(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a surface configuration of a door for a vehicle, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This application is related to the following co-pending application, of the inventor, filed on even date herewith:

Application Ser. No. 29/270,222, entitled "Surface Configuration of a Vehicle, Toy, and/or Other Replicas".

FIG. 1 is a left perspective view of a first embodiment of a surface configuration of a door for a vehicle according to my novel design;

FIG. 2 is a right perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a left perspective view of a second embodiment of the surface configuration of a door for a vehicle according to my novel design;

FIG. 7 is a right perspective view FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a front view FIG. 6;

FIG. 9 is a right side view FIG. 6; and,

FIG. 10 is a left side view FIG. 6.
