FIG. 4 is a top view of the design of the present invention;

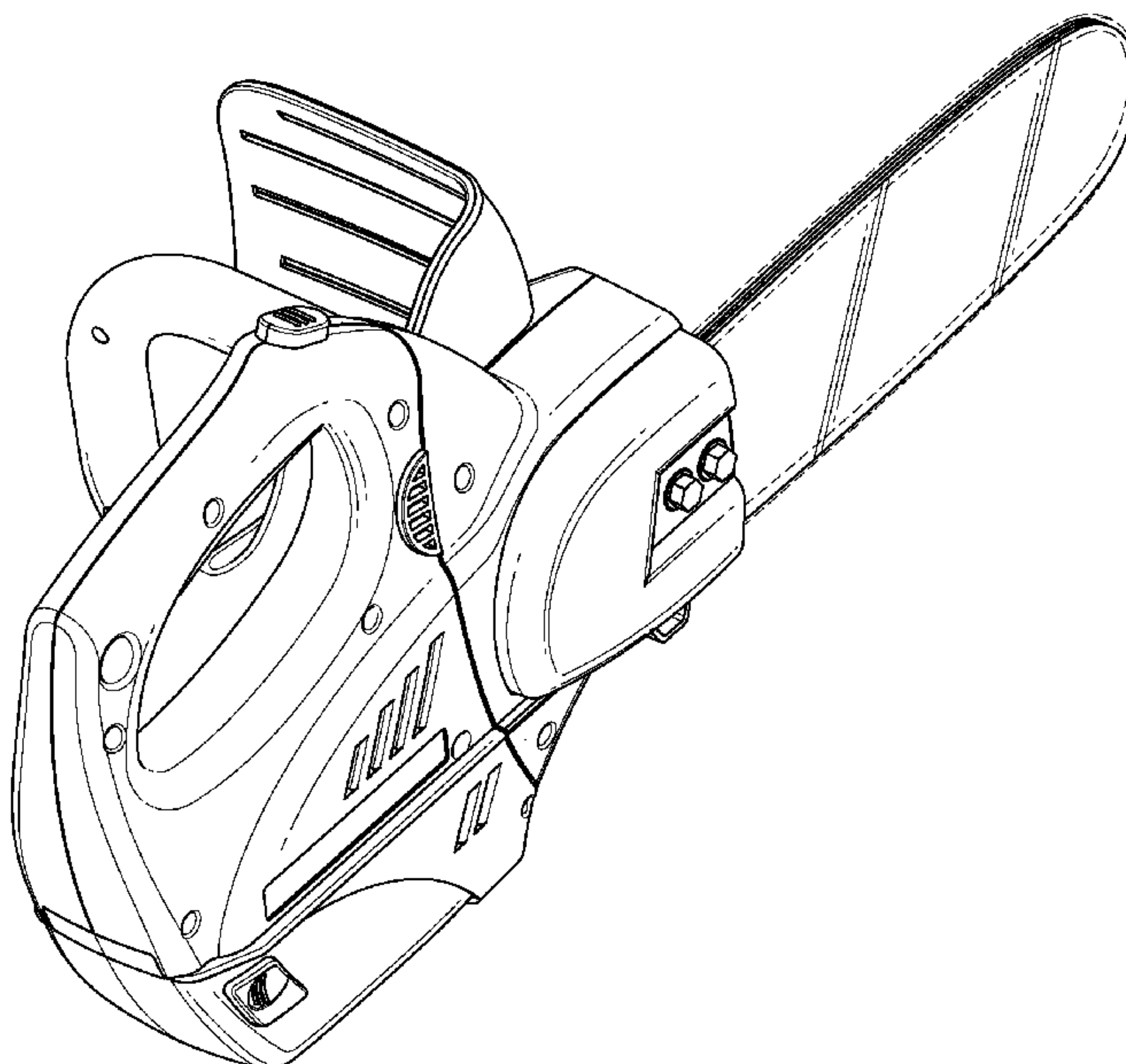
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the design of the present invention;

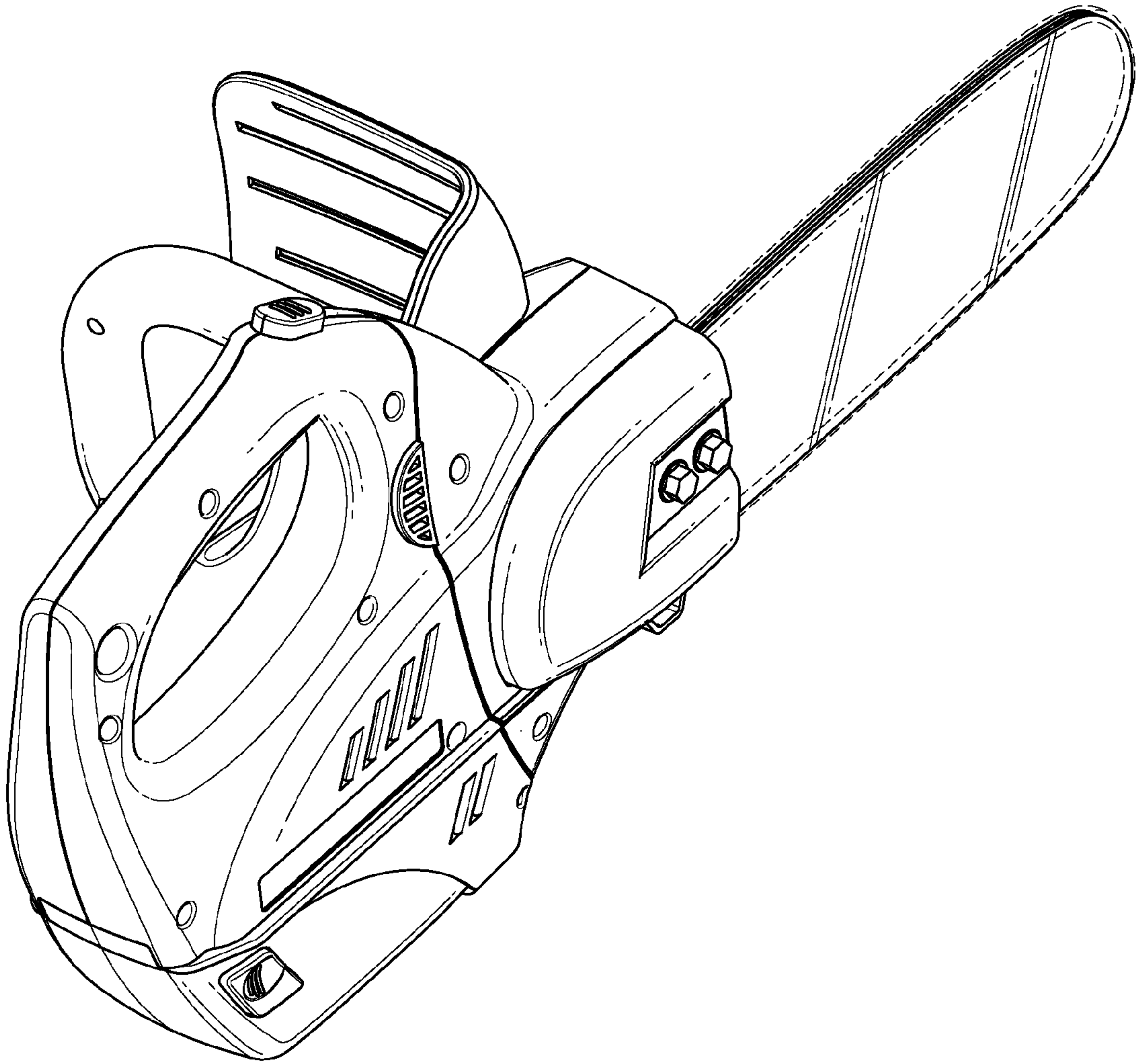

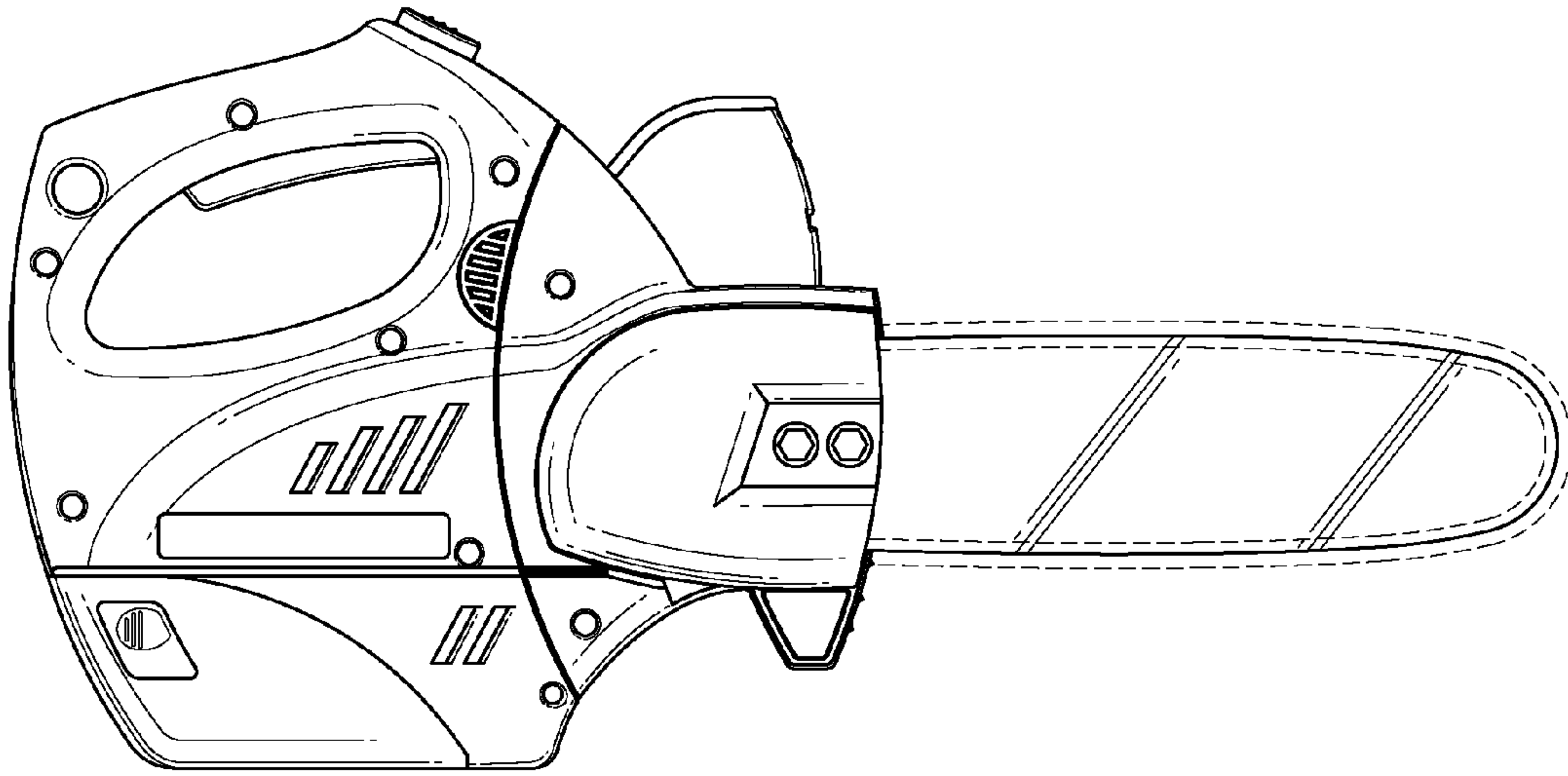

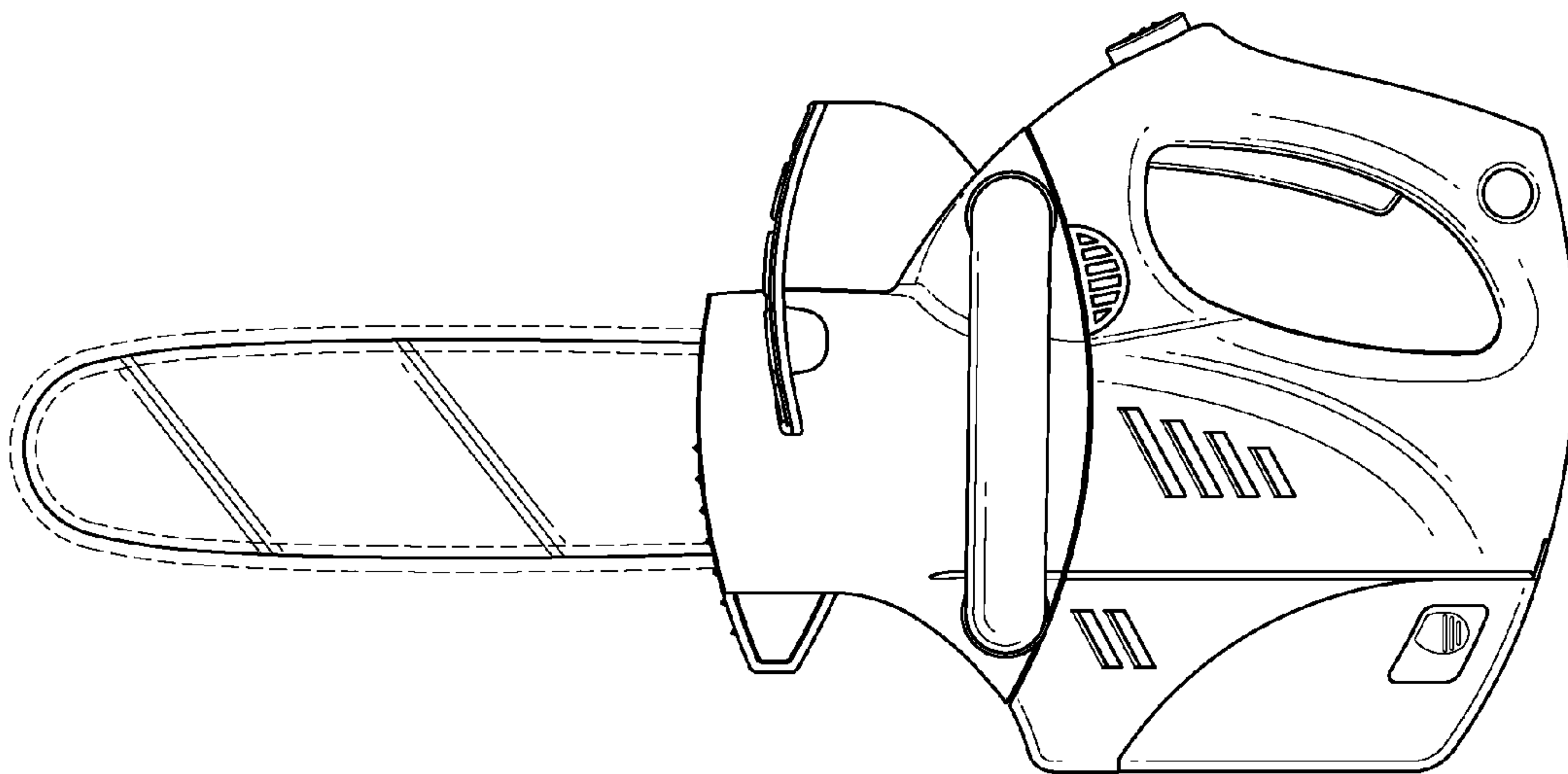

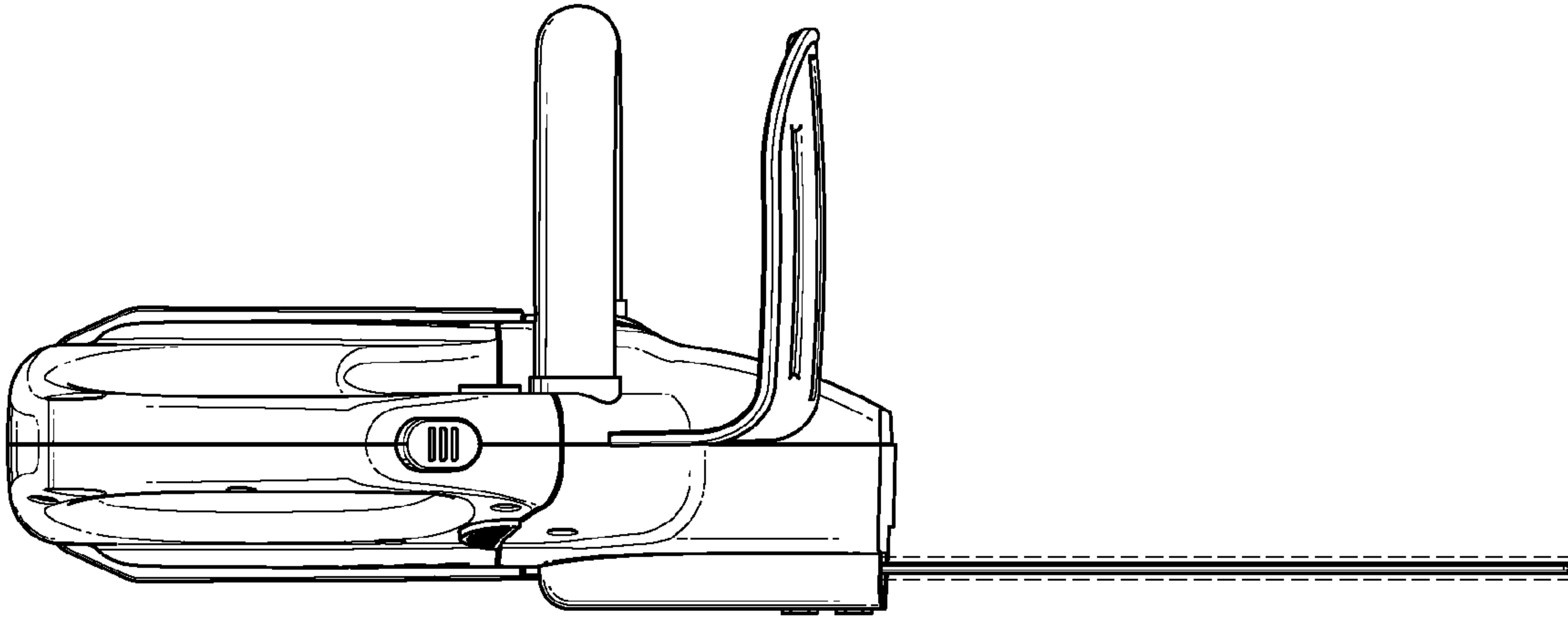

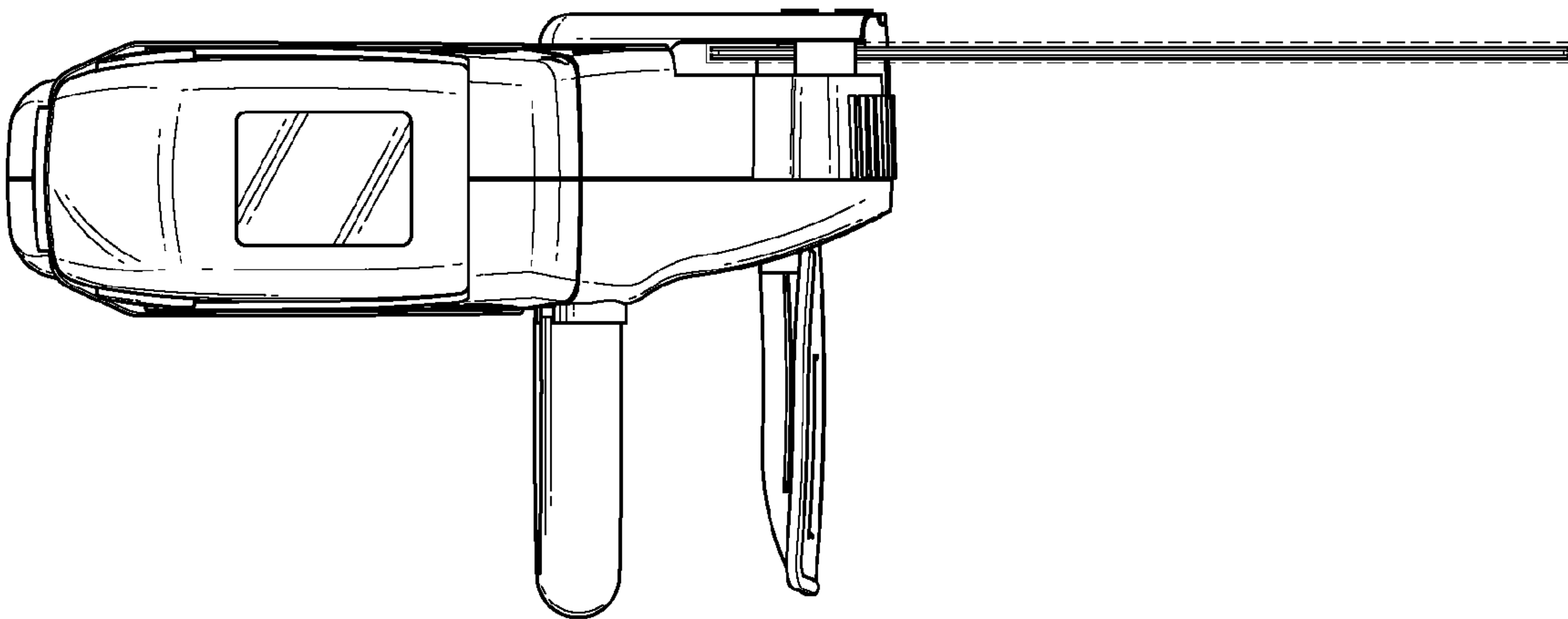

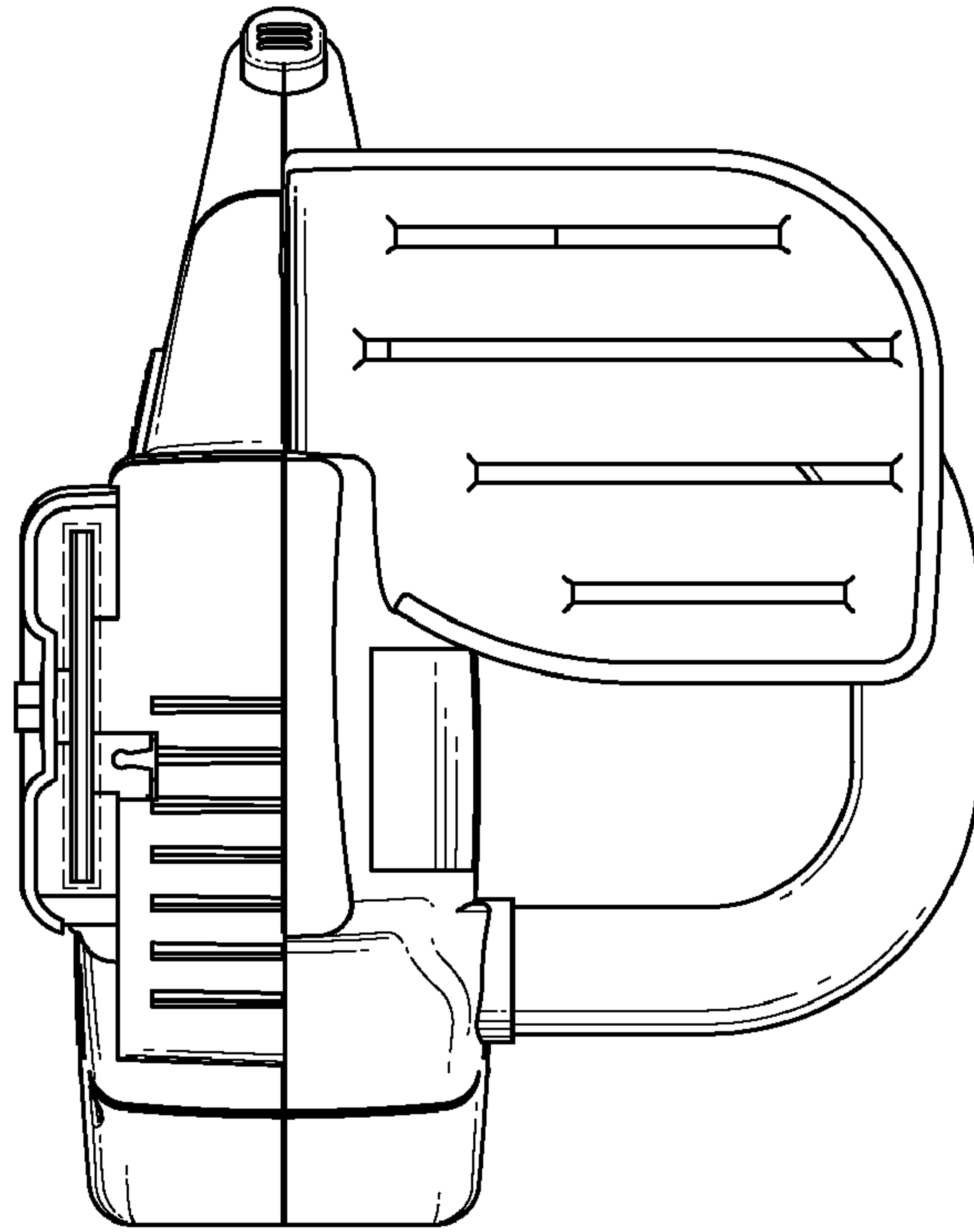

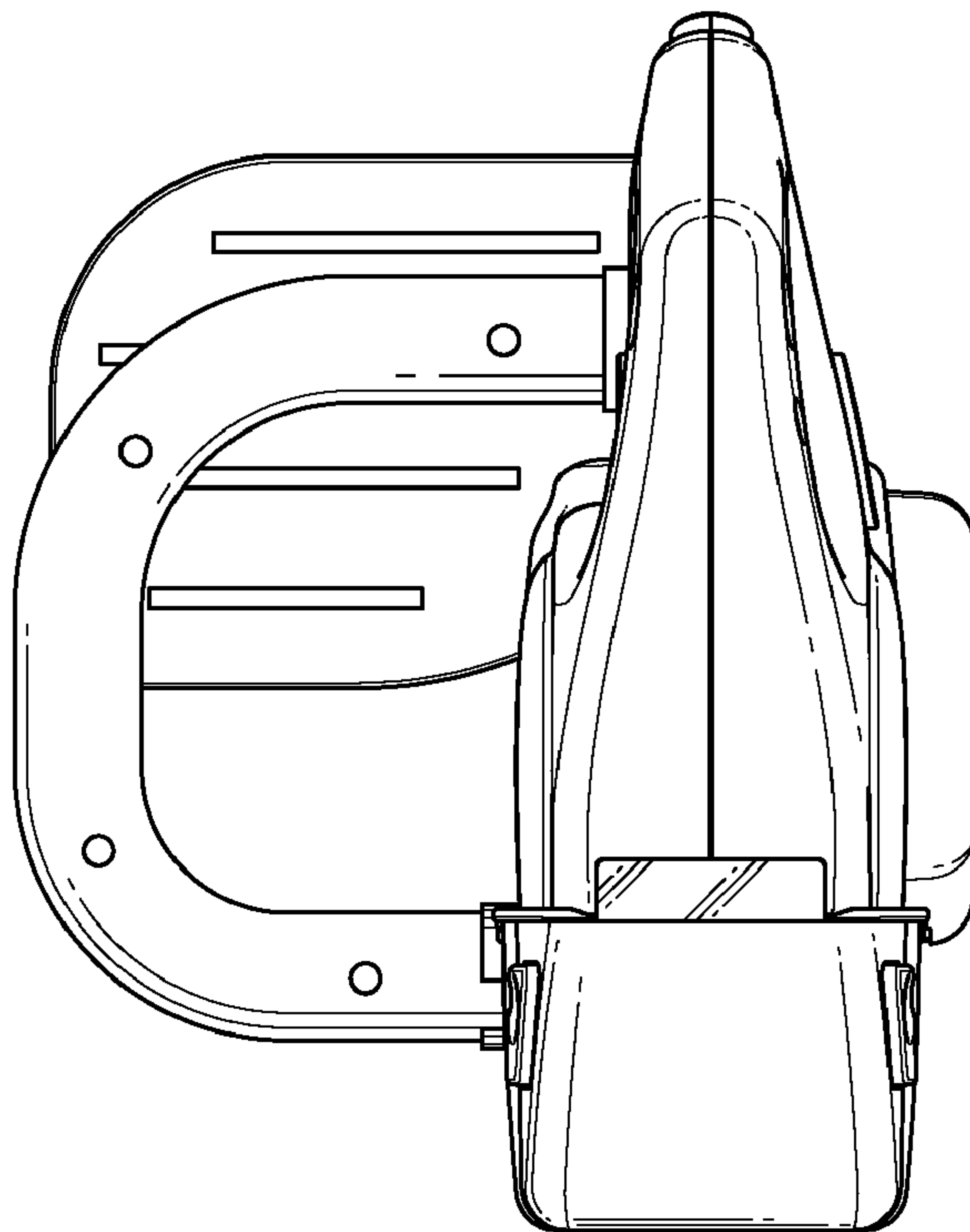
