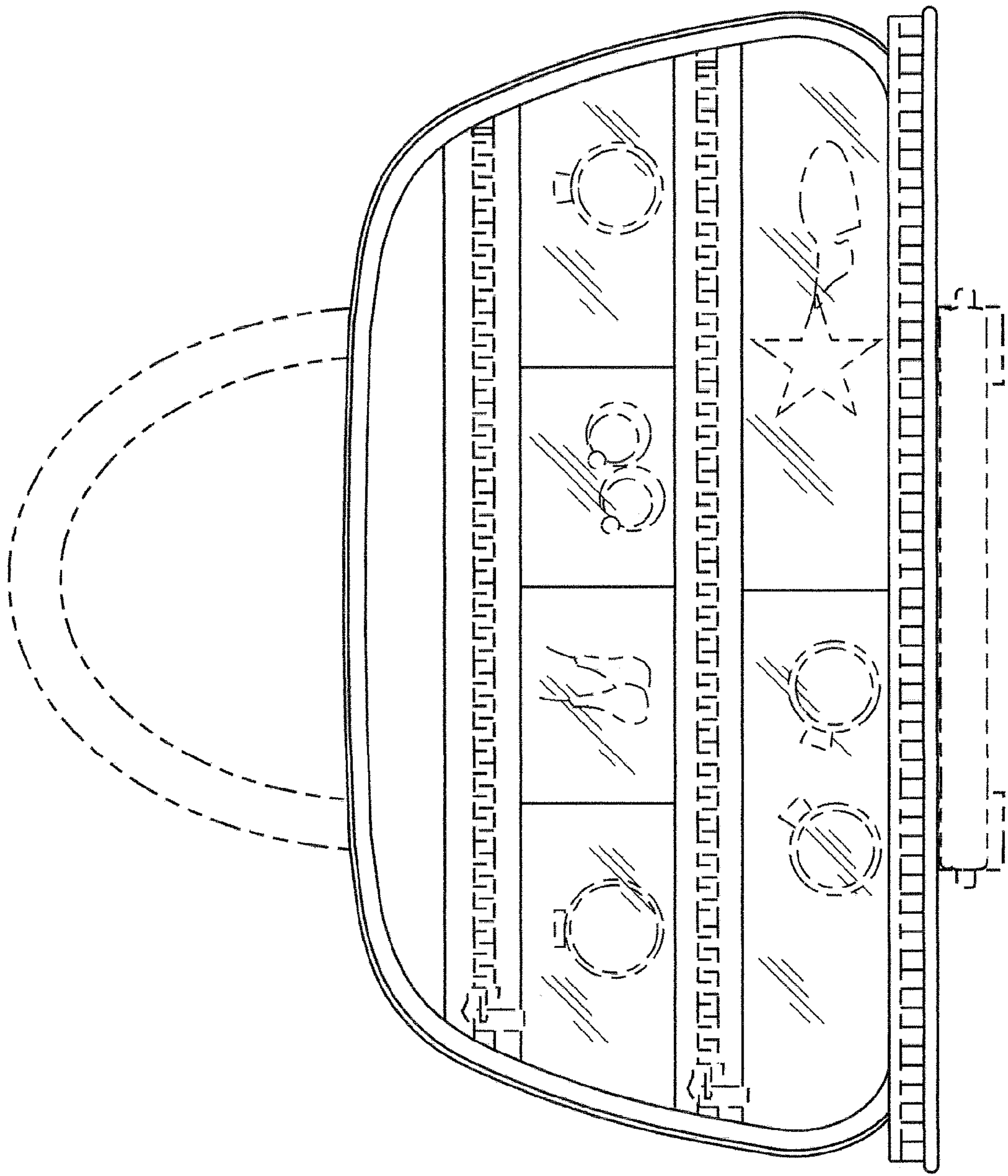

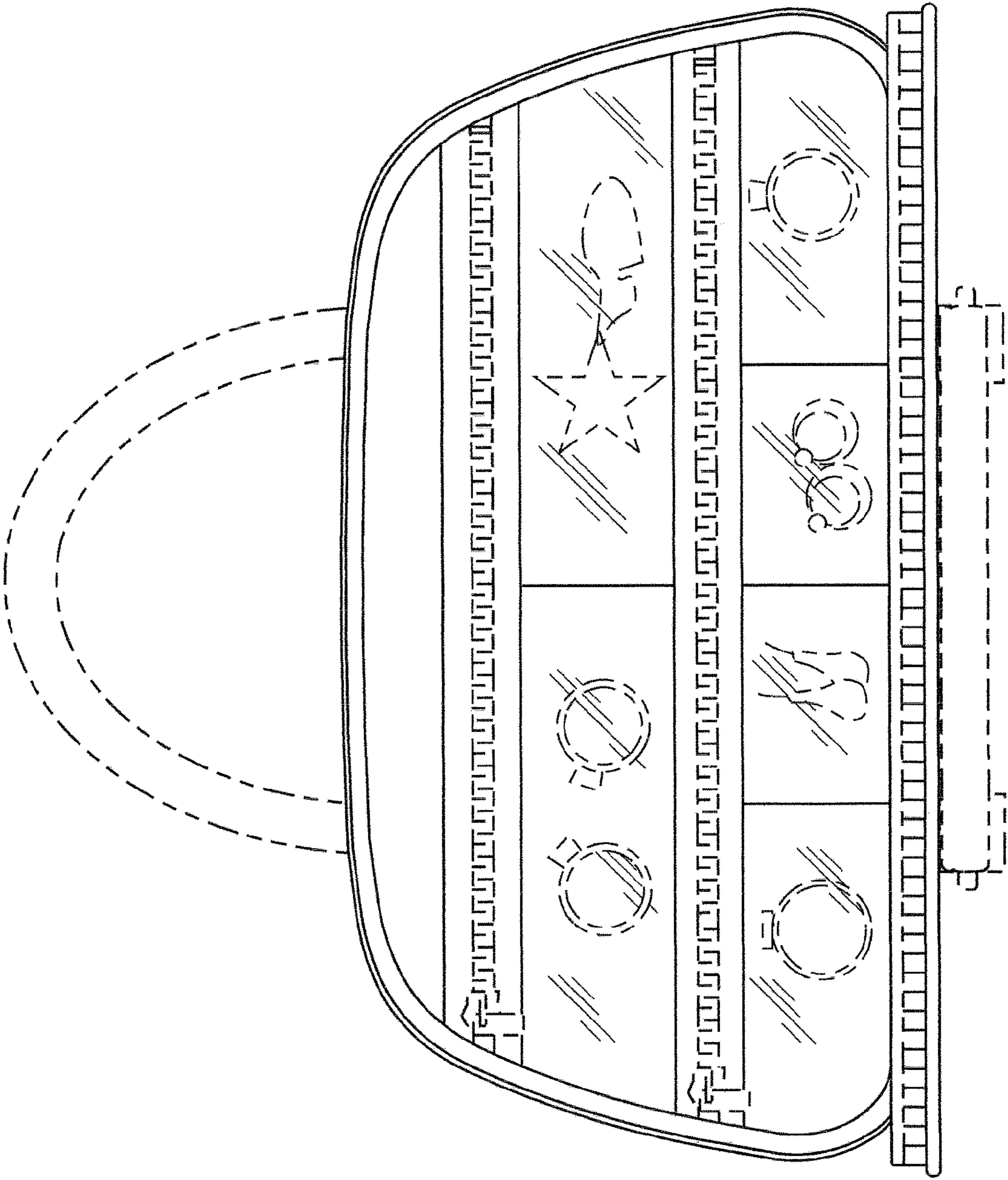

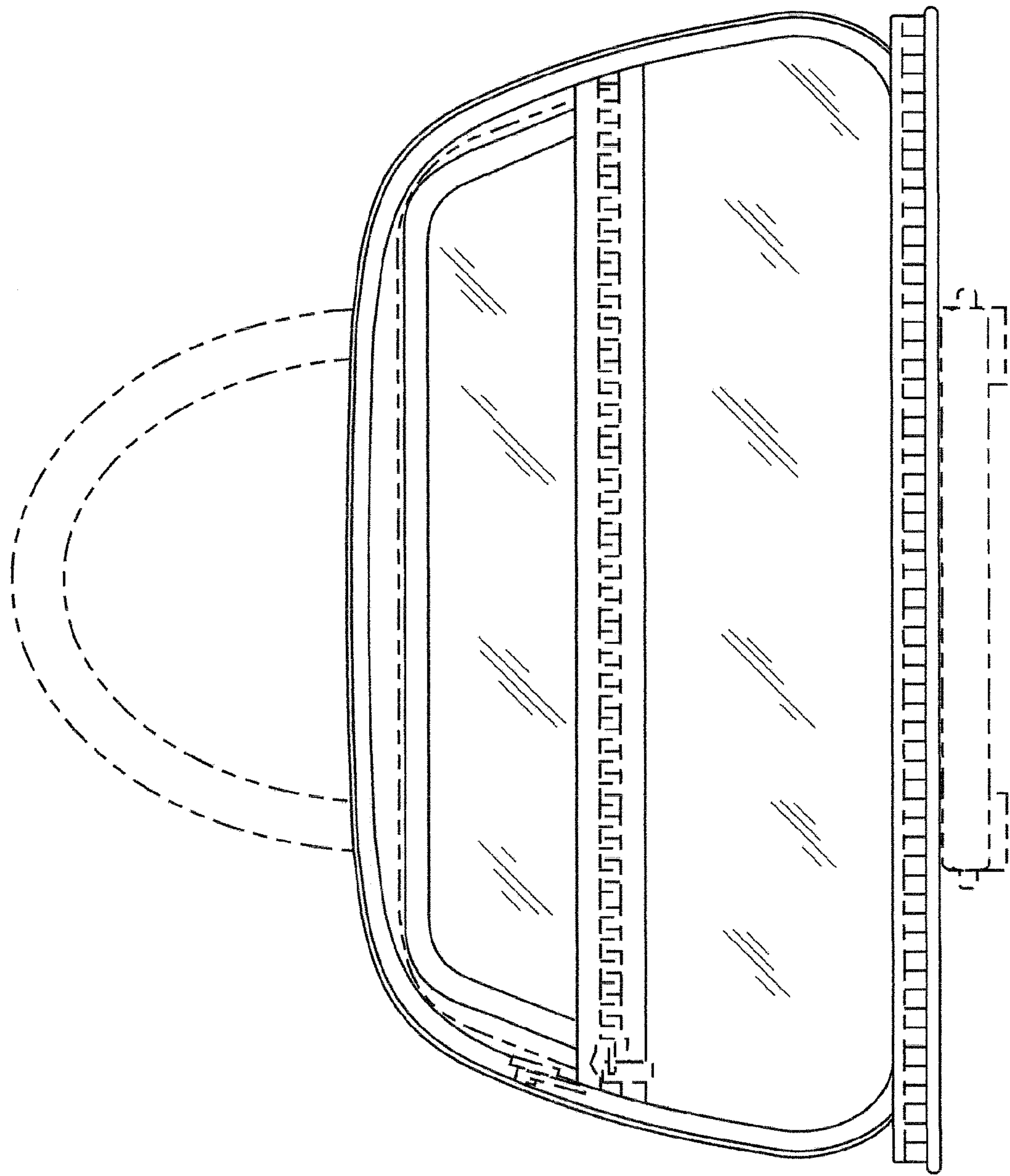
