
(57)**CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for cocktail trunk, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cocktail trunk according to an embodiment of the invention.
- FIG. 2 is an overhead view of a cocktail trunk according to an embodiment of the invention.
- FIG. 3 is a side view of a cocktail trunk according to an embodiment of the invention, the view from the opposite side being a mirror-image thereof; and,
- FIG. 4 is an end view of a cocktail trunk according to an embodiment of the invention, the view from the opposite end being a mirror-image thereof.







