(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an exhaust pipe end for a vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

This application is related to the following co-pending applications, of the inventor, filed on even date herewith: Application Ser. No. 29/271,454, entitled “Vehicle, Toy, and/or Other Replicas”; and Application Ser. No. 29/271,453, entitled “Vehicle, Toy, and/or Other Replicas”.

FIG. 1 is a front view of a first embodiment of an exhaust pipe end for a vehicle according to my novel design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of a second embodiment of the exhaust pipe end for a vehicle according to my novel design;

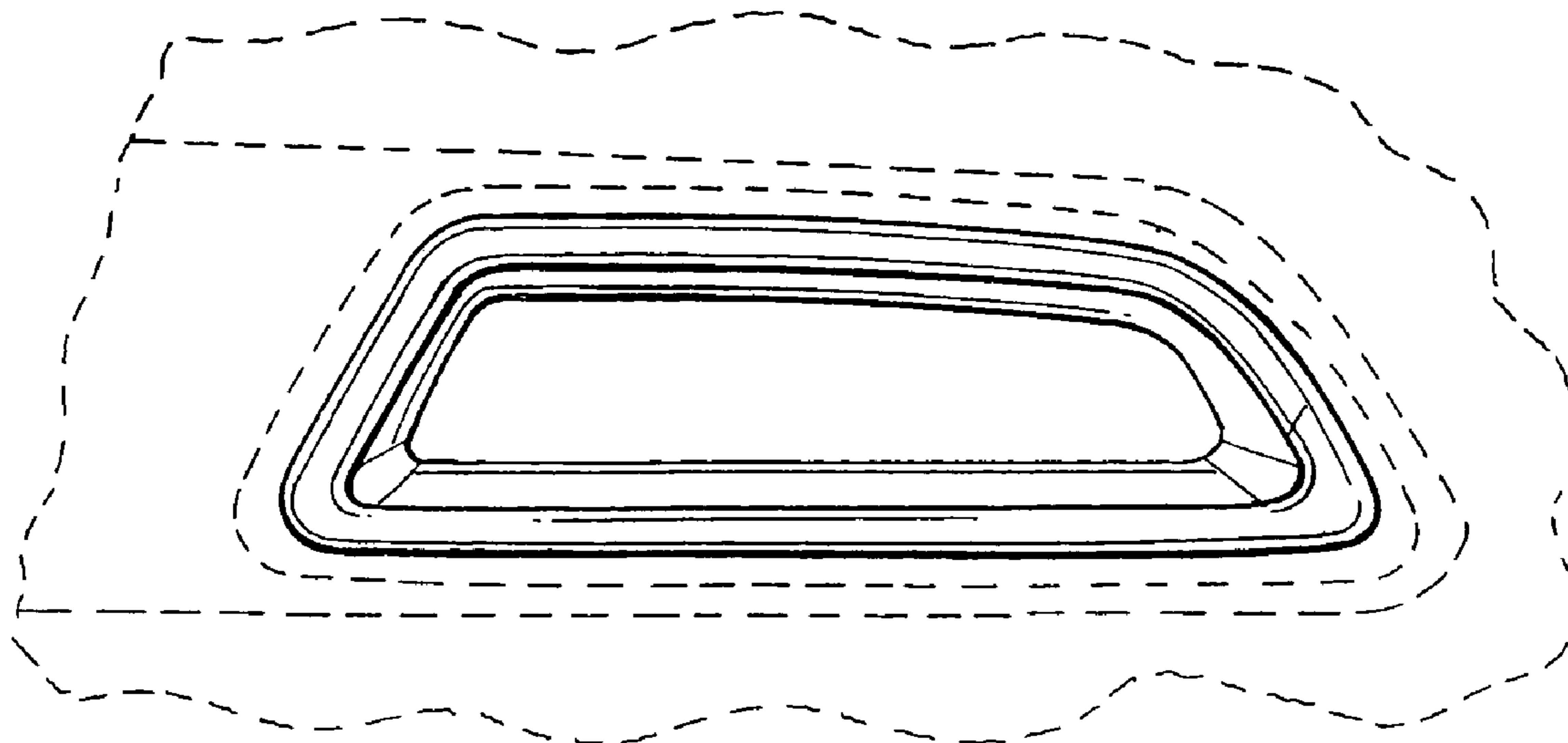
FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the first embodiment of the exhaust pipe end for a vehicle according to my novel design;

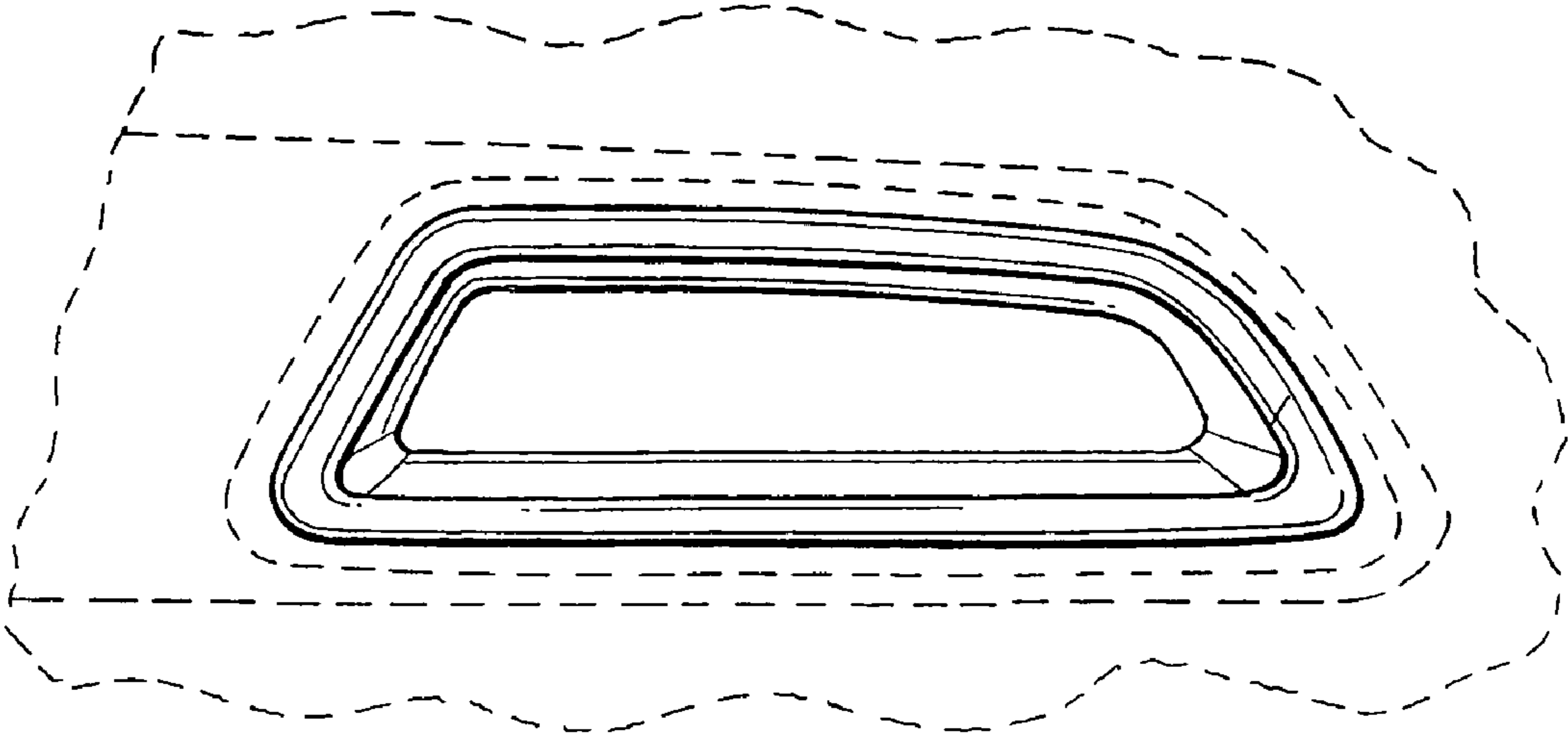

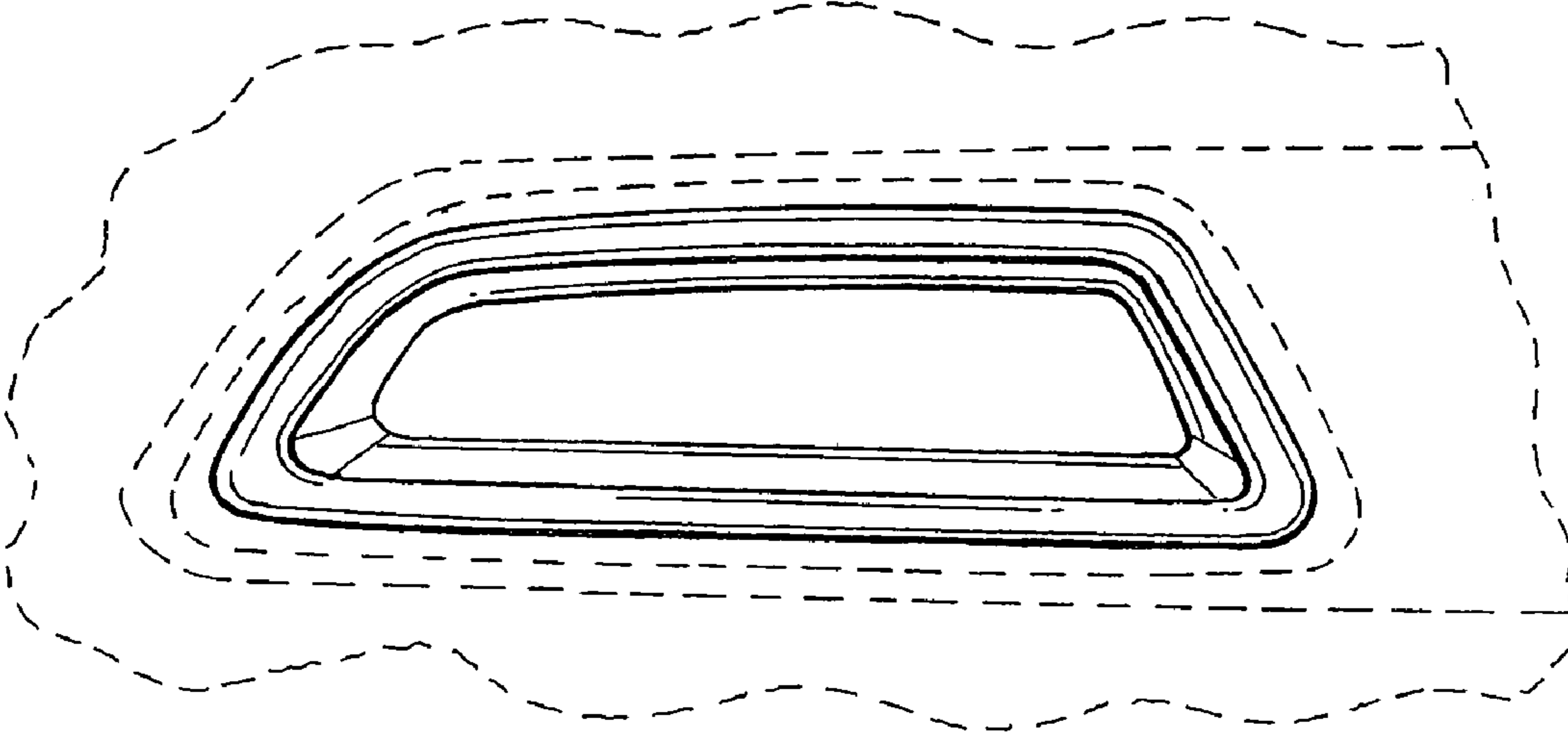

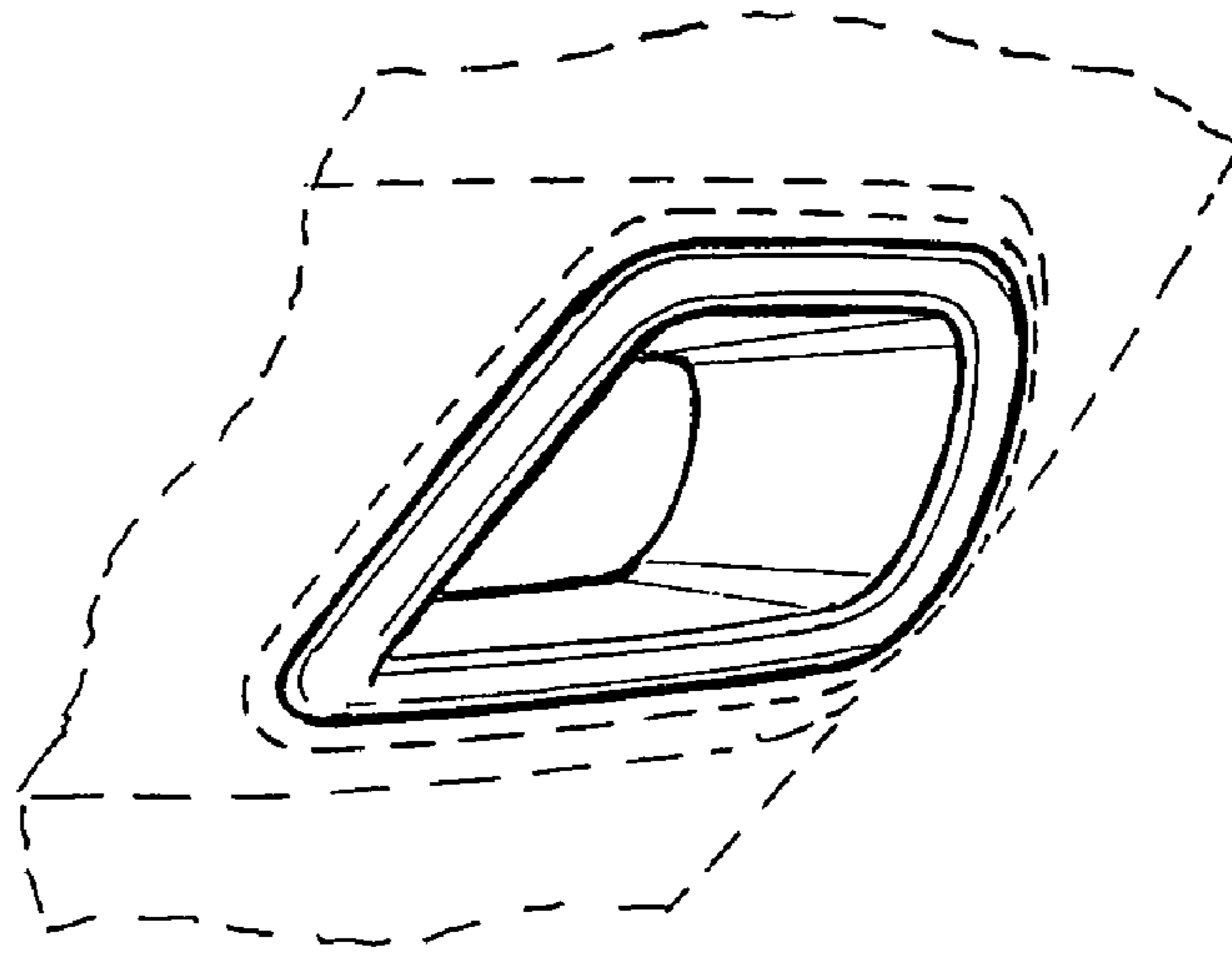

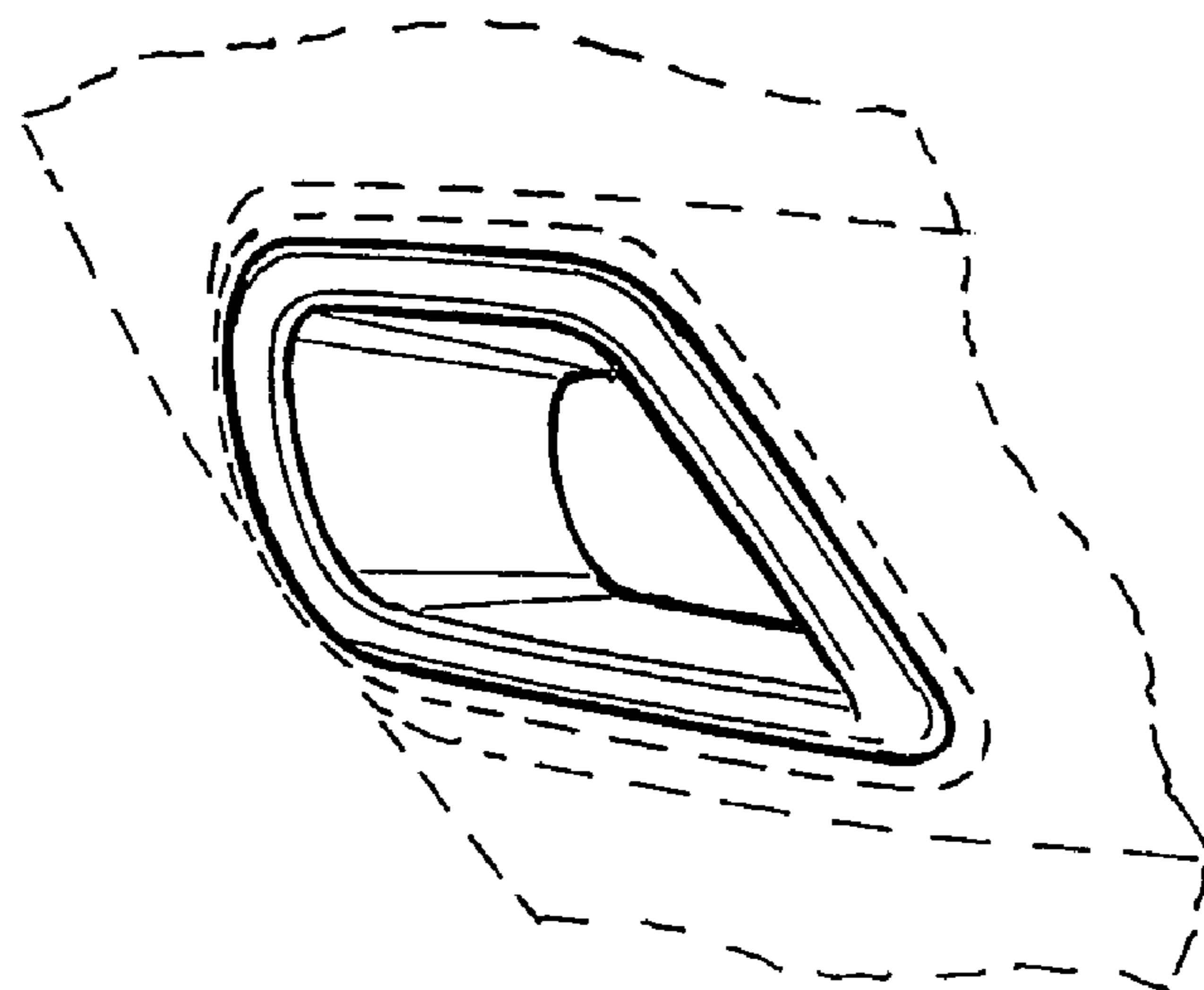

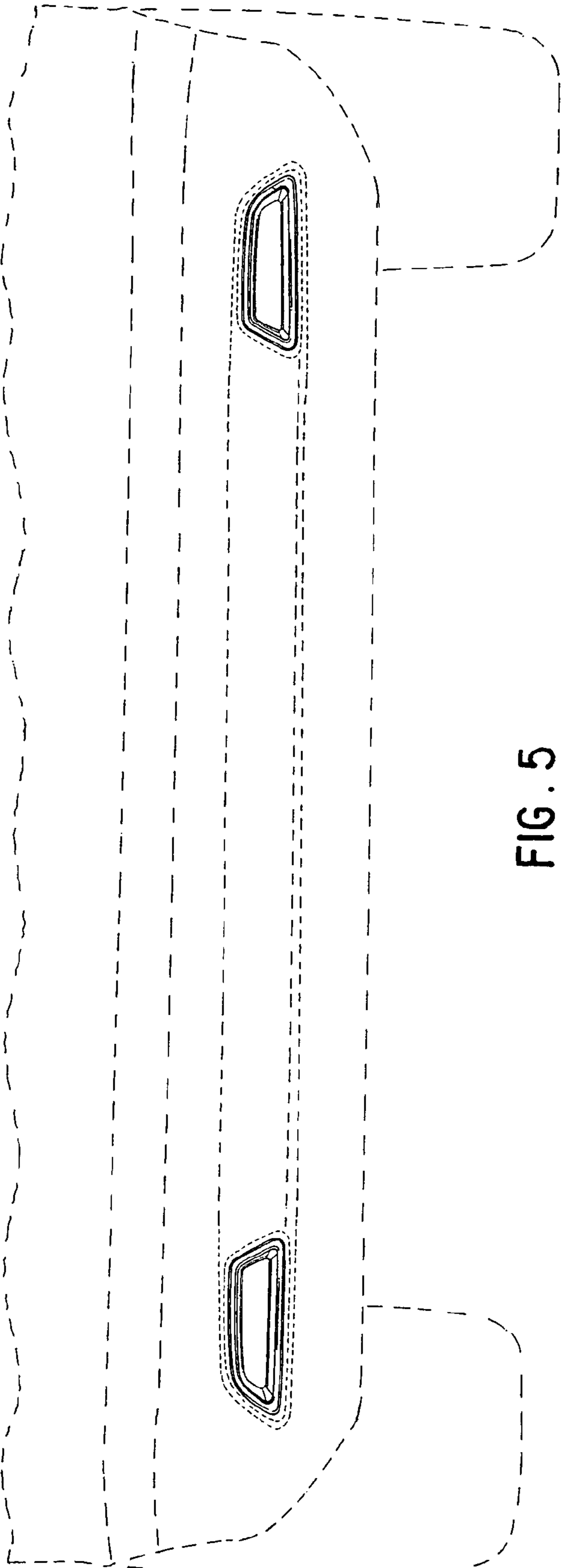
