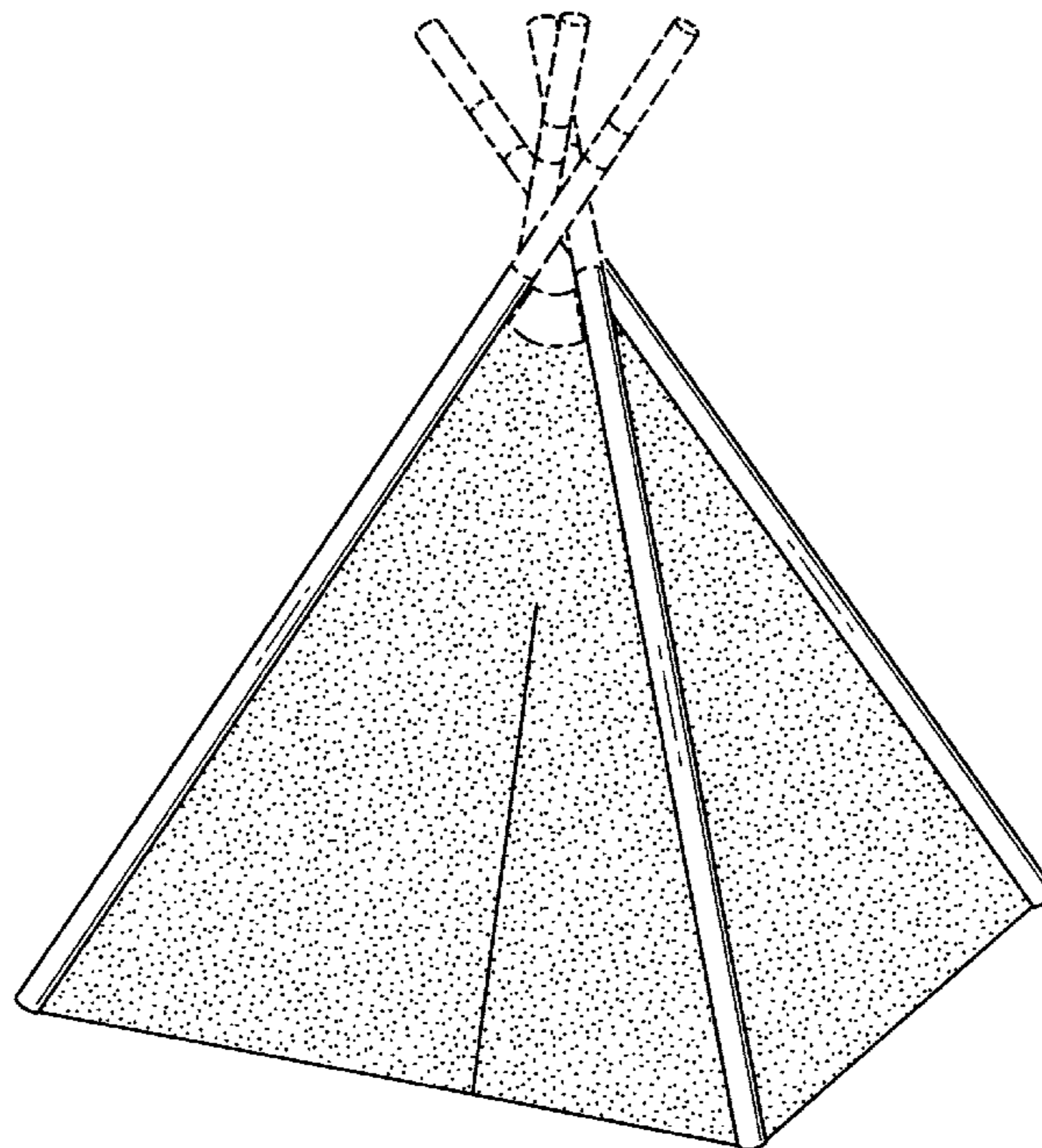
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

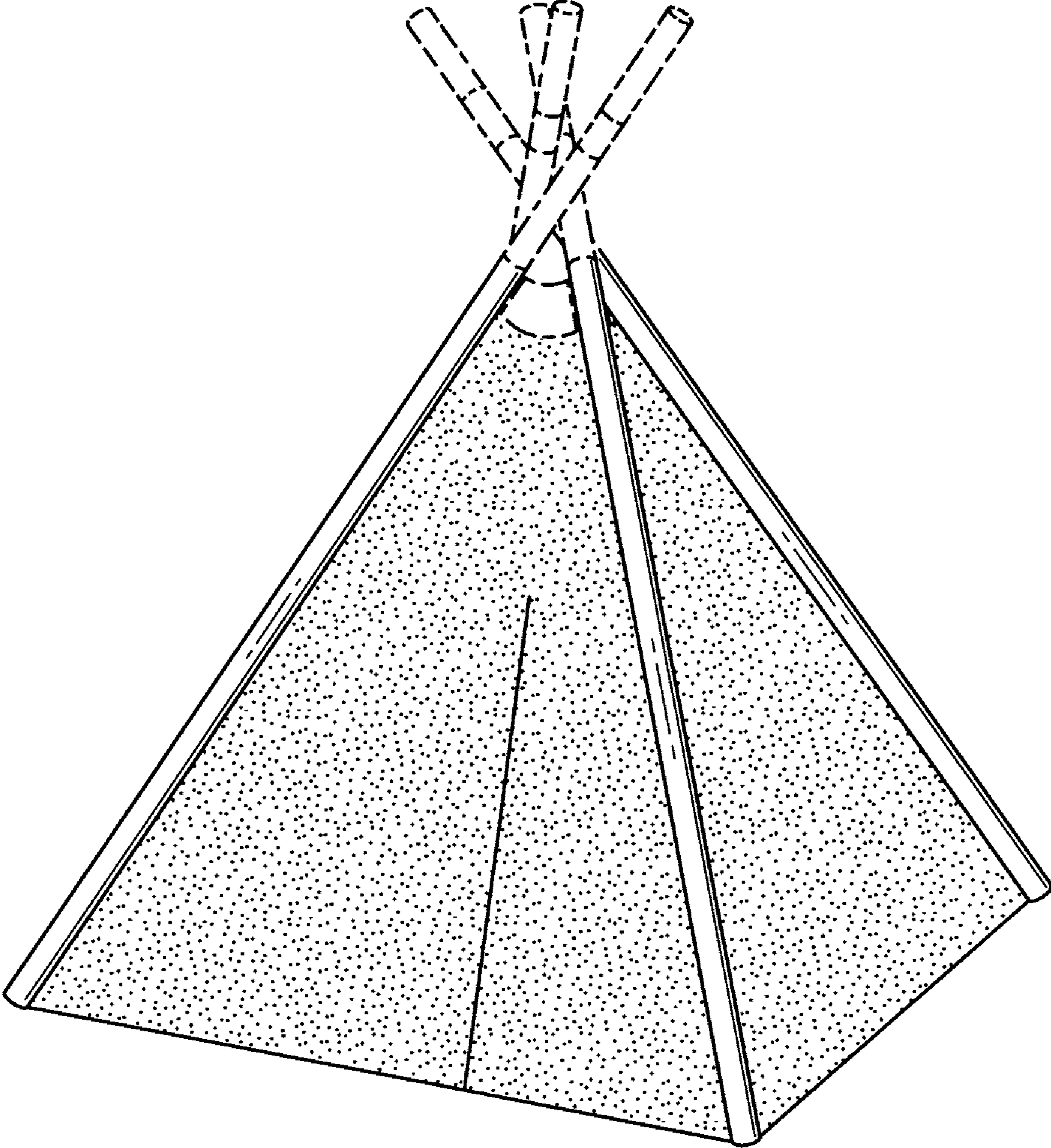

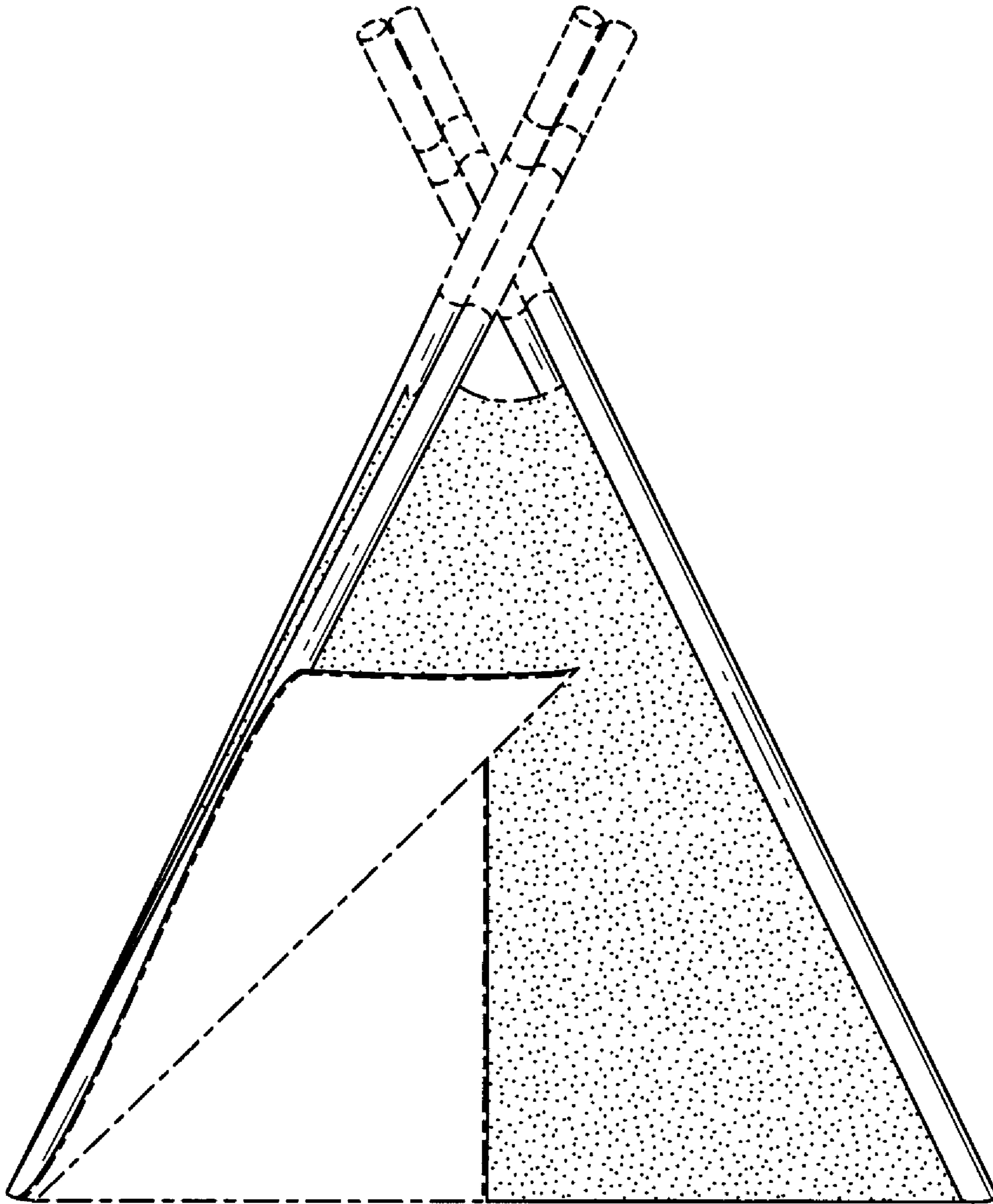

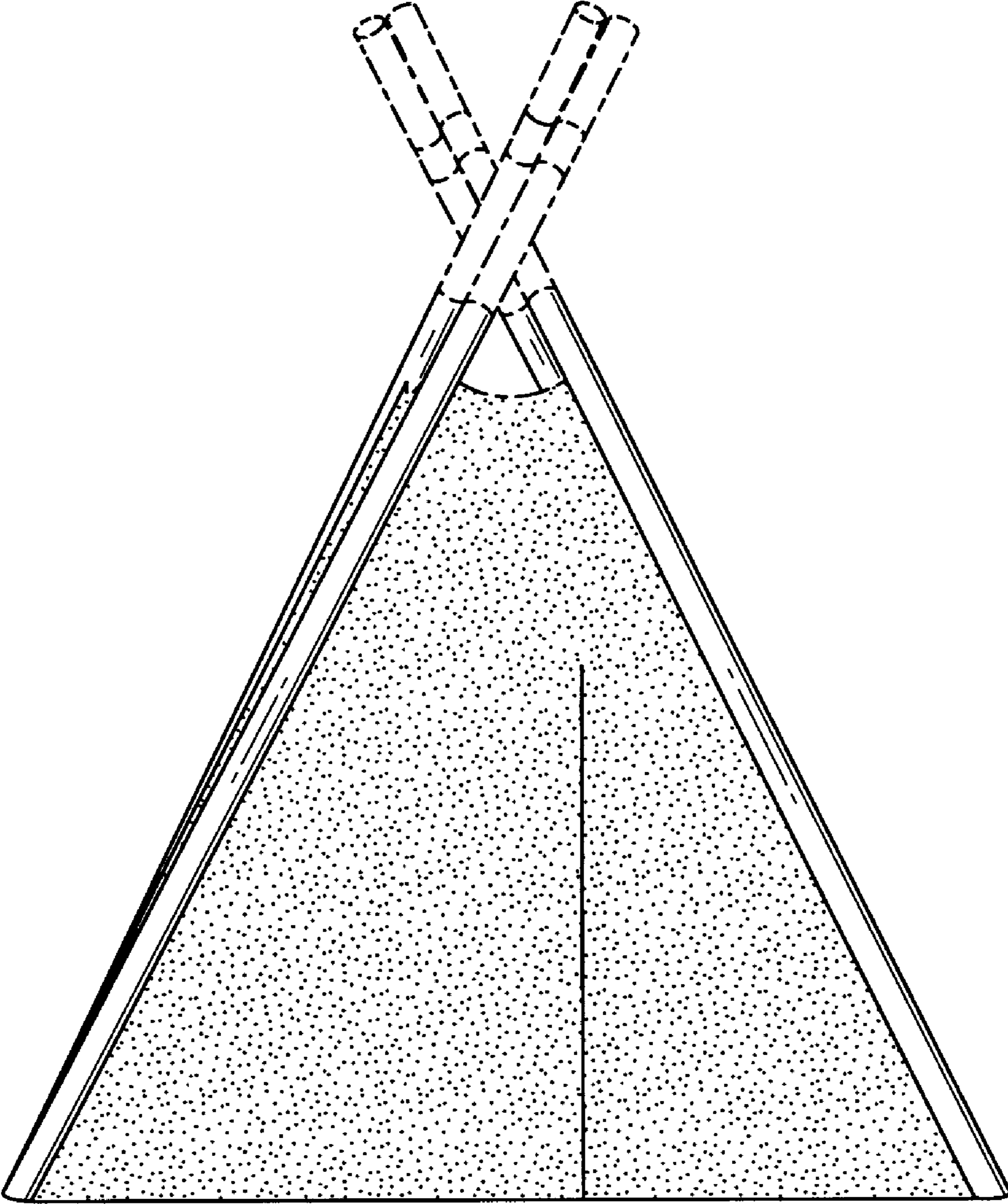

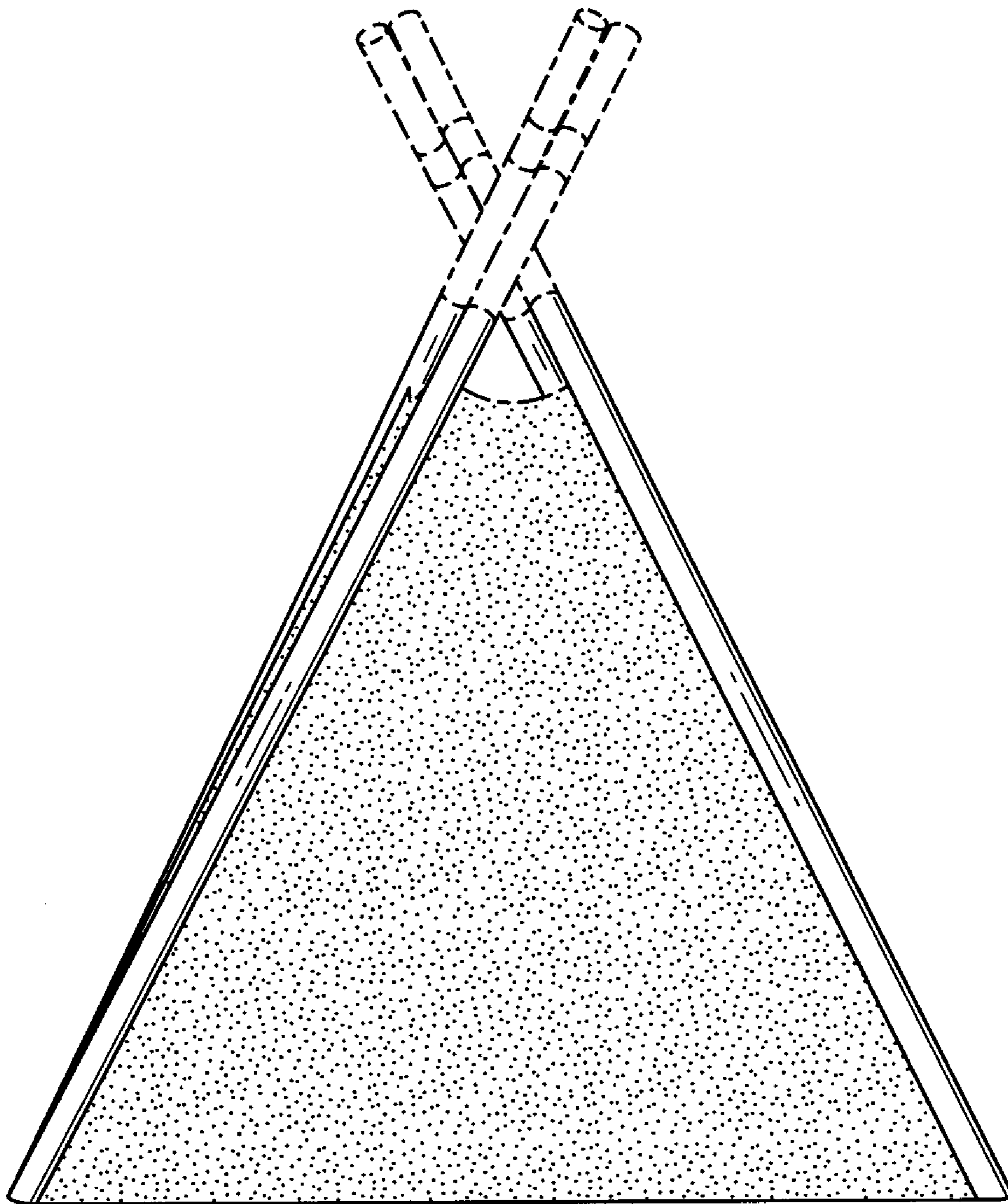

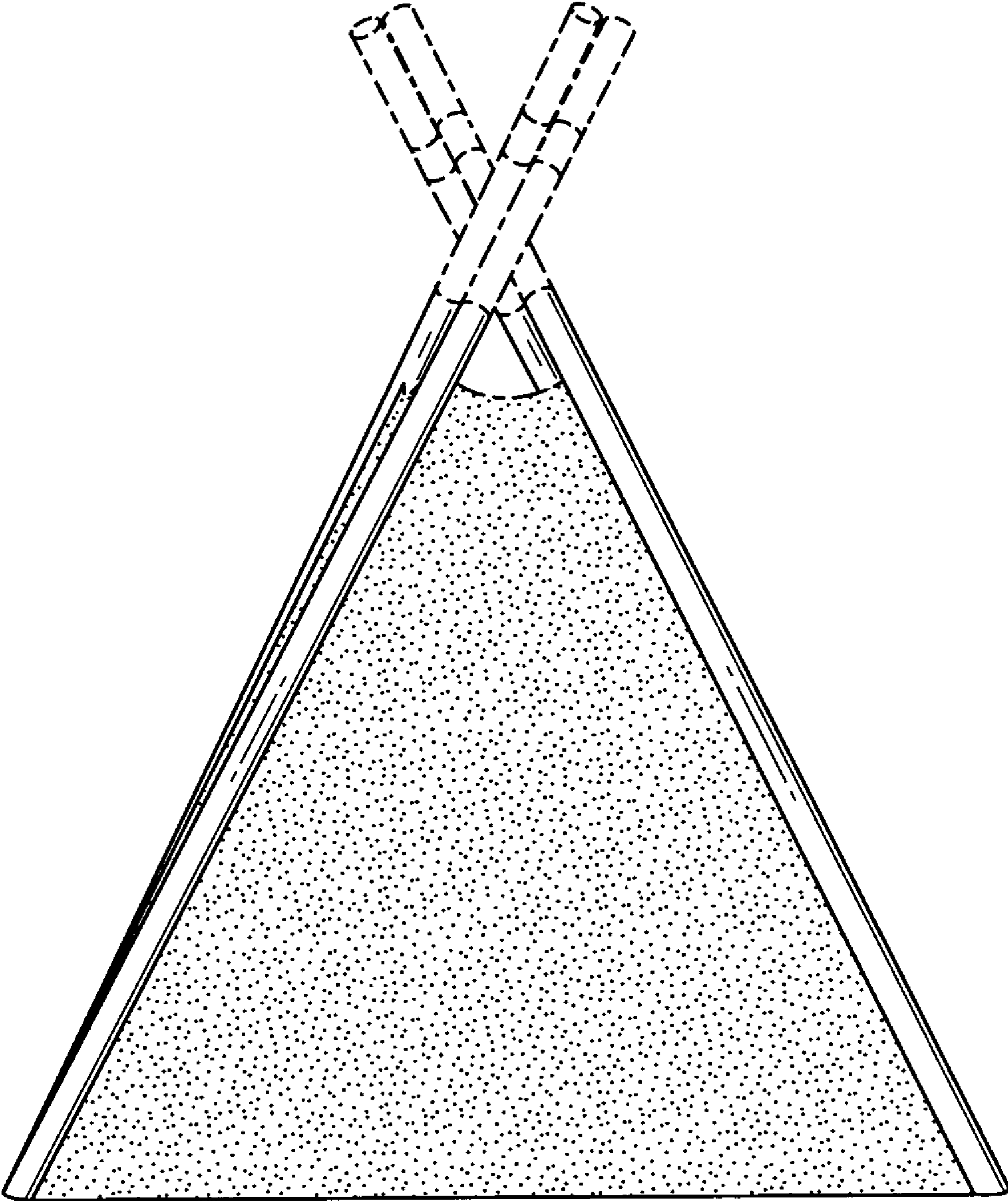

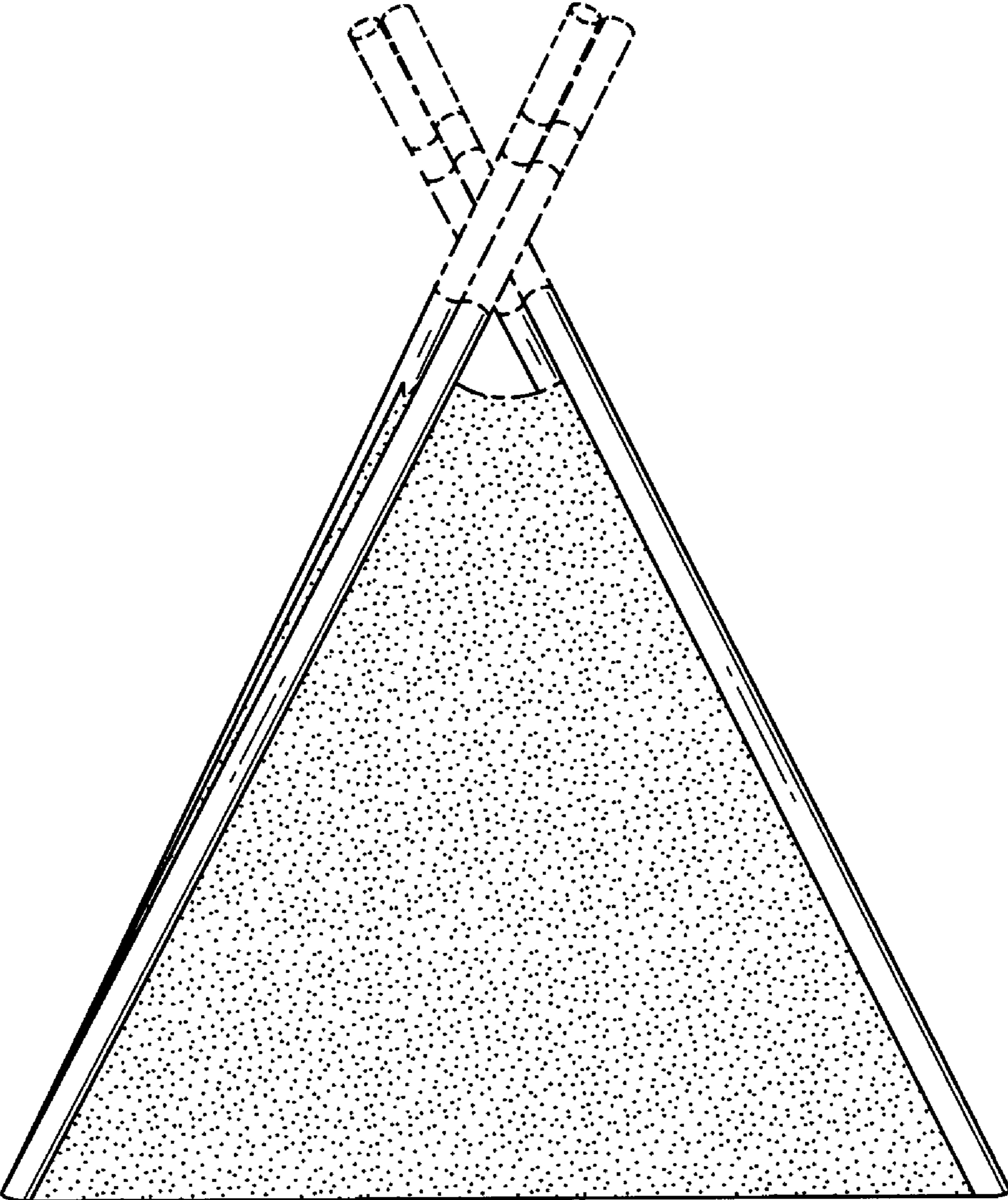

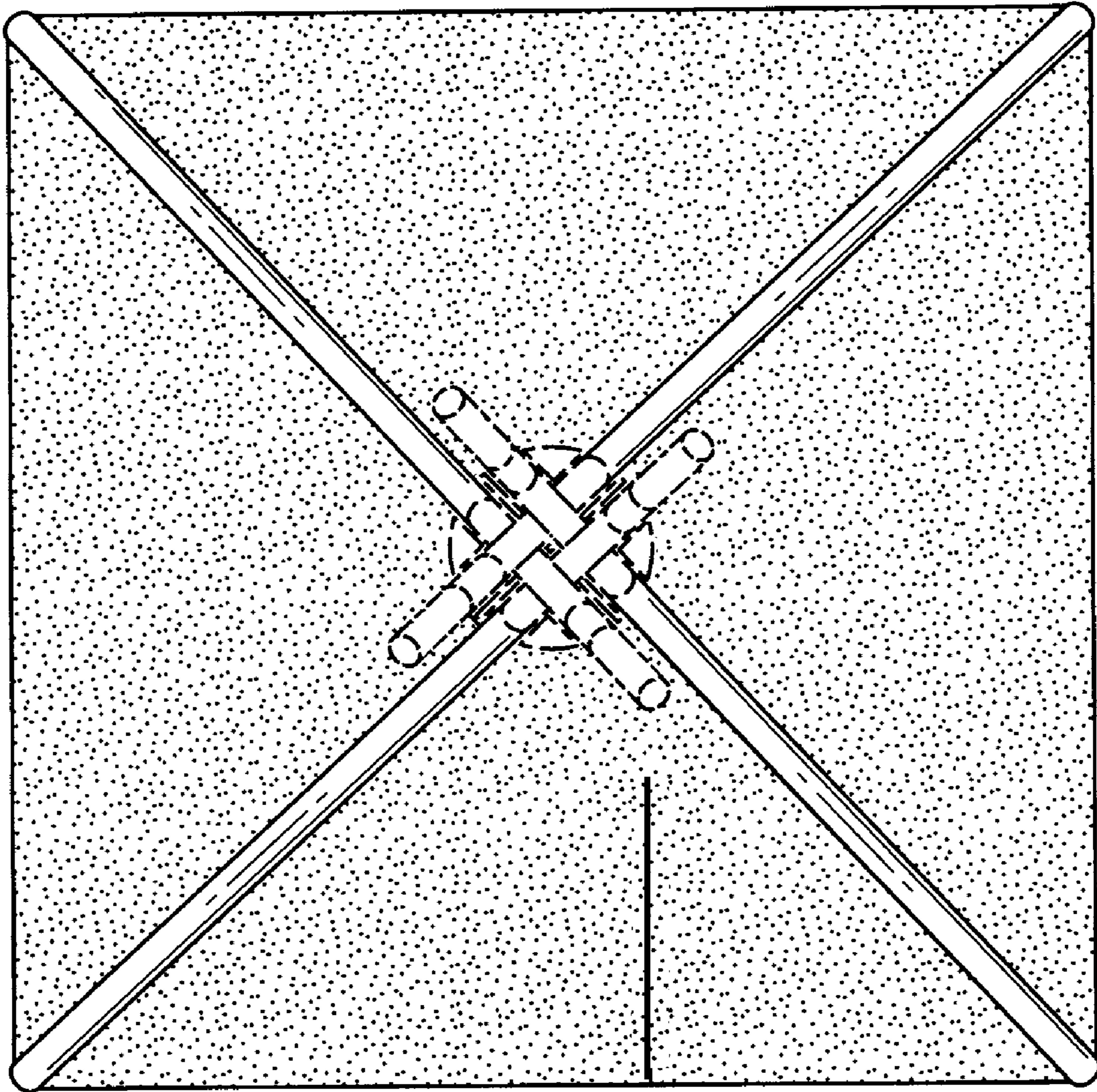
