The ornamental design for a stained glass for door, as shown.

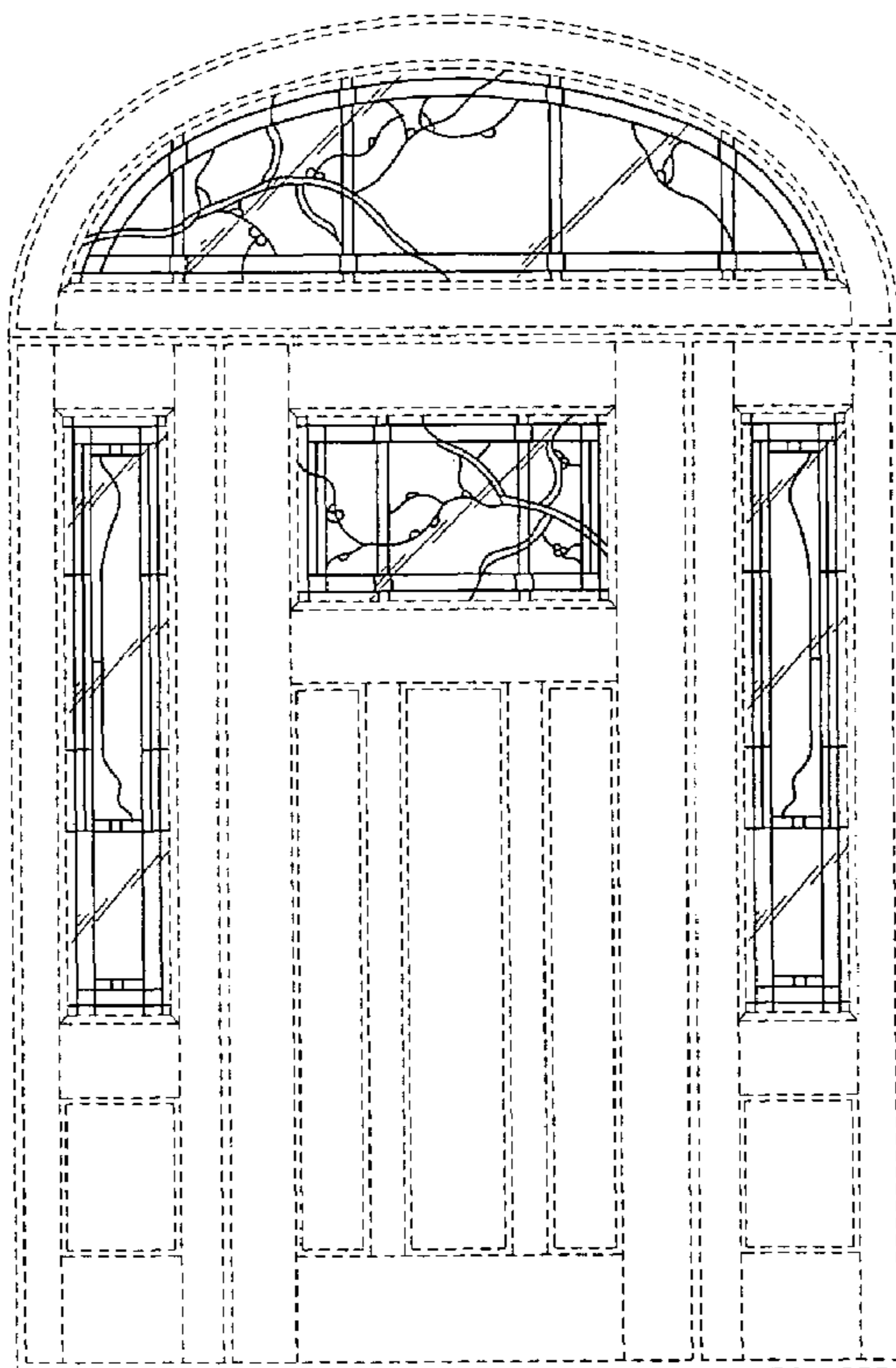
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a stained glass for door in an embodiment of the present invention; and,

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a stained glass for door in the embodiment of the present invention shown in FIG. 1.

The broken lines adjoining the solid line claimed disclosure define the bounds of the claimed design and form no part thereof and the broken lines showing of a door frame form no part thereof.

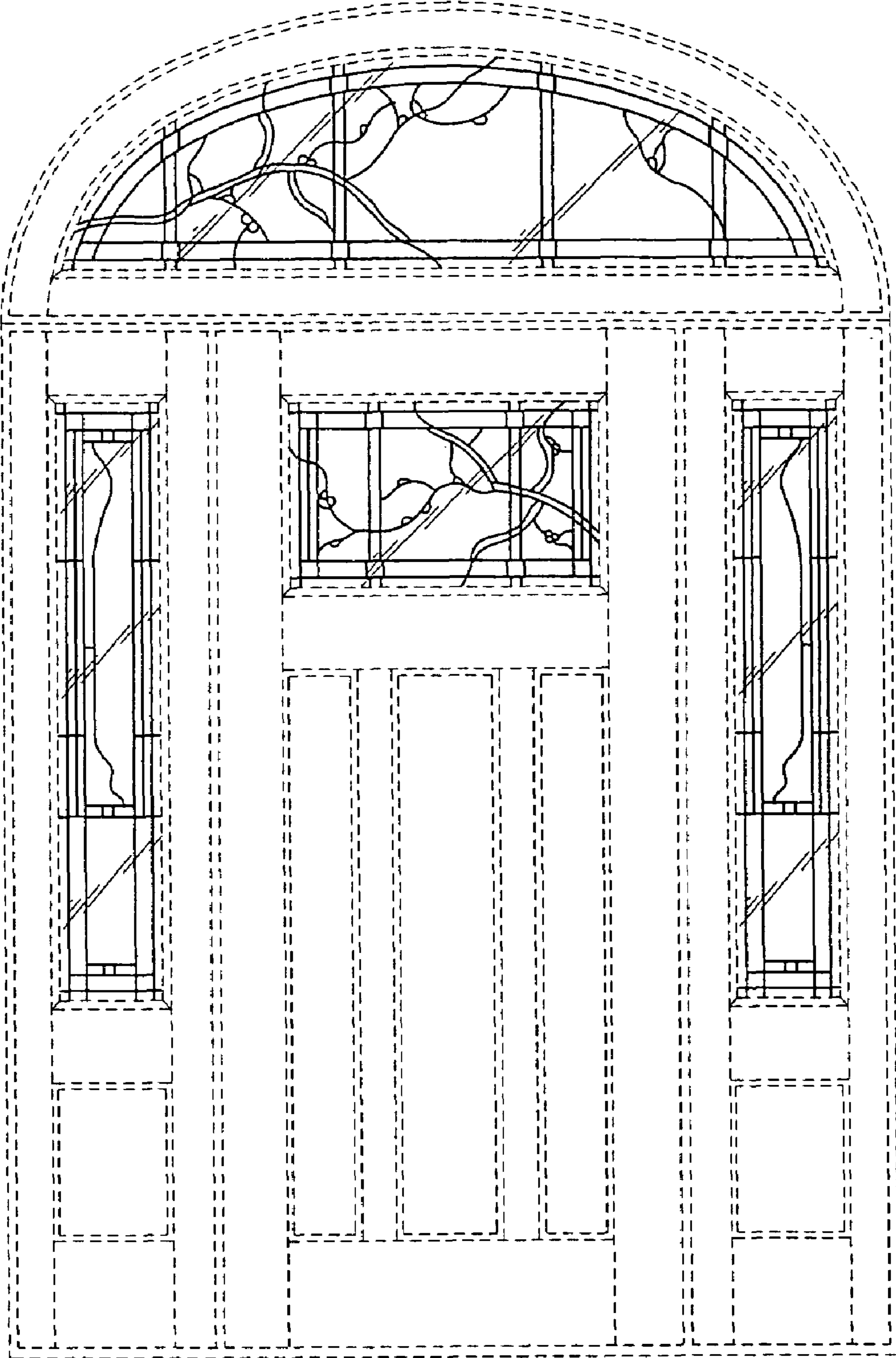

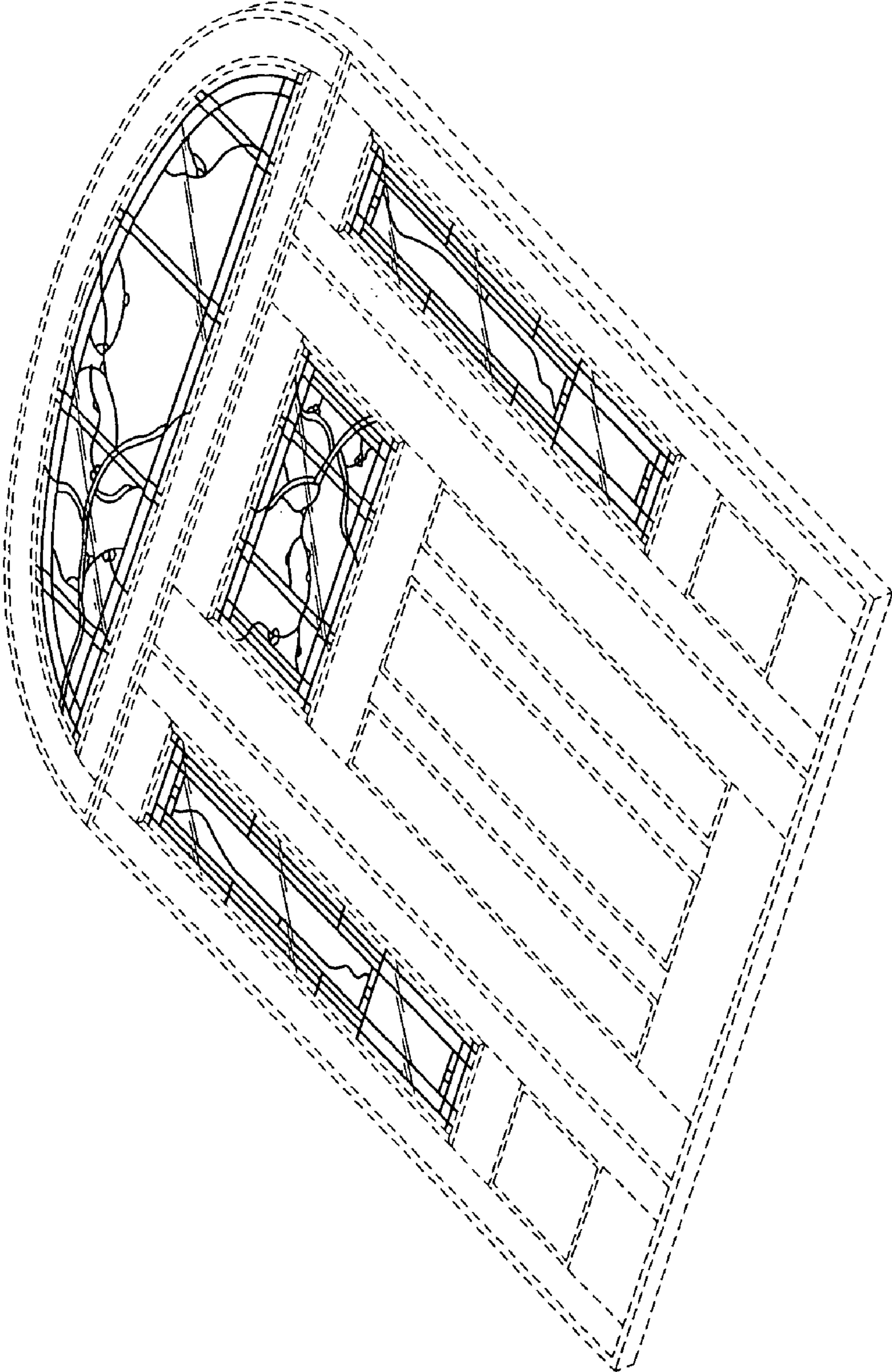
