(57) **CLAIM**

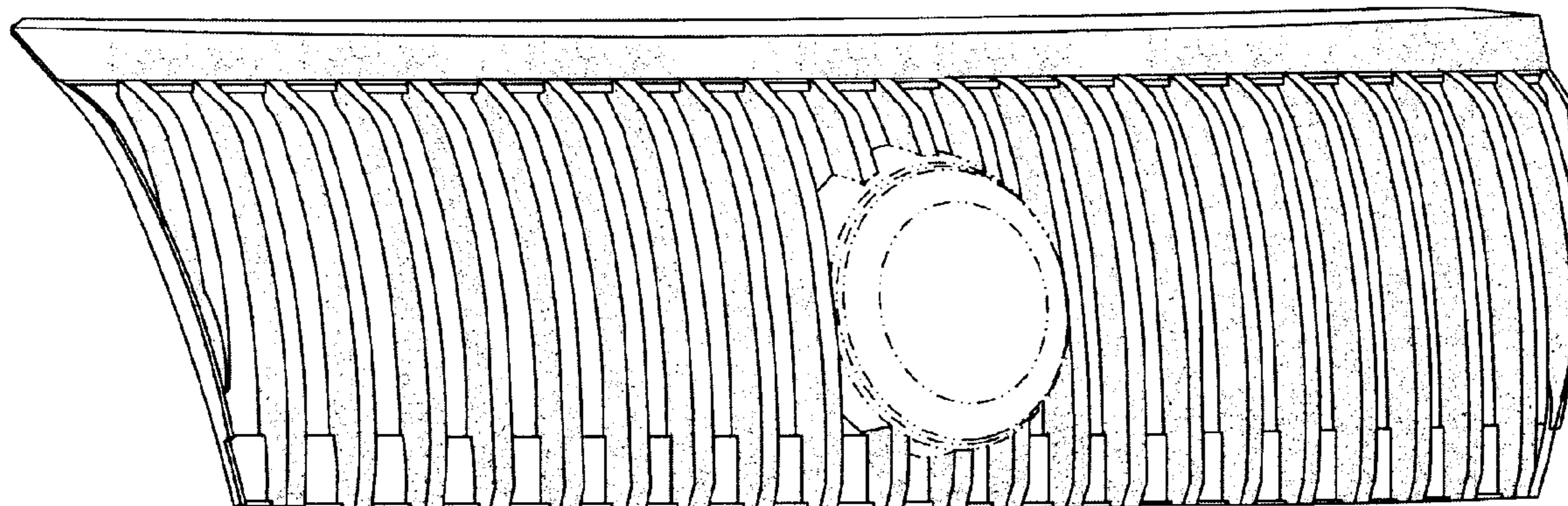
The ornamental design for an automobile grille, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the vehicle grille;
 FIG. 2 is a front view of the vehicle grille;
 FIG. 3 is a left side view of the vehicle grille, the right side (not shown) is a mirror image of the left side;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the vehicle grille; and,
 FIG. 5 is a detailed view of the area marked 5 in FIG. 2.

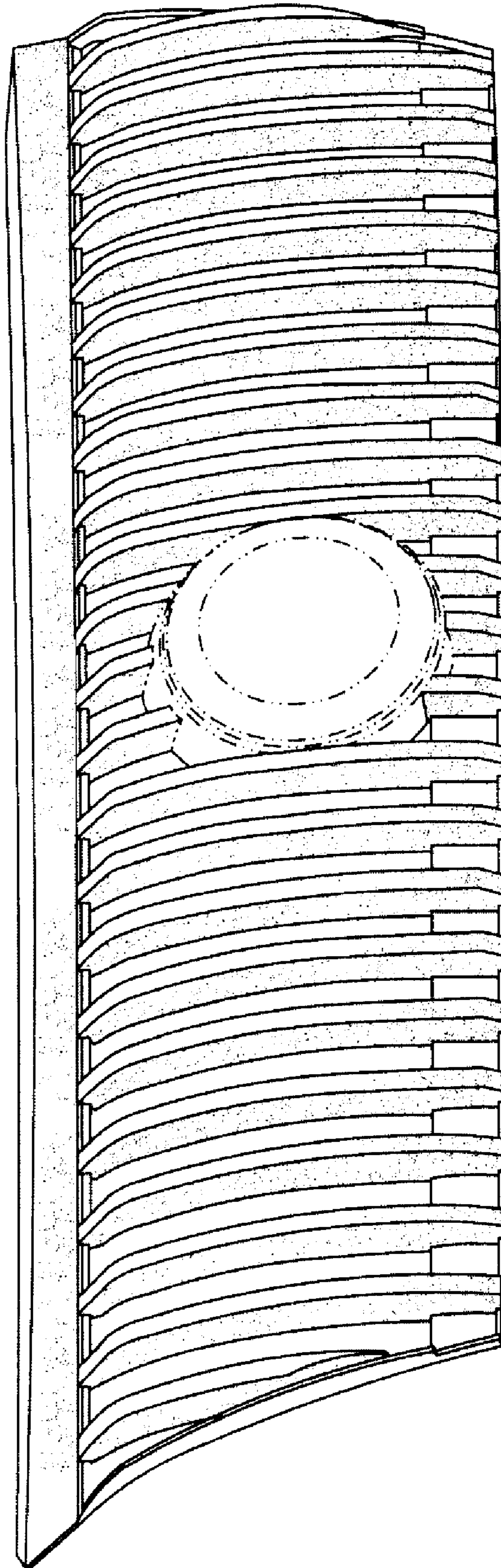

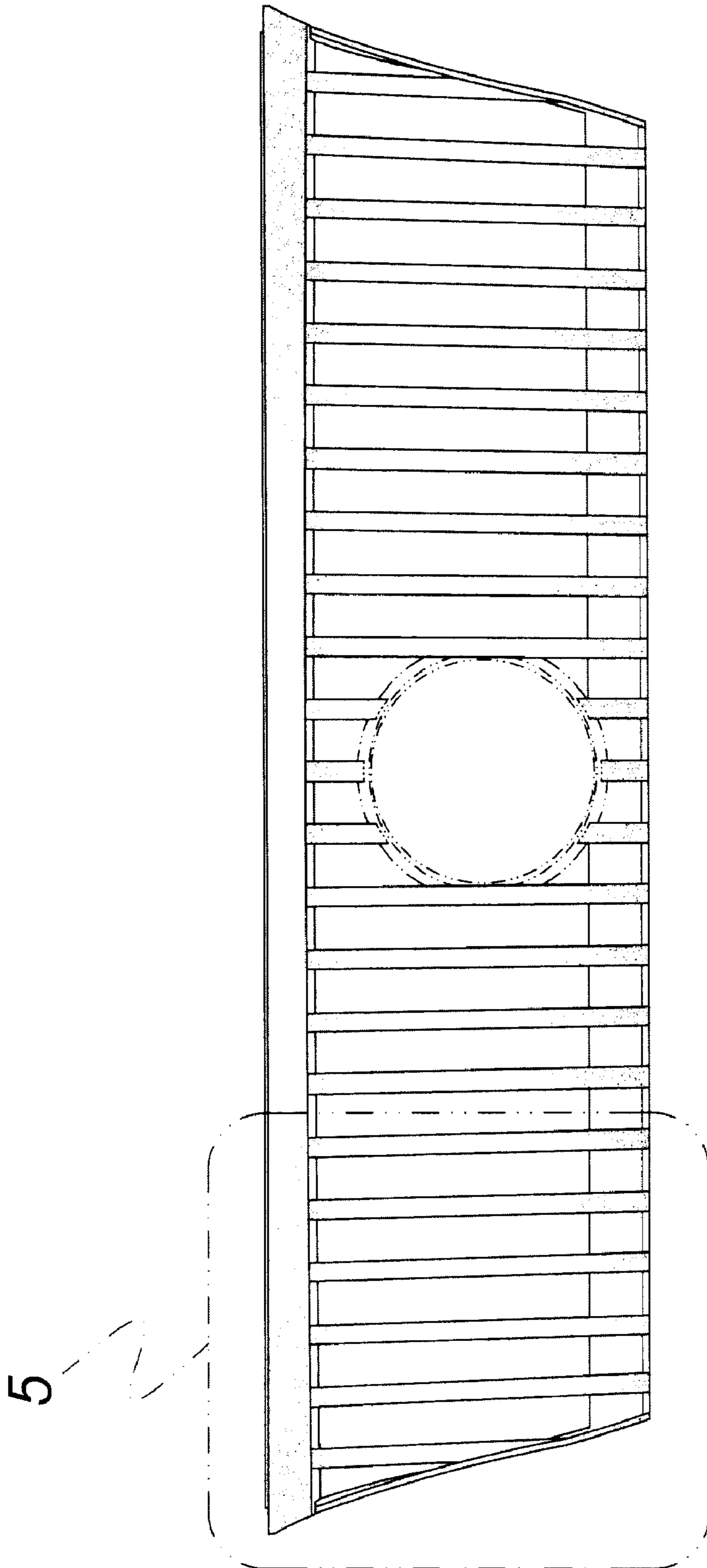

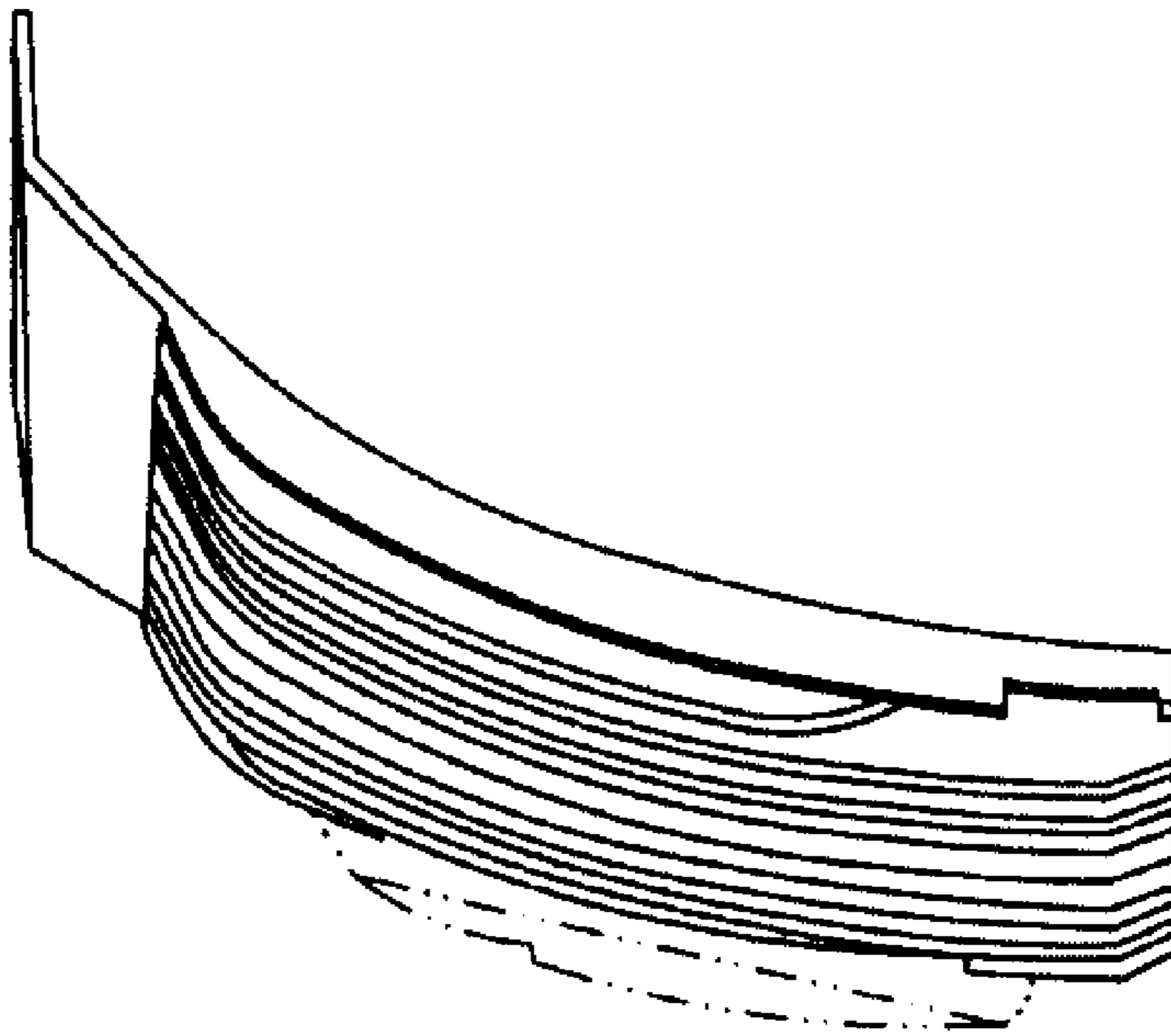

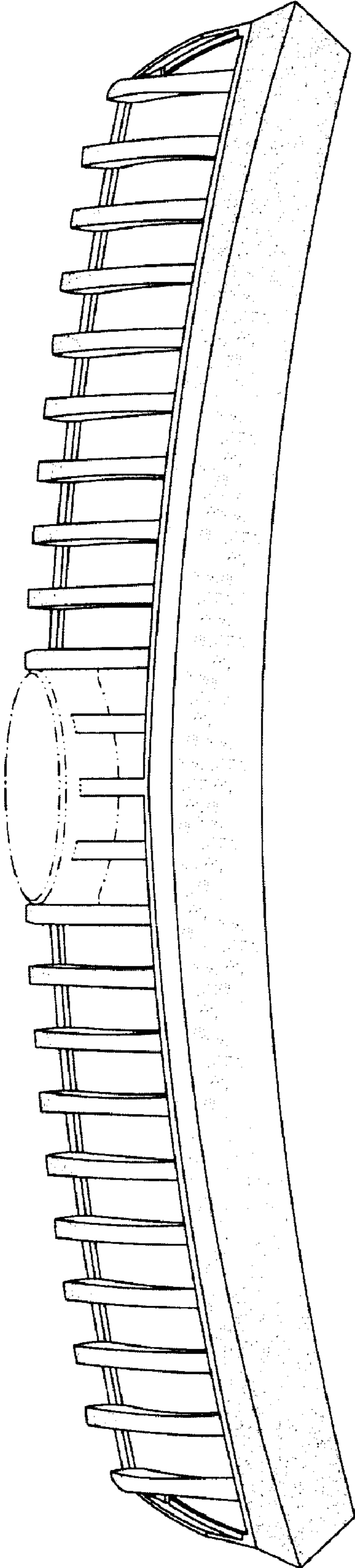

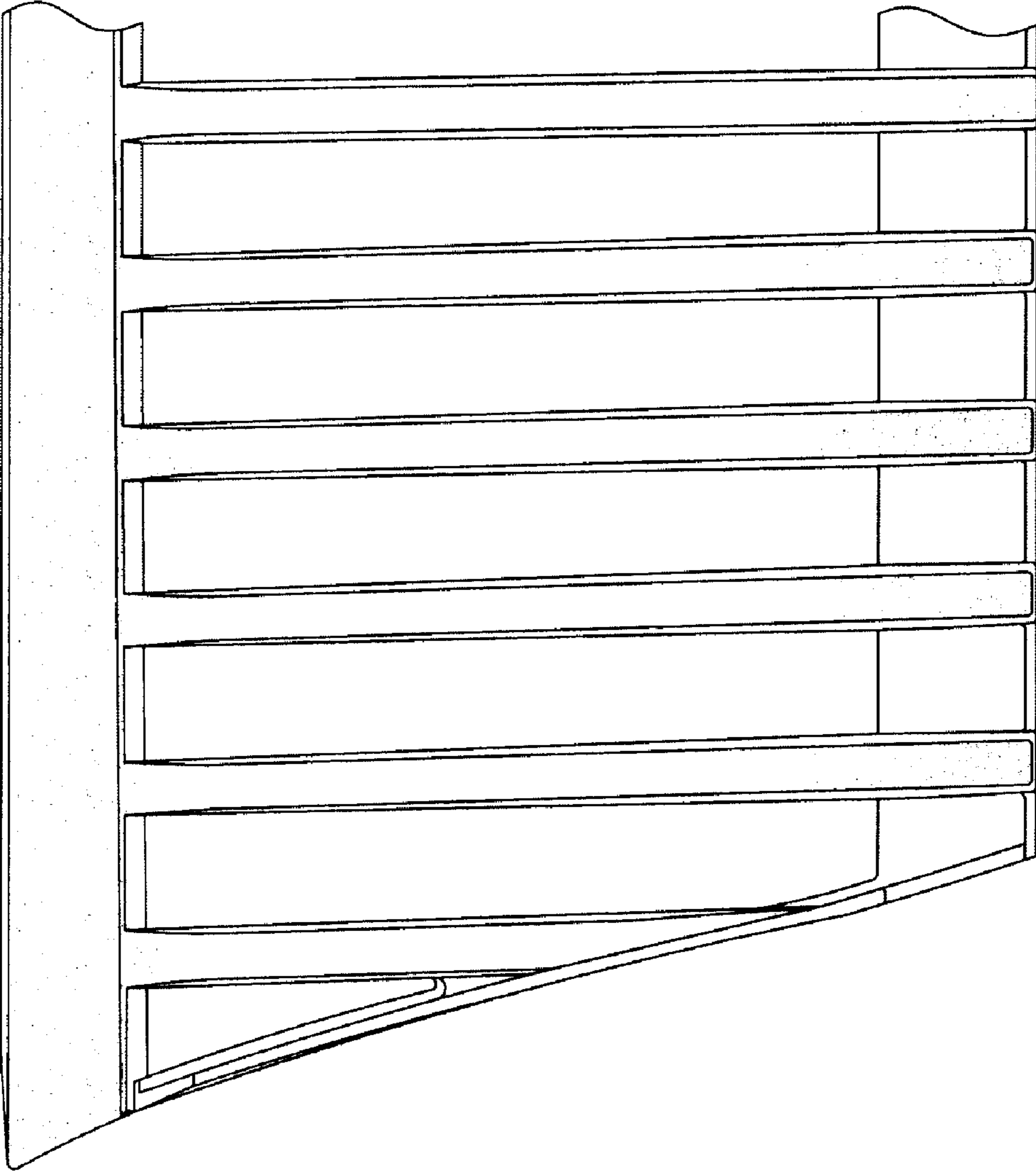
