FIG. 1 is a right, rear perspective view of the design showing a portable electronic article surveillance scanner, detector, and reactivator;

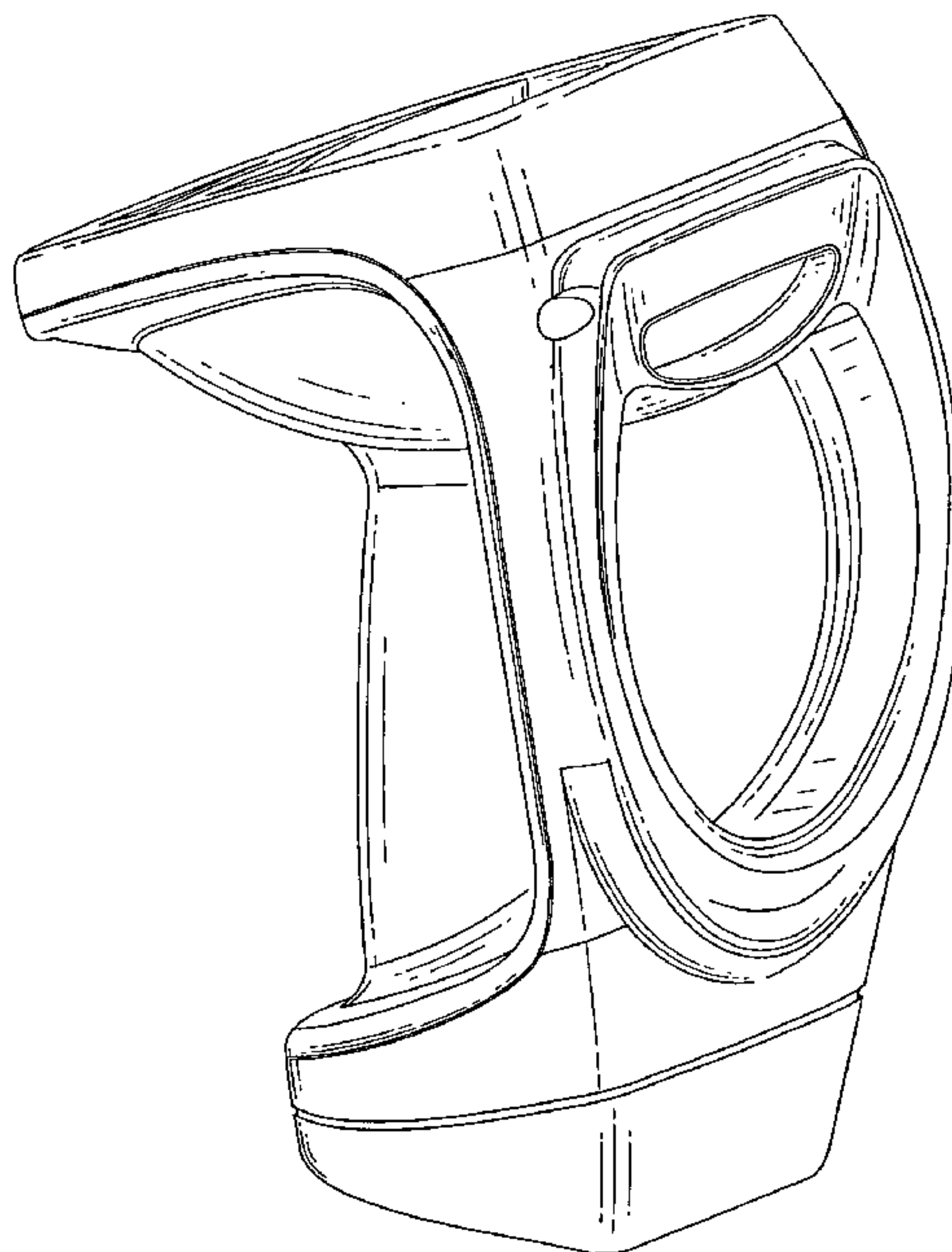
FIG. 2 is a left, rear perspective view thereof;

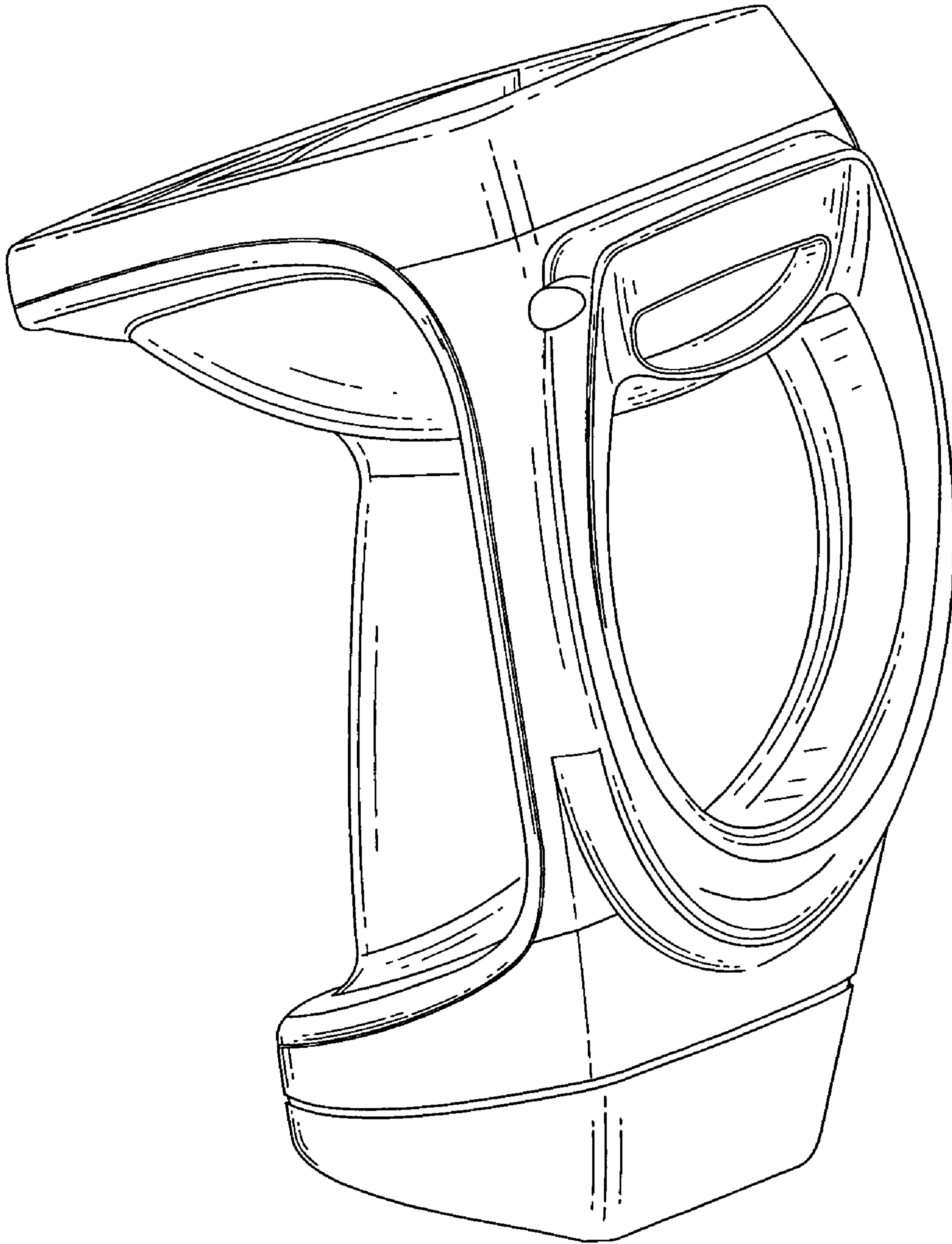

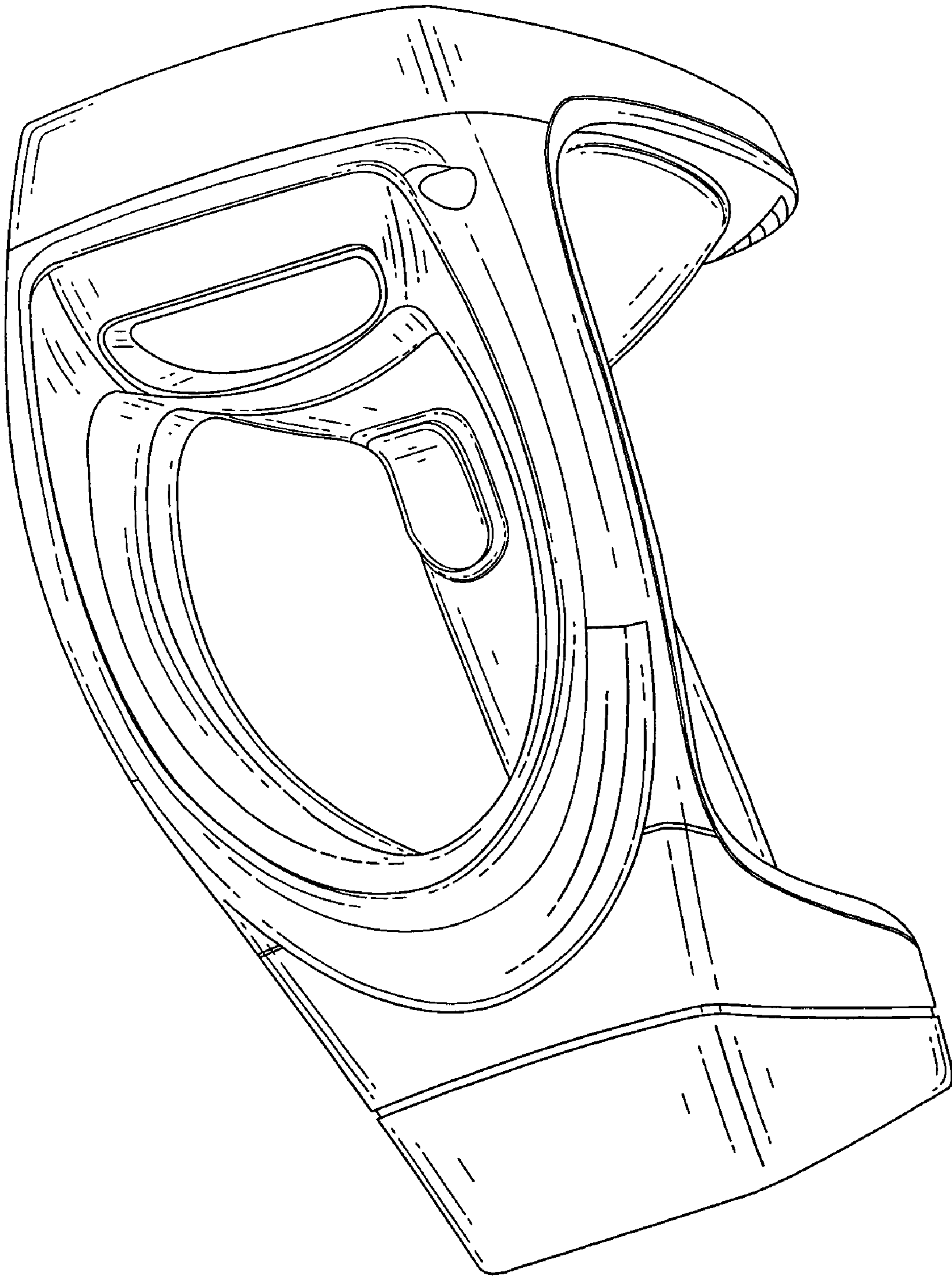

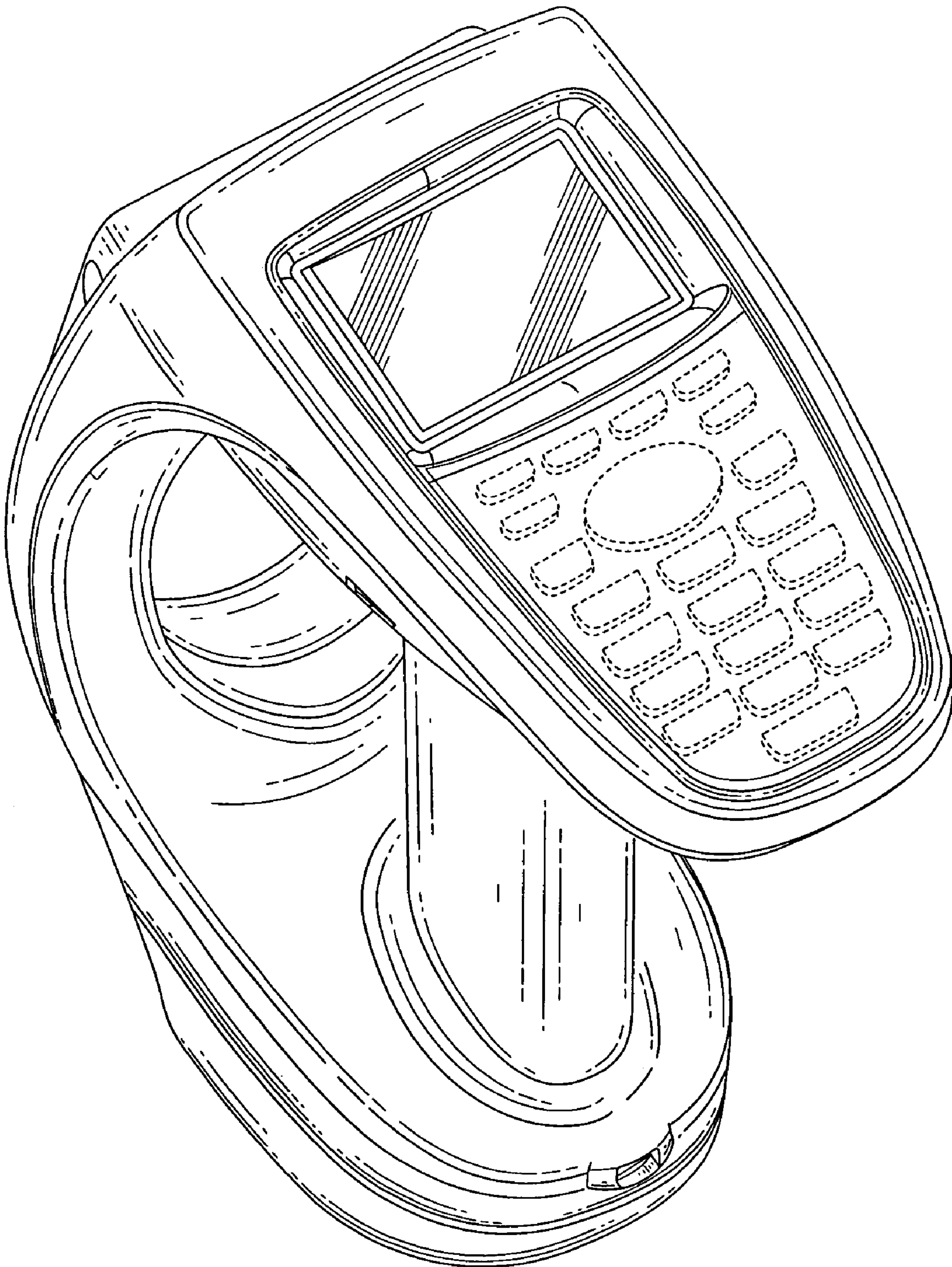

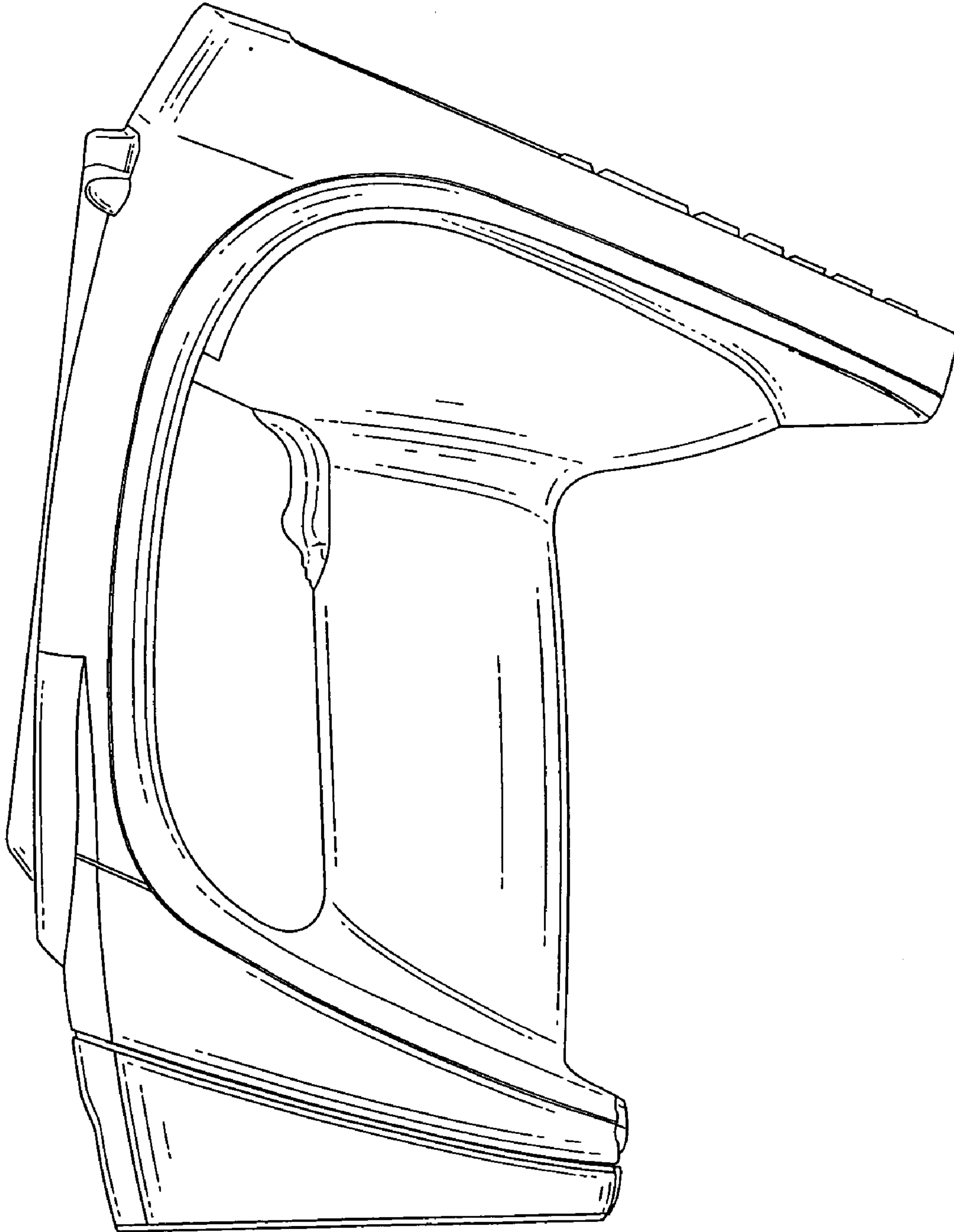
