FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;

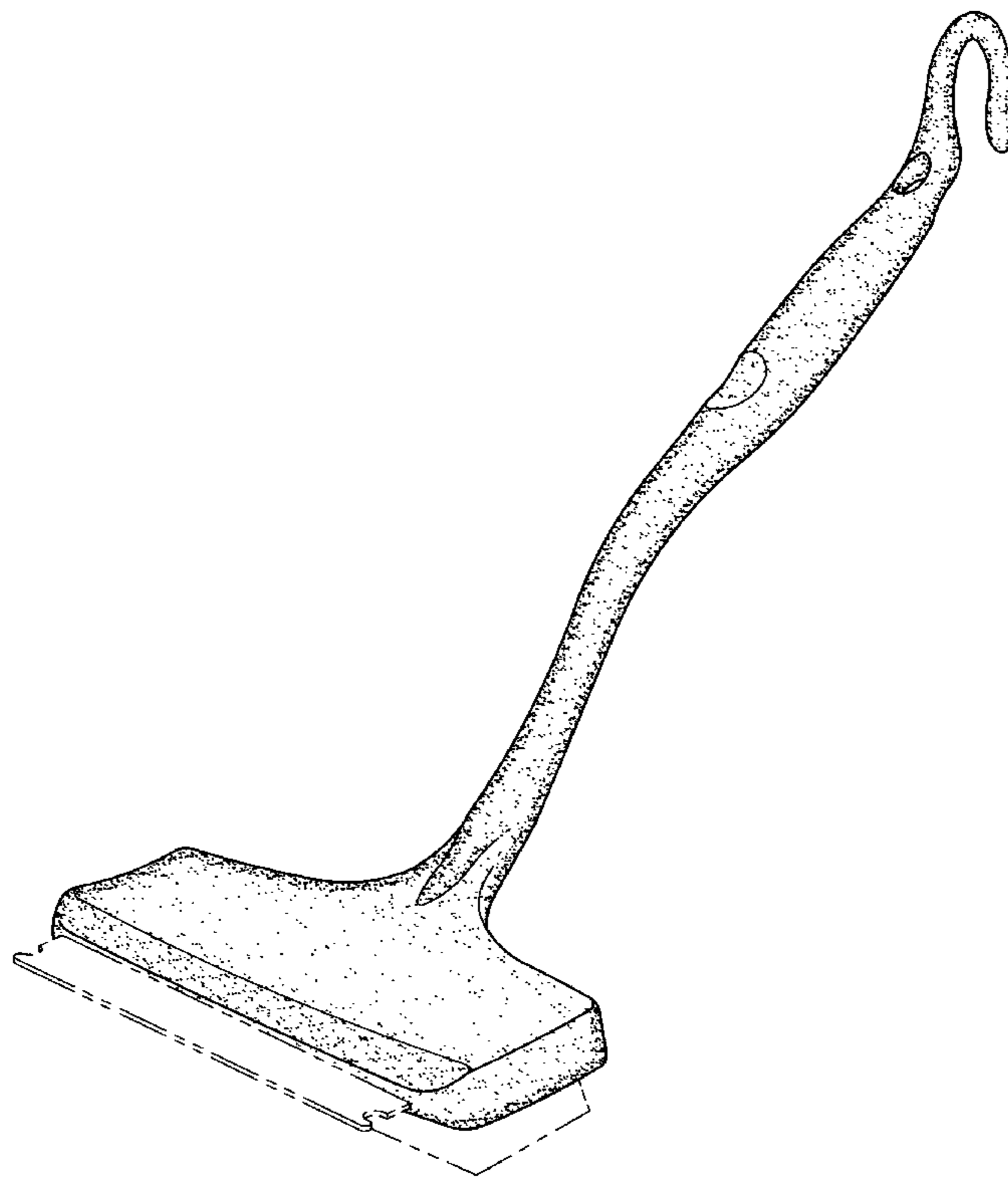
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

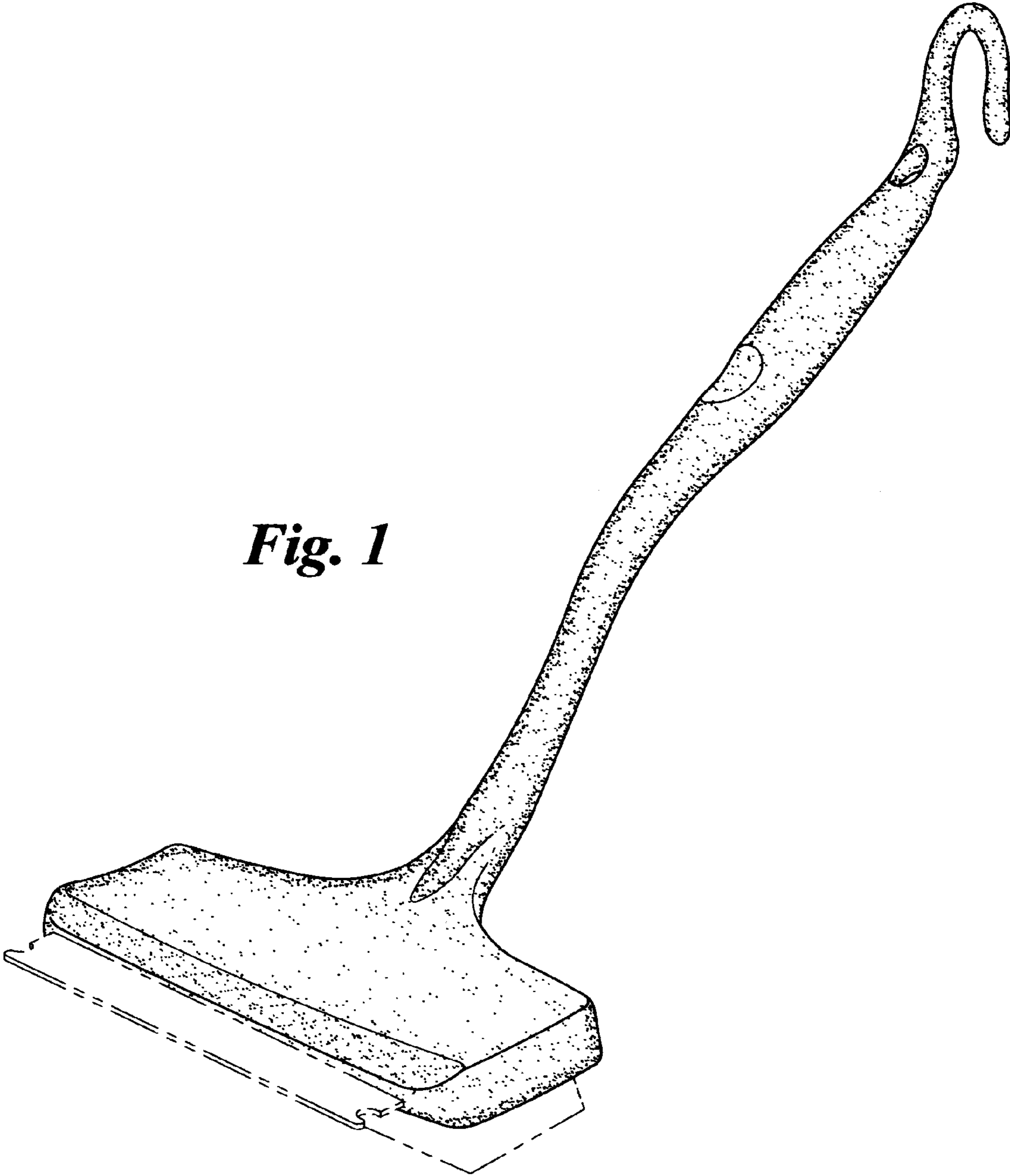
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

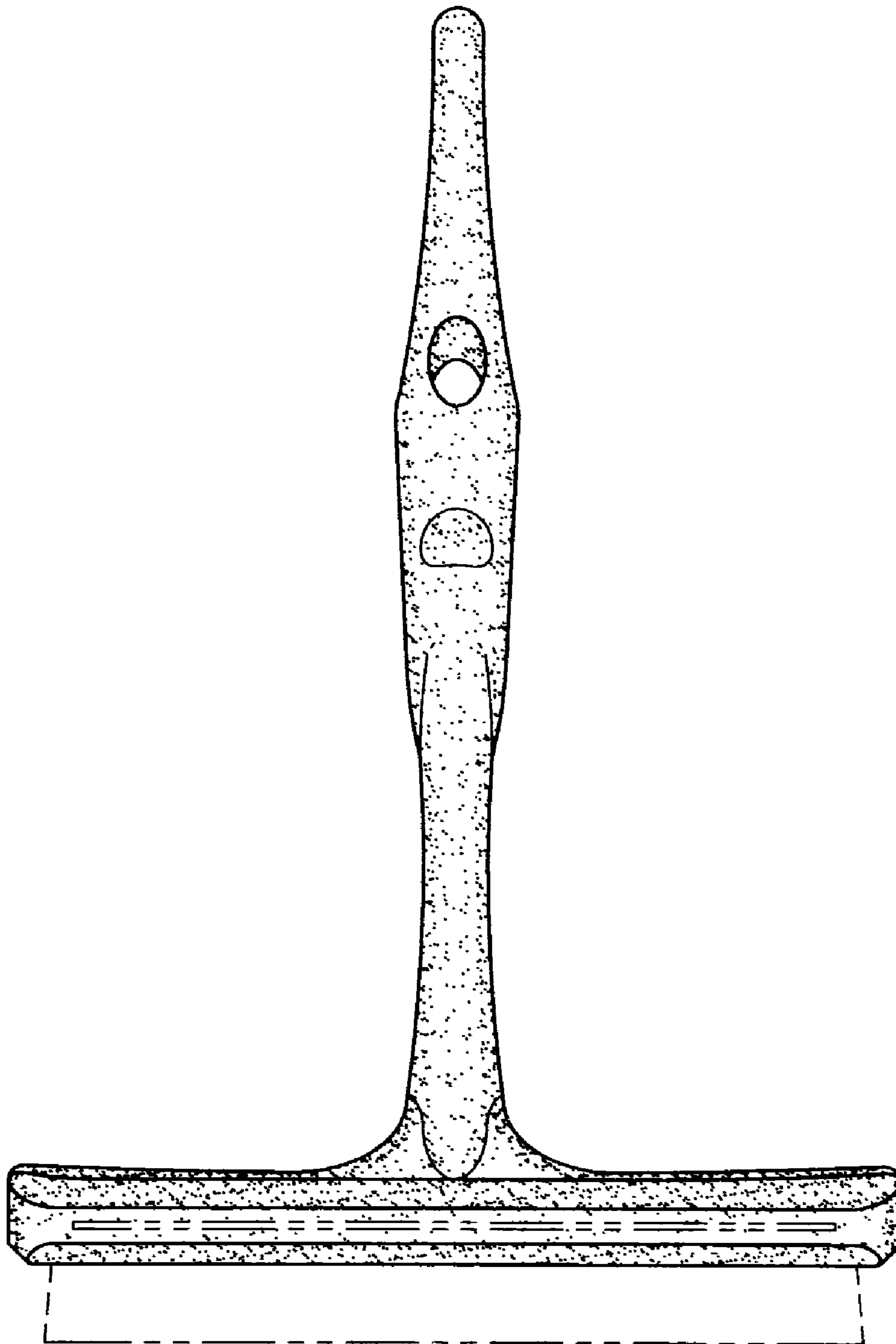
The side elevational view not illustrated is a mirror image of the side elevational view illustrated in FIG. 3 and the broken line showings form no part of the claimed design.

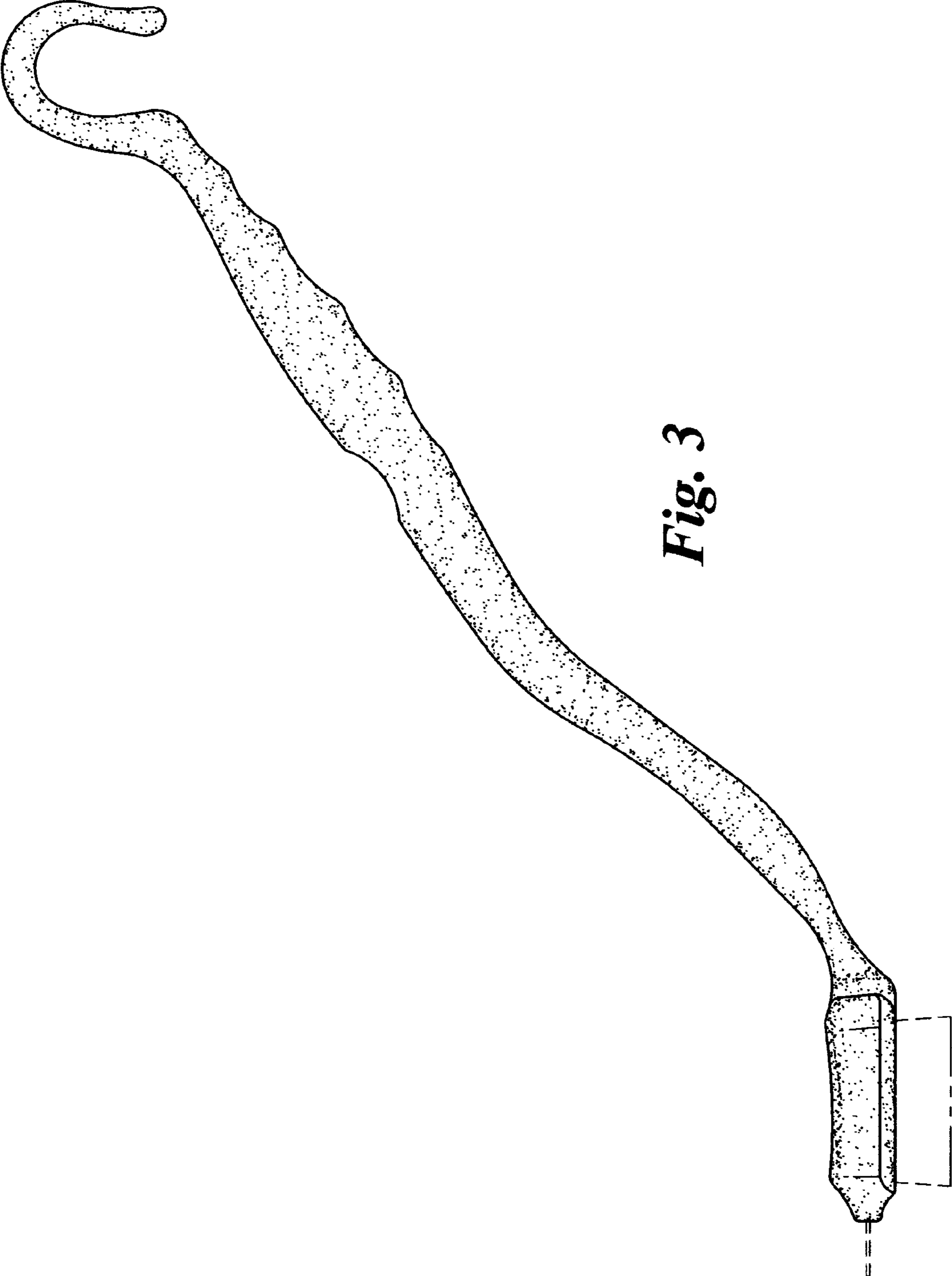




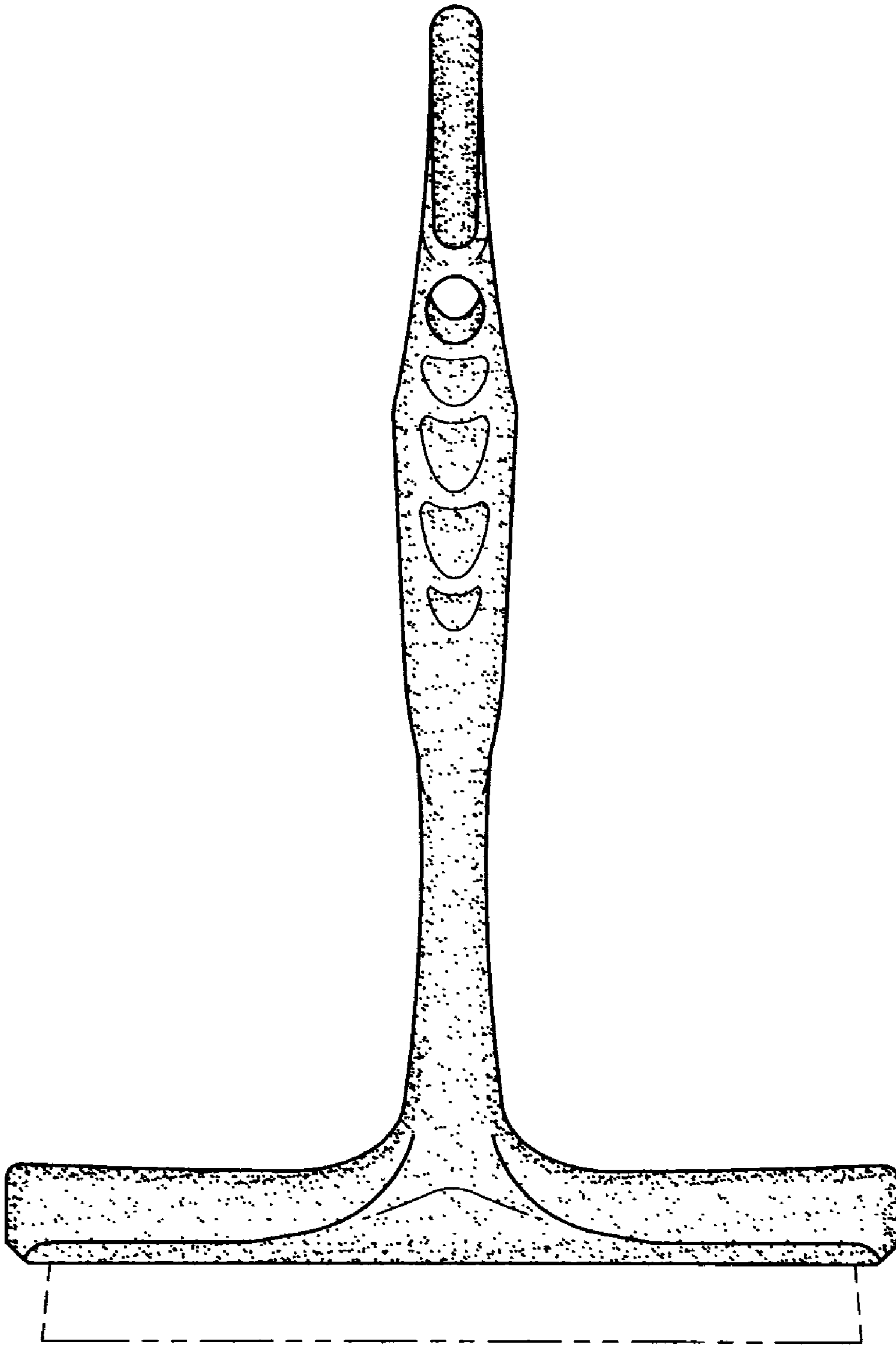

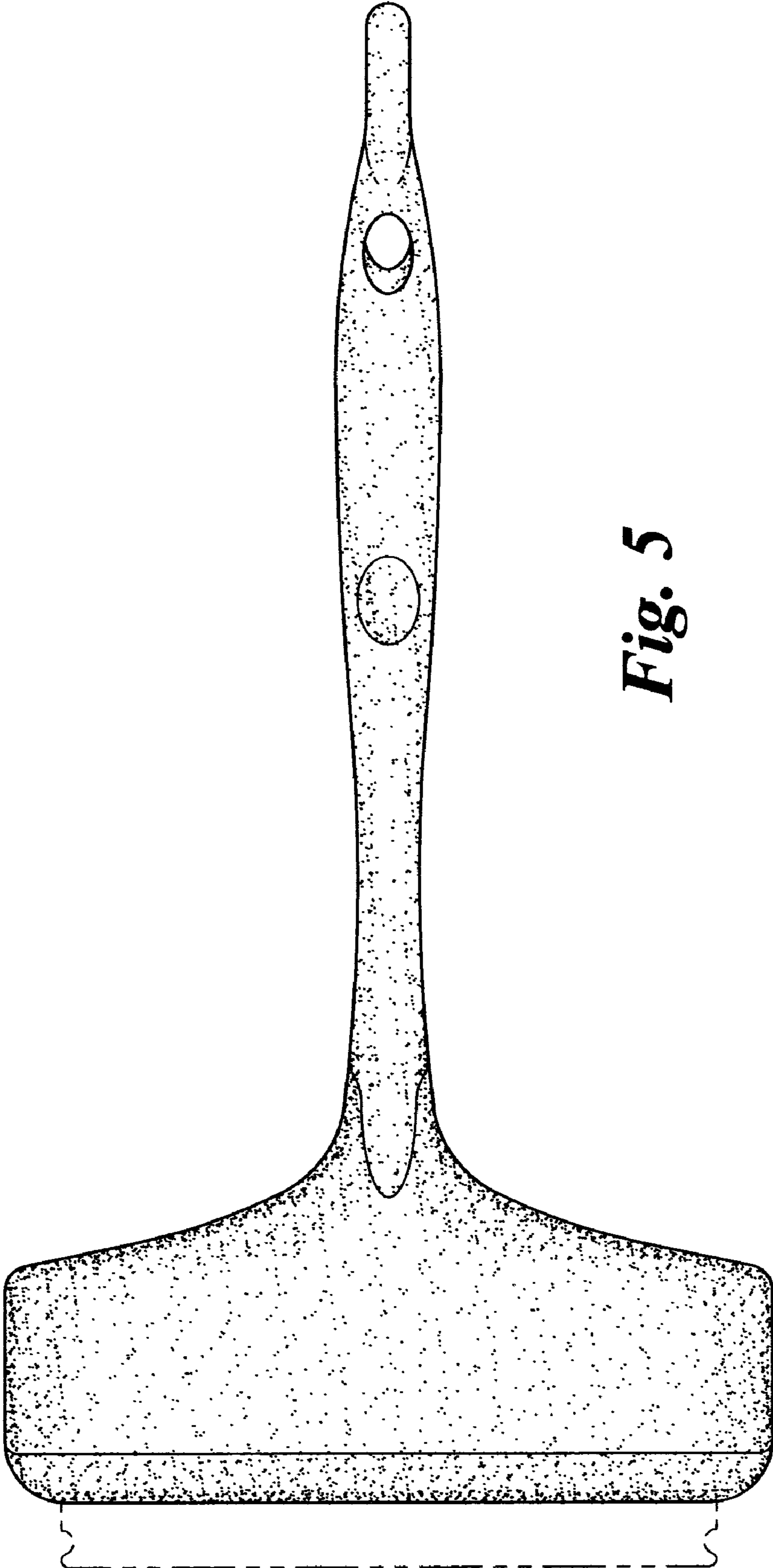

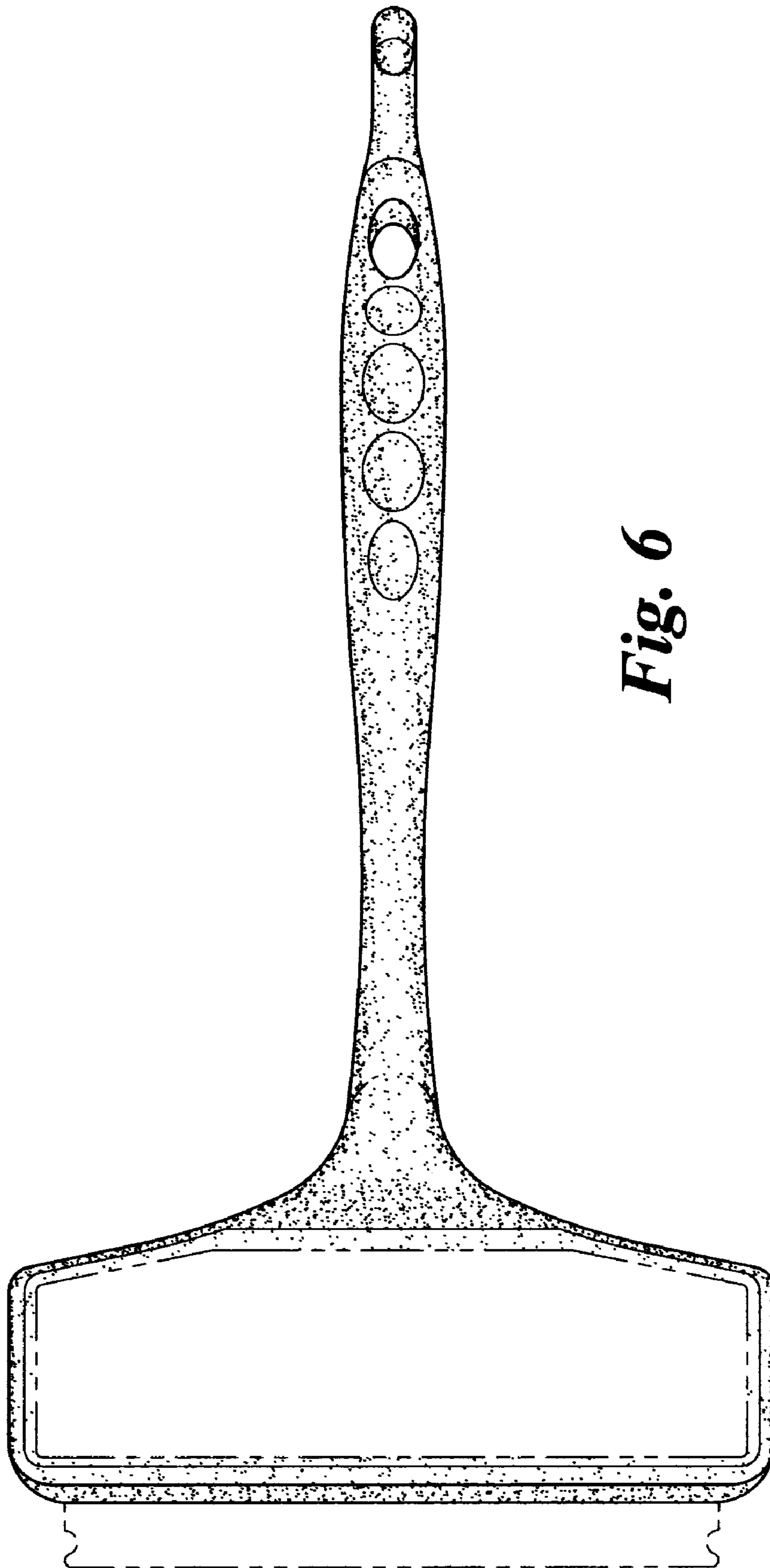
