FIG. 4 is a front view of the invention;

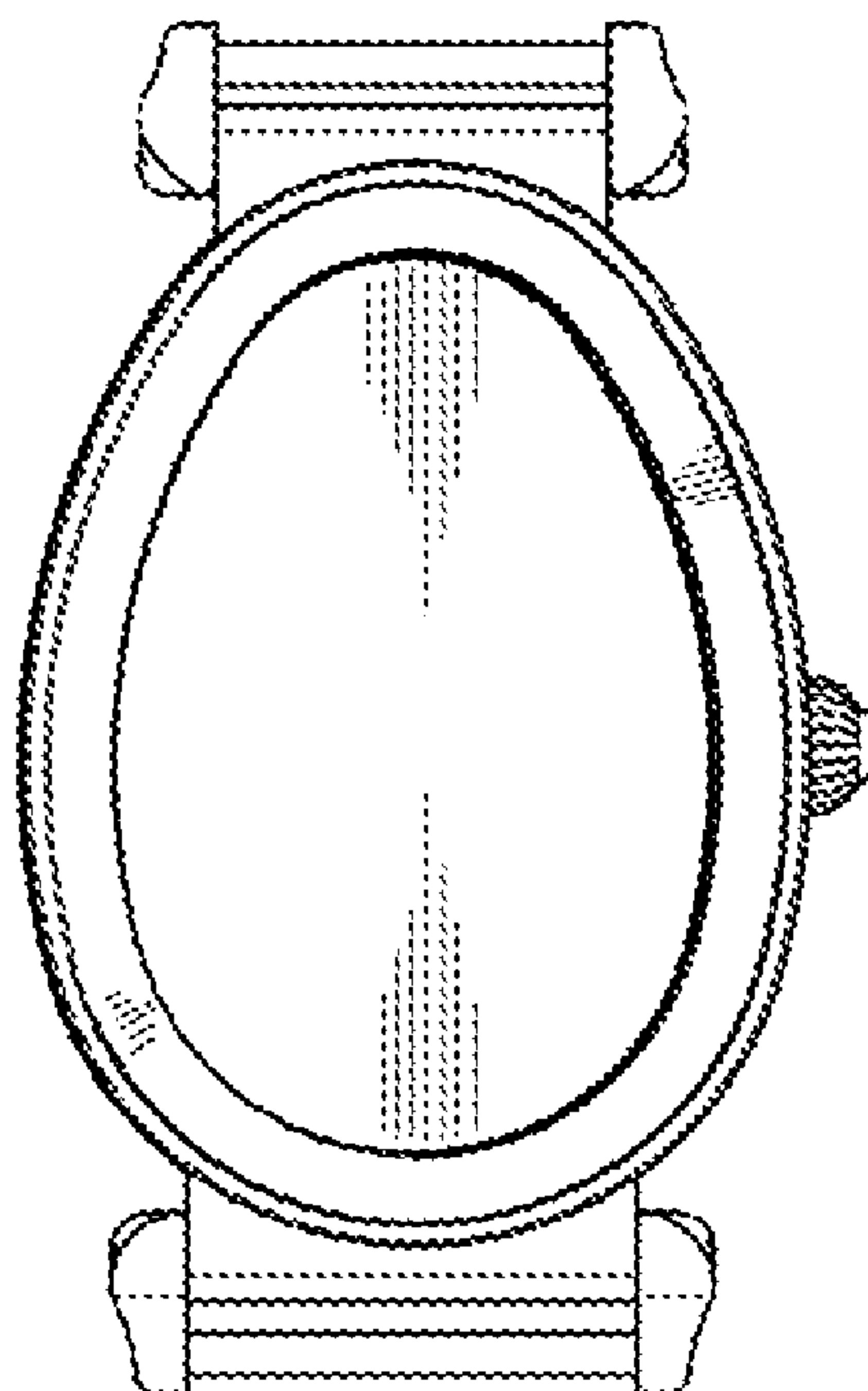
FIG. 5 is a back view of the invention, with the watch case inverted;

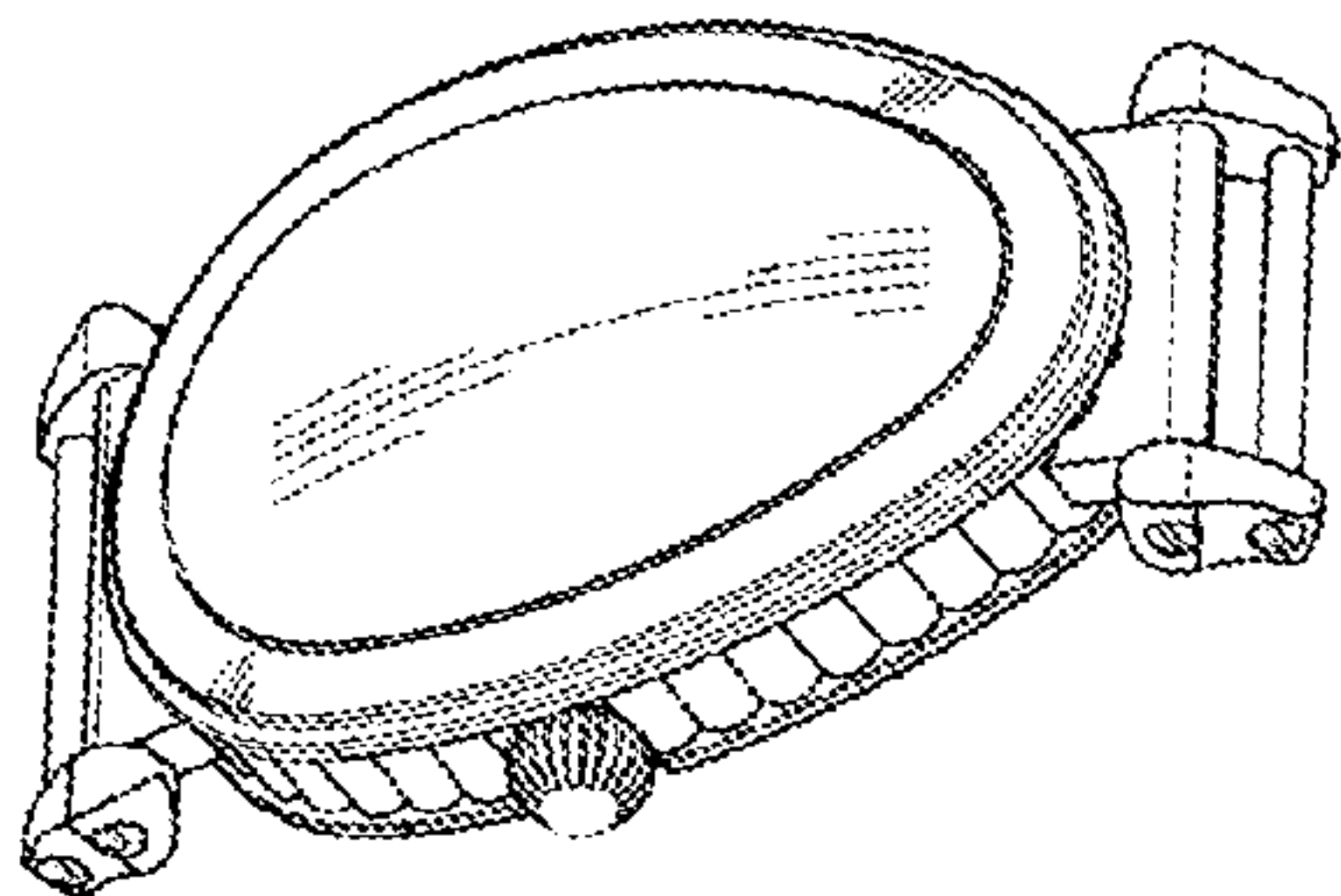

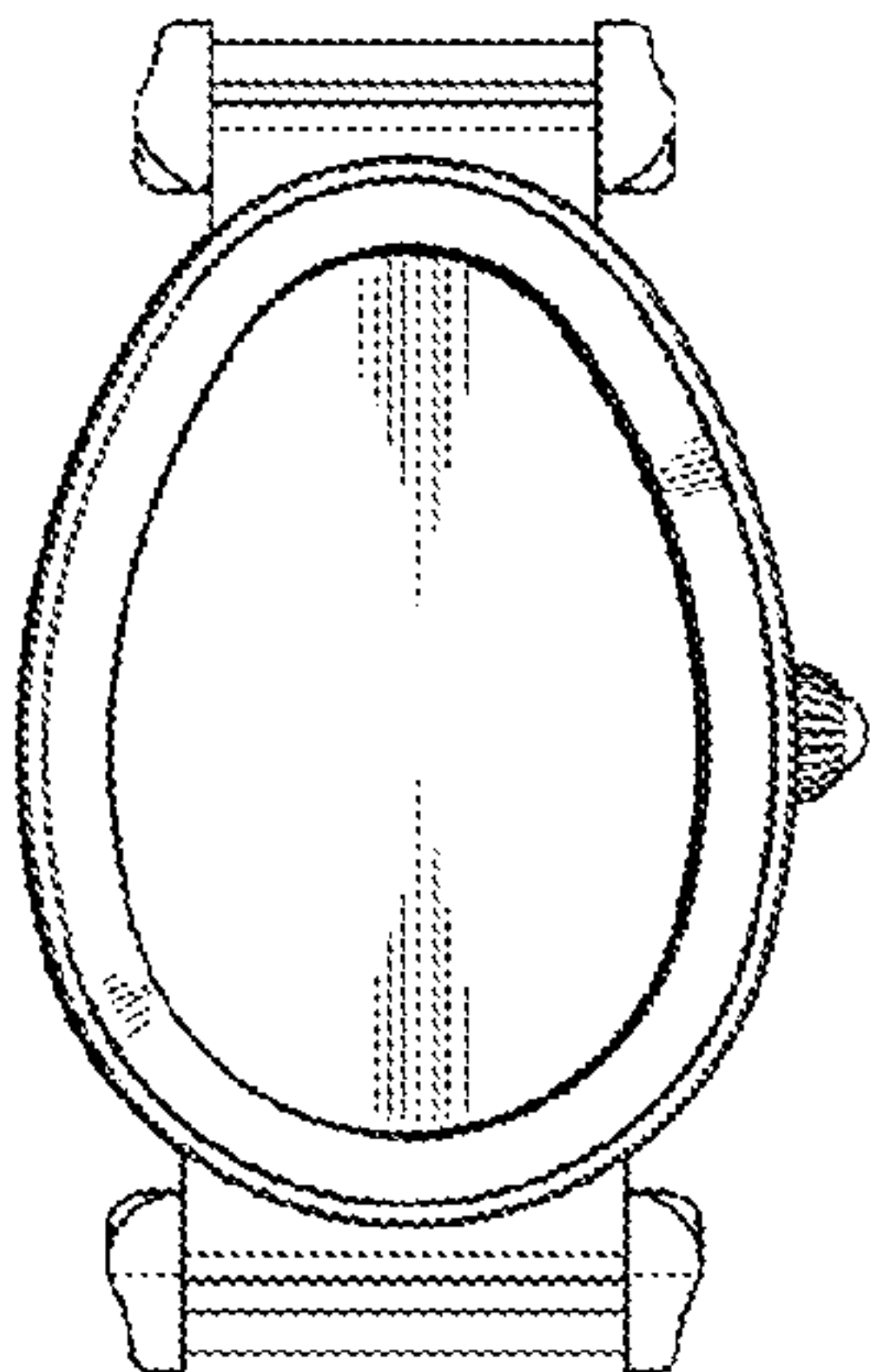

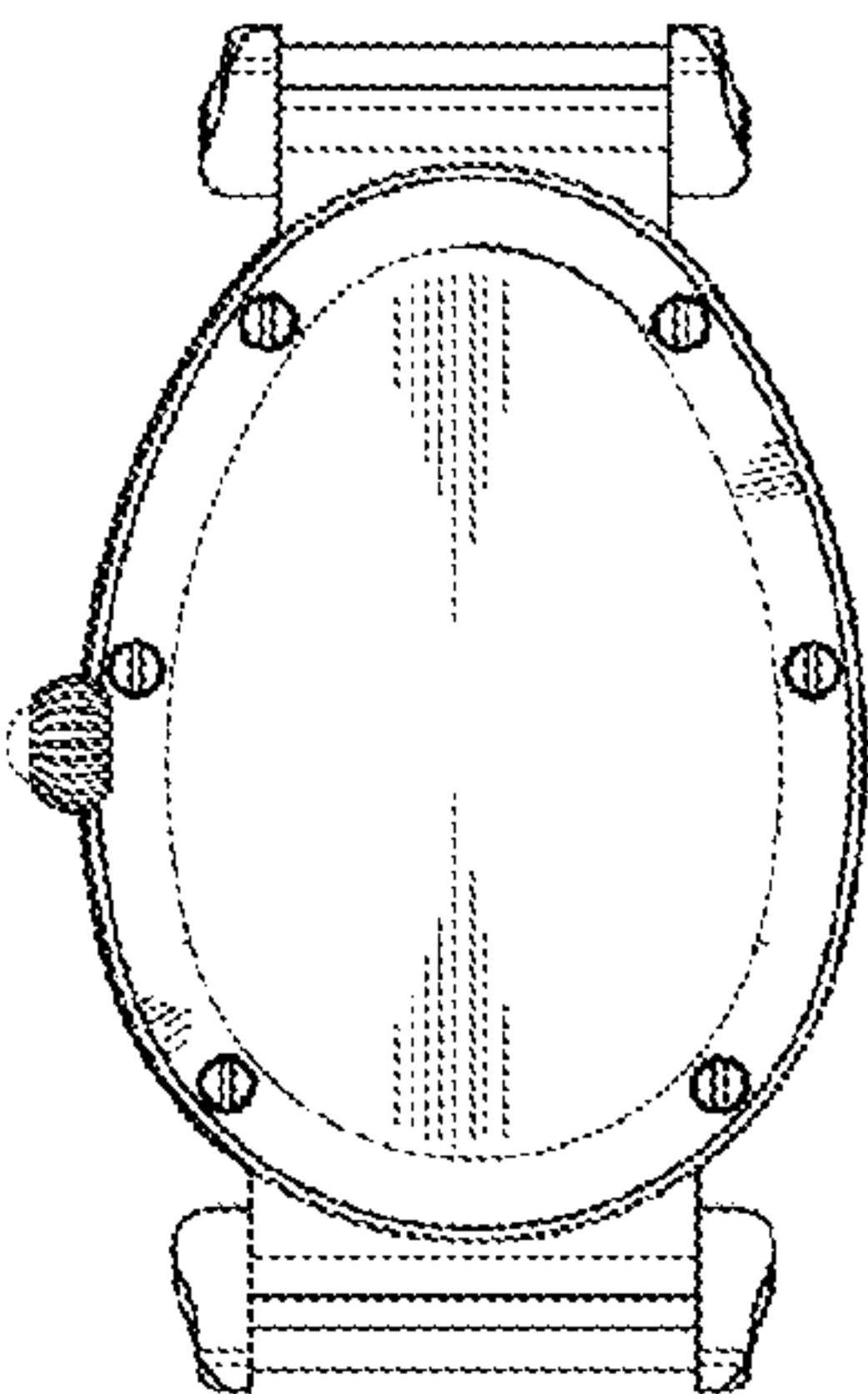

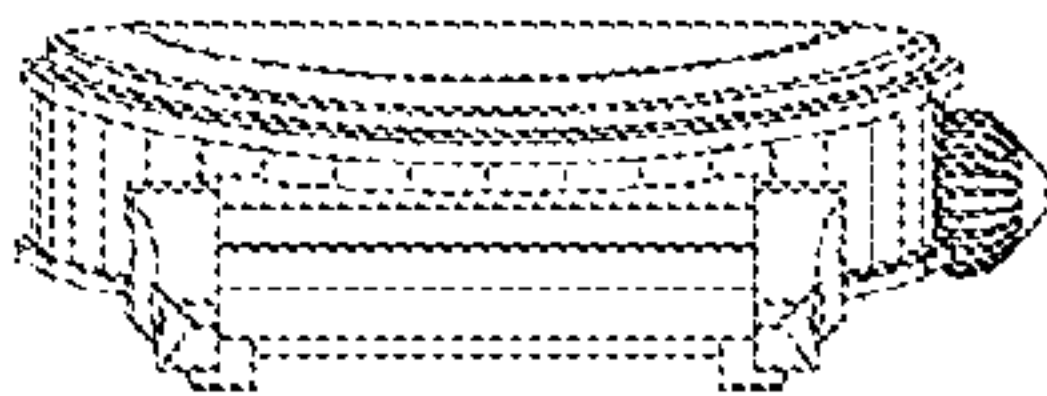

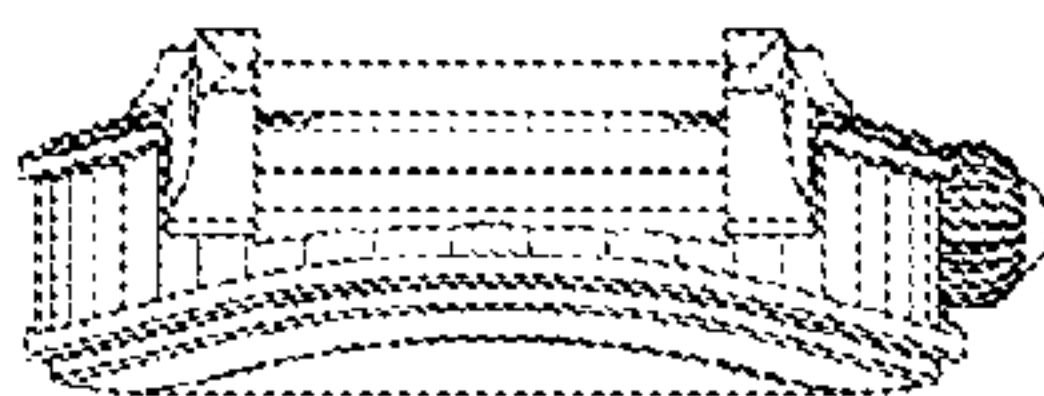

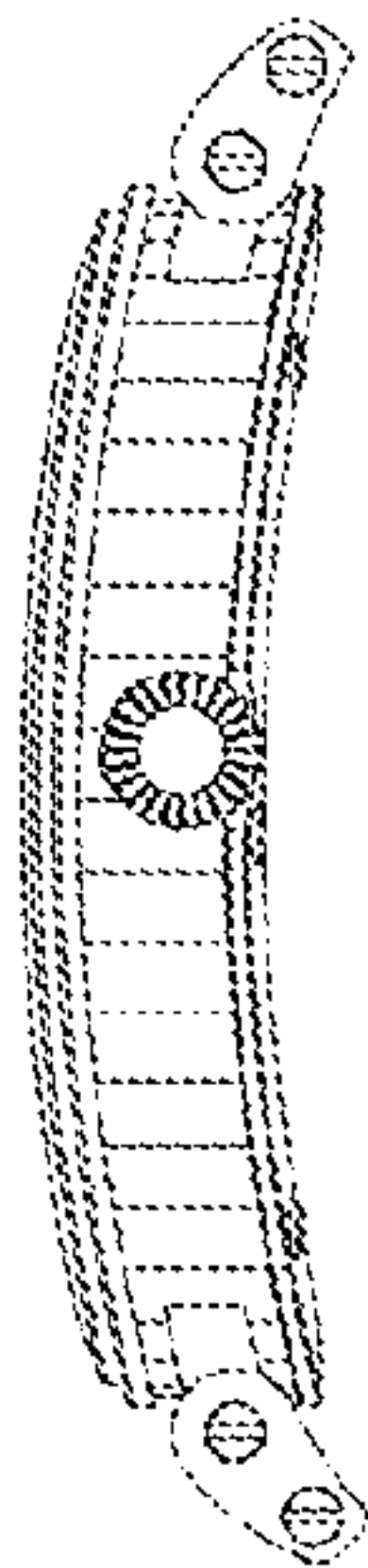

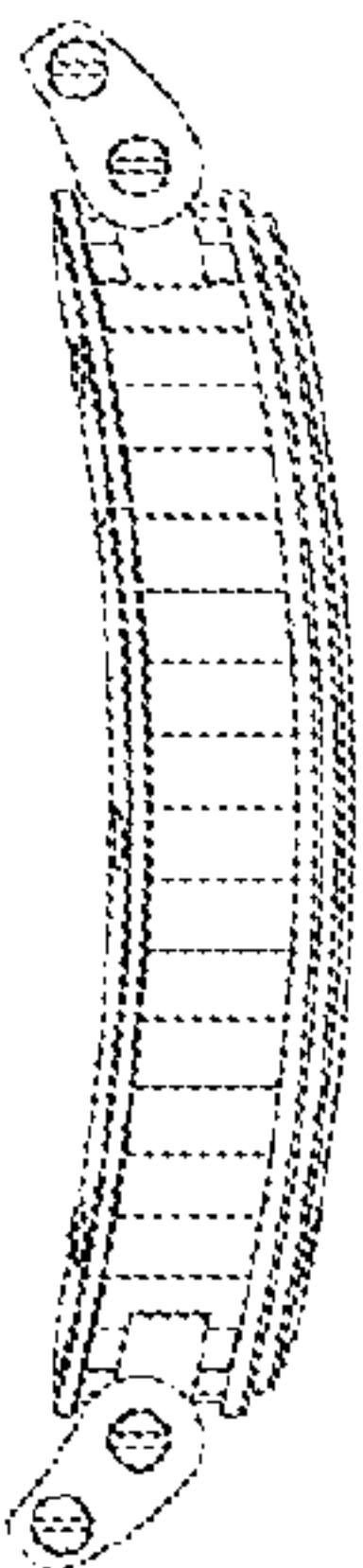
