(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a switch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a switch of a first embodiment of the new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the switch of FIG. 1, the rear elevational view being a mirror image of the front elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the switch of FIG. 1, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of the left side elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the switch of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the switch of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a switch of a second embodiment of the new design;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the switch of FIG. 6, the rear elevational view being a mirror image of the front elevational view;

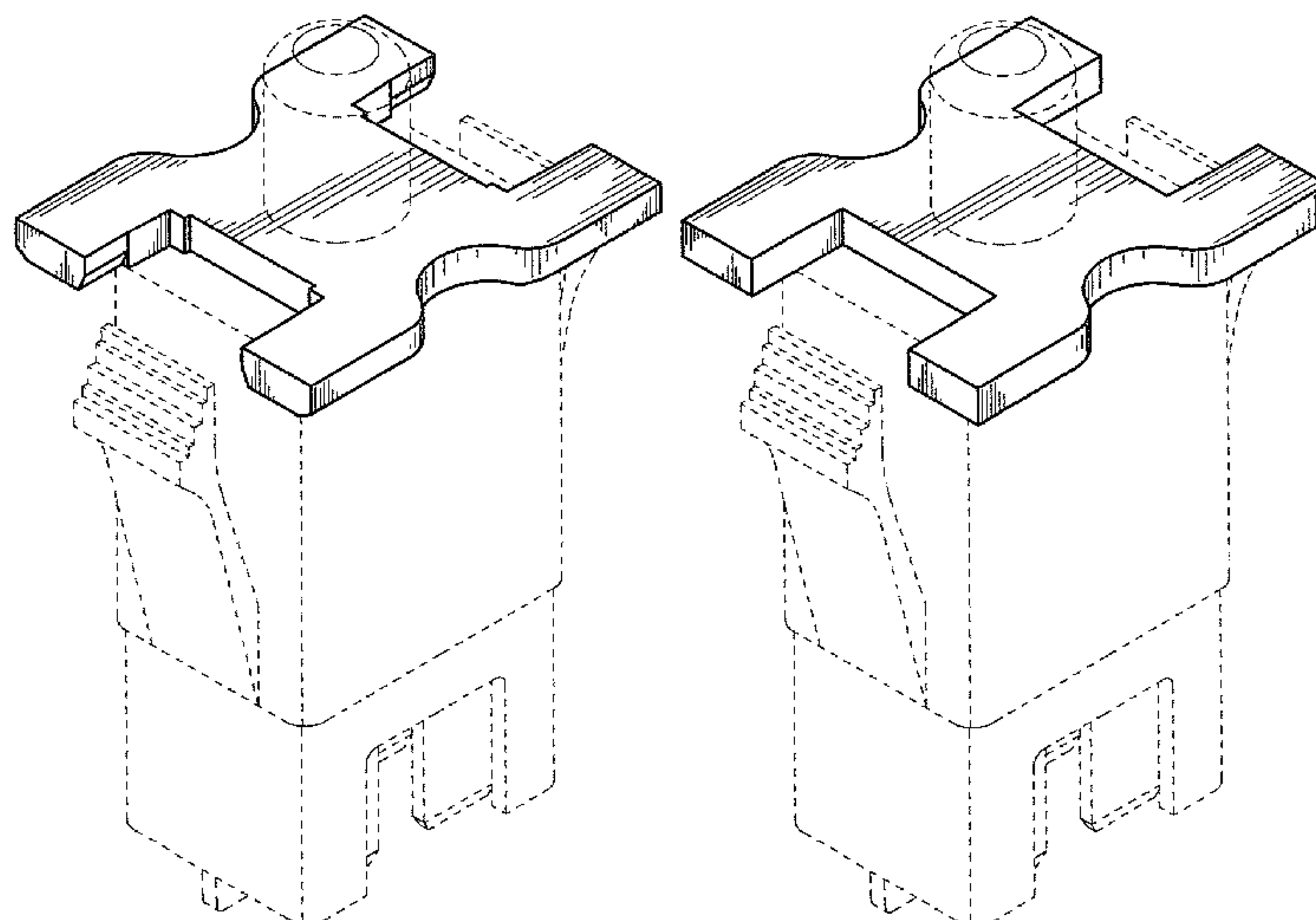
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of the switch of FIG. 6, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of the left side elevational view;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the switch of FIG. 6; and,

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of the switch of FIG. 6.

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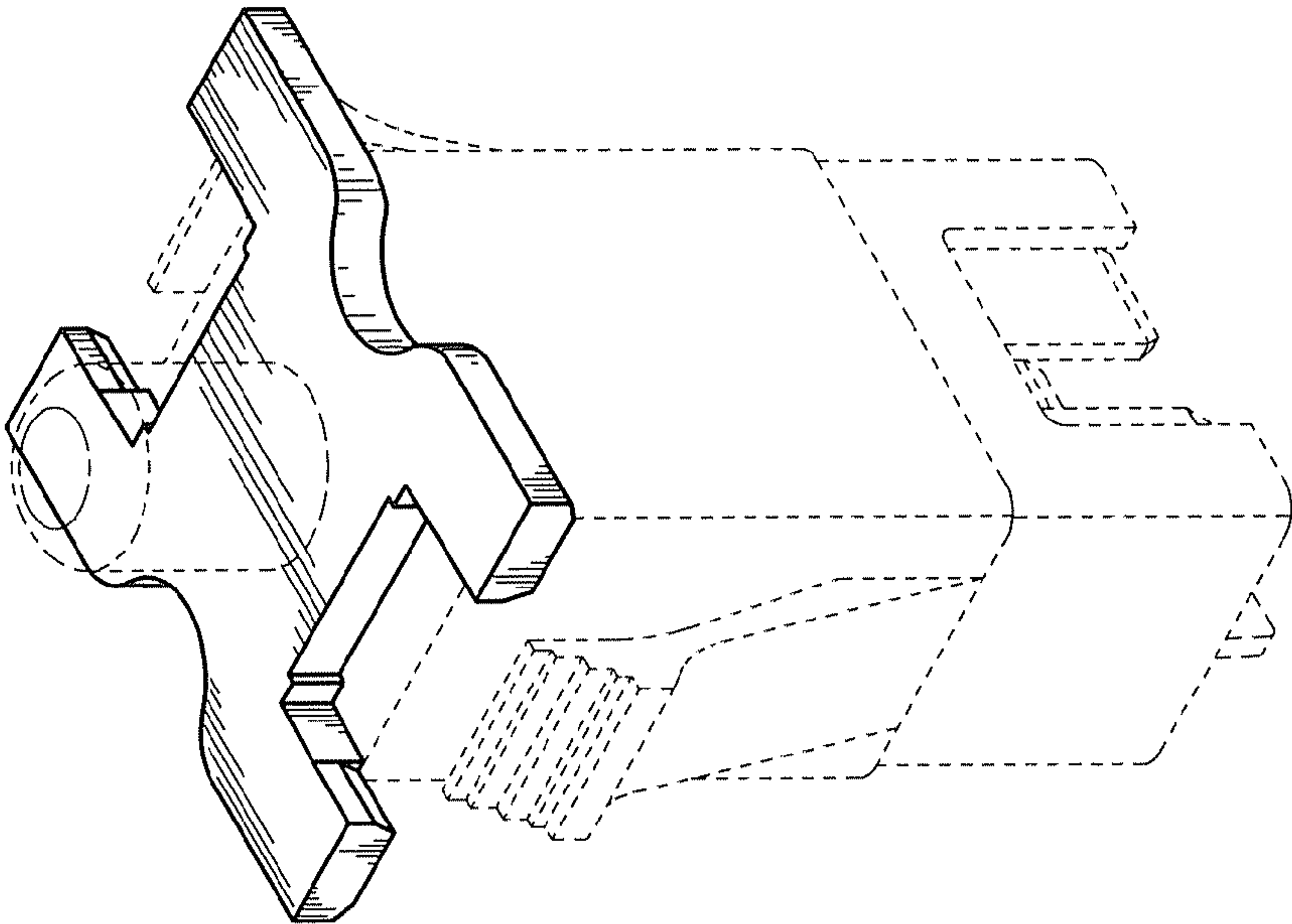

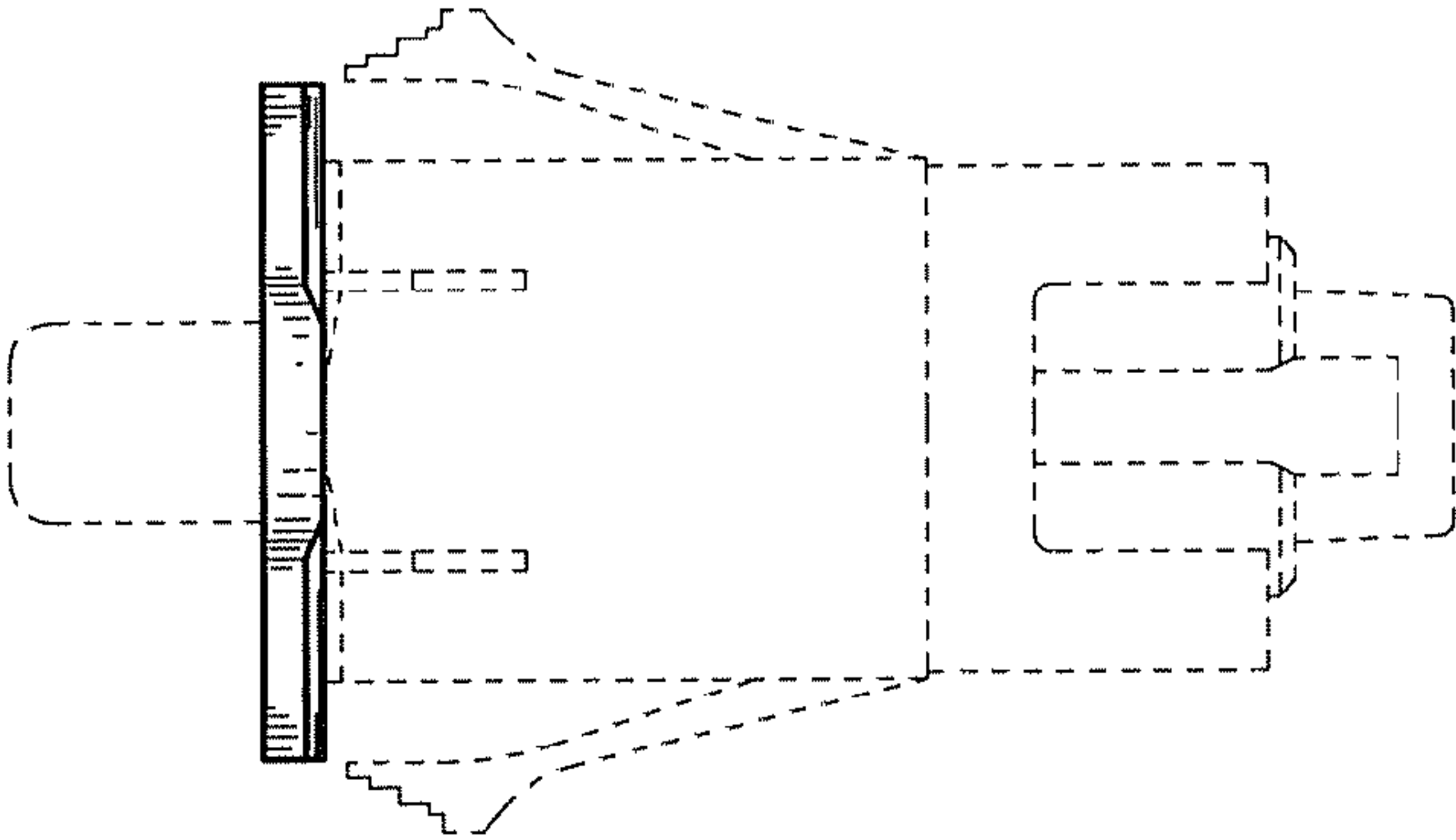

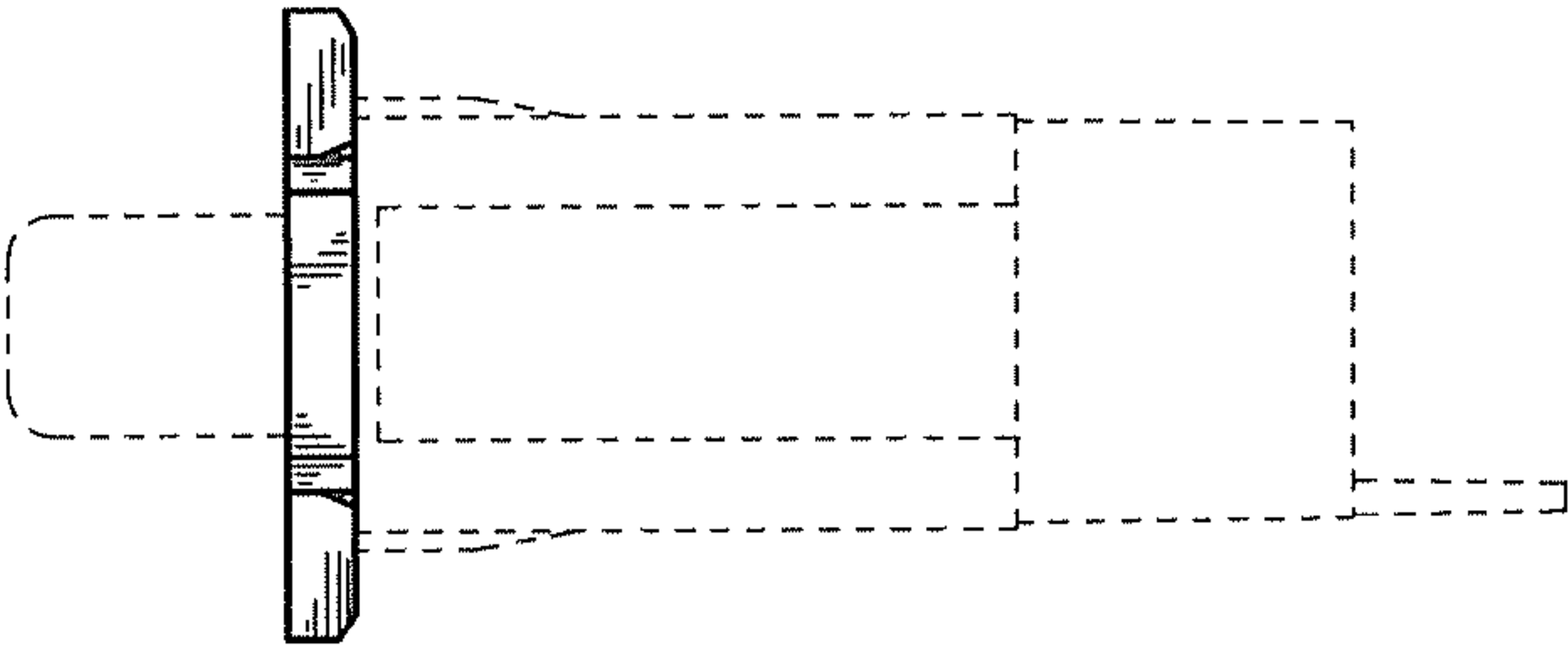

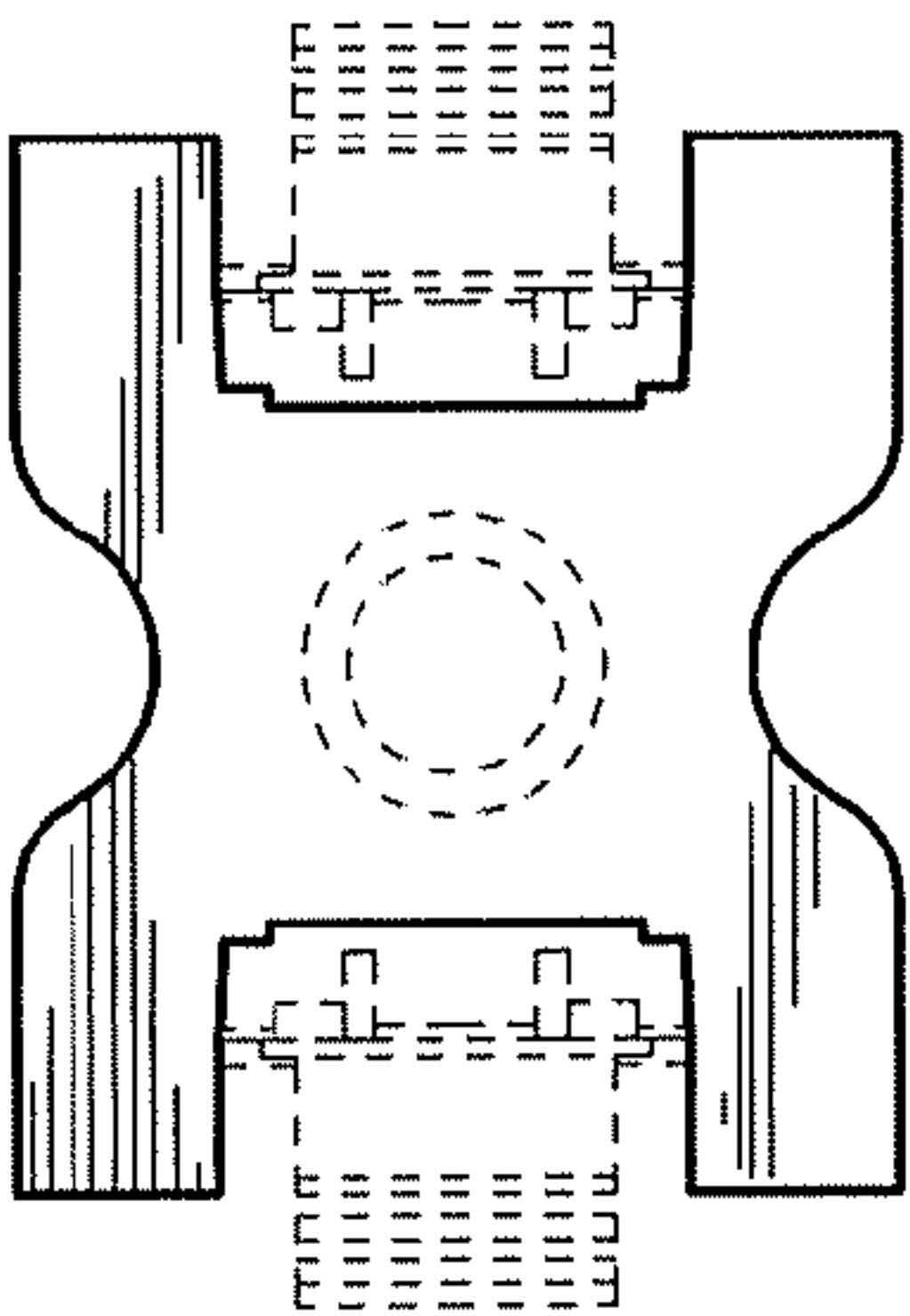

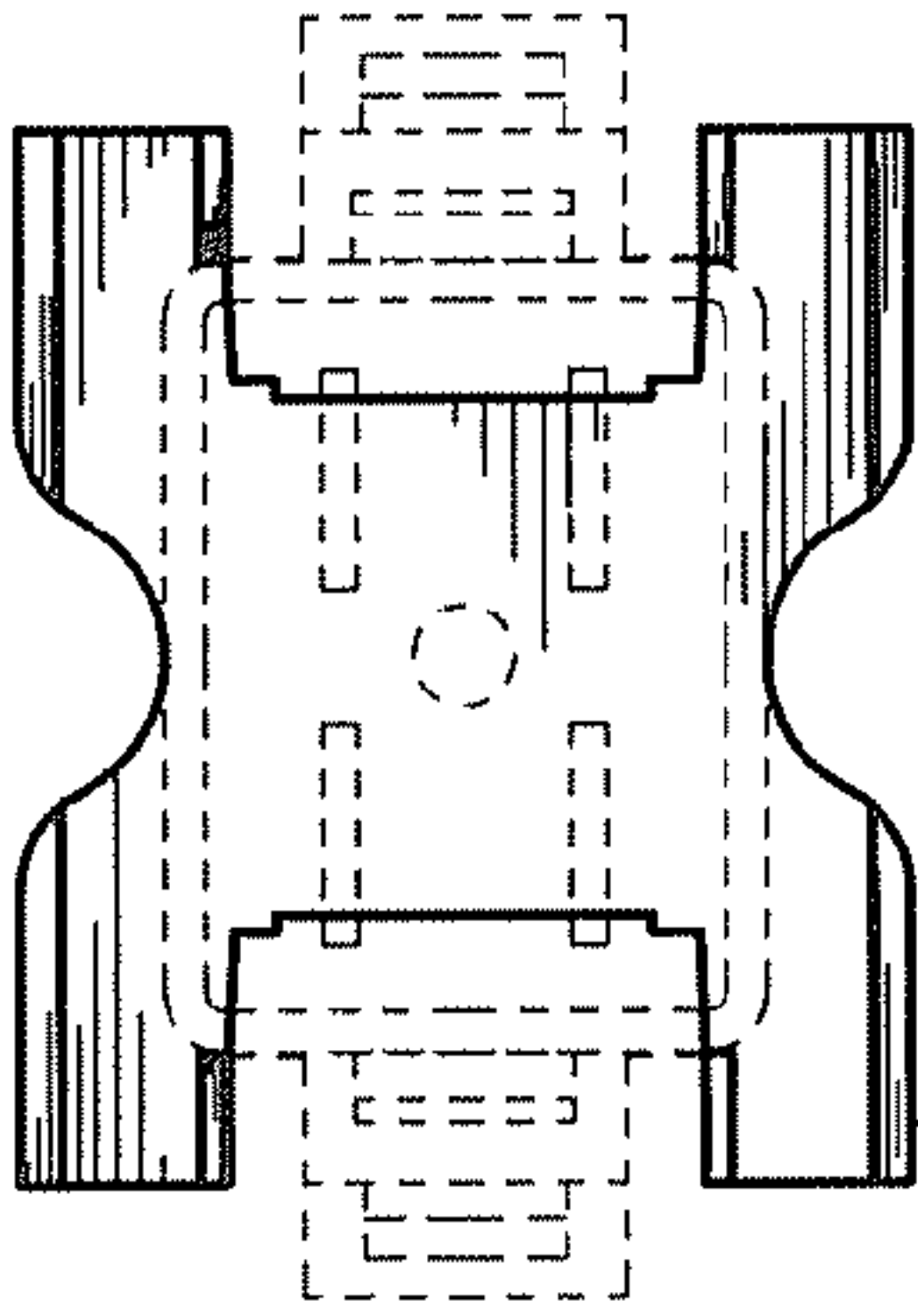

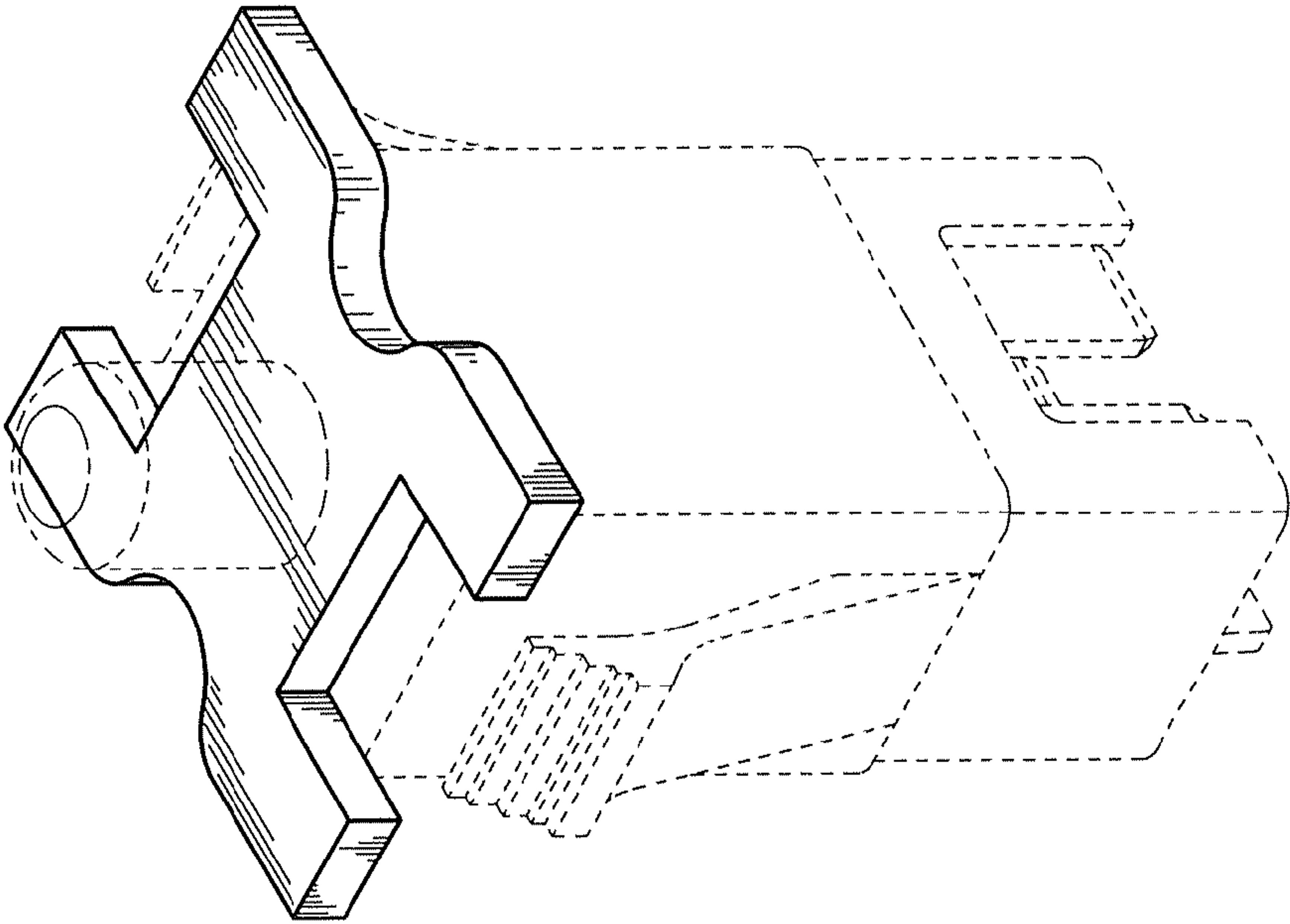

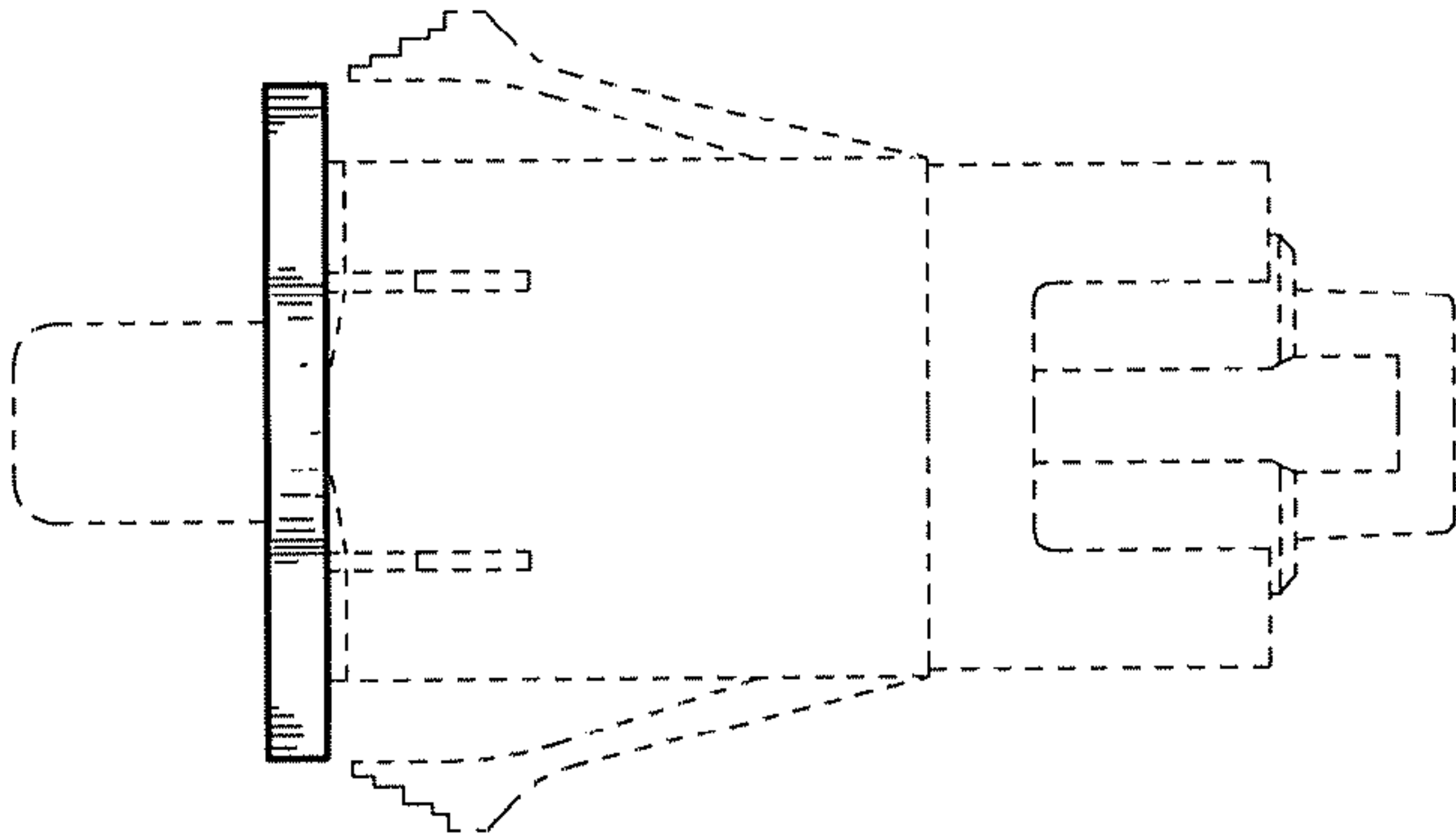

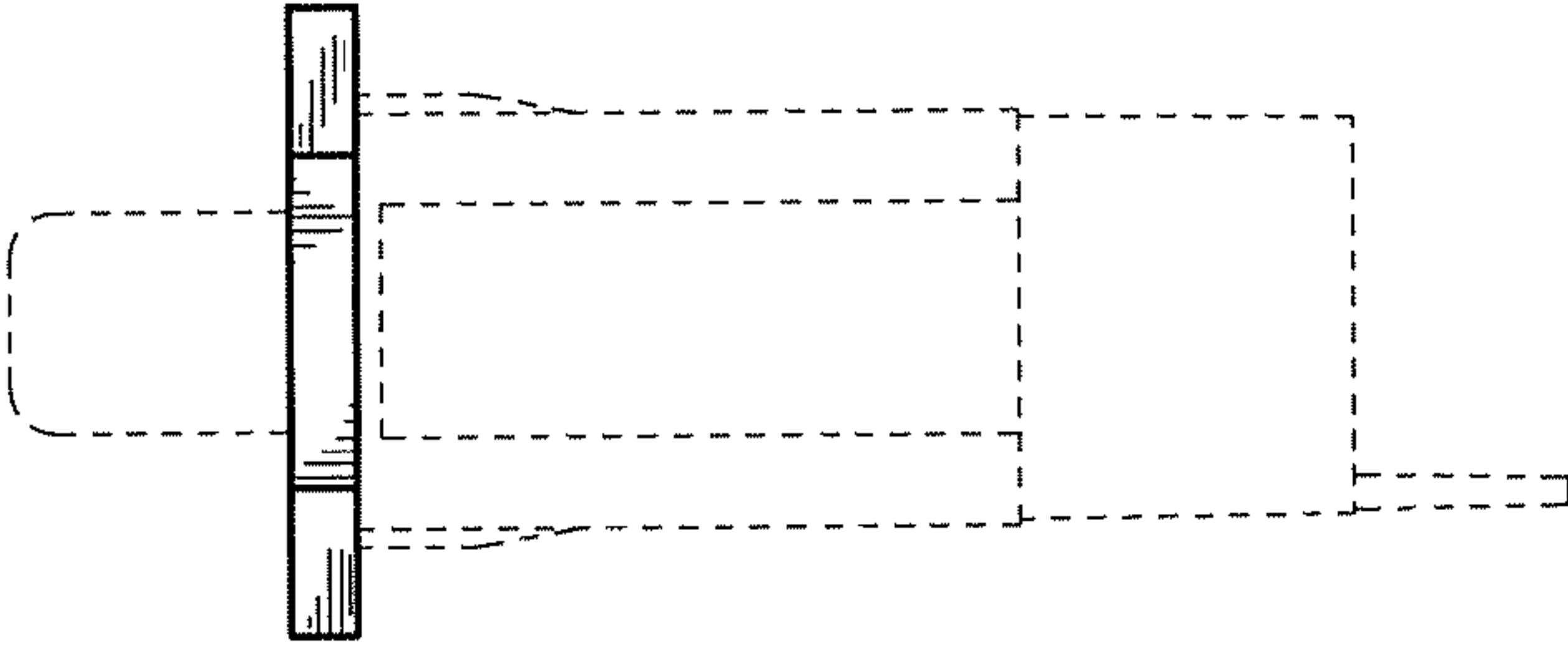

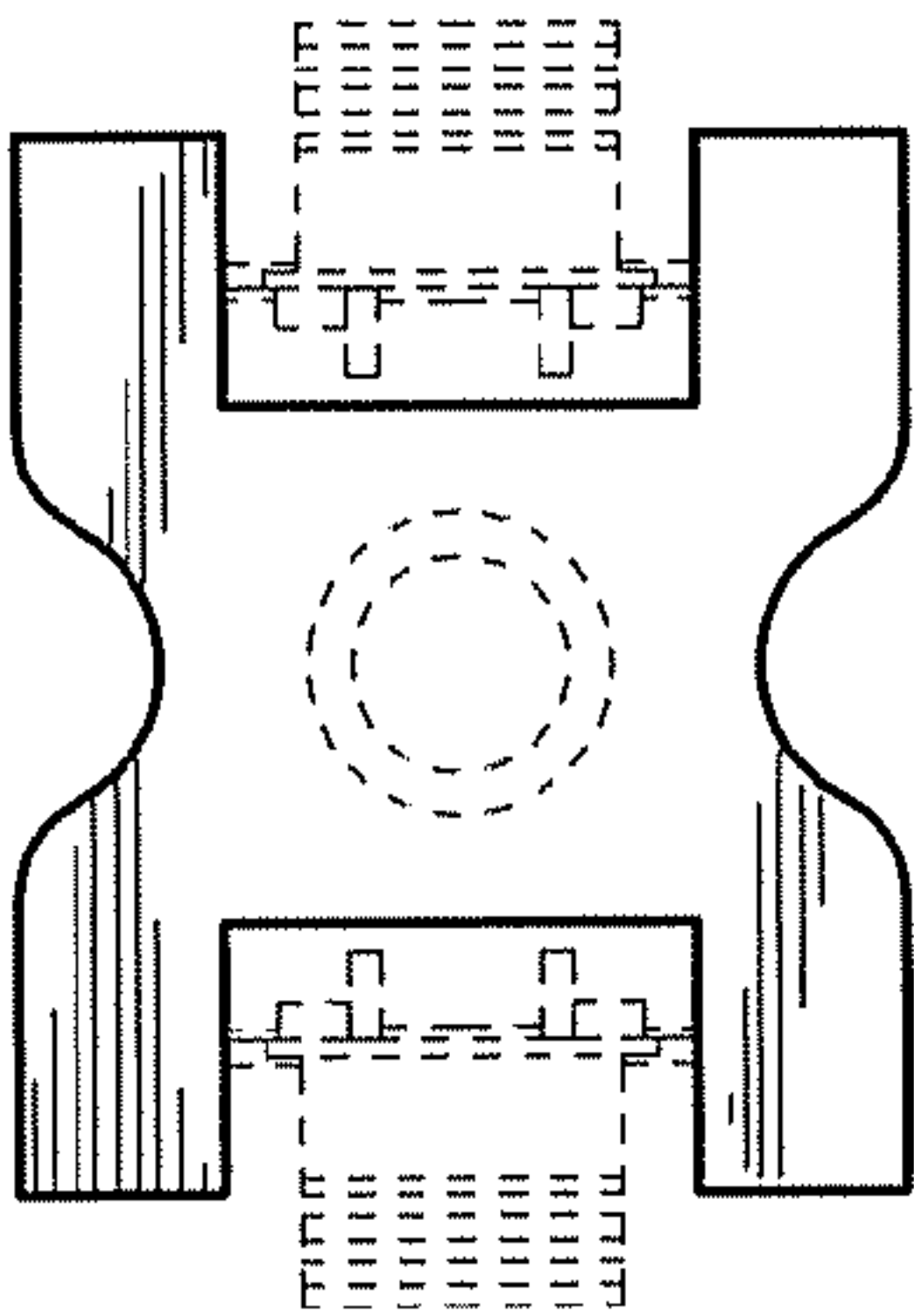

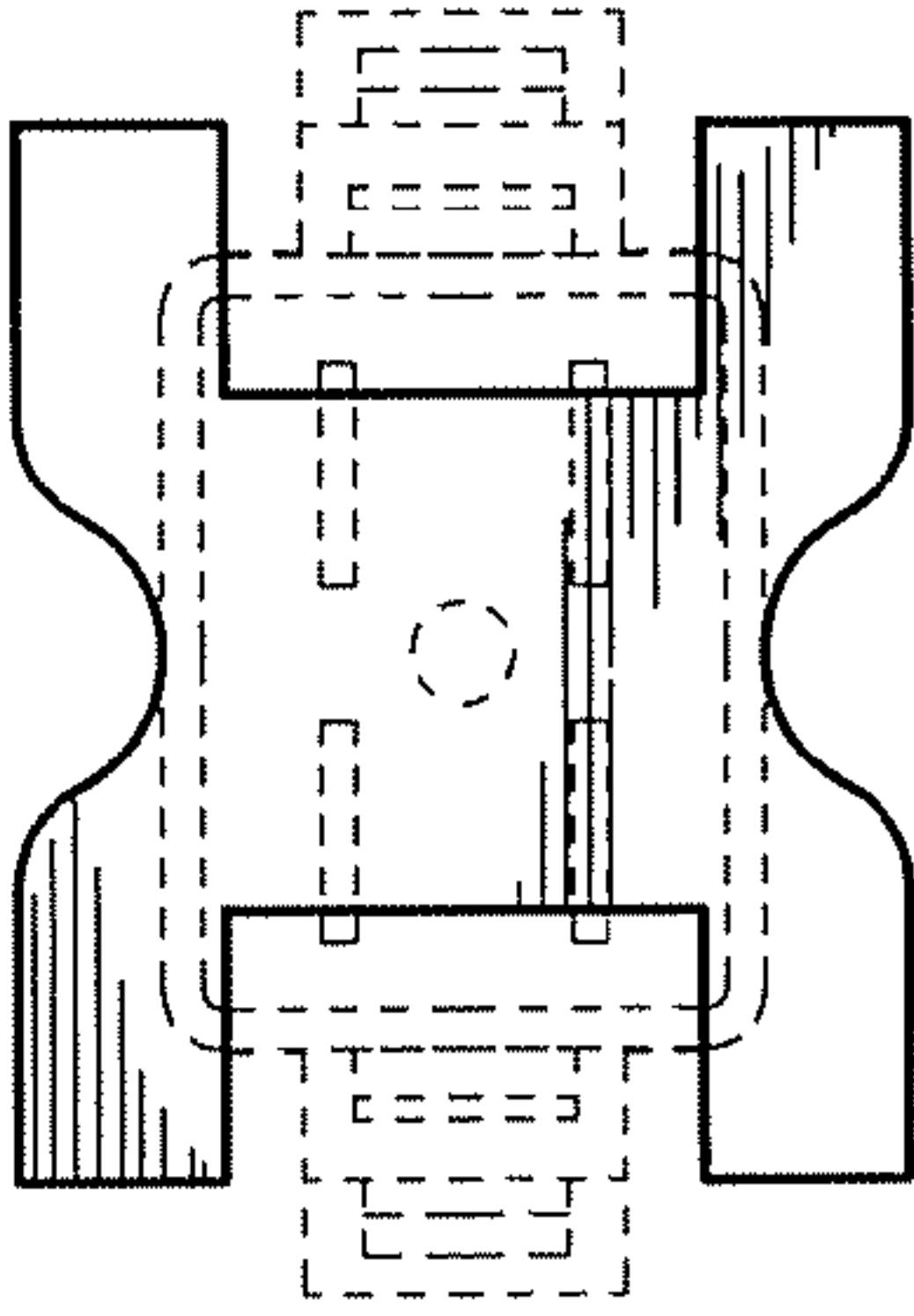
