FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the design;

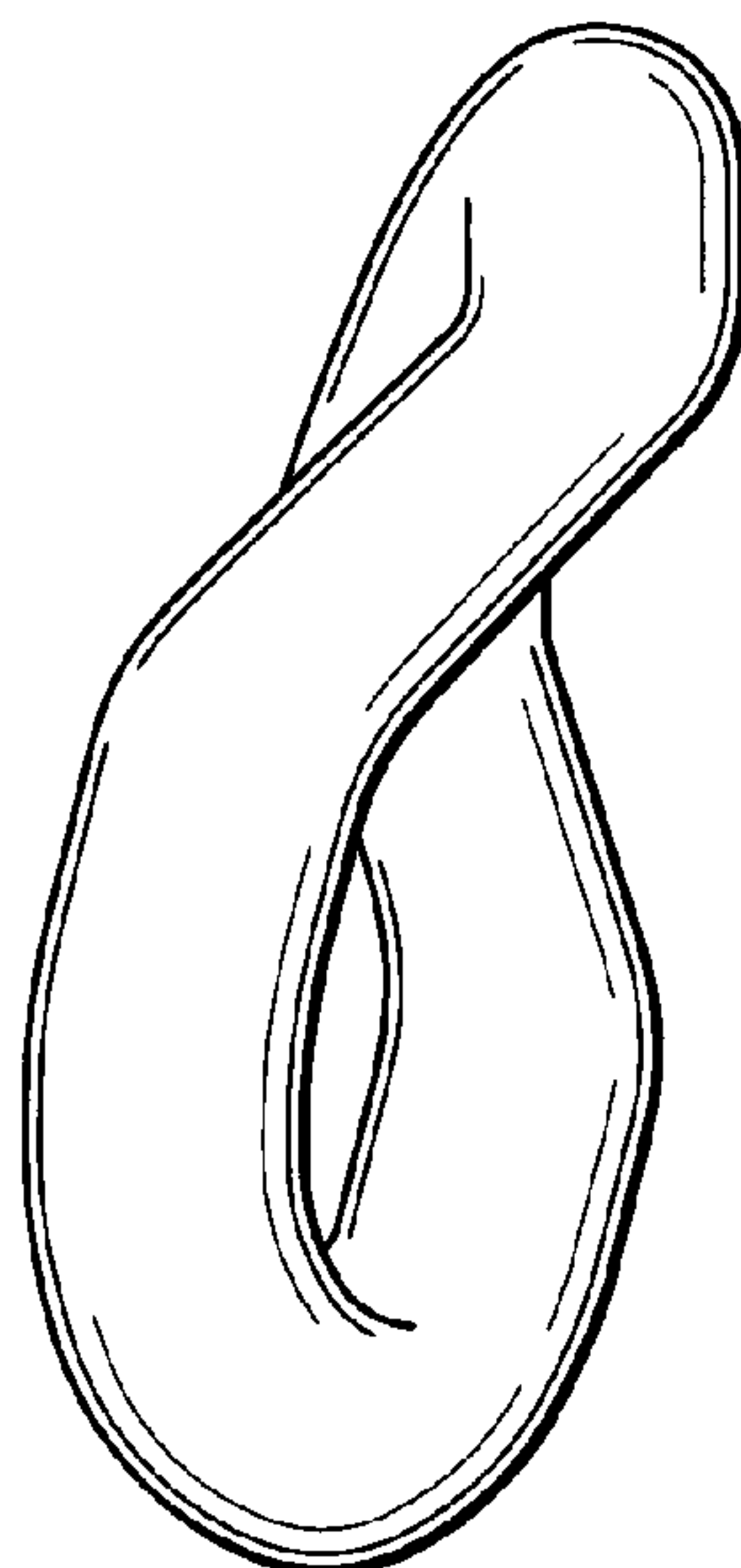
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the design;

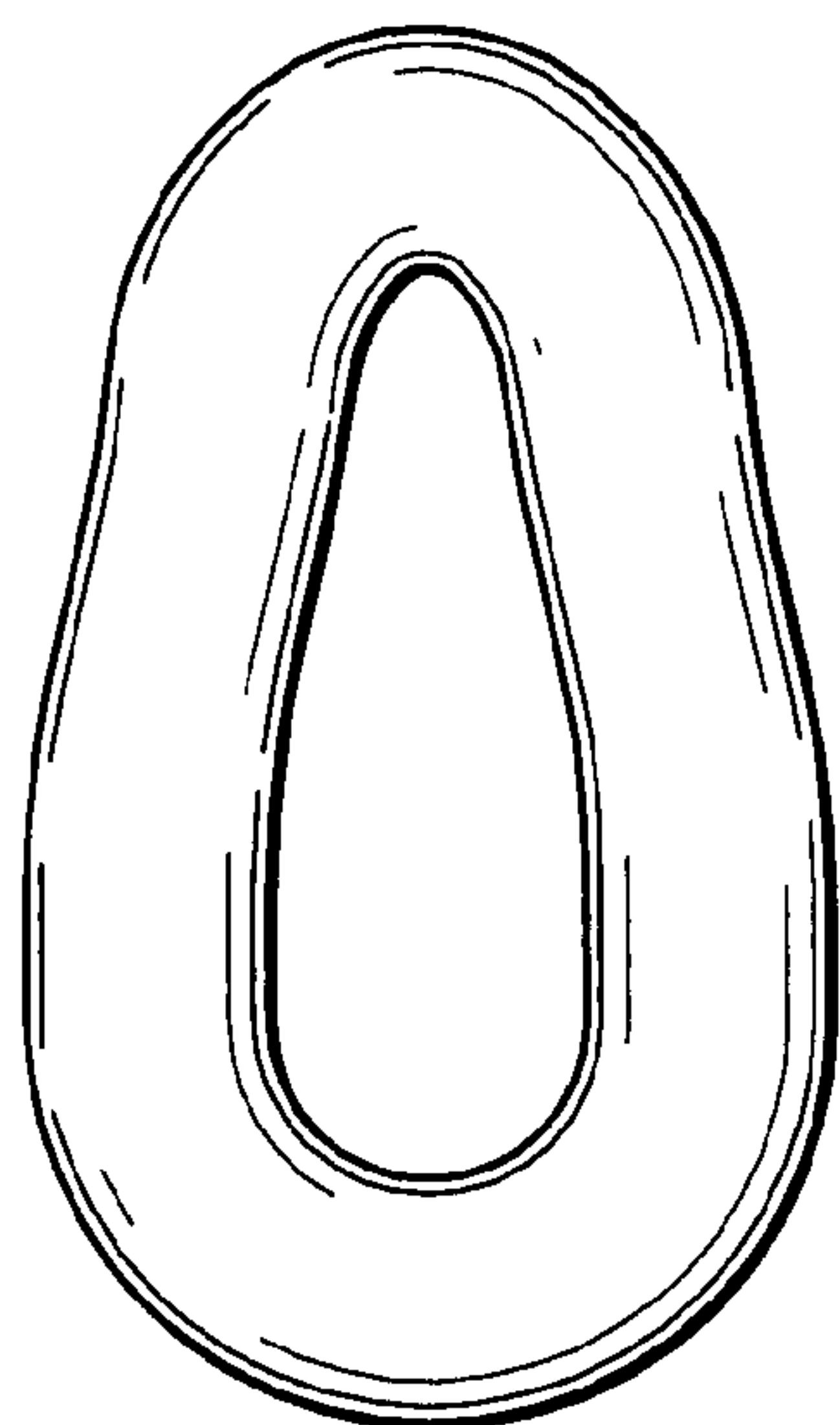

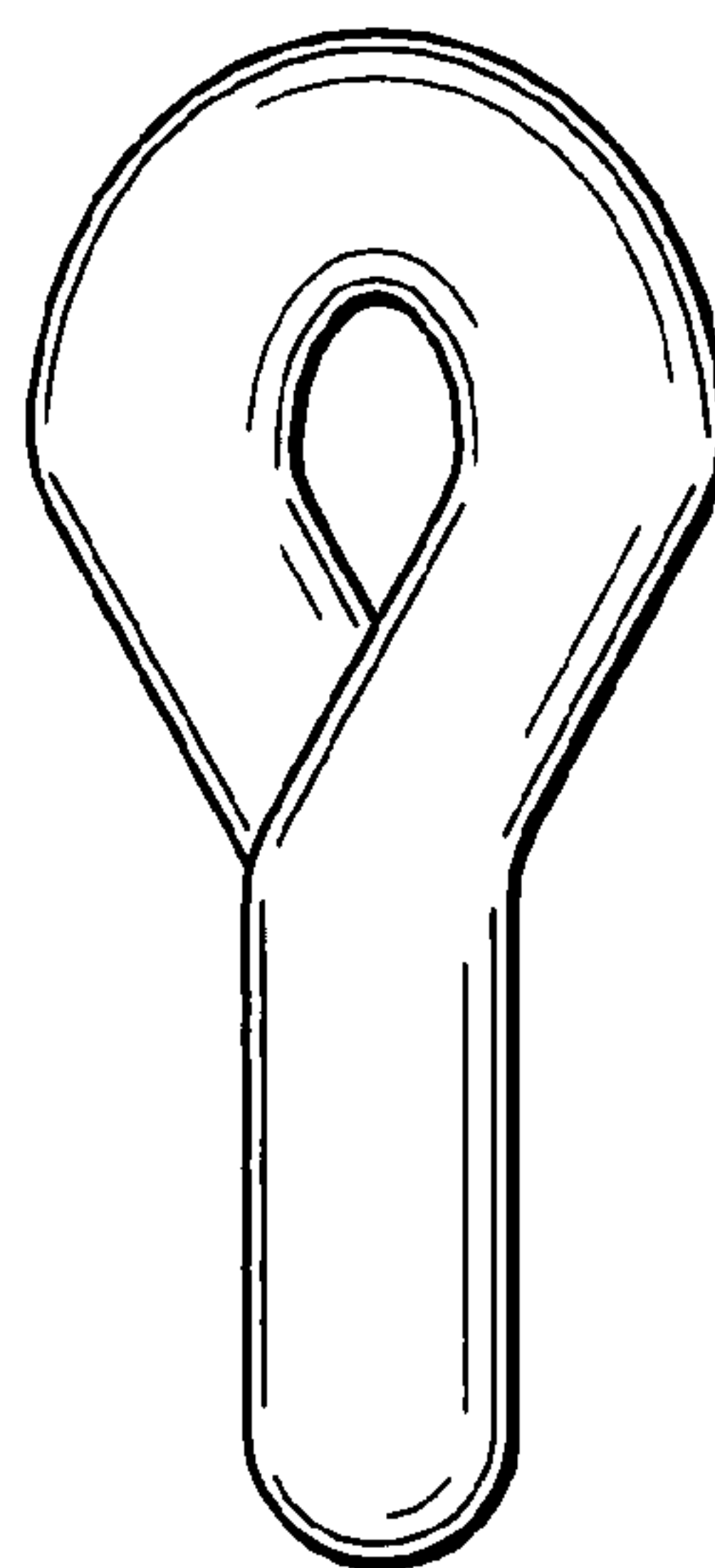

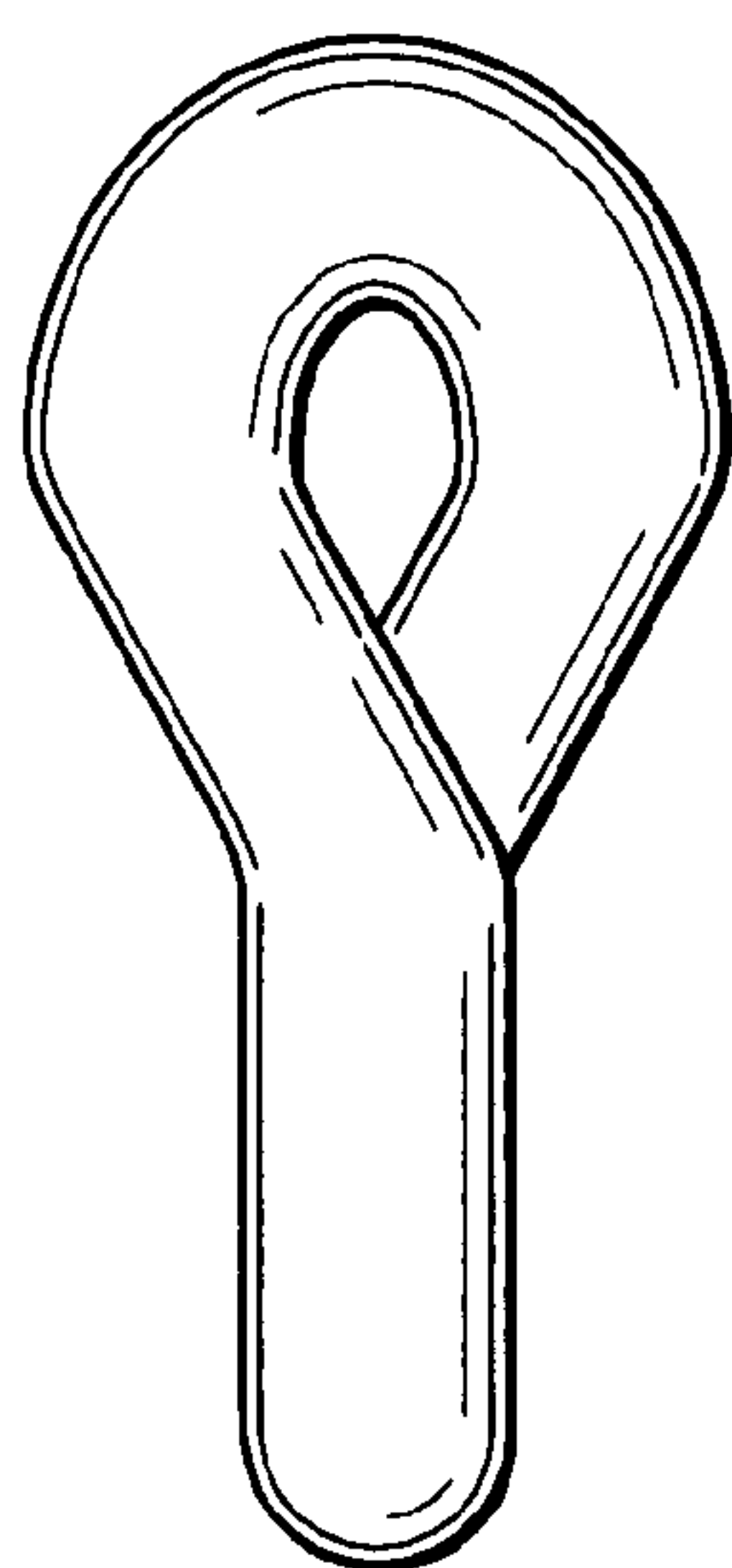

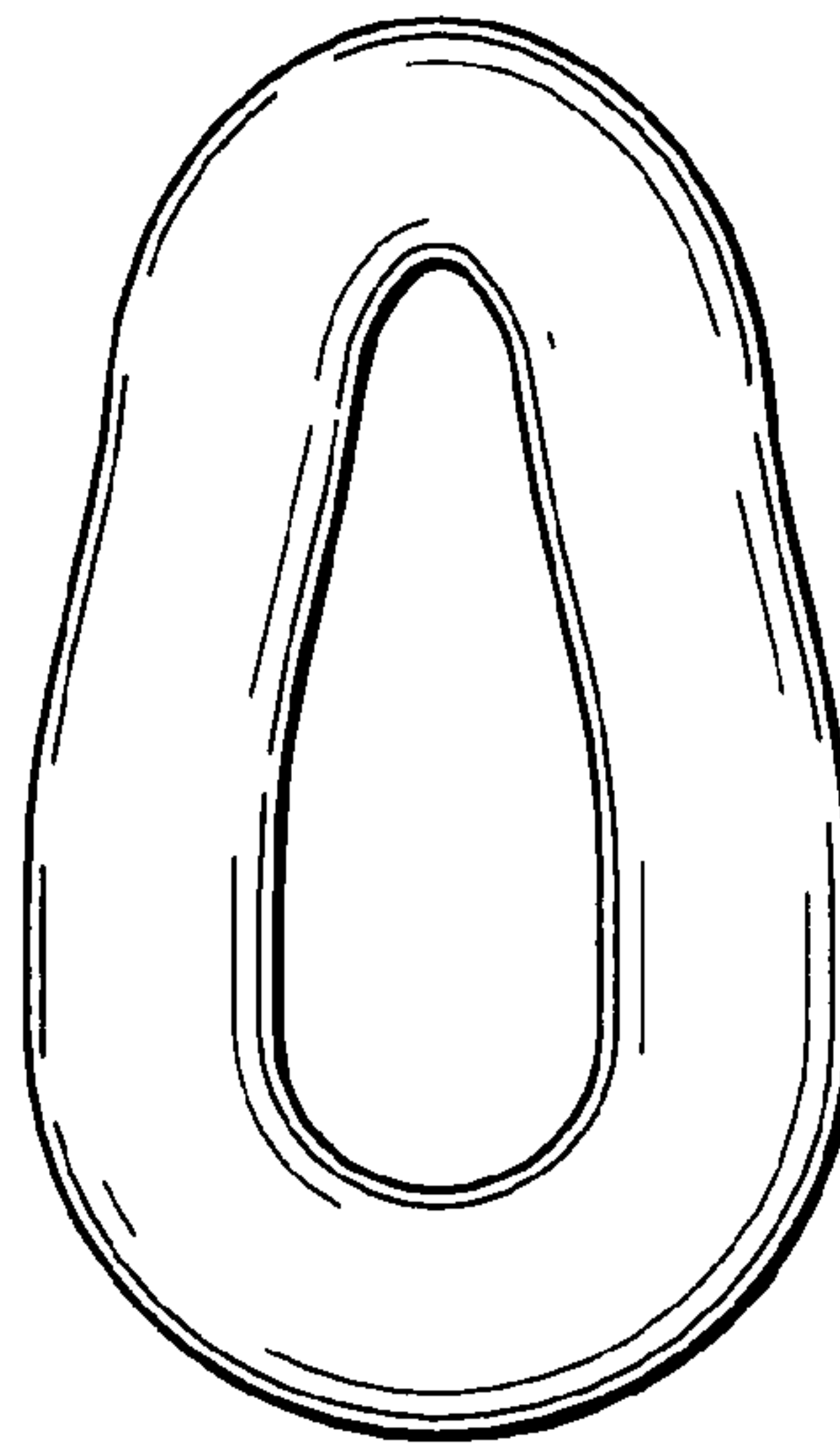

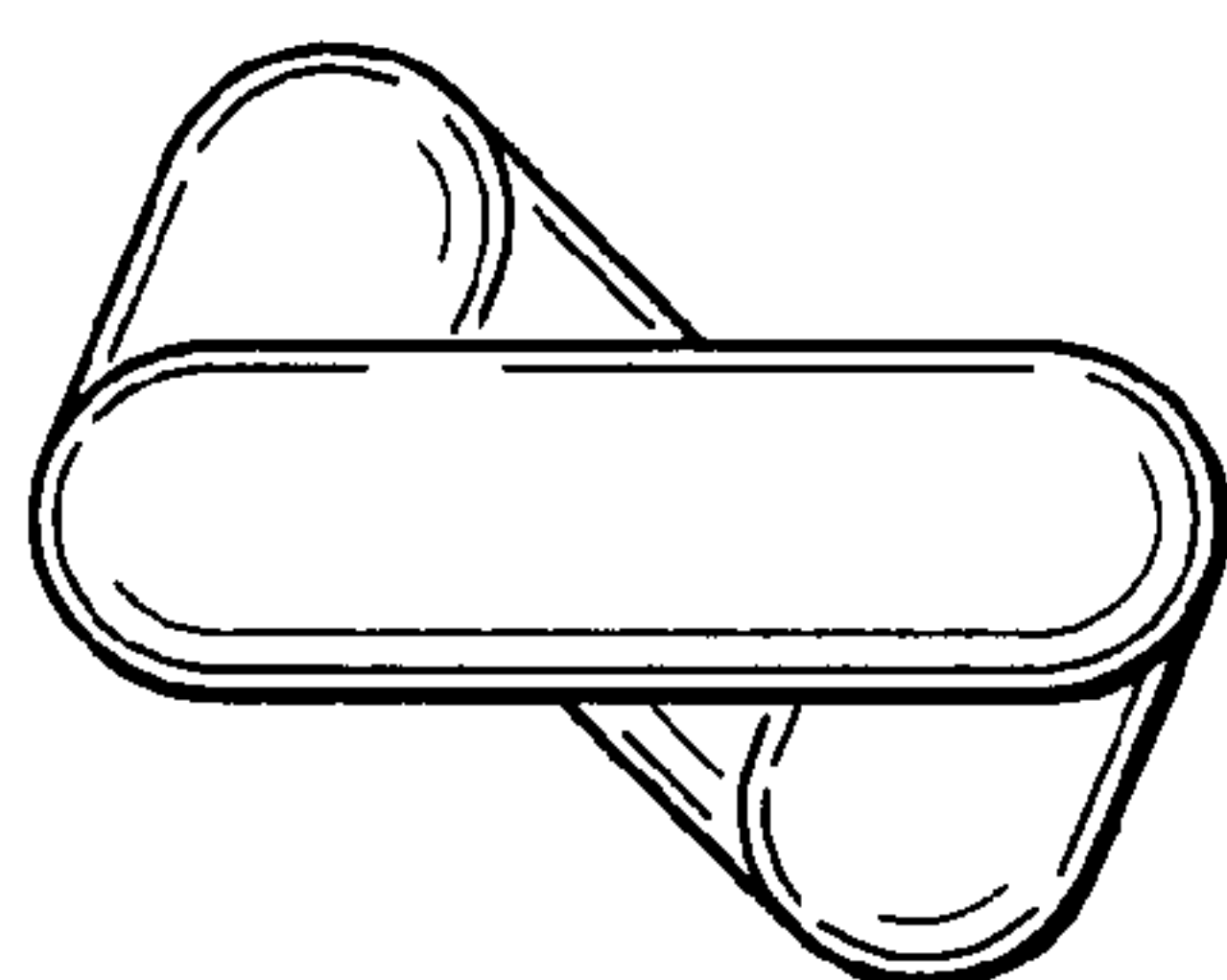

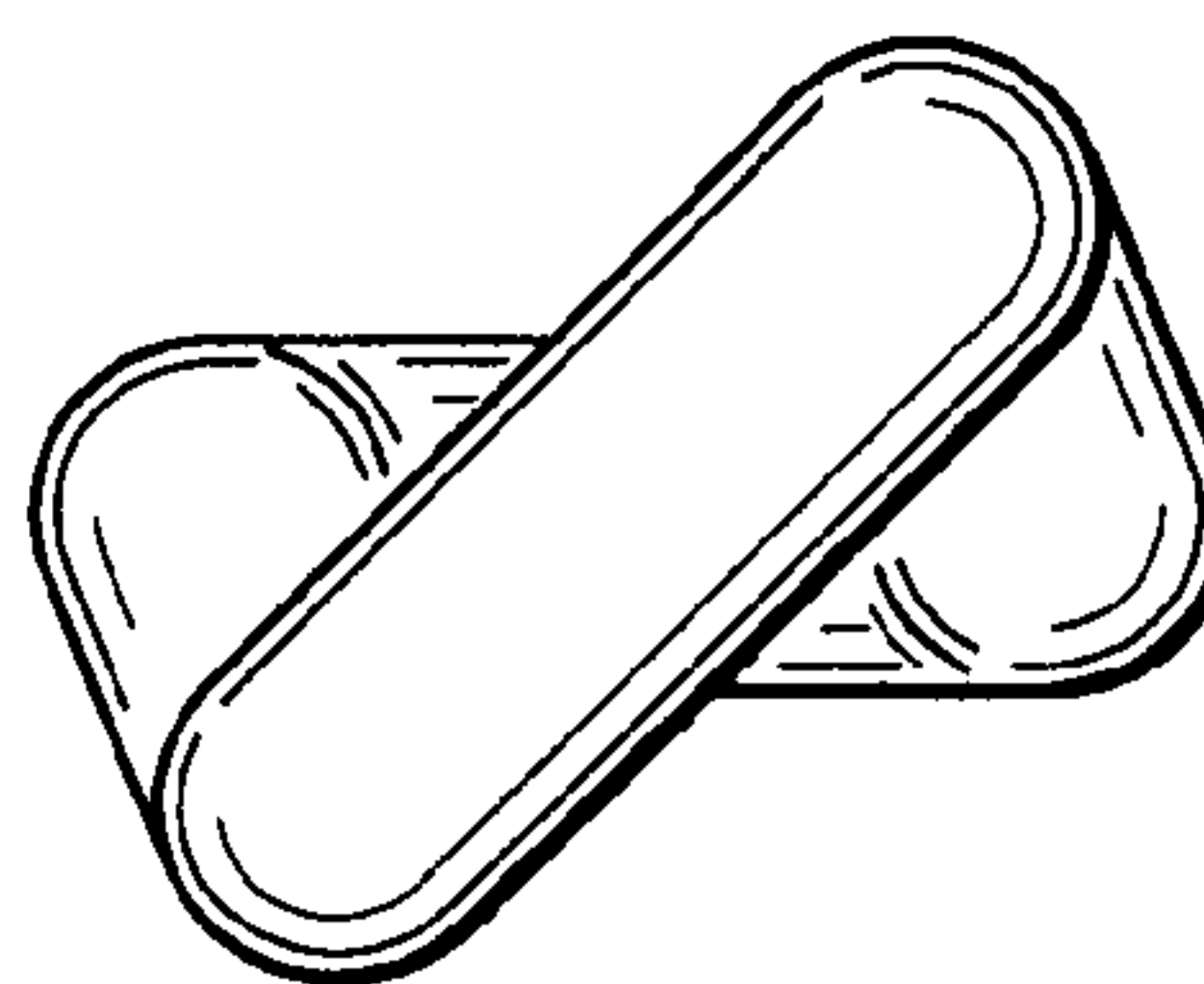

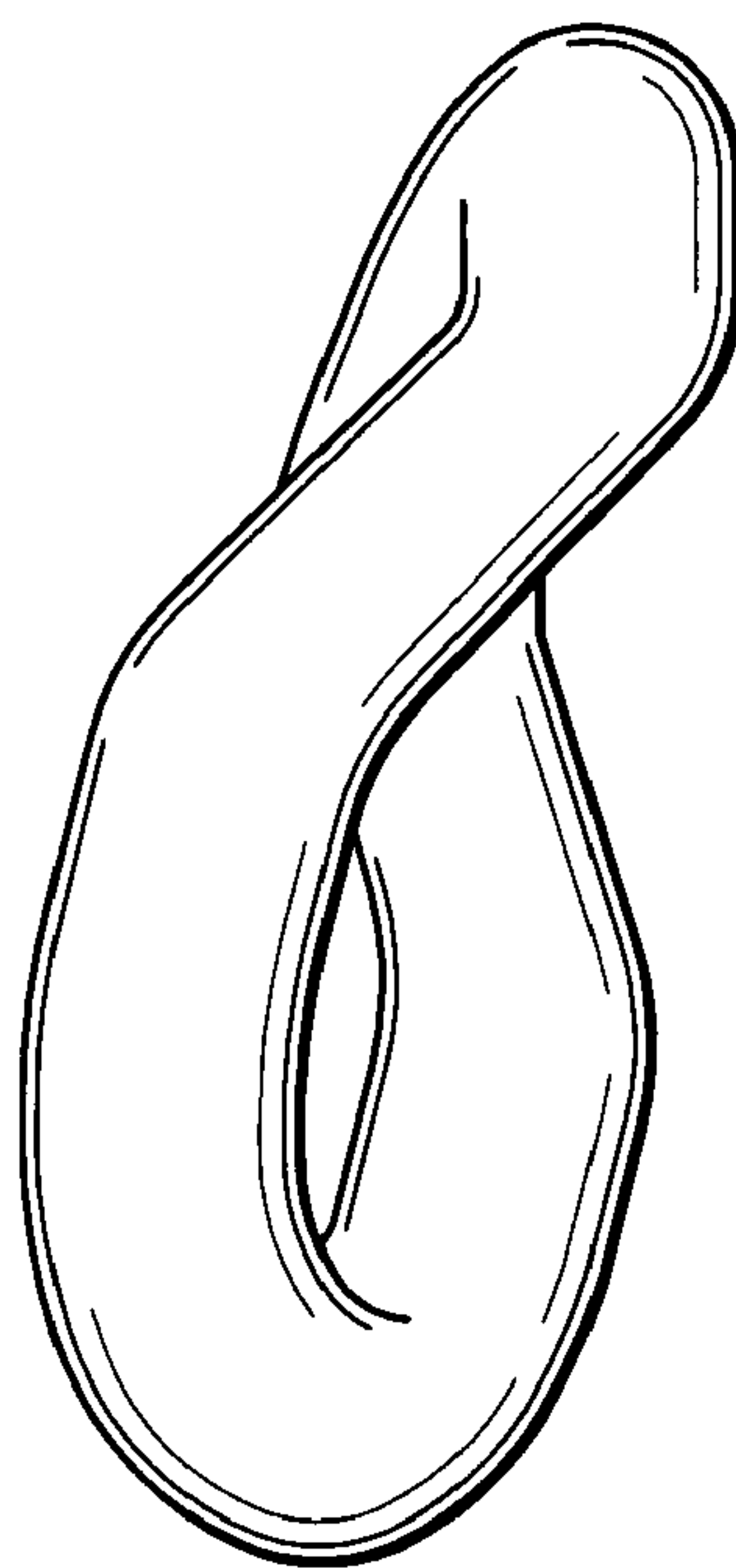
