DESCRIPTION

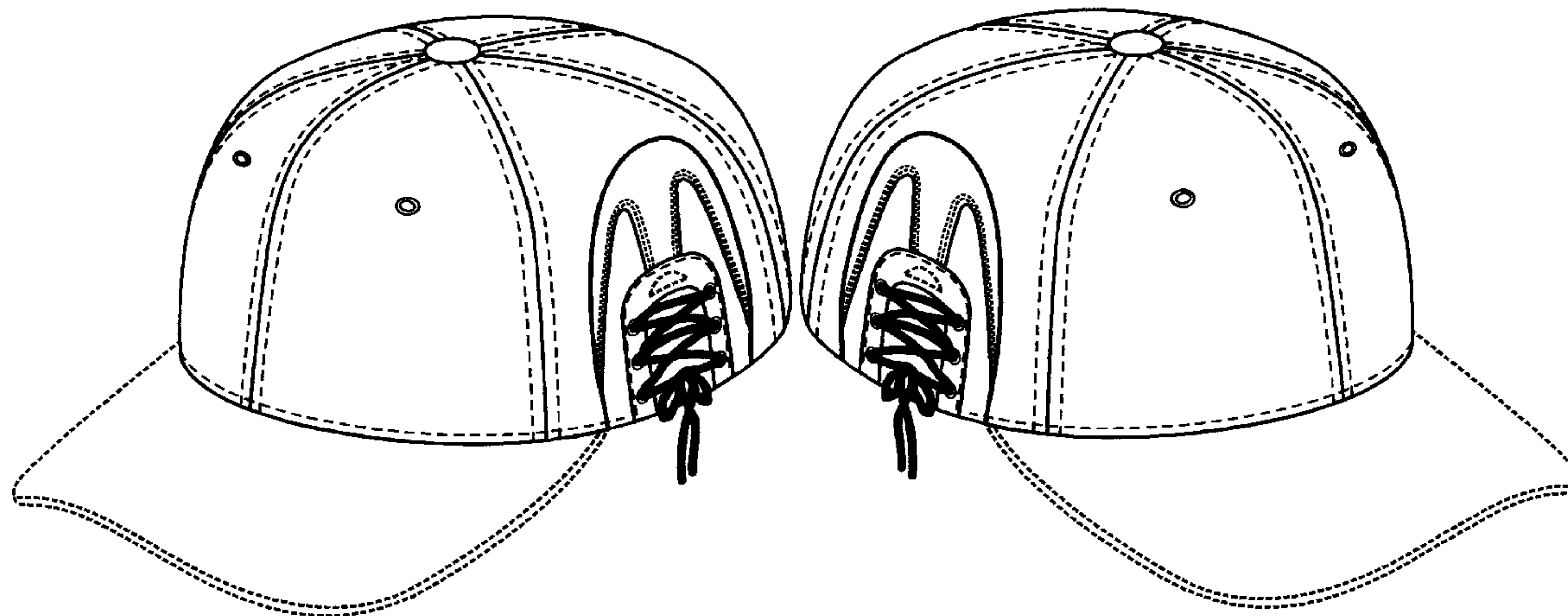

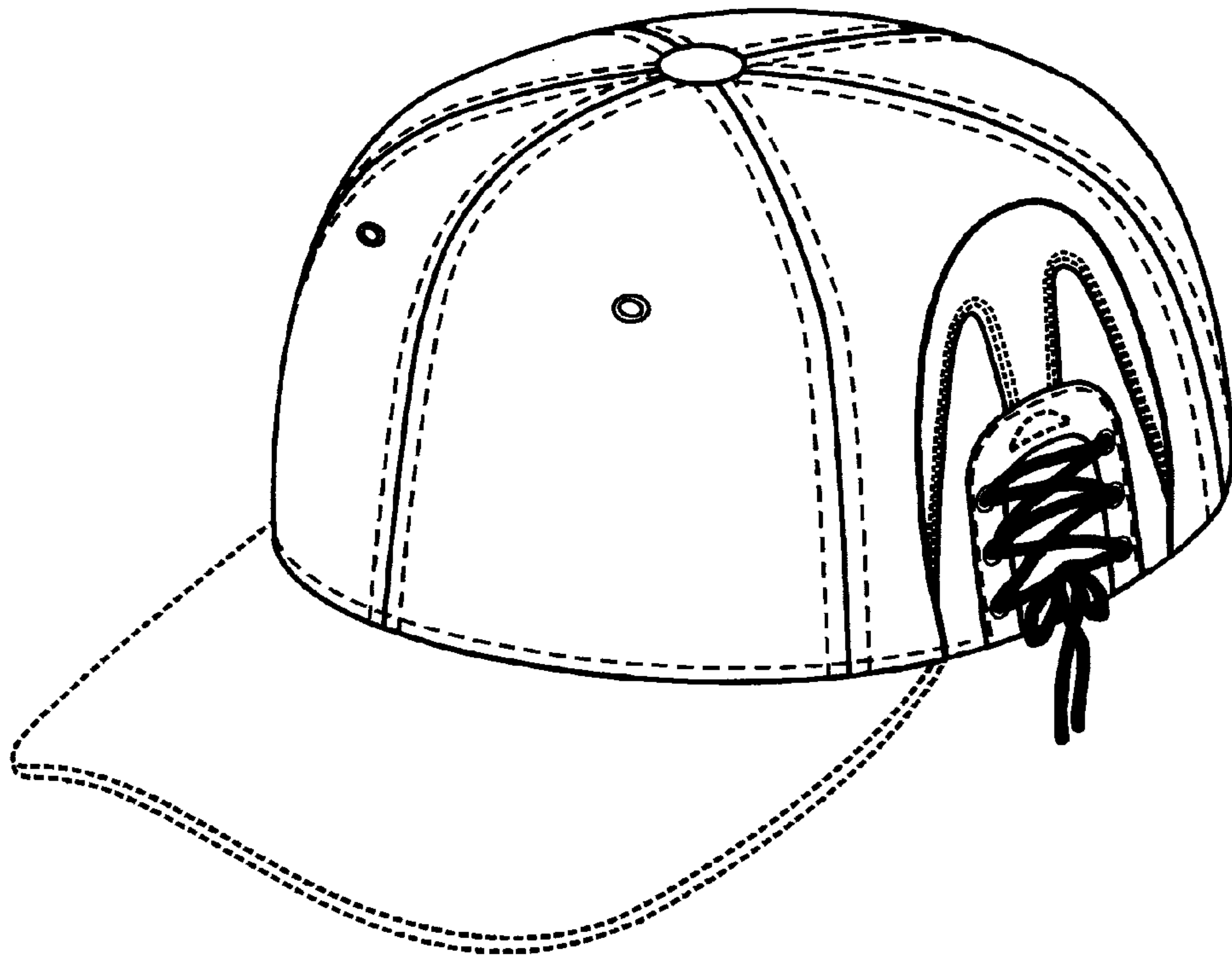

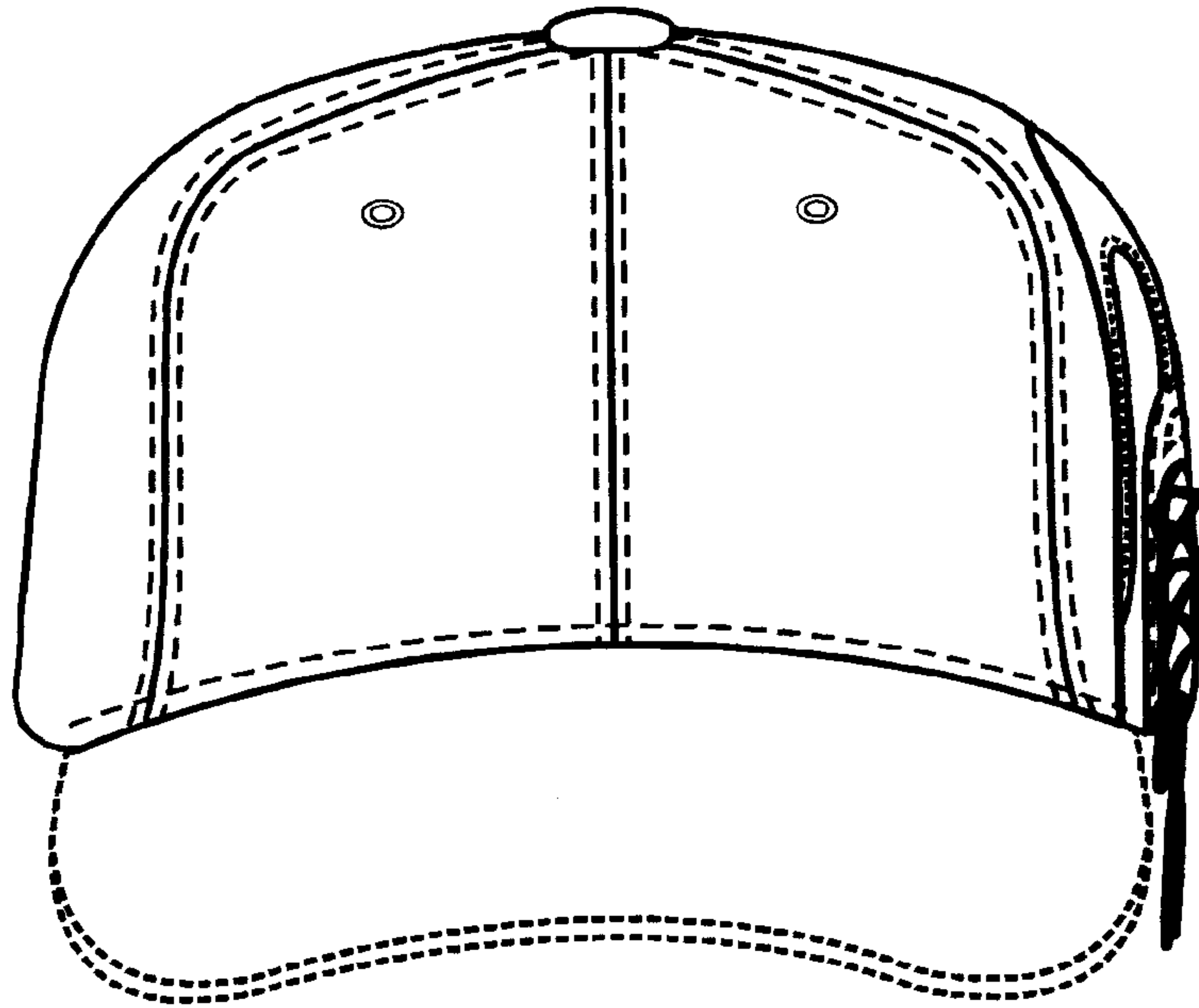

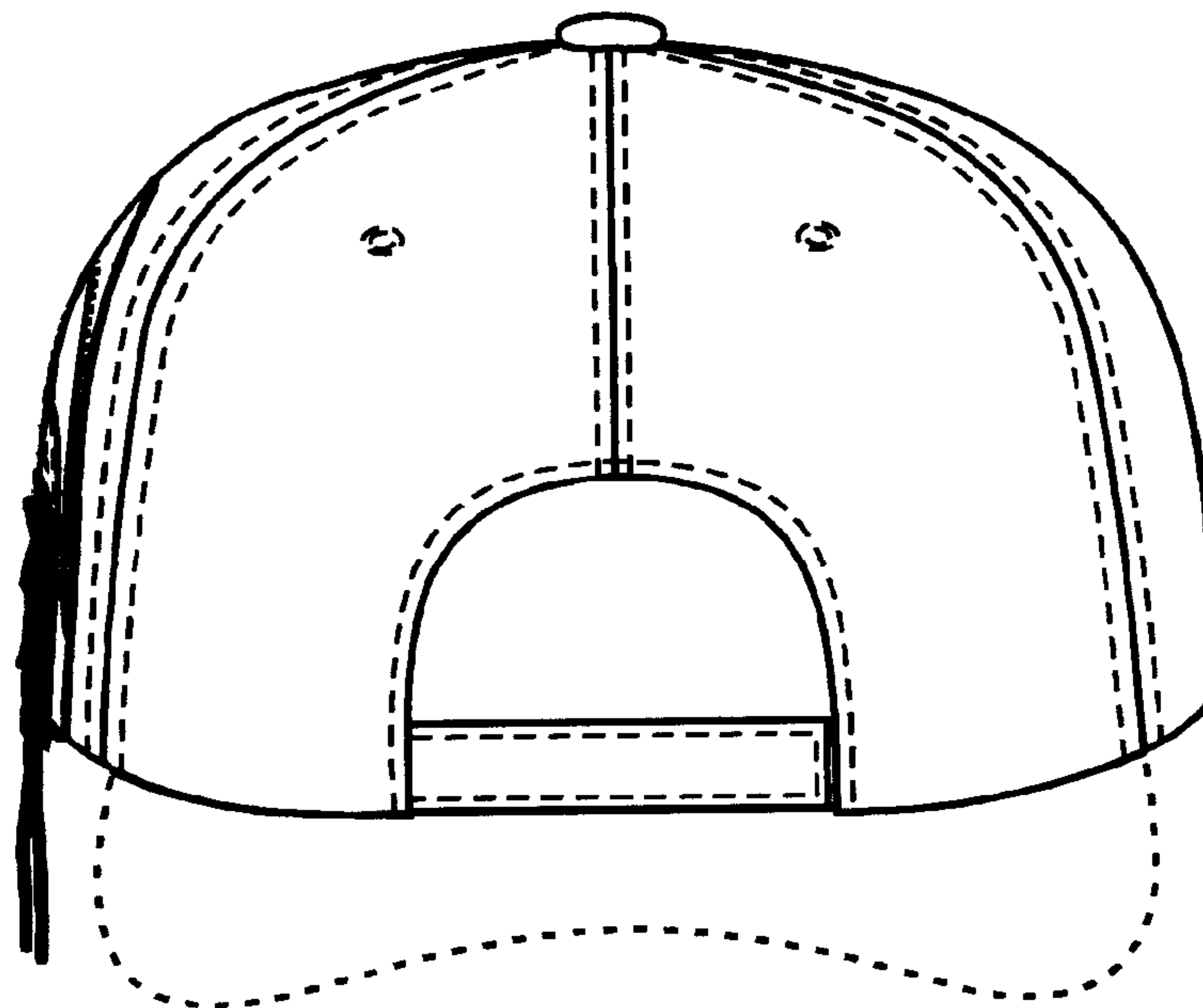

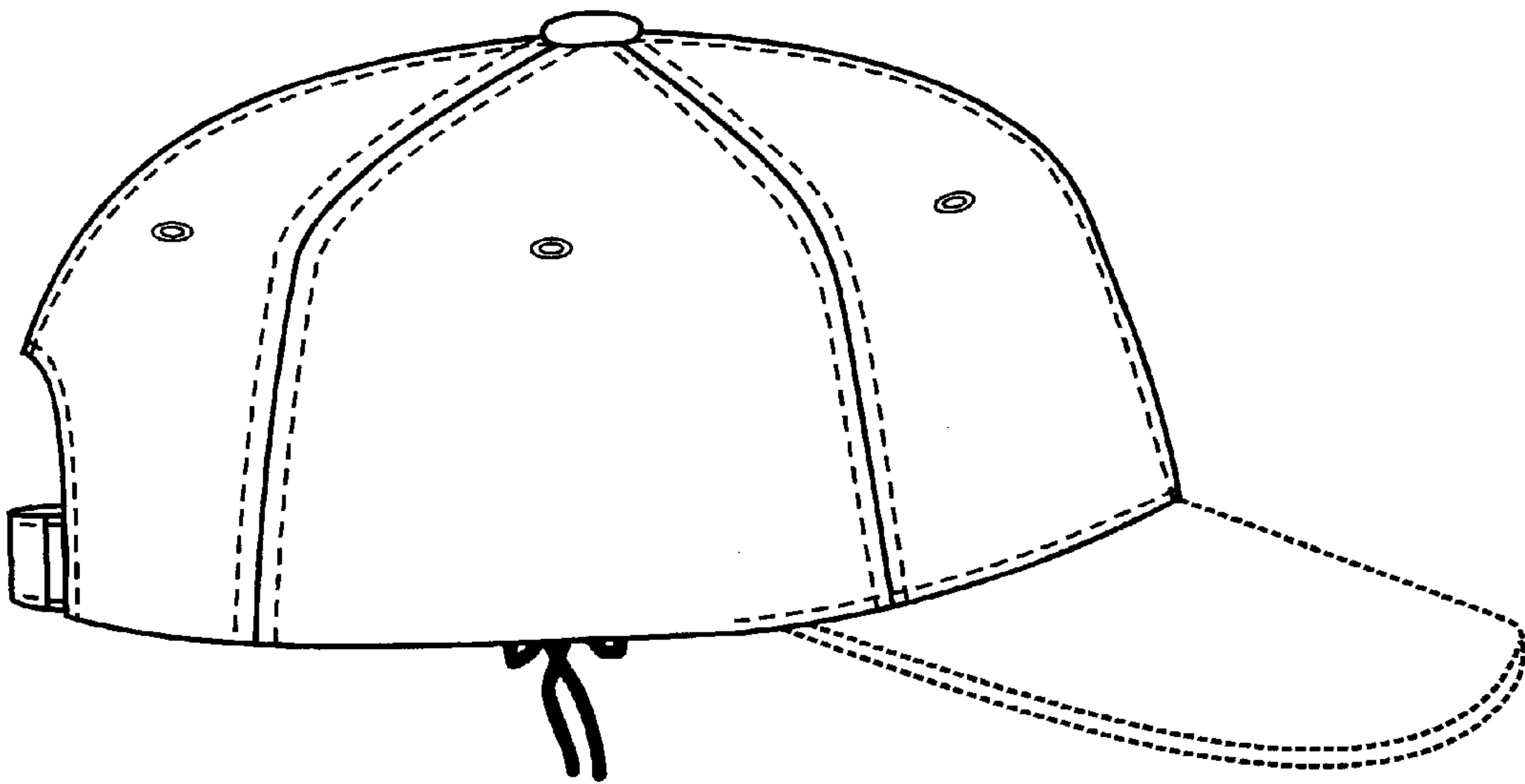

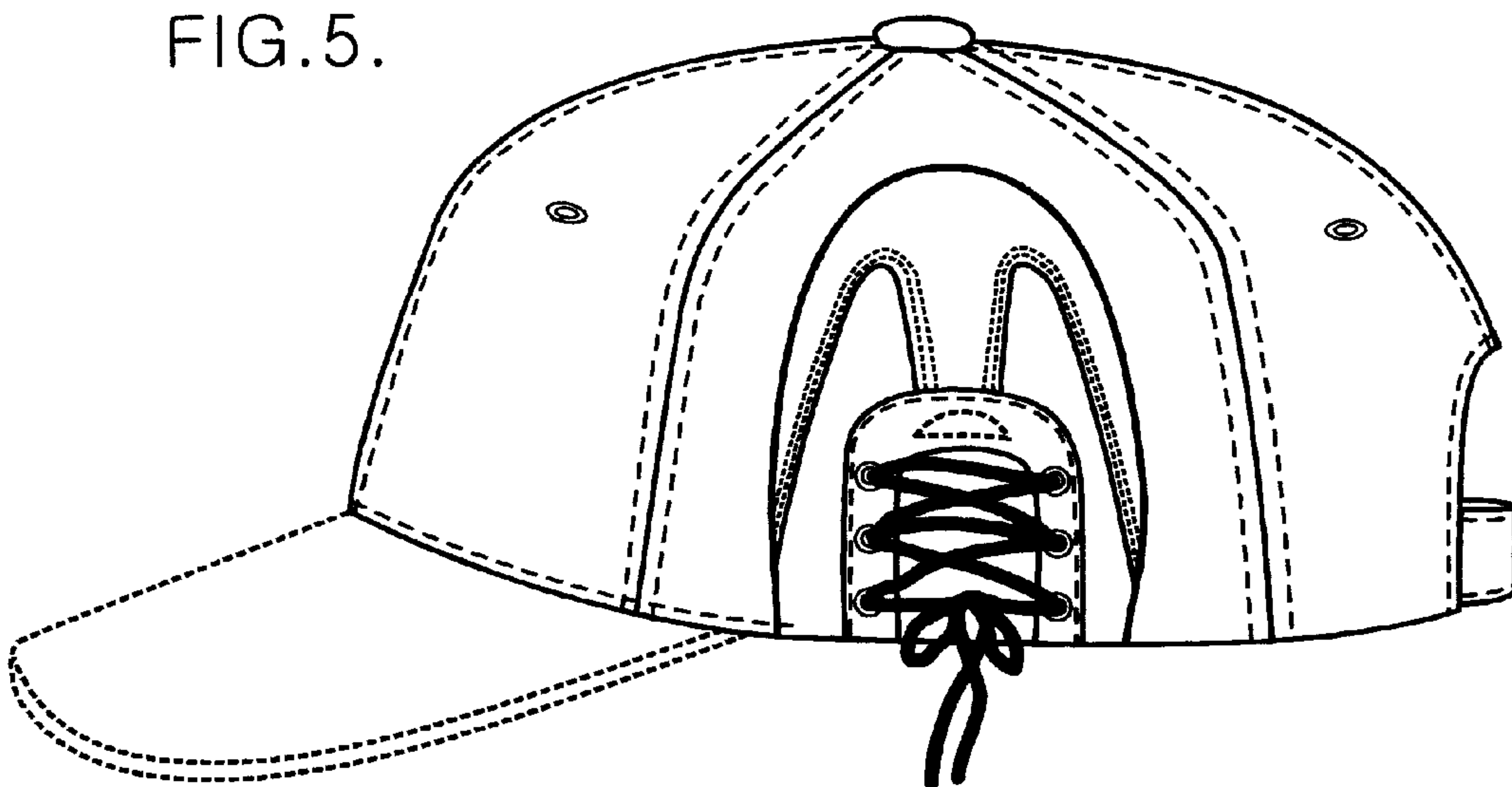

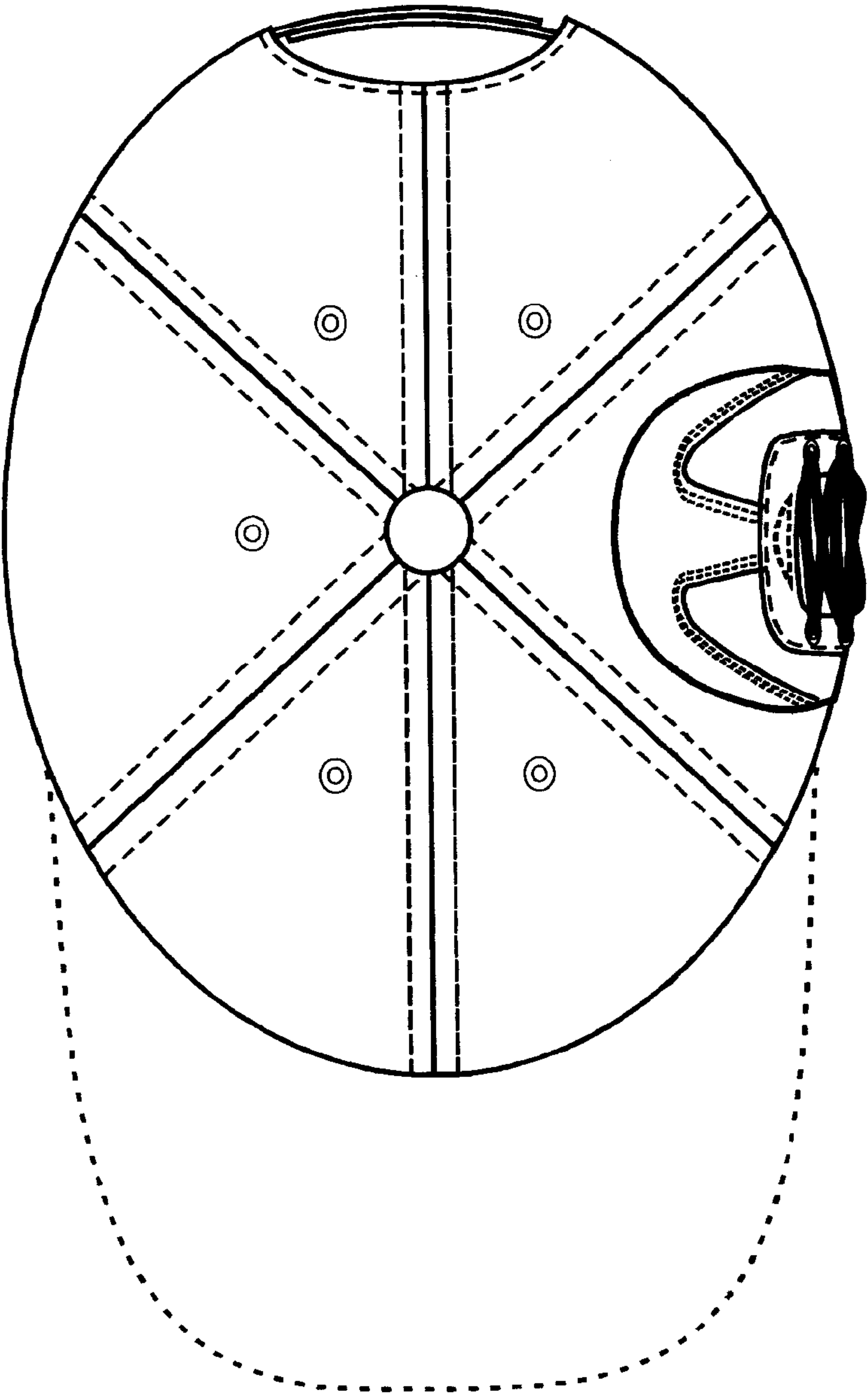
