## (57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a motorcycle foot peg, as shown and described herein.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the motorcycle foot peg of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view of the motorcycle foot peg of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view of the motorcycle foot peg of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a rear side elevation view of the motorcycle foot peg of FIG. 1.


FIG. 5 is a front side elevation view of the motorcycle foot peg of FIG. 1.










