FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

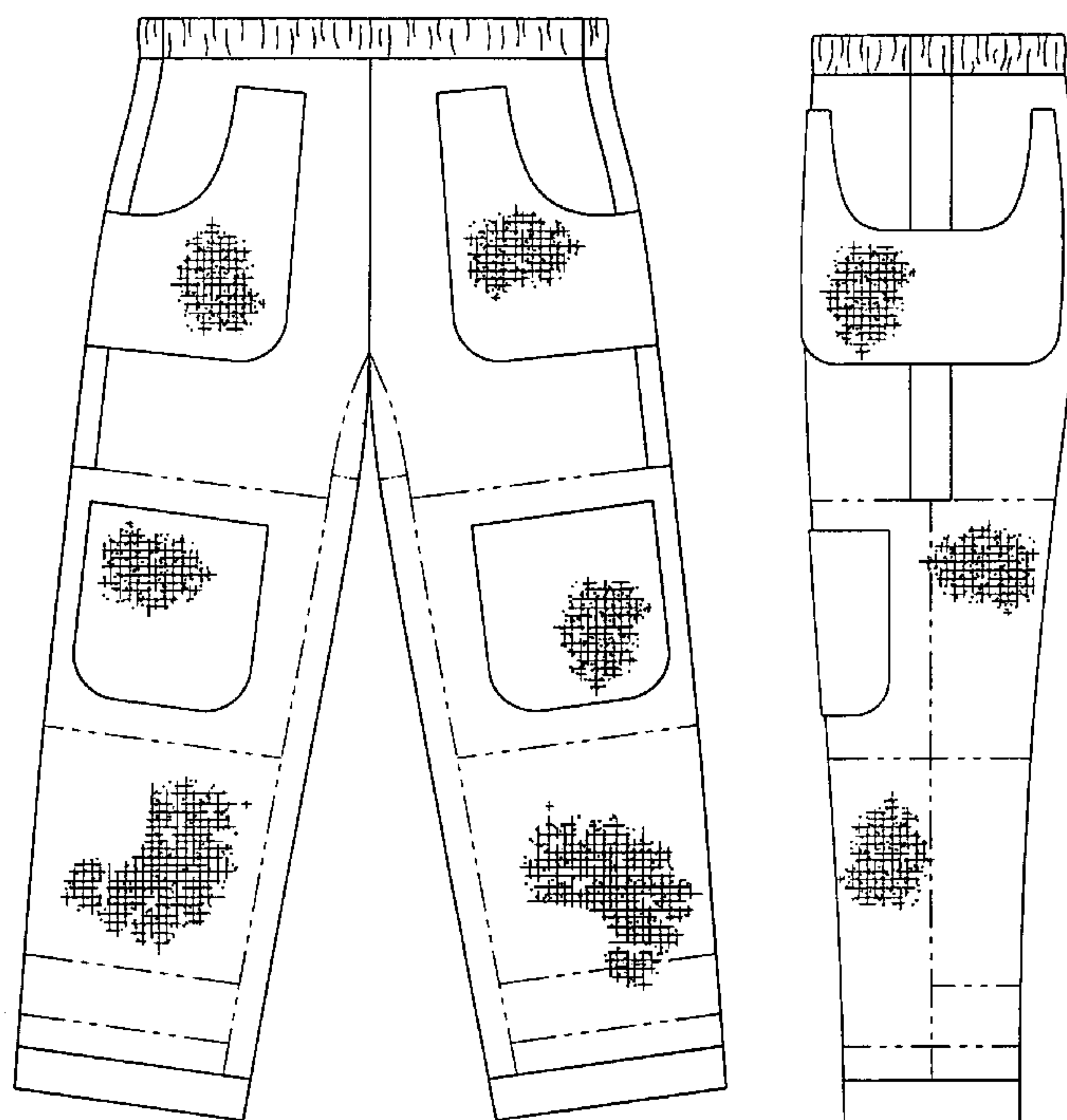
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

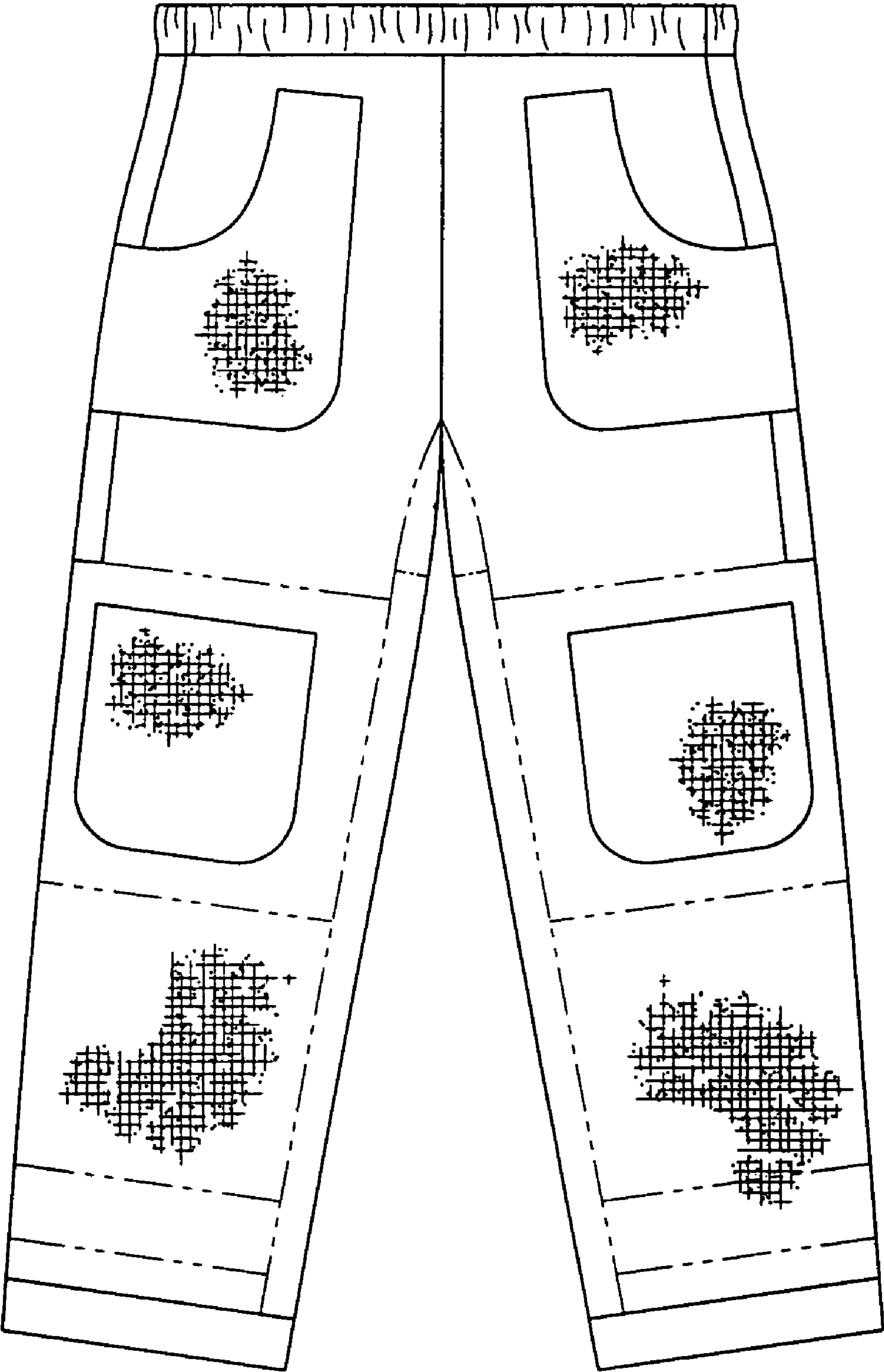
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

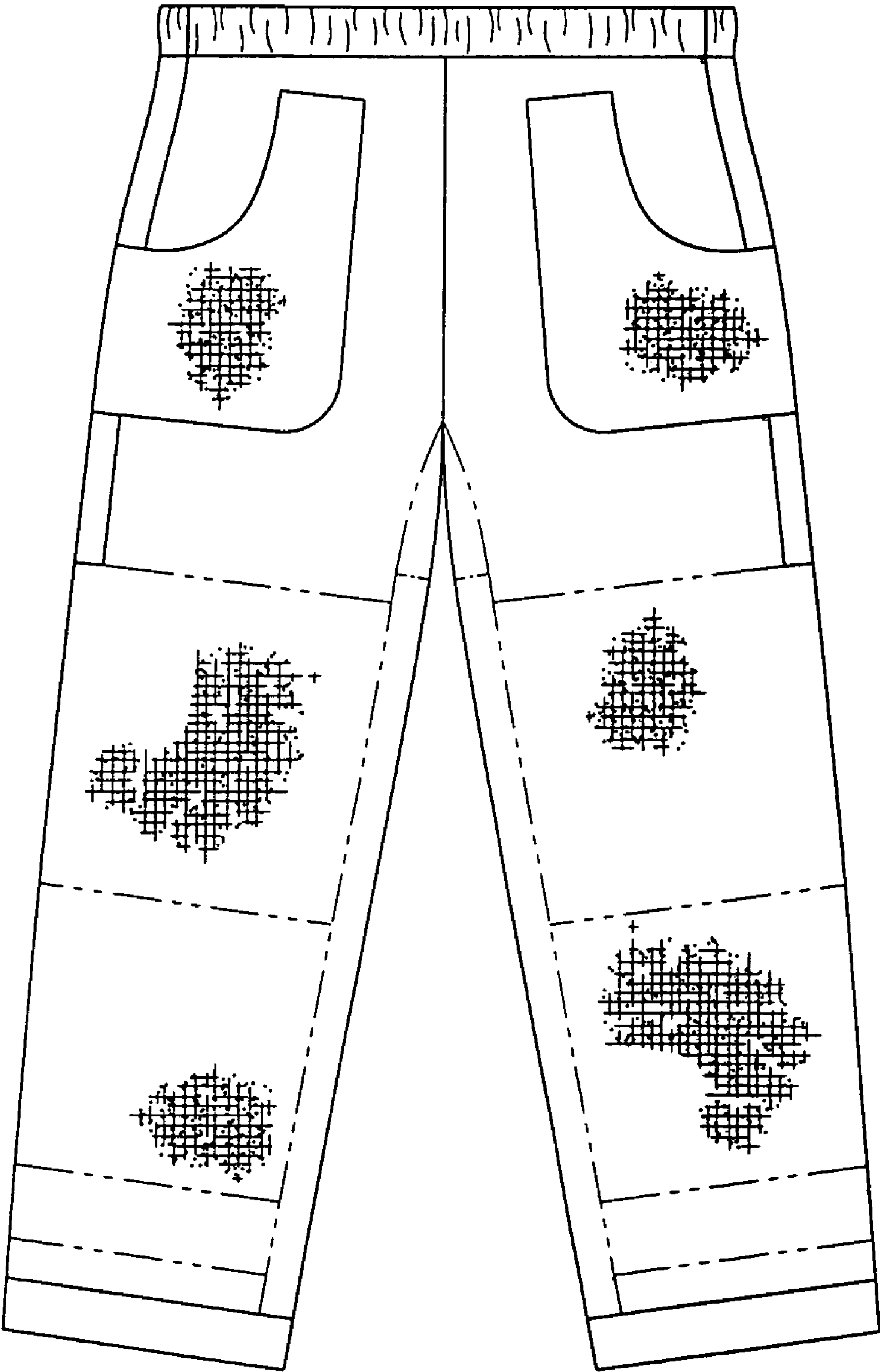

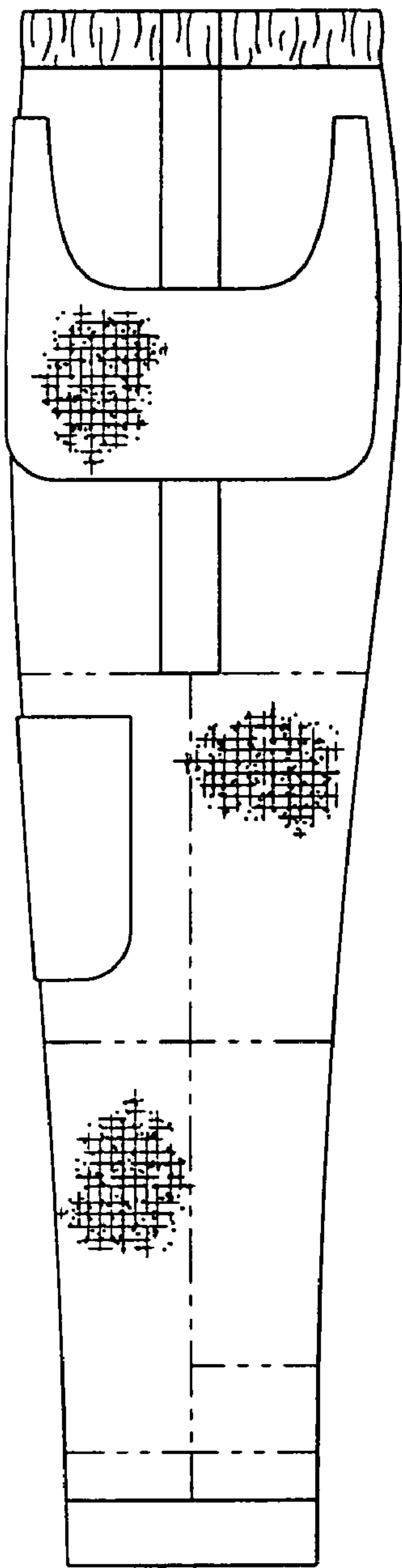

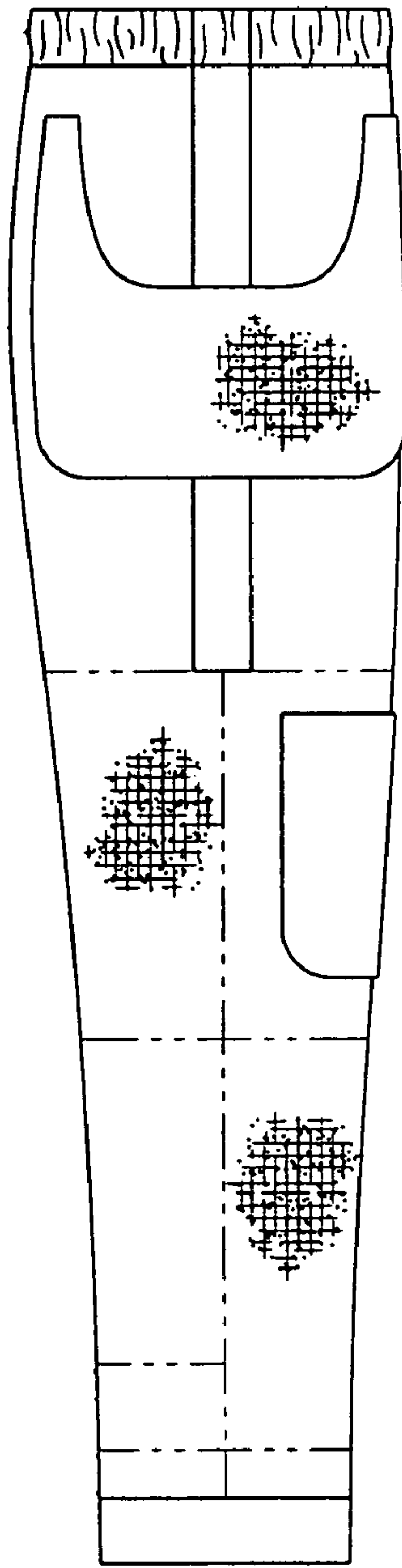
