(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an outsole for a shoe, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of an outsole for a shoe showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;

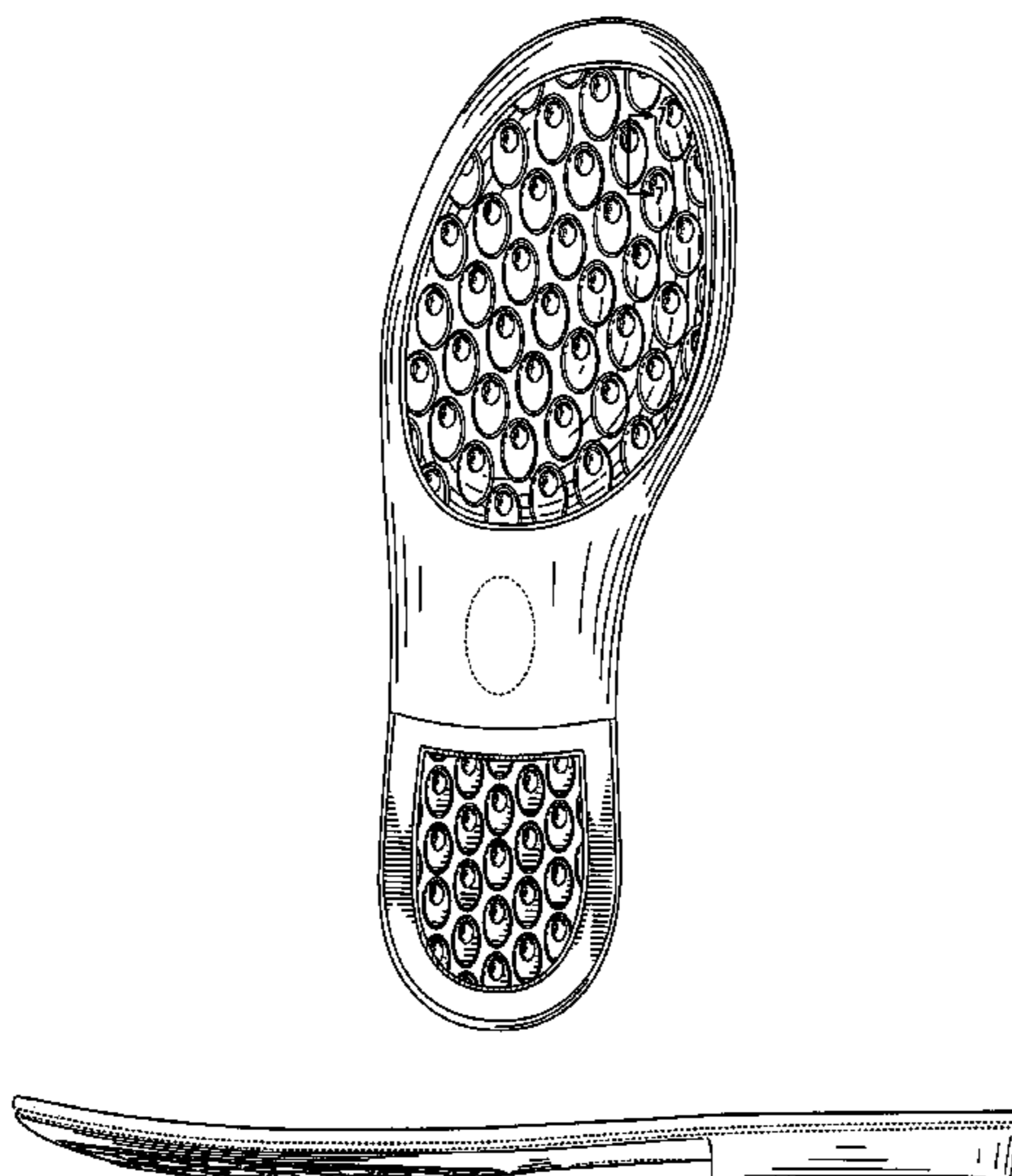
FIG. 5 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken along line 7—7 shown in FIG. 2.

The broken line showing an oval shape in the arch area of FIGS. 1 & 2, along with the parallel broken lines around the peripheries of FIGS. 2-6, represent the boundaries of the design. The broken lines showing a portion of the interior surface in FIG. 7 represents the portion of the design that forms no part of the claim. Neither the broken lines themselves, nor the areas within them form any part of the claim.

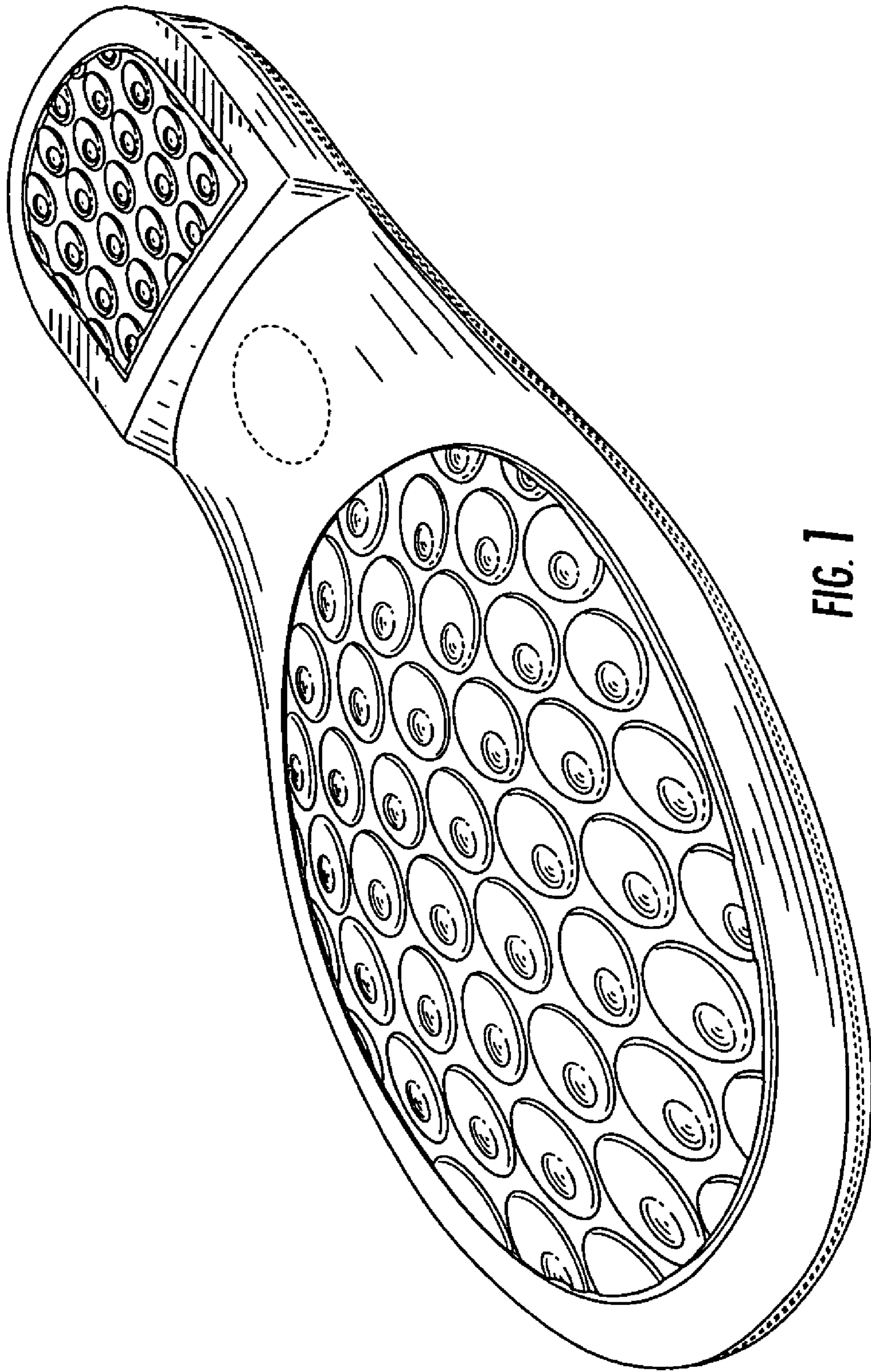

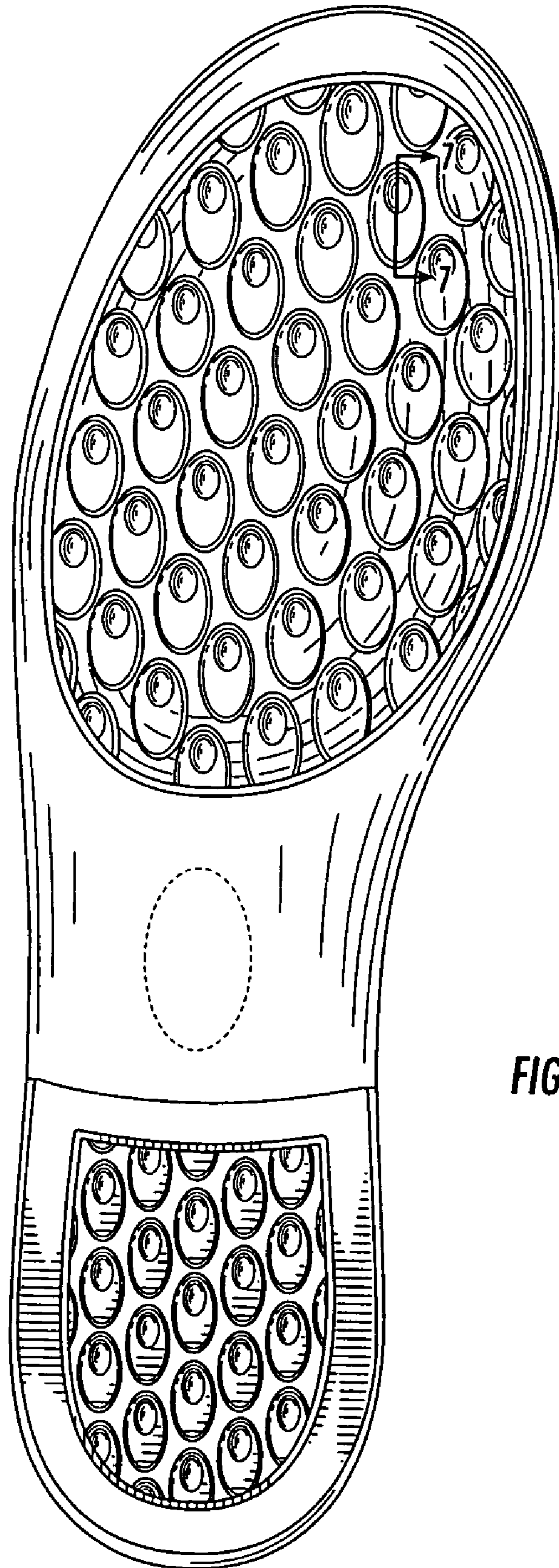

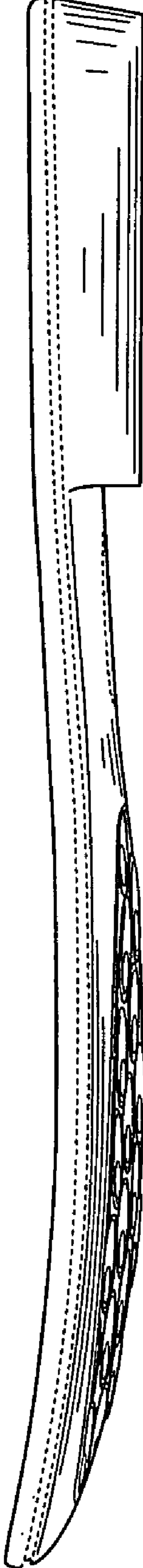

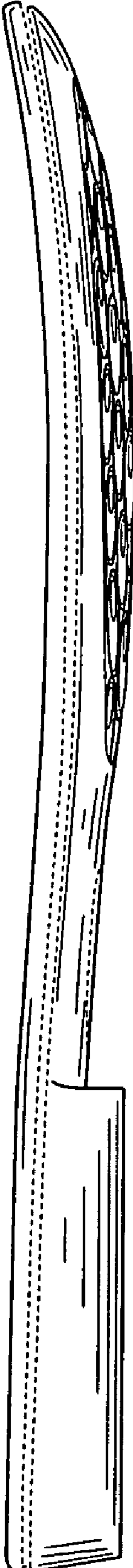
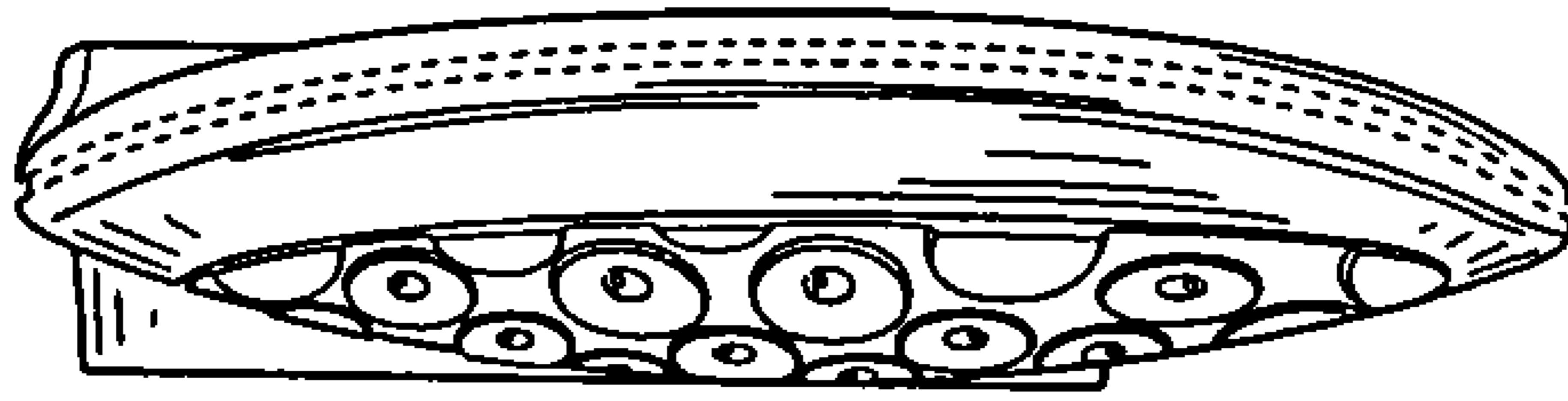
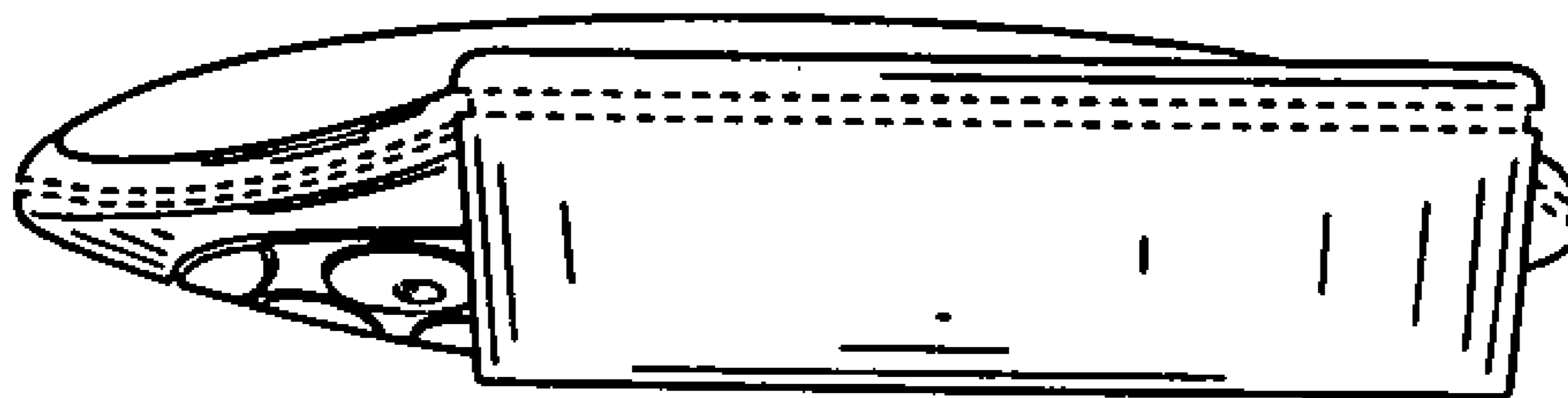


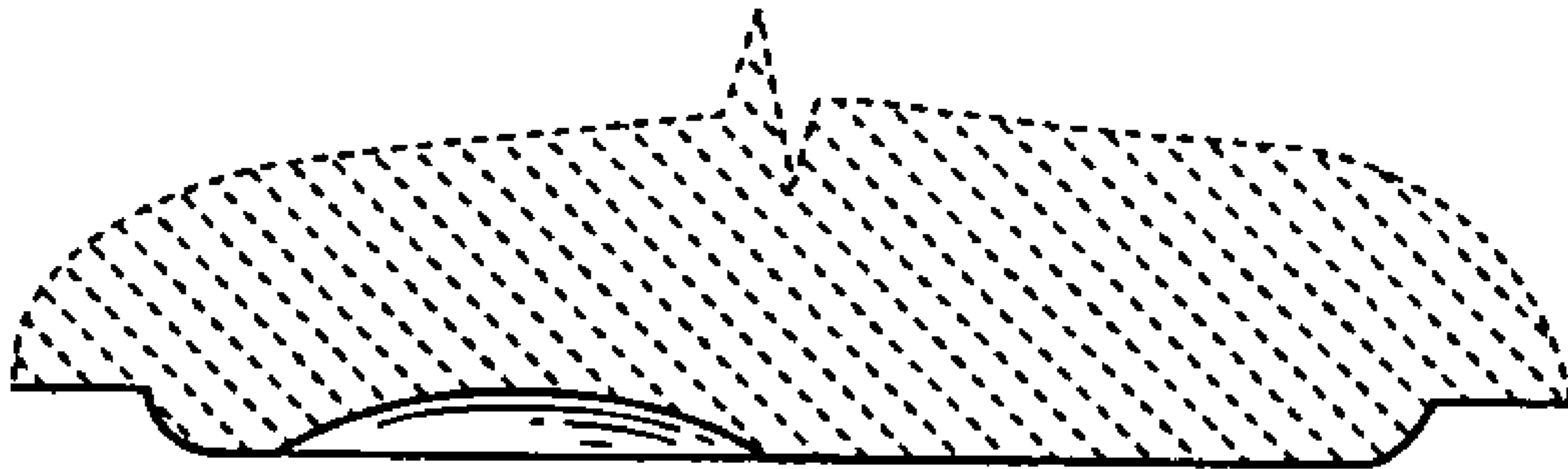
