FIG. 3 is a left side view of the polarizing lamp head, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;

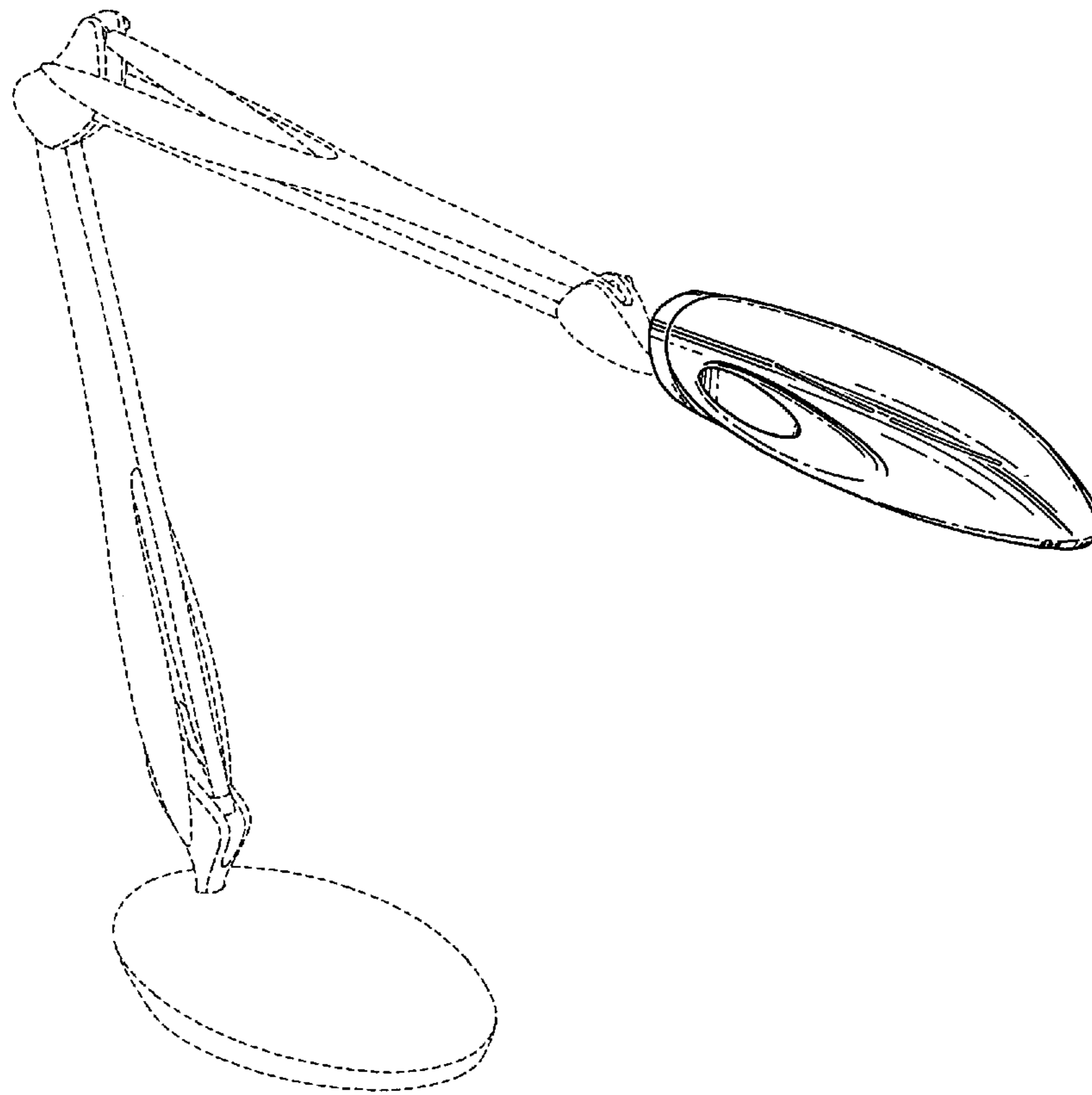
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the polarizing lamp head;

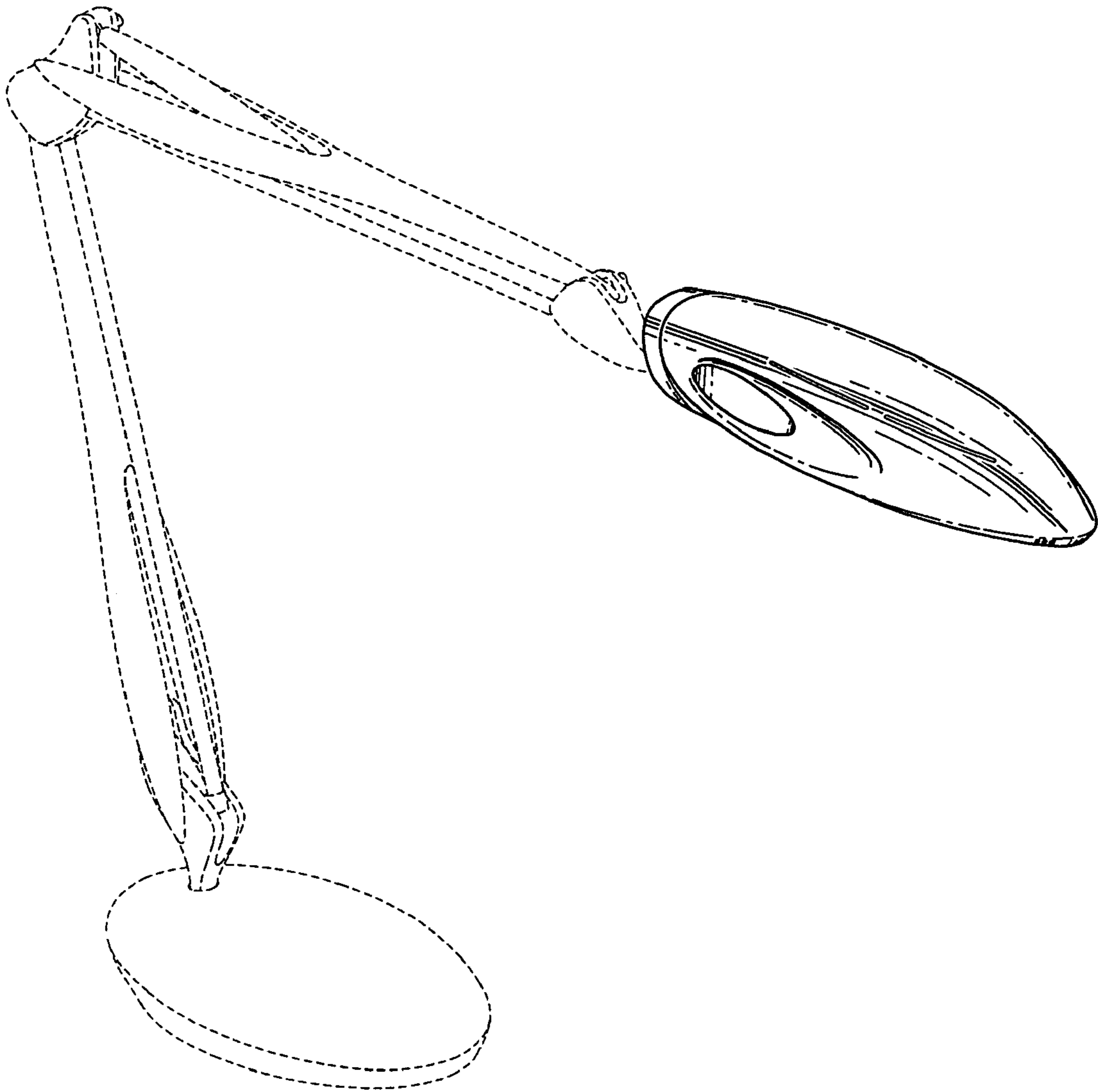
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the polarizing lamp head; and,

FIG. 6 is a front view of the polarizing lamp head.

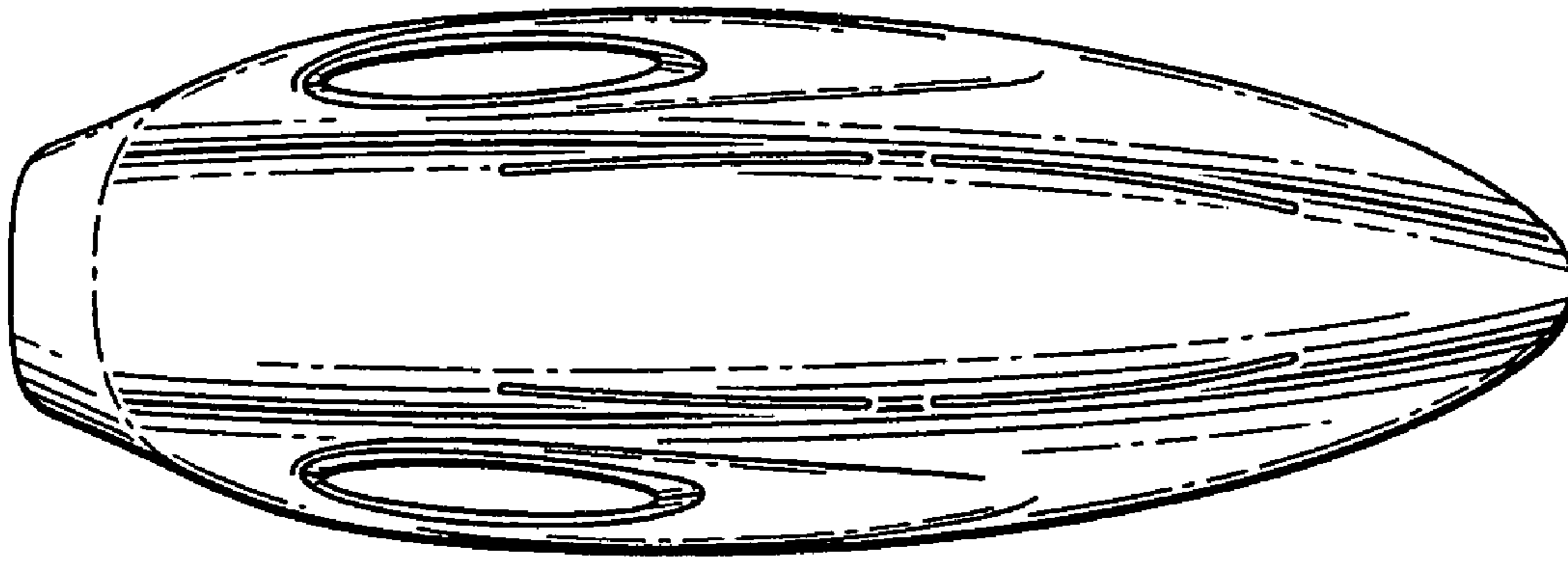
The broken lines are meant to show environment and form no part of the claimed design.

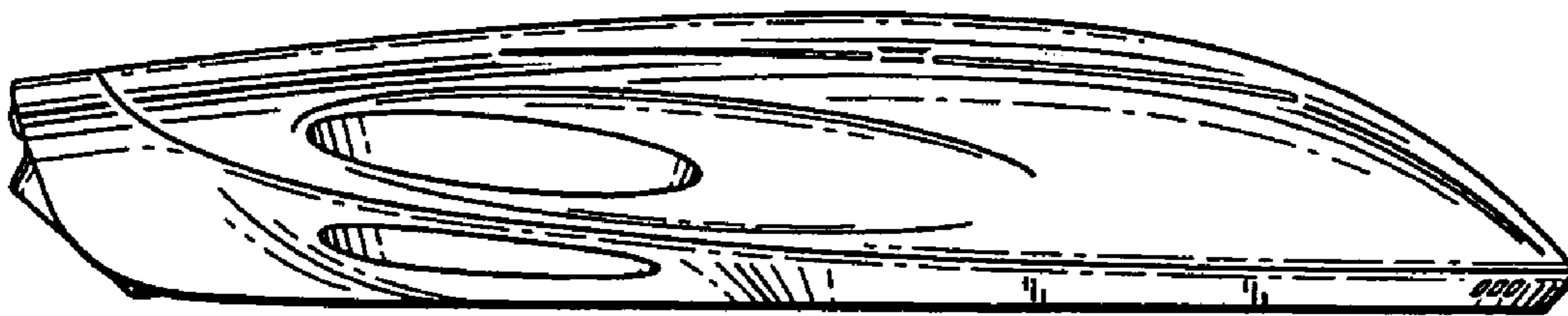




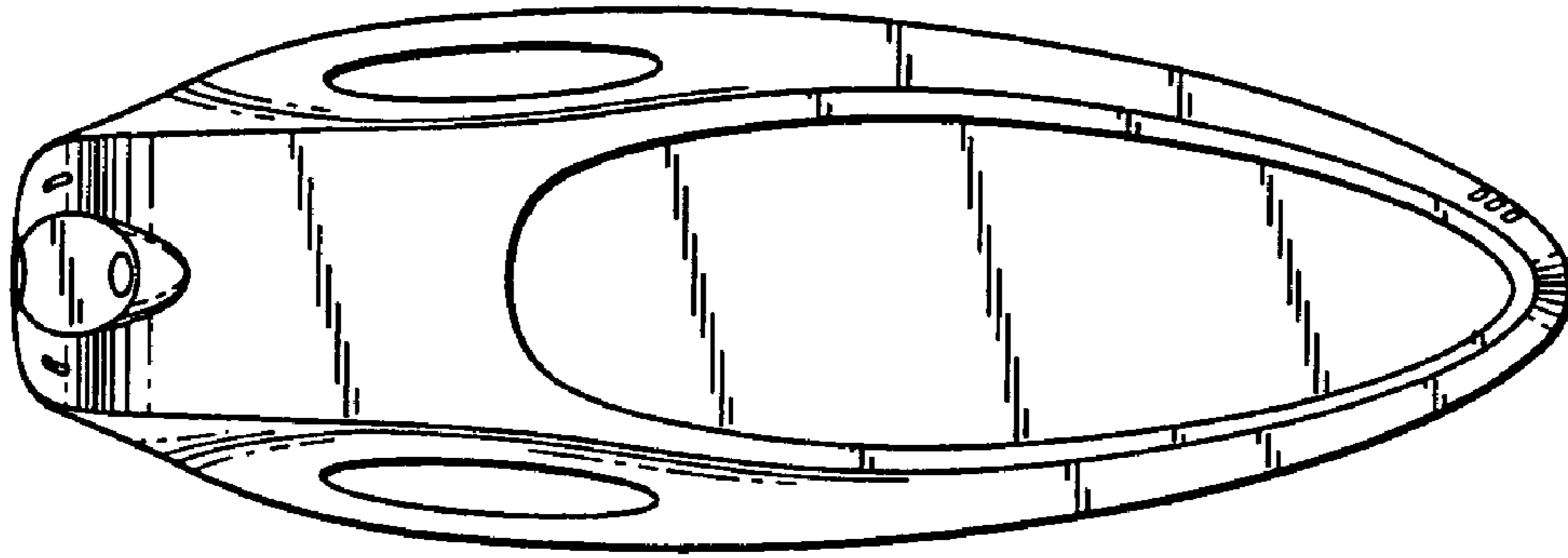

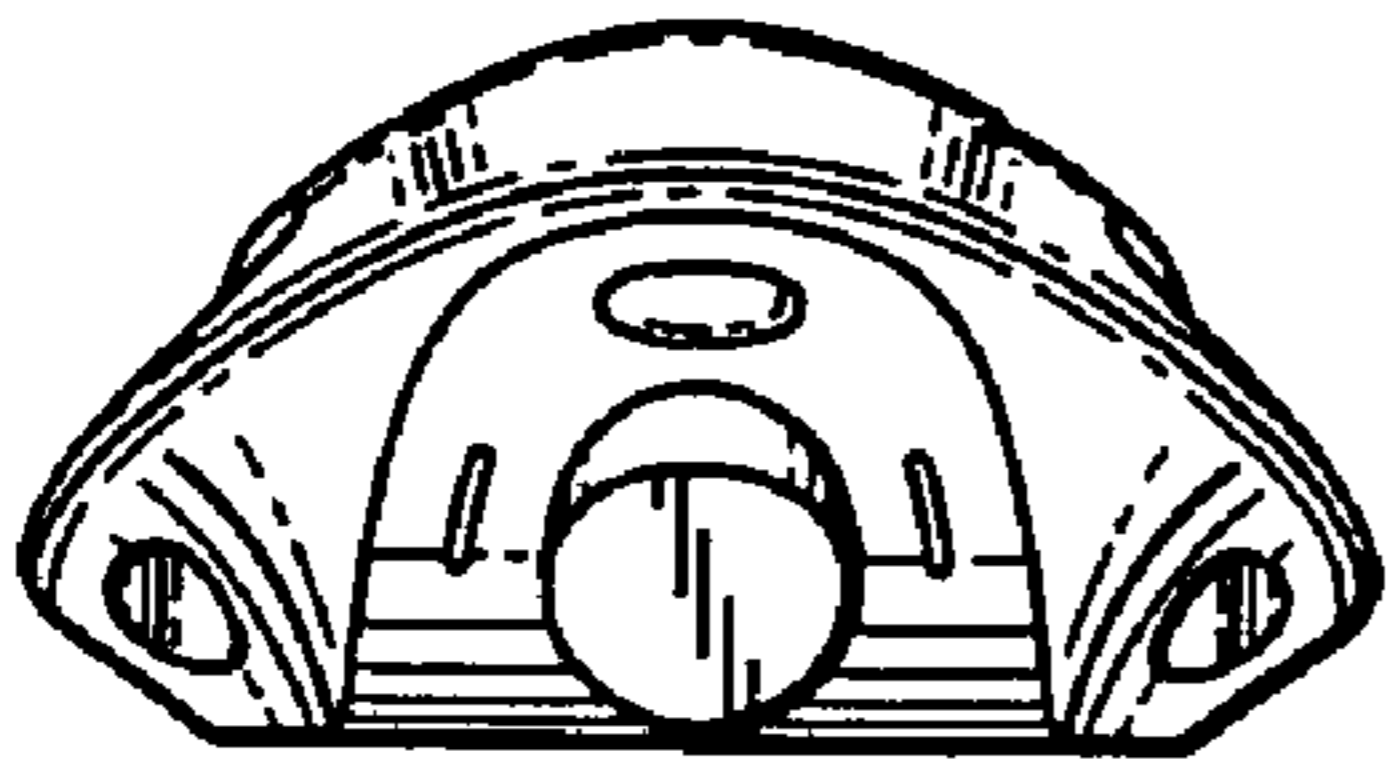

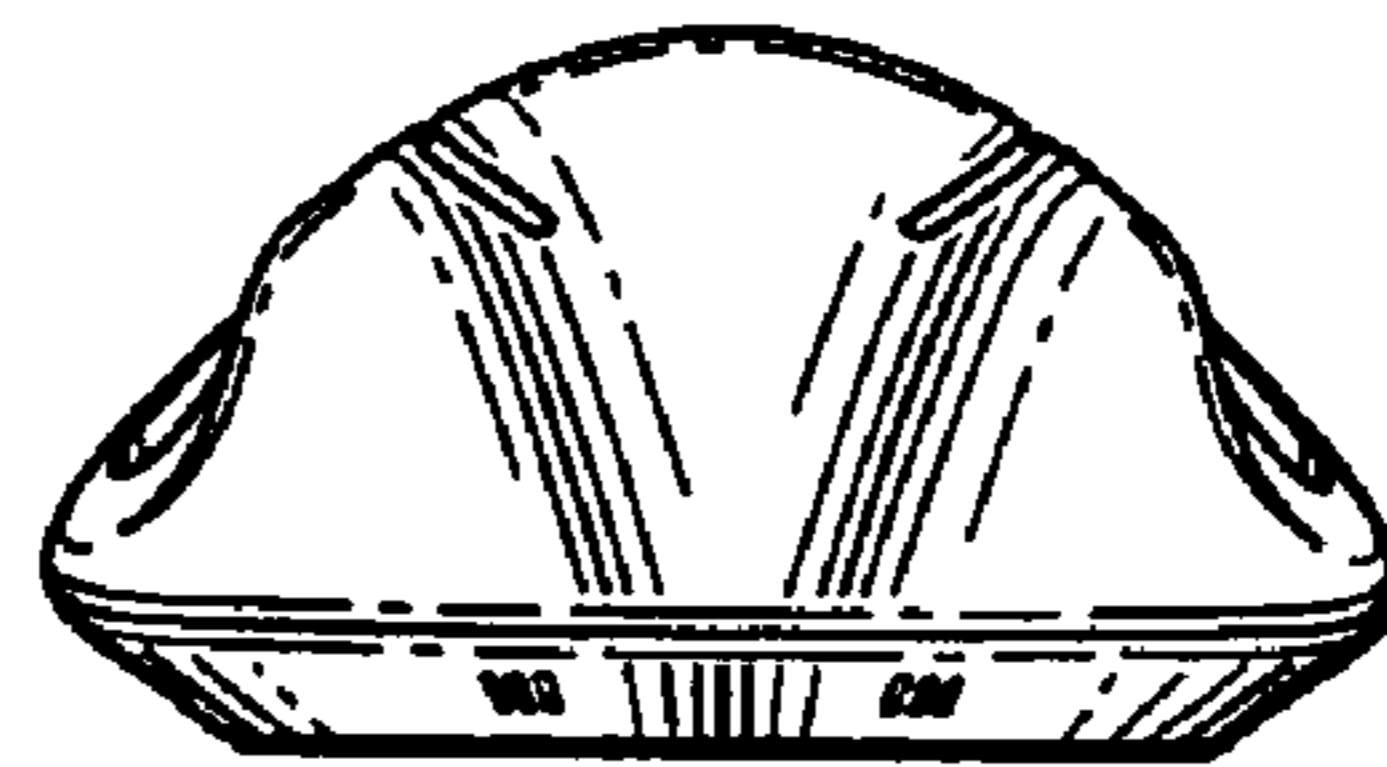
