FIG. 4 is an elevation from the left side of the spectacles of FIG. 1, where the temples are shown in an extended position;

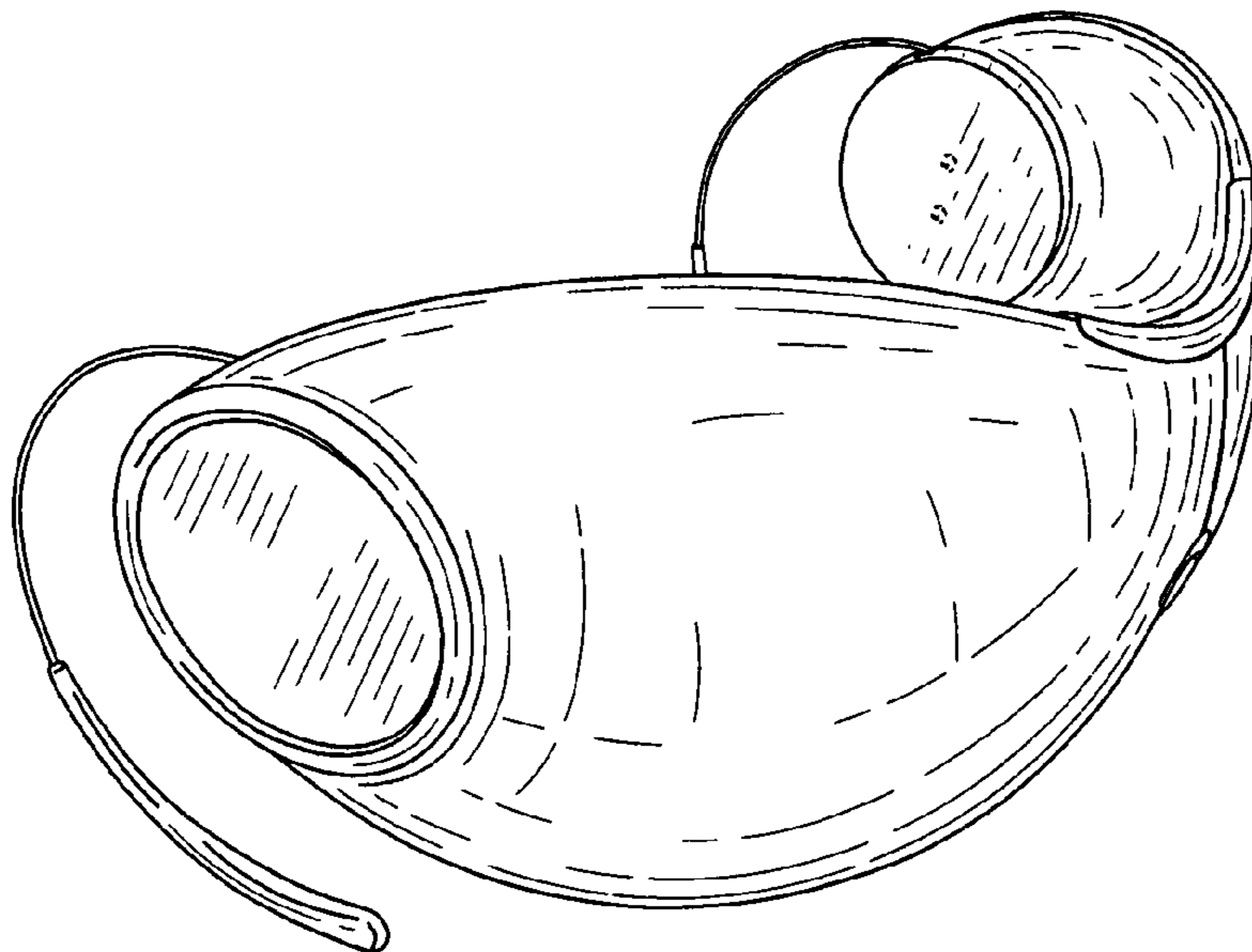
FIG. 5 a top plan view of the spectacles of FIG. 1, where the temples are shown in an extended position;

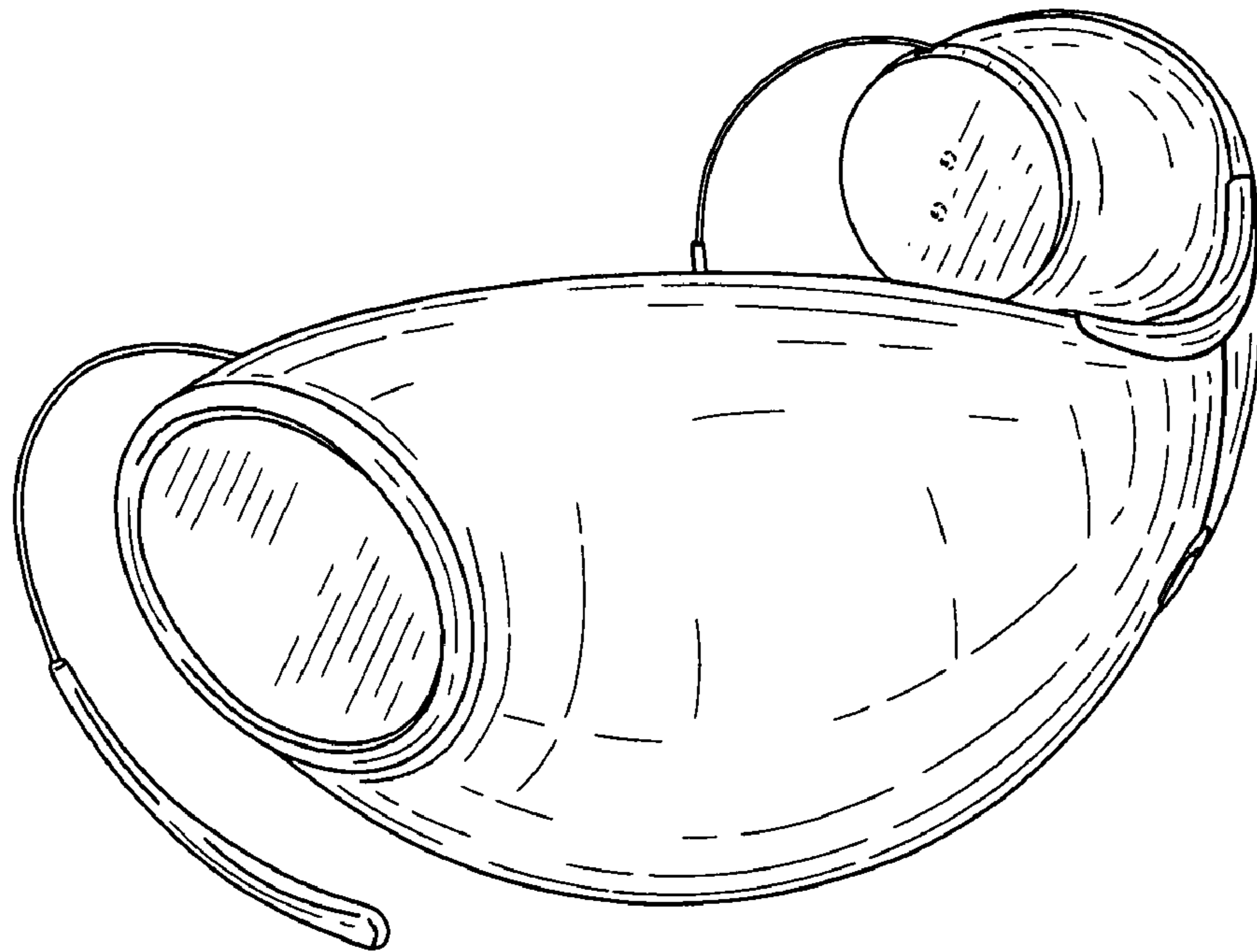

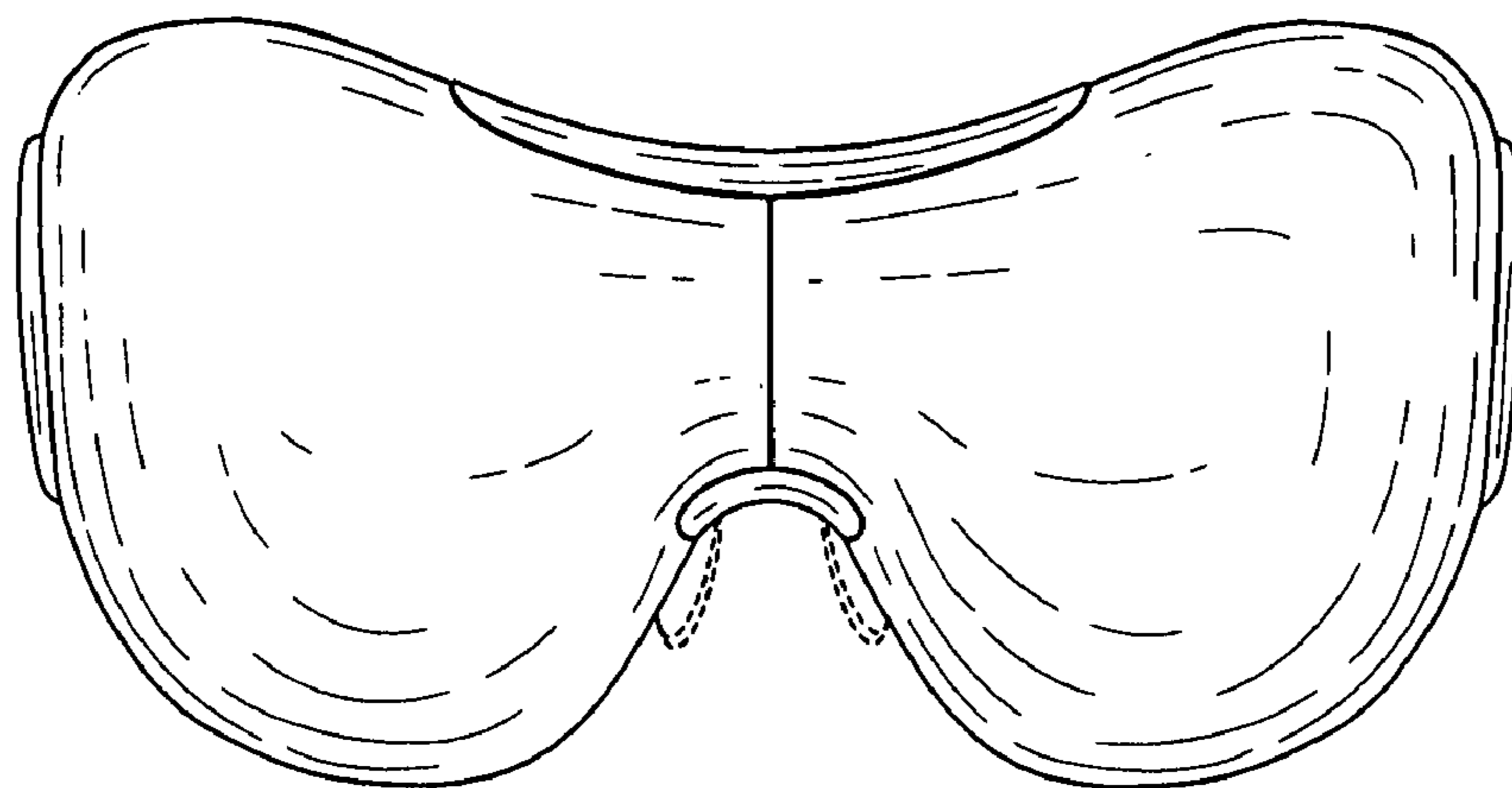

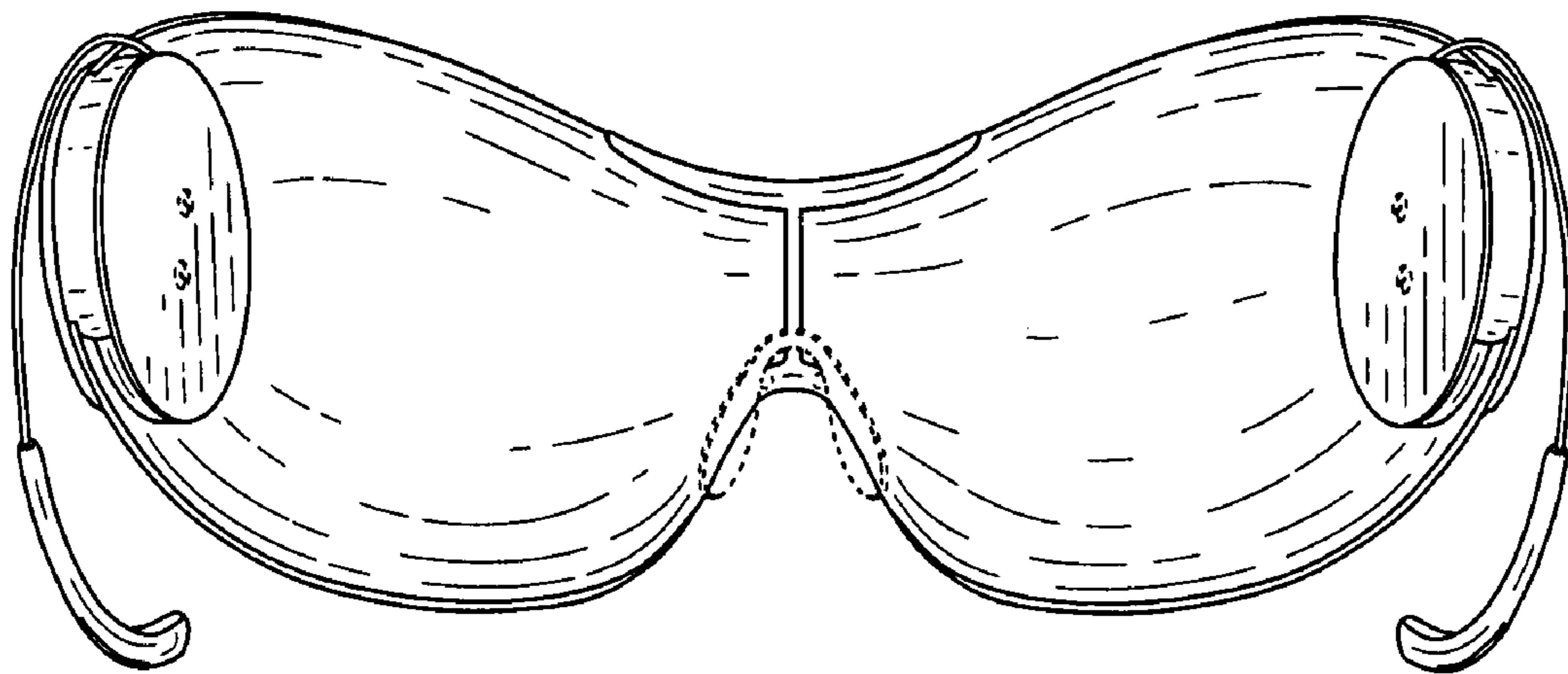

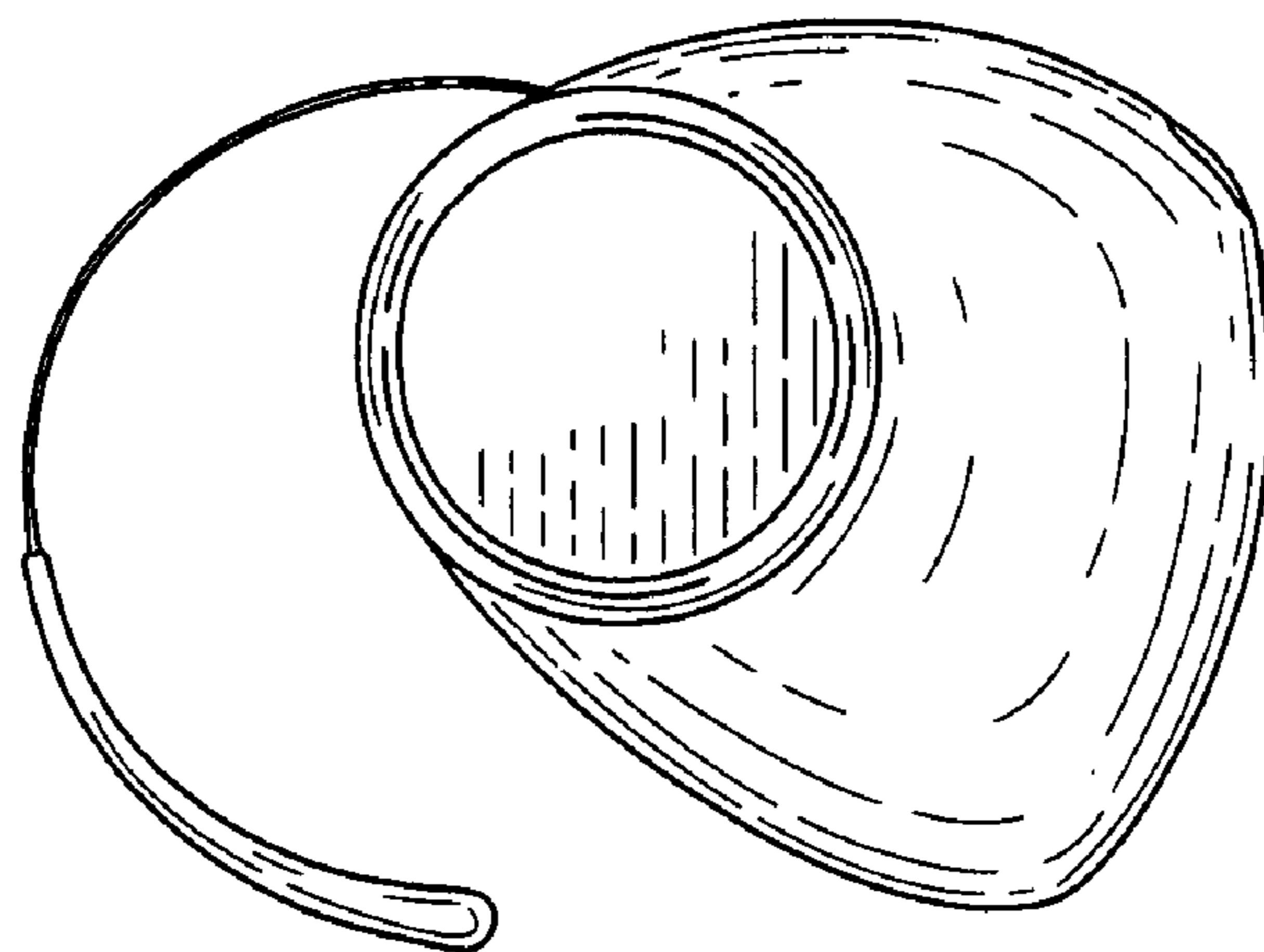

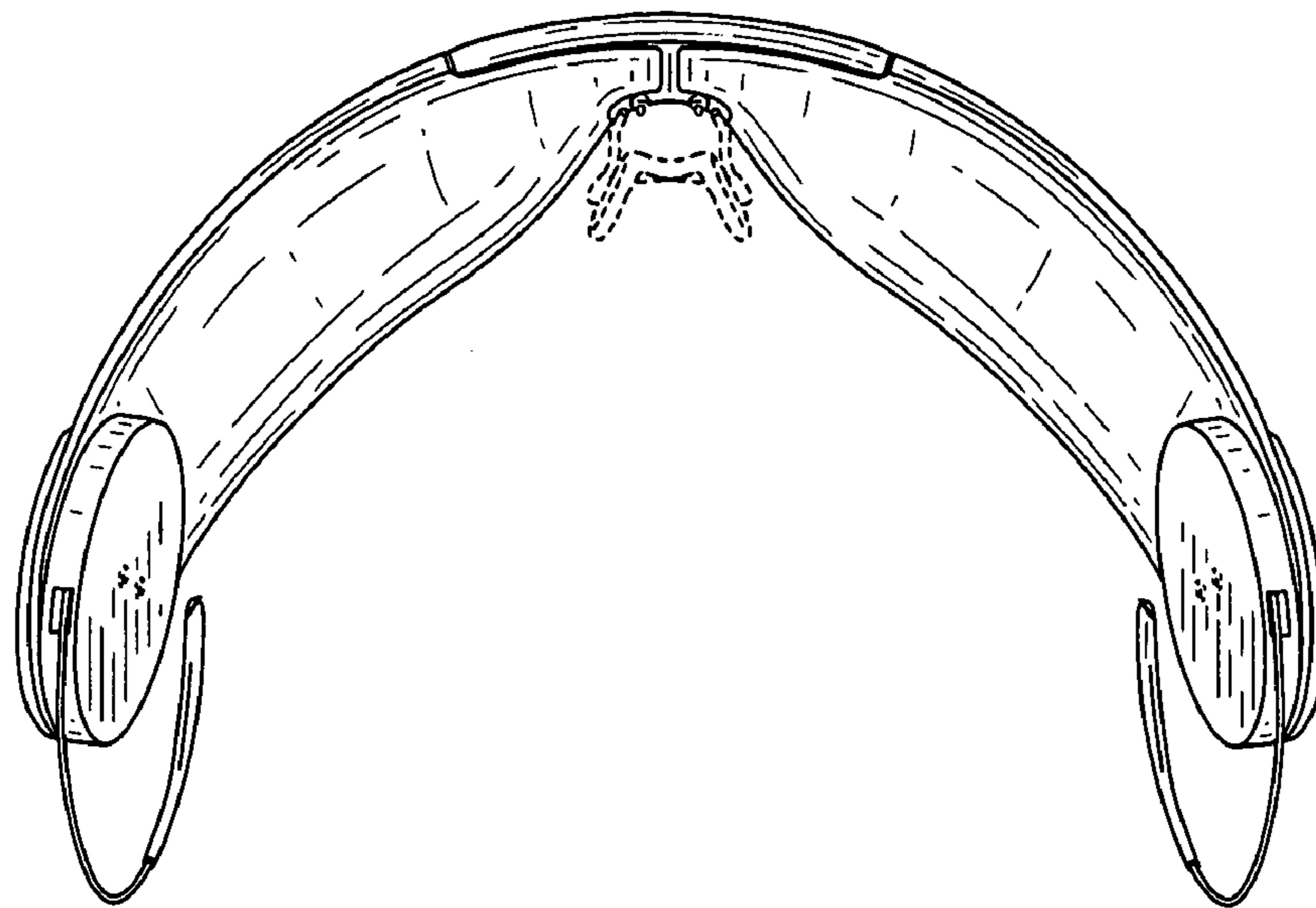

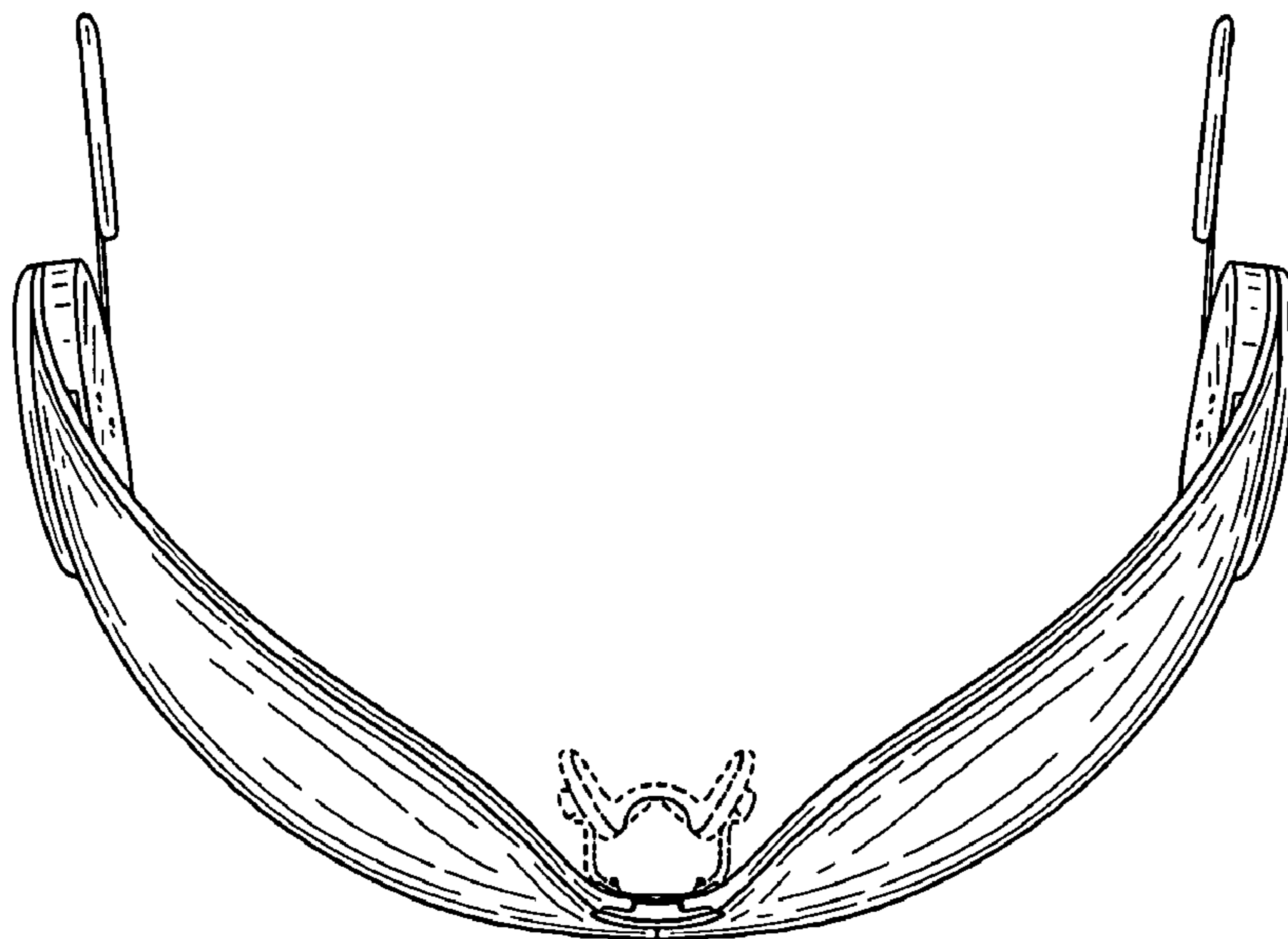

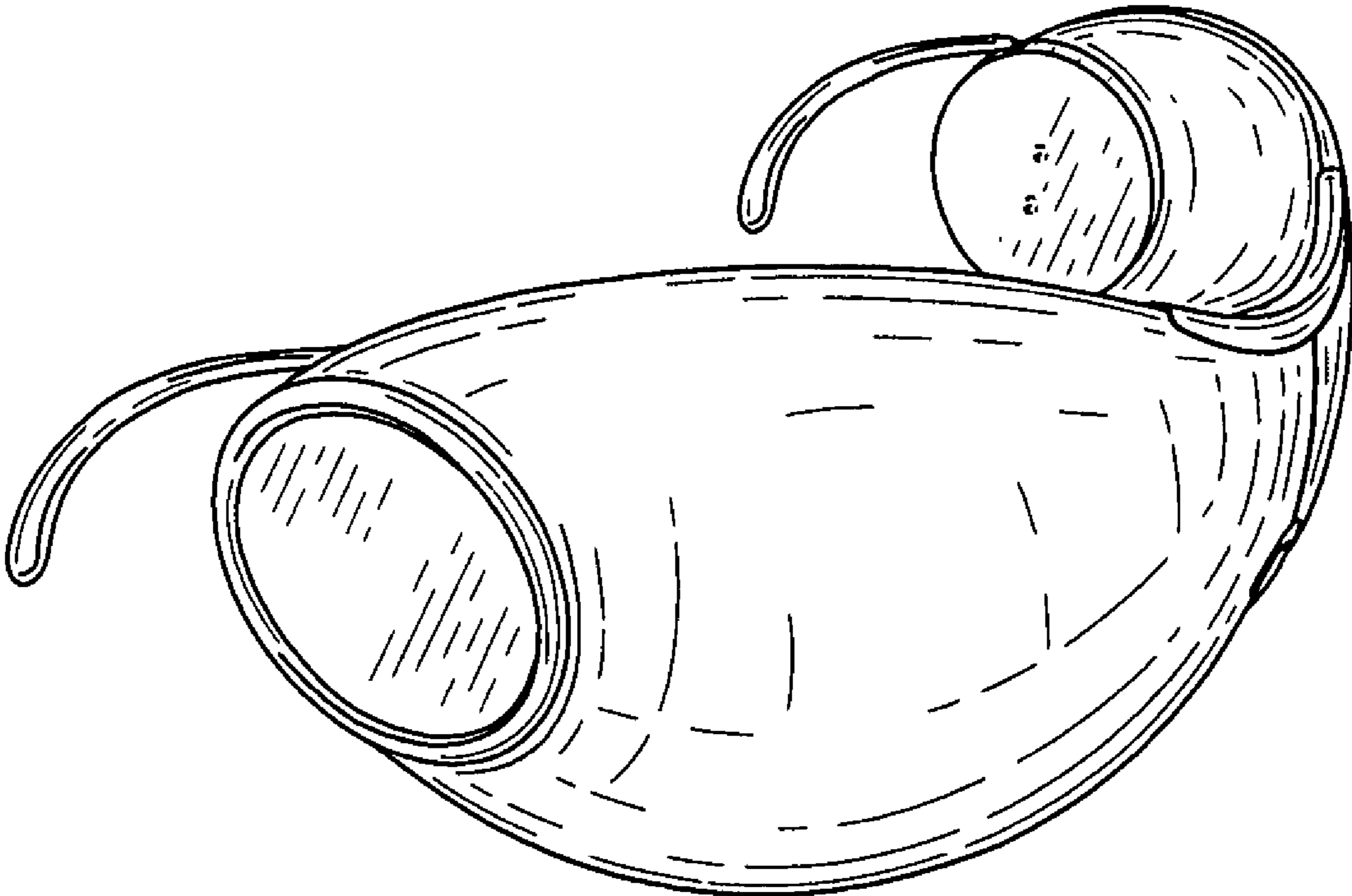
