FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

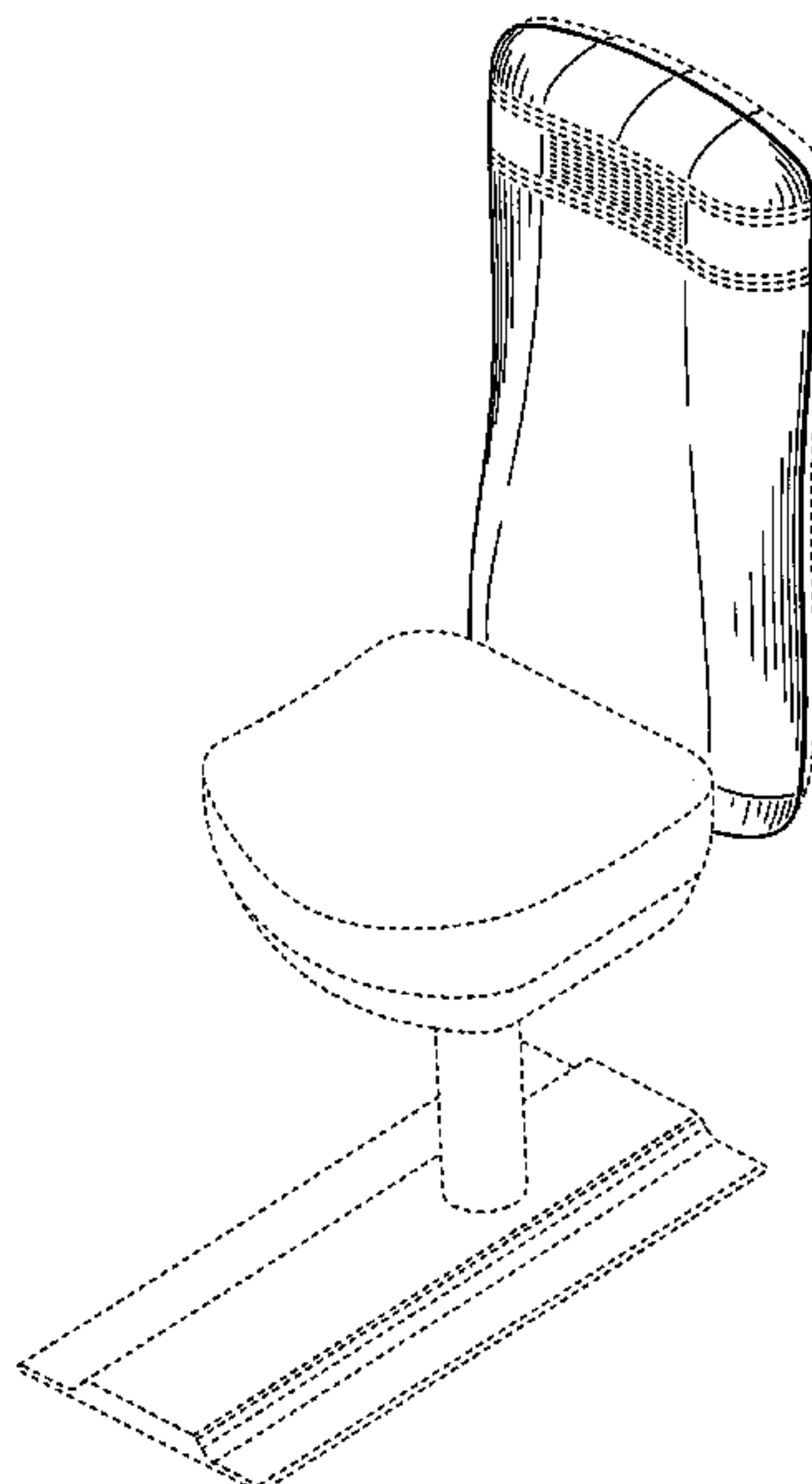
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

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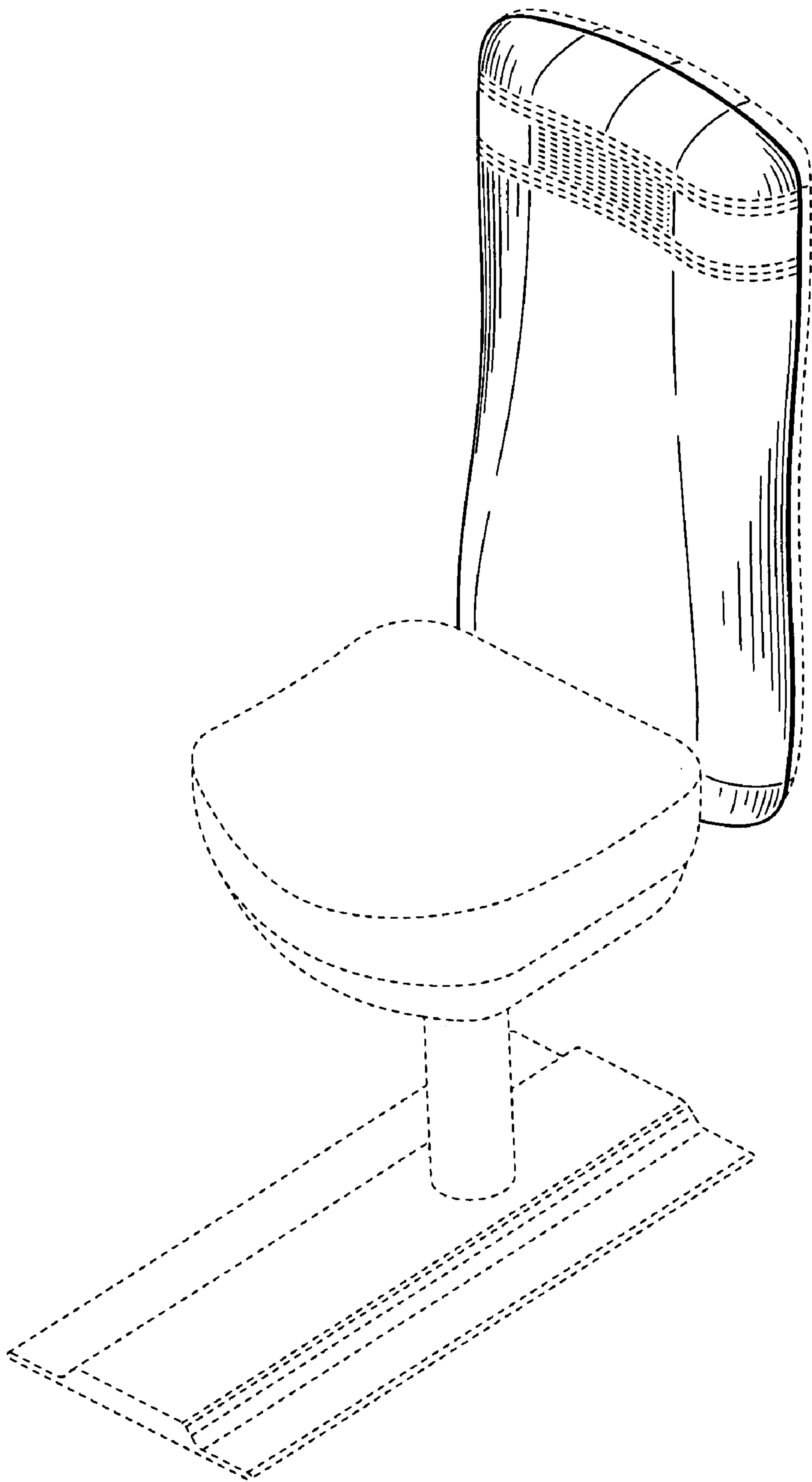

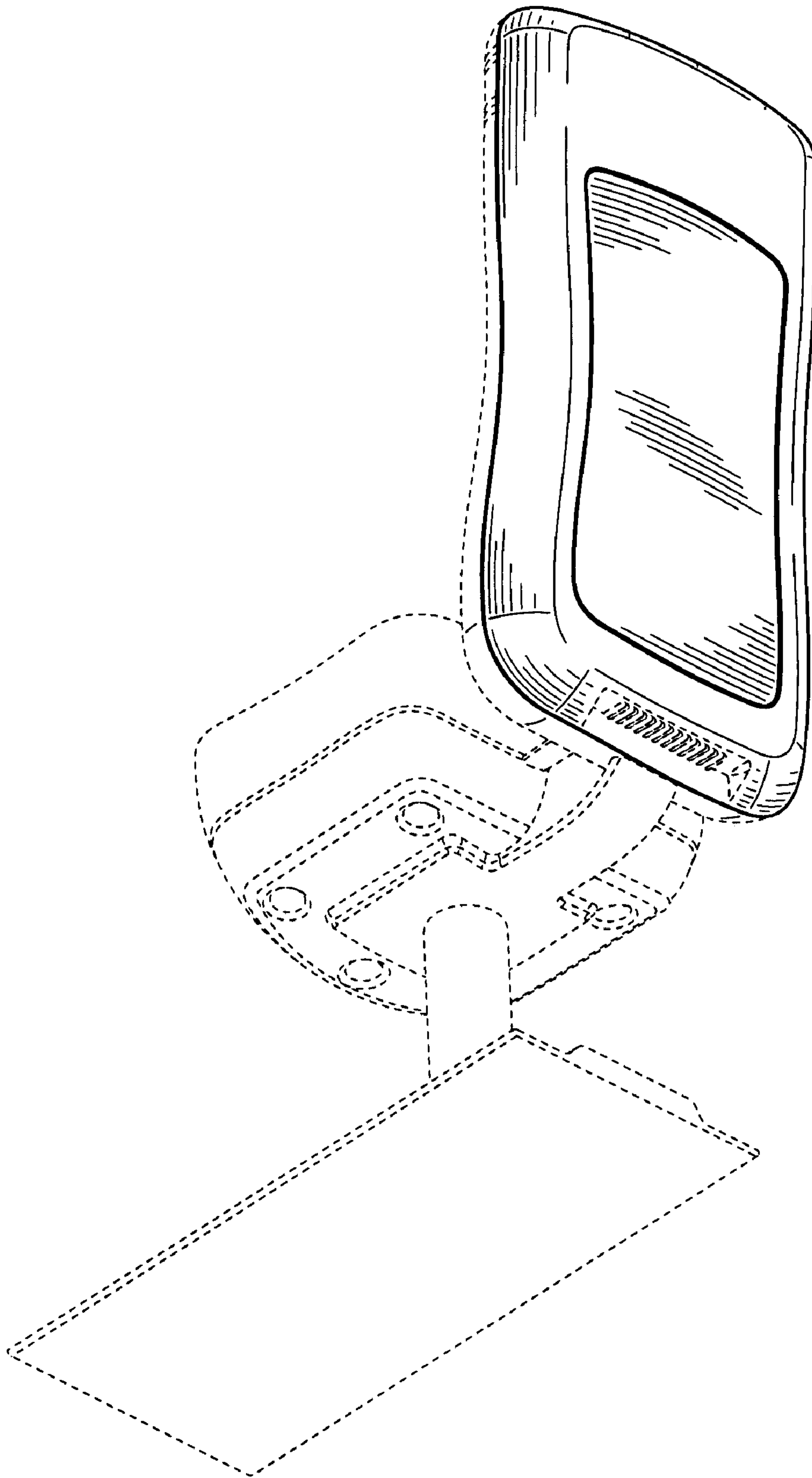

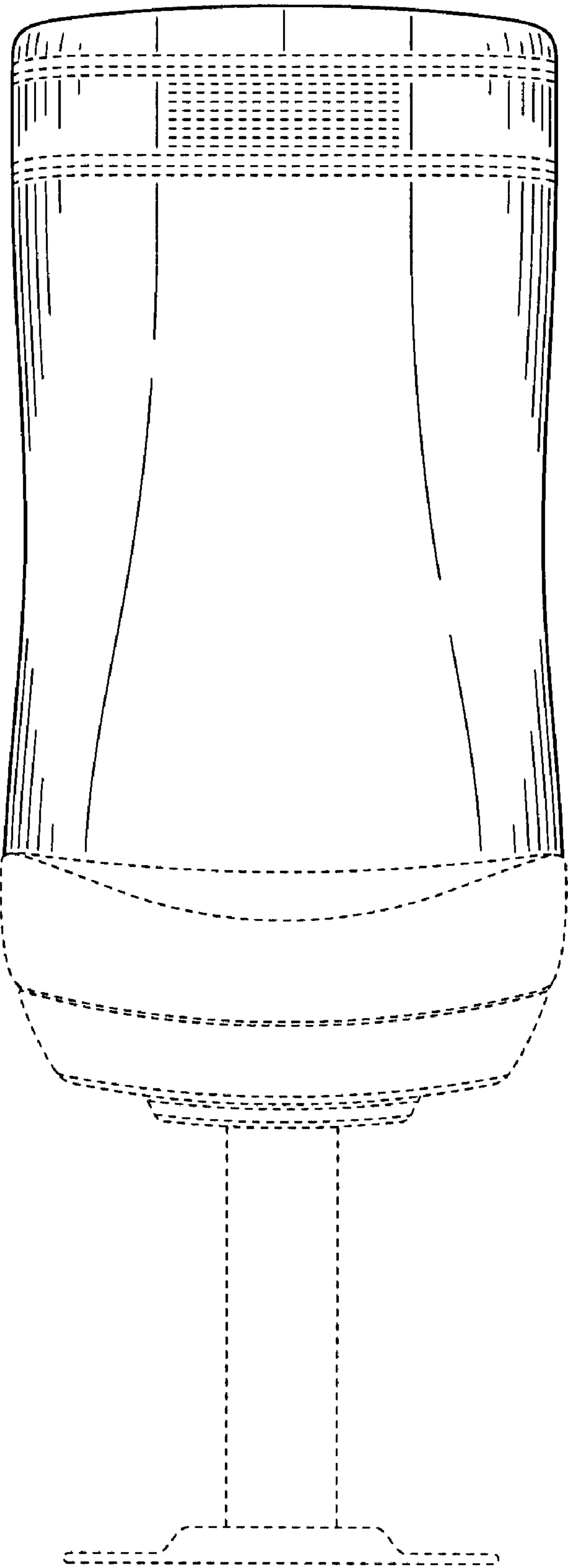

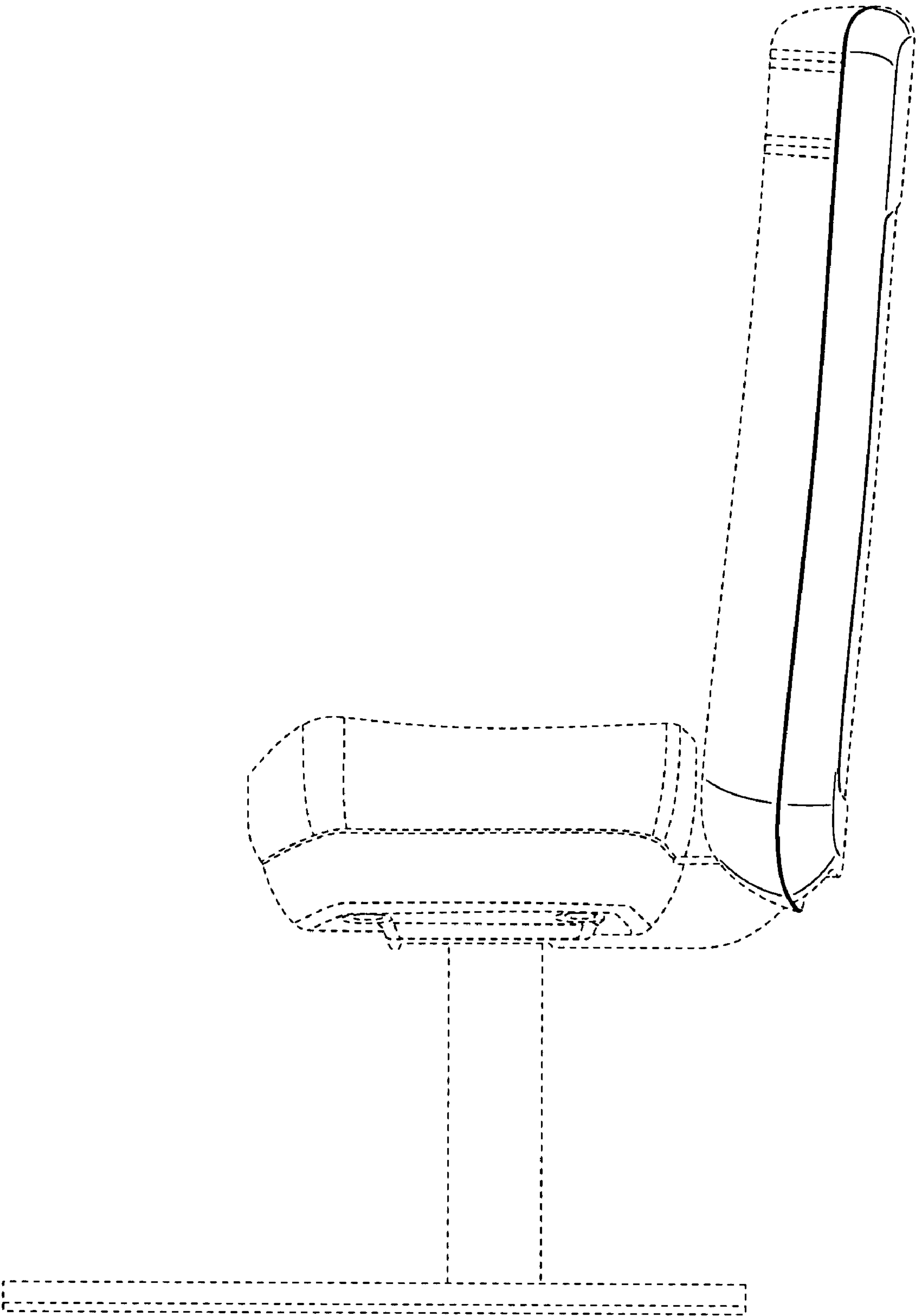

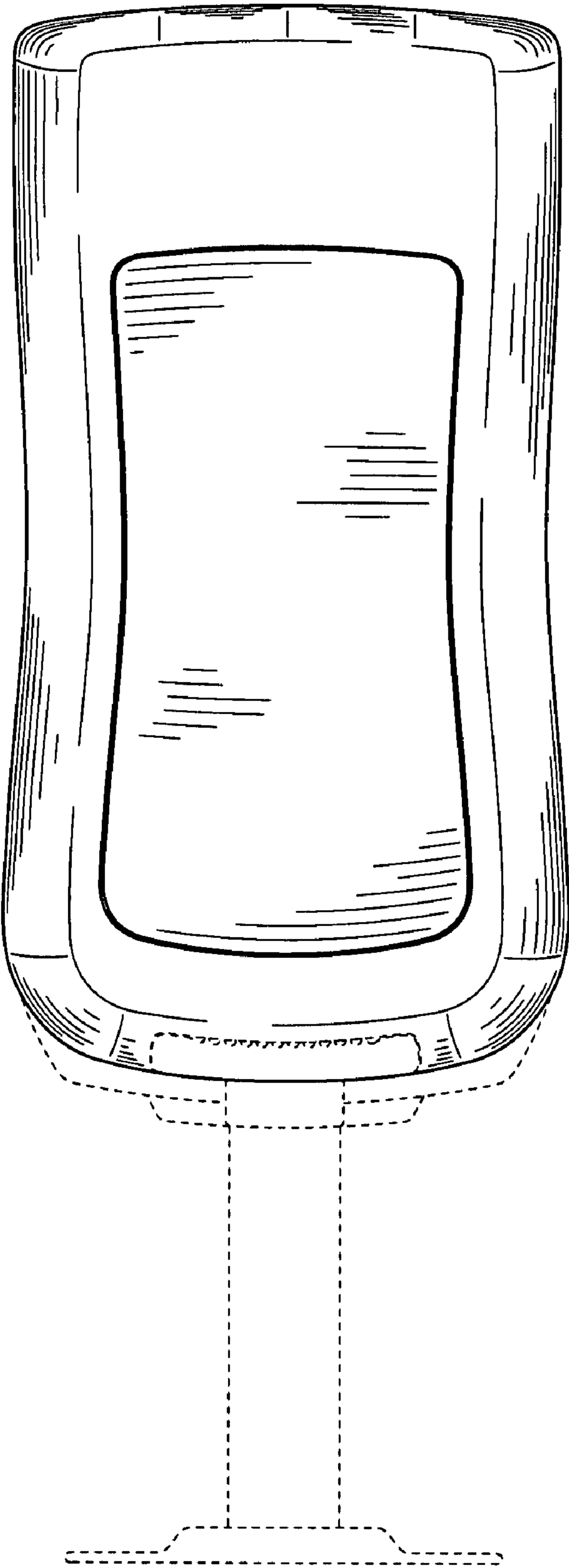

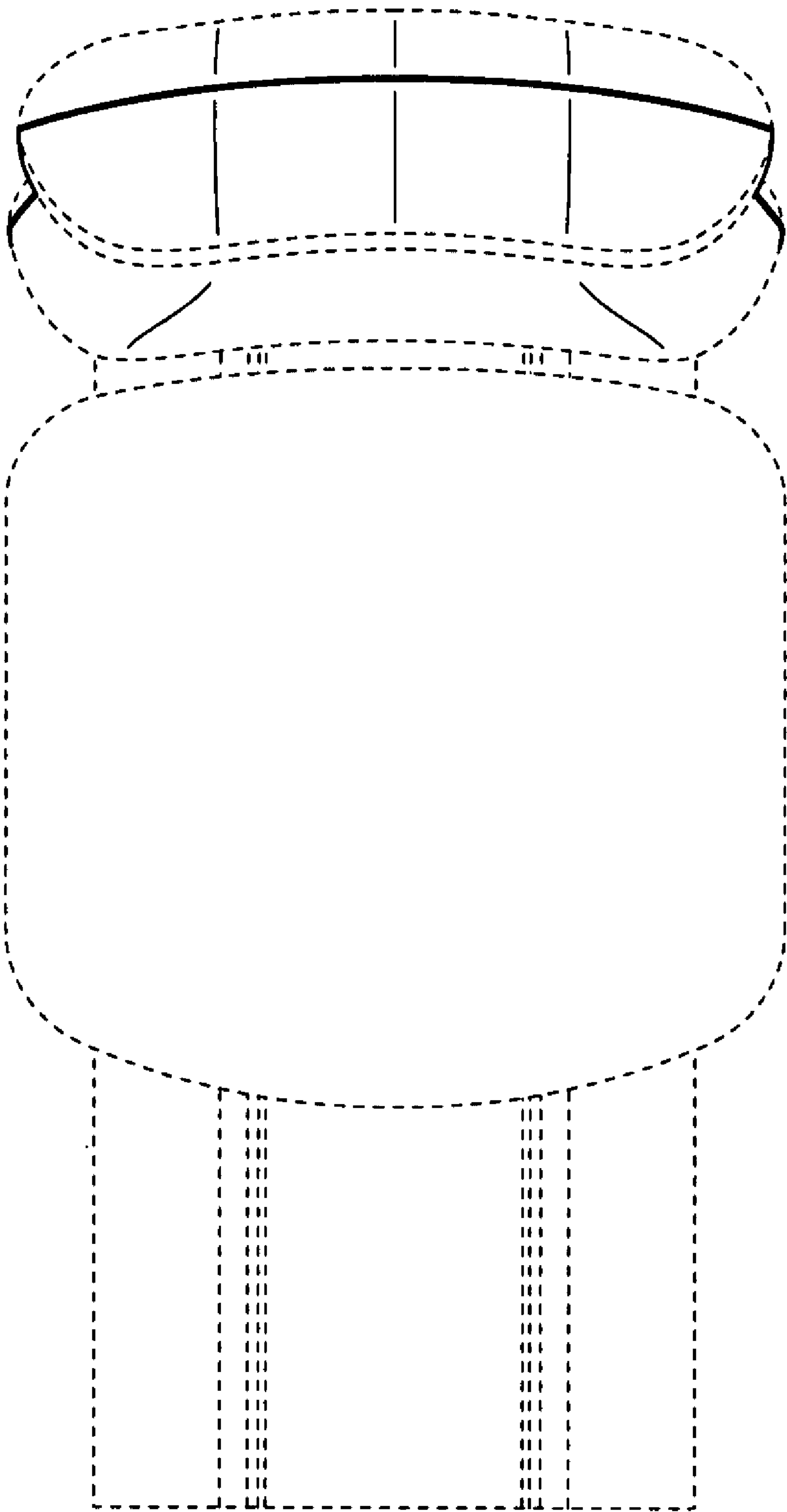

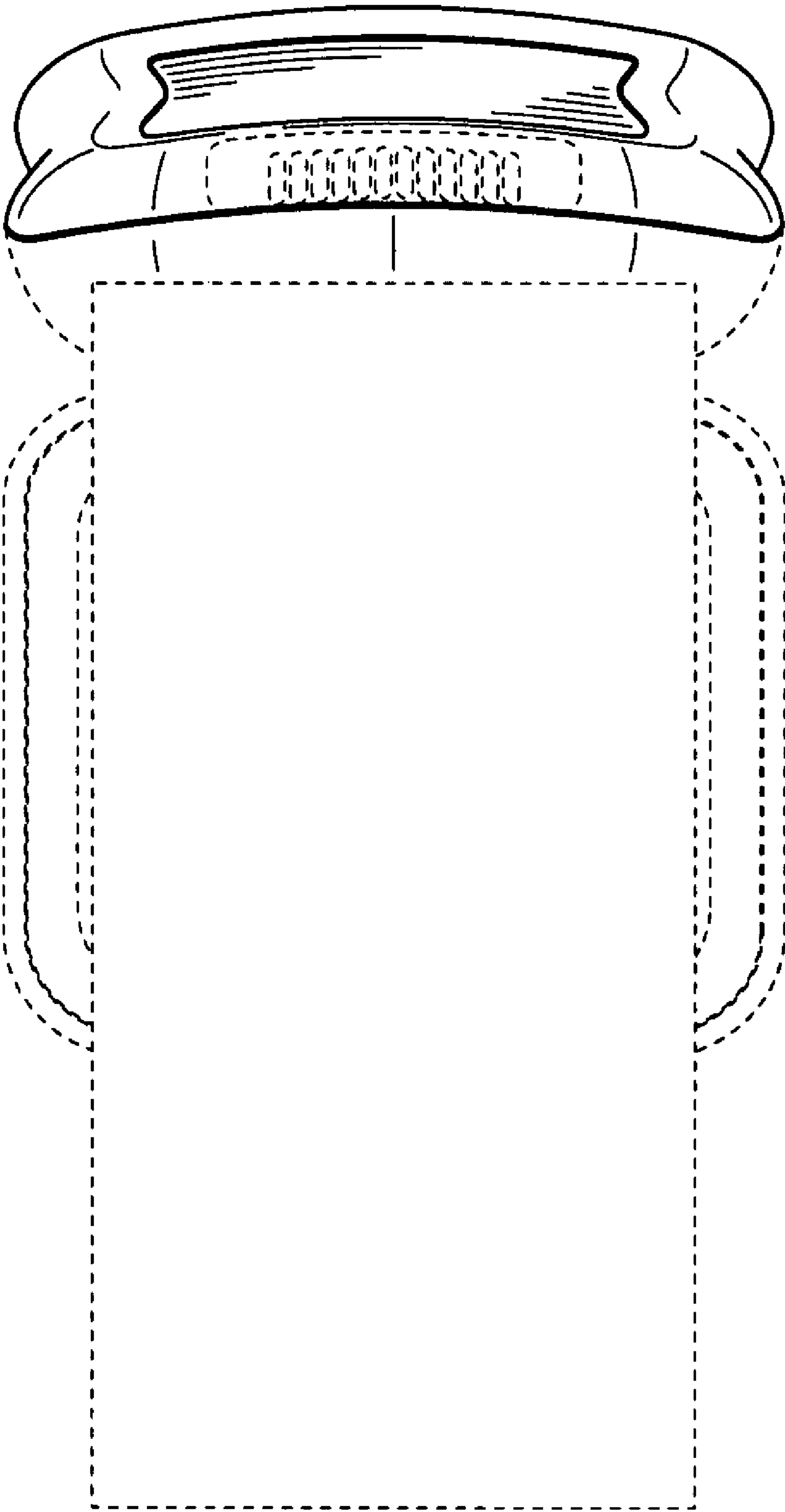
