(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a post surgical chin strap with ear protectors, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the post surgical chin strap with ear protectors according to the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

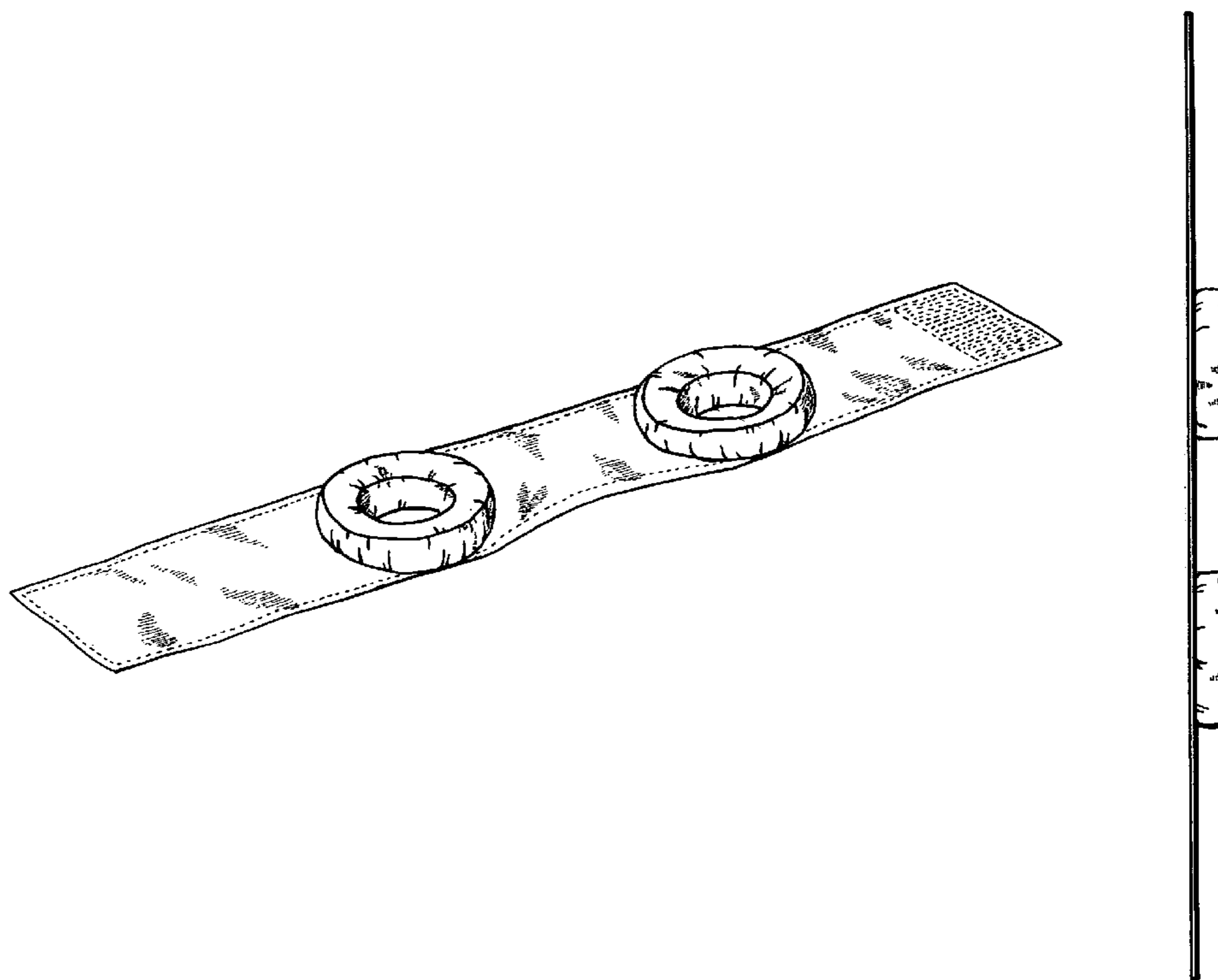
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical thereto;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

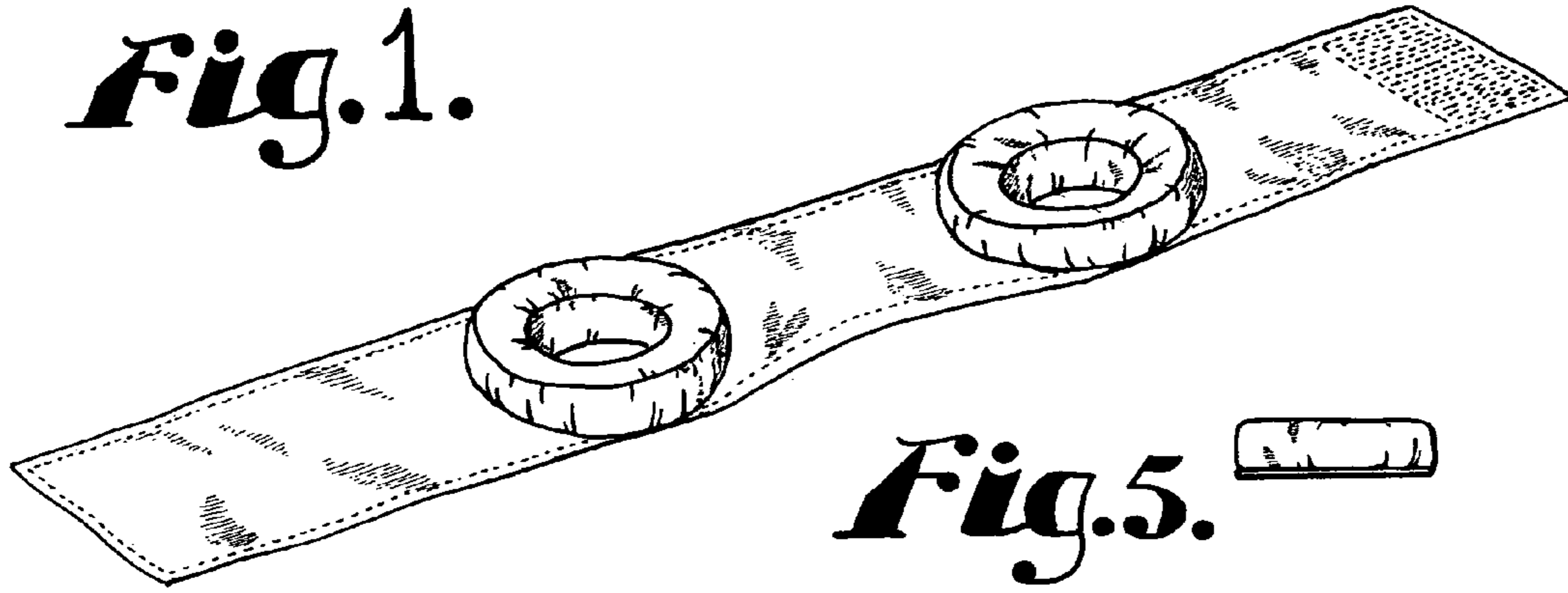
FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being identical thereto.
